**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 13 is an opposite side view thereof.

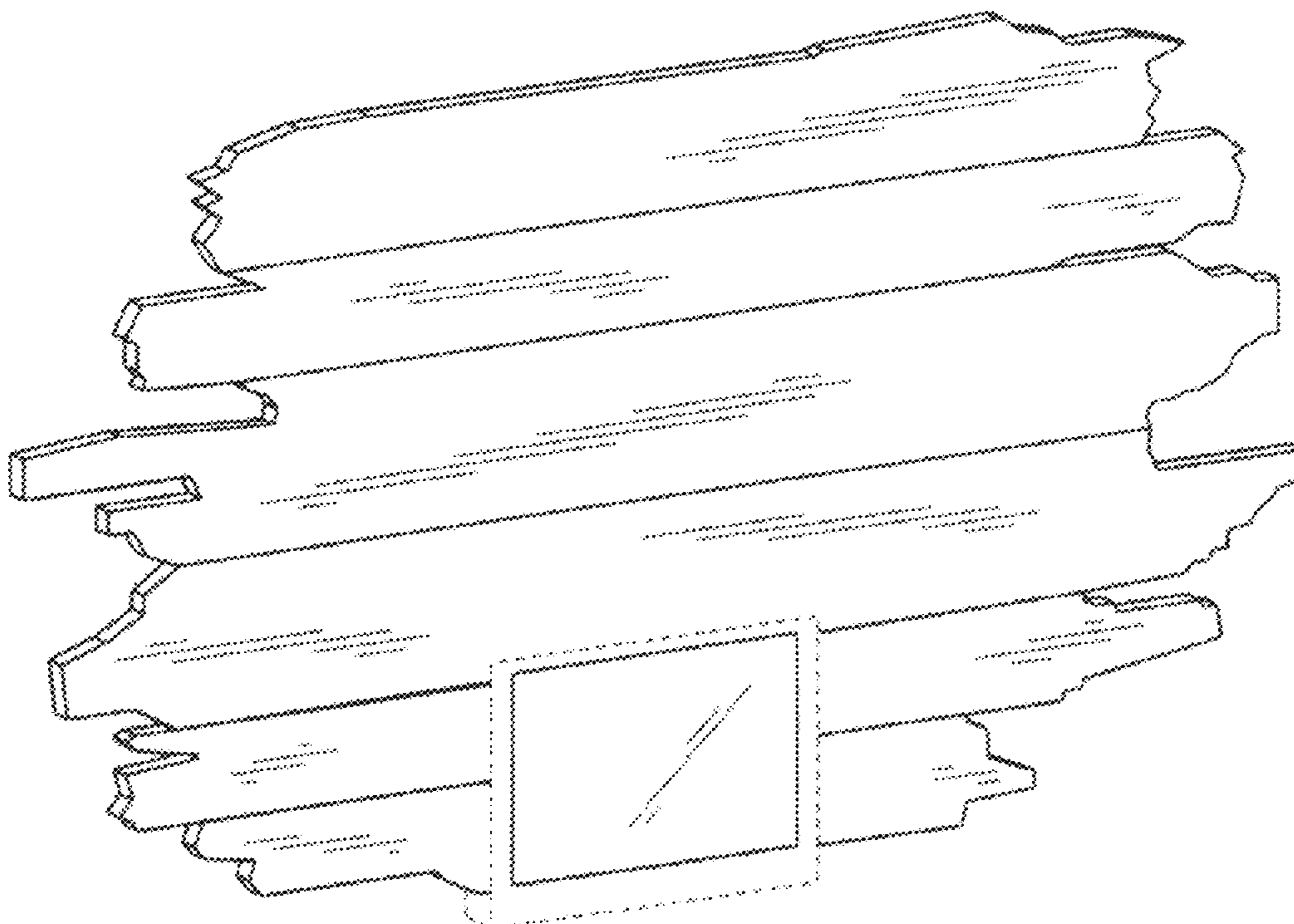
FIG. 14 is a top view thereof.

