The dashed-dotted broken lines define a boundary of the design that forms no part of the claimed design.

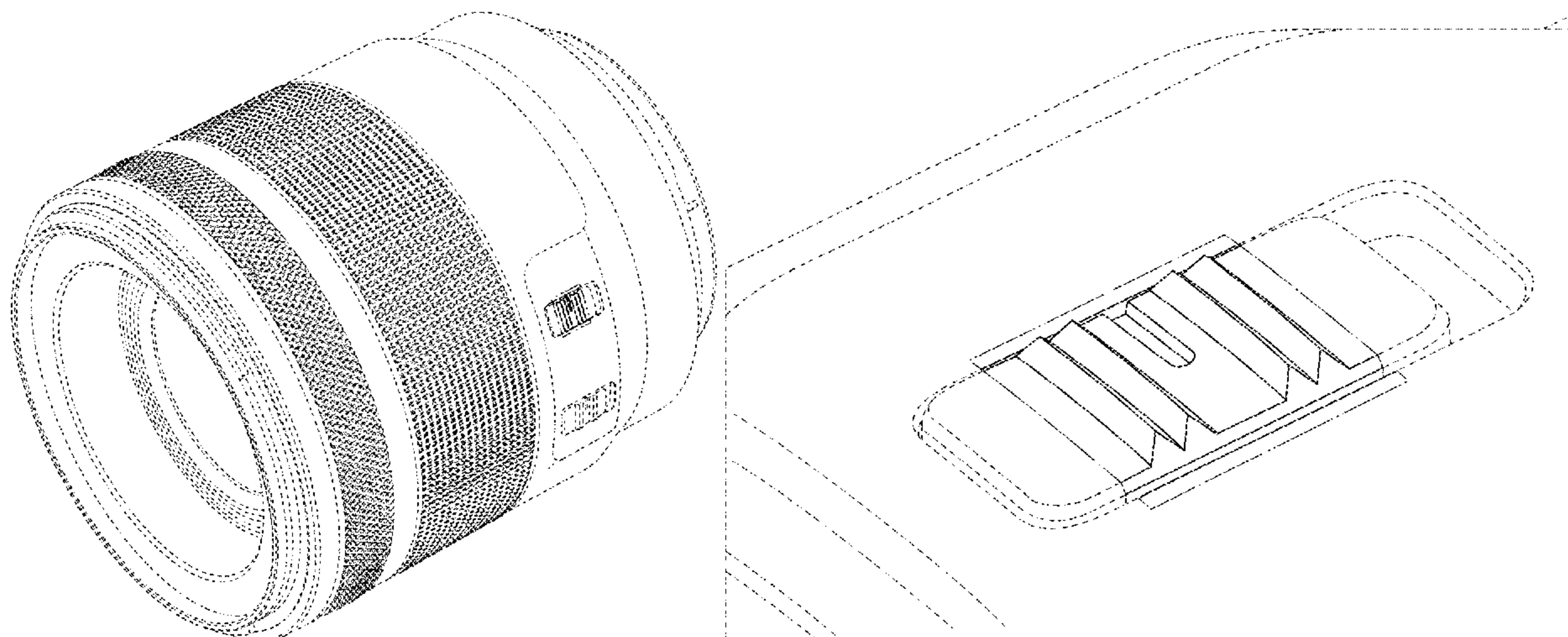

