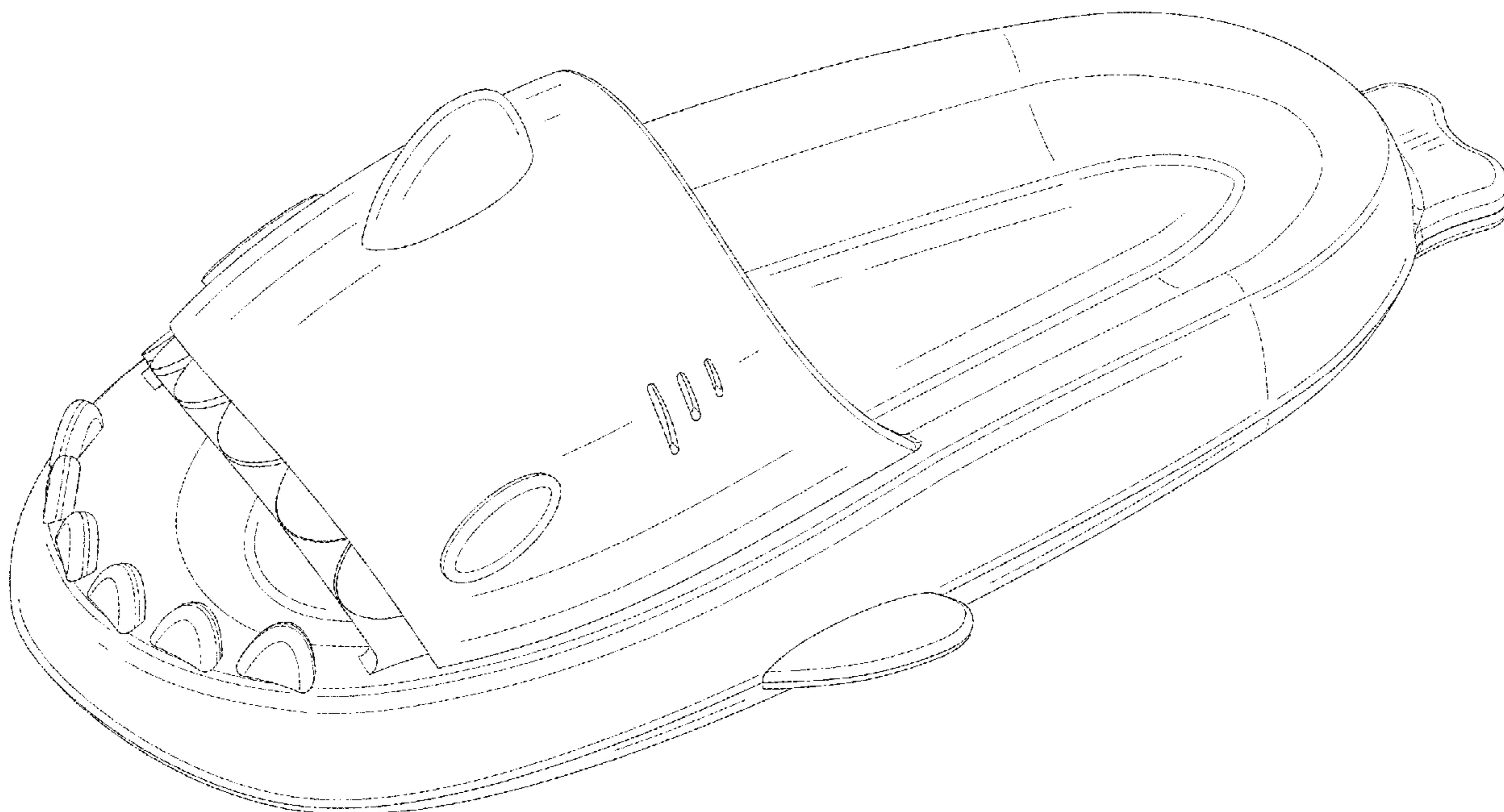
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a slipper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left and top perspective view of a slipper, showing my design.
FIG. 2 is a rear, right and bottom perspective view thereof.
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof.
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.
FIG. 9 is a partial enlarged view of an area labeled 9 in FIG. 5.
FIG. 10 is a partial enlarged view of an area labeled 10 in FIG. 5.
FIG. 11 is a partial enlarged view of an area labeled 11 in FIG. 6; and,
FIG. 12 is a partial enlarged view of an area labeled 12 in FIG. 6.
A left shoe of the slipper is a mirror image of the right shoe as shown in FIGS. 1 to 12.
The broken lines shown in the drawings are included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the slipper that form no part of the claimed design. In addition, the dot-dash broken lines in FIGS. 5-6 and 9-12 depict the boundaries of the enlargements that form no part of the claimed design.

