FIG. 4 is a back view thereof.

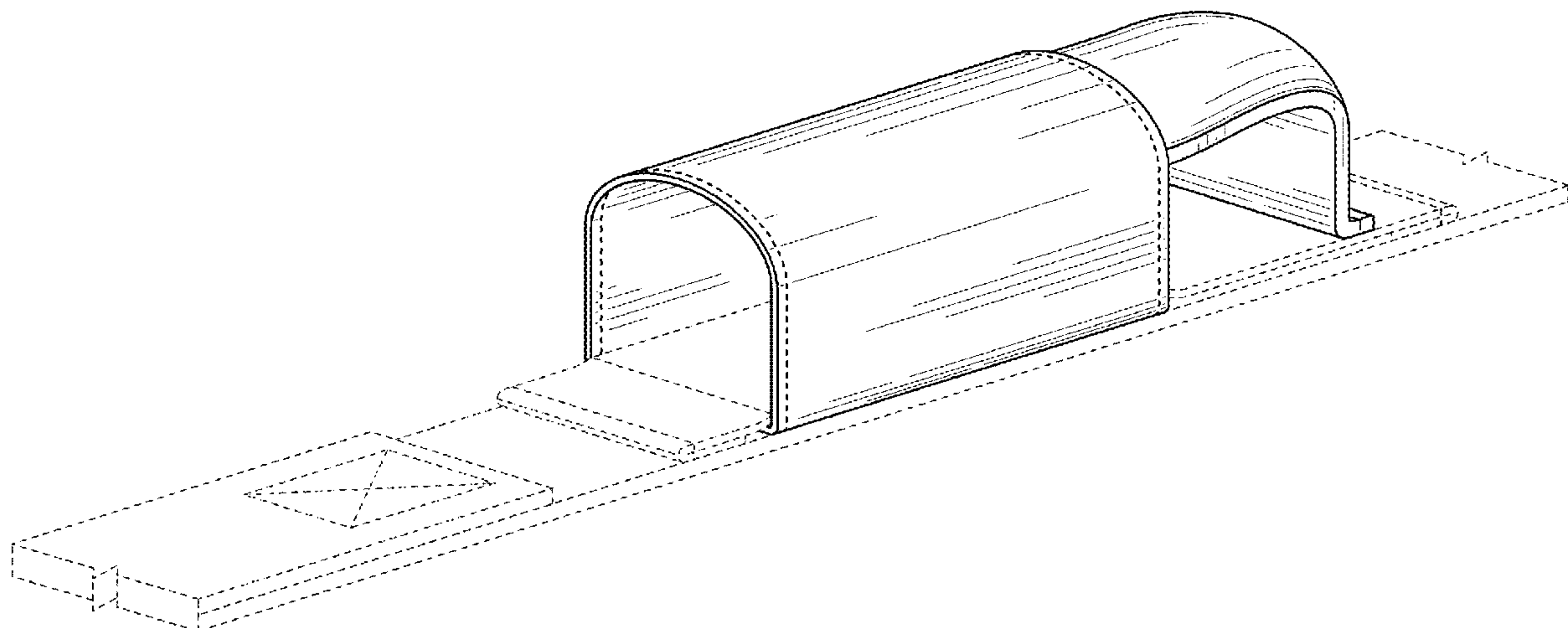
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof.