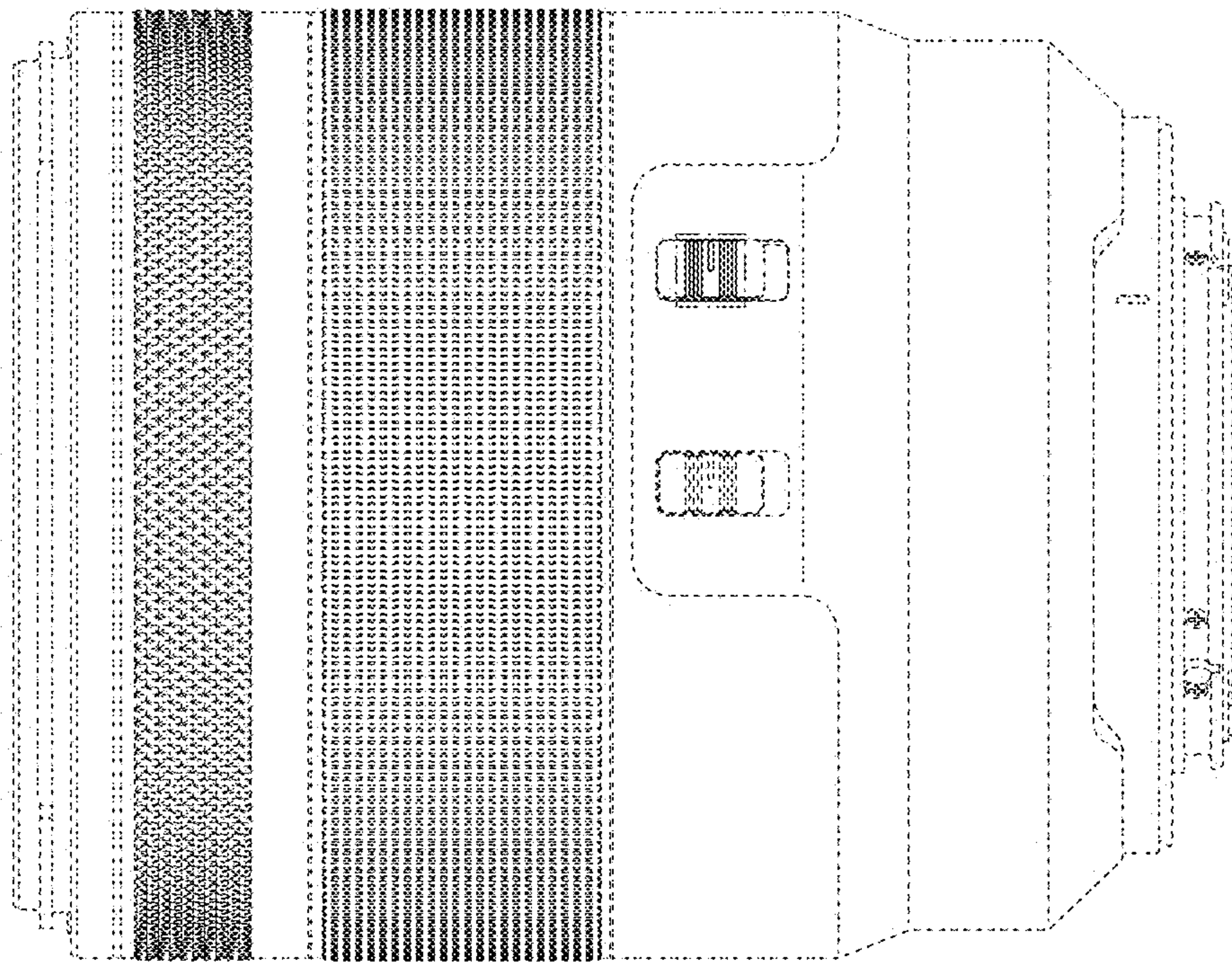

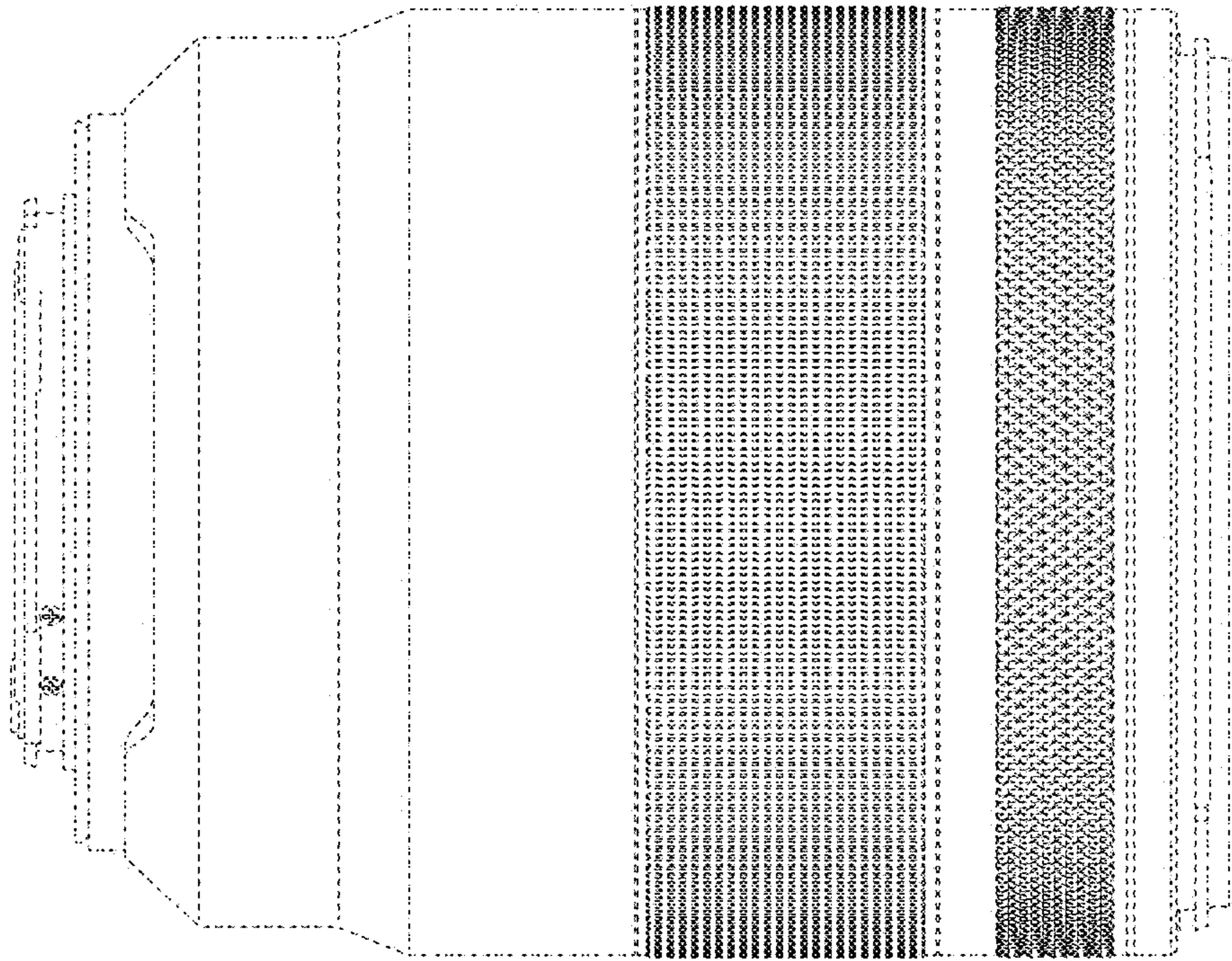

