(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sofa, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a first embodiment of a sofa showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear left perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged detail view taken from the area labelled 7 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged detail view taken from the area labelled 8 in FIG. 5;

FIG. 9 is a front right perspective view of a second embodiment of a sofa showing my new design;

FIG. 10 is a rear left perspective view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view thereof;

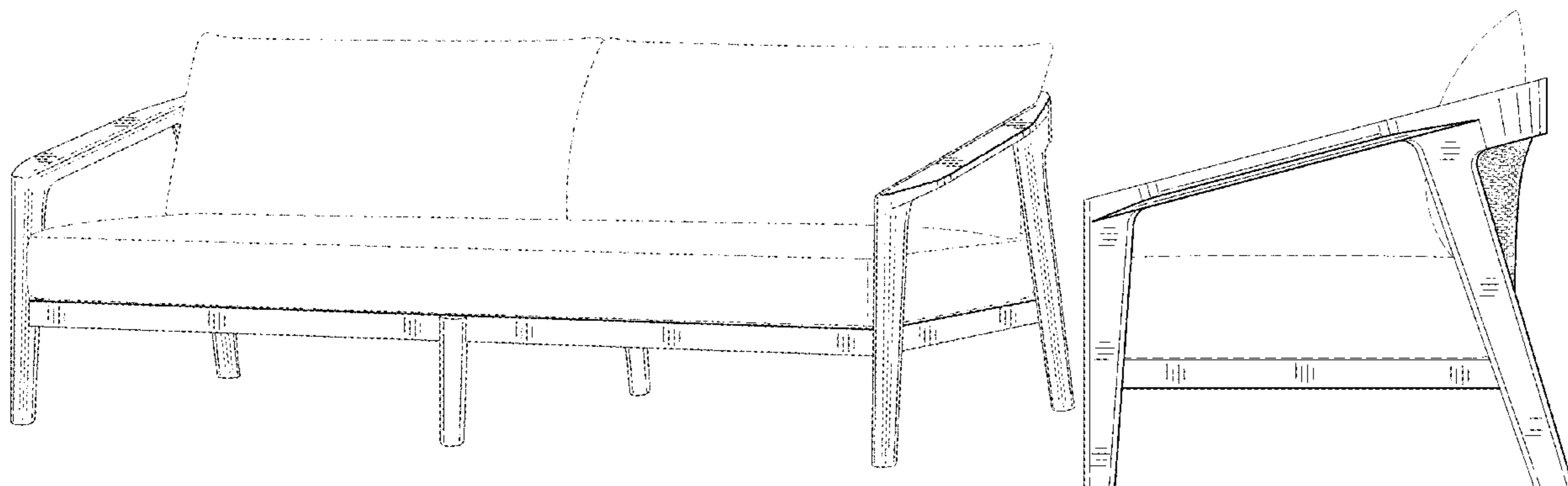
FIG. 14 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 15 is an enlarged detail view taken from the area labelled 15 in FIG. 10; and,

FIG. 16 is an enlarged detail view taken from the area labelled 16 in FIG. 13.

The fragmentary showing of a weave pattern in FIGS. 2, 4, 5, 10, 12, and 13, and shown in detail in FIGS. 7, 8, 15, and 16, is understood to be repeated throughout the surfaces shown. The broken lines show environmental subject matter and form no part of the claimed design. The second embodiment is shown with symbolic breaks in FIGS. 9, 10, 11, 13, and 14, and those portions of the article between the break lines form no part of the claimed design.

