(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a router, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right-side perspective view of a router showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear, top and left-side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged view of the area 9 indicated by the dot-dash broken lines in FIG. 1;

FIG. 16 is an enlarged view of the area 16 indicated in FIG. 12;

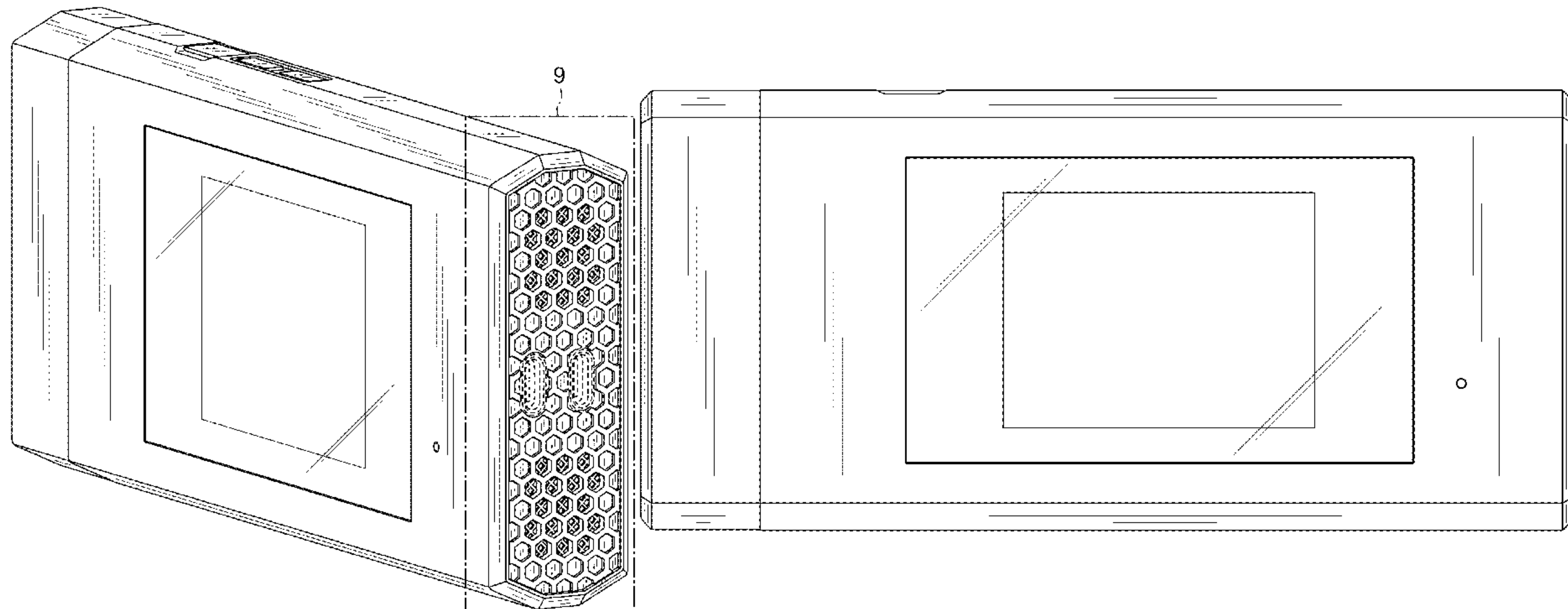
FIG. 17 is an enlarged view of the area 17 indicated in FIG. 12;

