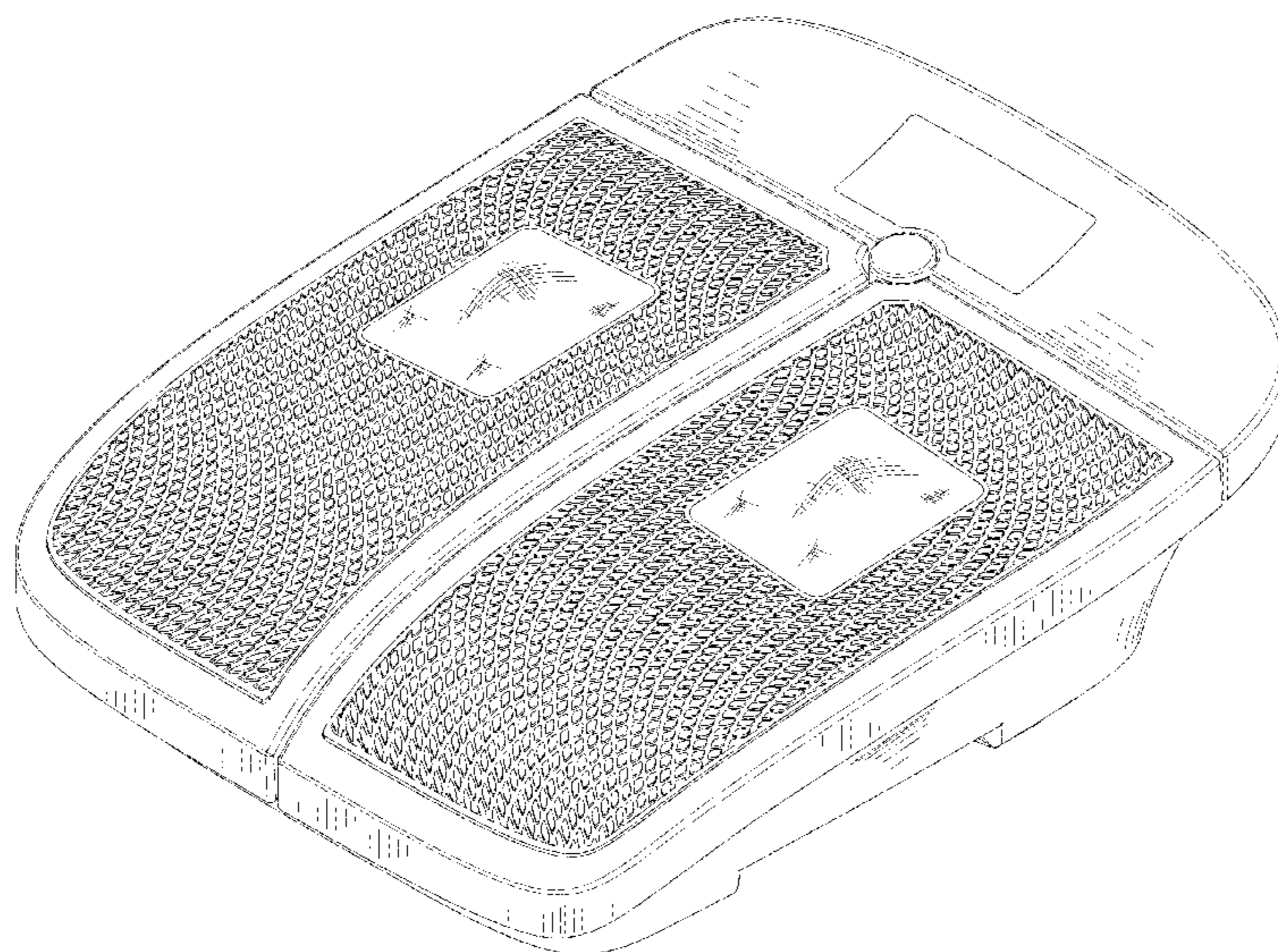
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a foot massager, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a foot massager showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.
The cross-hatching shading in the figures is fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration, it being understood that the cross-hatching shading is uniformly continued over the surface on which it appears.
