DESCRIPTION

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FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ankle brace showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof from another angle;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

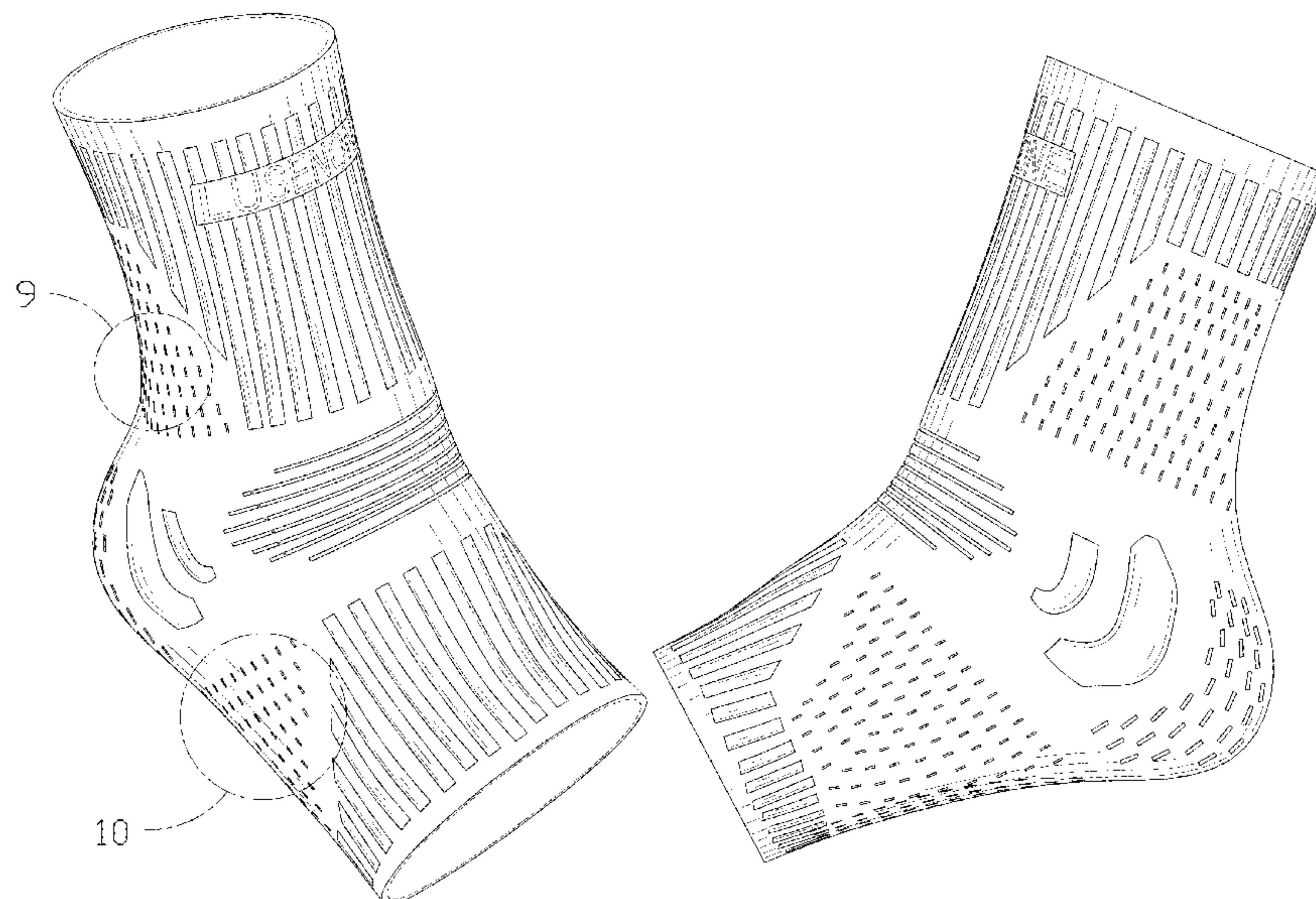
