FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof.

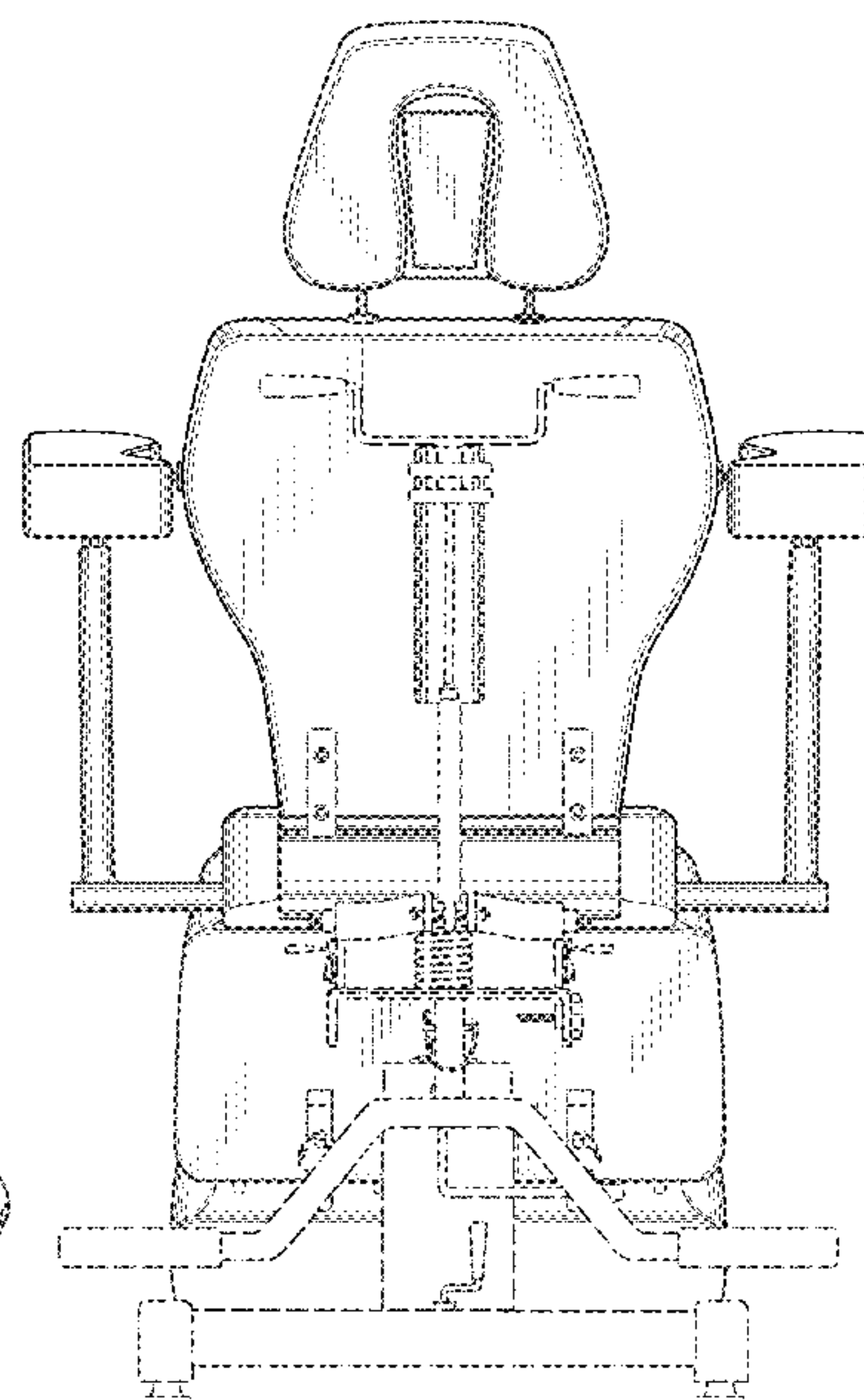