The broken lines shown in the figures are for the purpose of illustrating portions of the foot massager, which form no part of the claimed design.

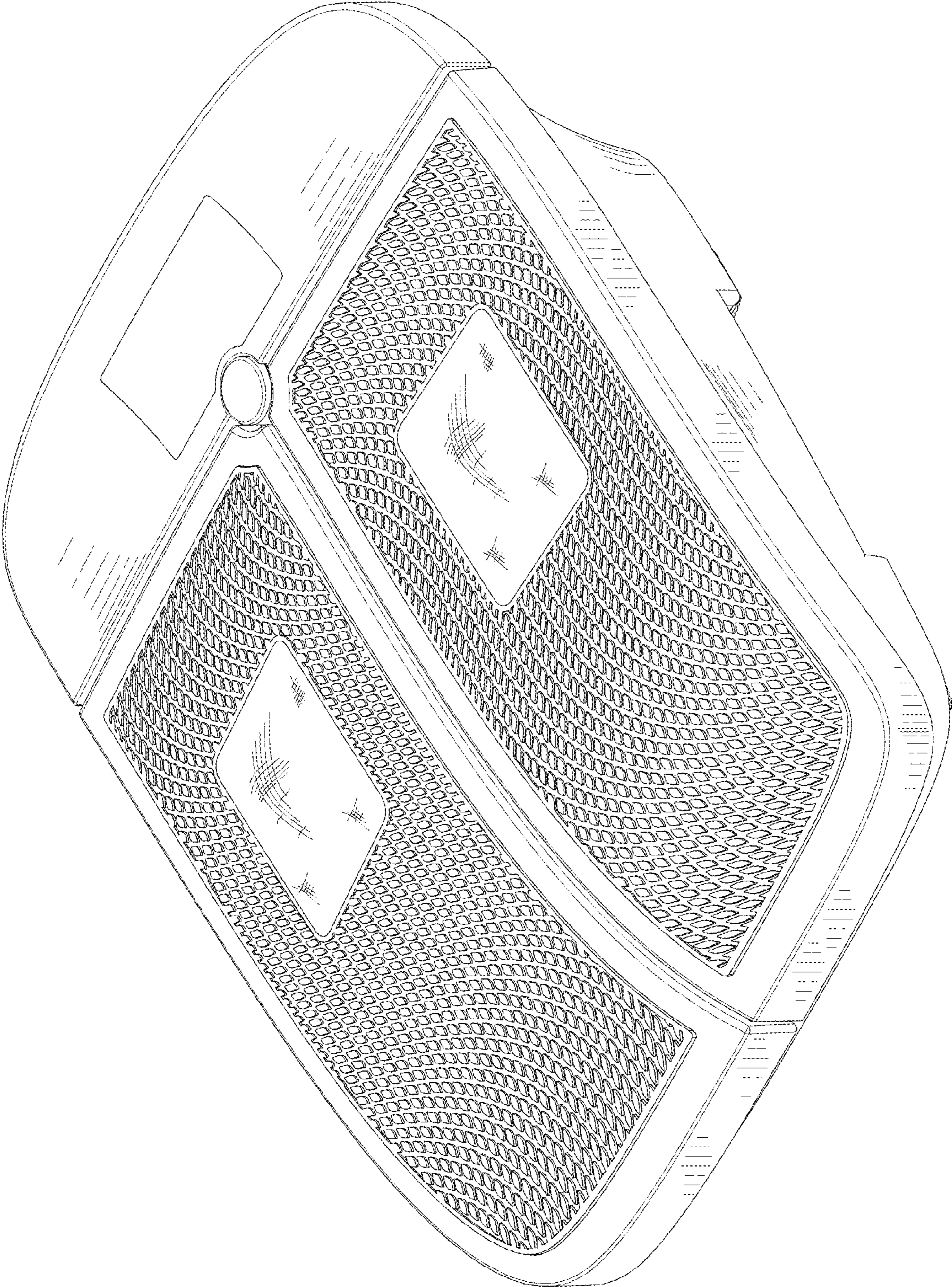

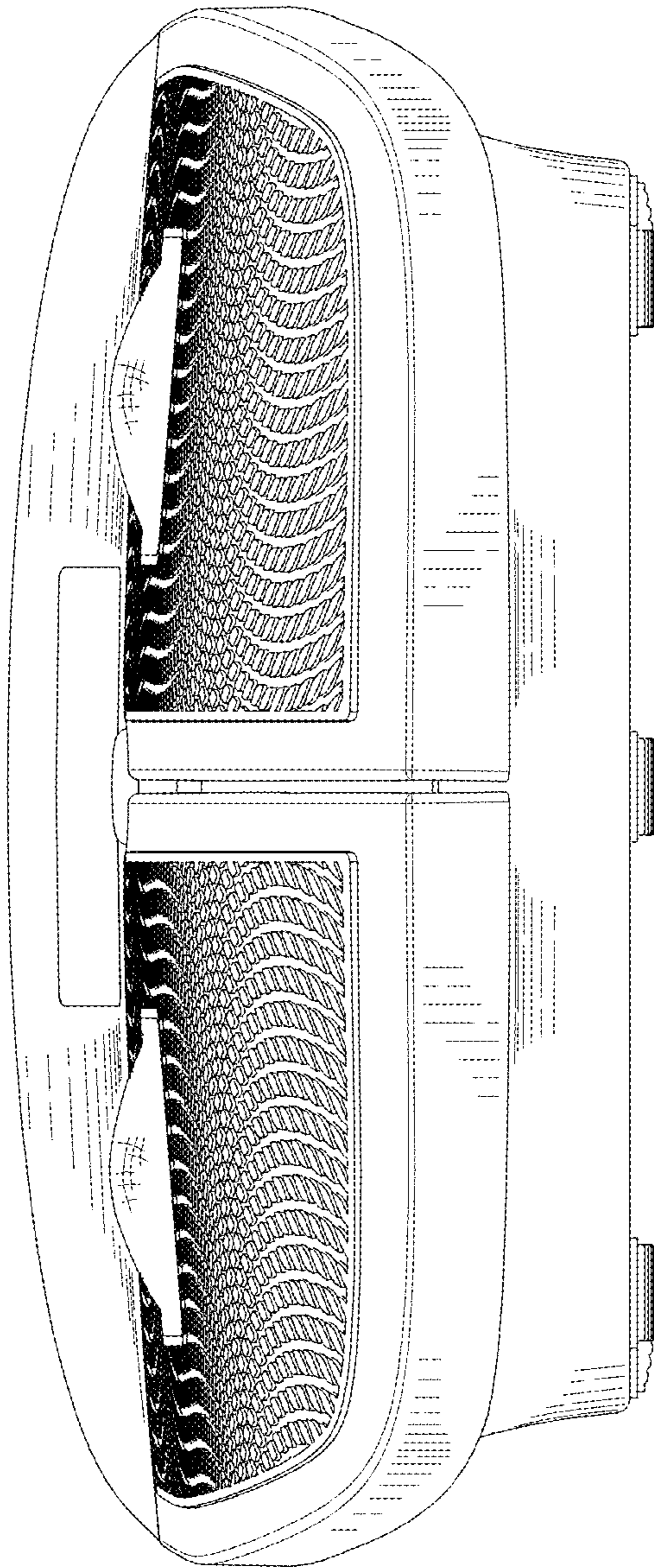