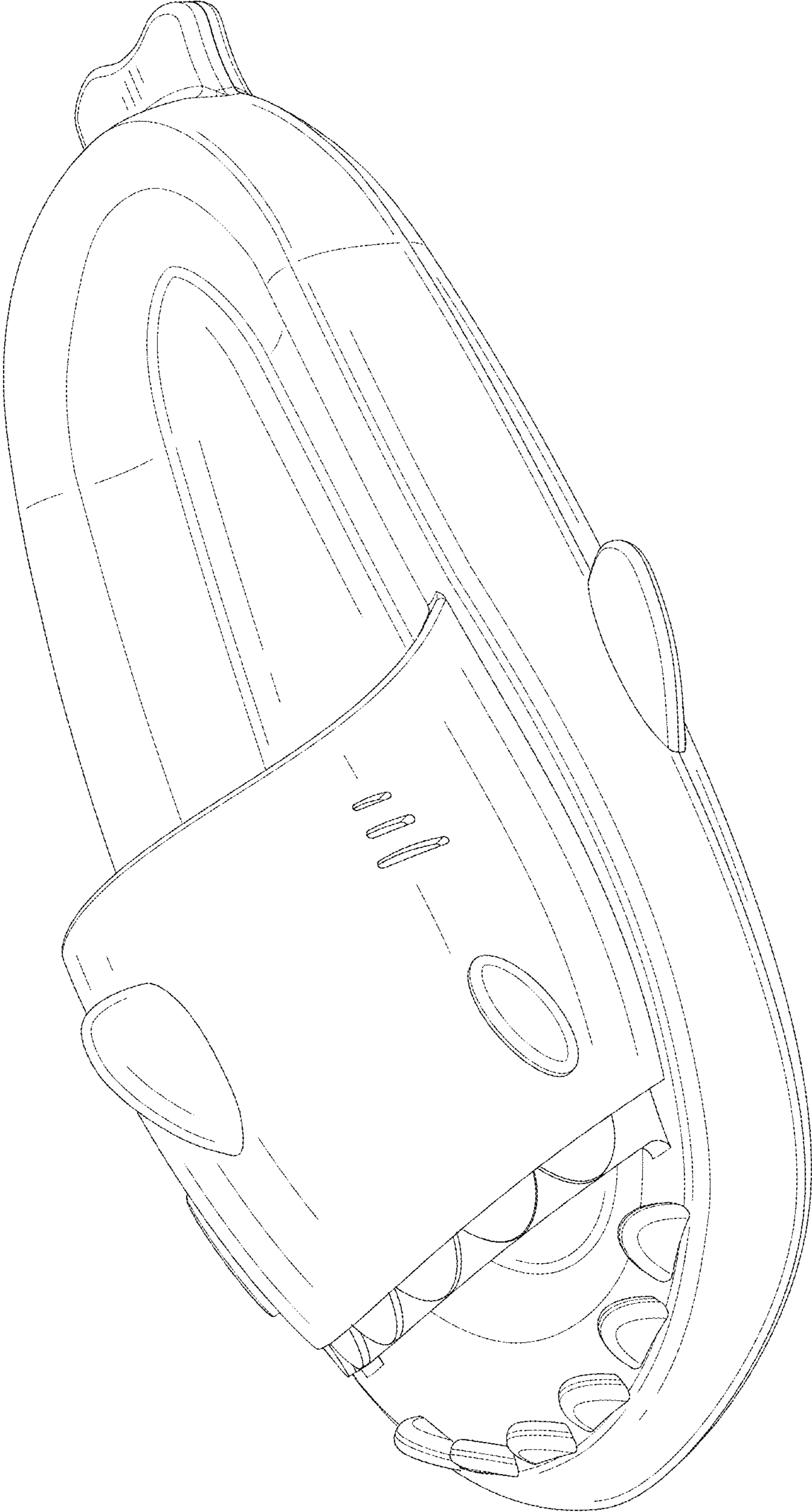

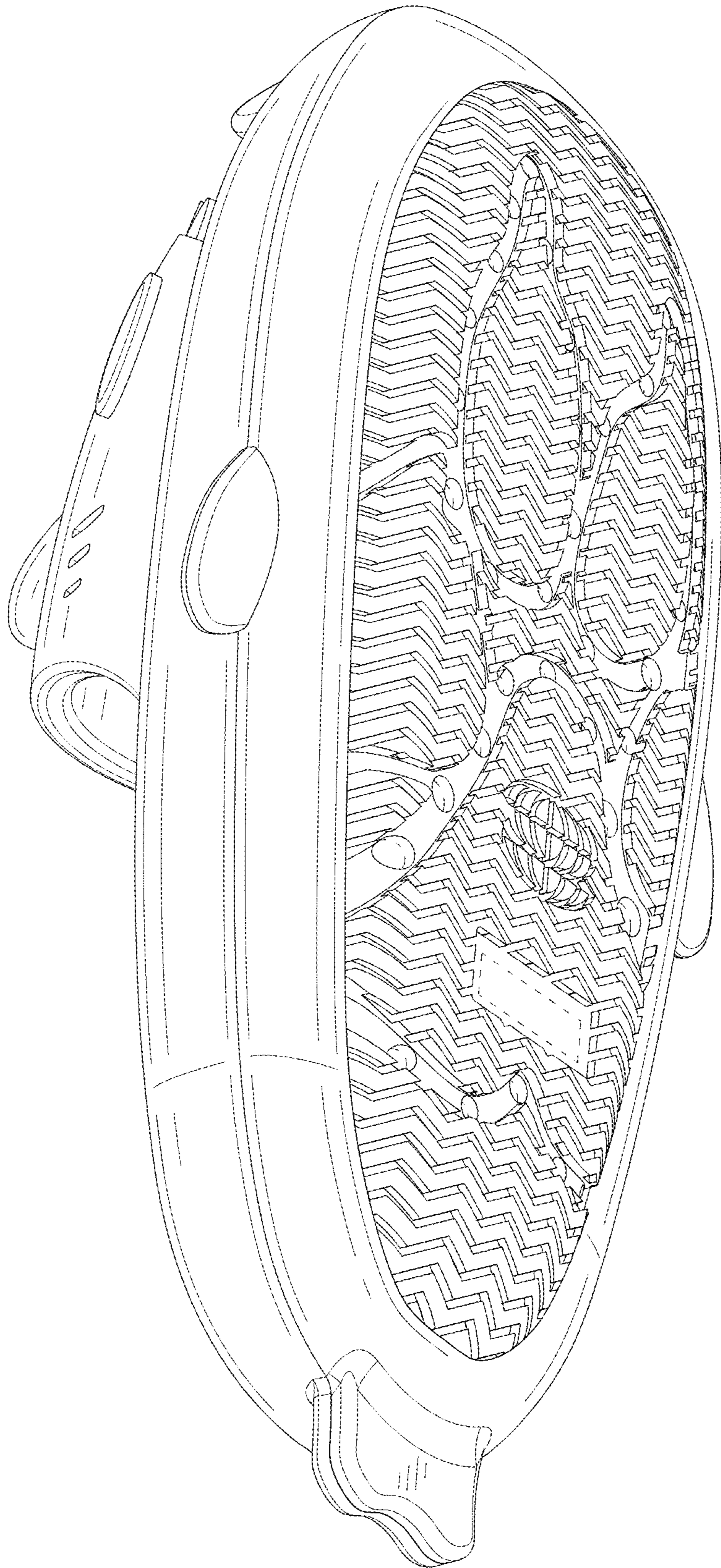