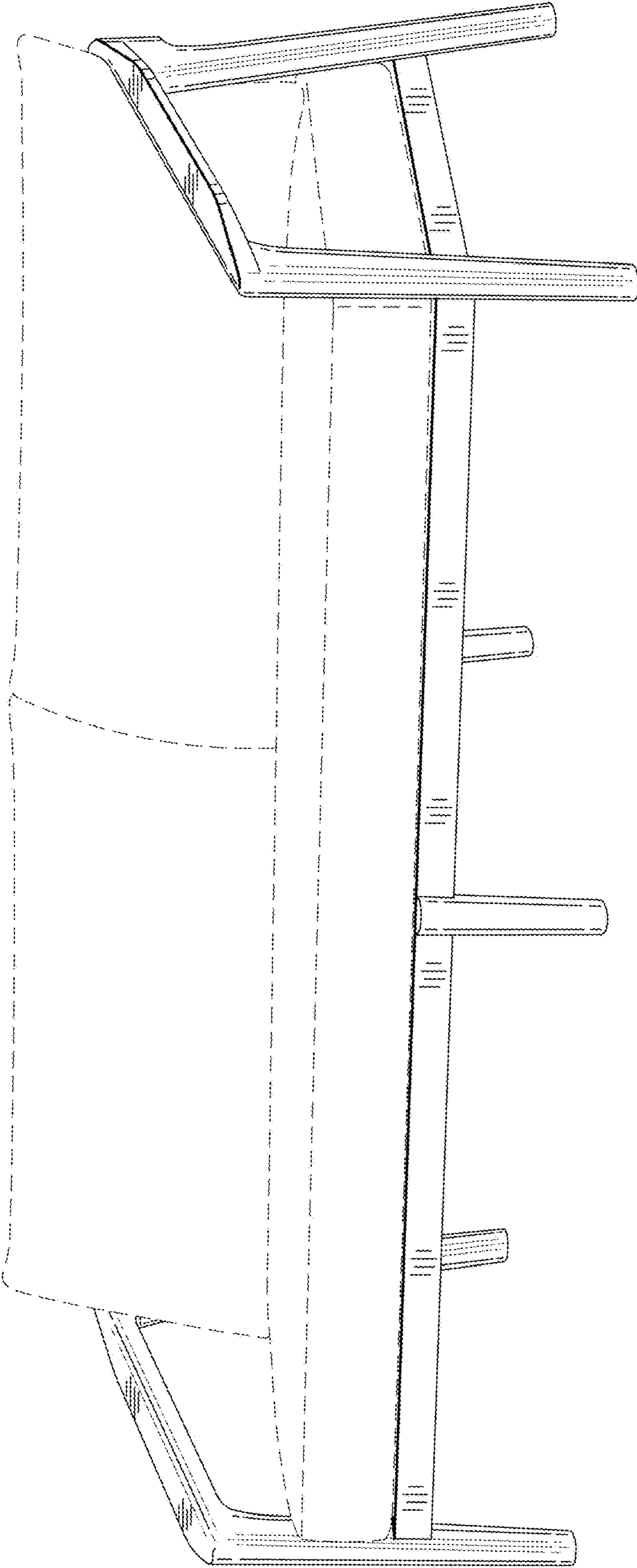

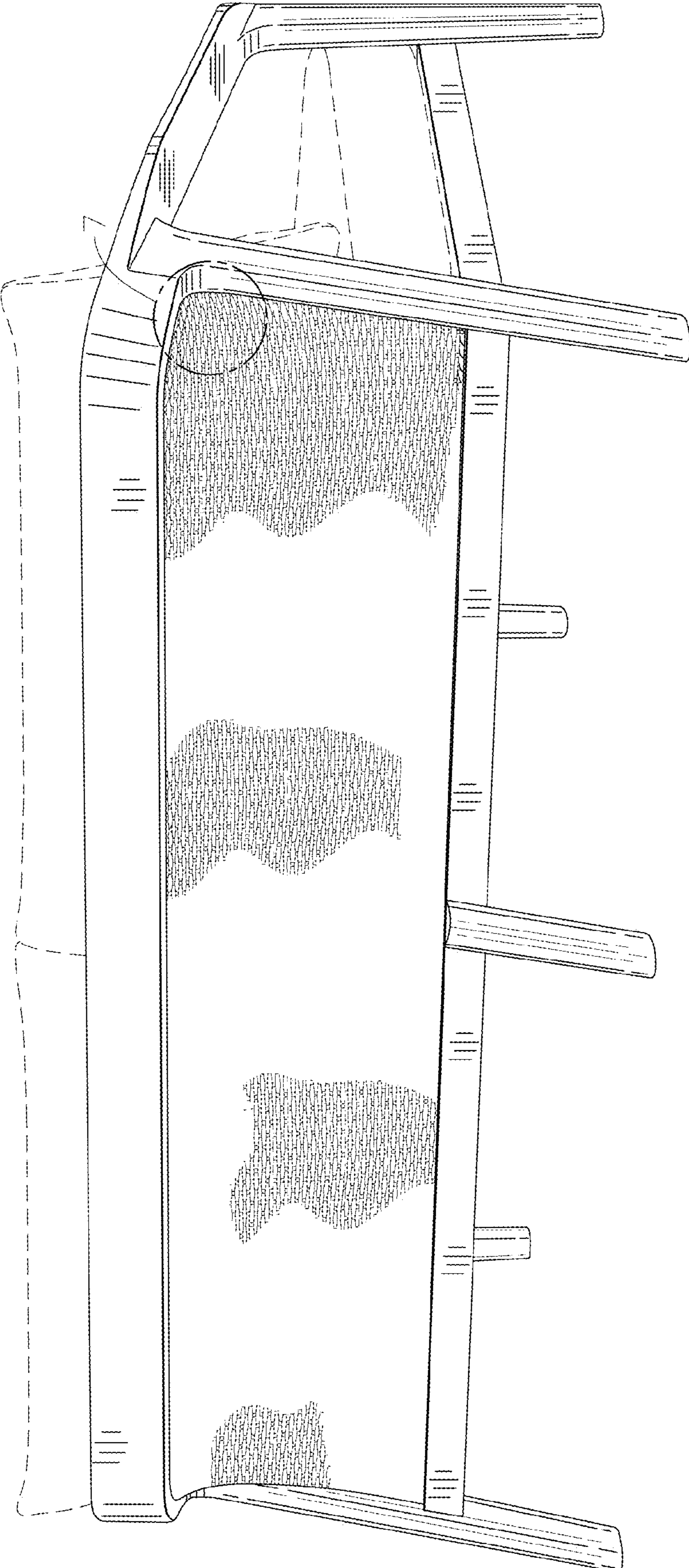