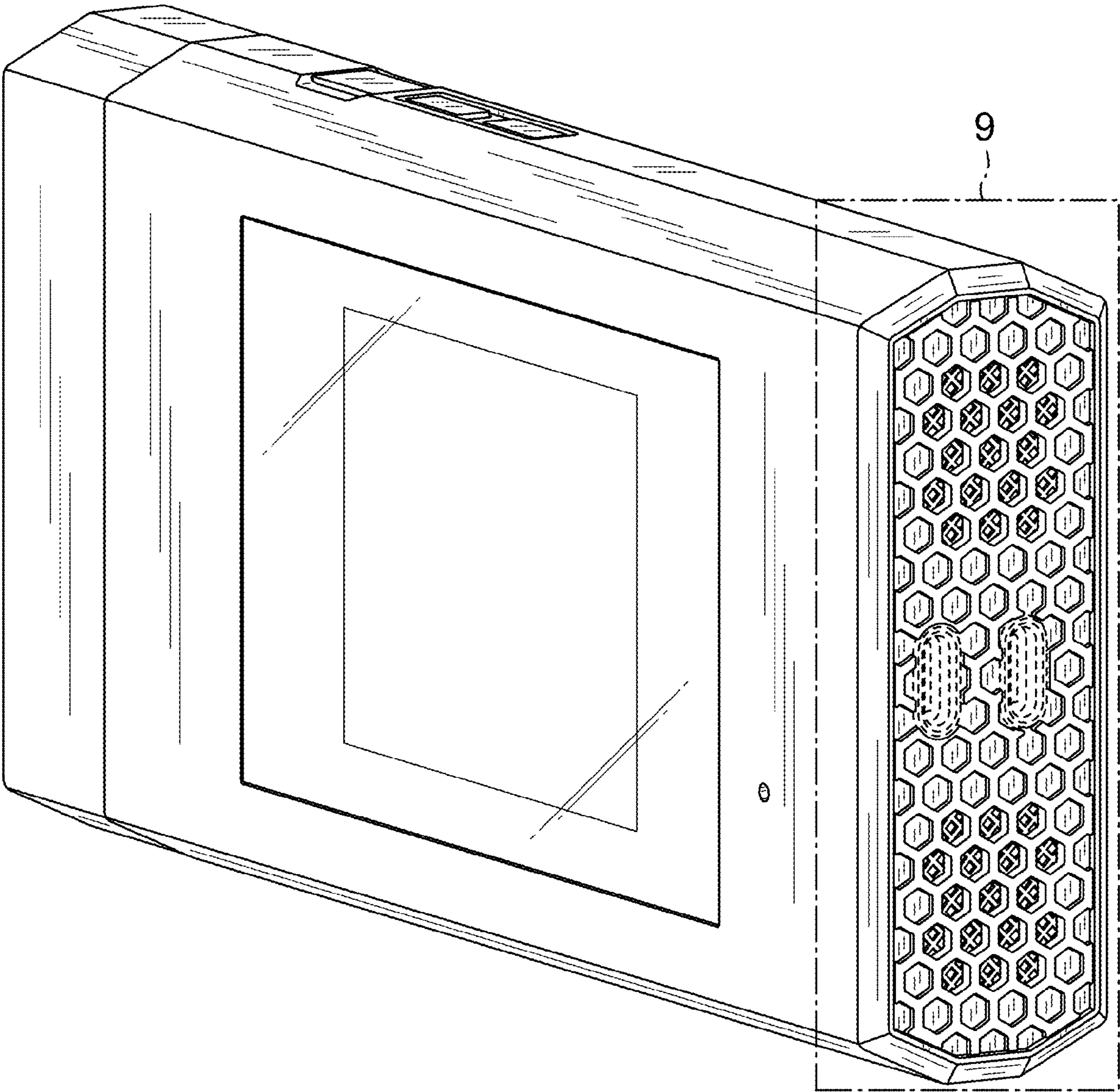

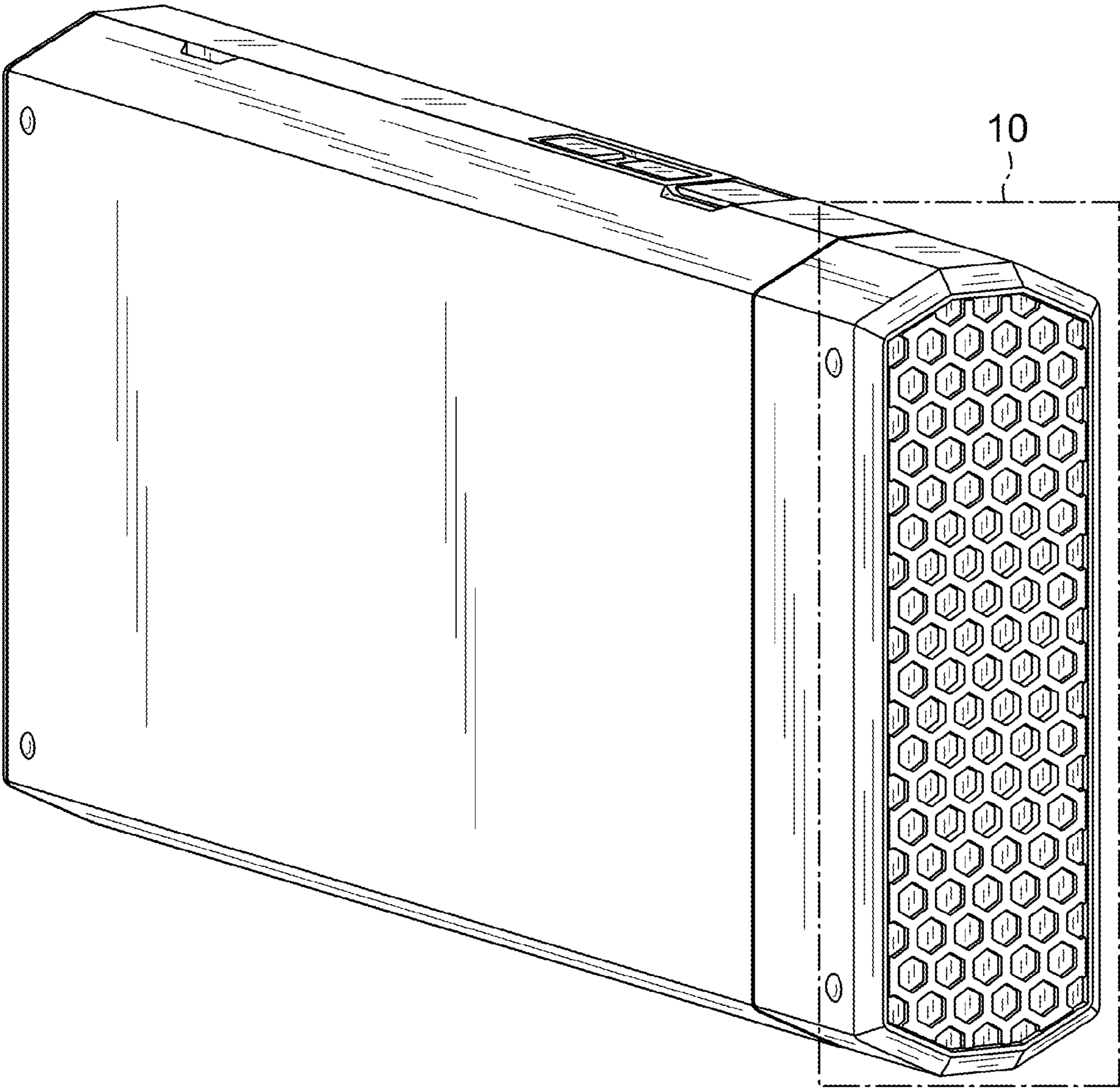

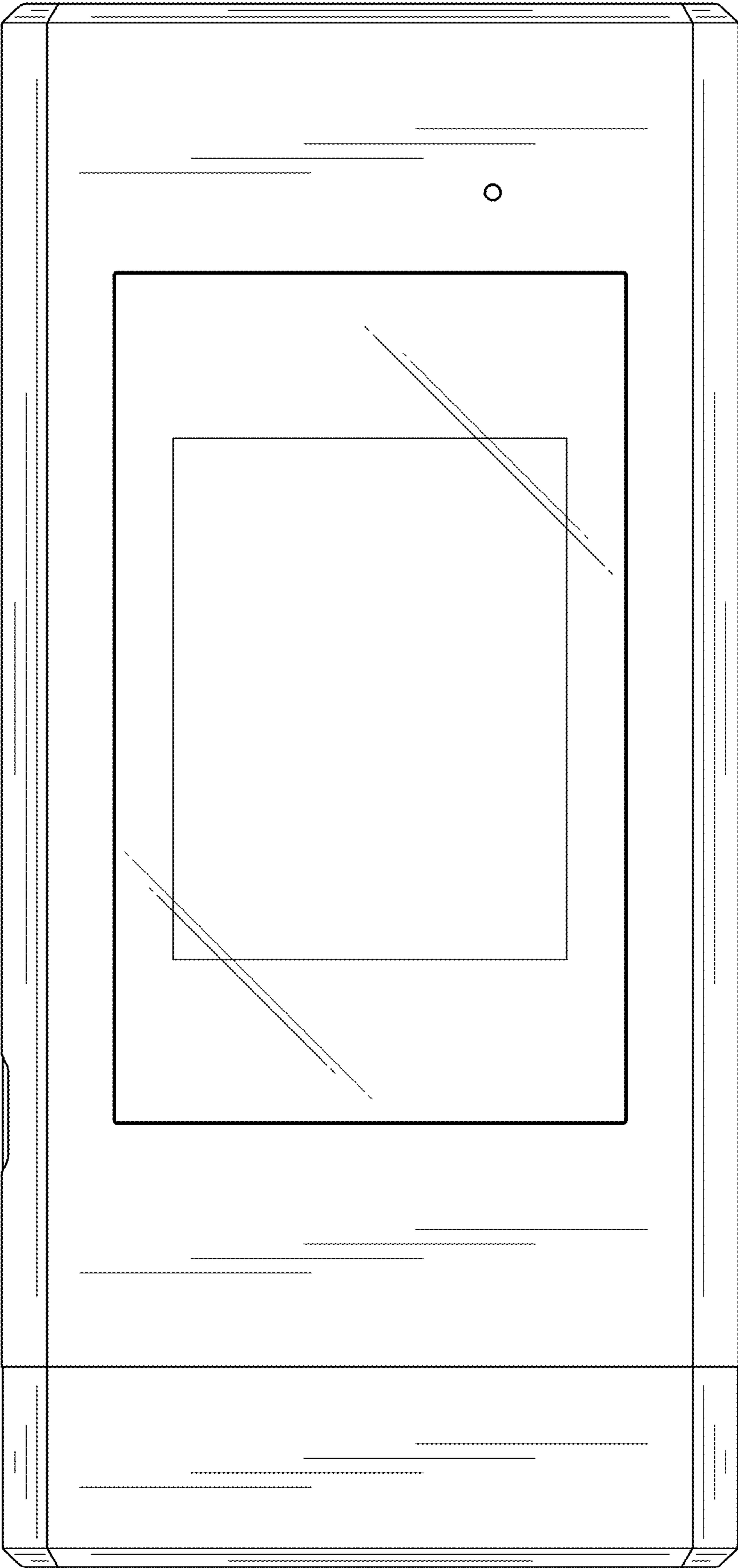