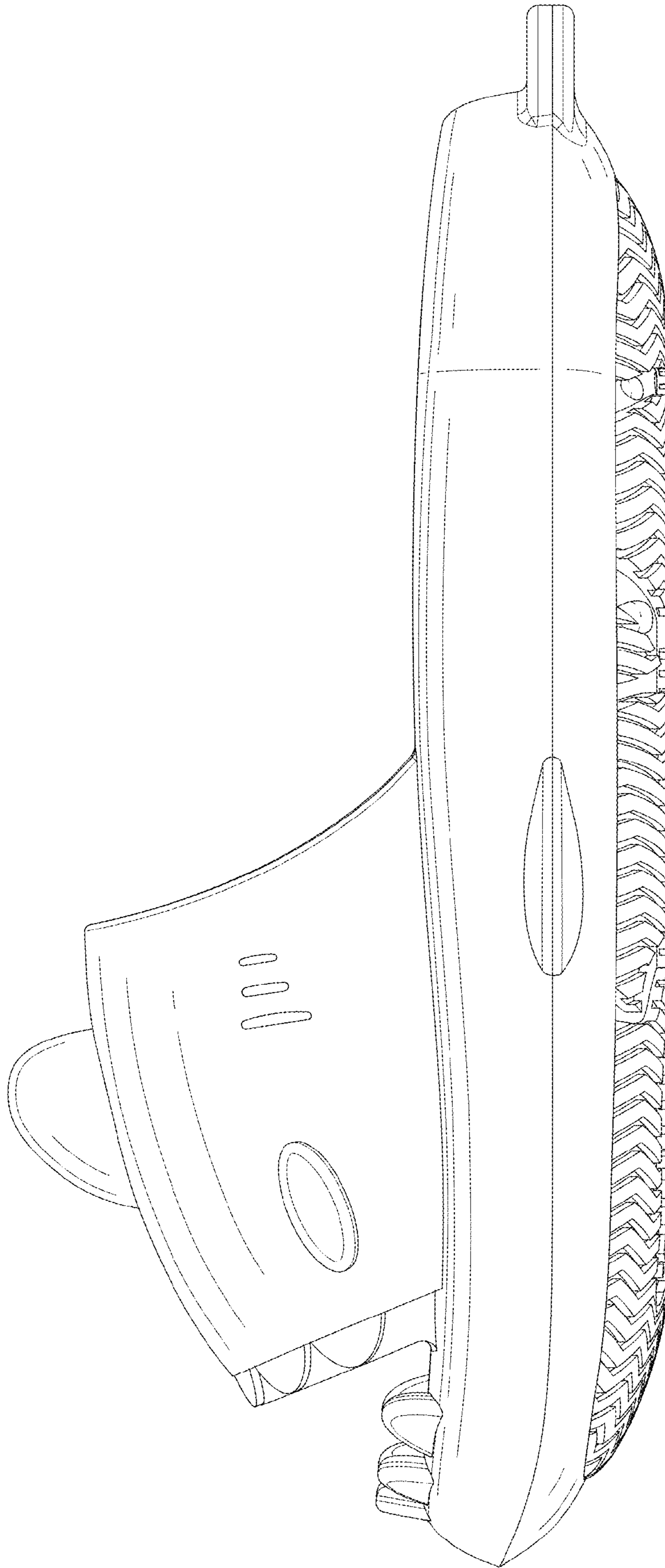

