FIG. 4 is a left side view of the fishing rod holder;

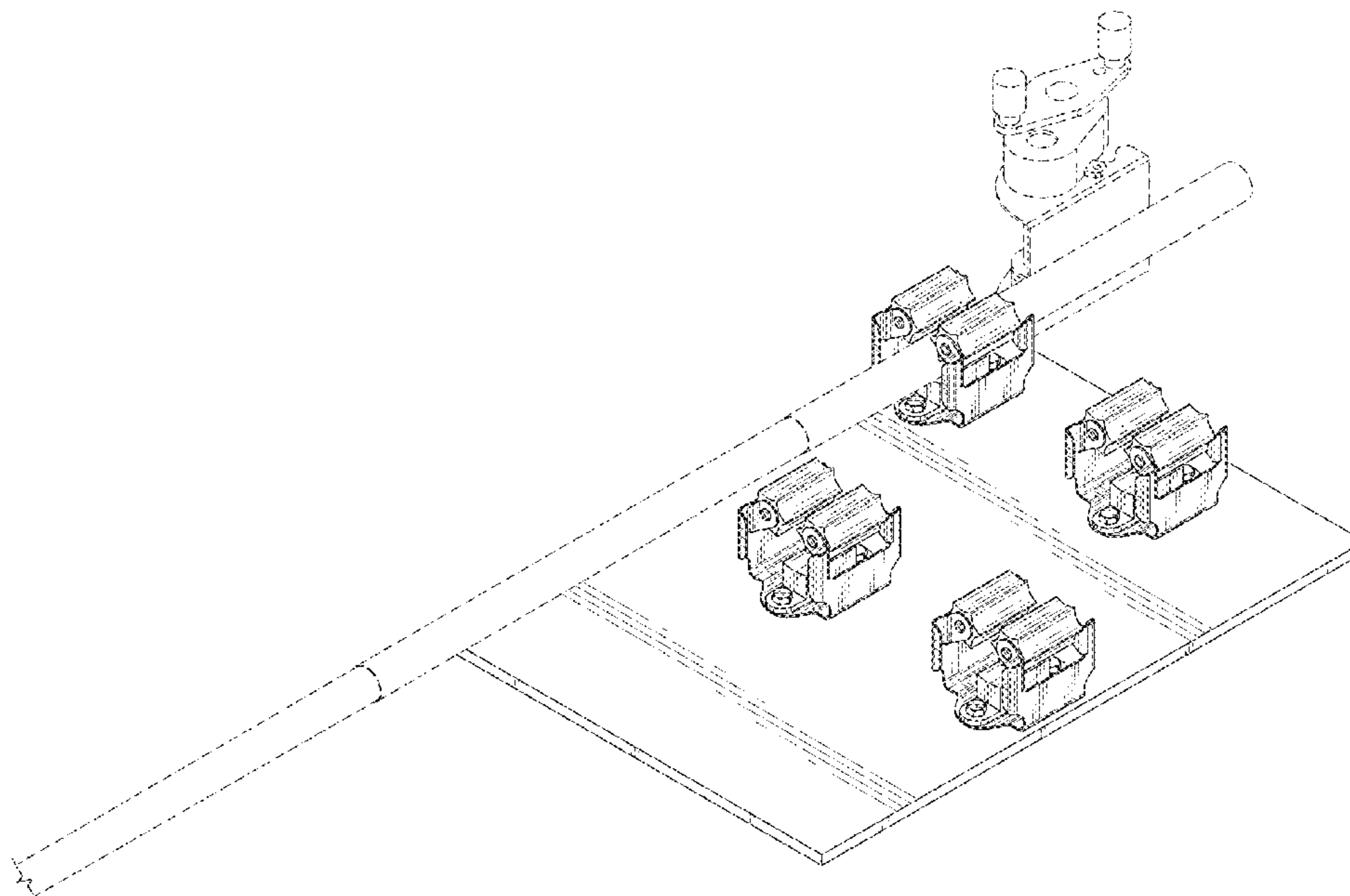
FIG. 5 is a top view of the fishing rod holder;