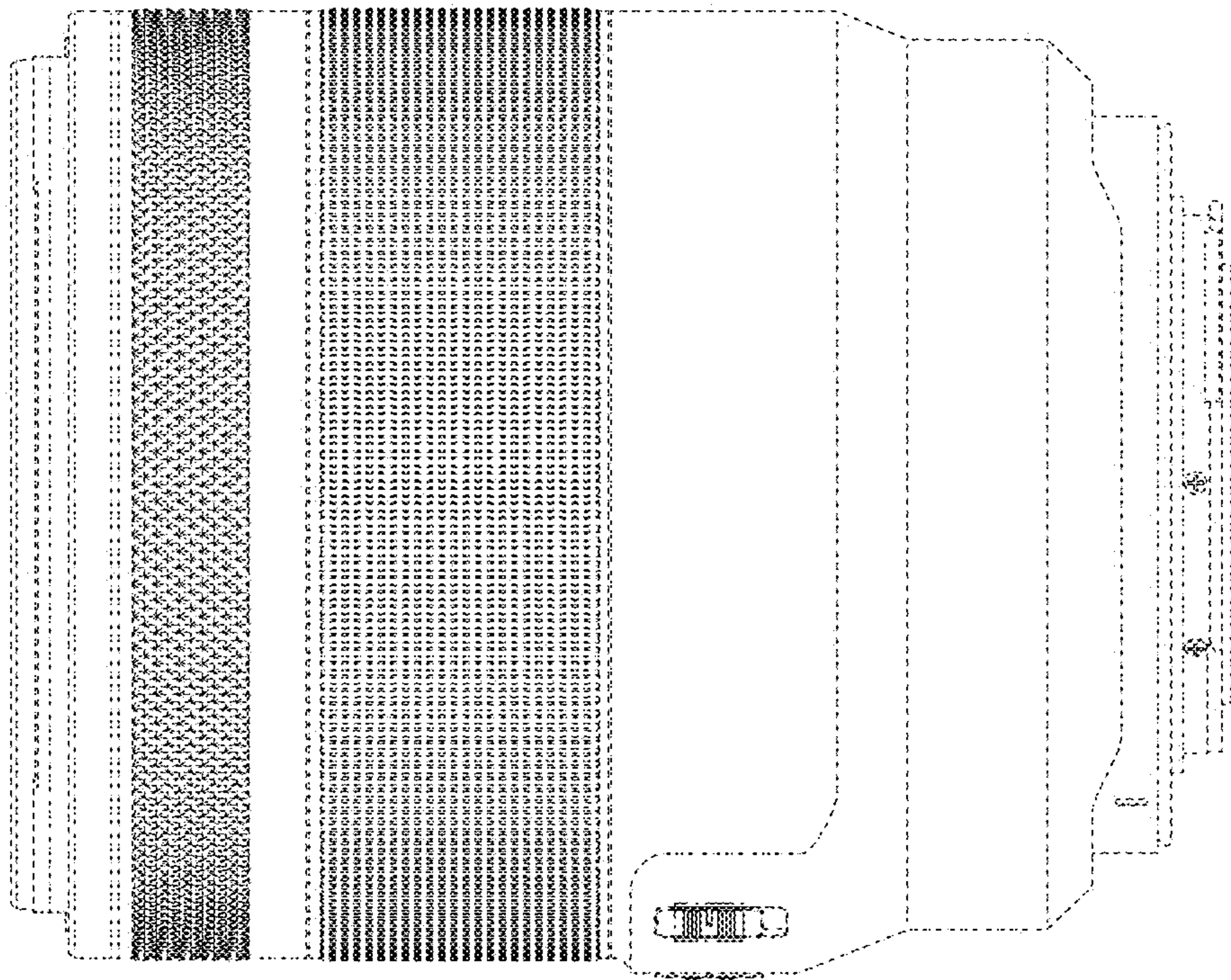