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

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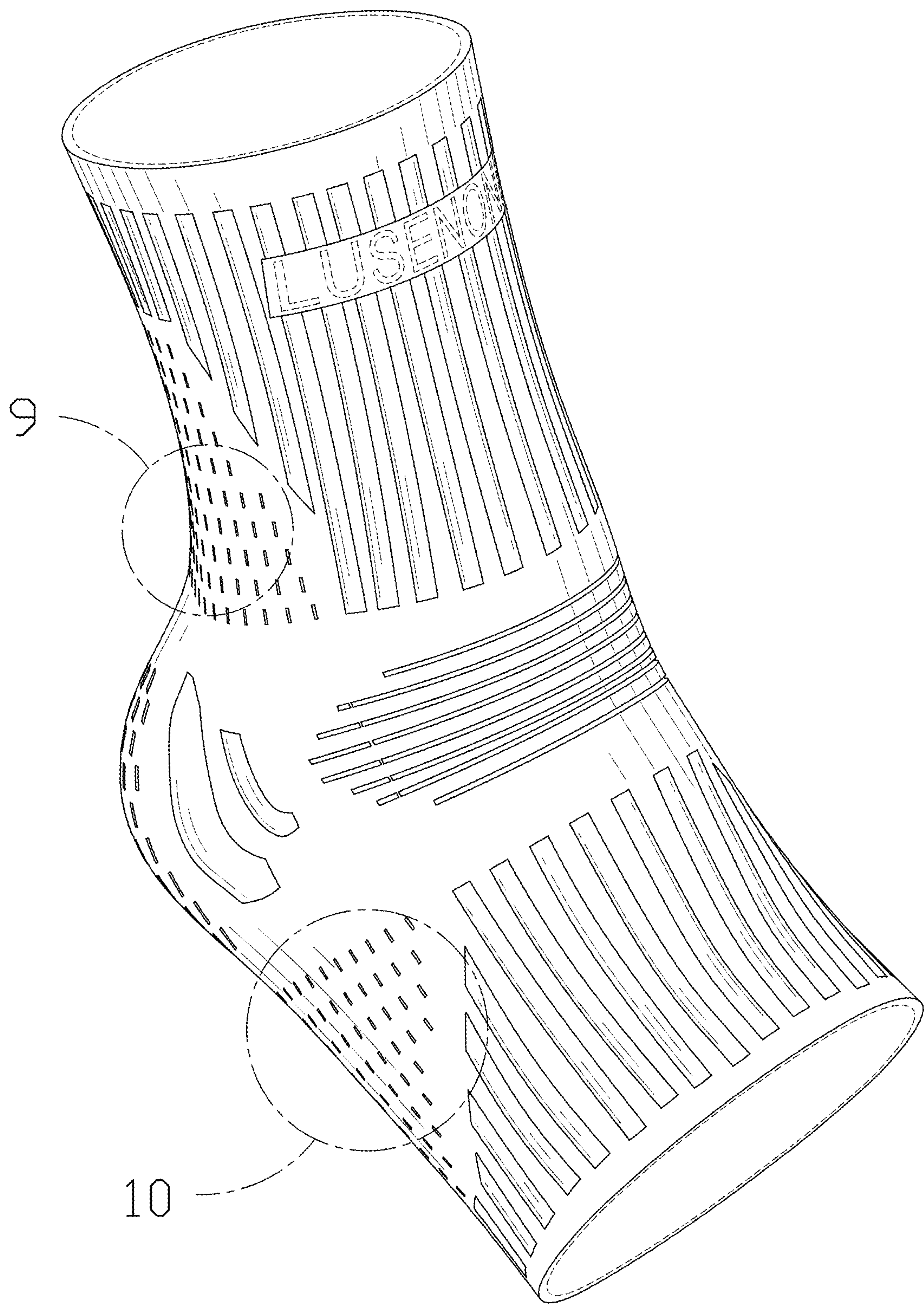

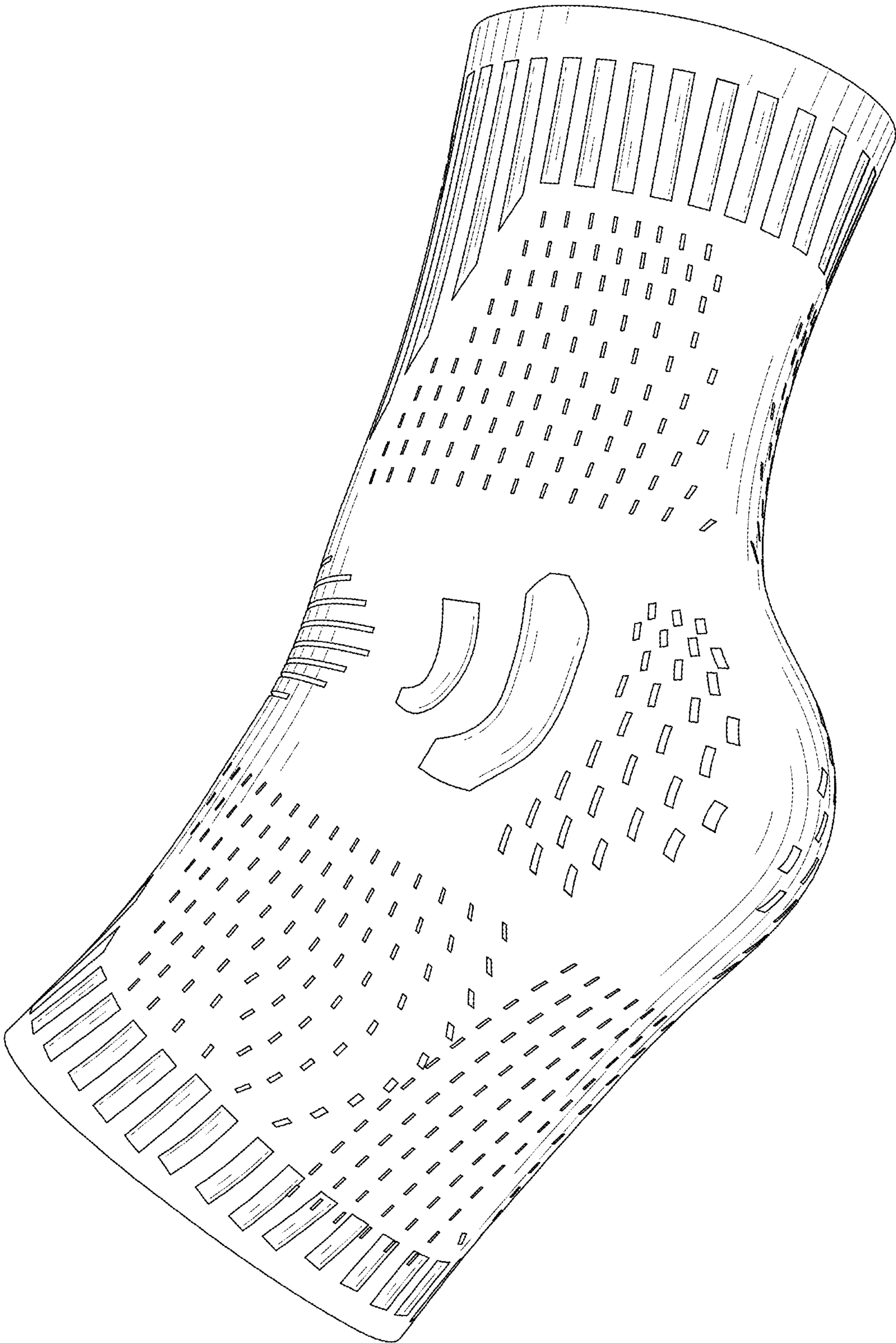

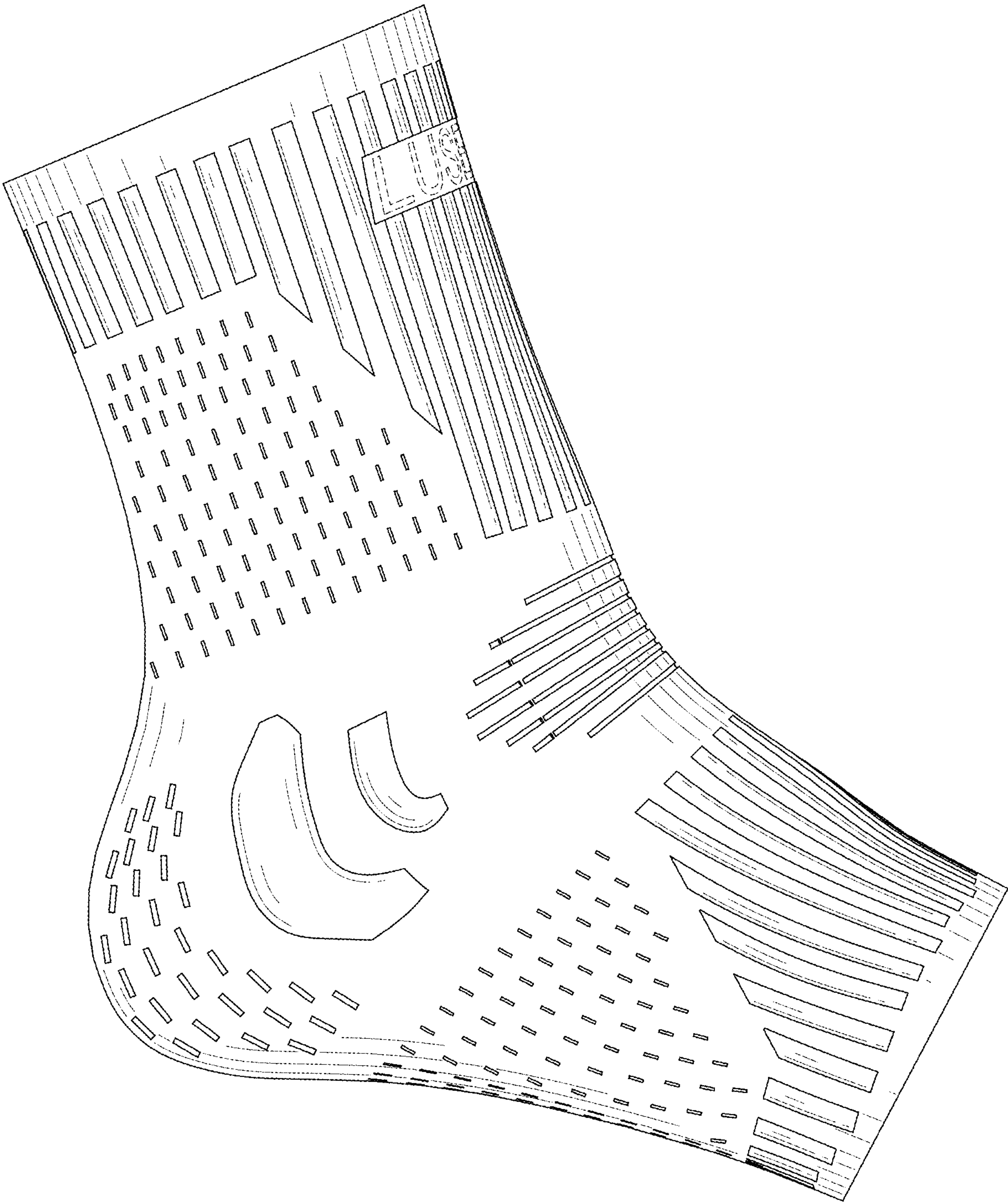