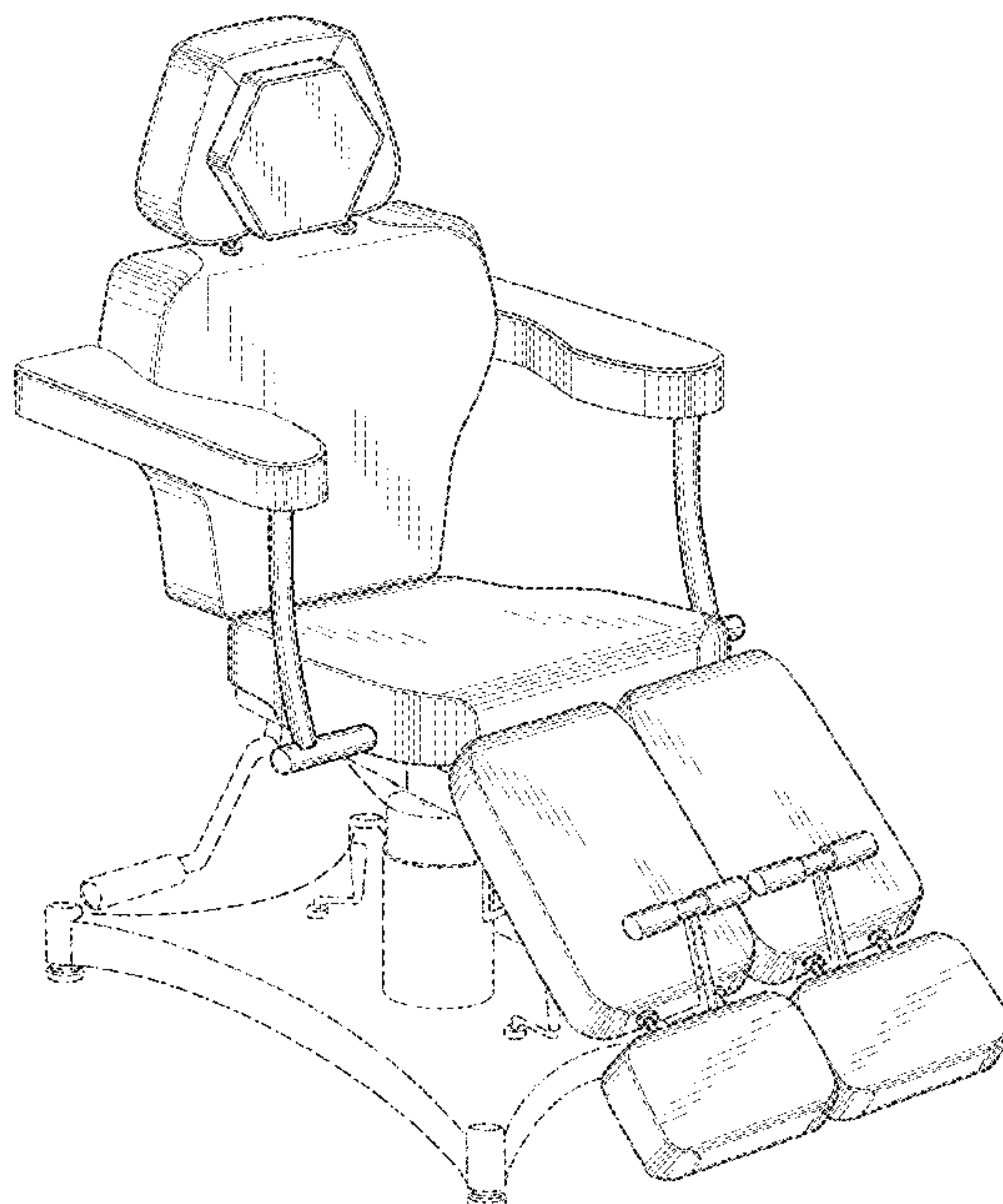
FIG. 4 is a top plan elevational view thereof.