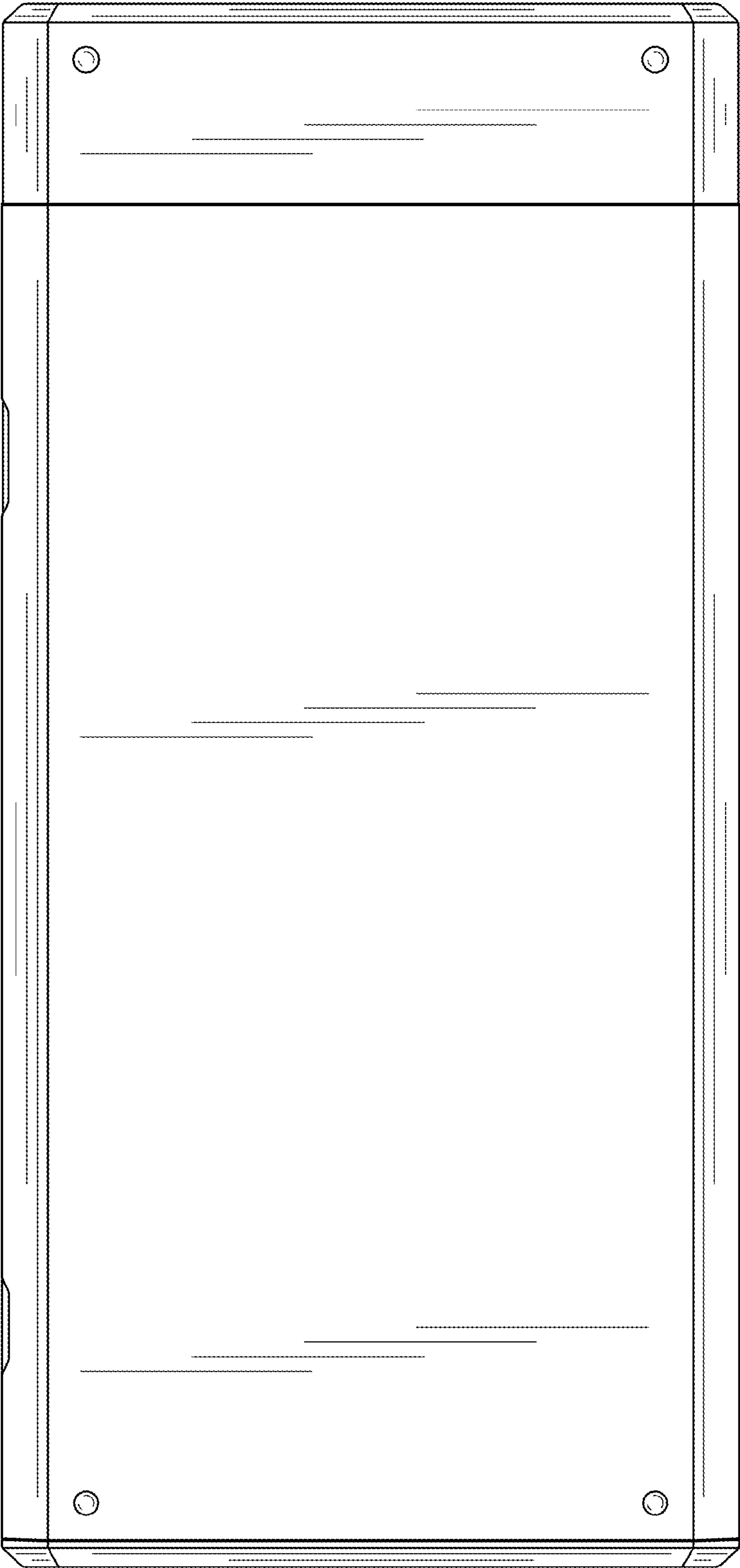

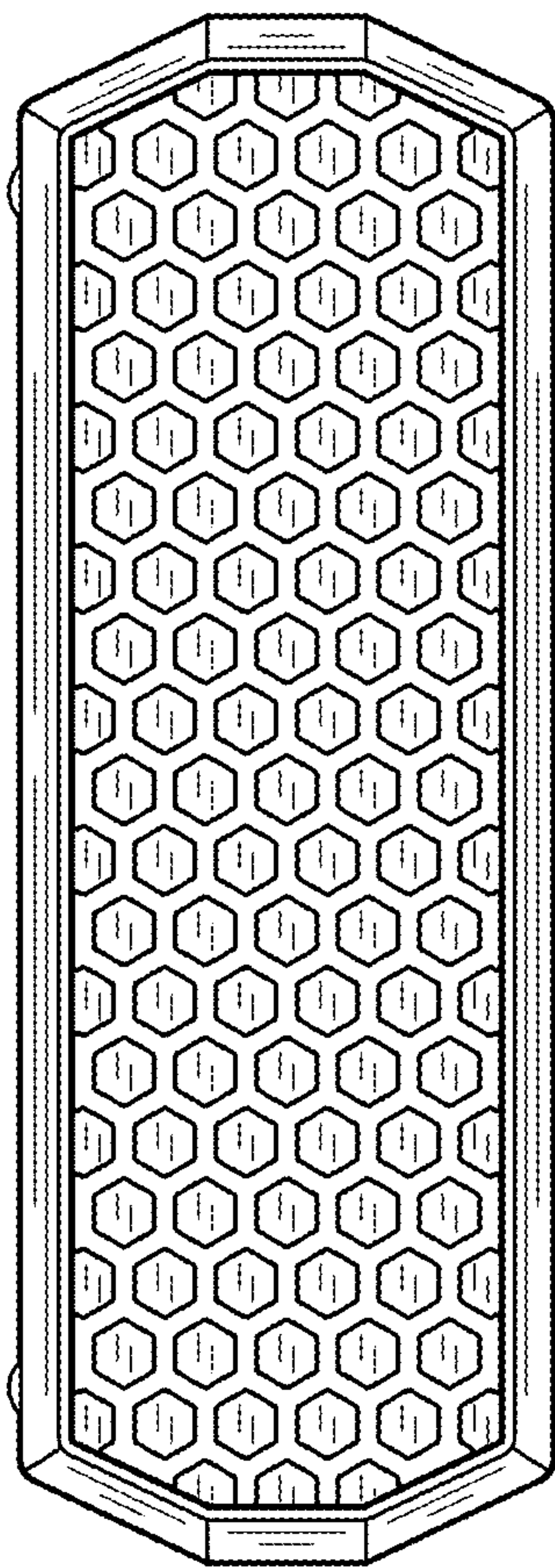