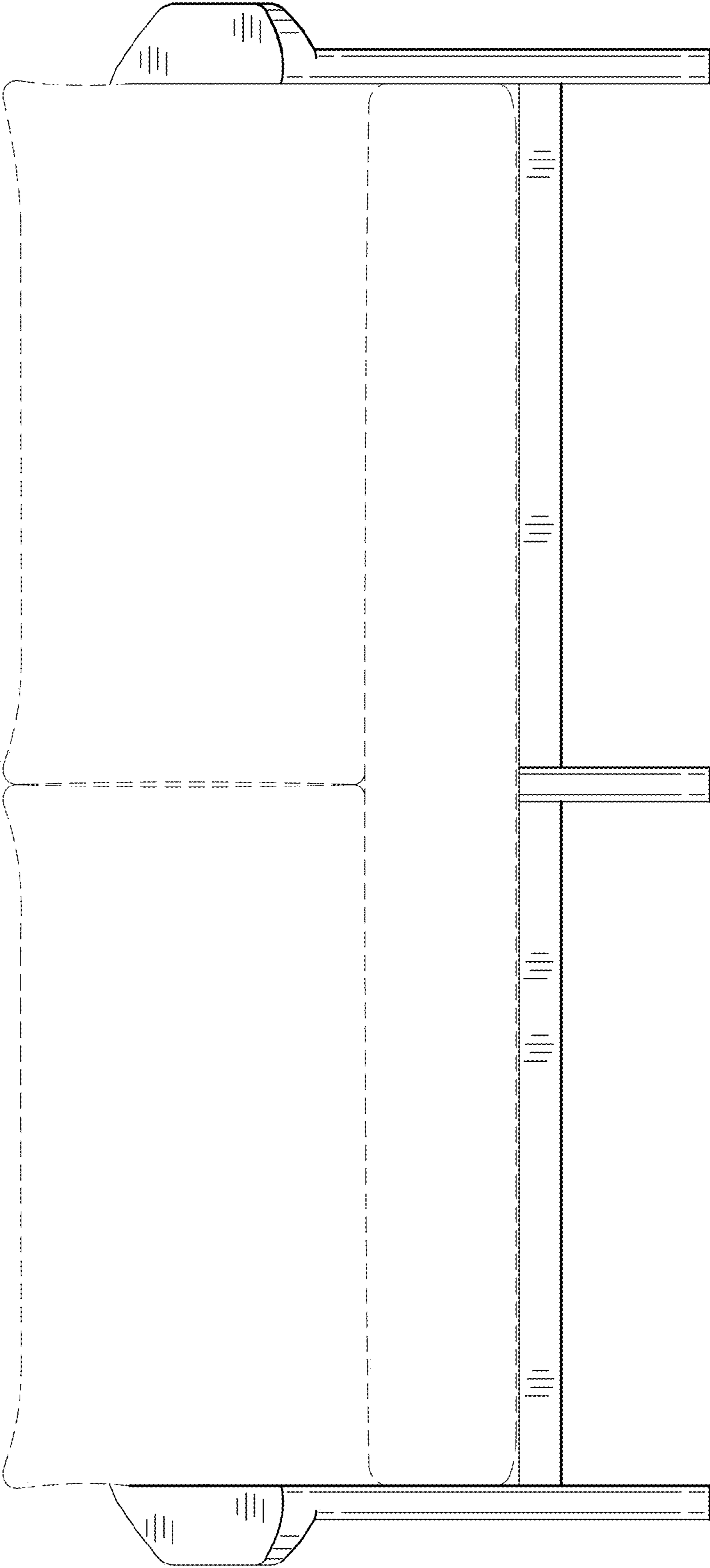

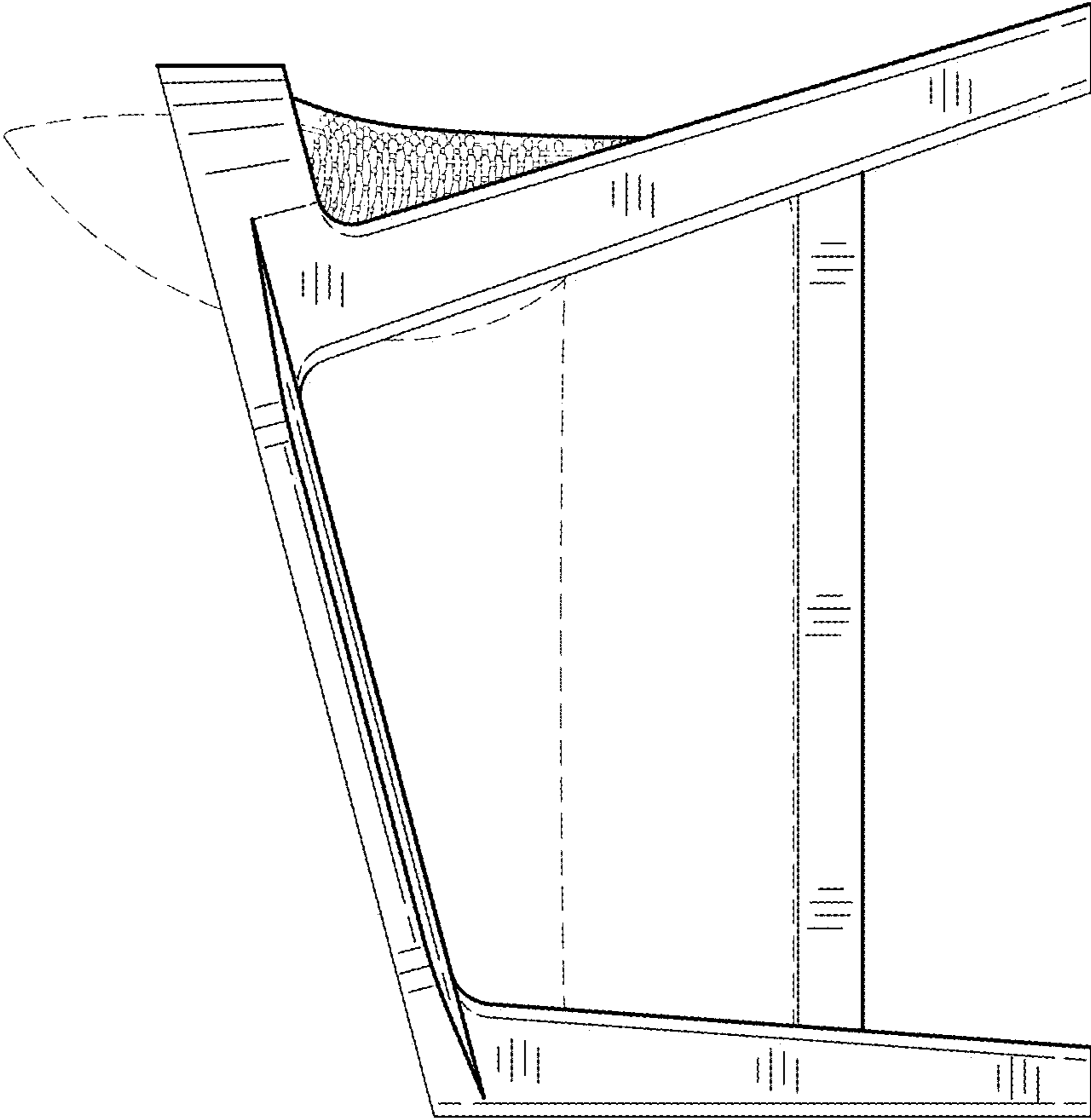