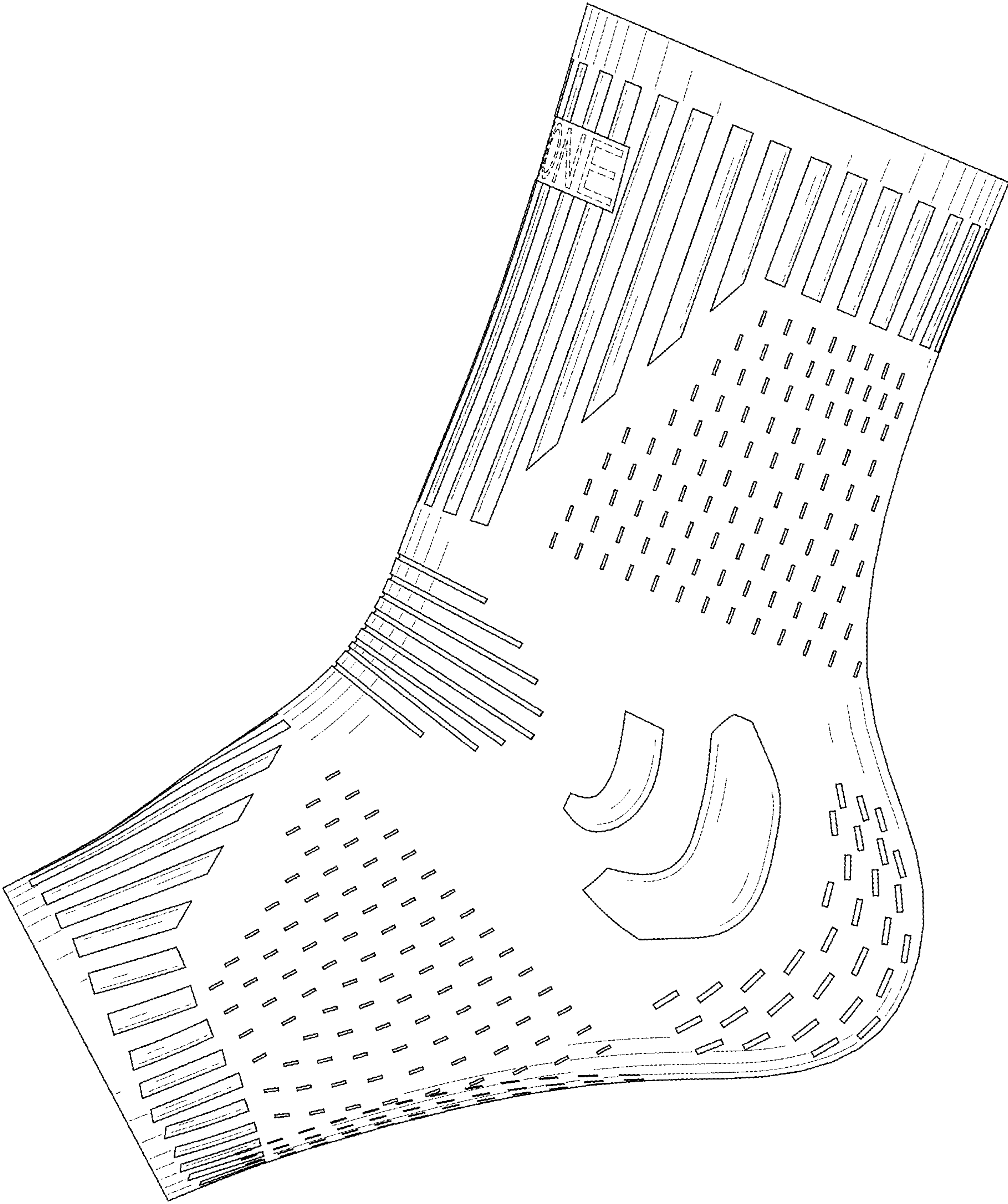

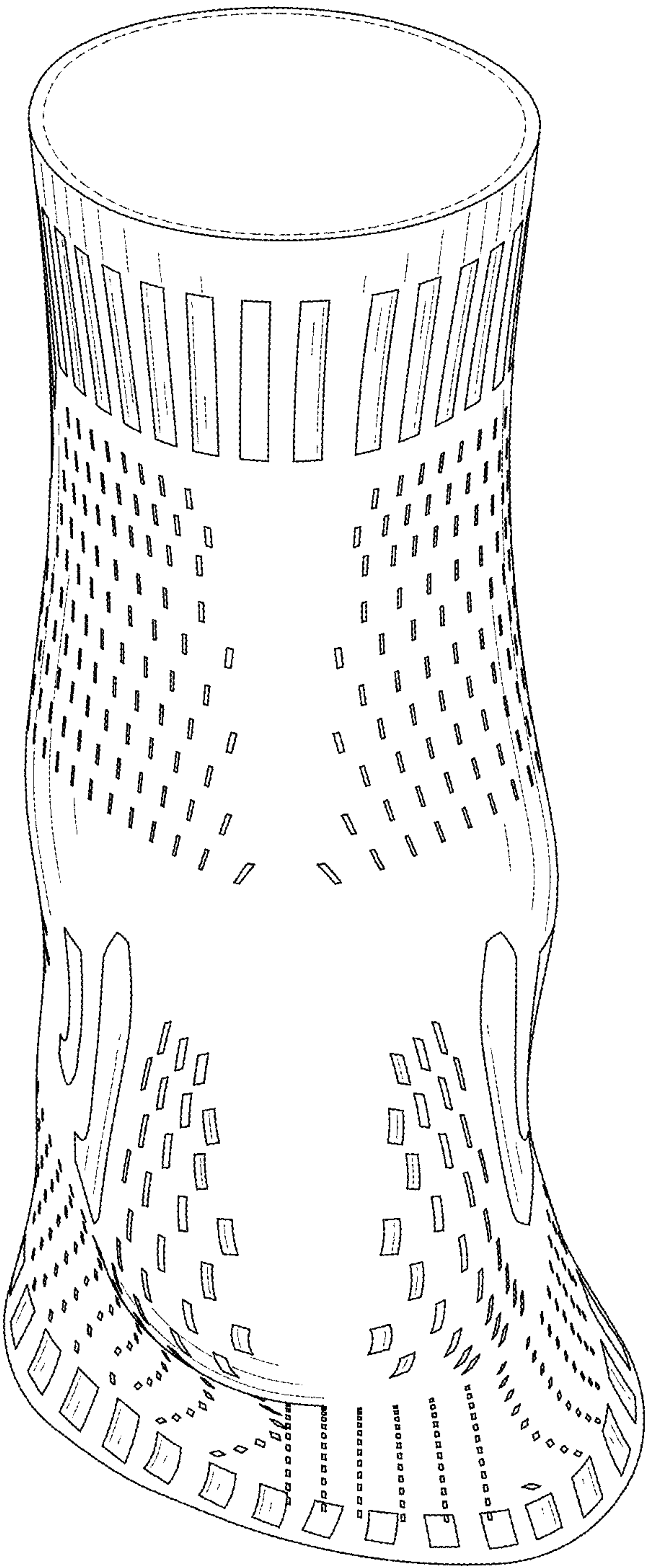