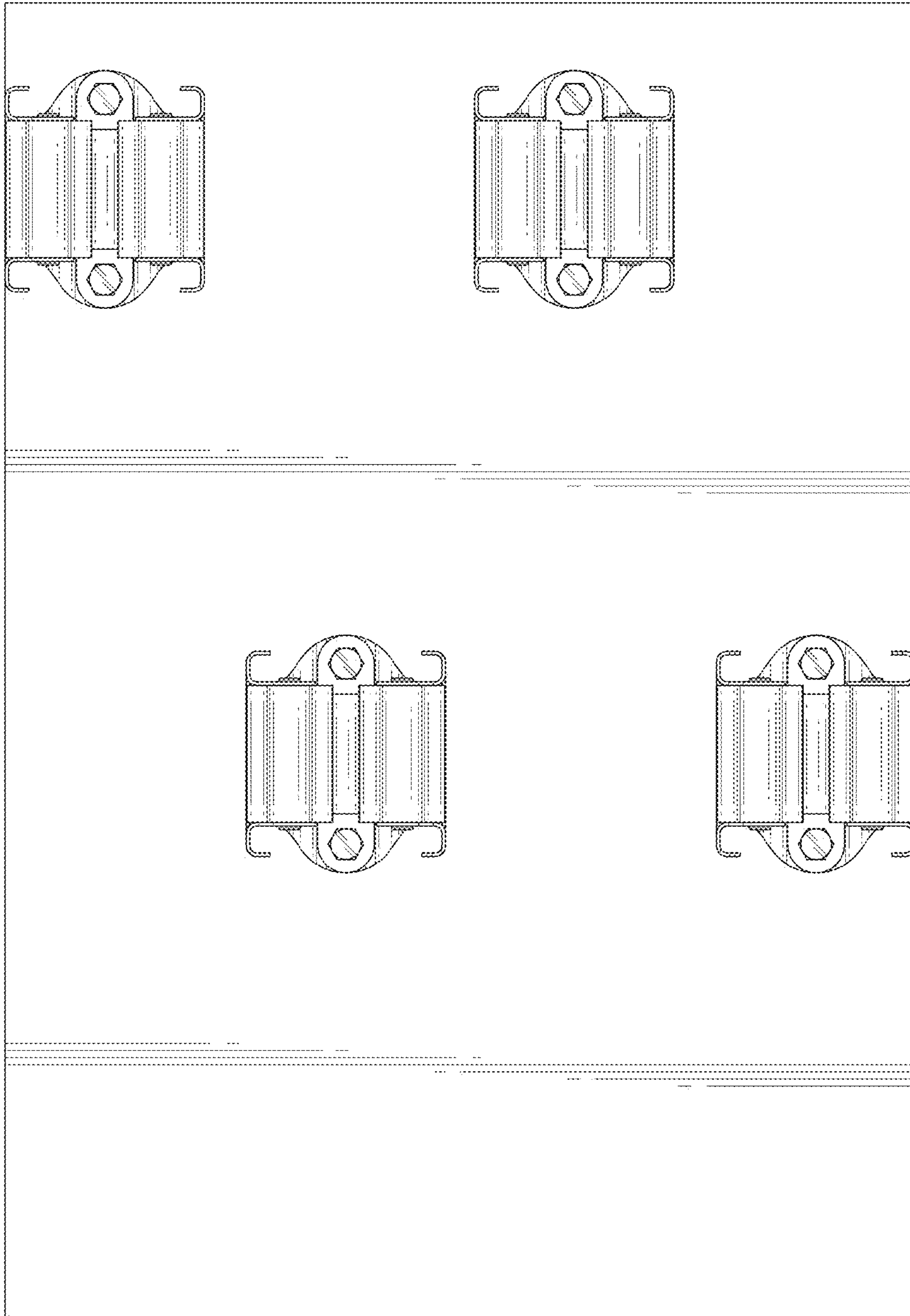

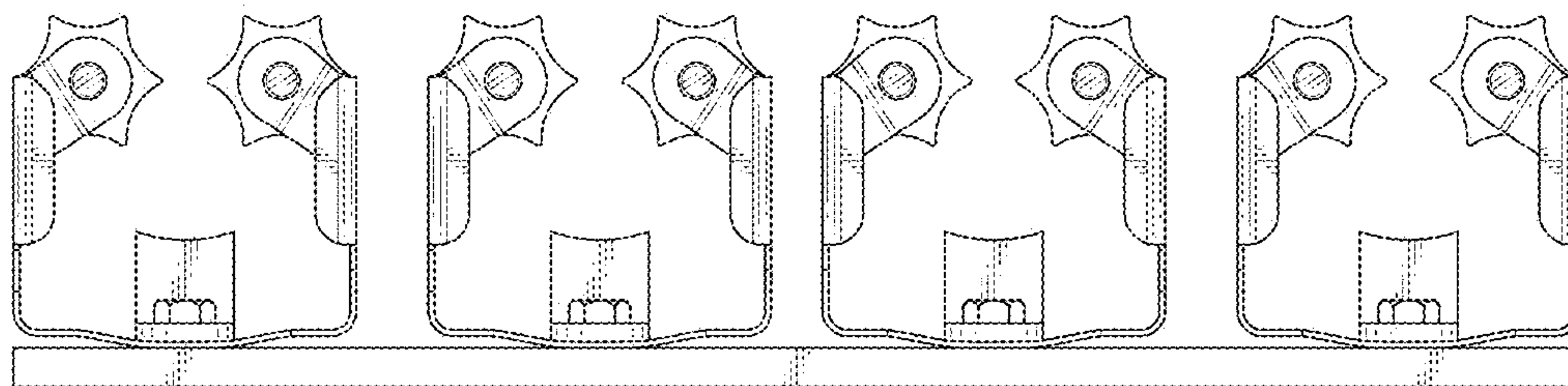