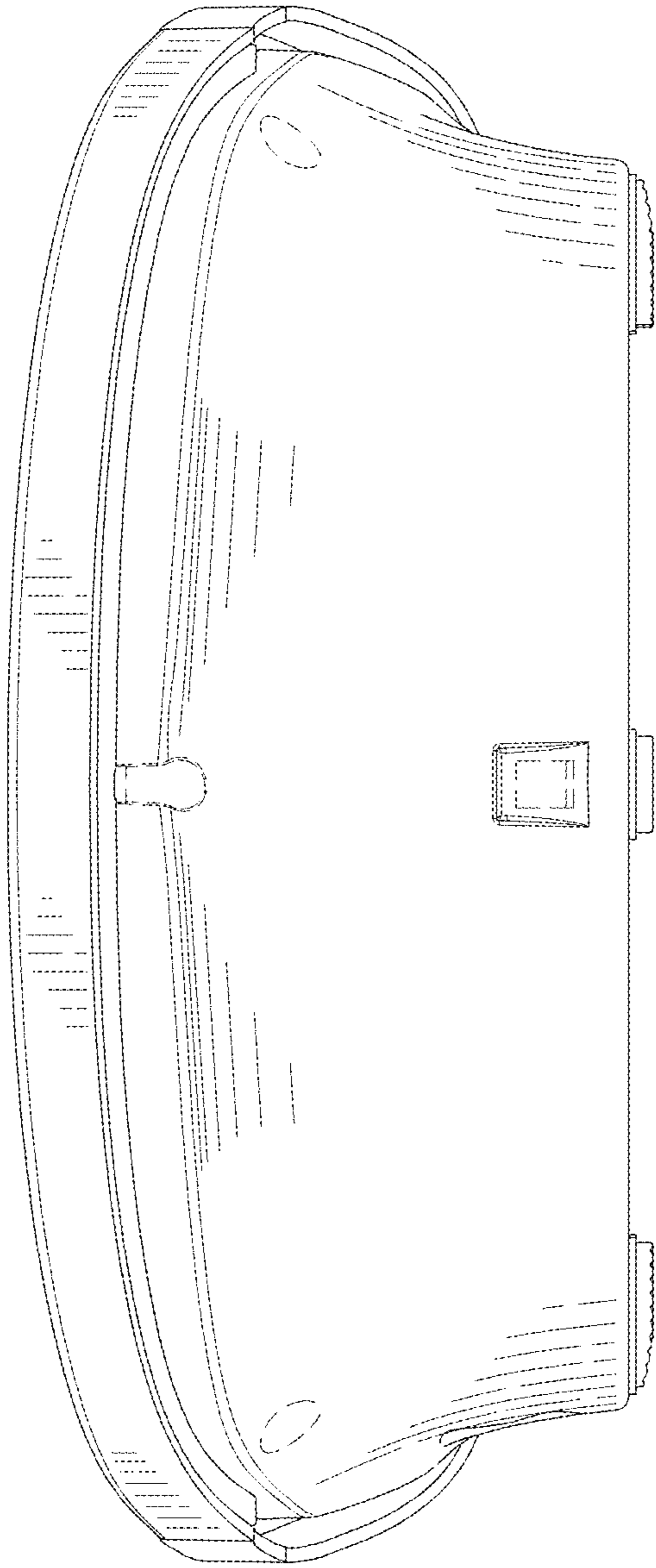