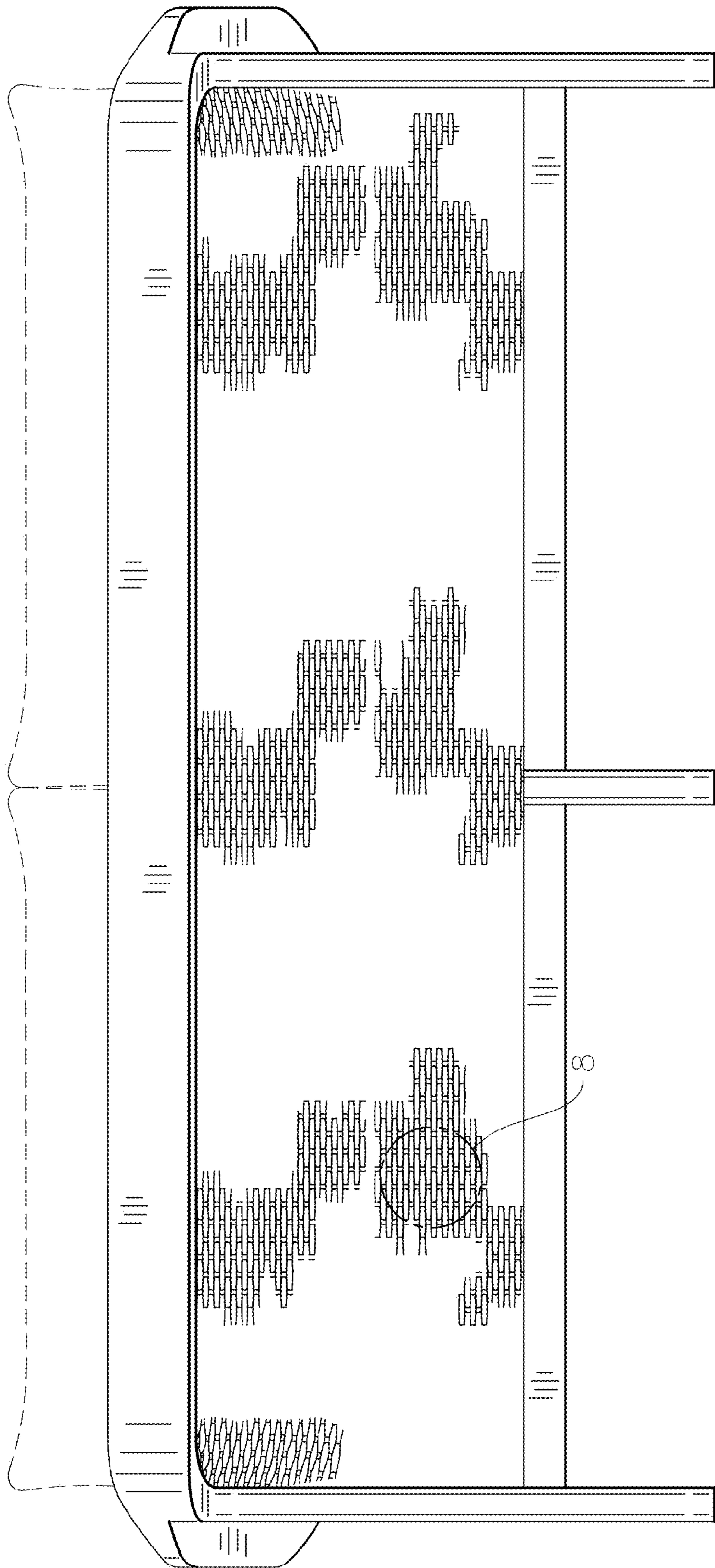

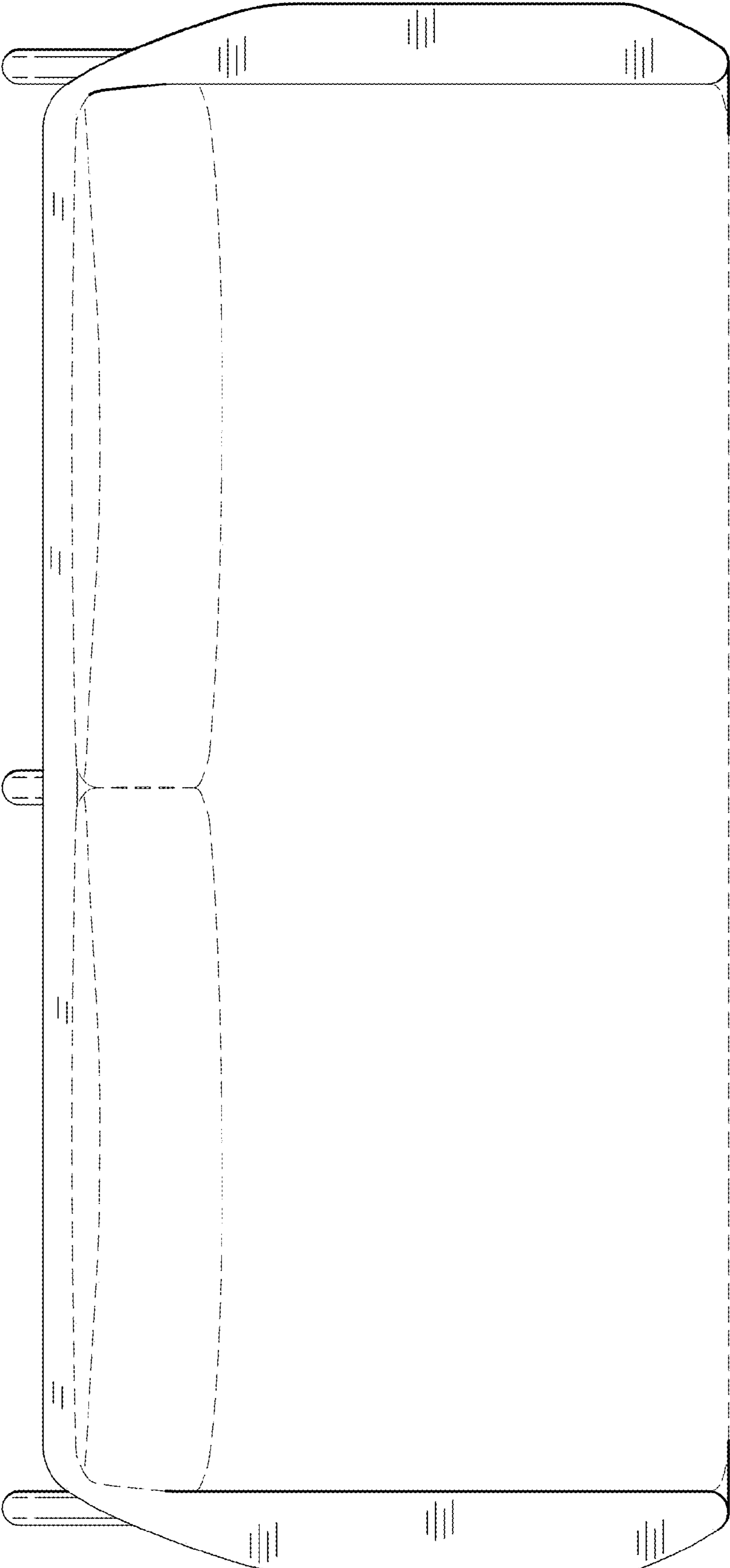