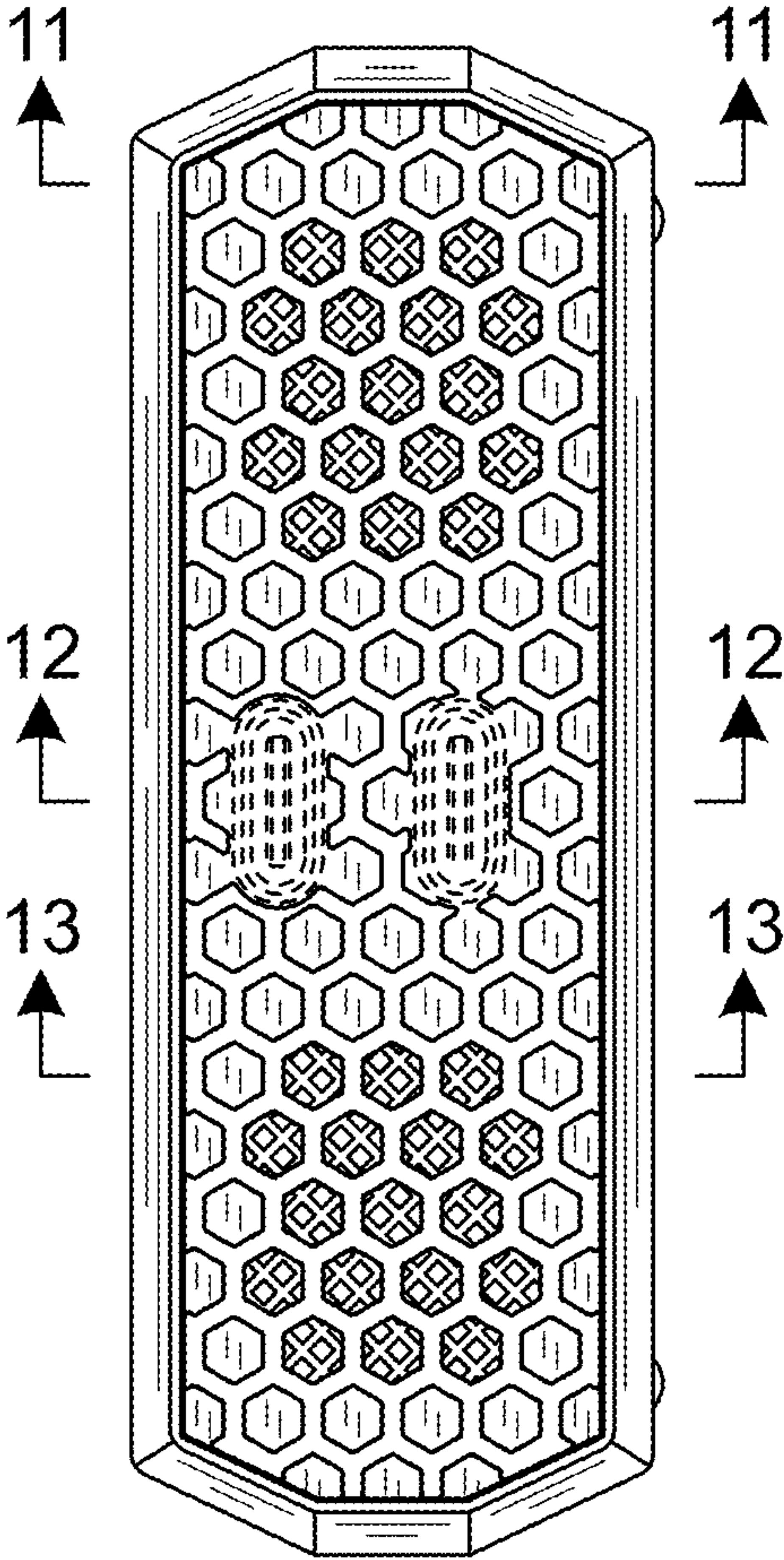

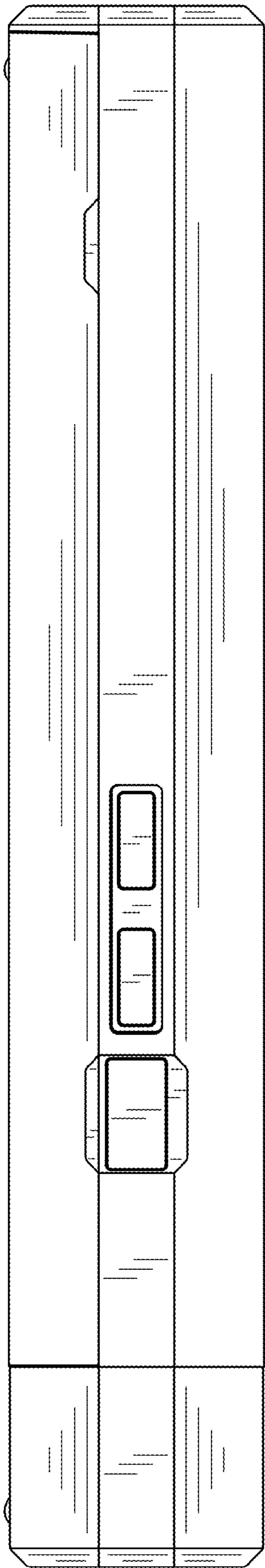

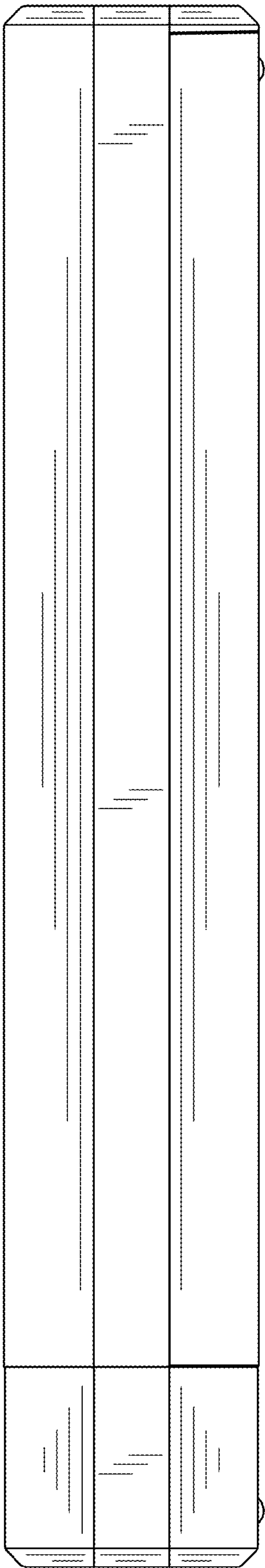