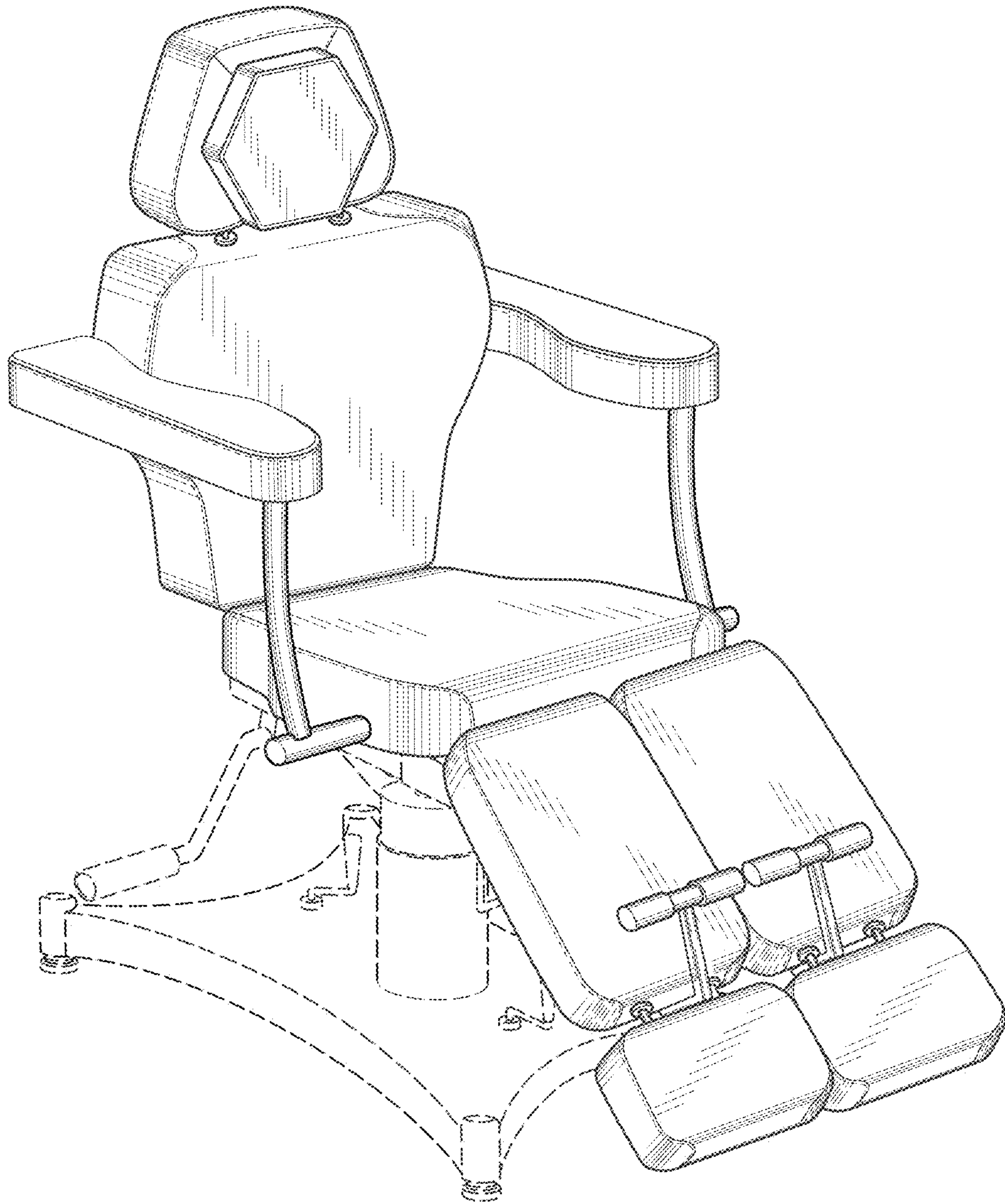

