DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a gift card carrier showing a first embodiment of our new ornamental design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 8 is a front perspective view showing the gift card carrier in a partially folded state; FIG. 9 is a front perspective view of a gift card carrier showing a second embodiment of our new ornamental design; FIG. 10 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 11 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 14 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 15 is a right side elevation view thereof; and, FIG. 16 is a front perspective view showing the gift card carrier in a partially folded state.
In the drawings, the shorter broken lines are for the purpose of illustrating perforations. The longer broken lines are for the purpose of illustrating environment and portions of the gift card carrier. In the drawings, the shorter and longer broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

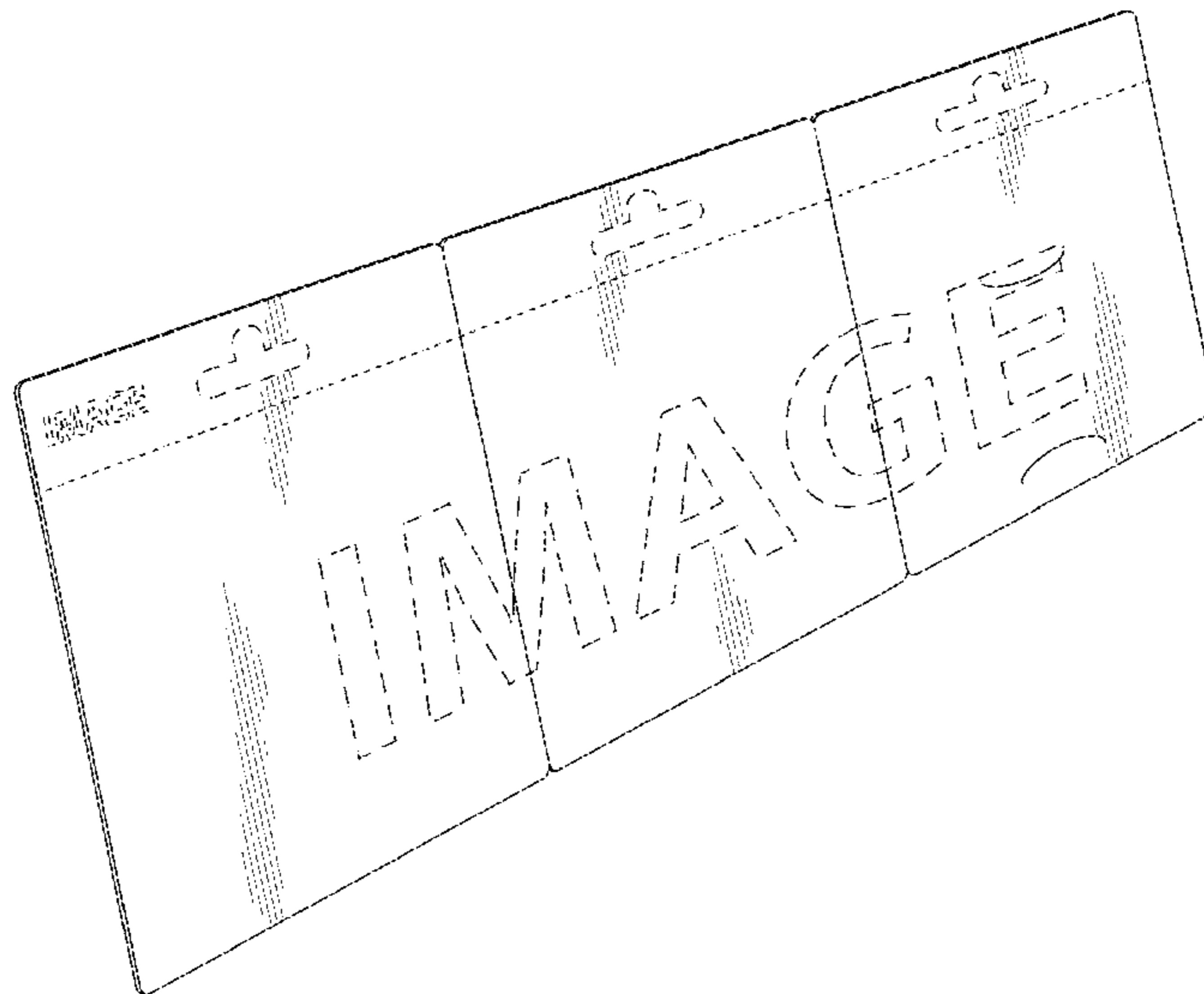

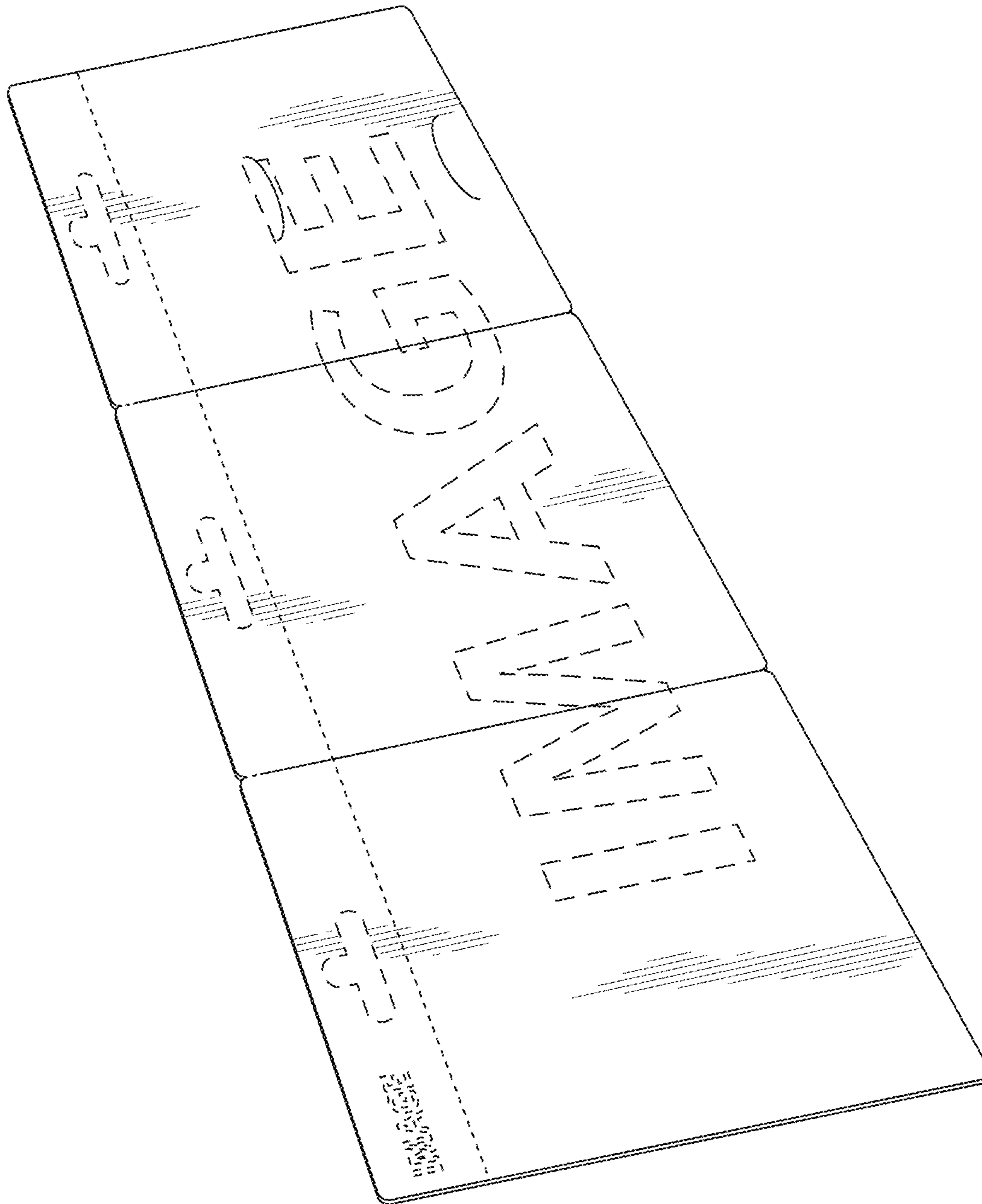

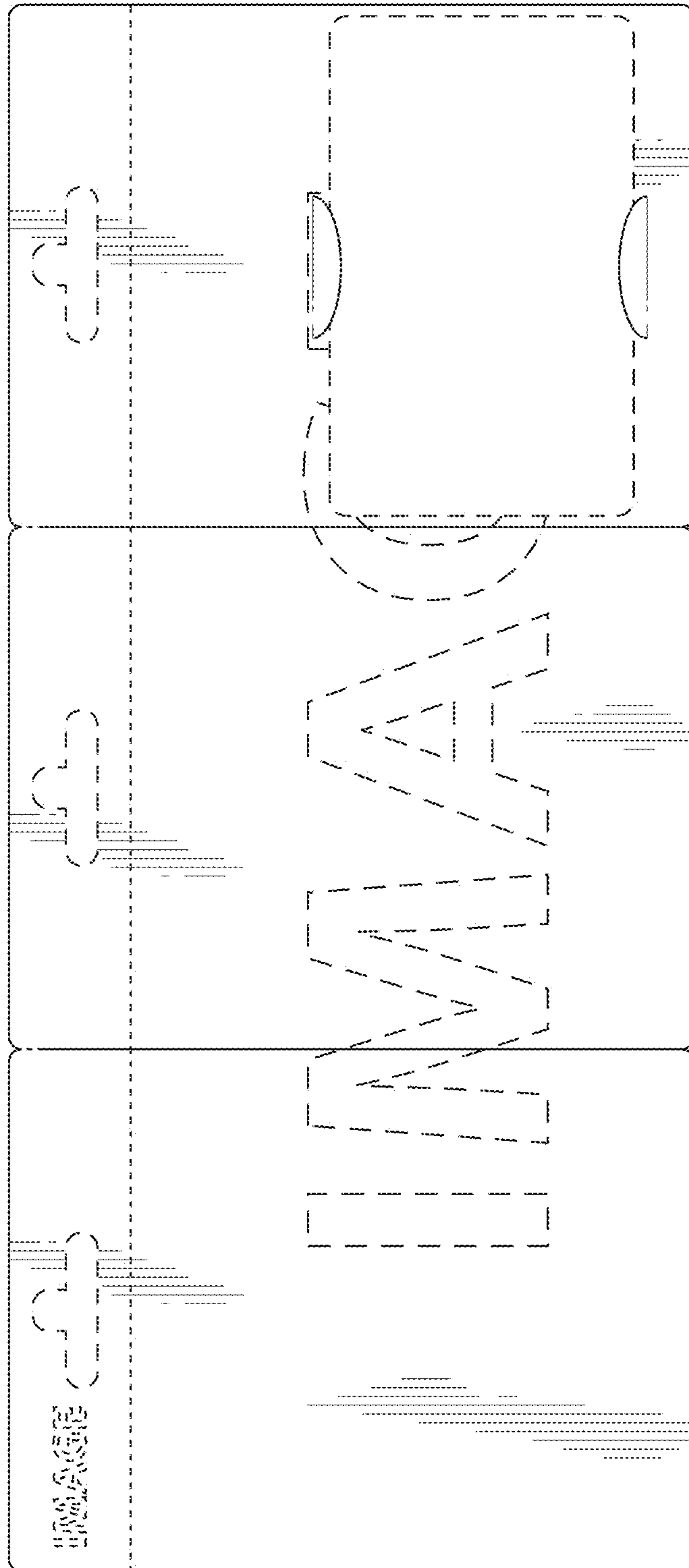

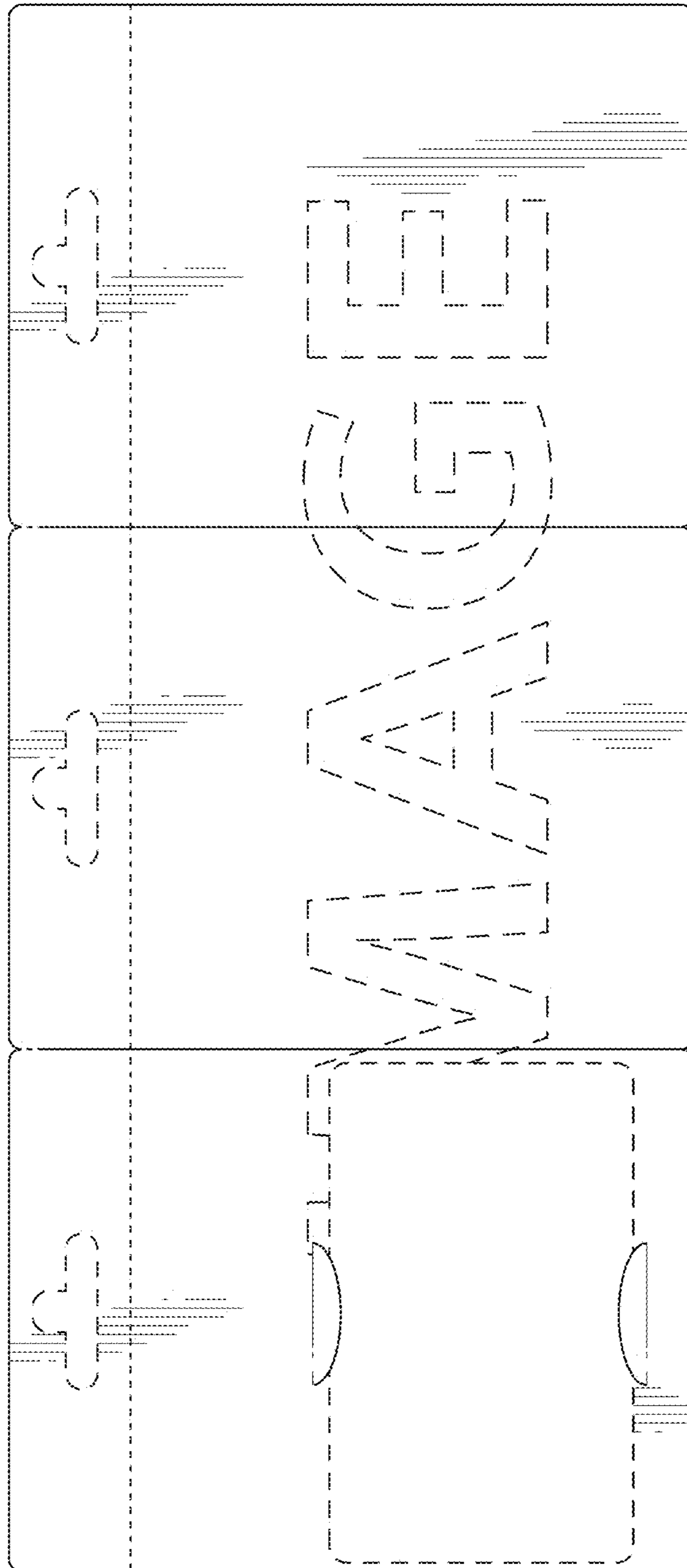