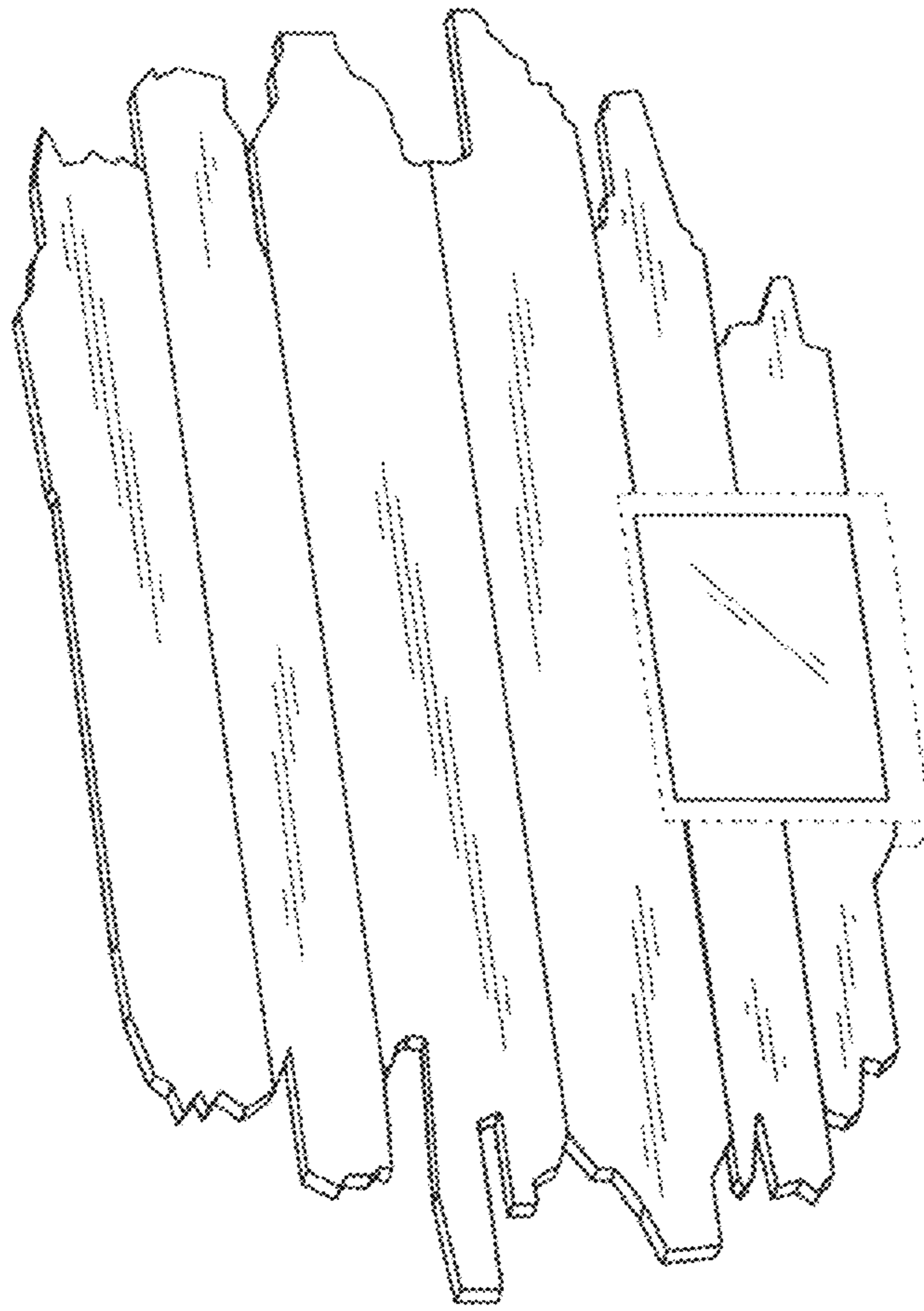

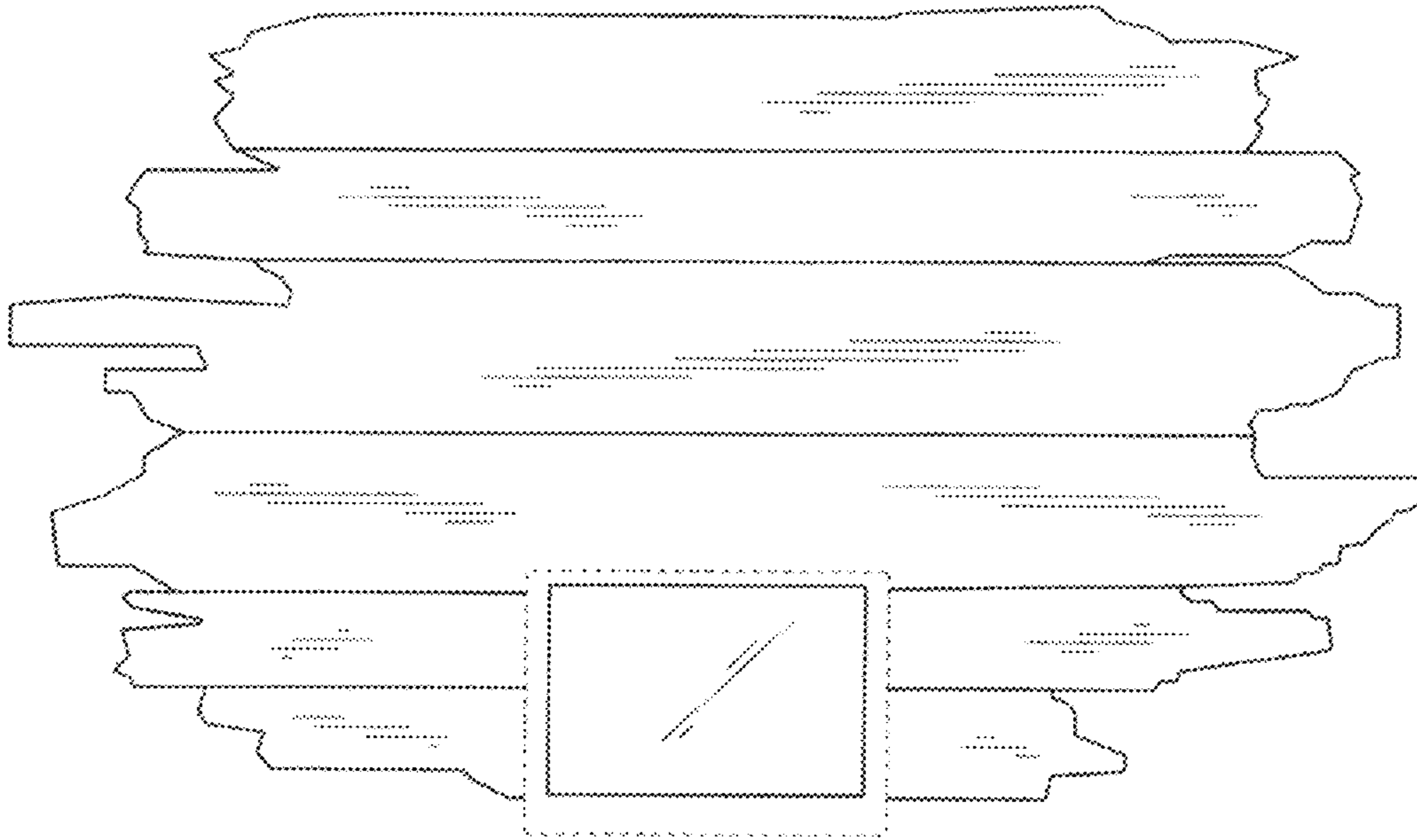