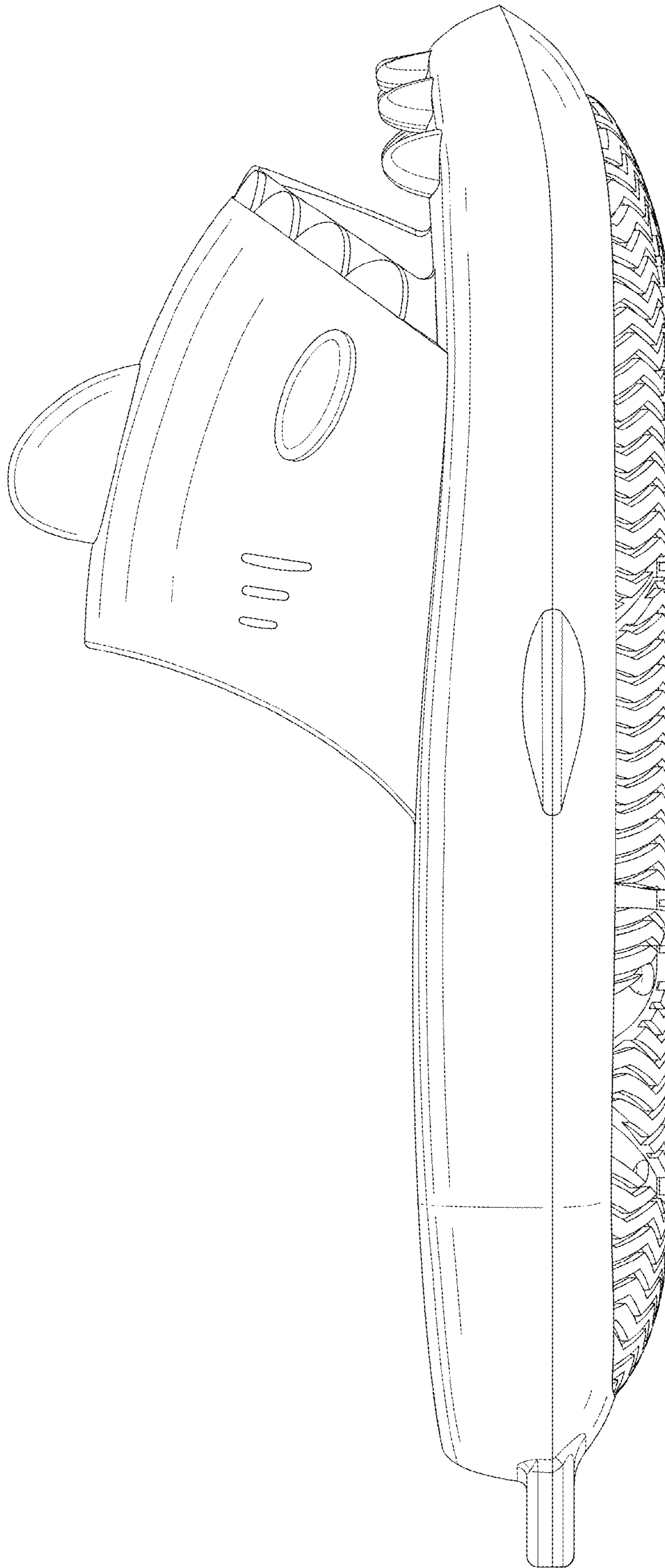

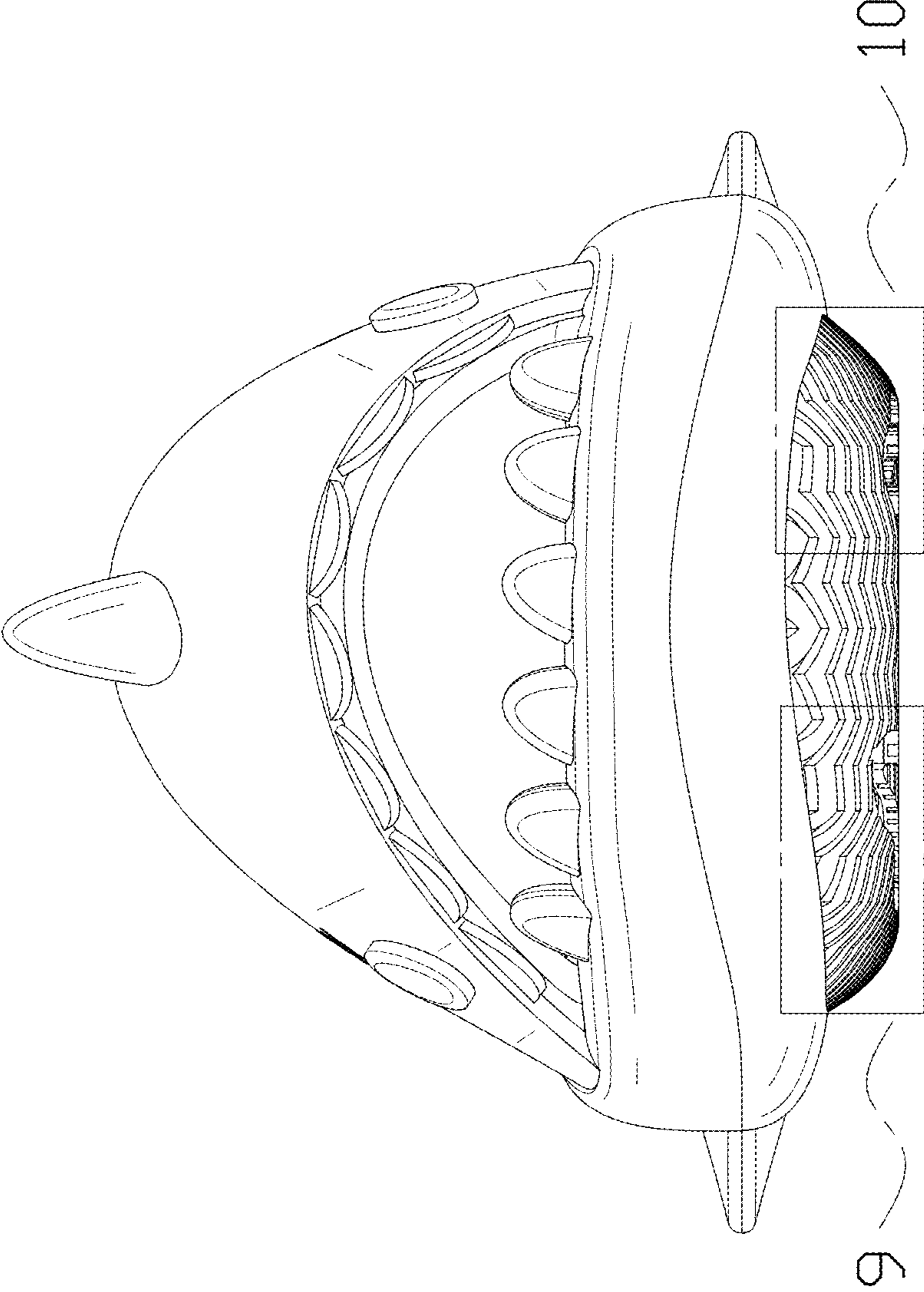