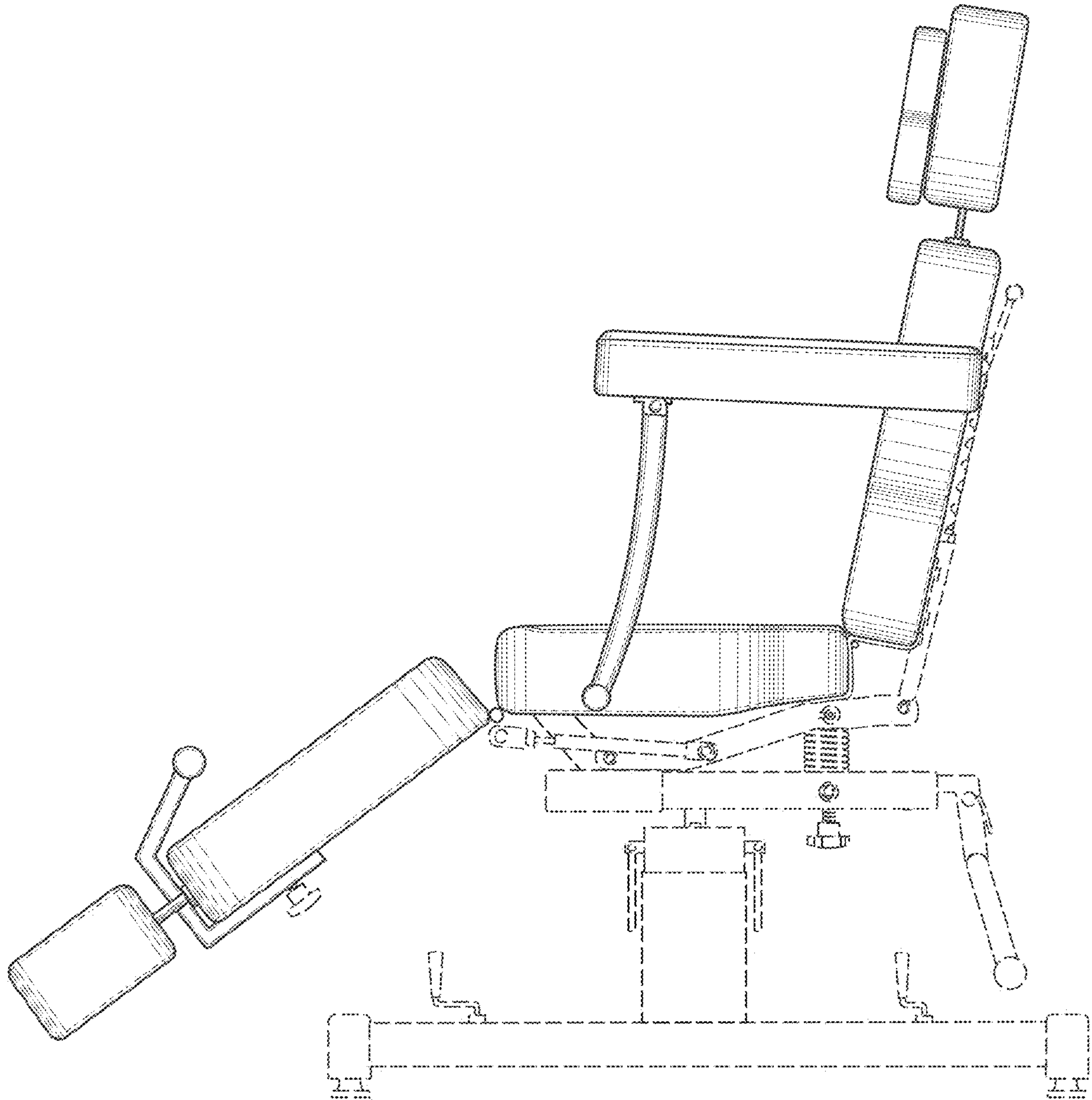