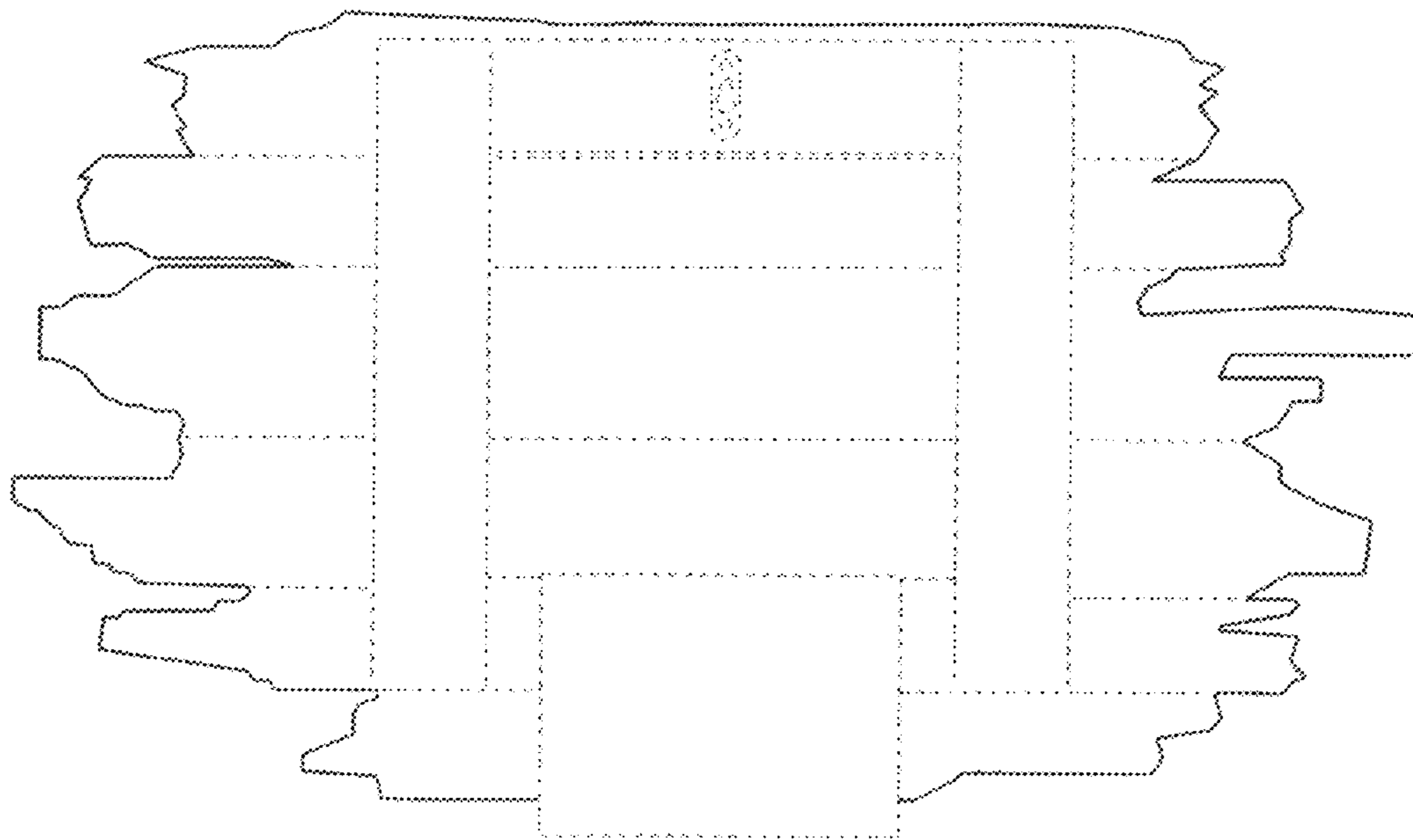

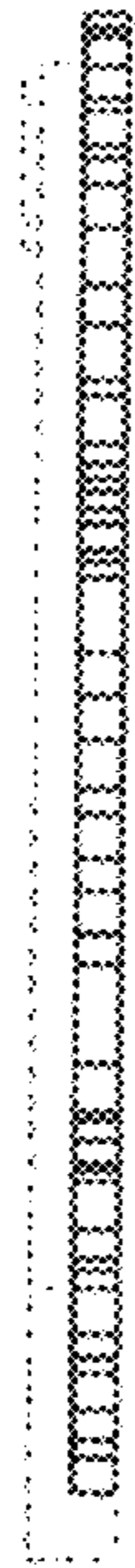

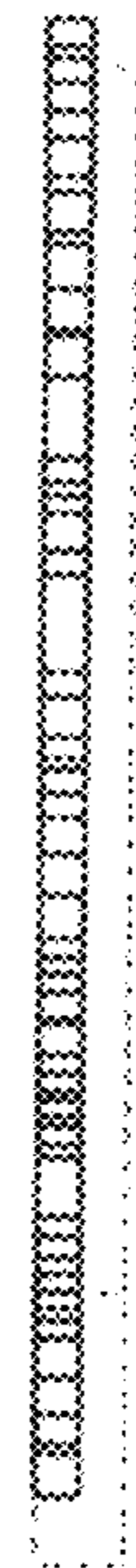