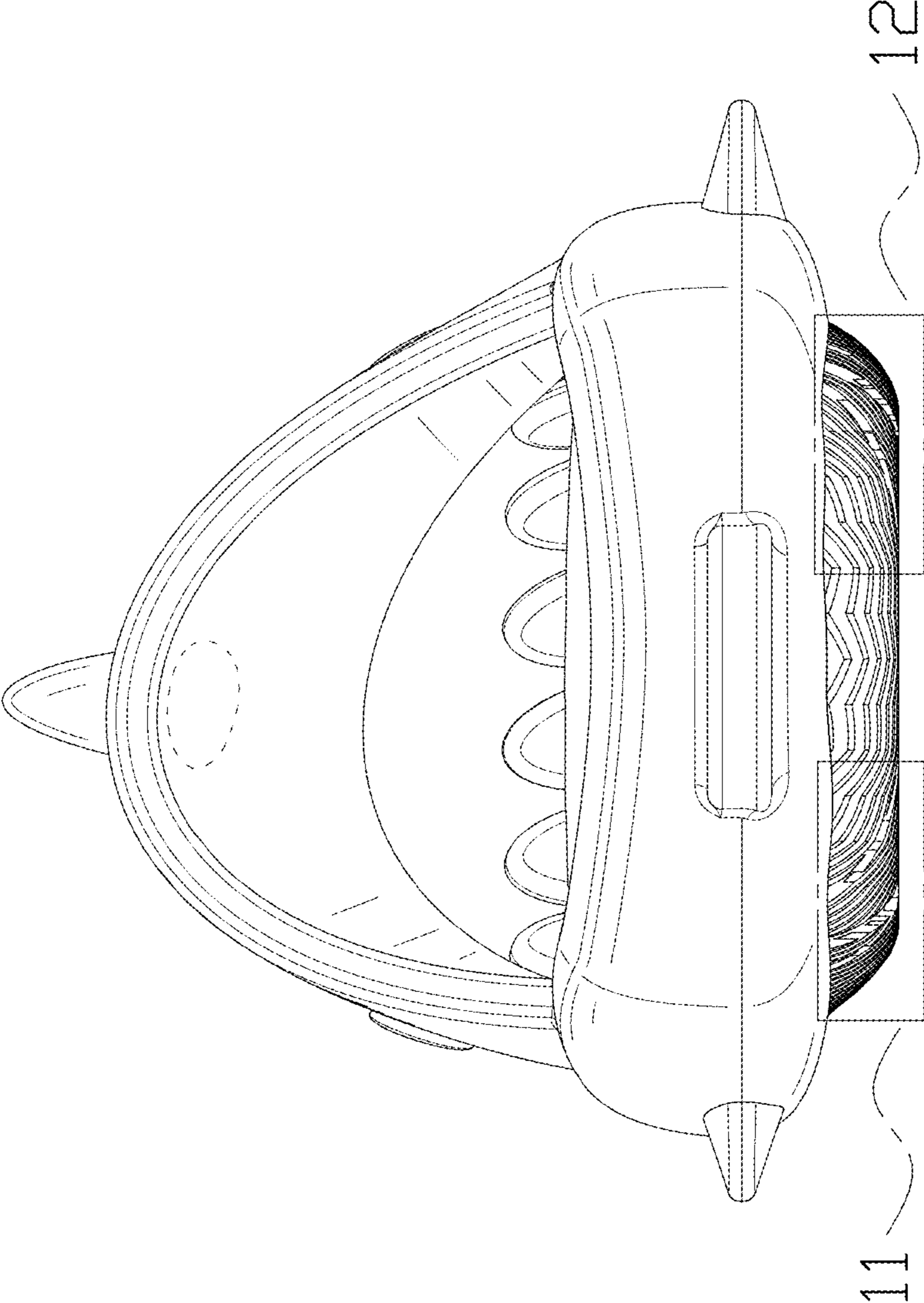

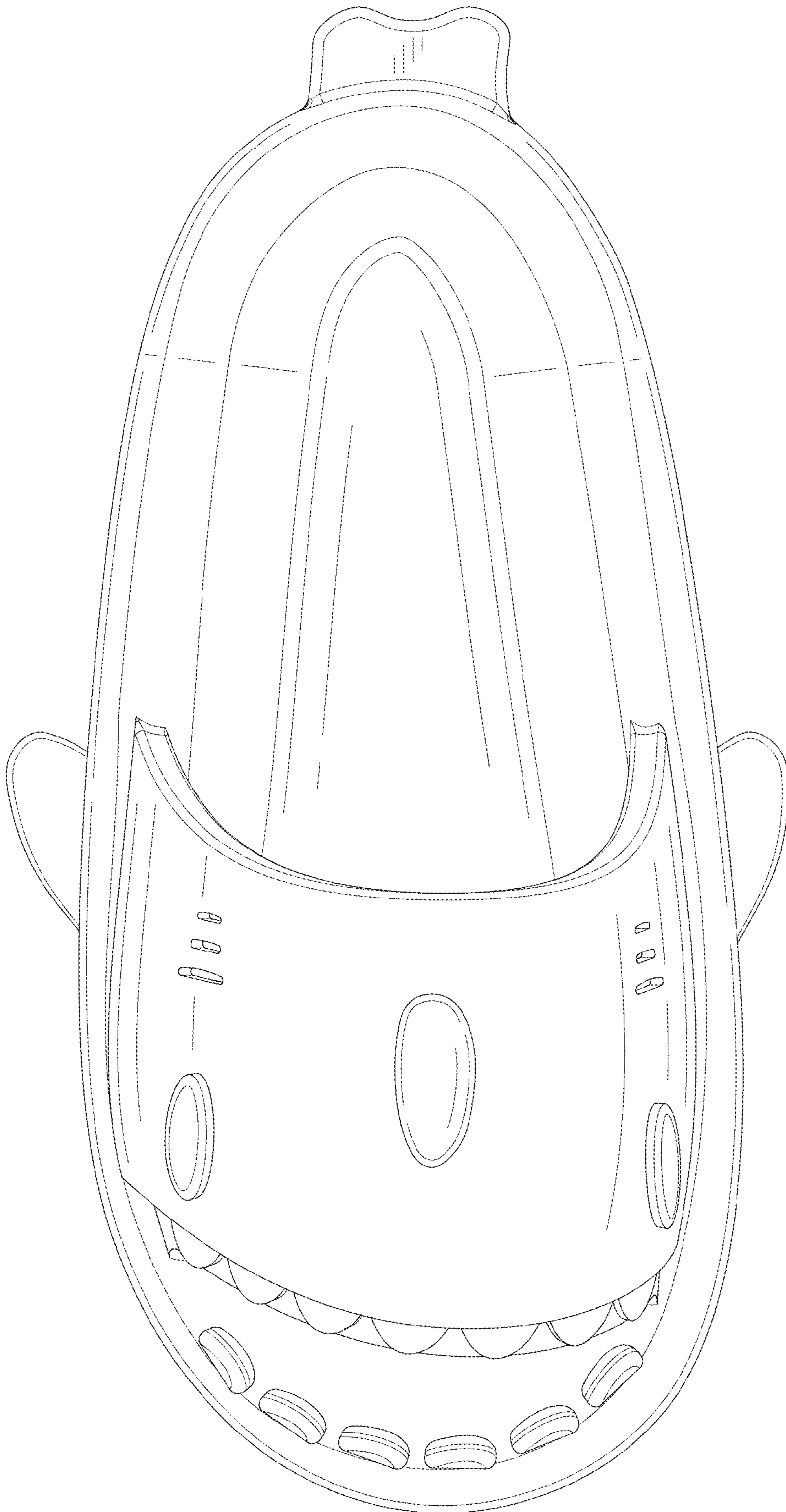

