DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a portion of a display panel or portion thereof with an animated graphical user interface showing the first image in a sequence according to our new design;

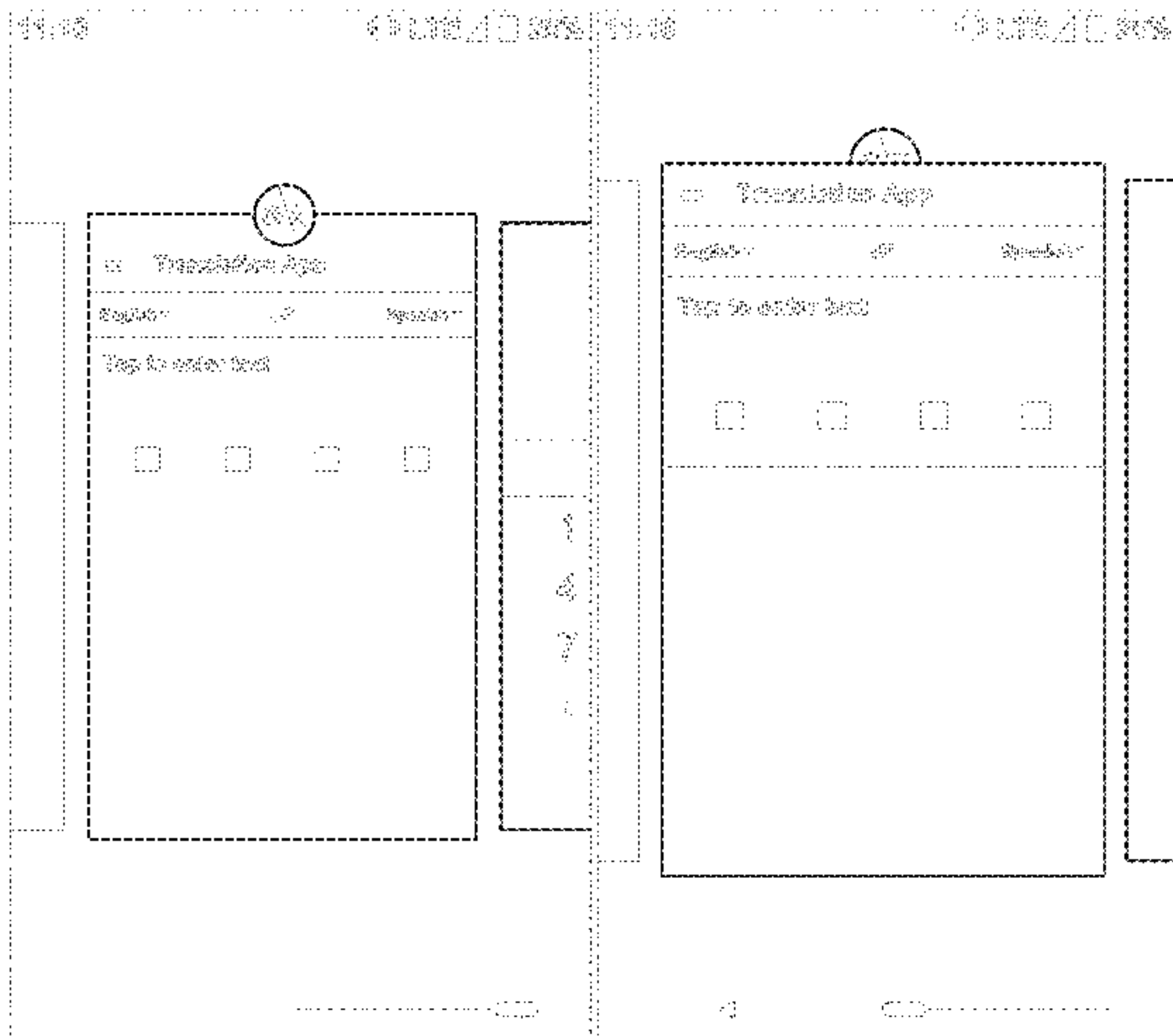
FIG. 2 is a second image thereof;