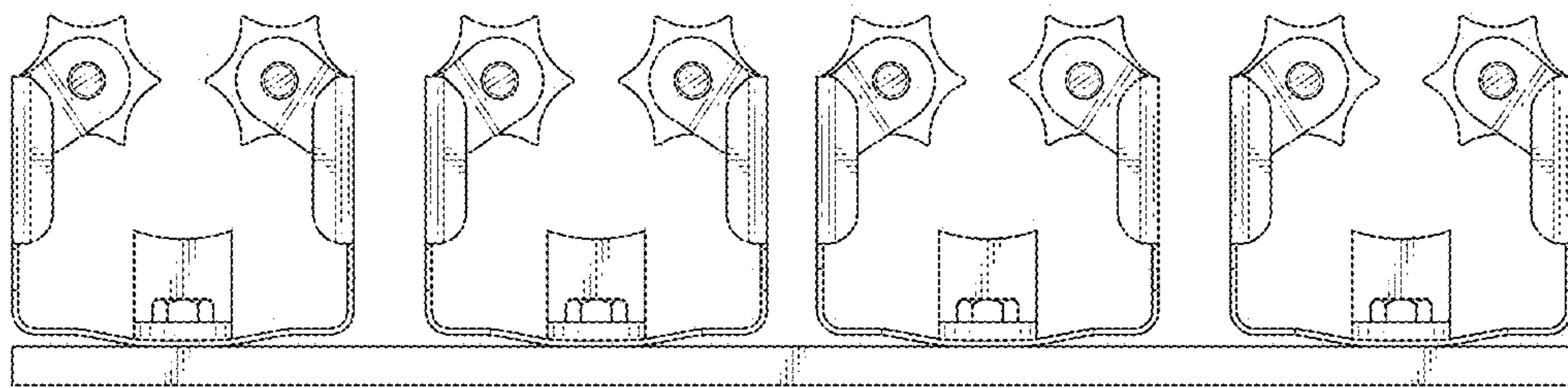

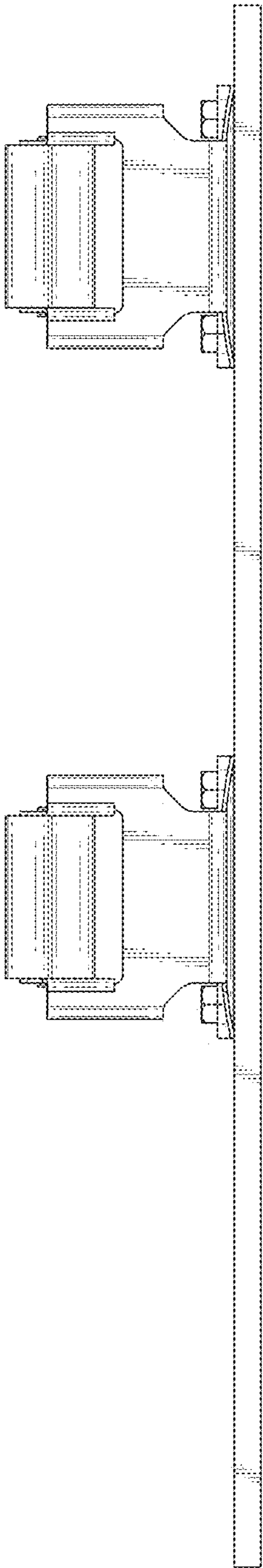