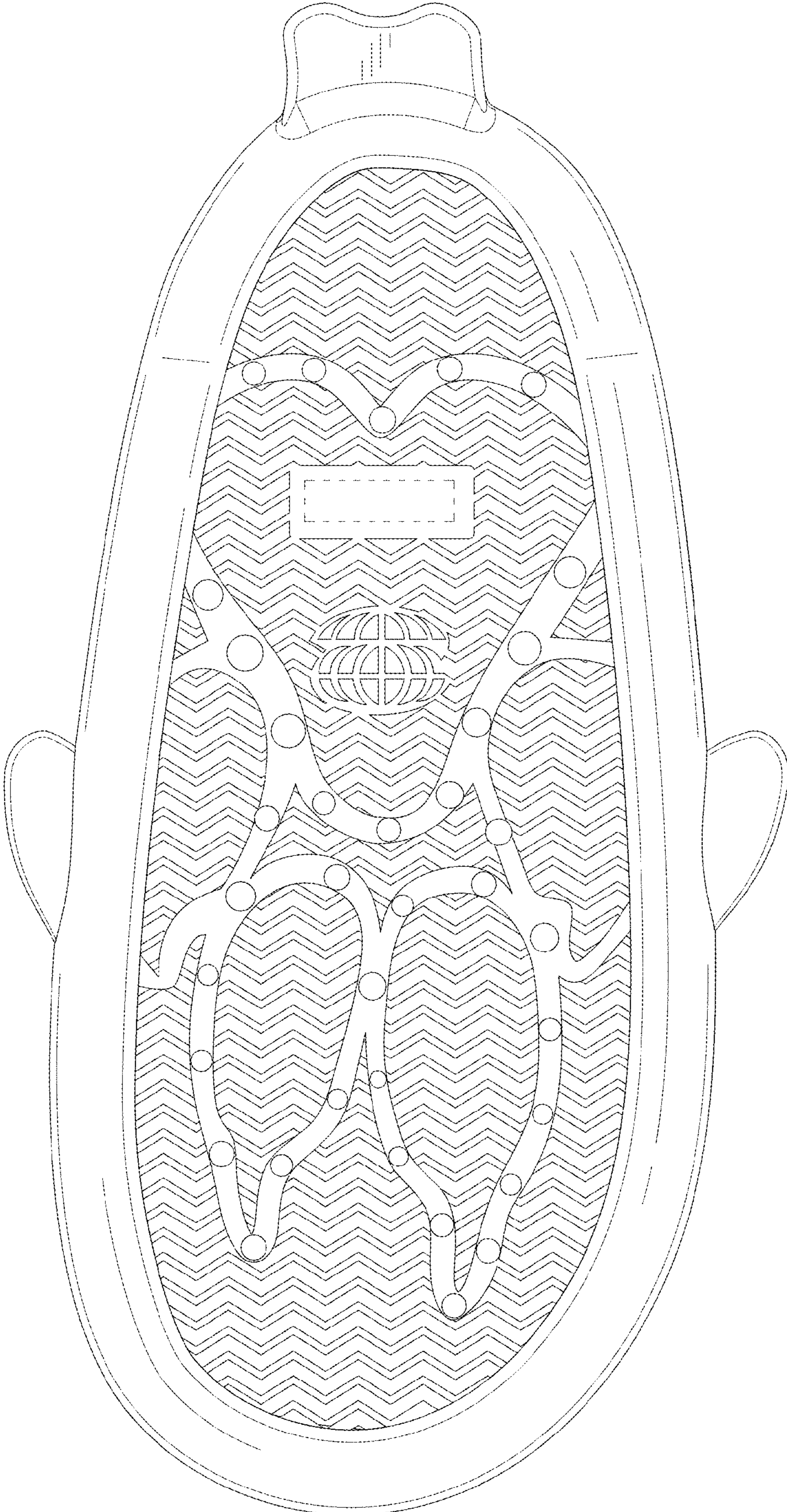

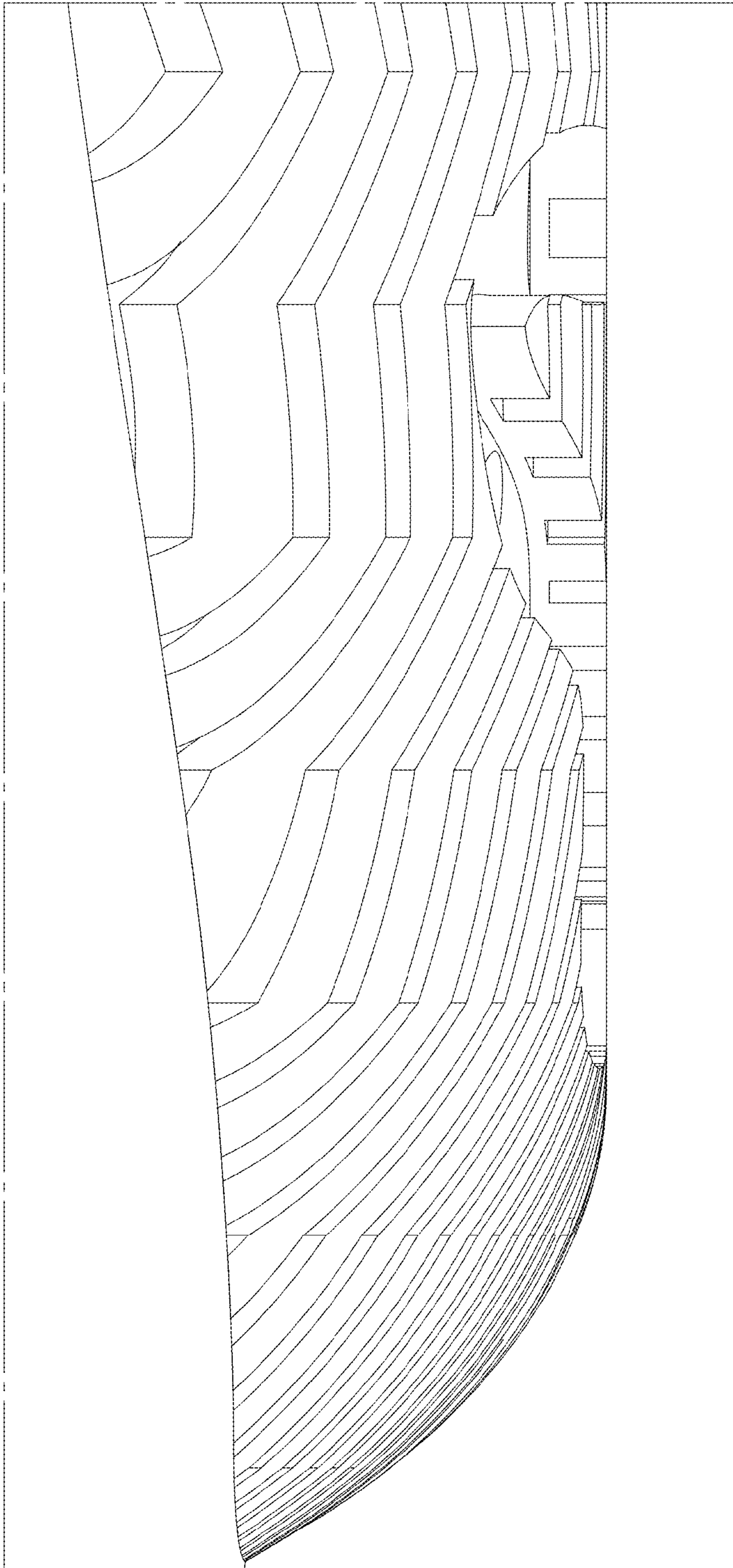