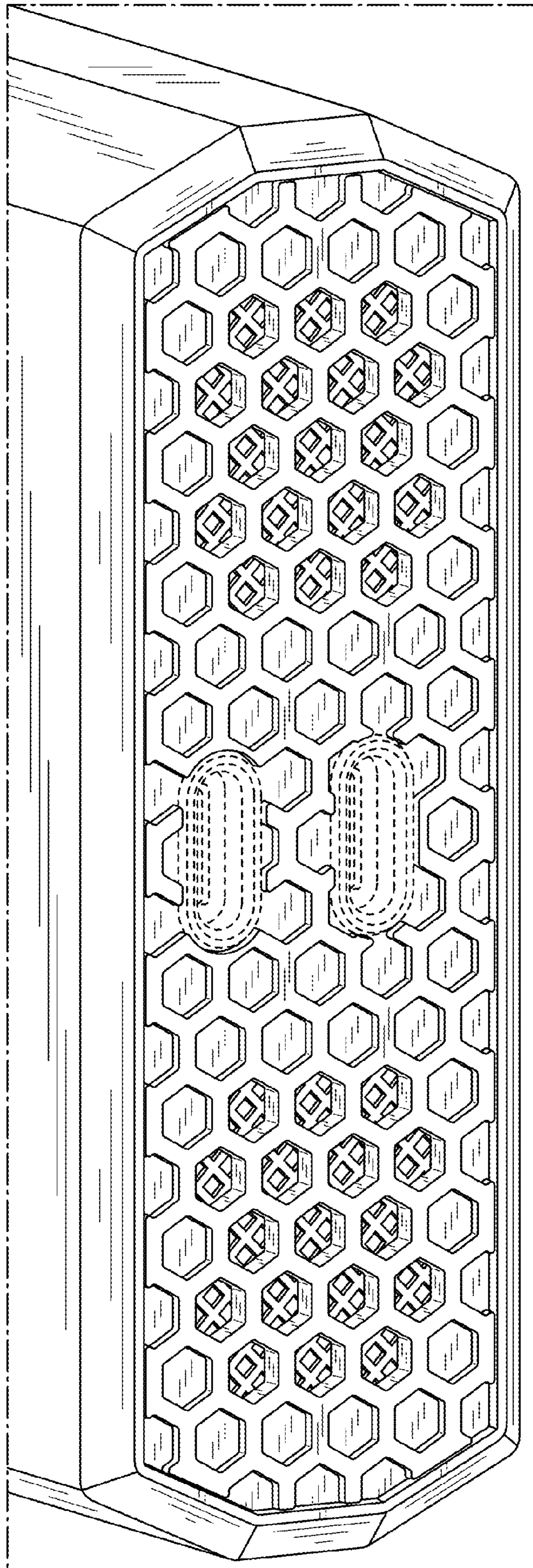

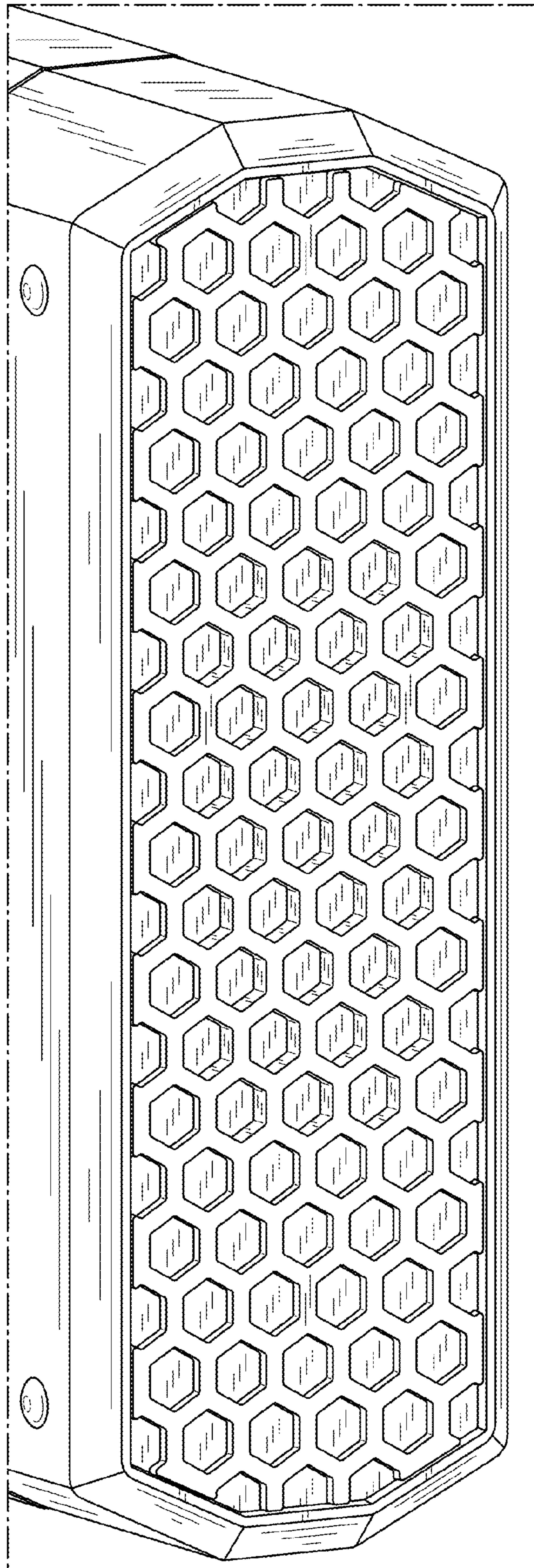