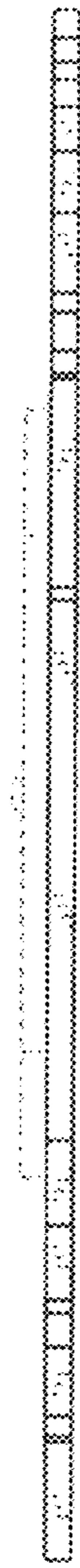

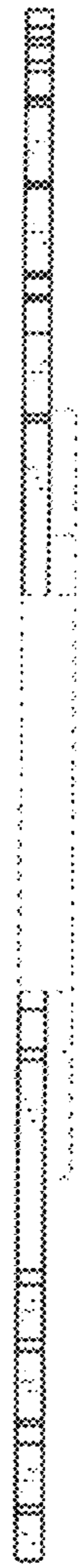

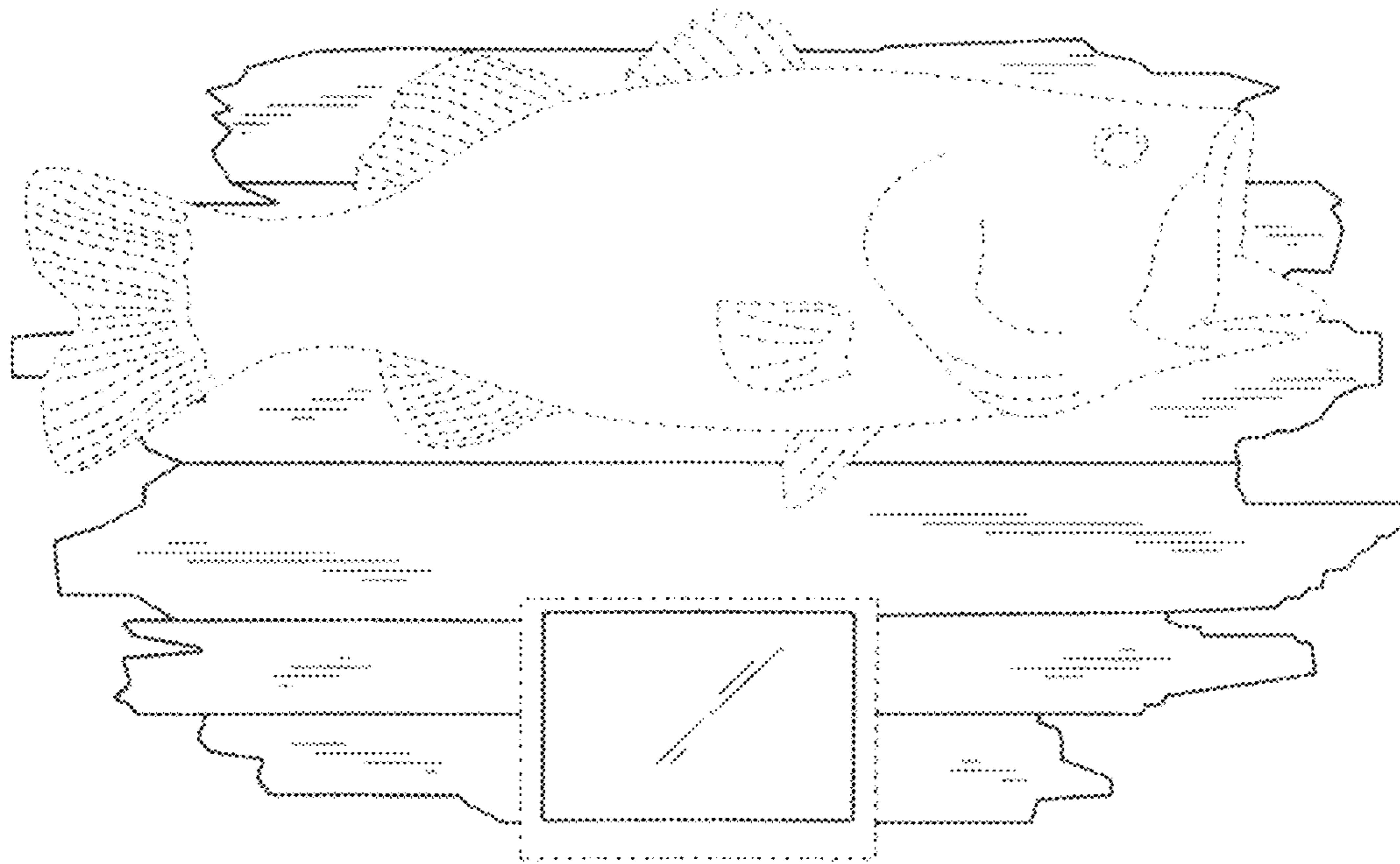

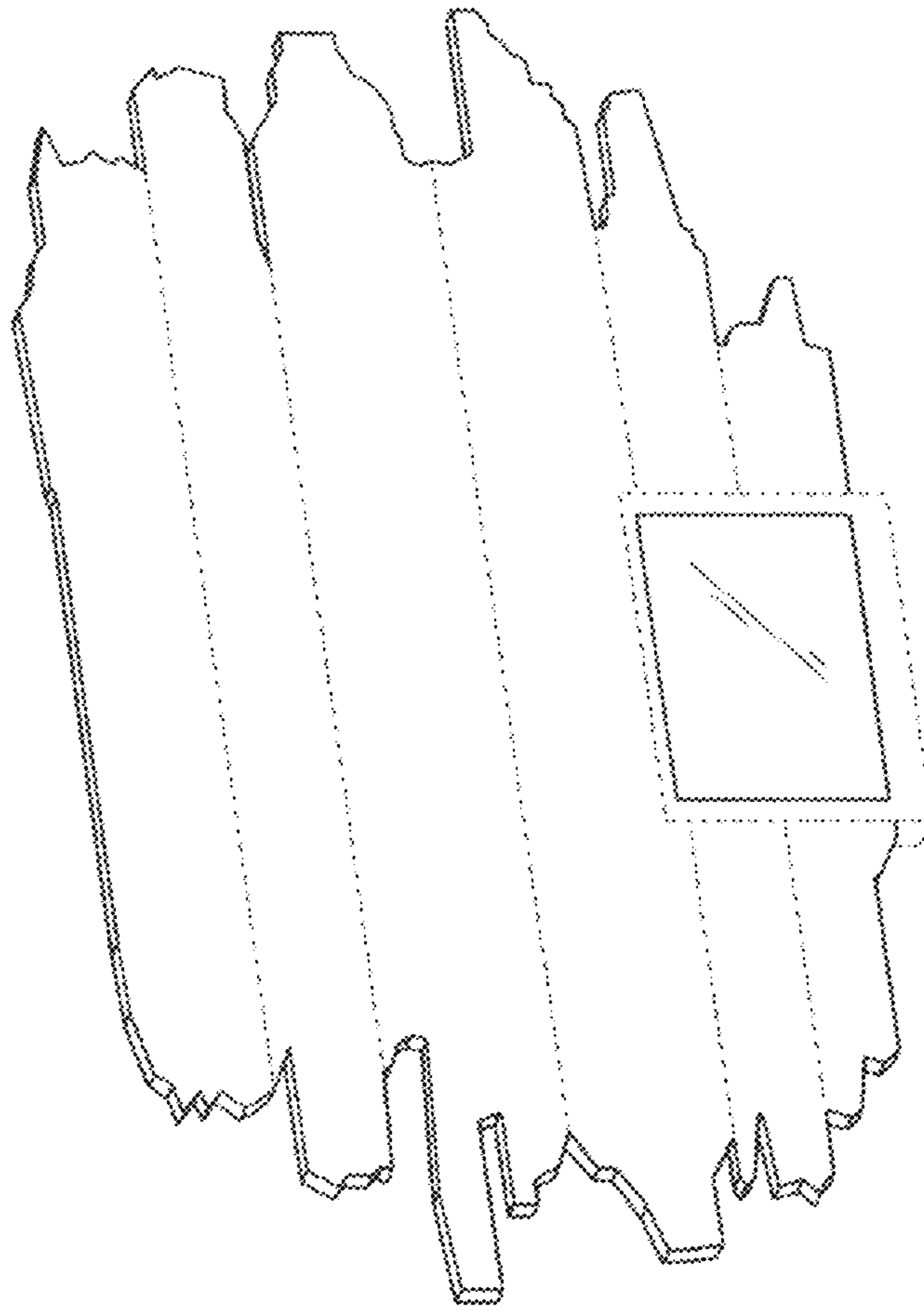