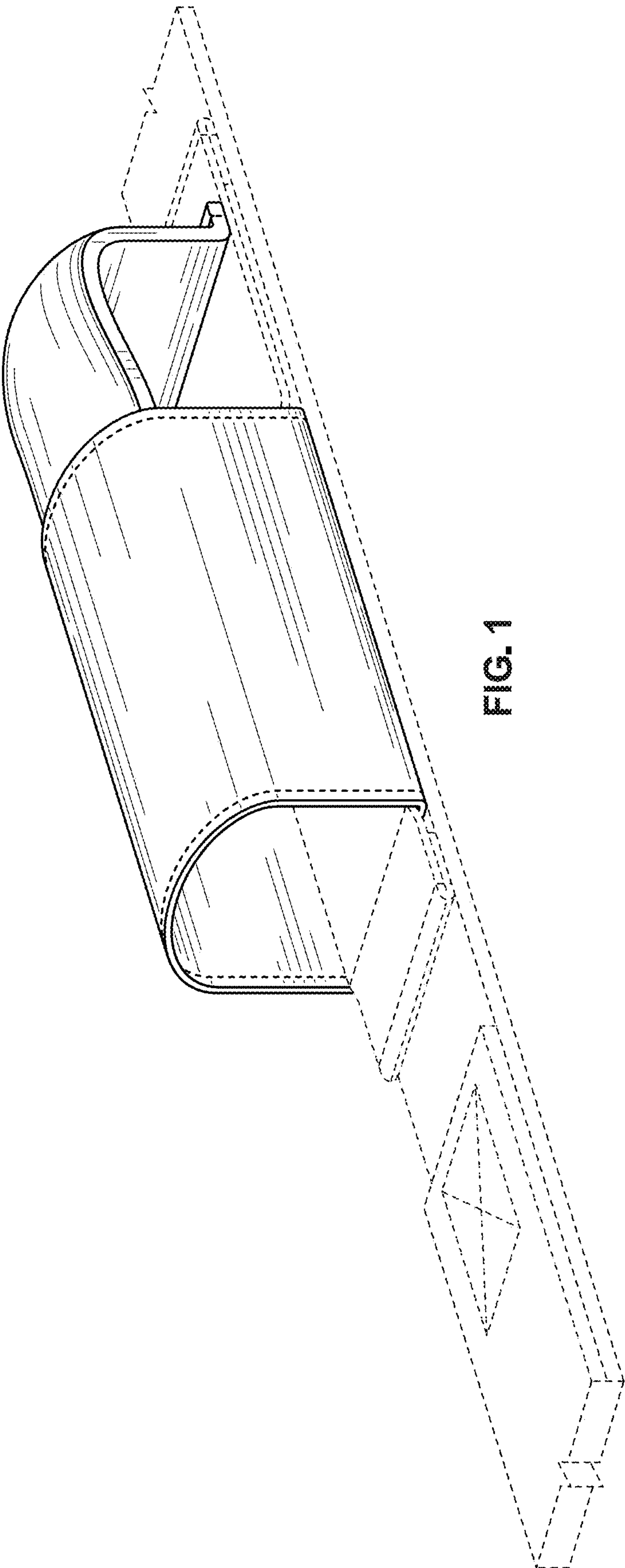

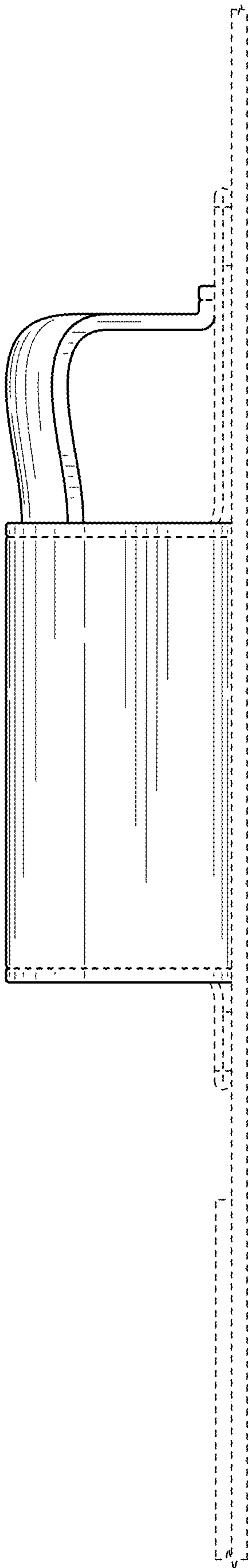