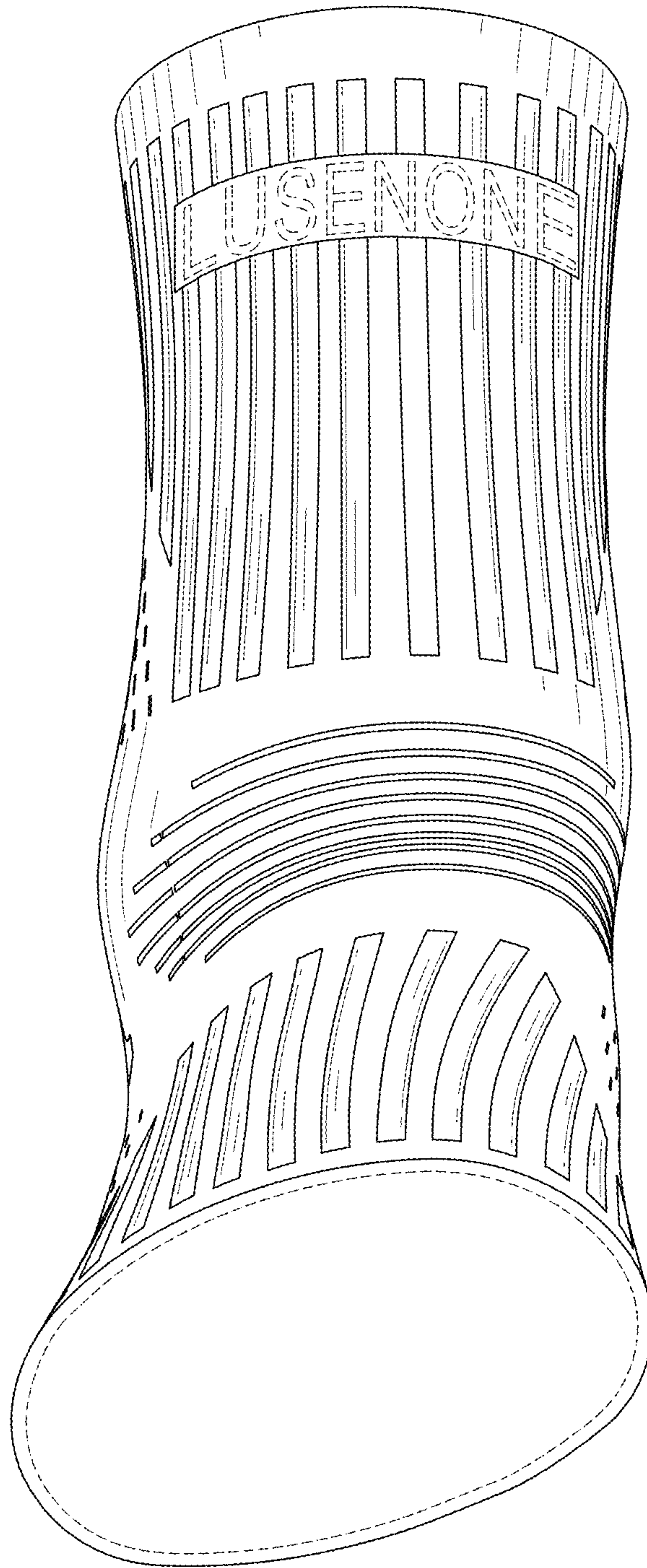

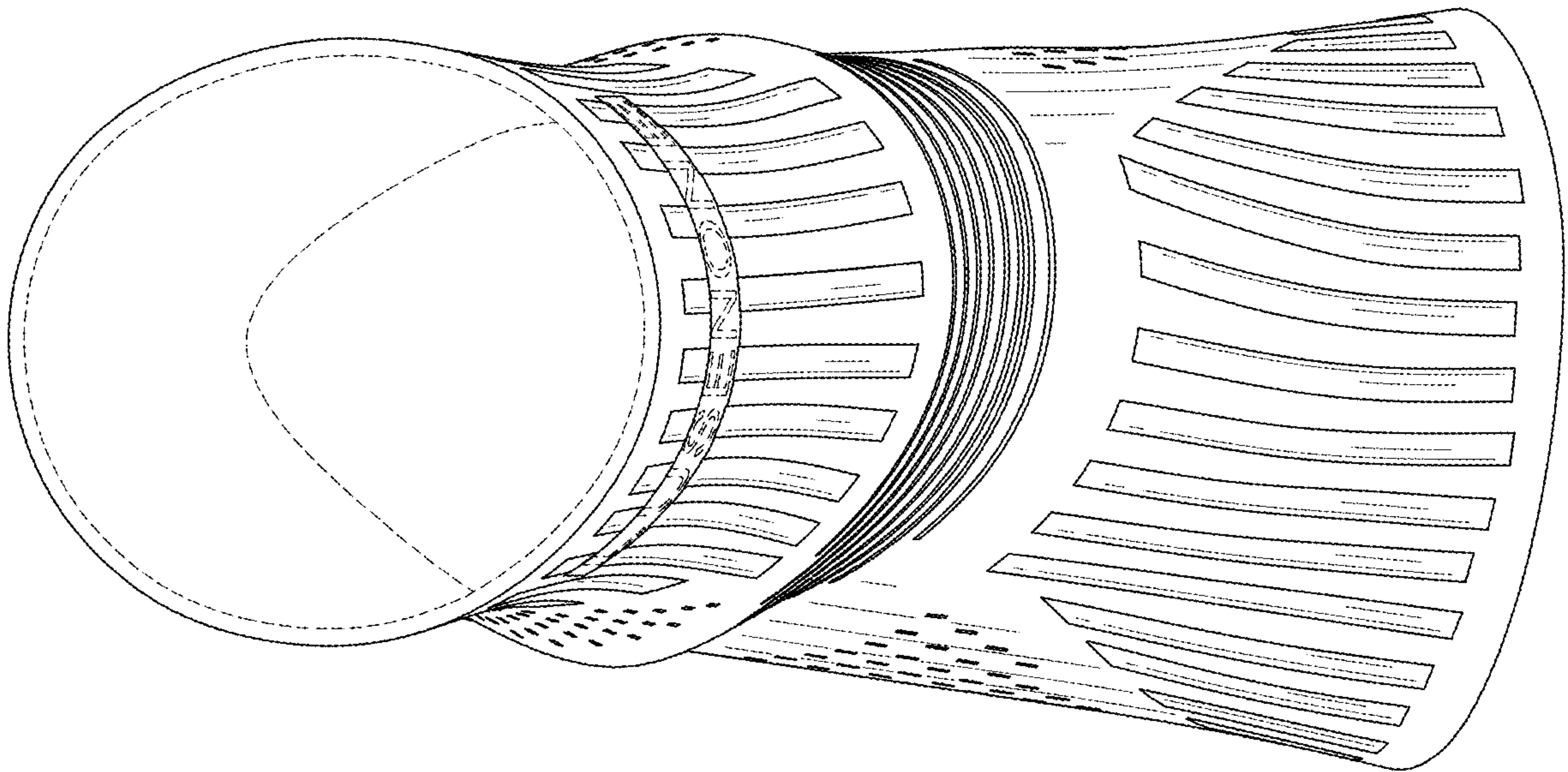

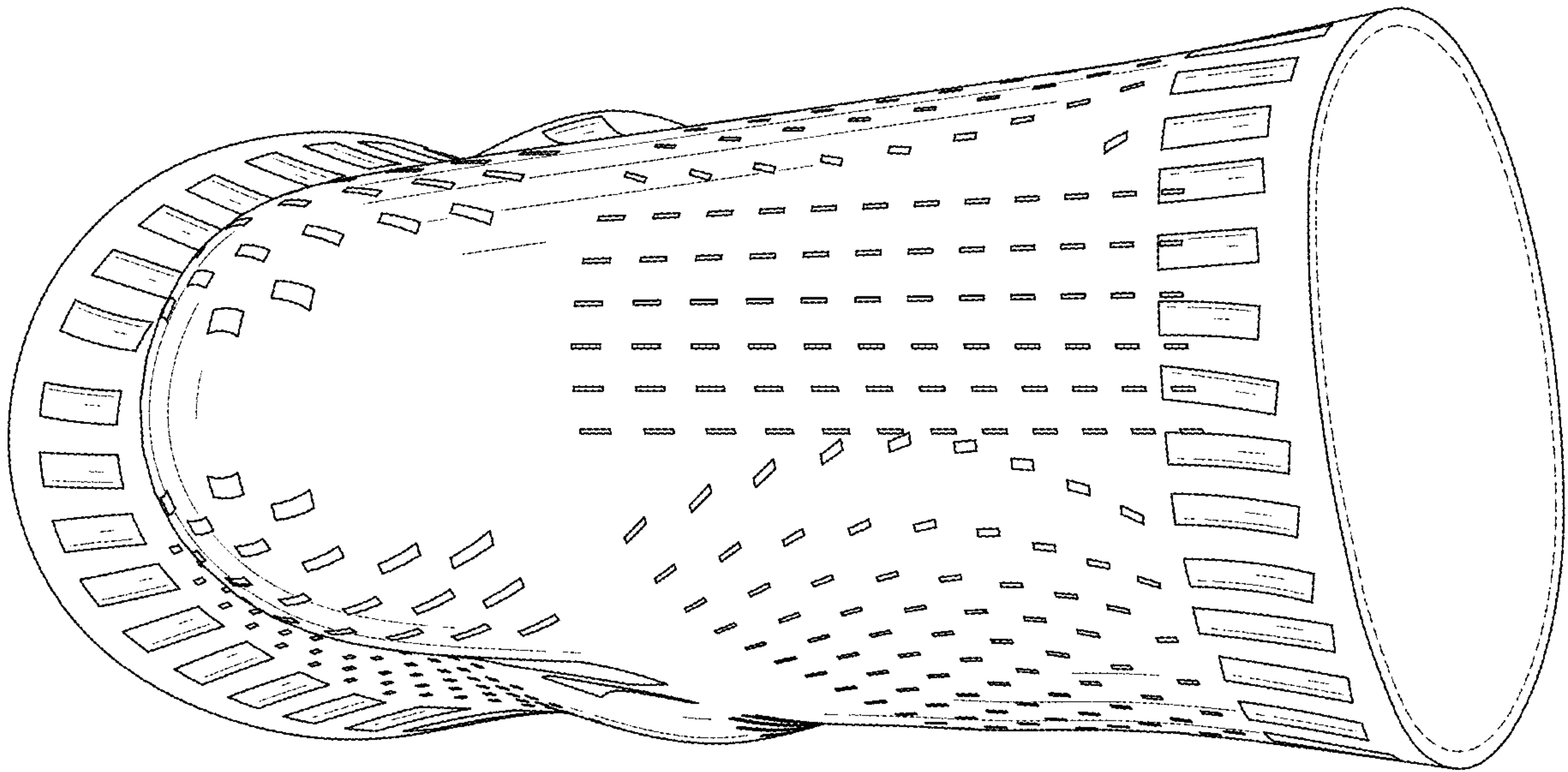