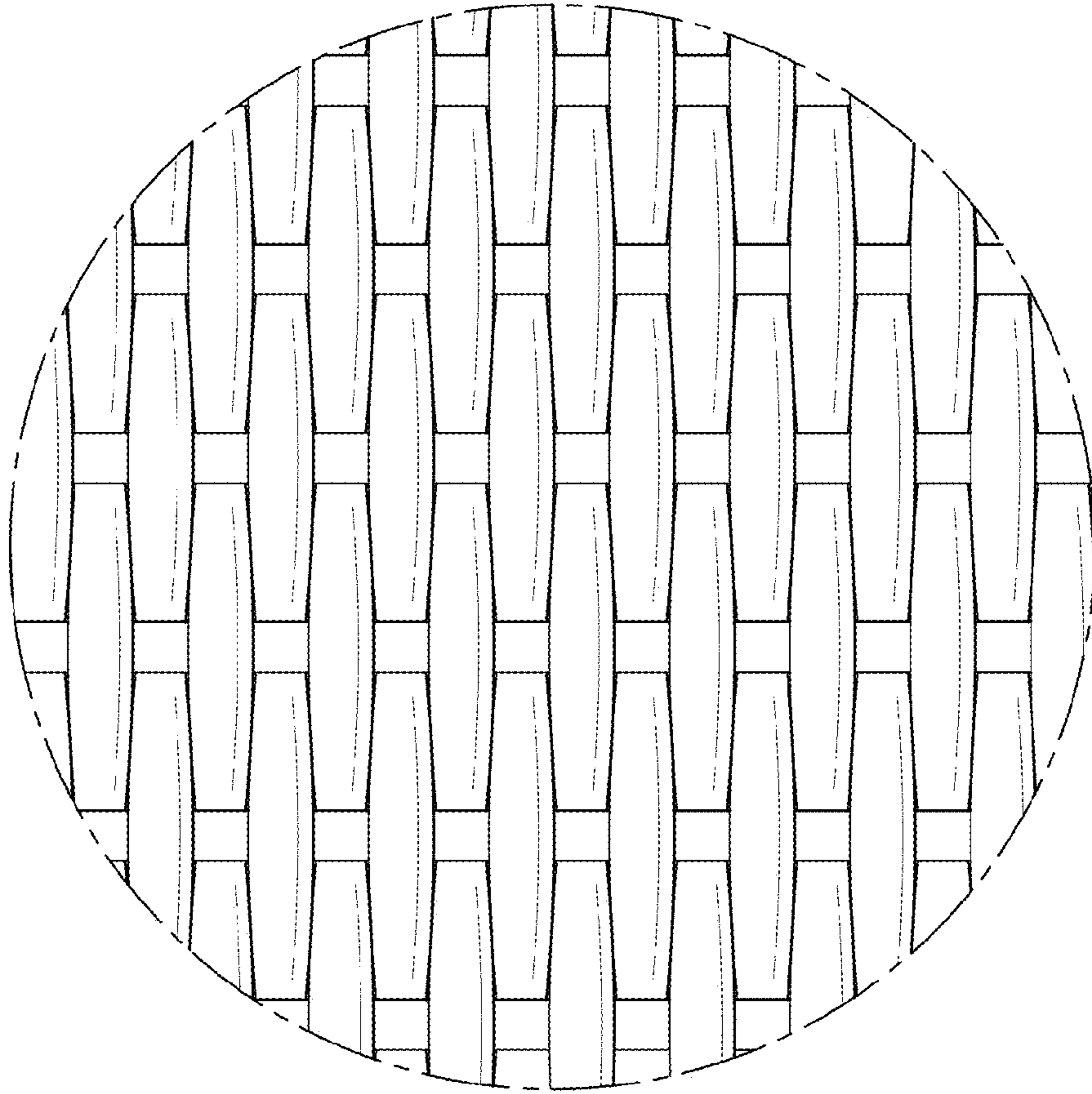

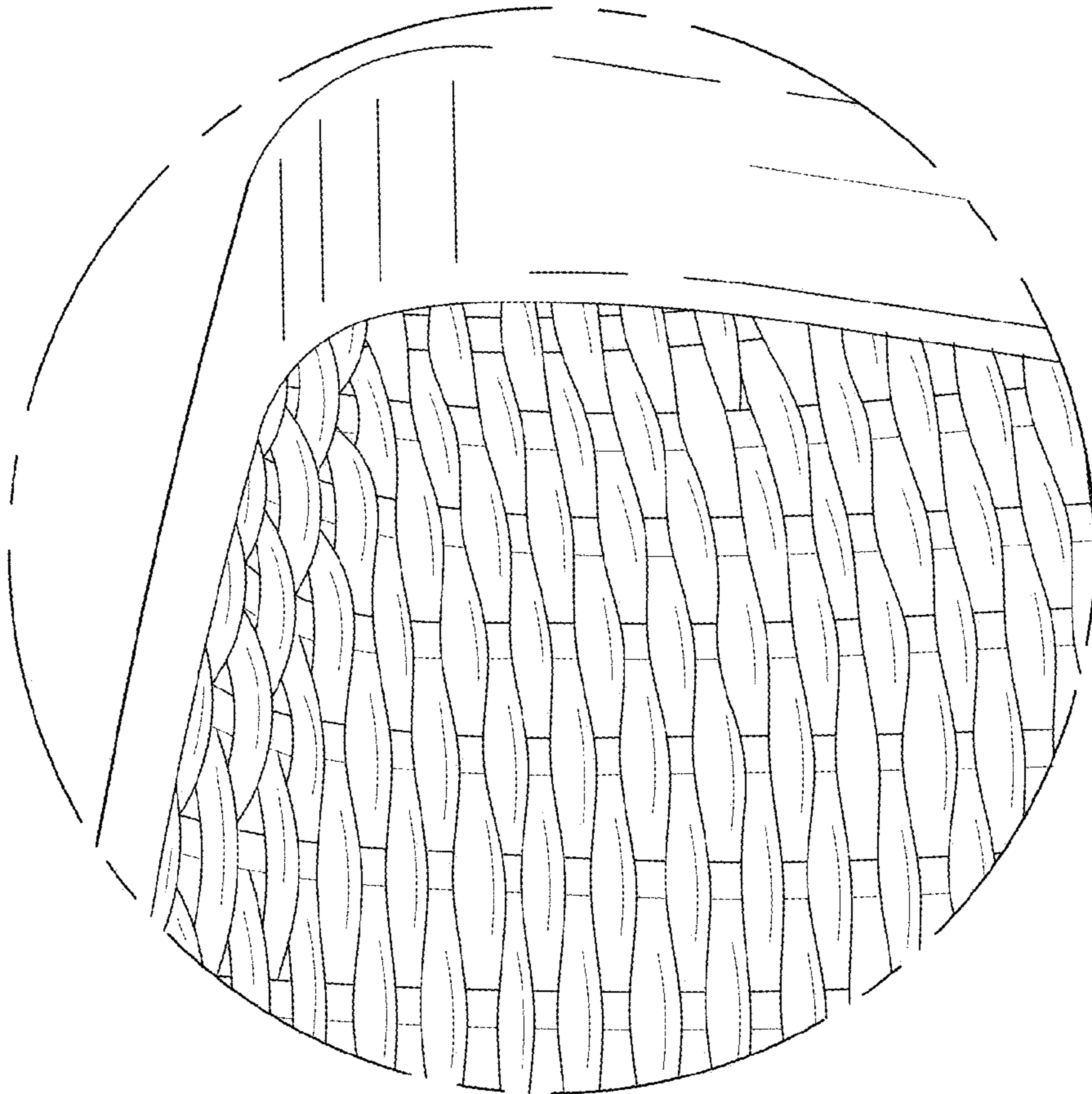

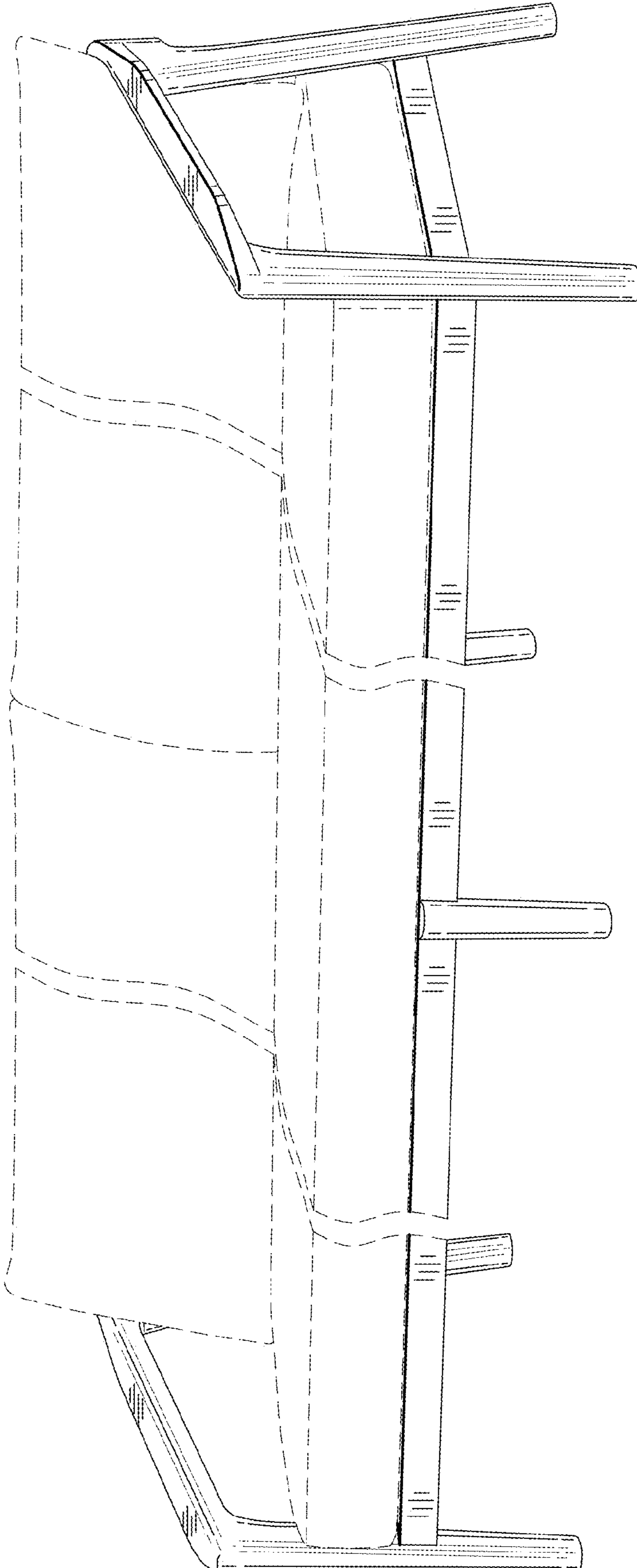