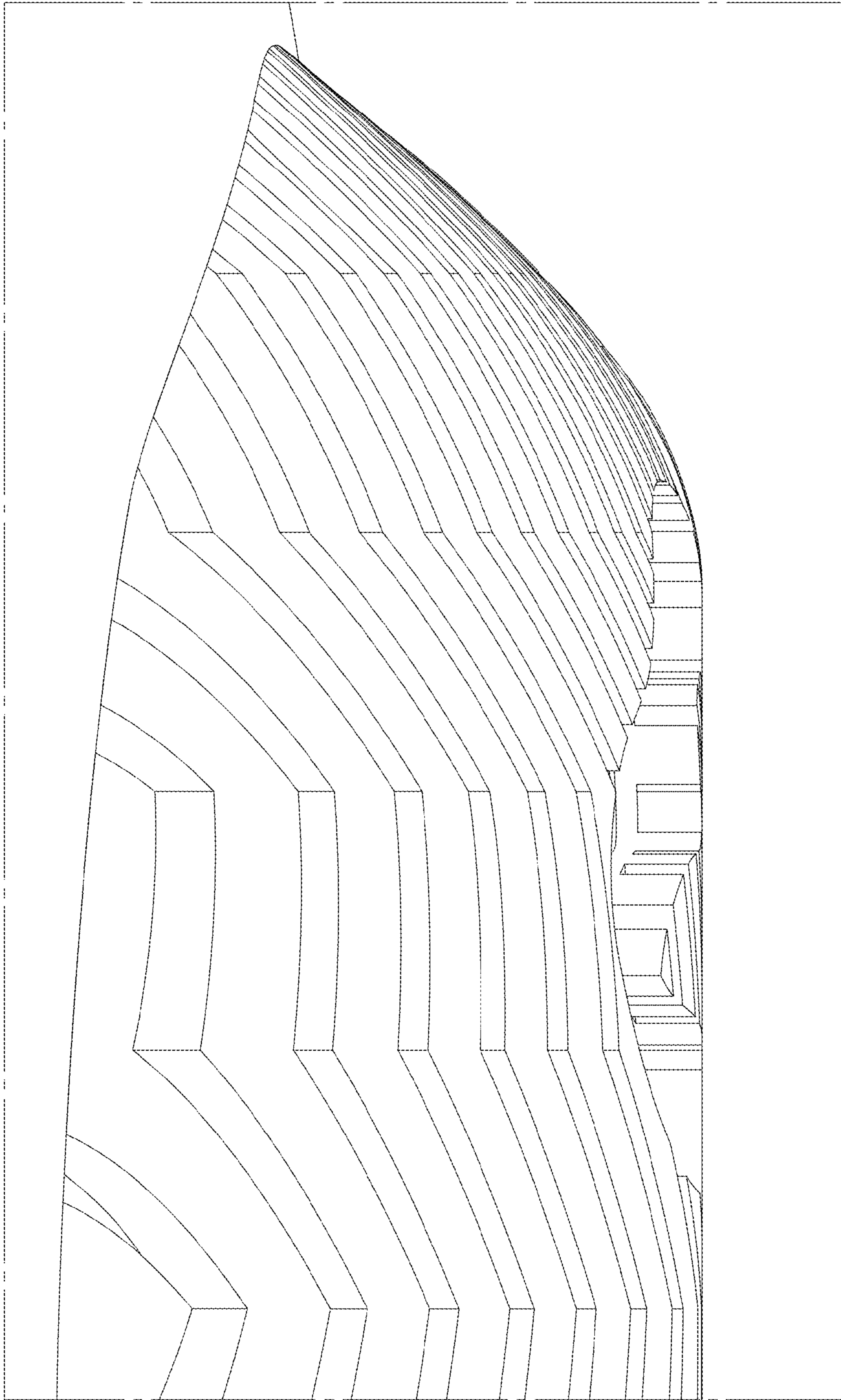