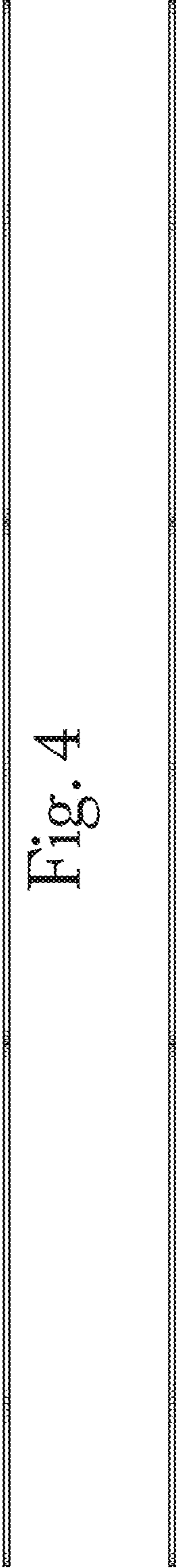

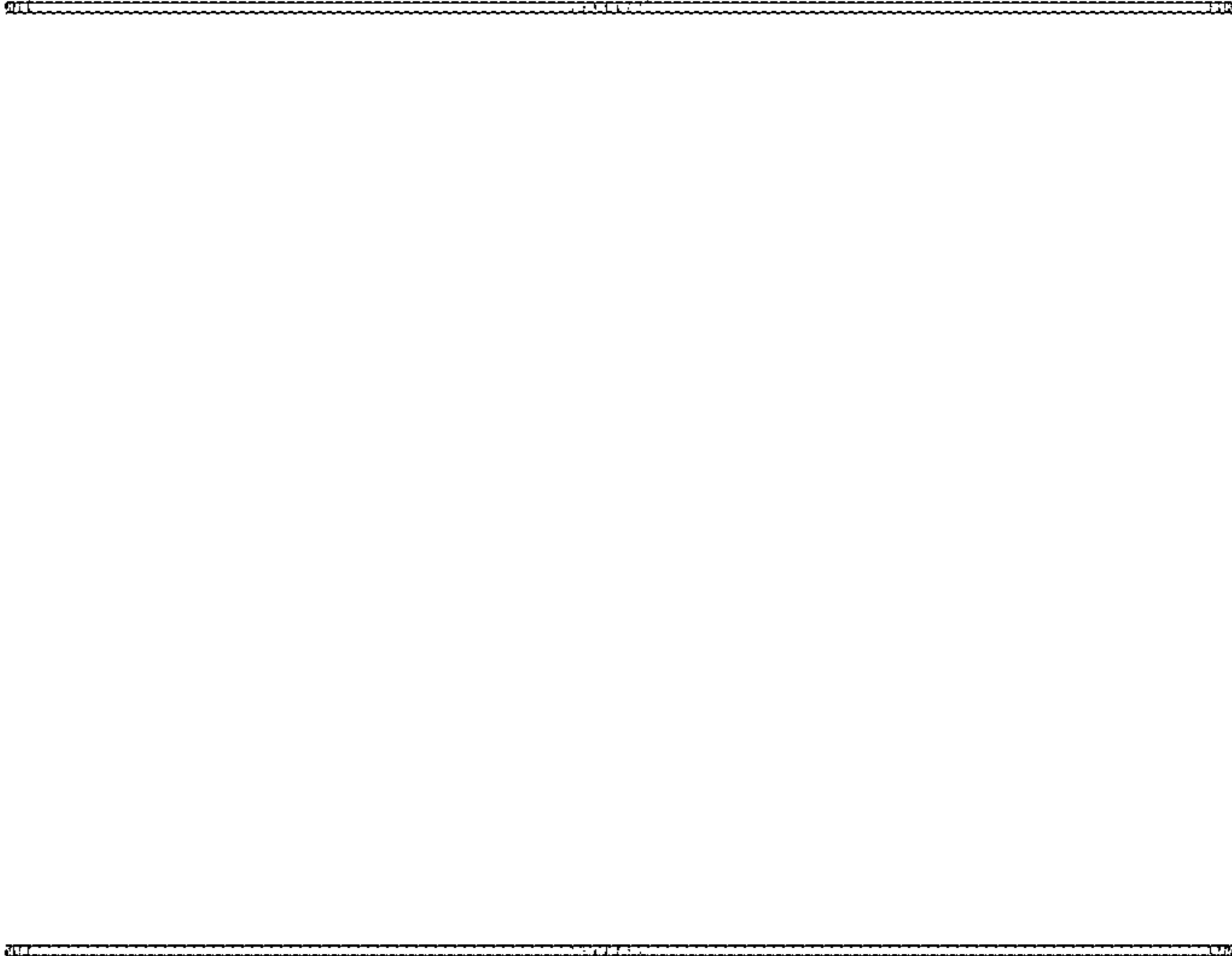

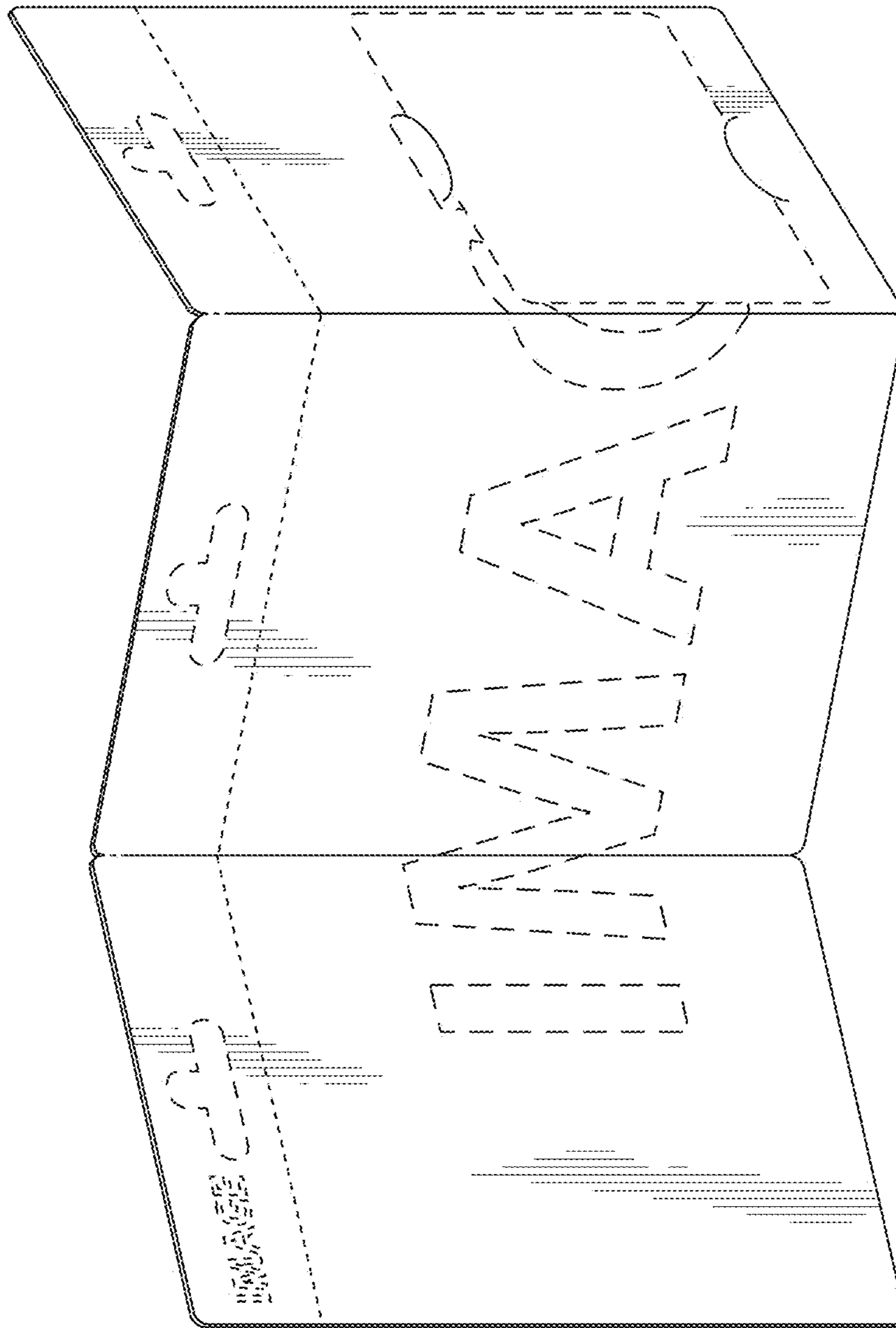

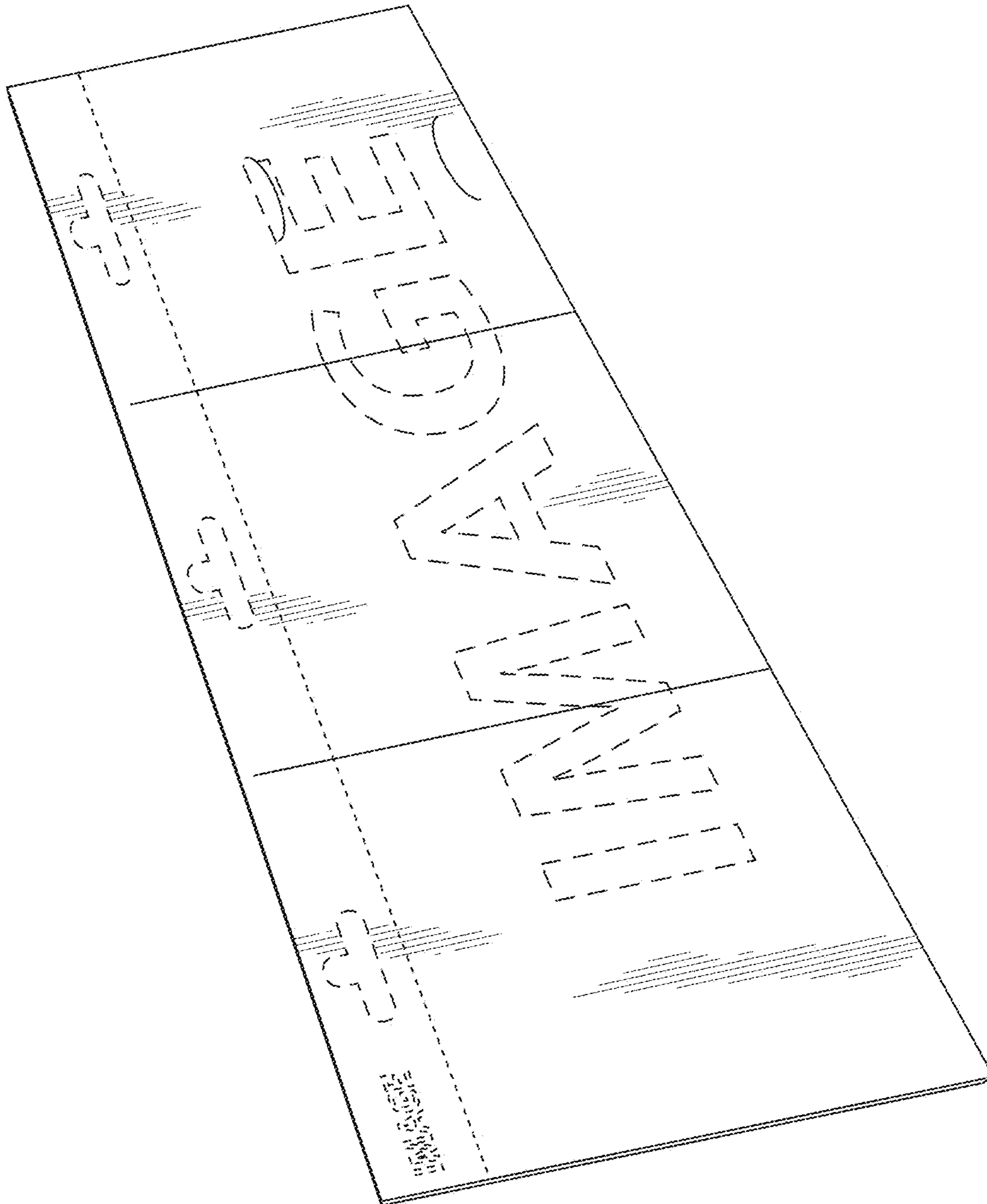