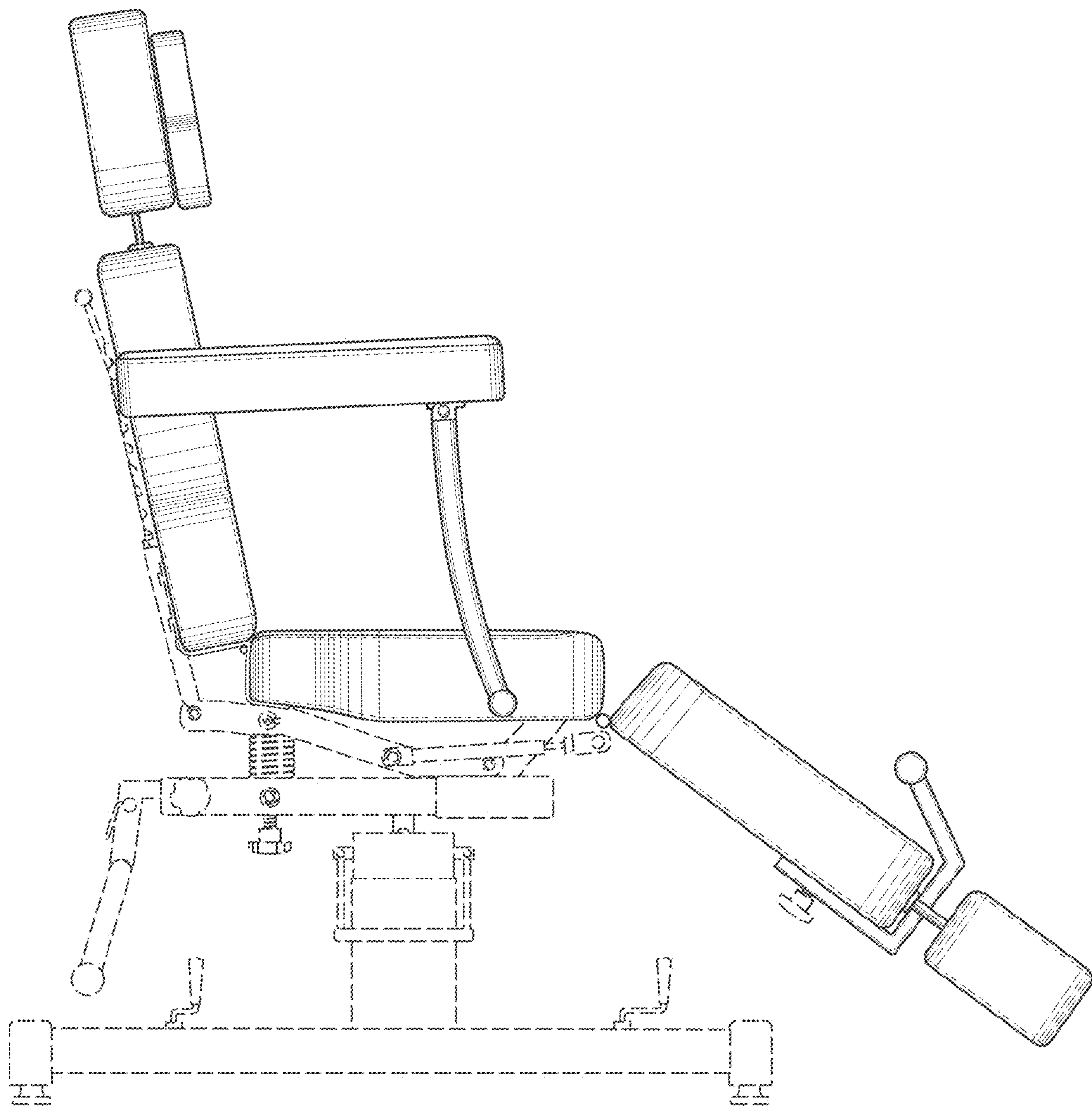