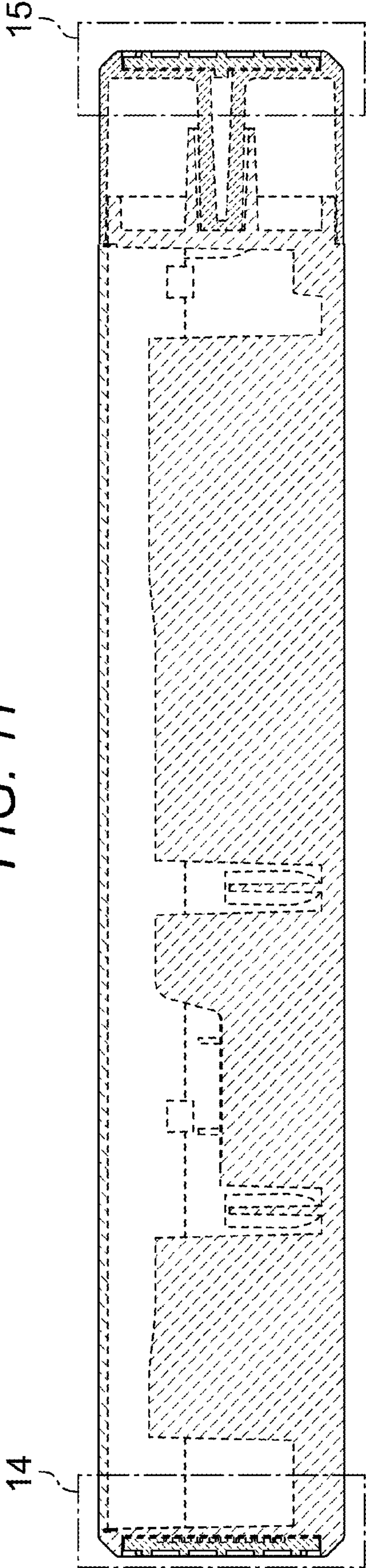

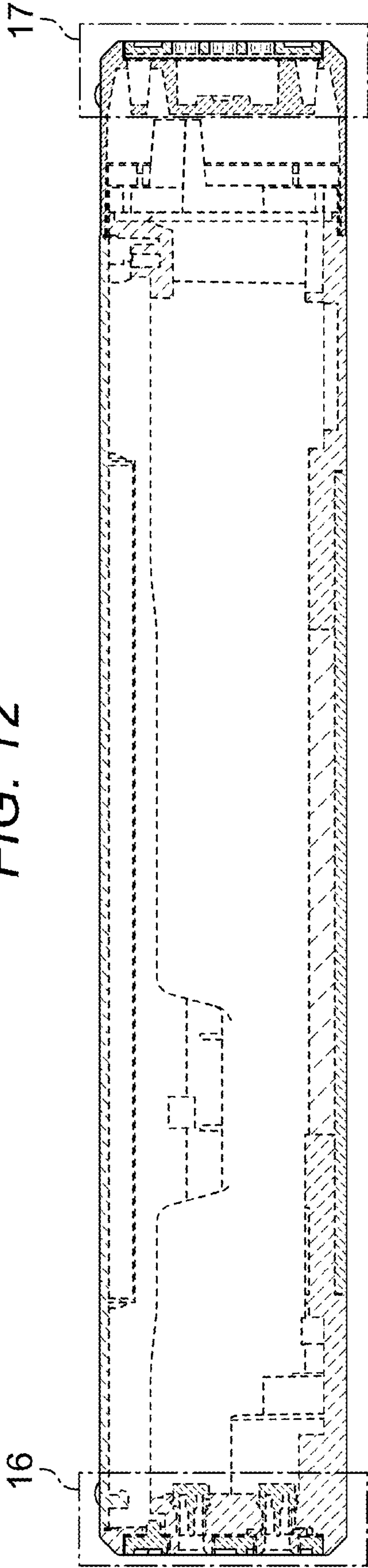

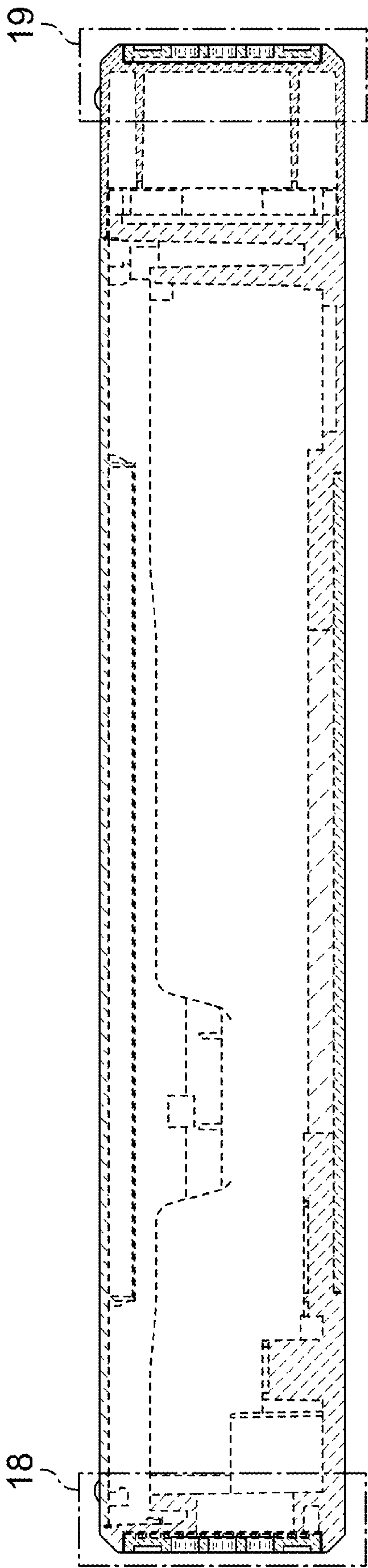