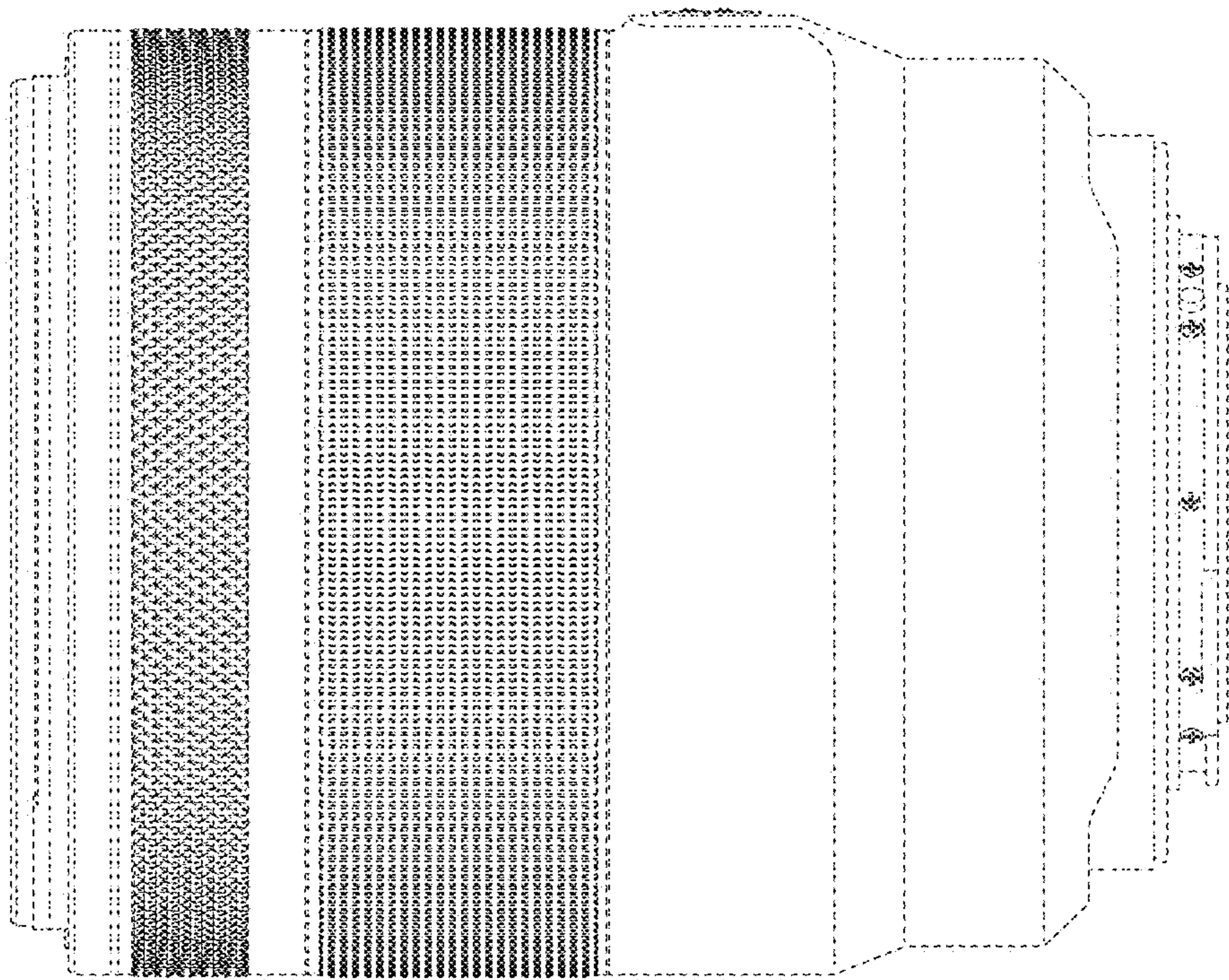

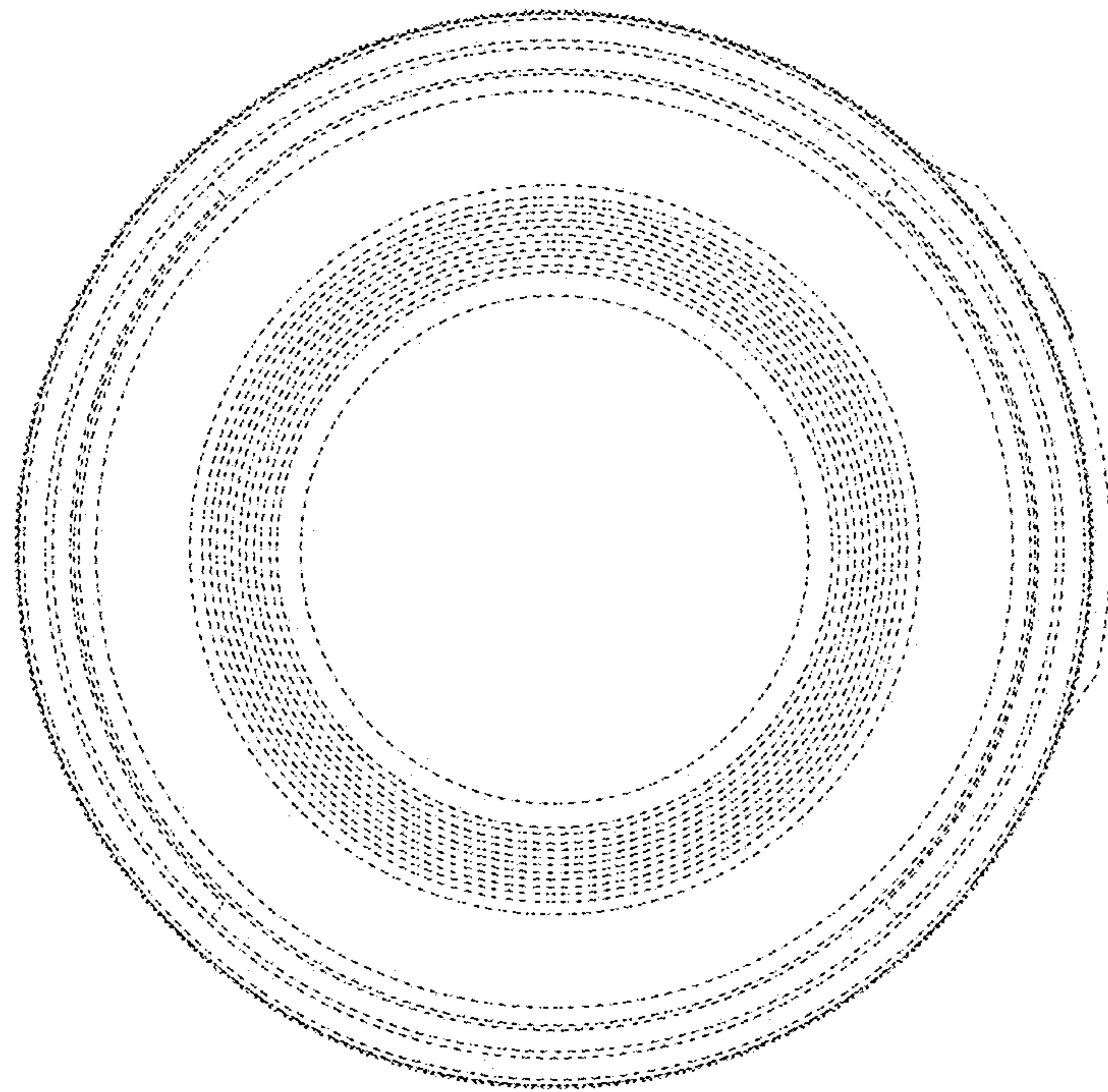

