DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, showing my new design, wherein the design is embodied in a shirt;

FIG. 2 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, showing my new design, wherein the design is embodied in a shirt;

FIG. 3 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, wherein the design is embodied in shorts;

FIG. 4 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, wherein the design is embodied in pants;

FIG. 5 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, wherein a portion of the design is embodied in a hat;

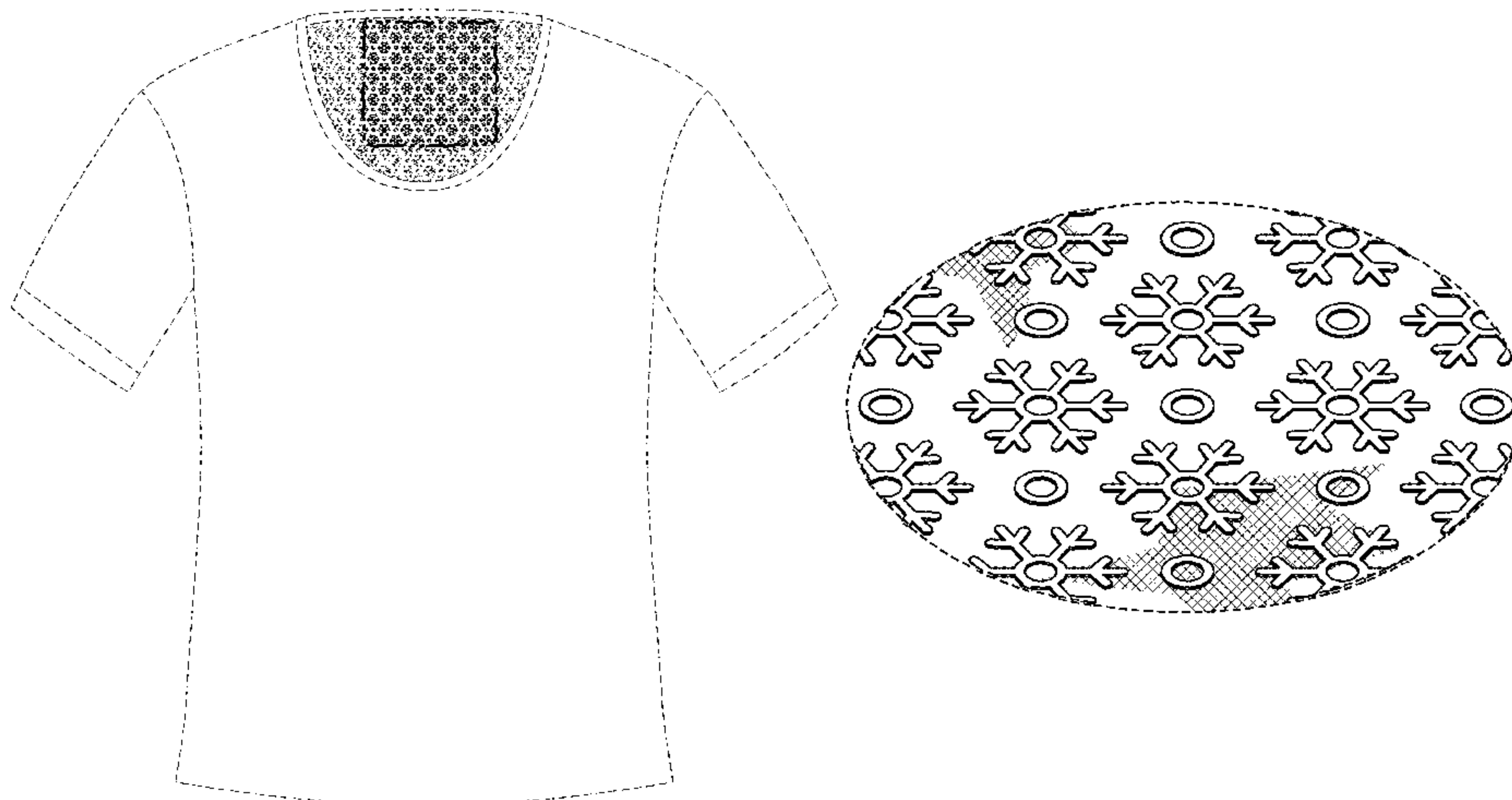
FIG. 6 is a front view of apparel with patterned