4.4 is a right view thereof;

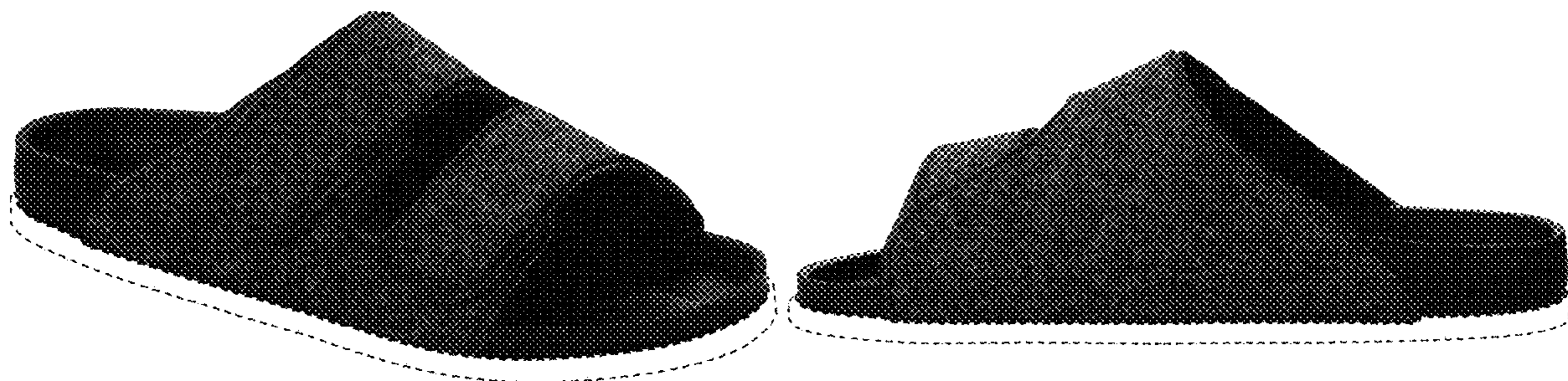
4.5 is a left view thereof;

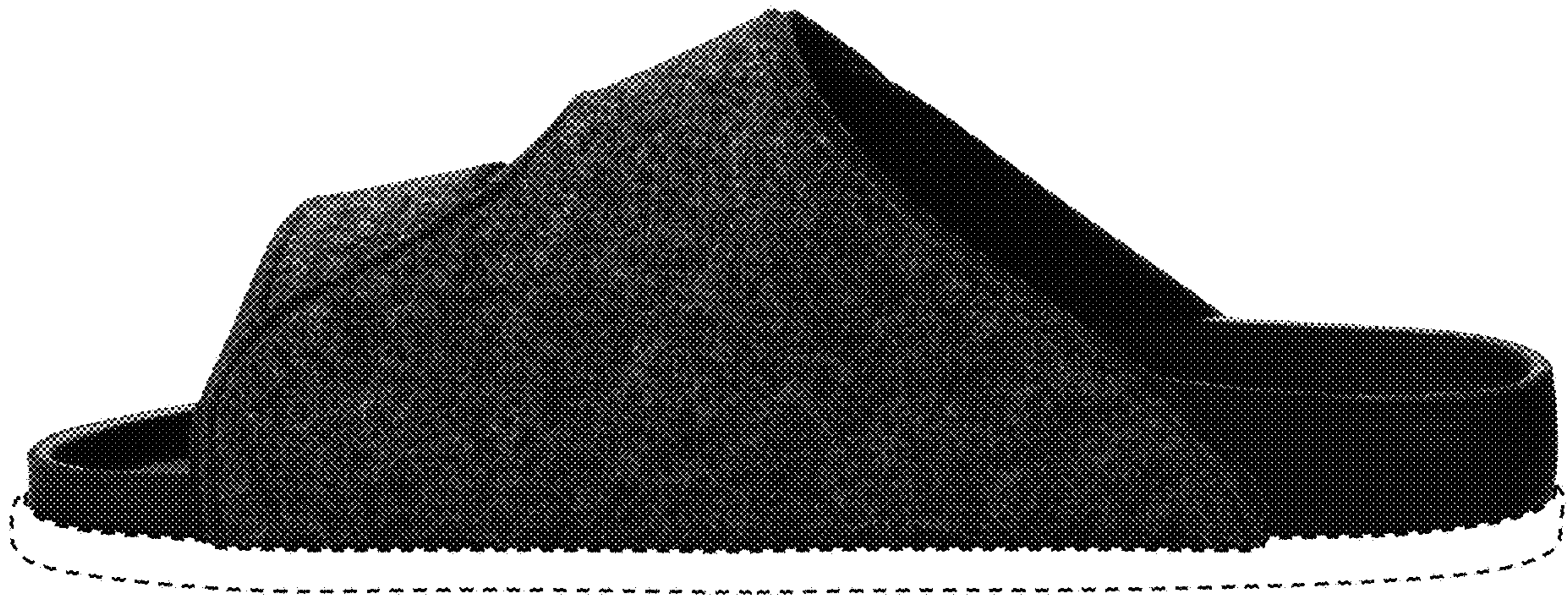