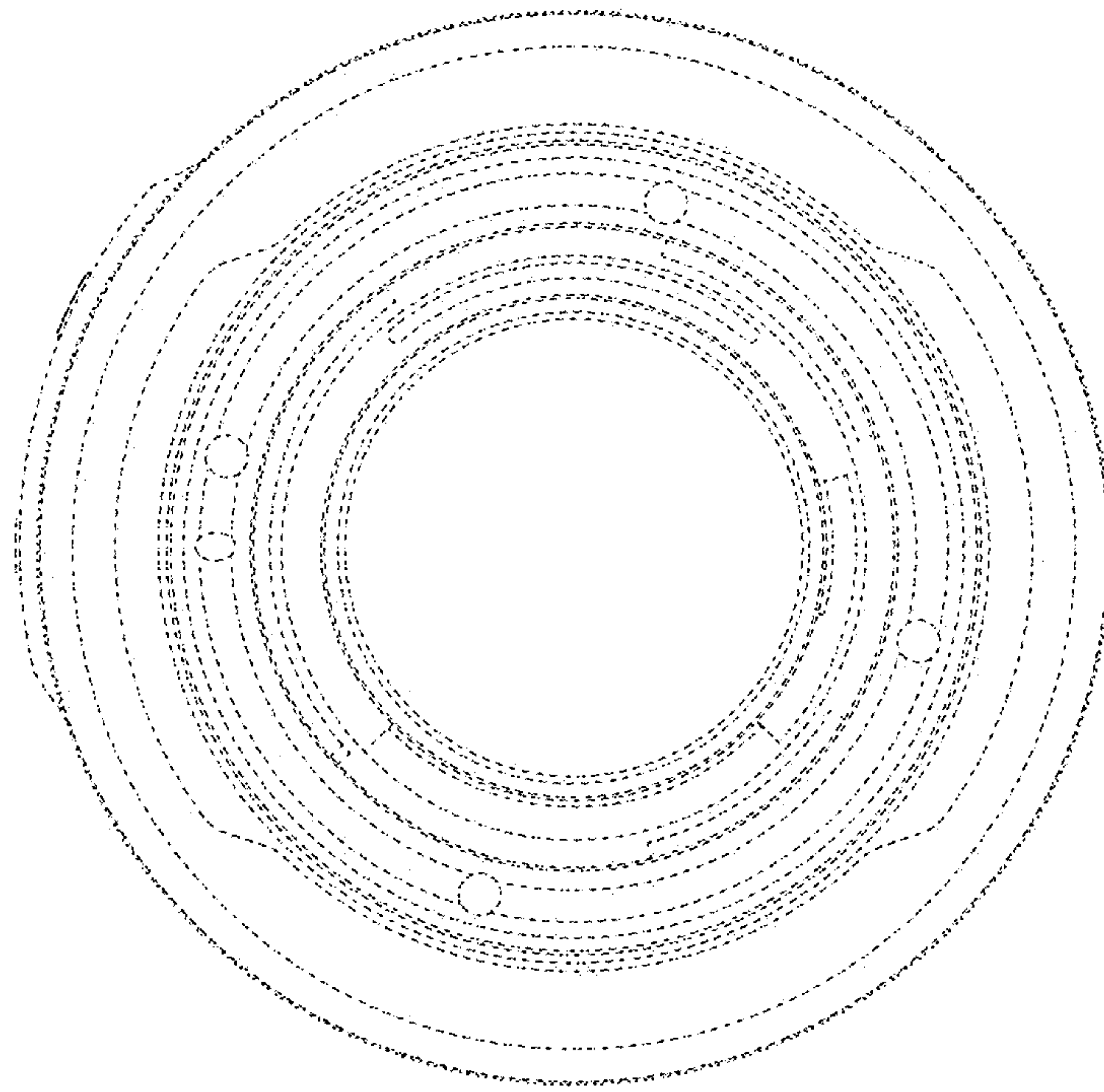

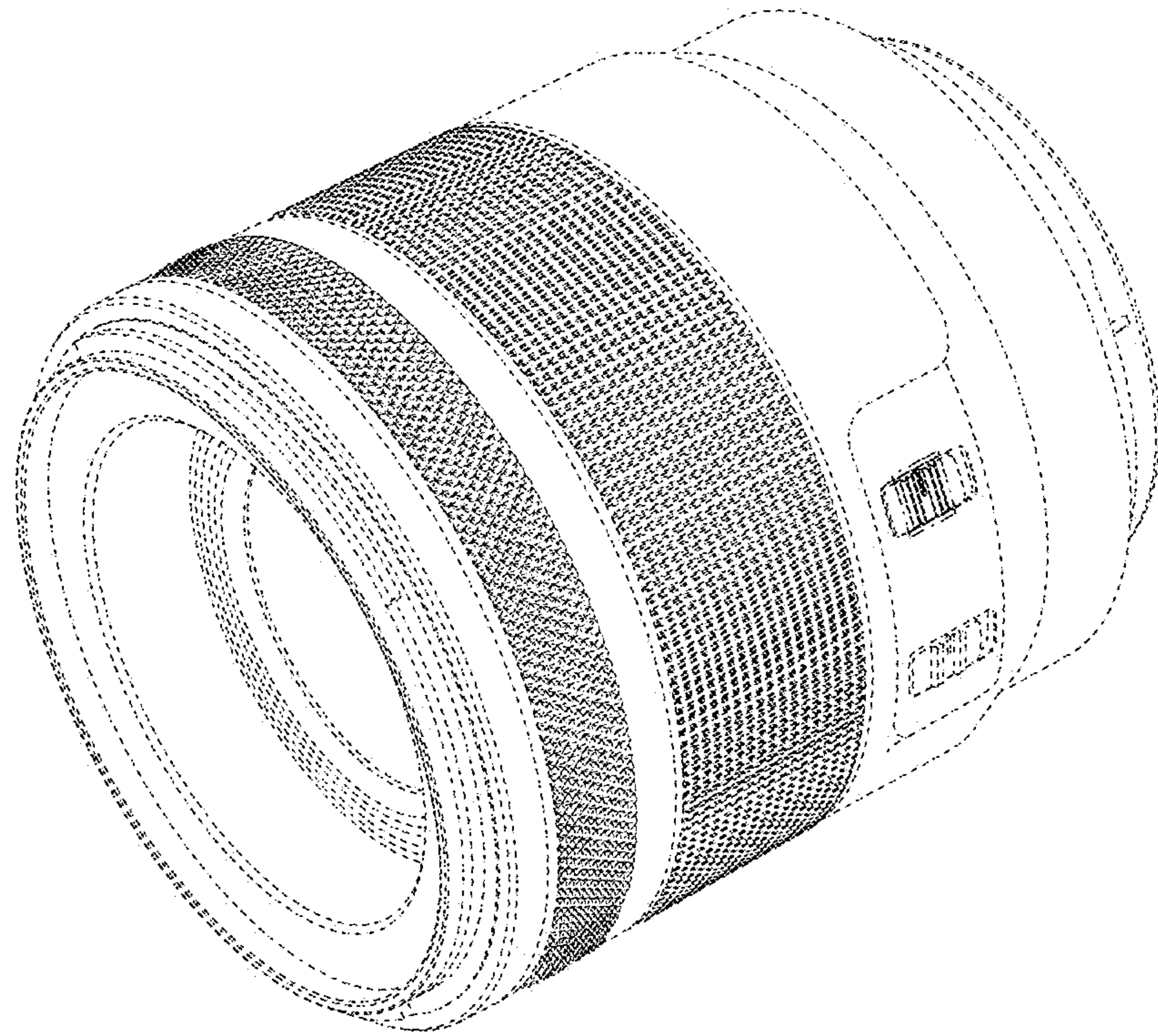