material, wherein the design is embodied in a jacket;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged front view of the claimed region of FIGS. 1-6; and,

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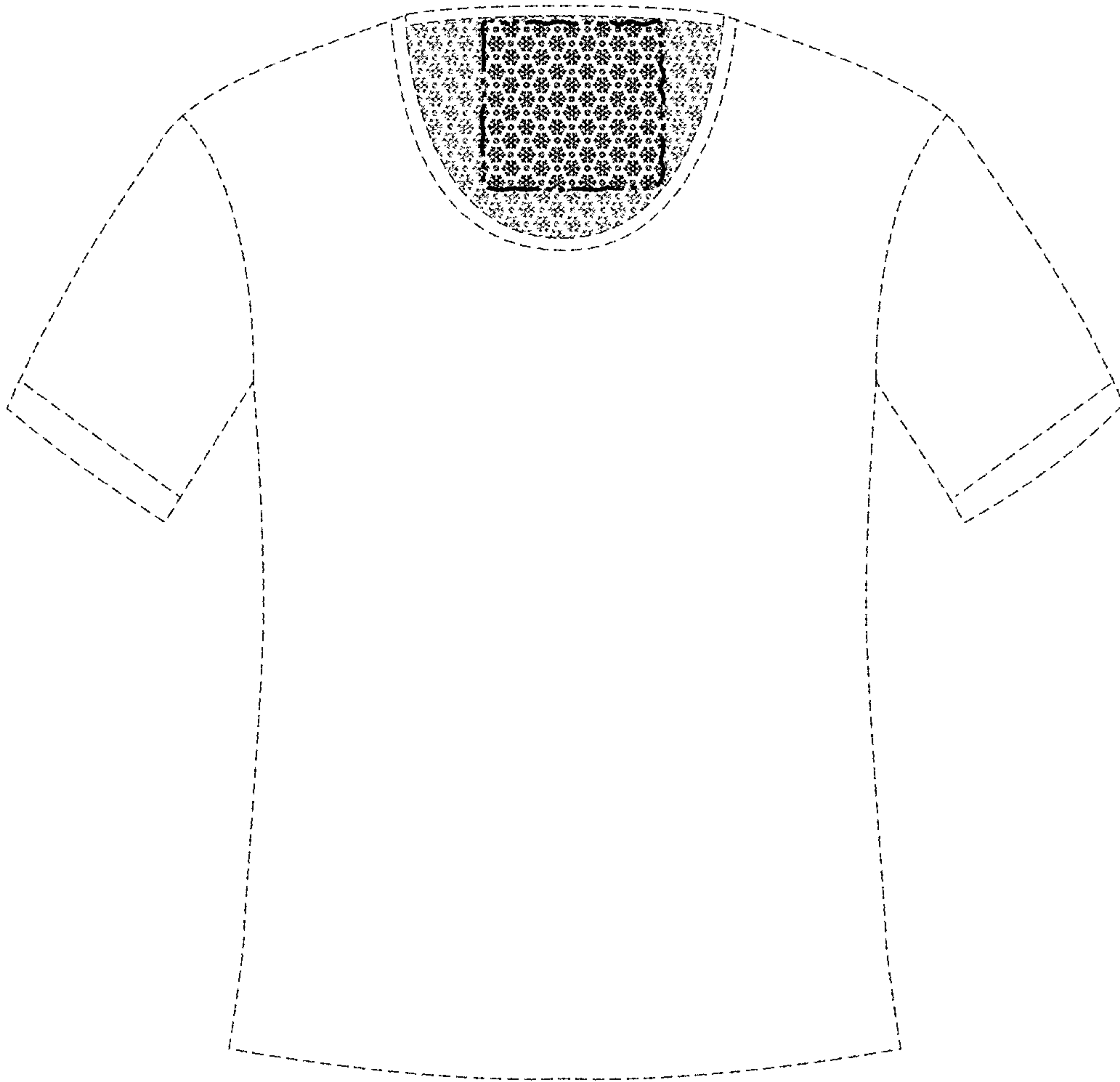

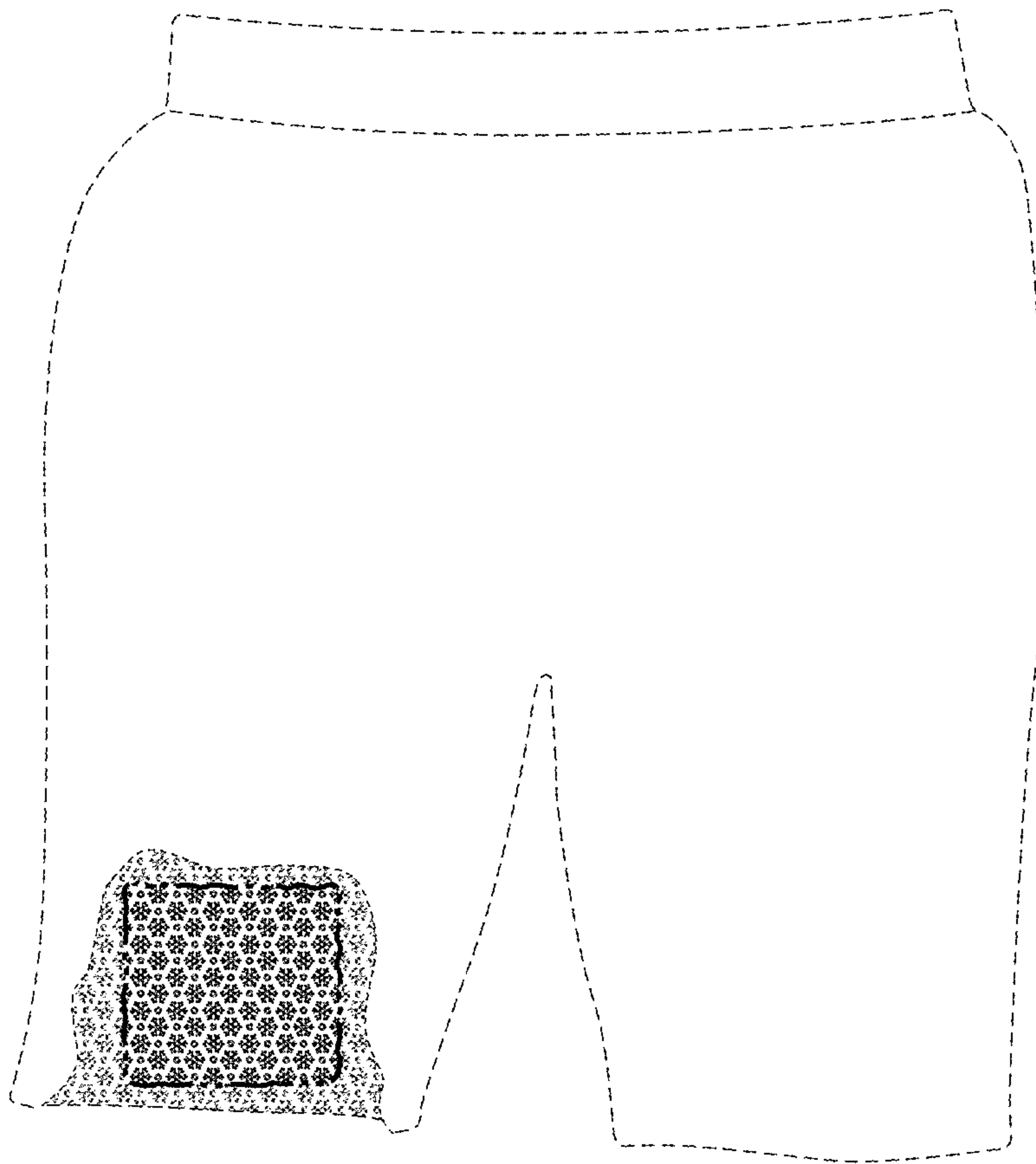

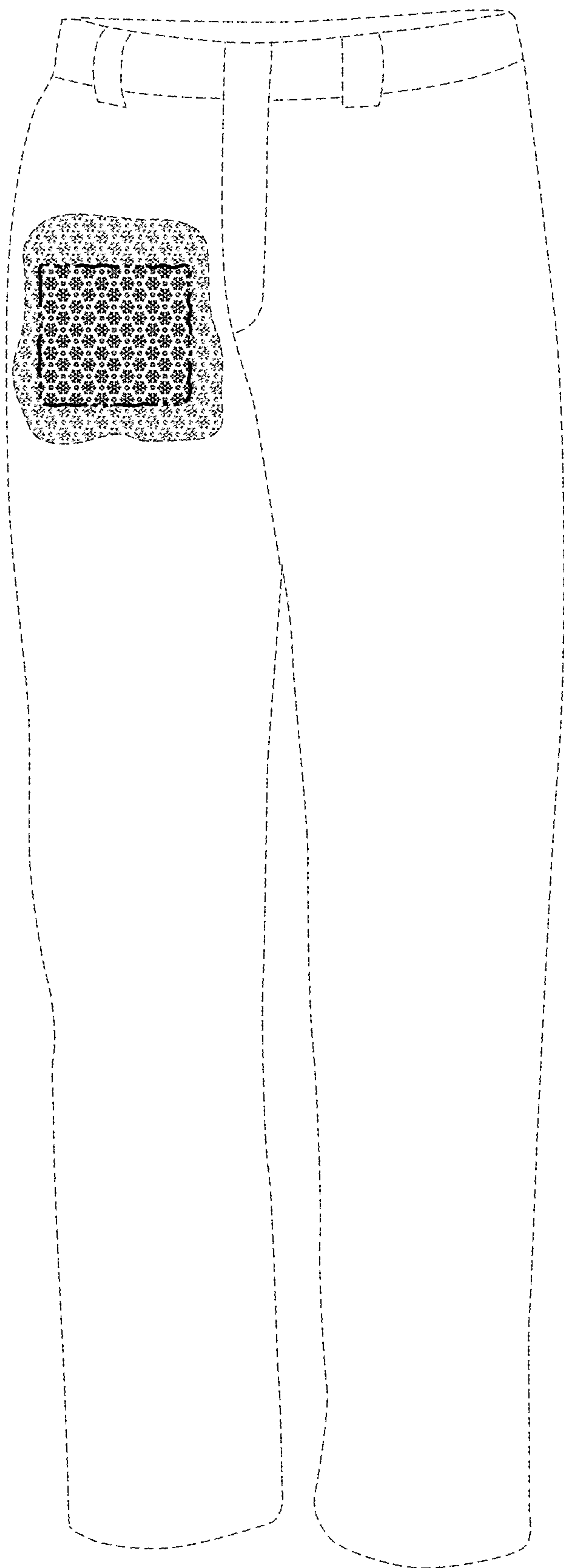