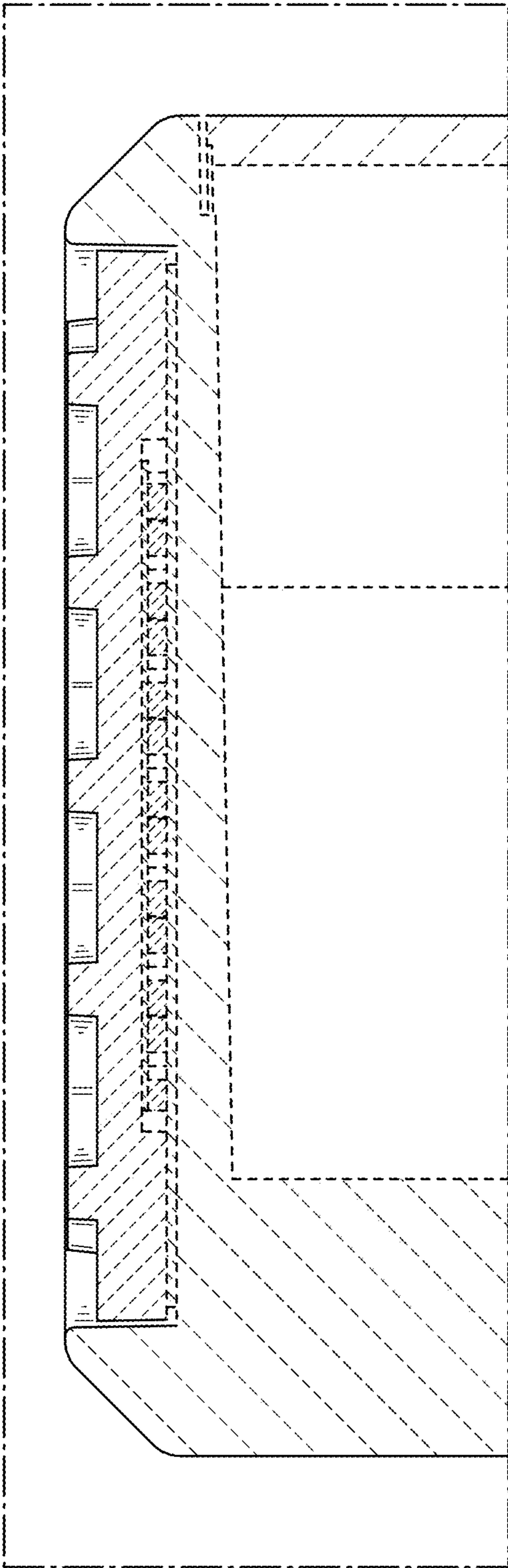

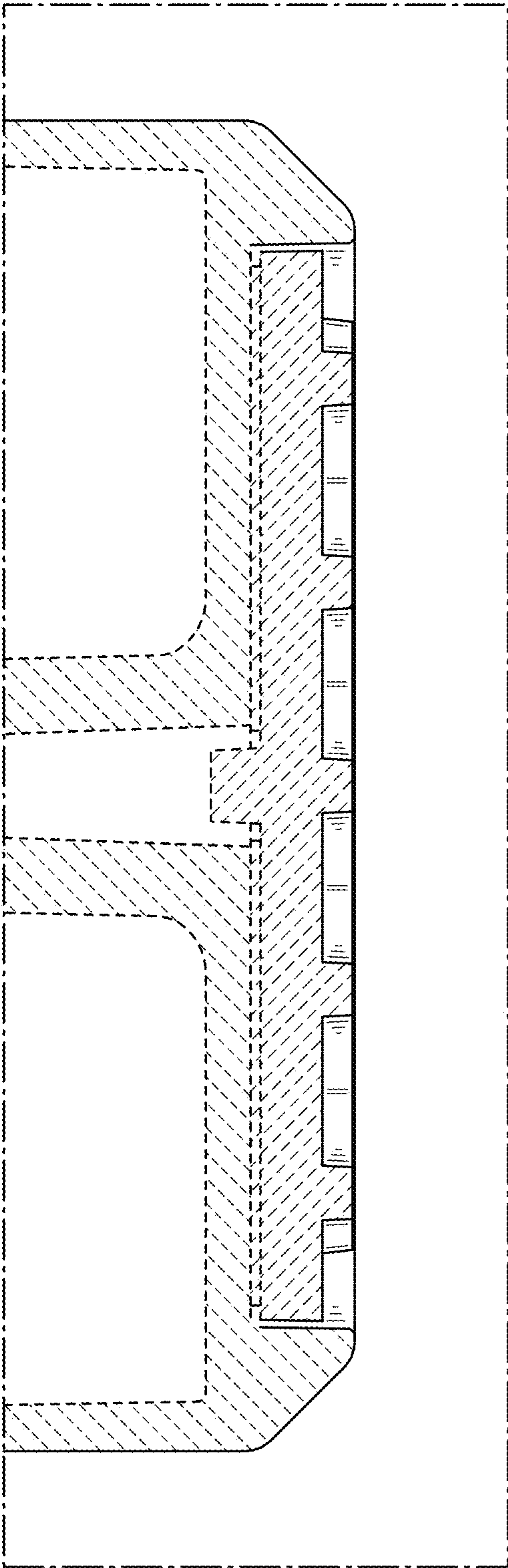