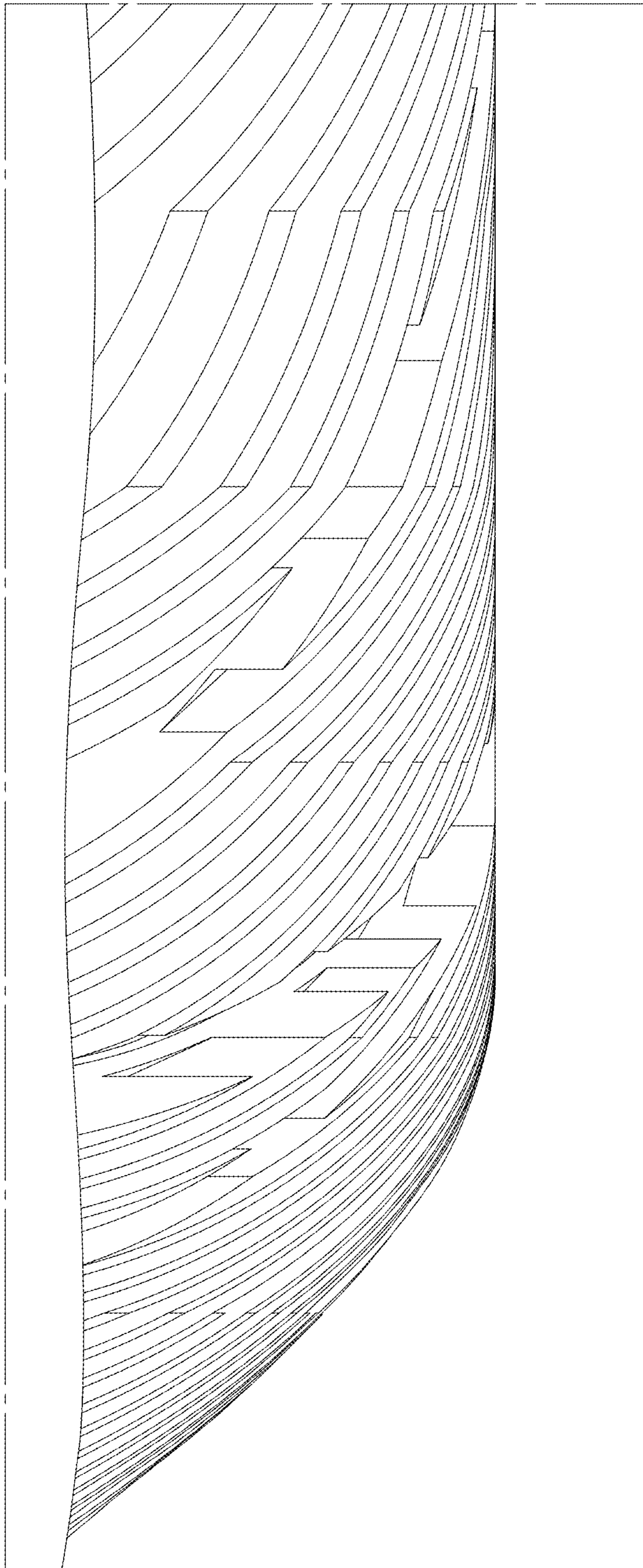

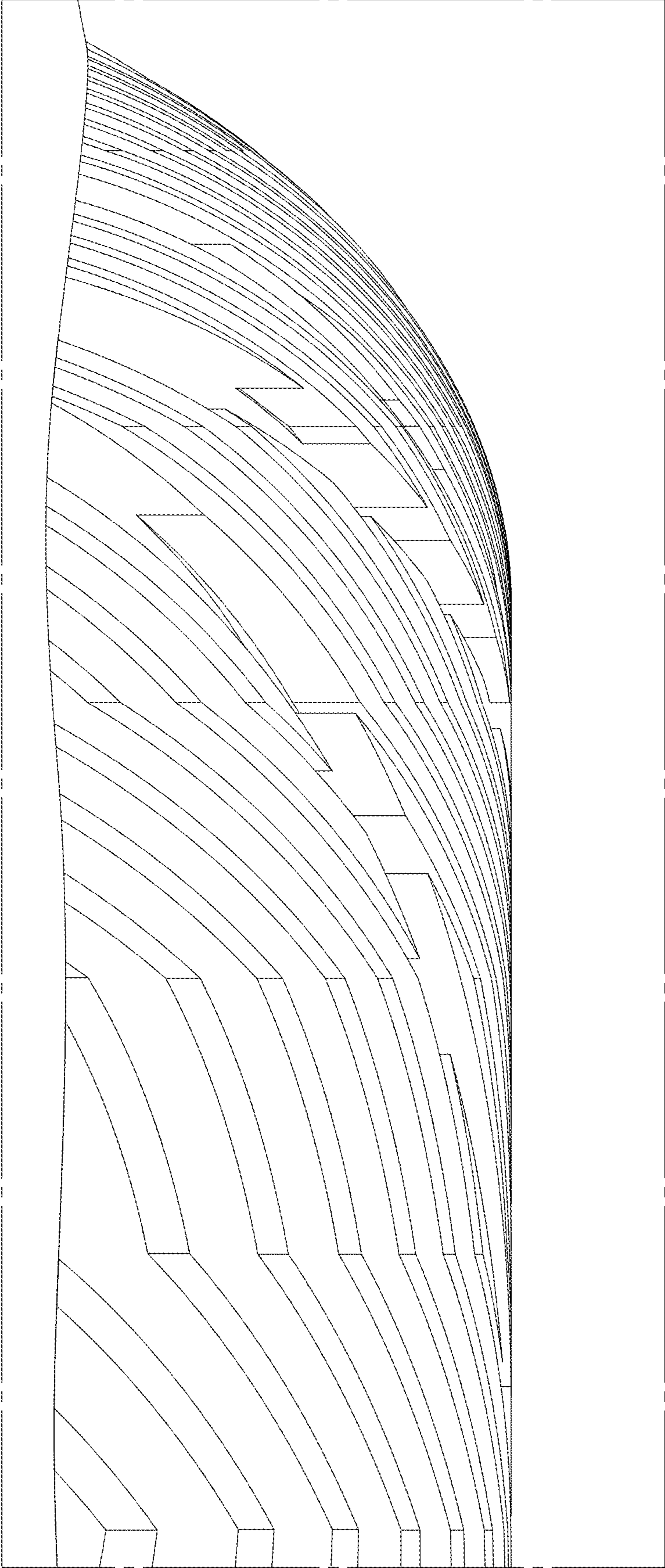