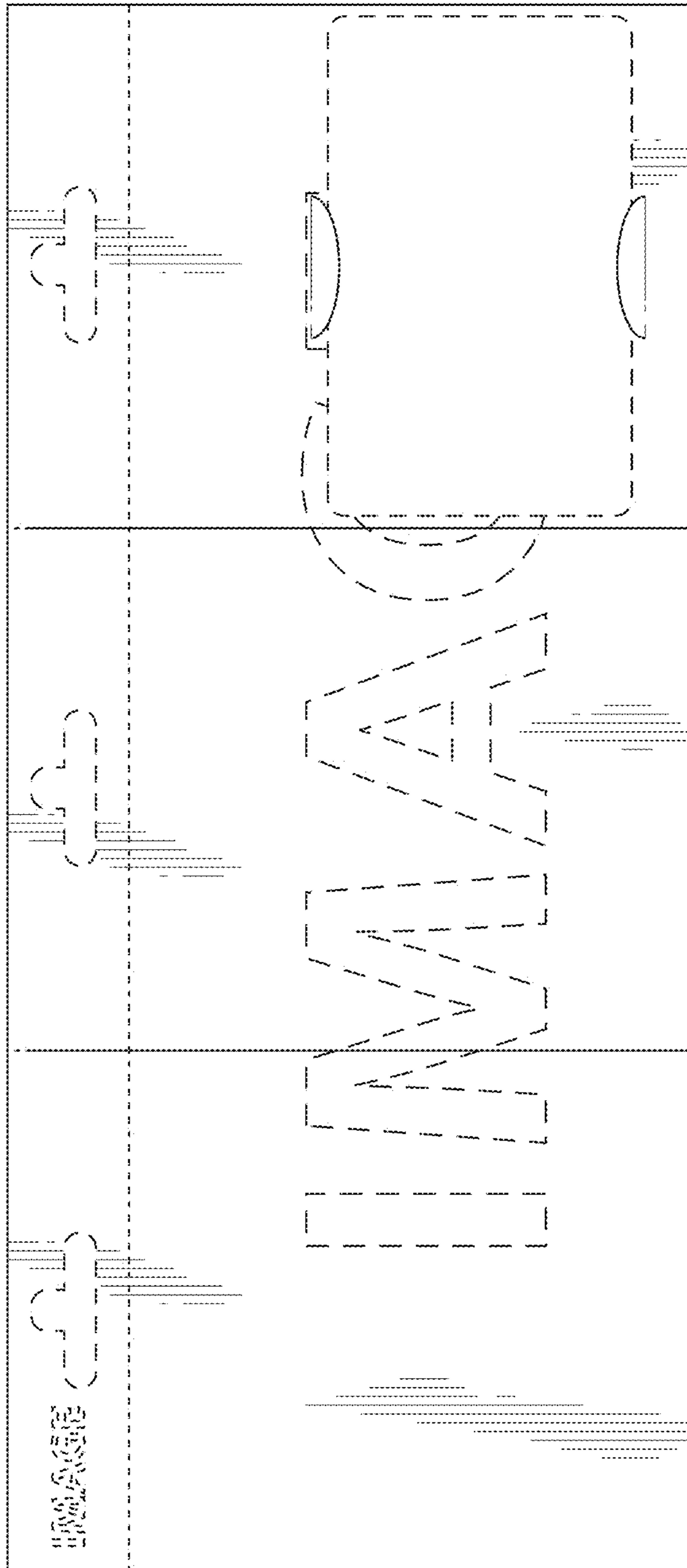

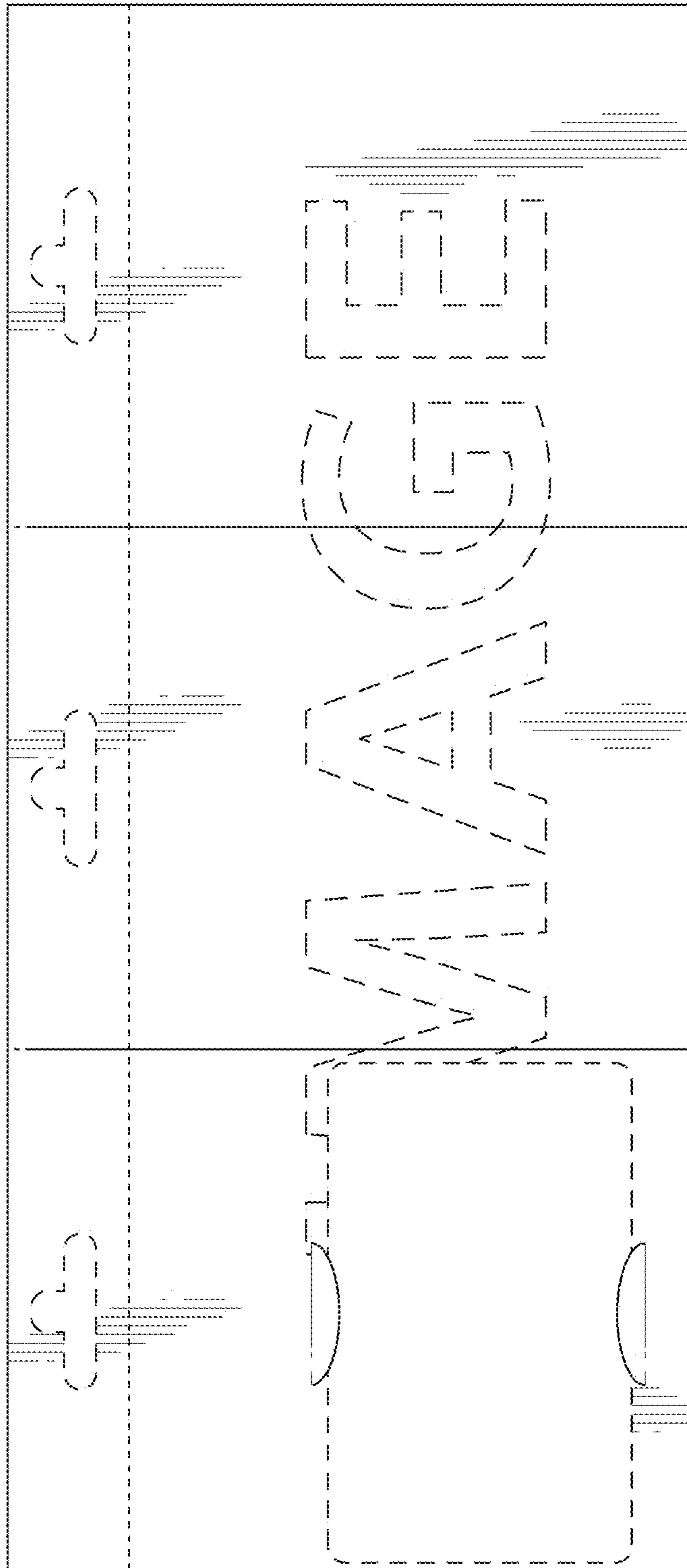

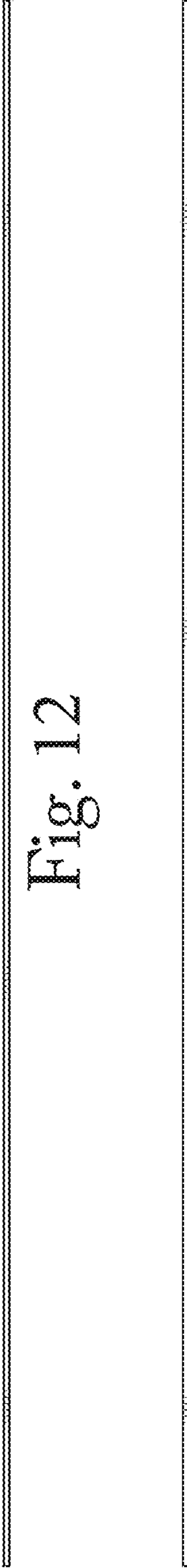

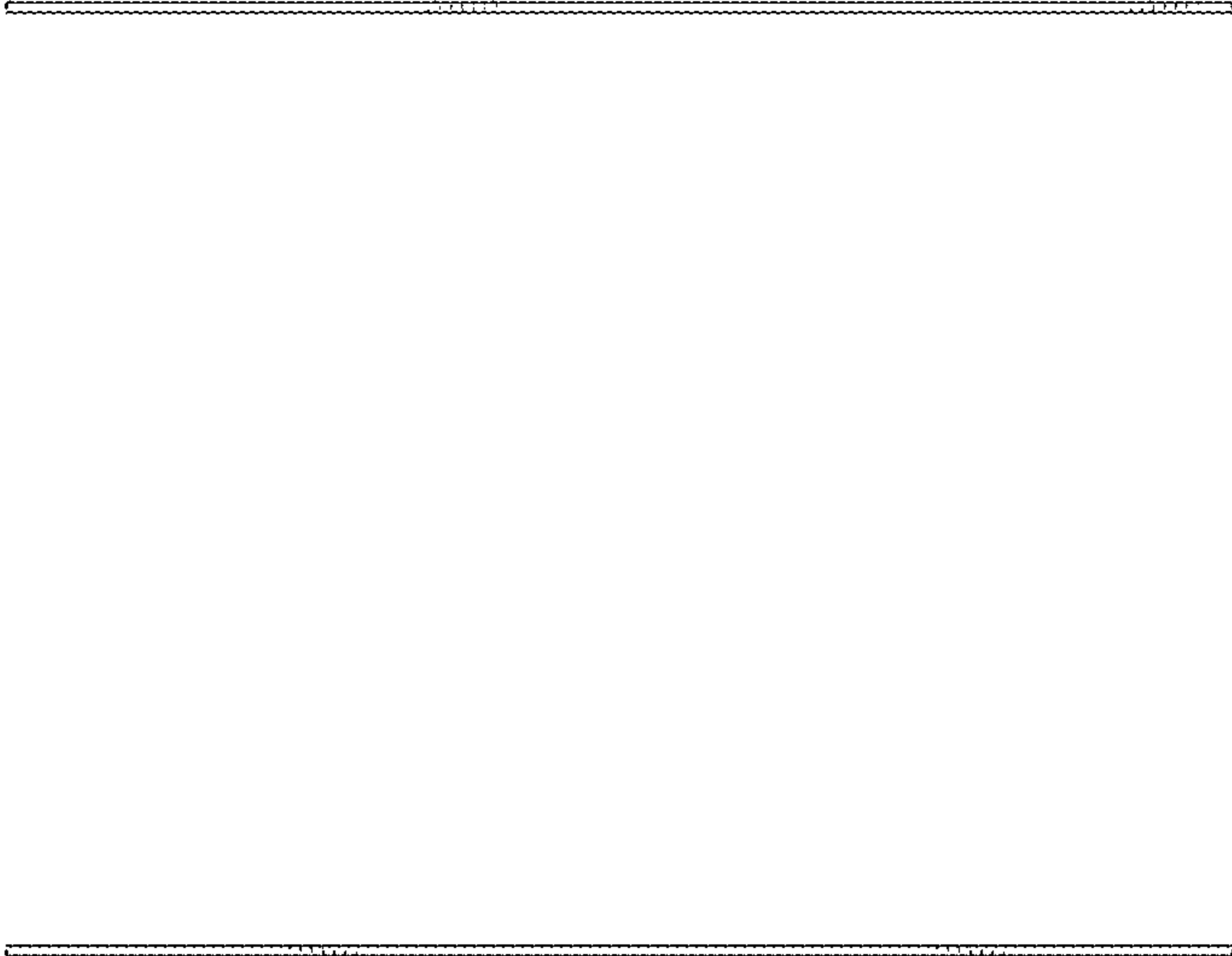

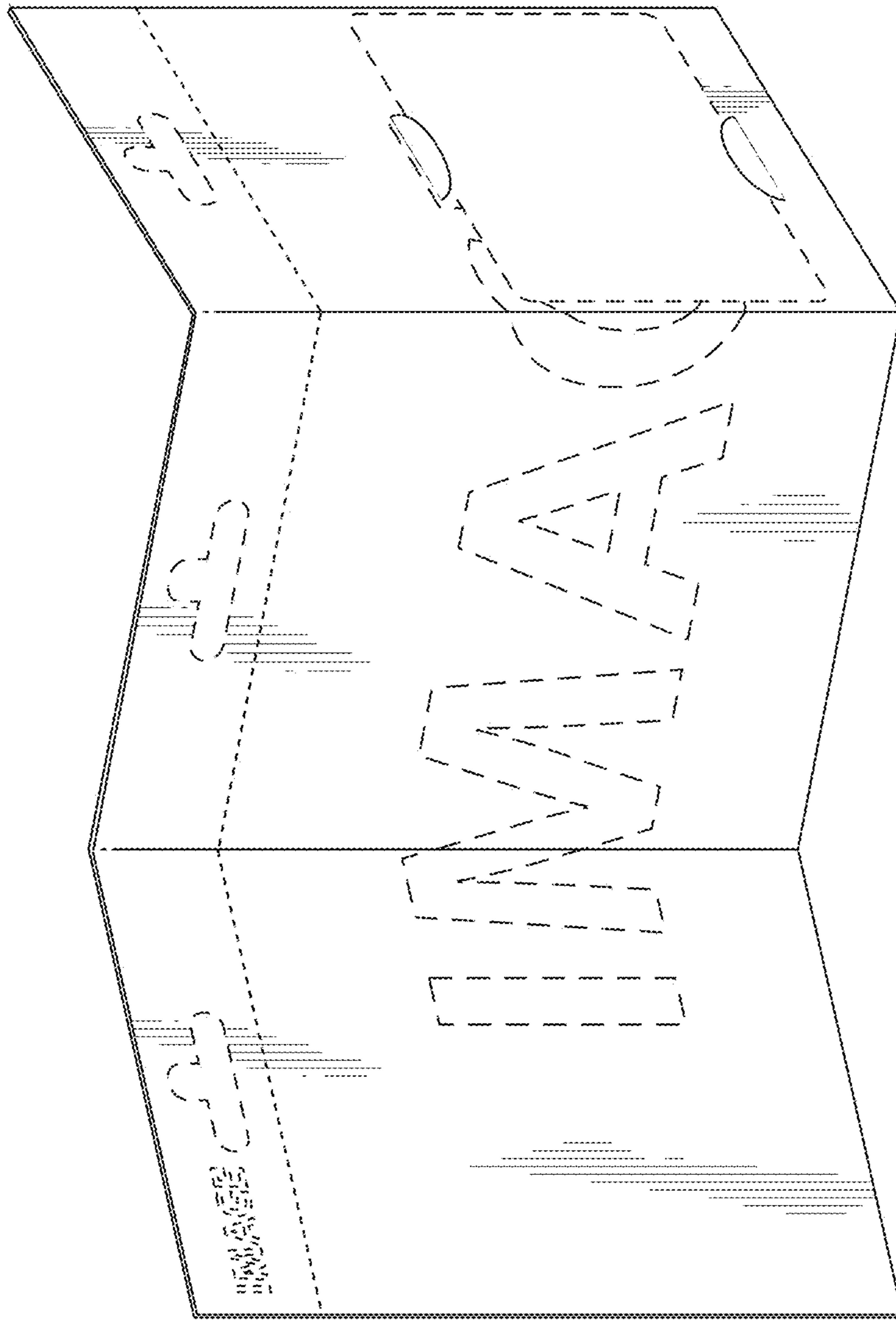