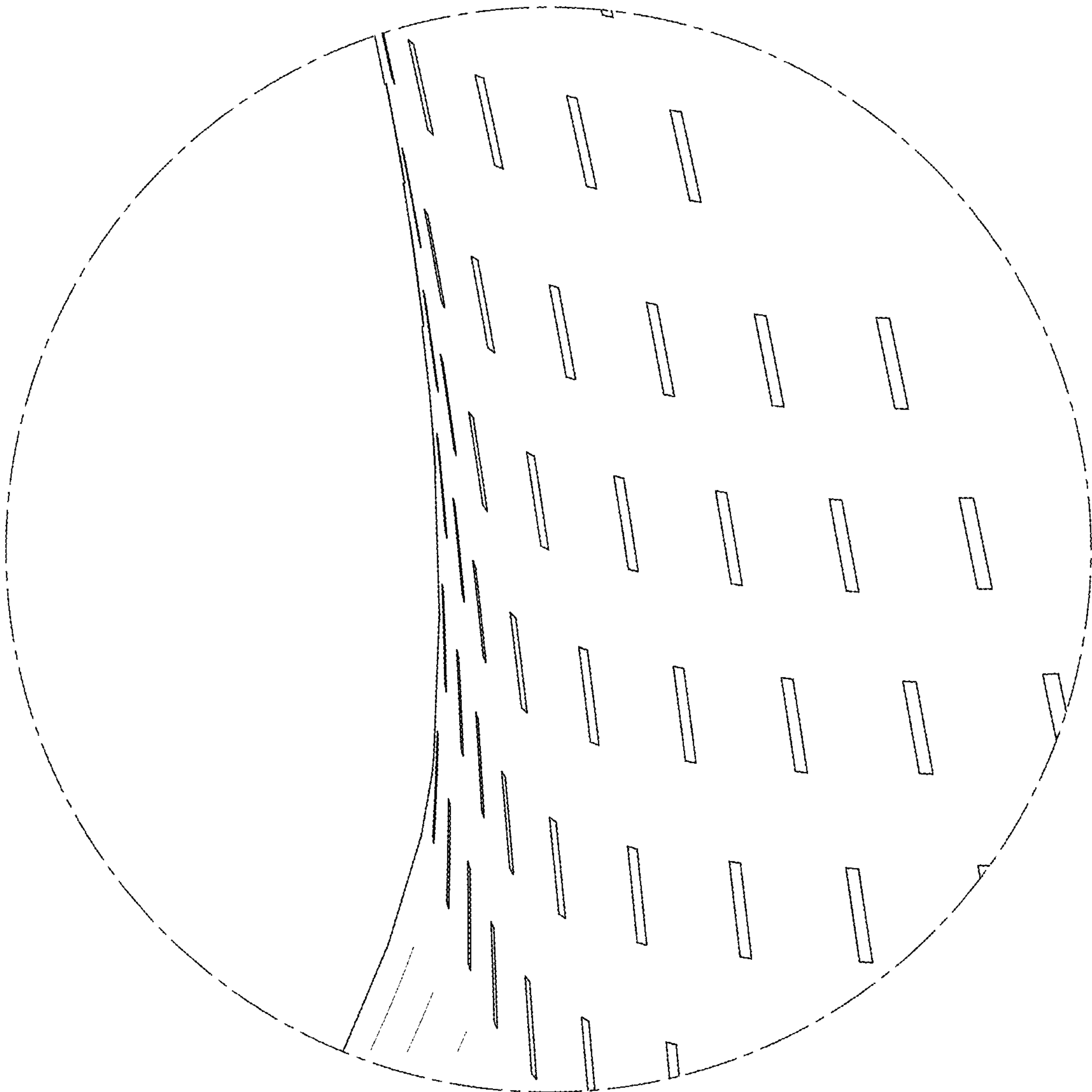

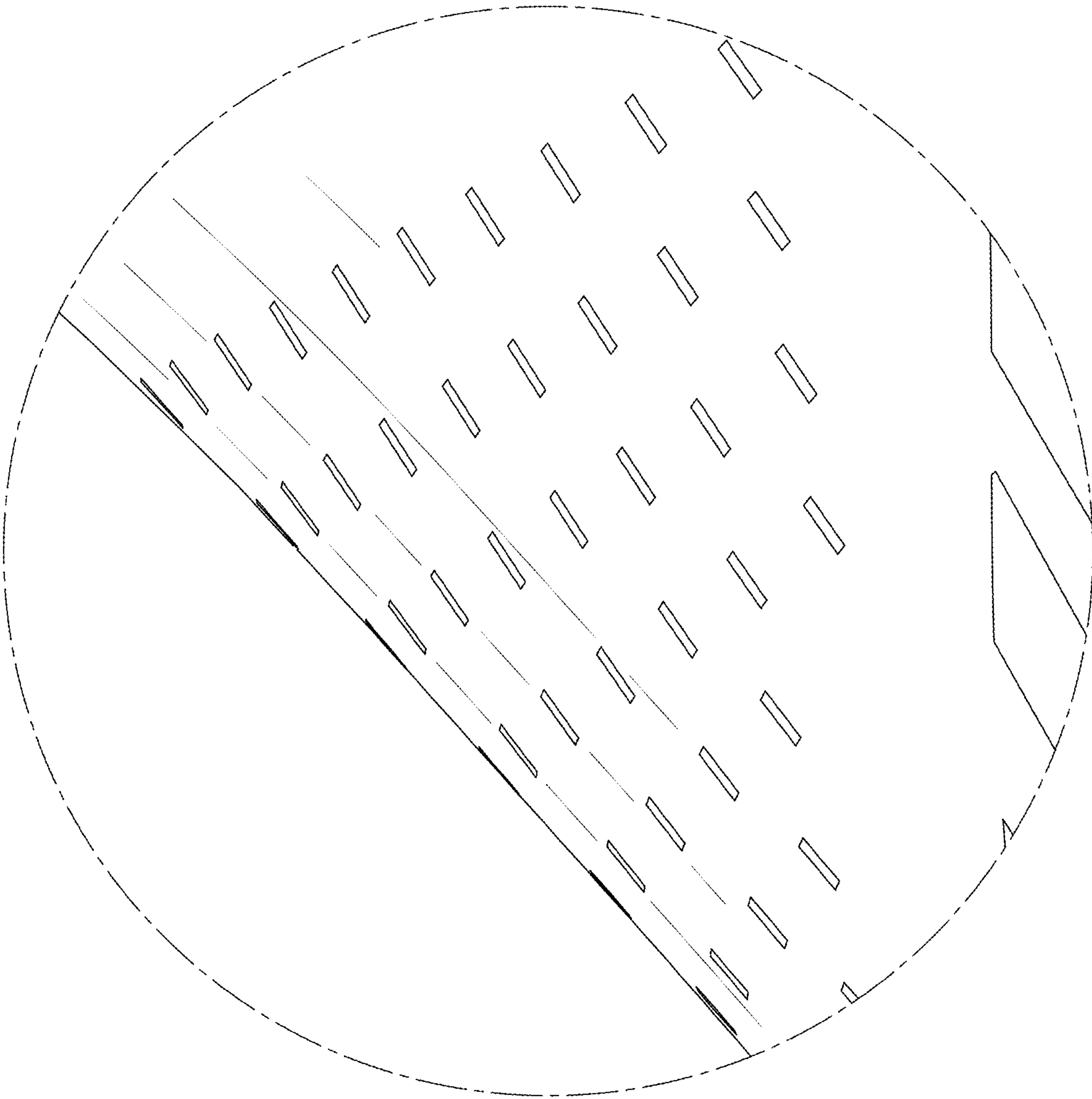