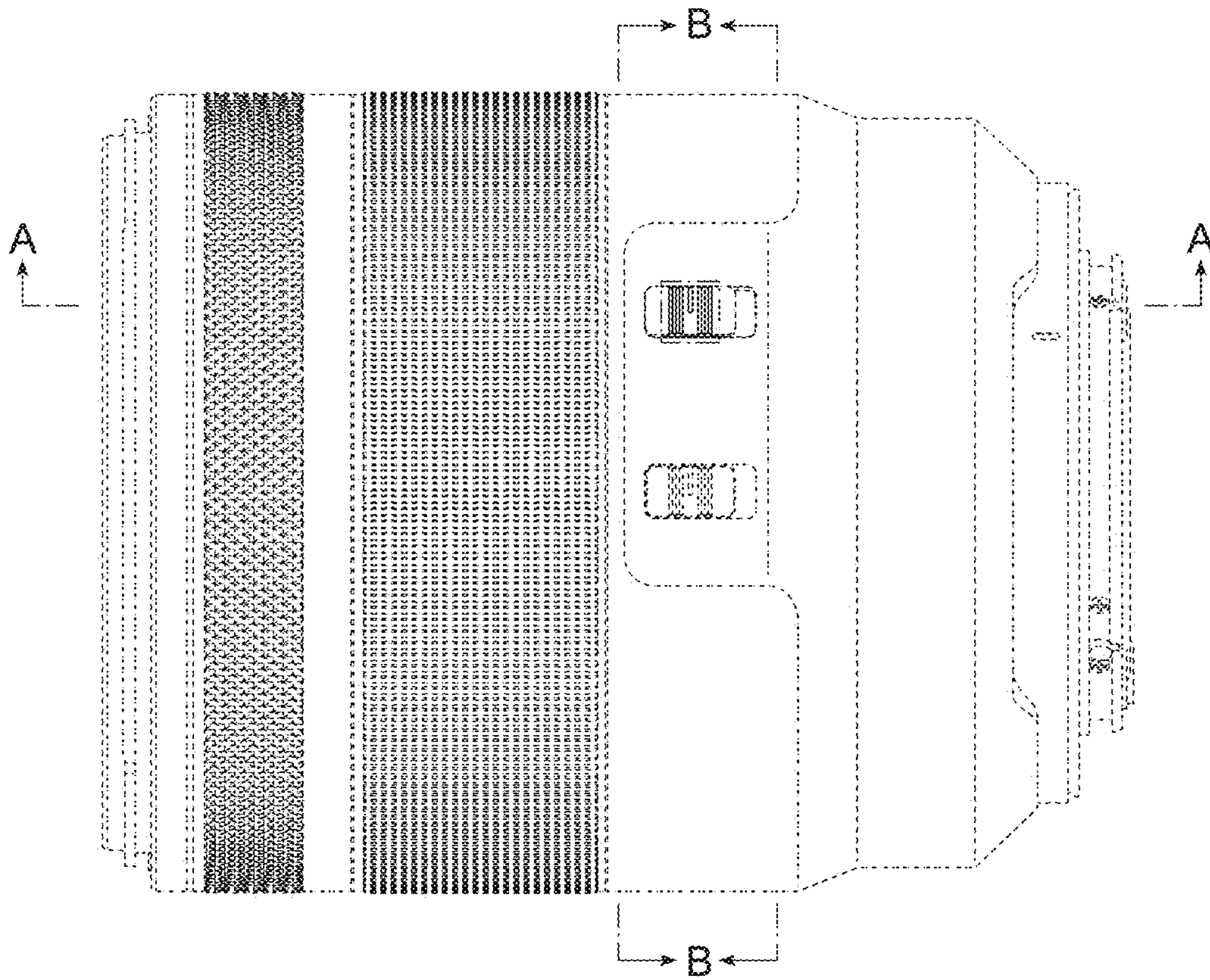