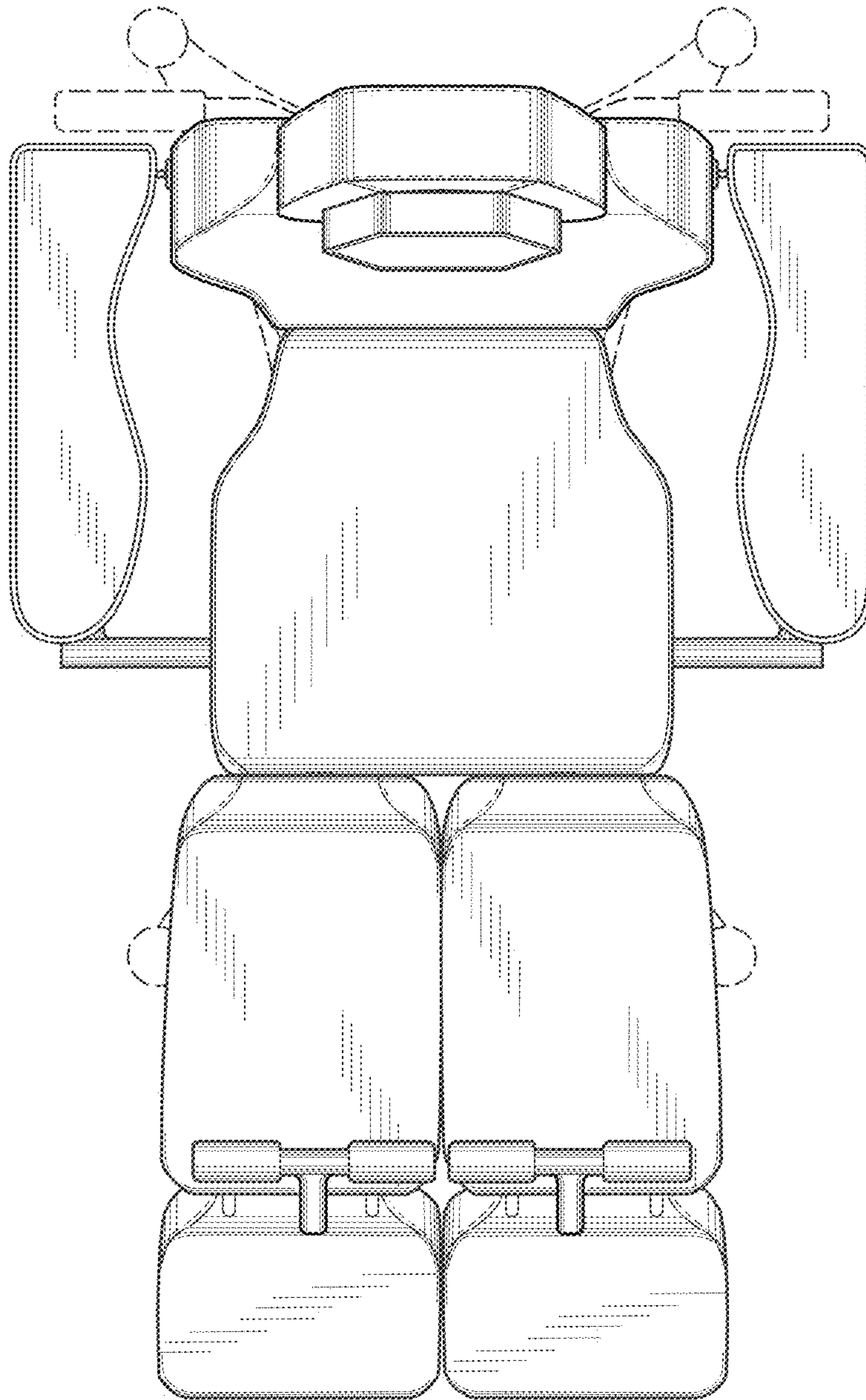