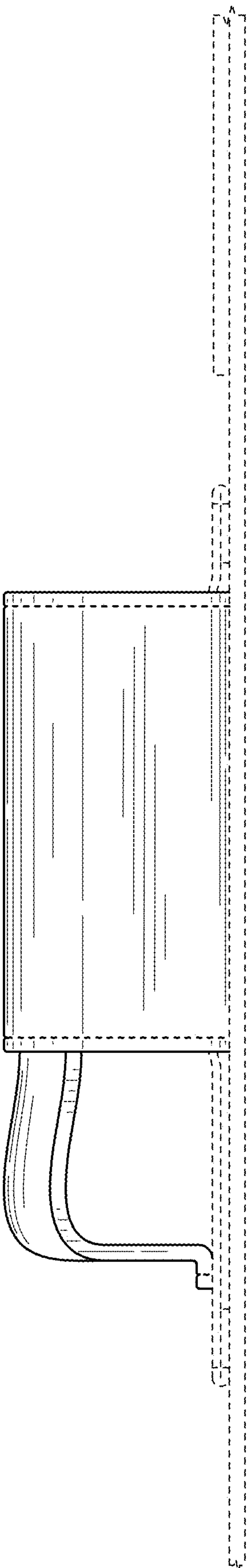

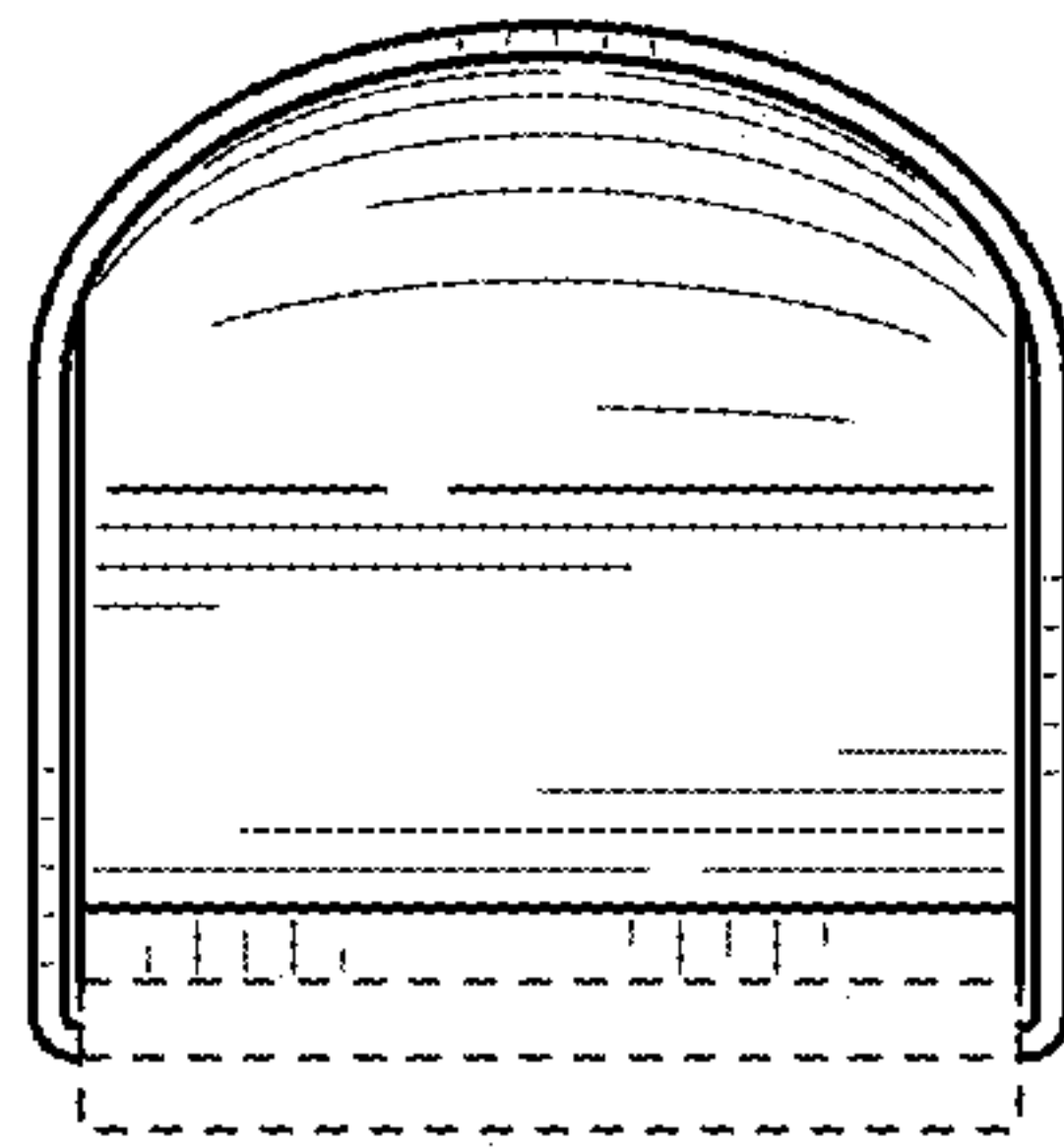

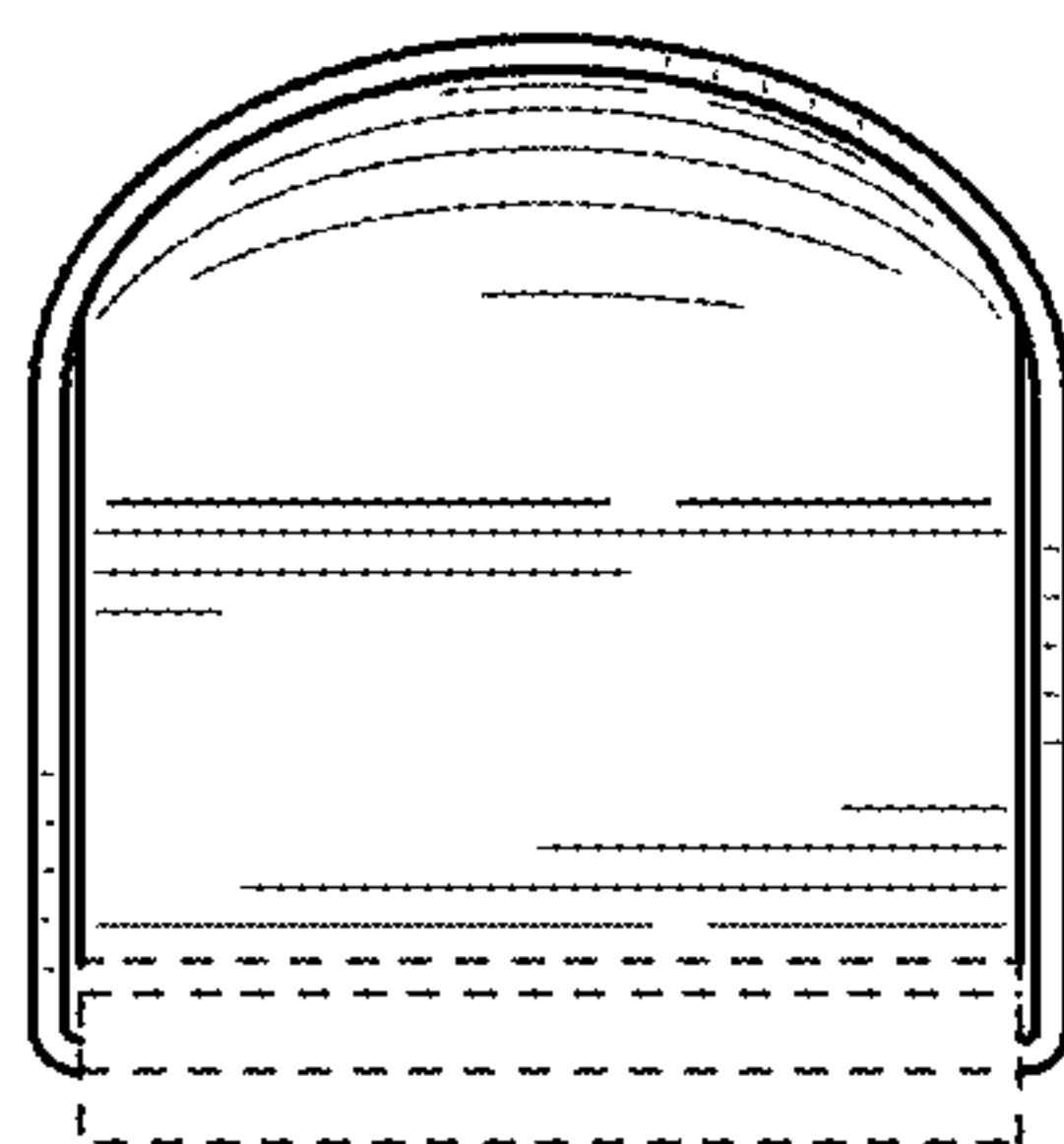