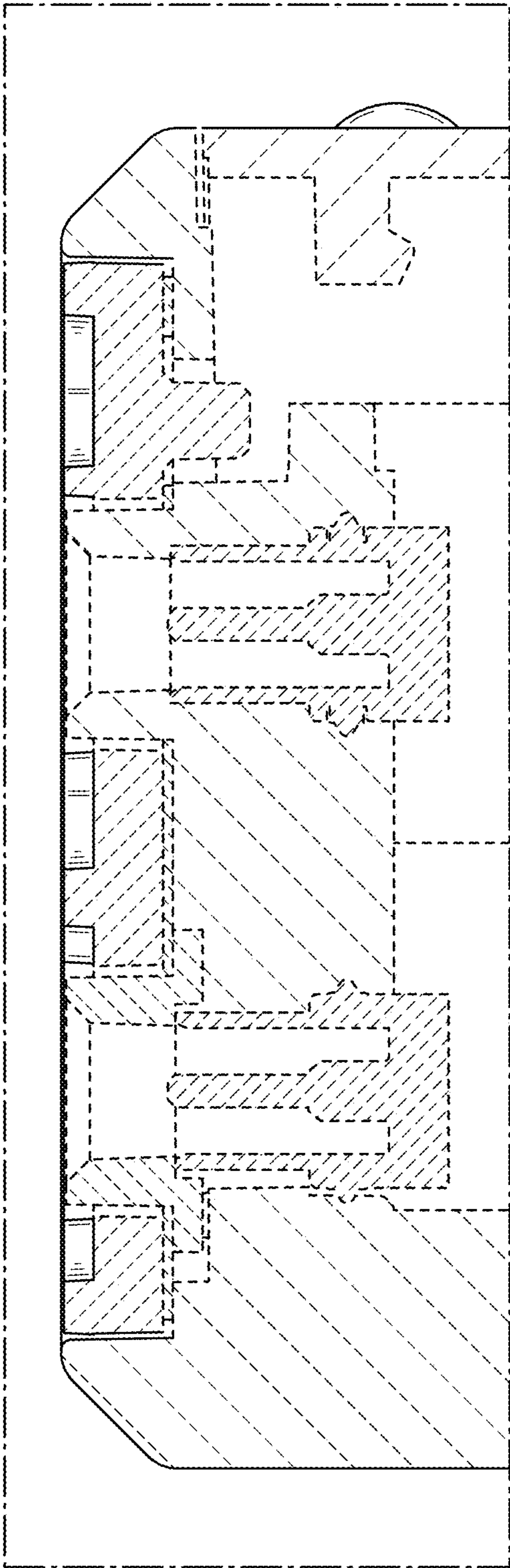

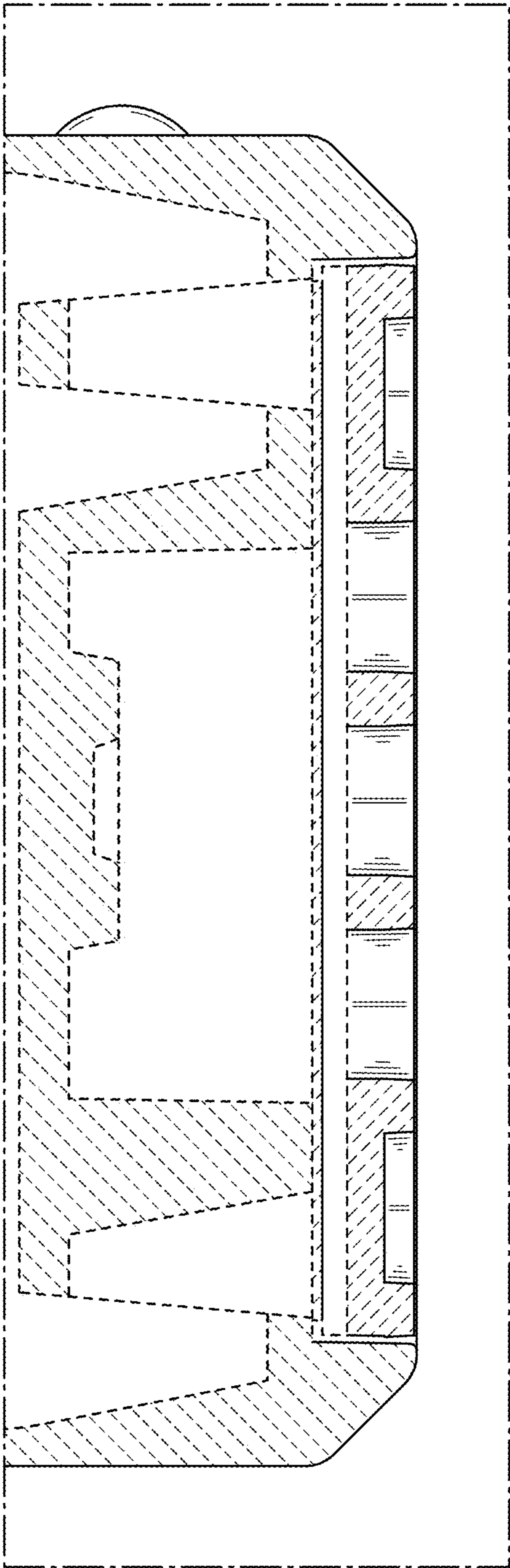

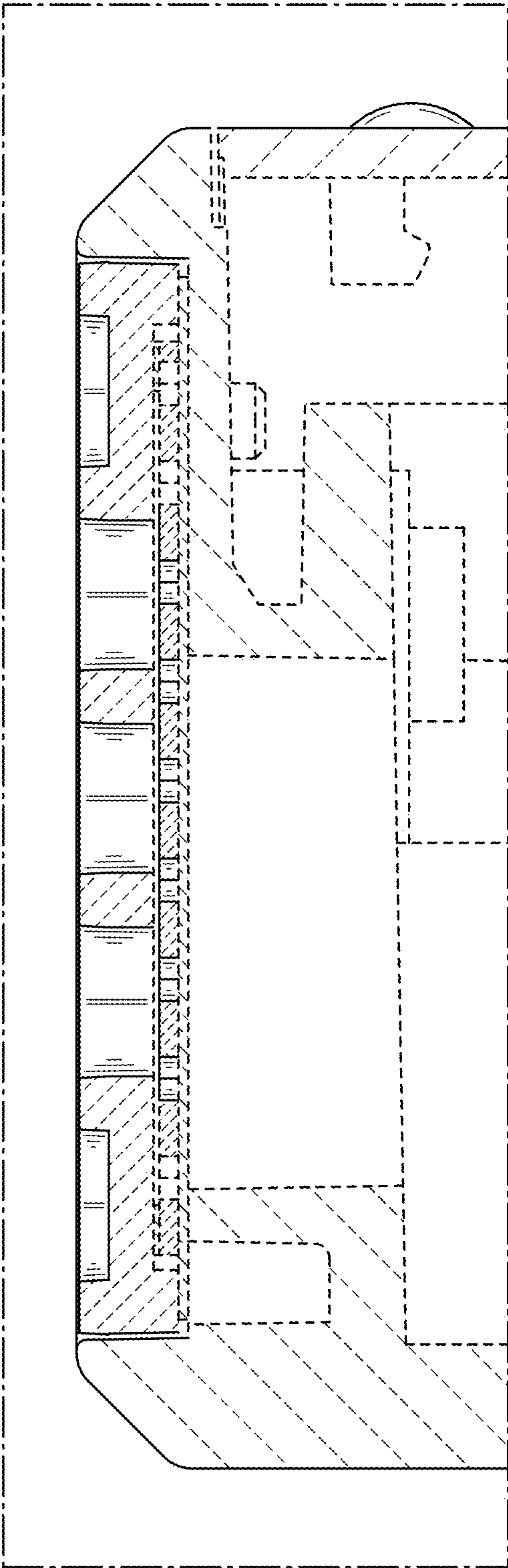