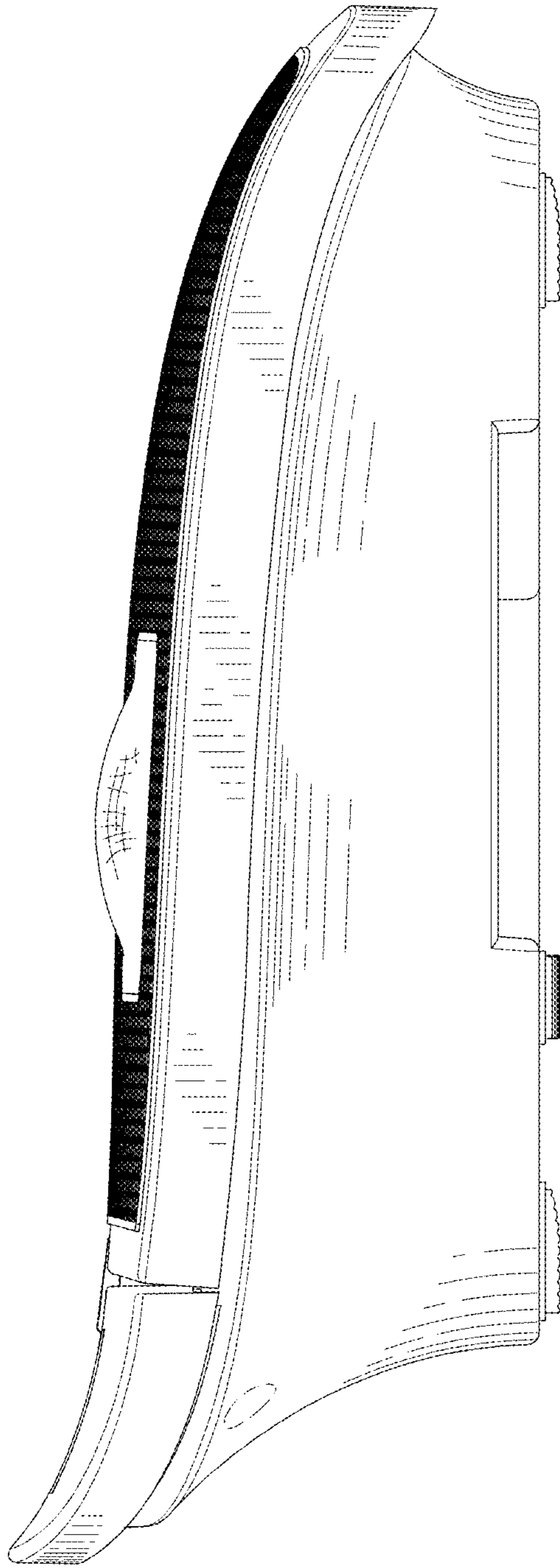

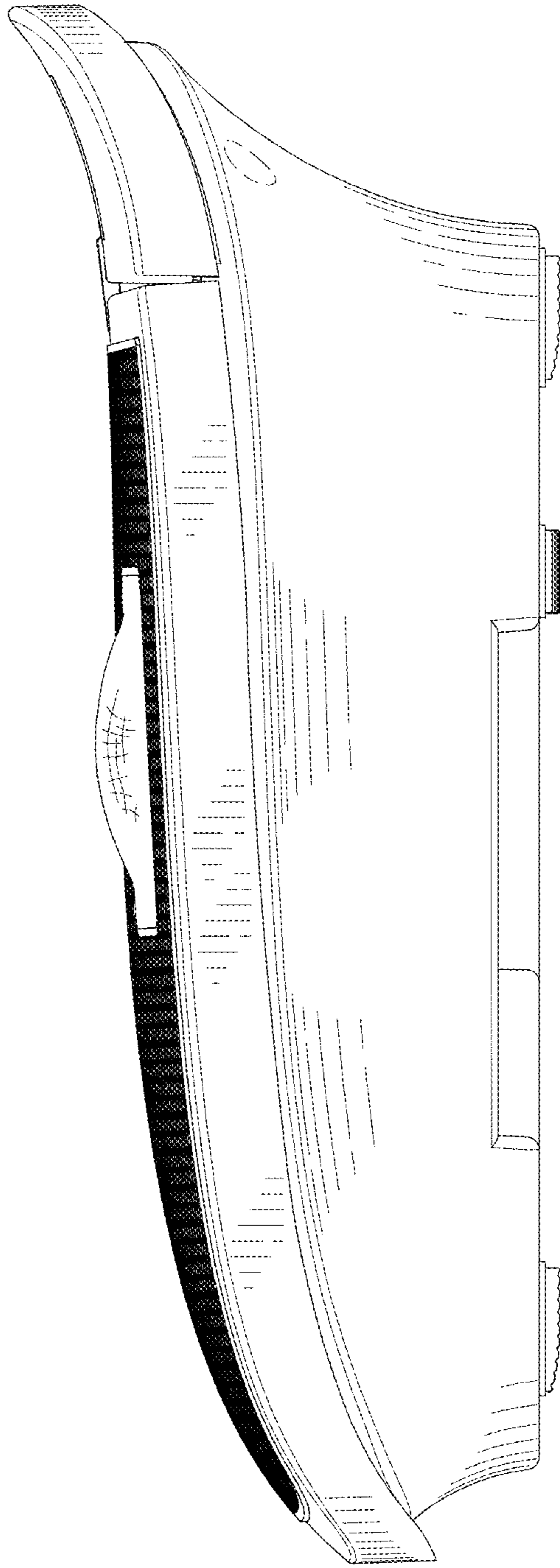