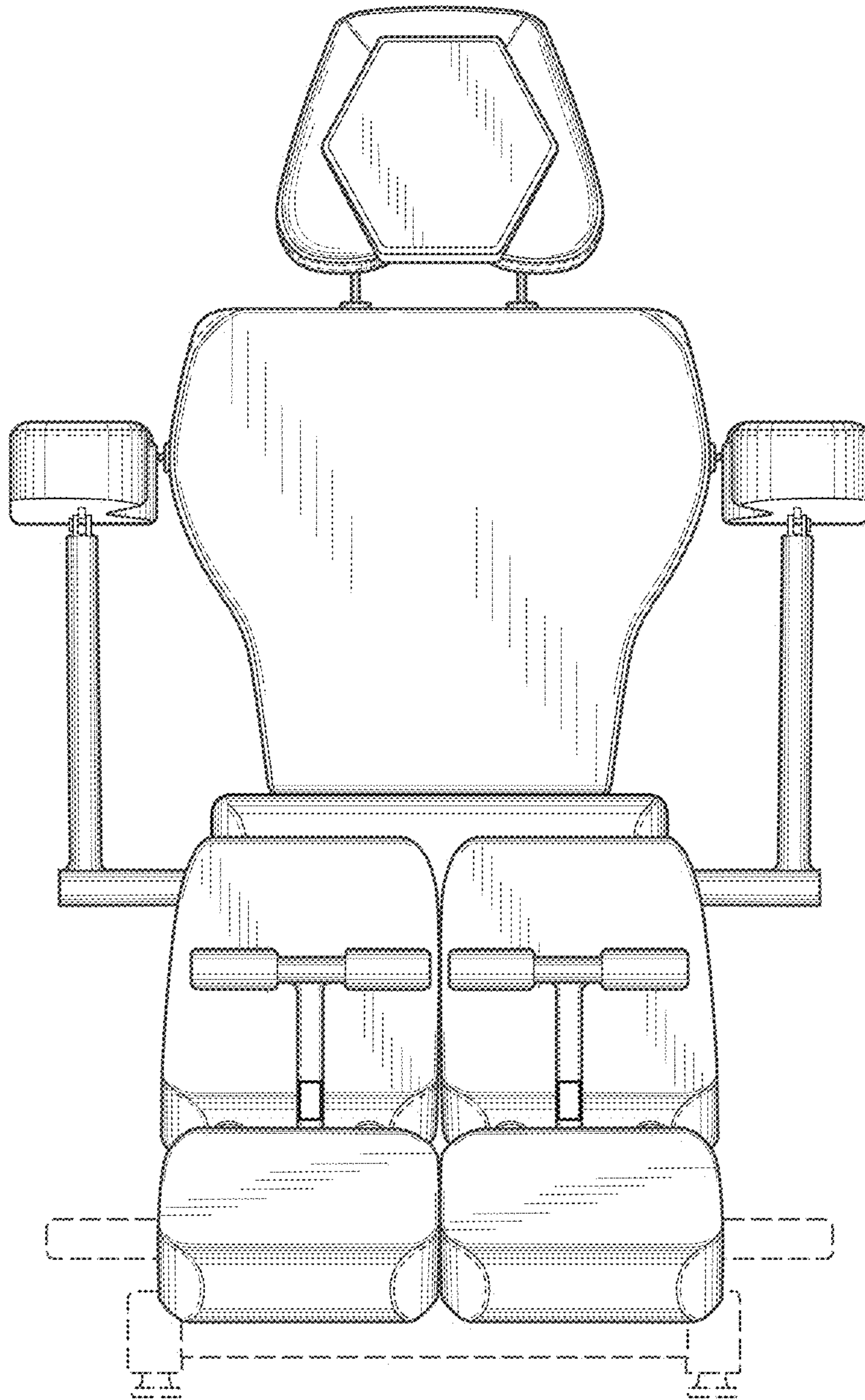