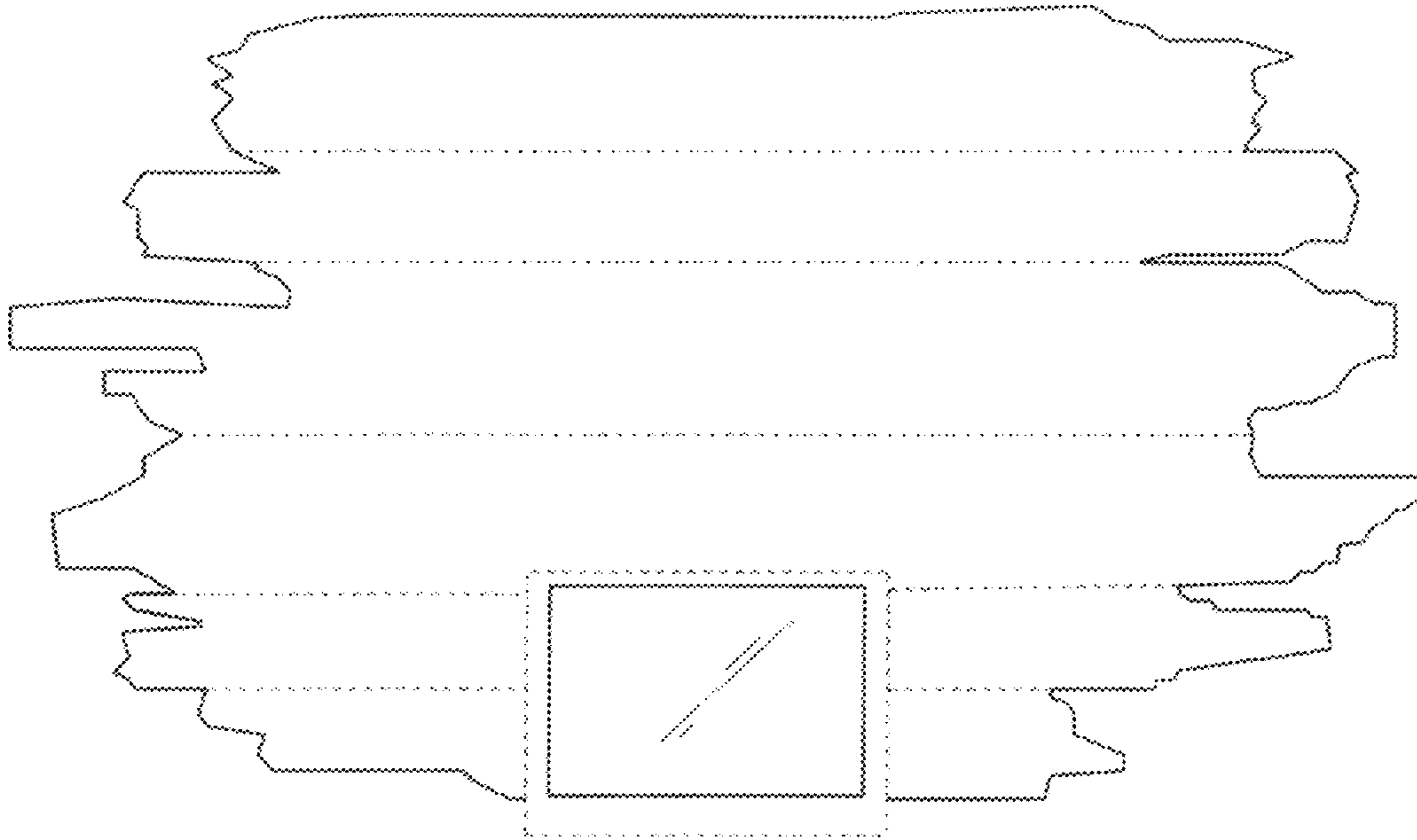

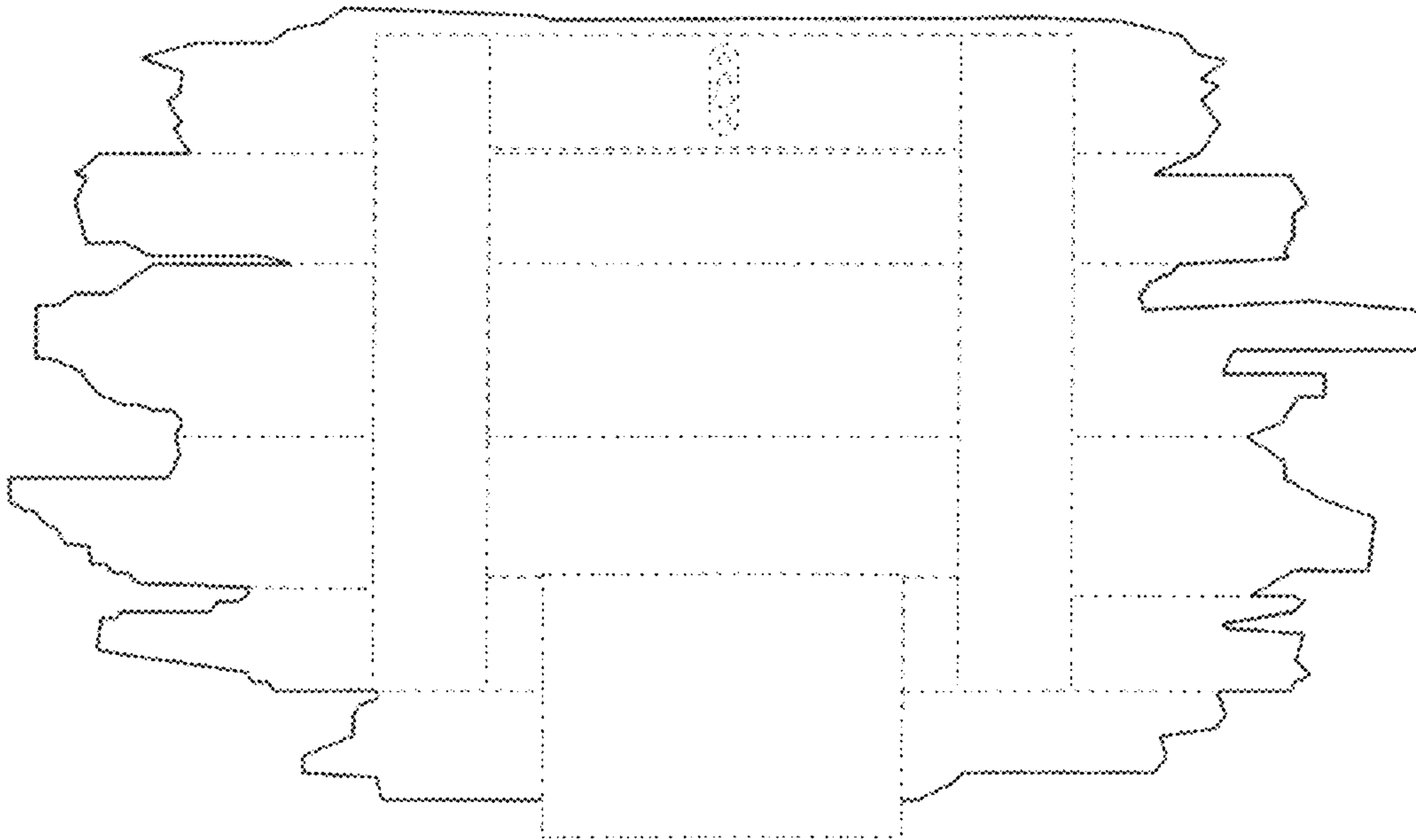