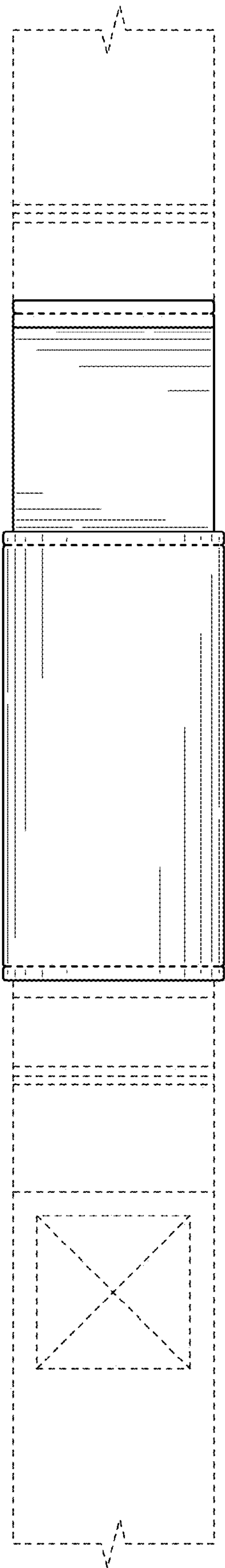

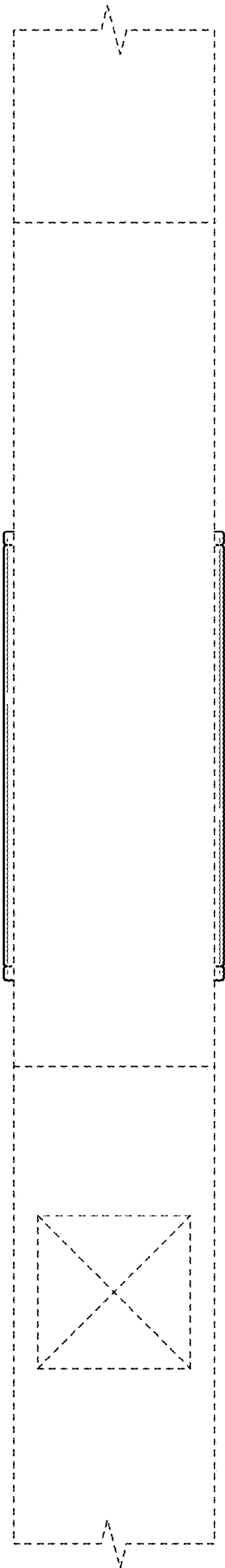