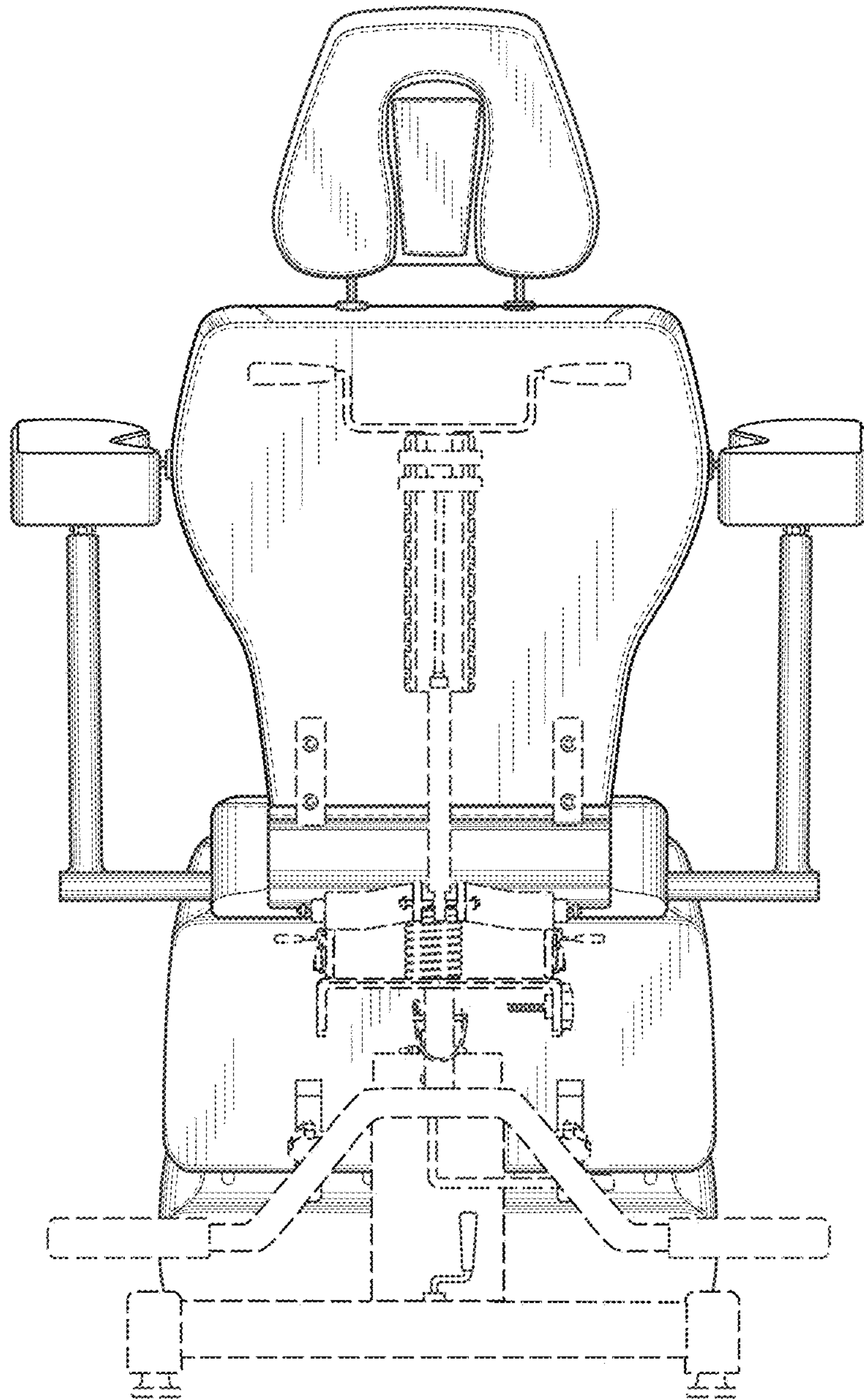