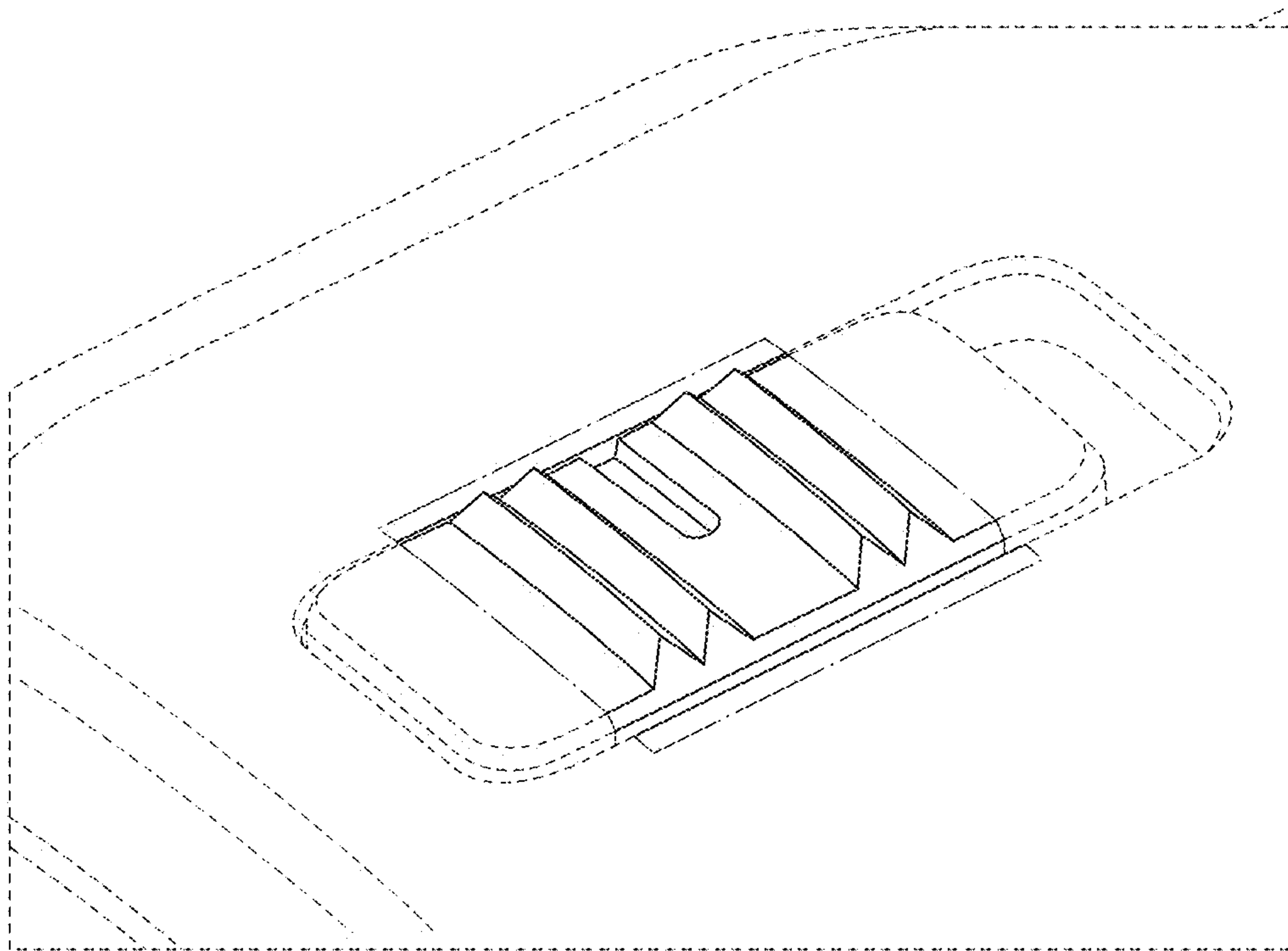

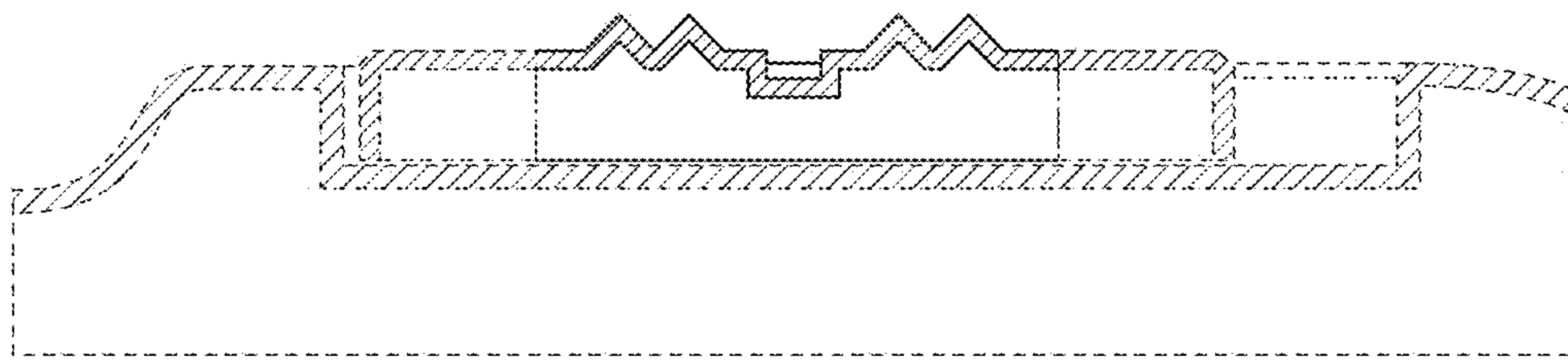