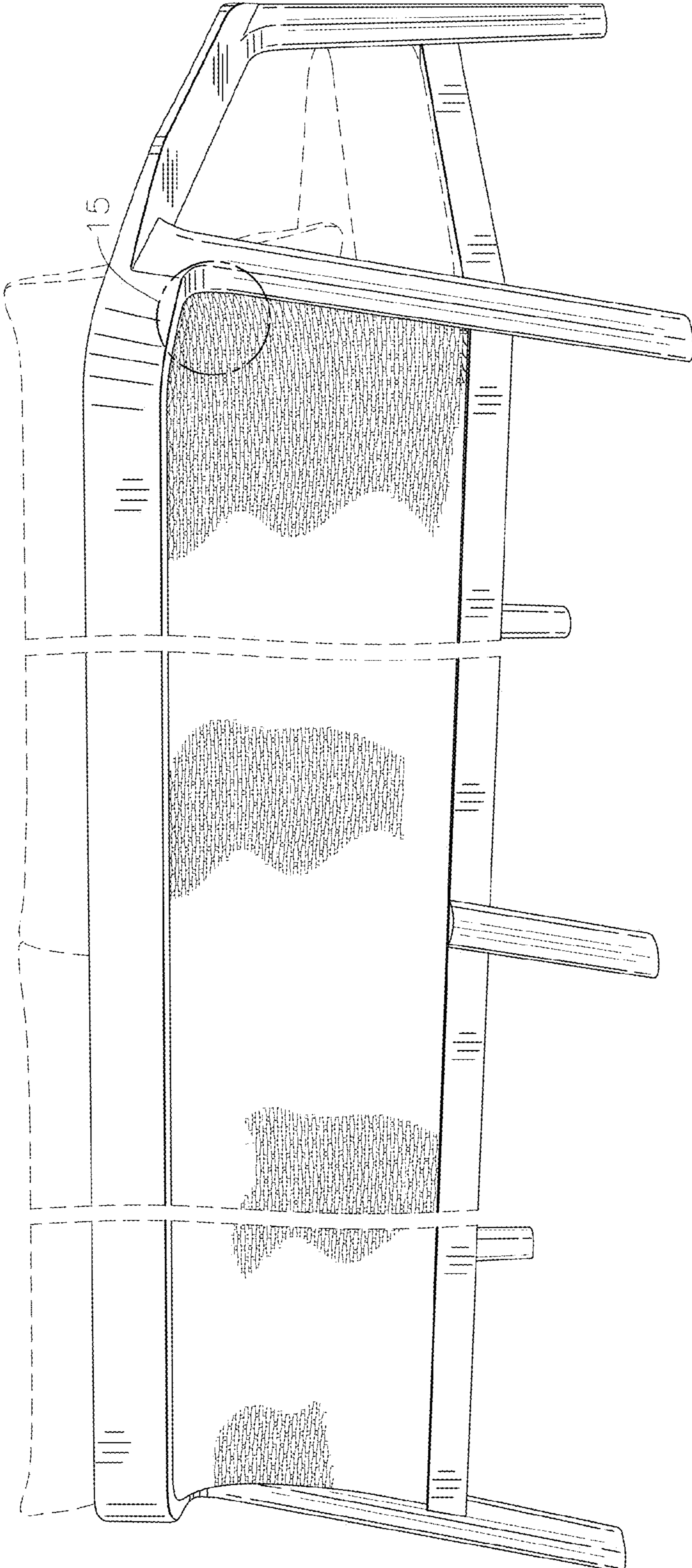

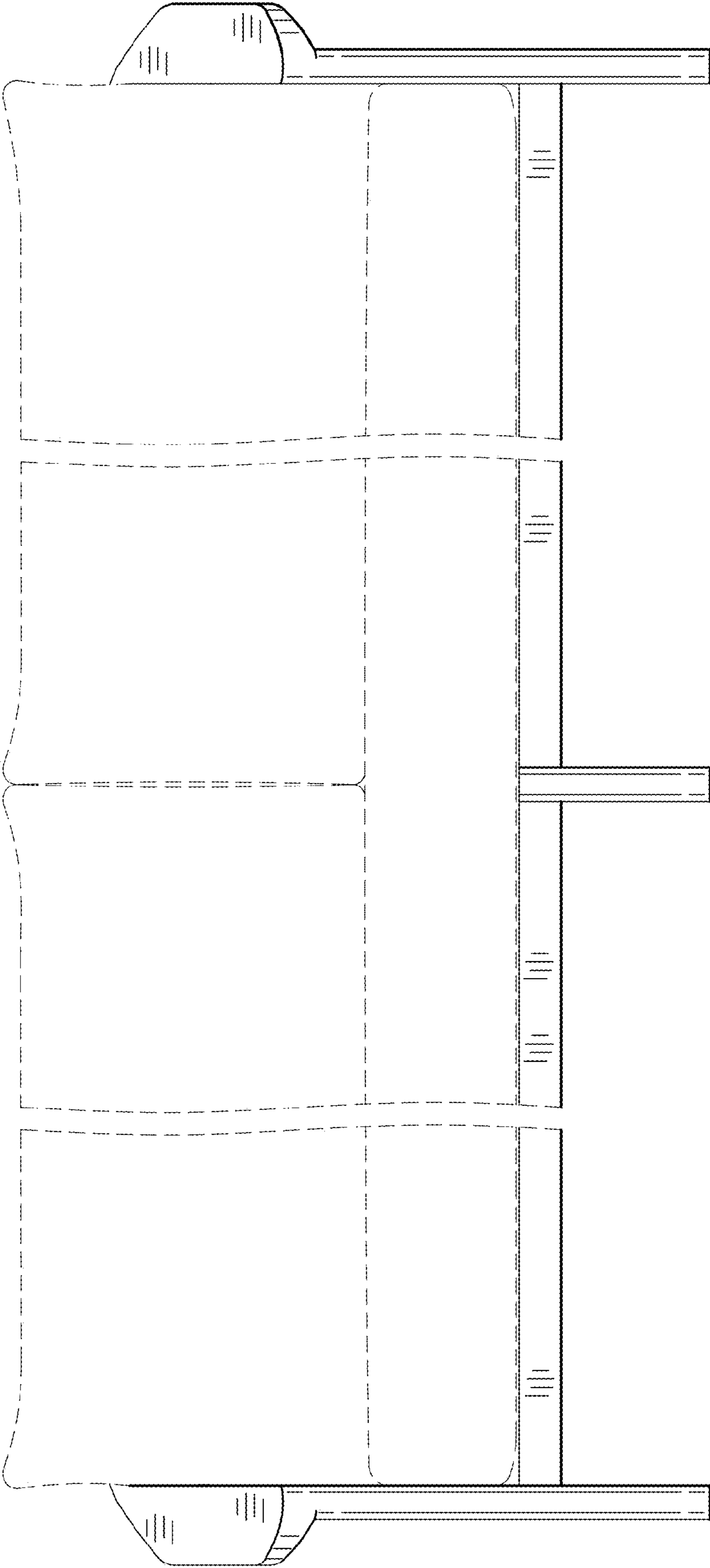