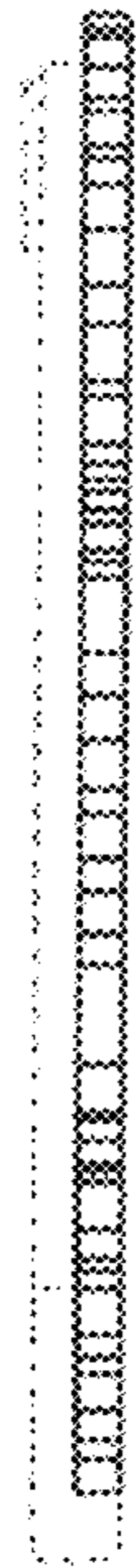

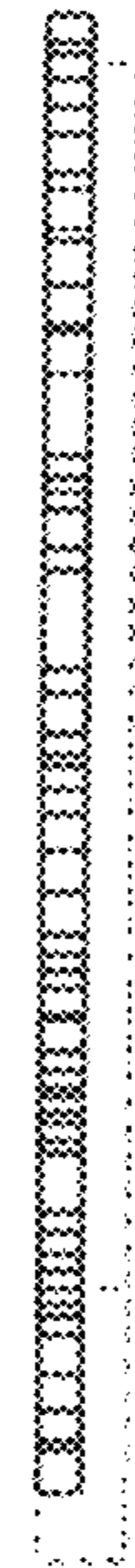

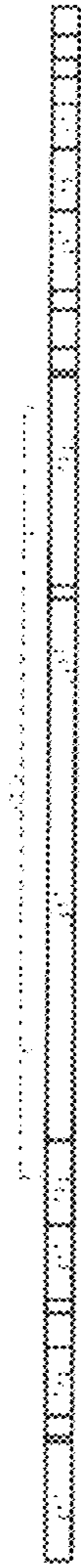