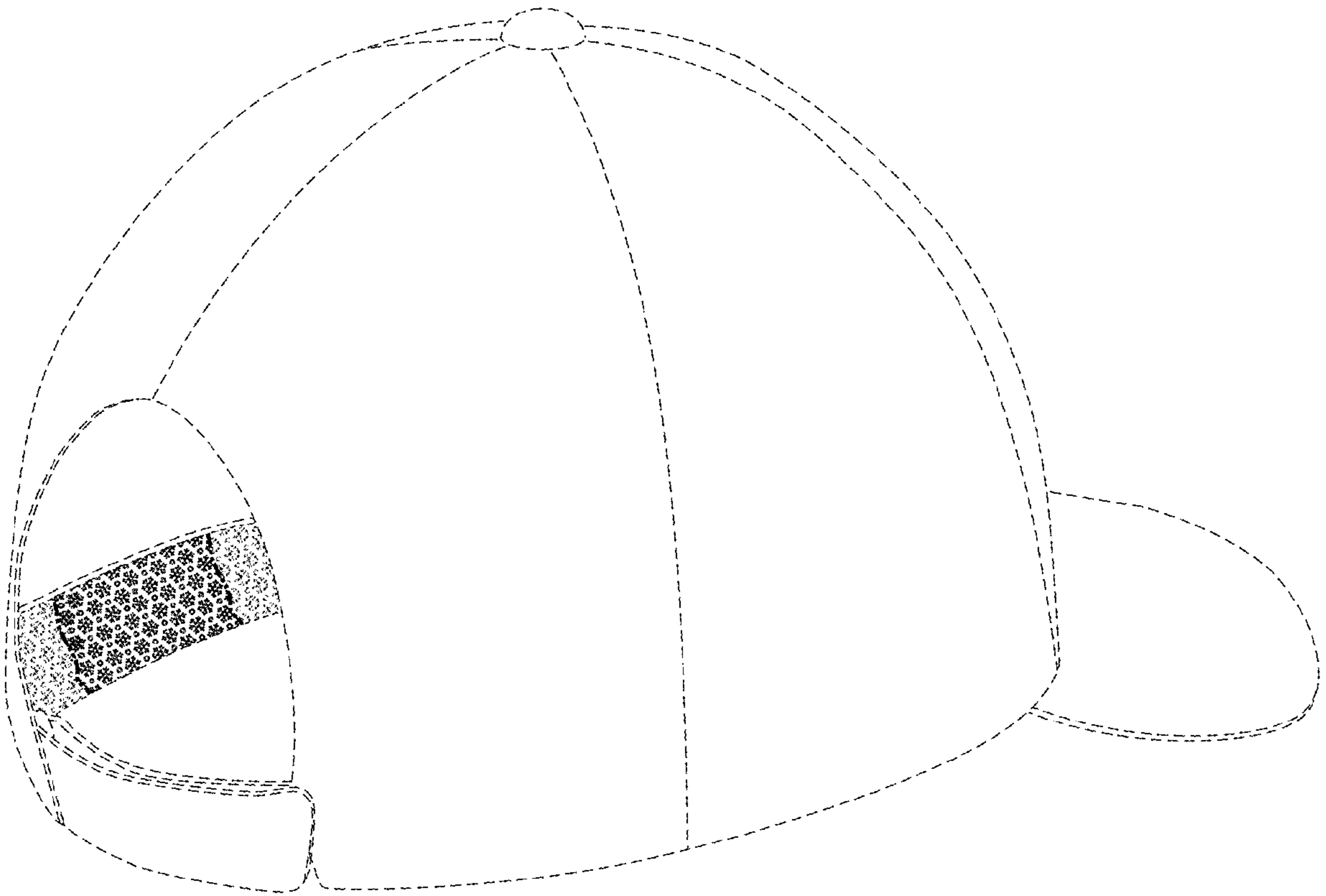

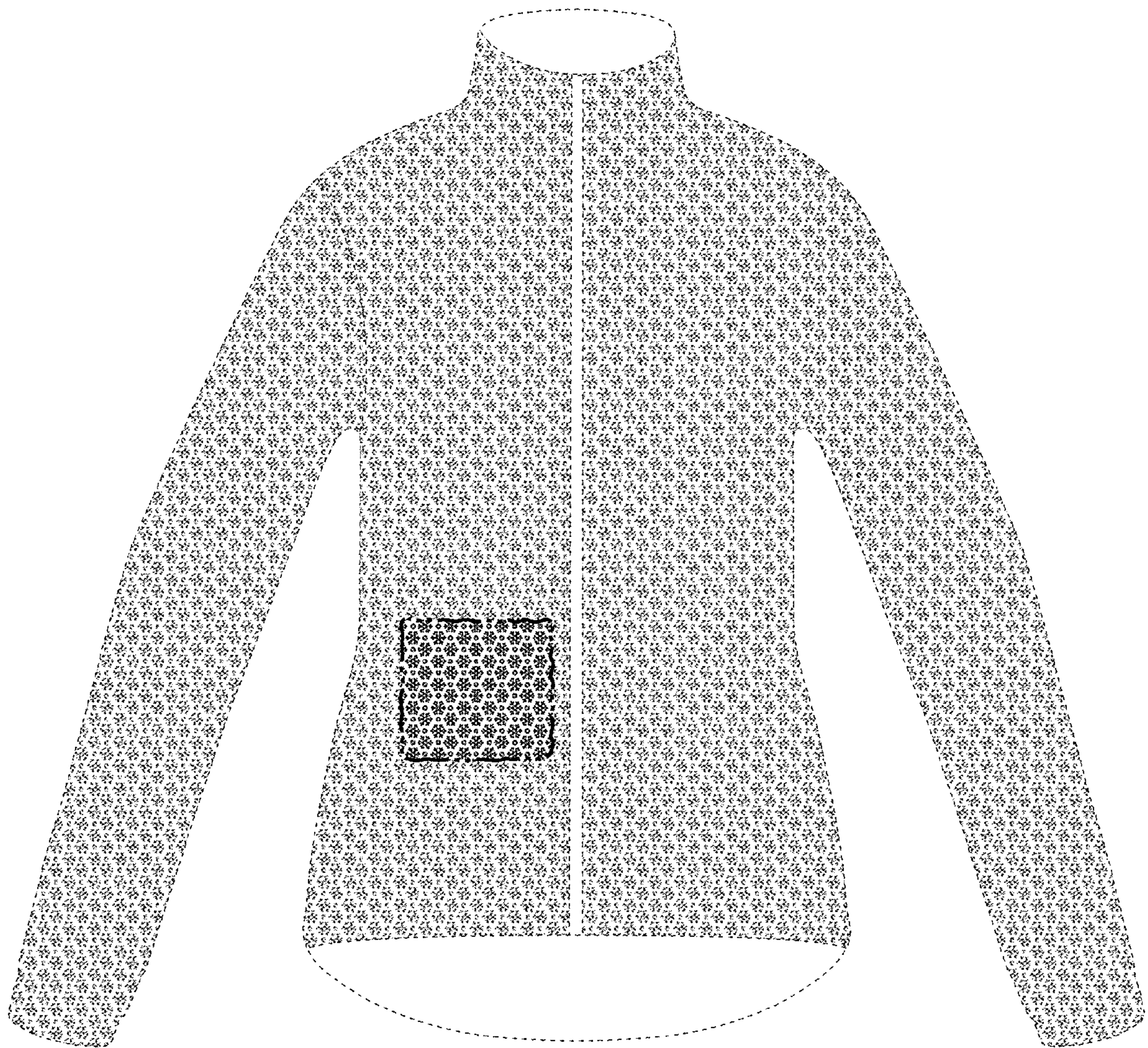
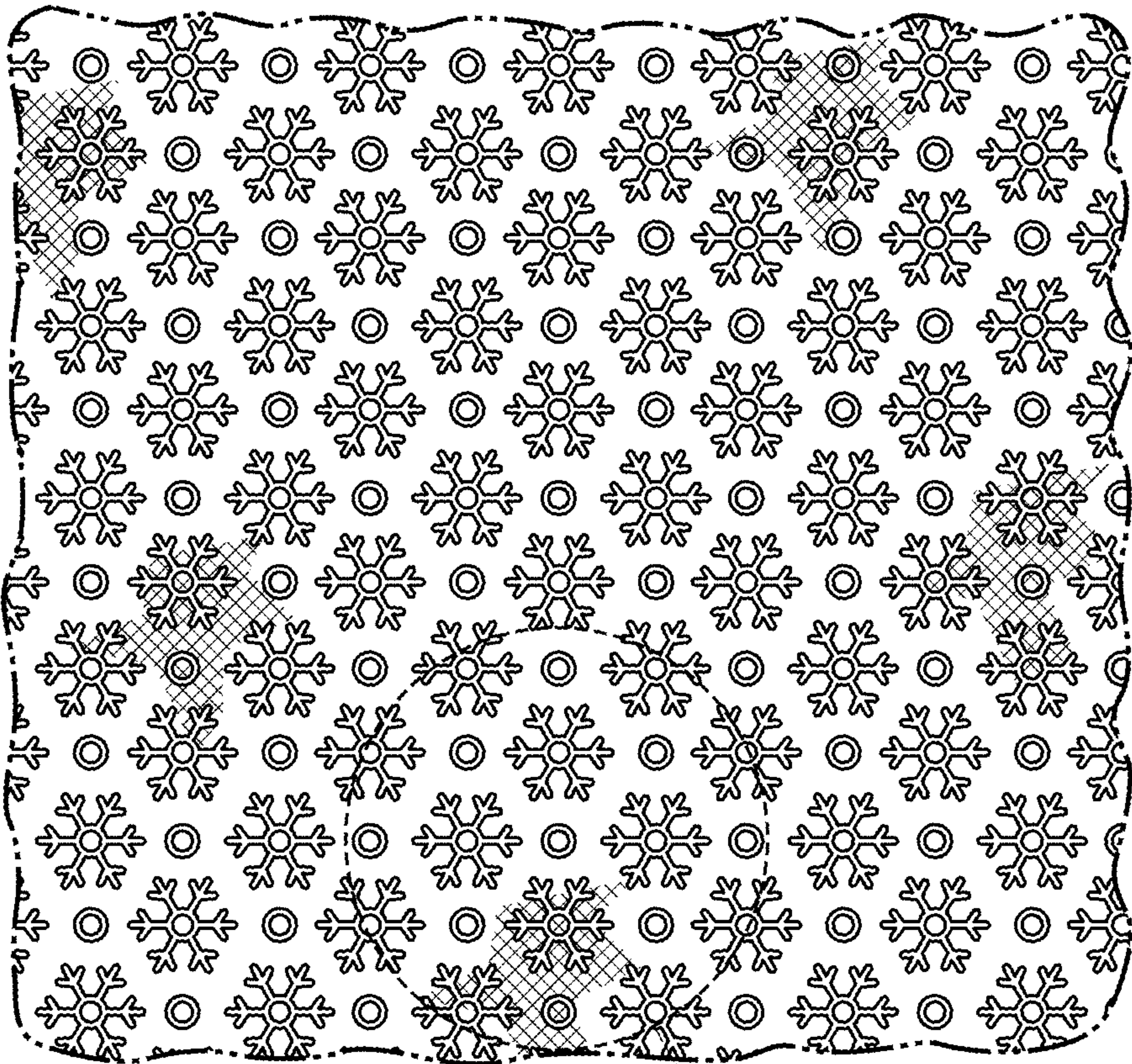

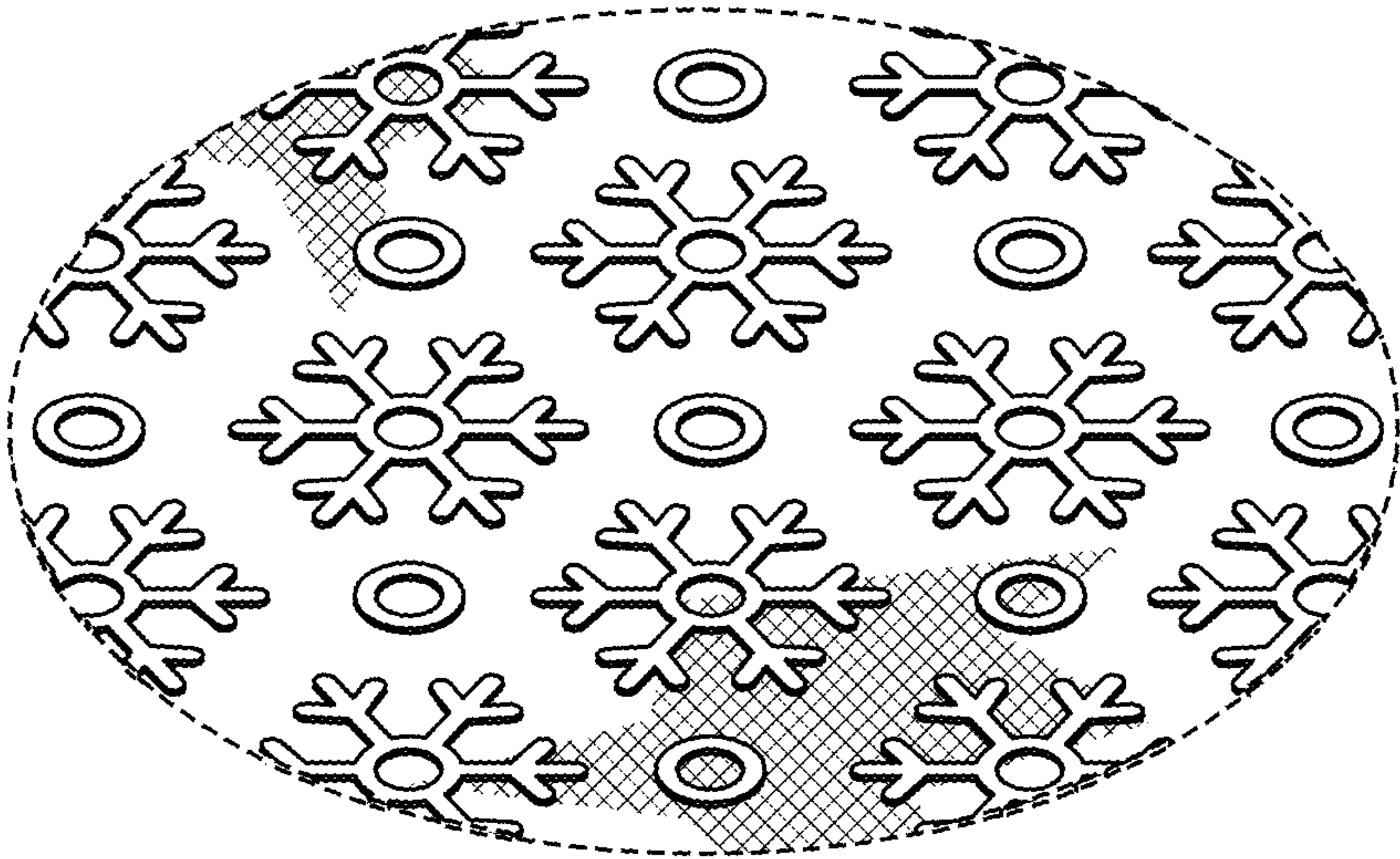