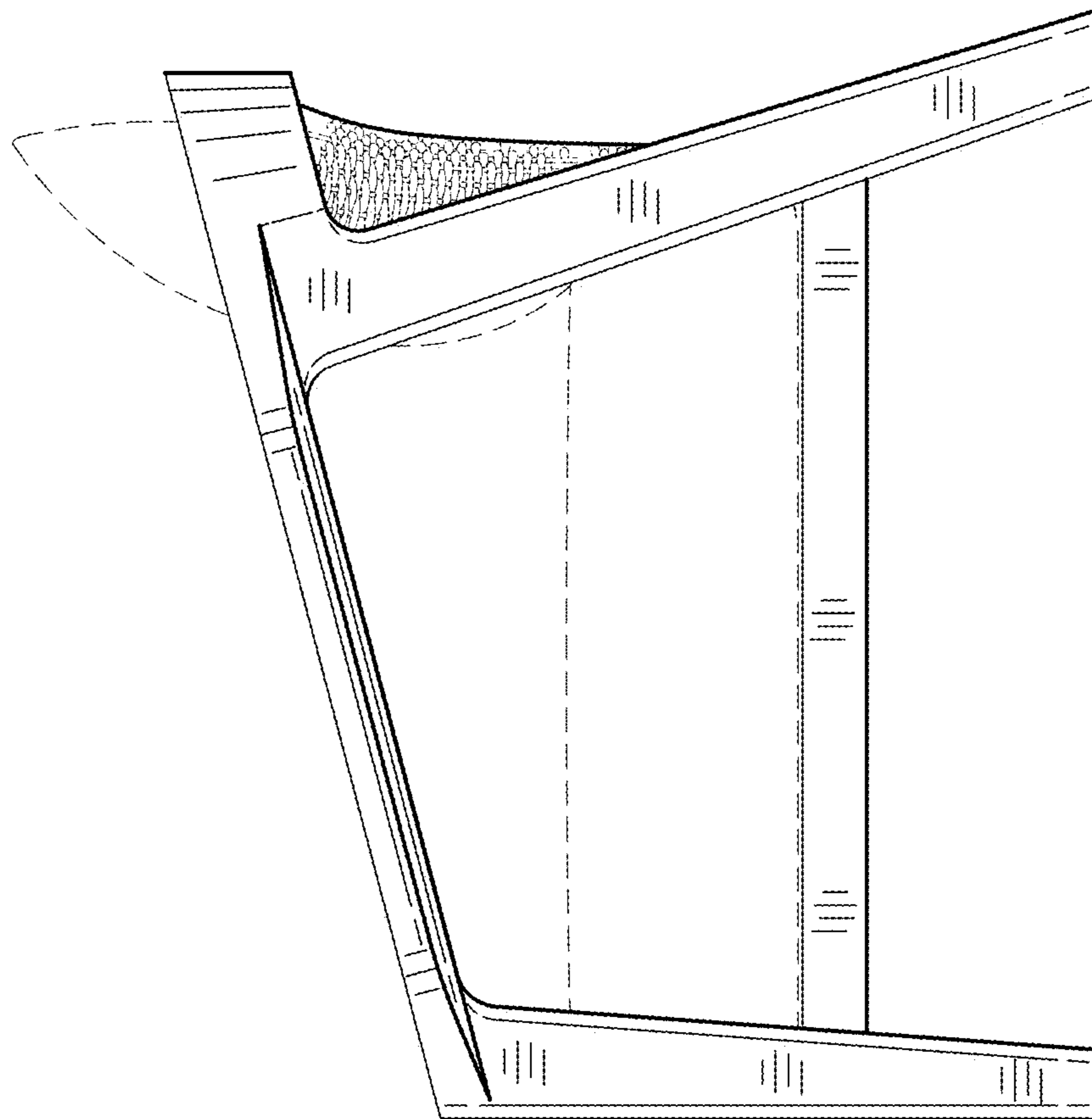

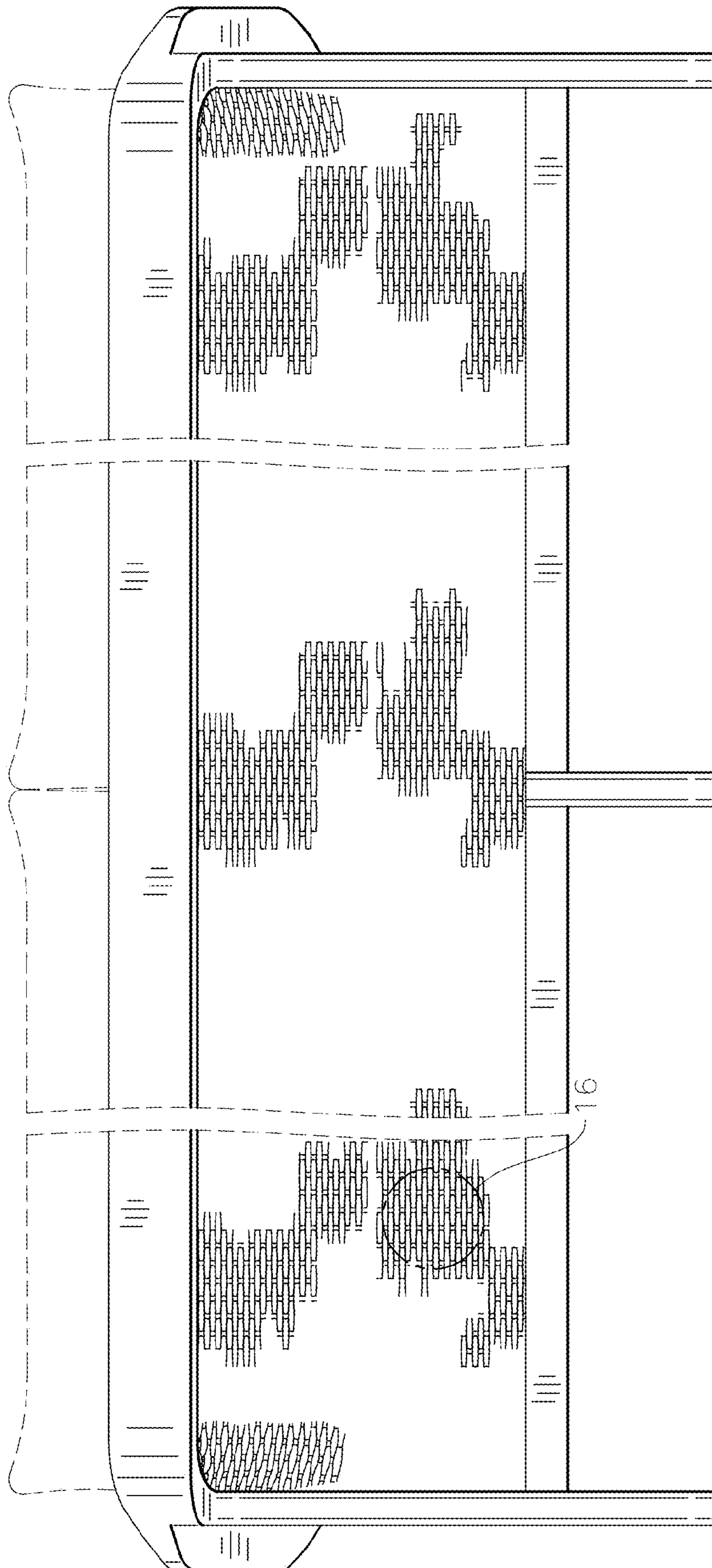