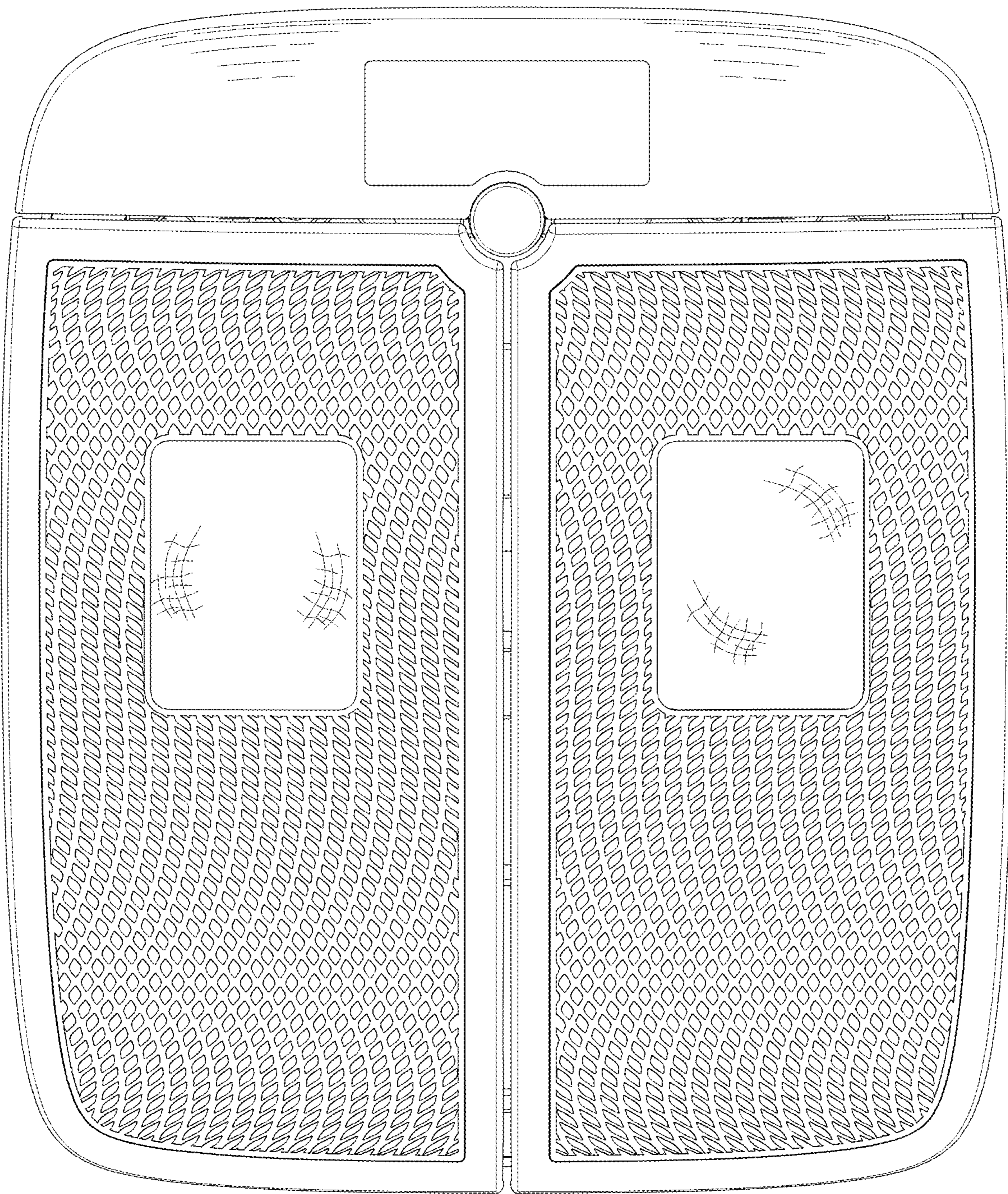

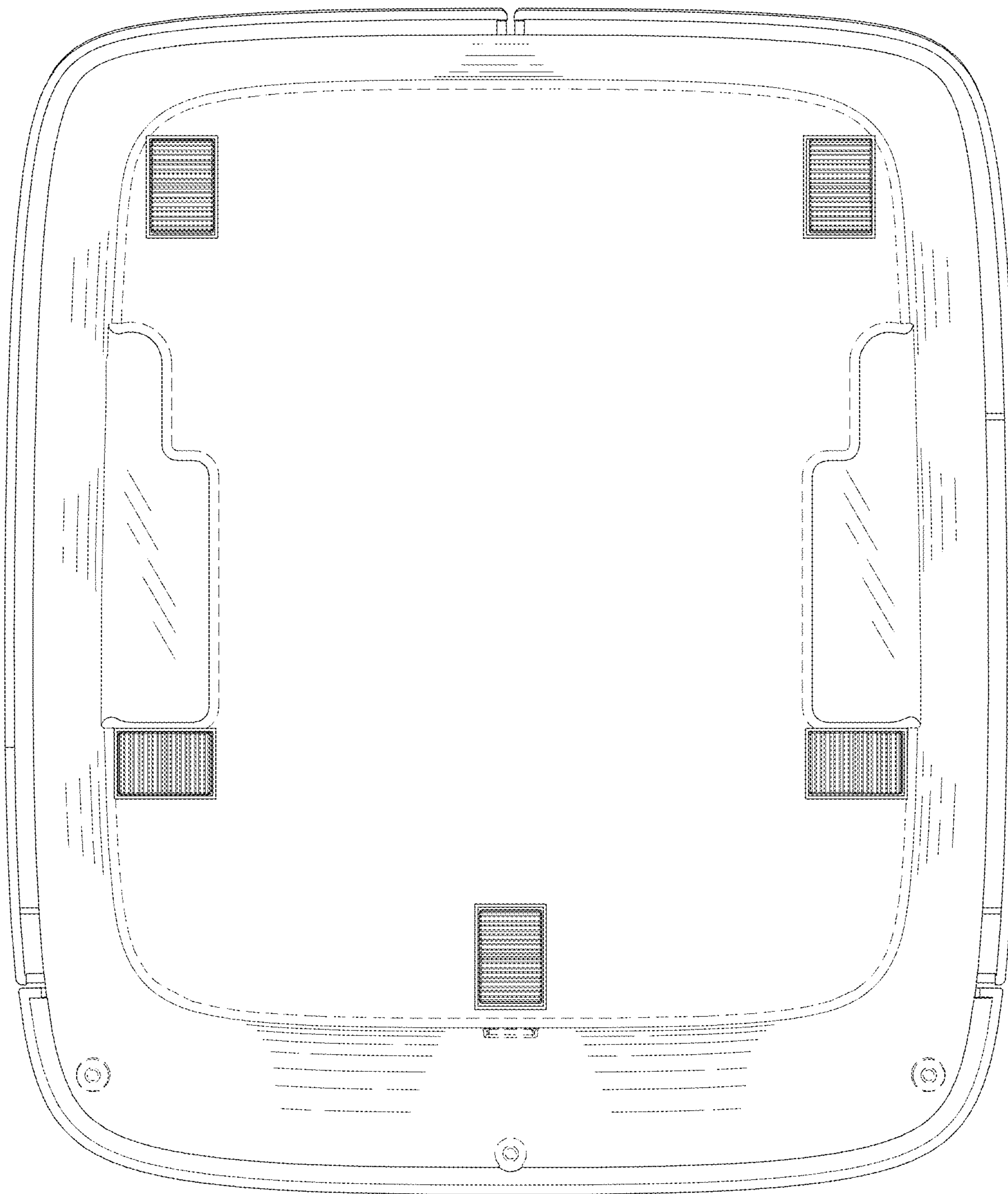