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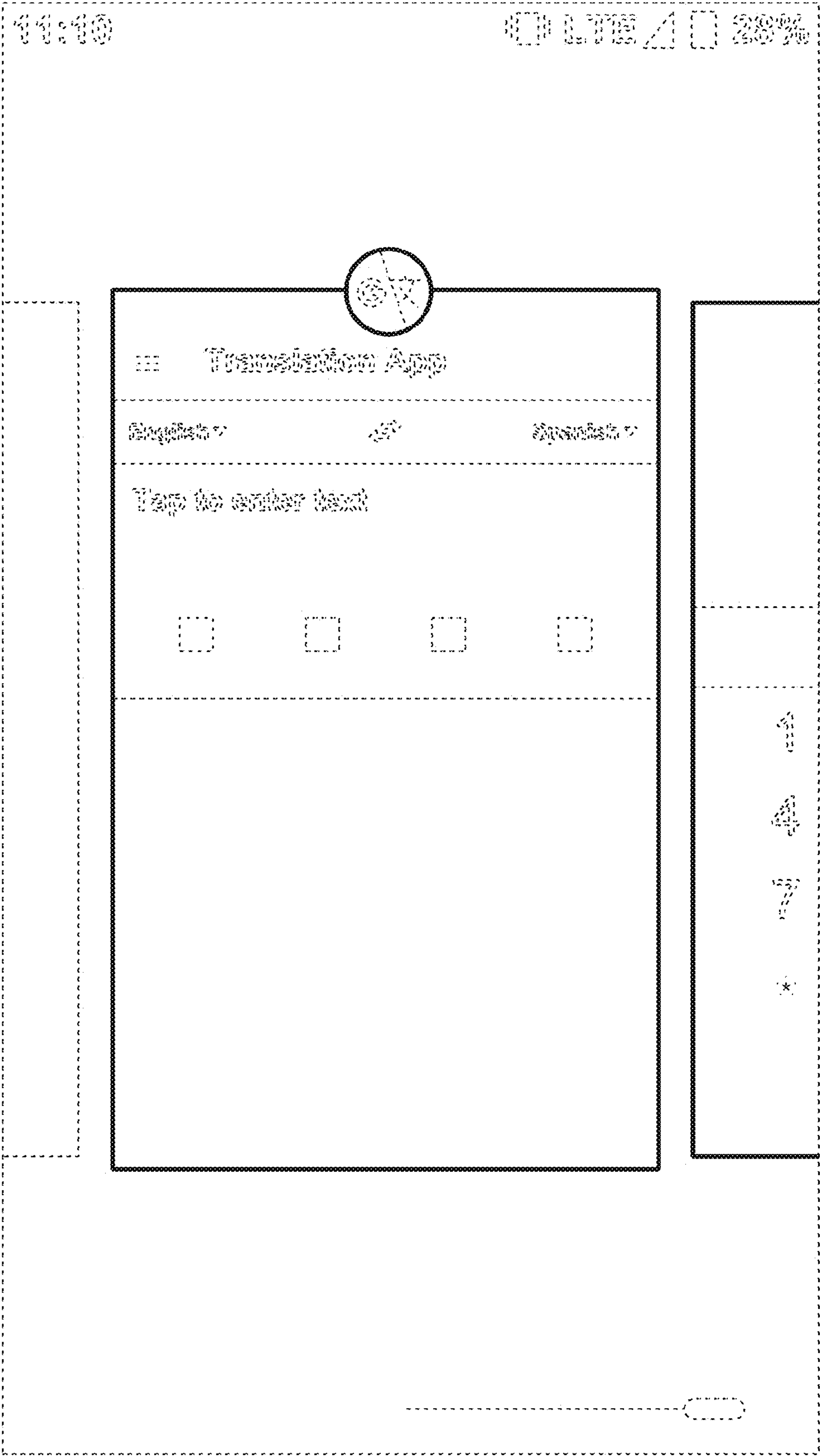

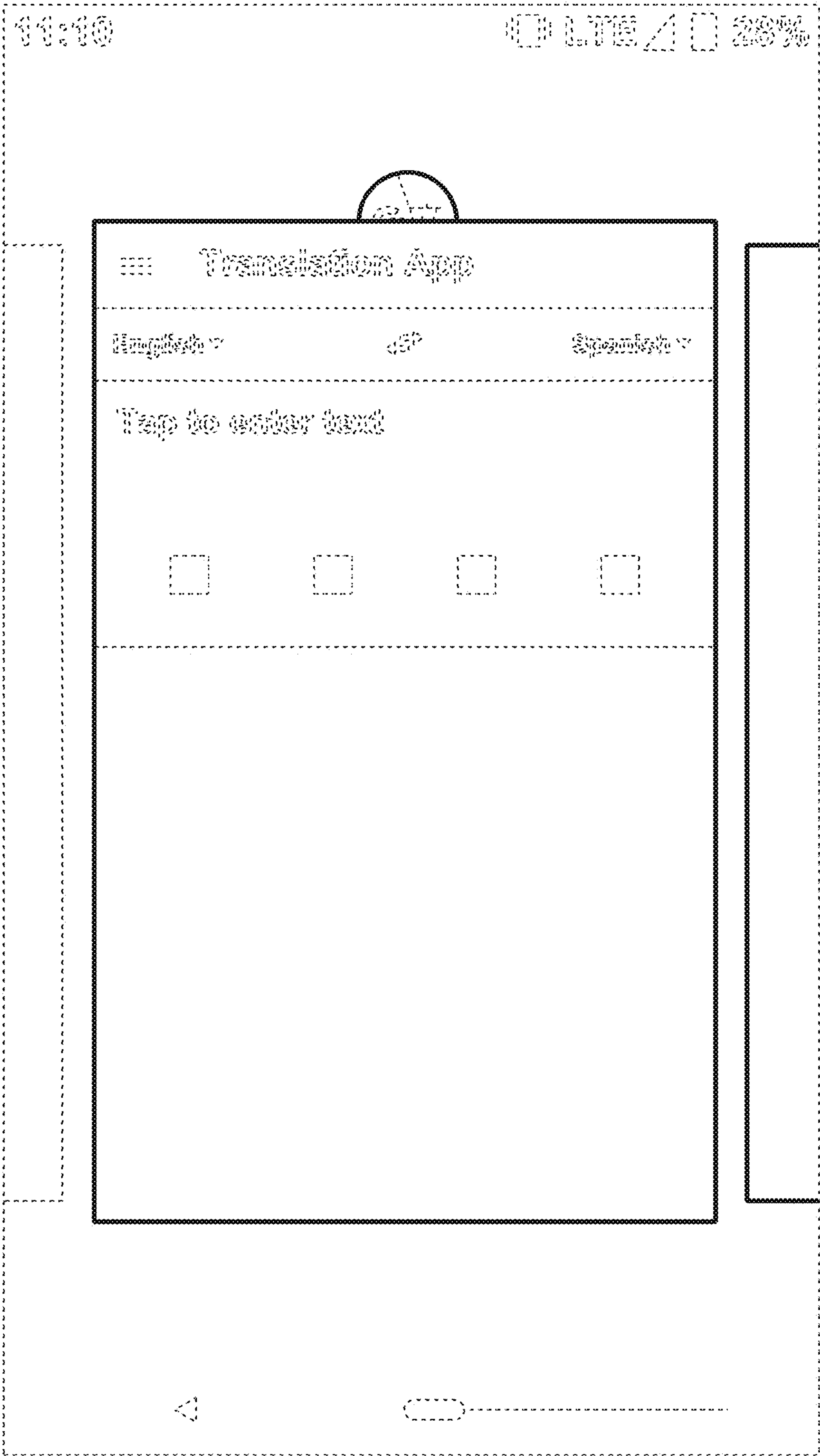