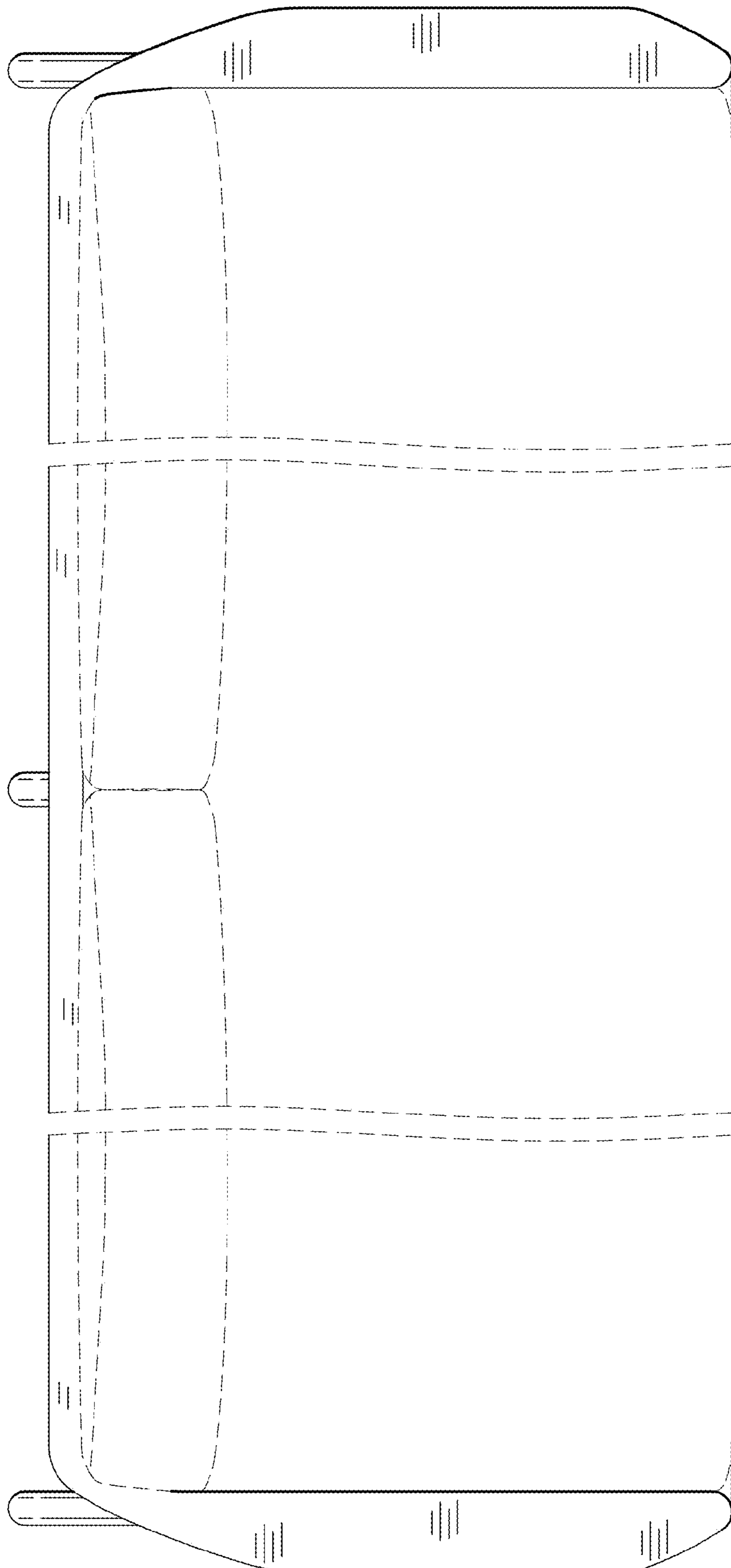

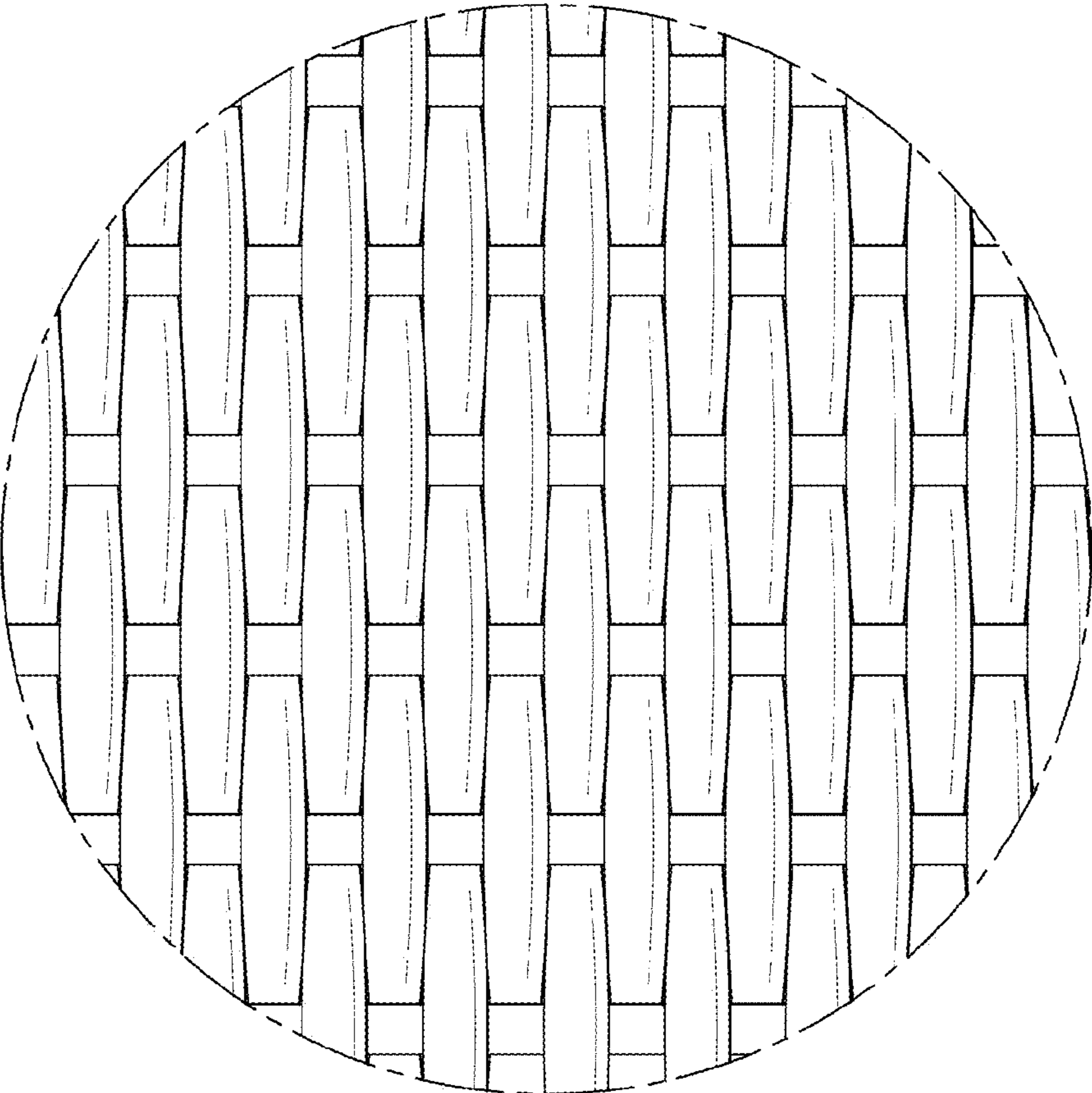