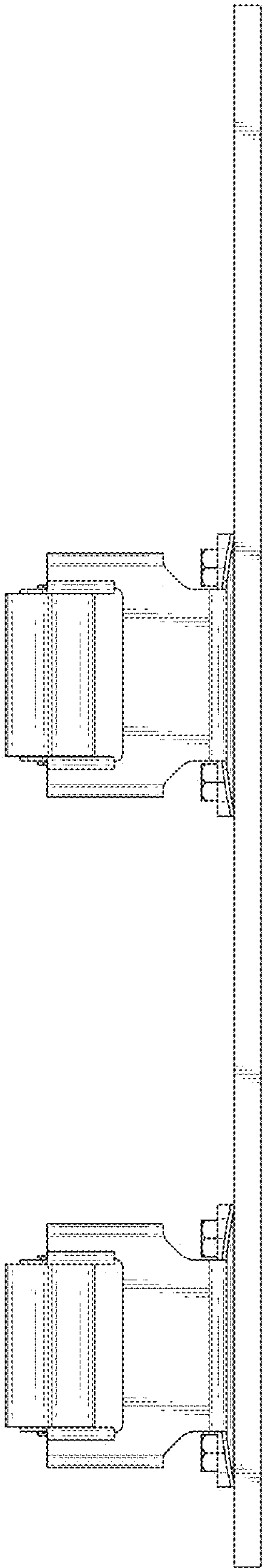

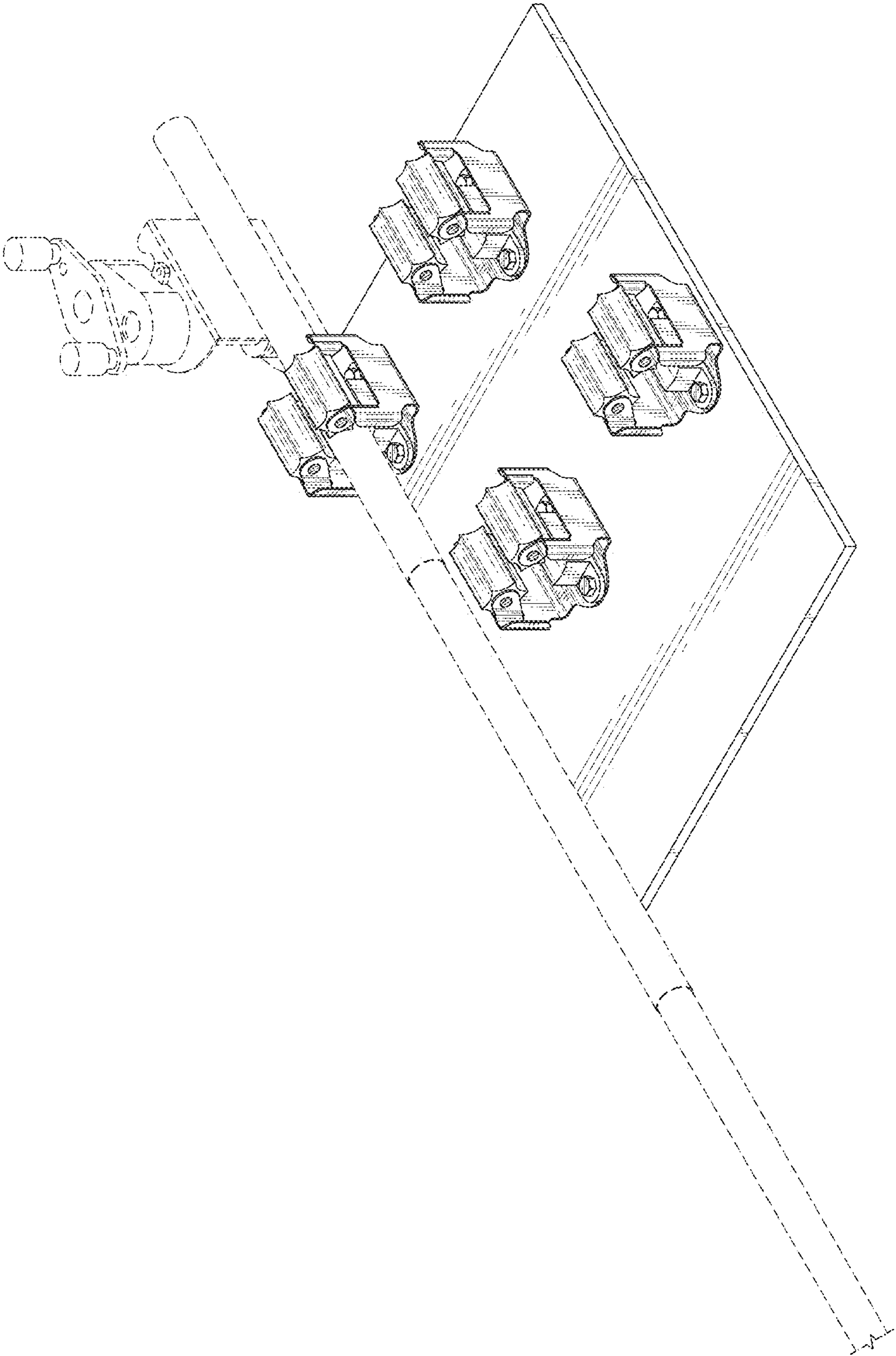
