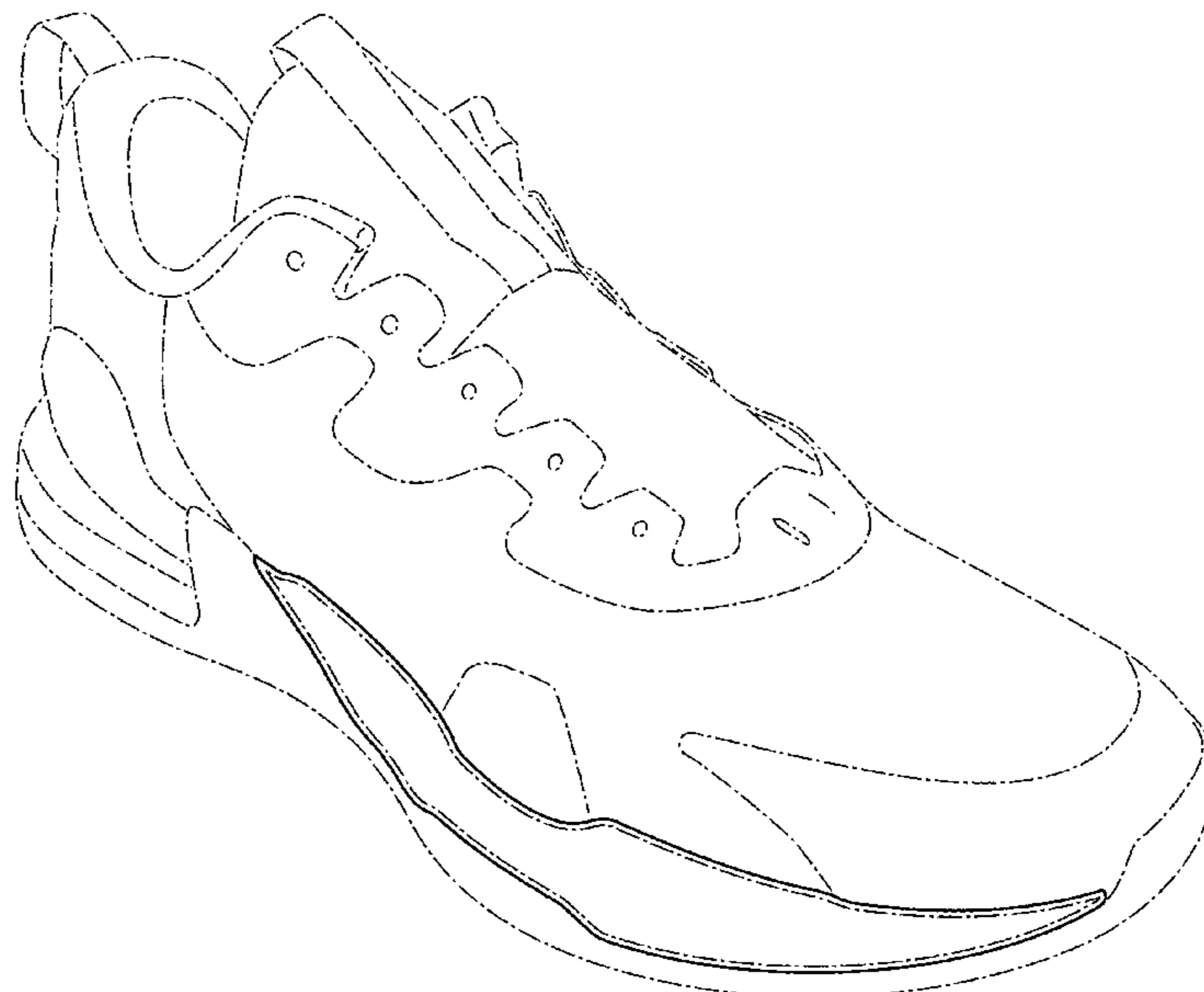
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof; and,
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.