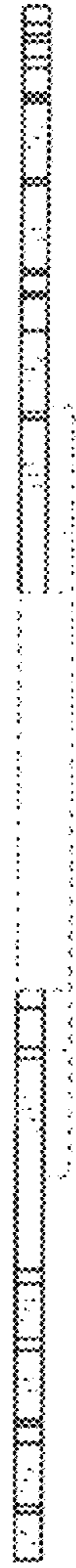

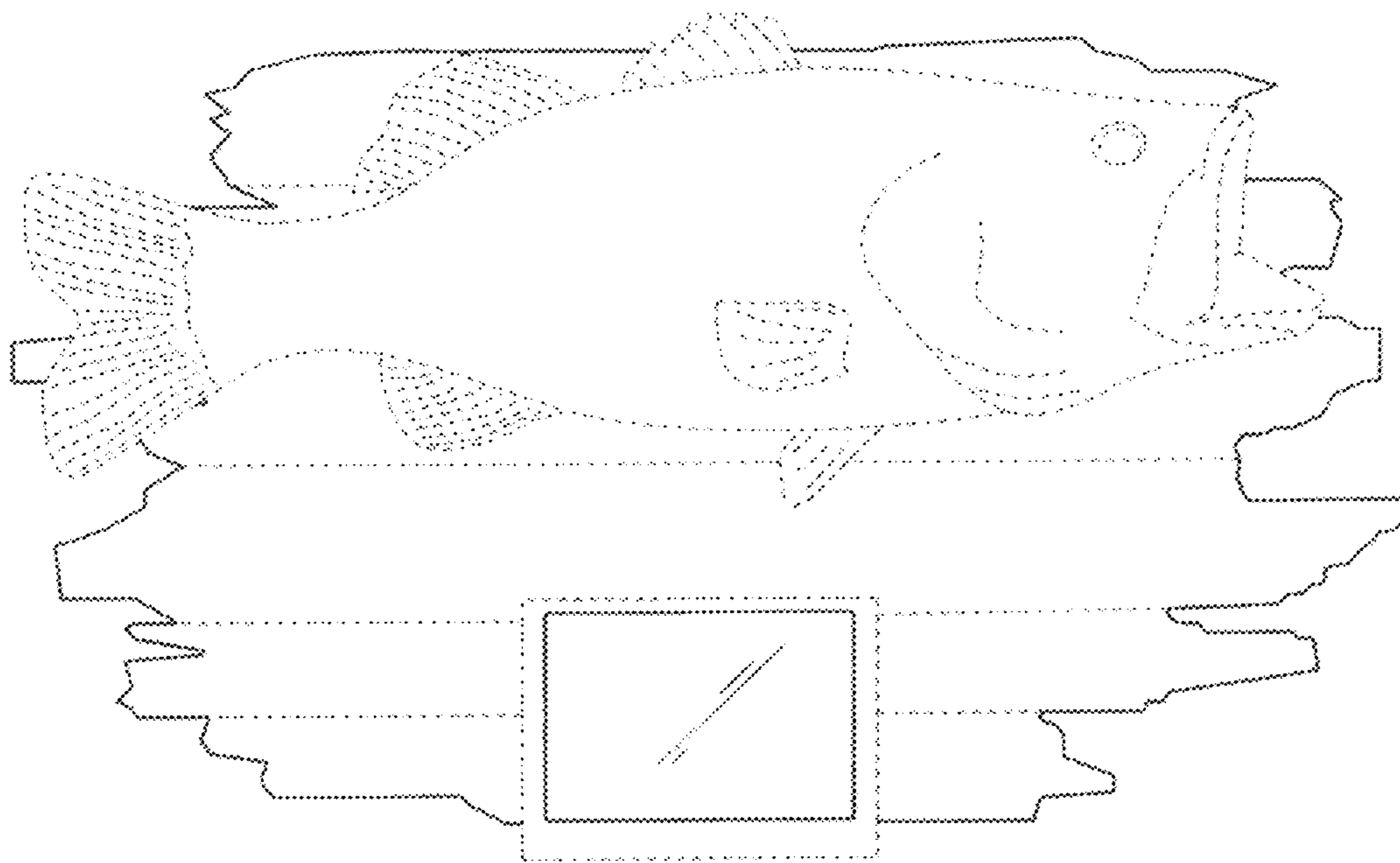