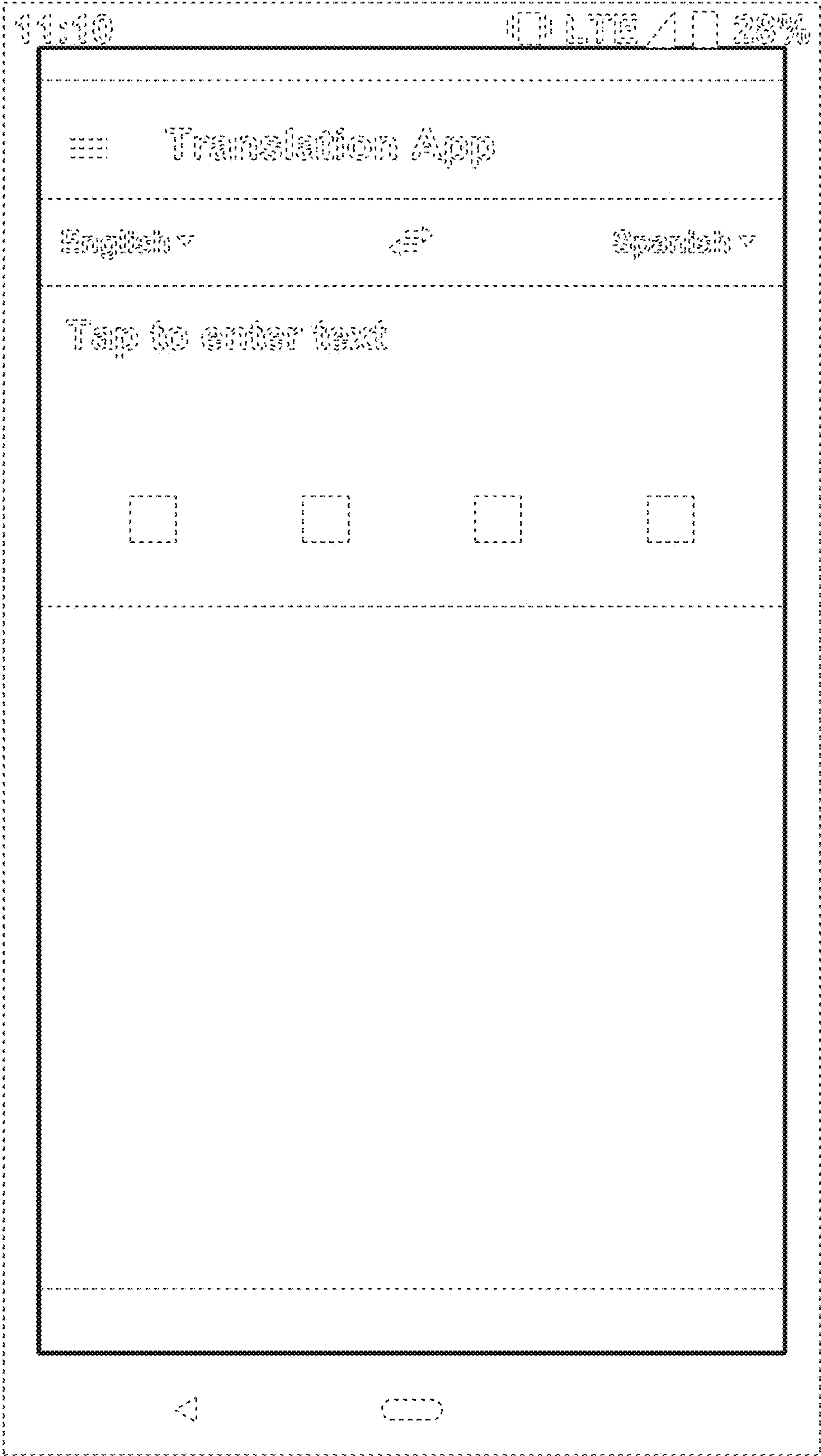

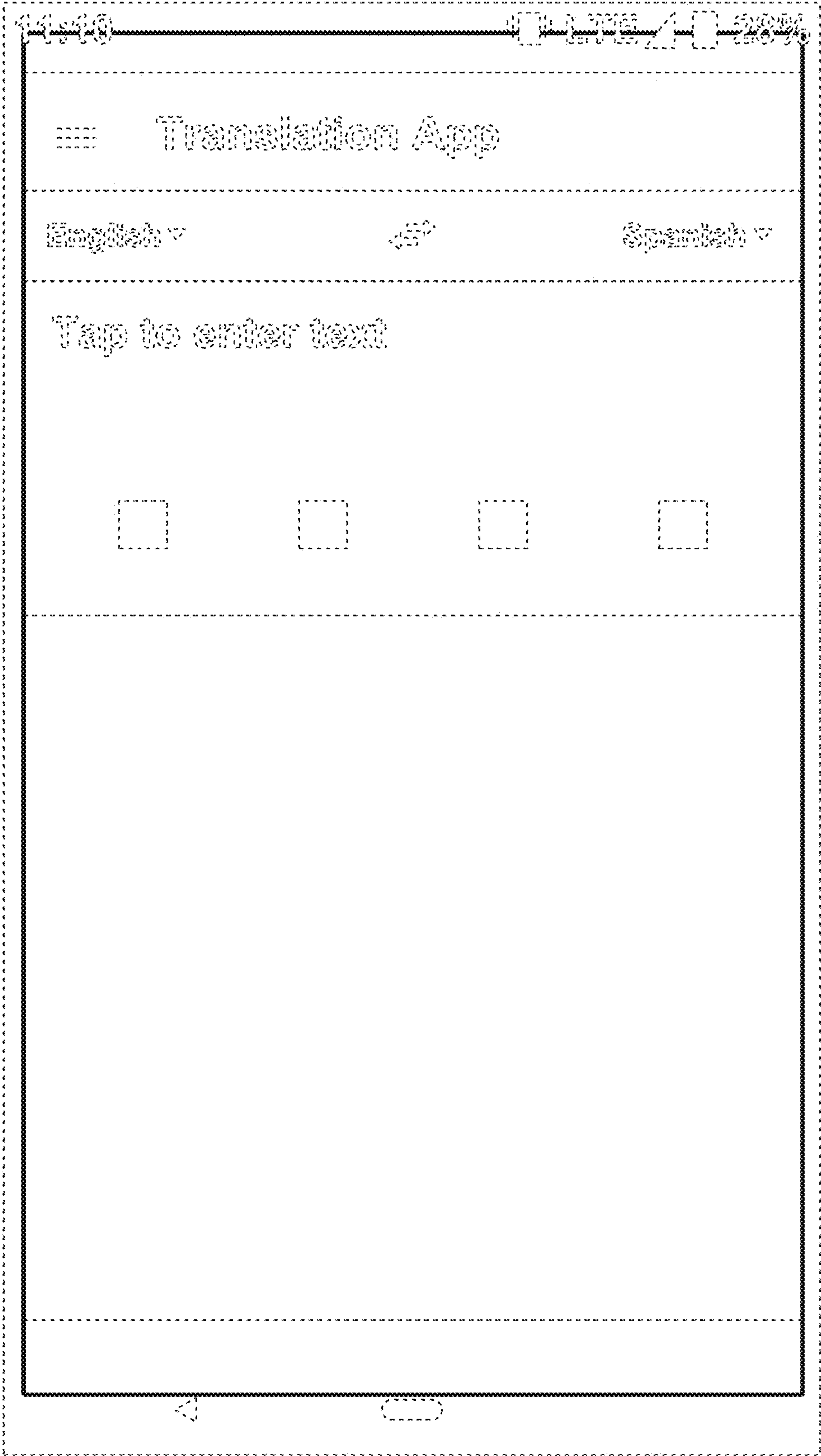