The broken line immediately adjacent to the internal perimeter of the solid line region defines an internal bound of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The broken lines depicting the remainder of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

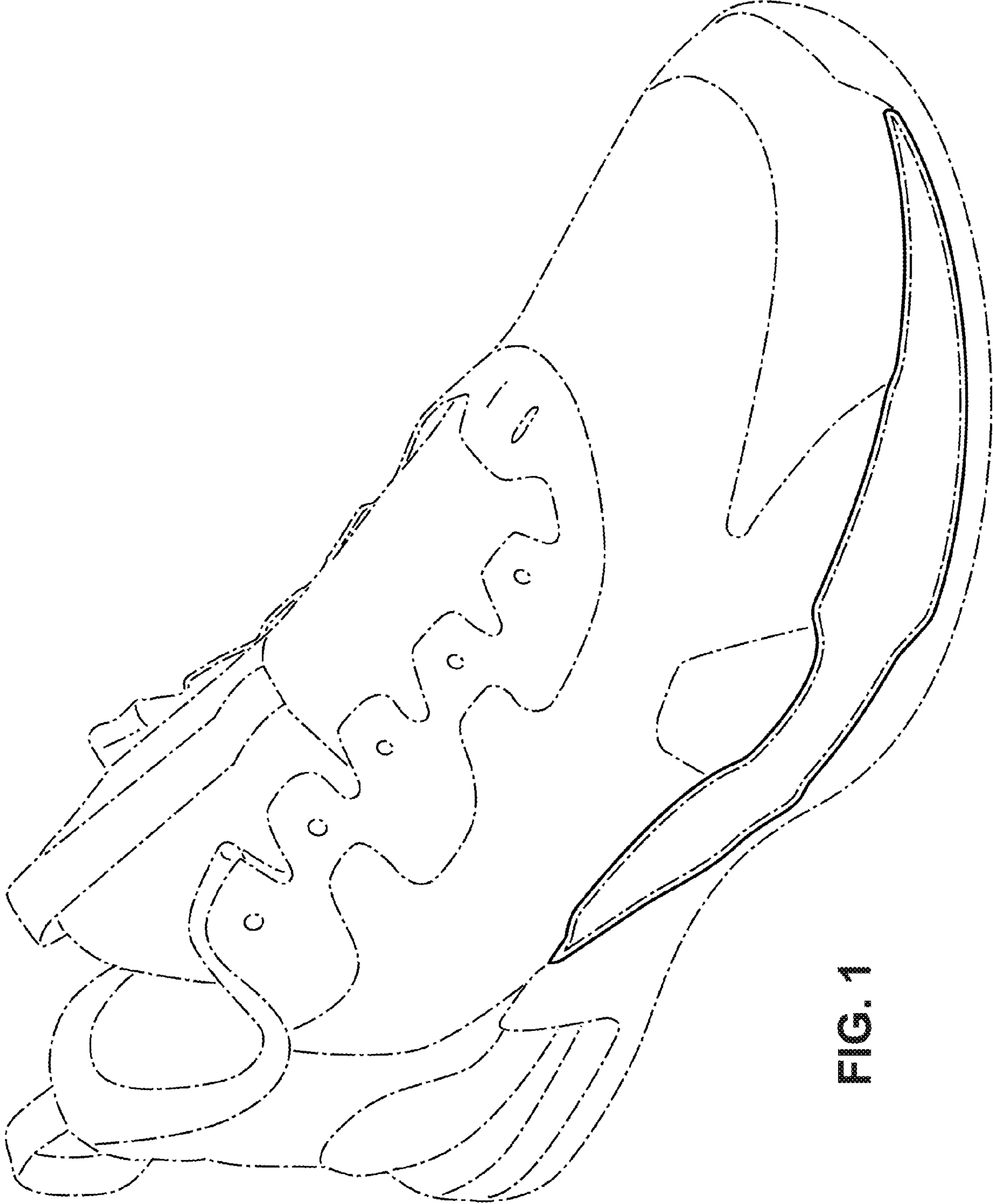

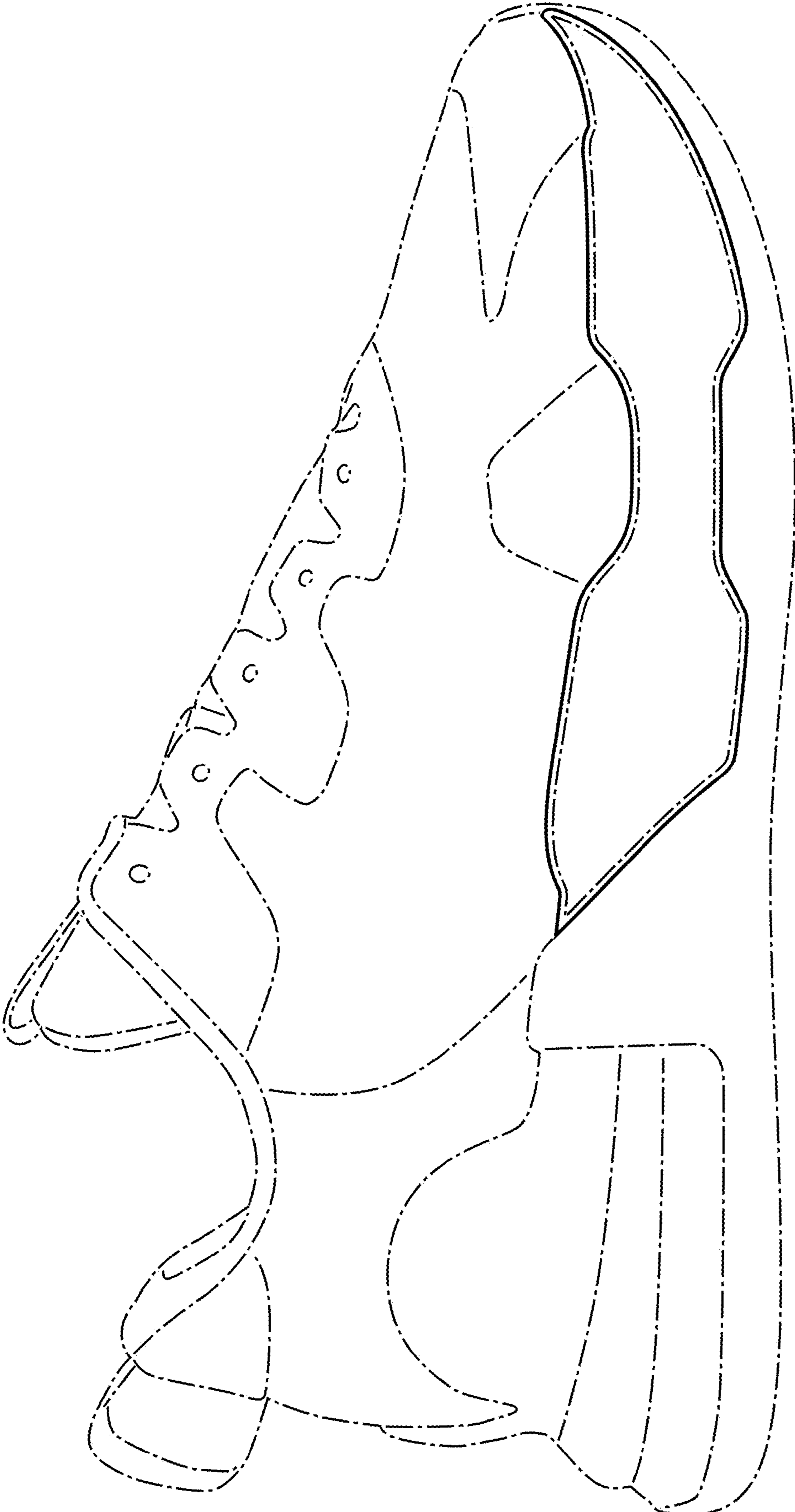
