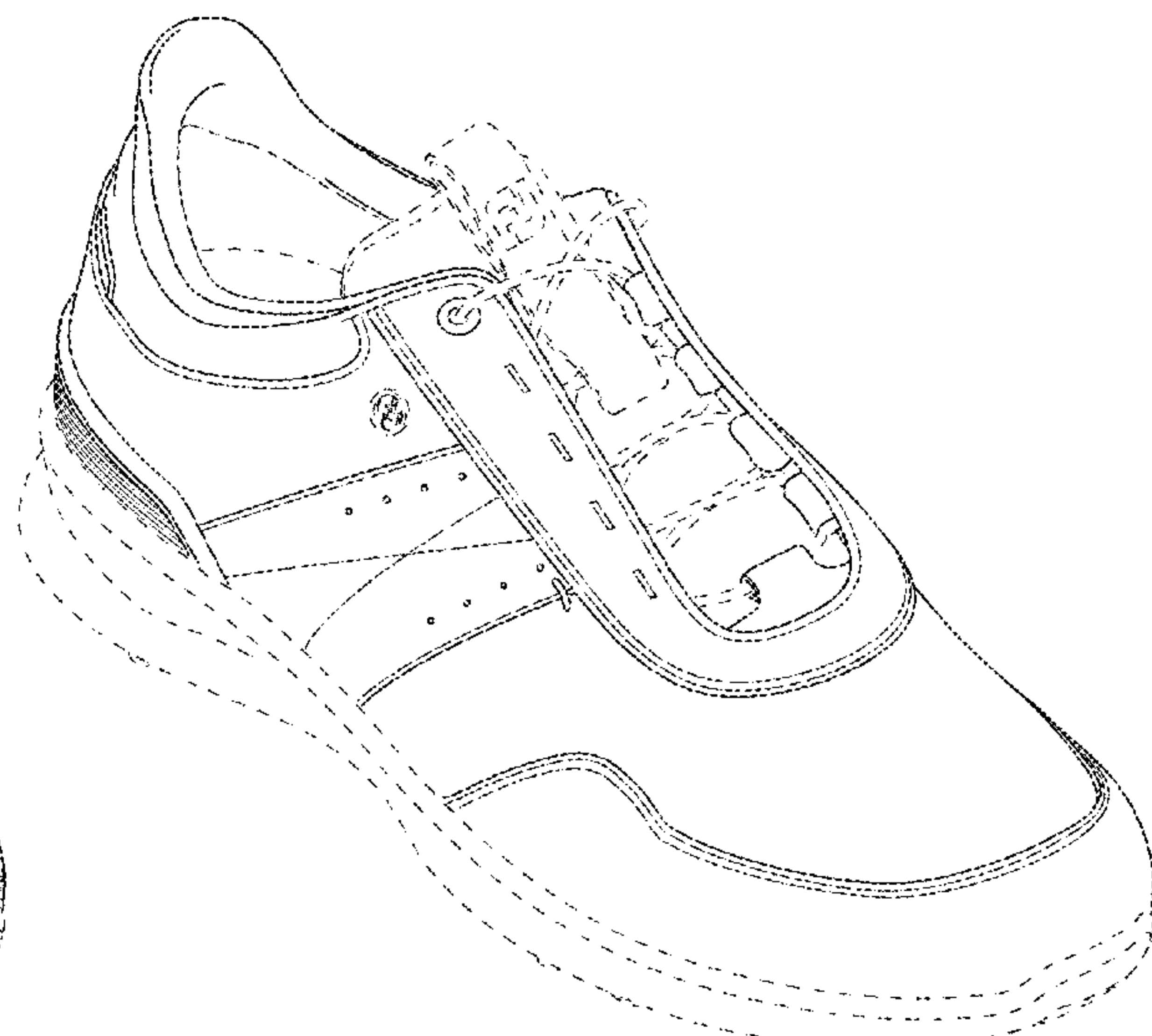
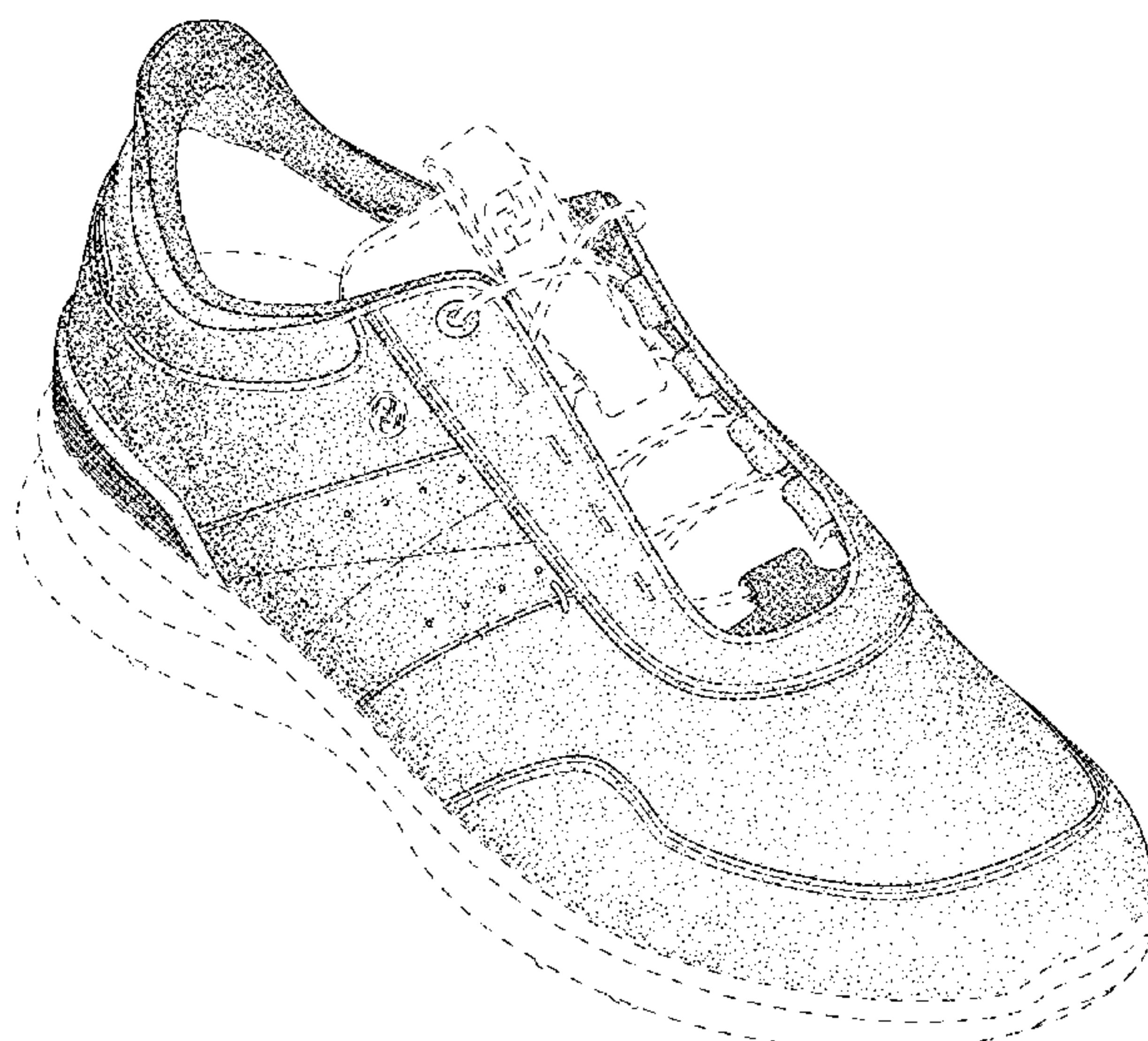
The ornamental design for a golf shoe upper, as shown and described.

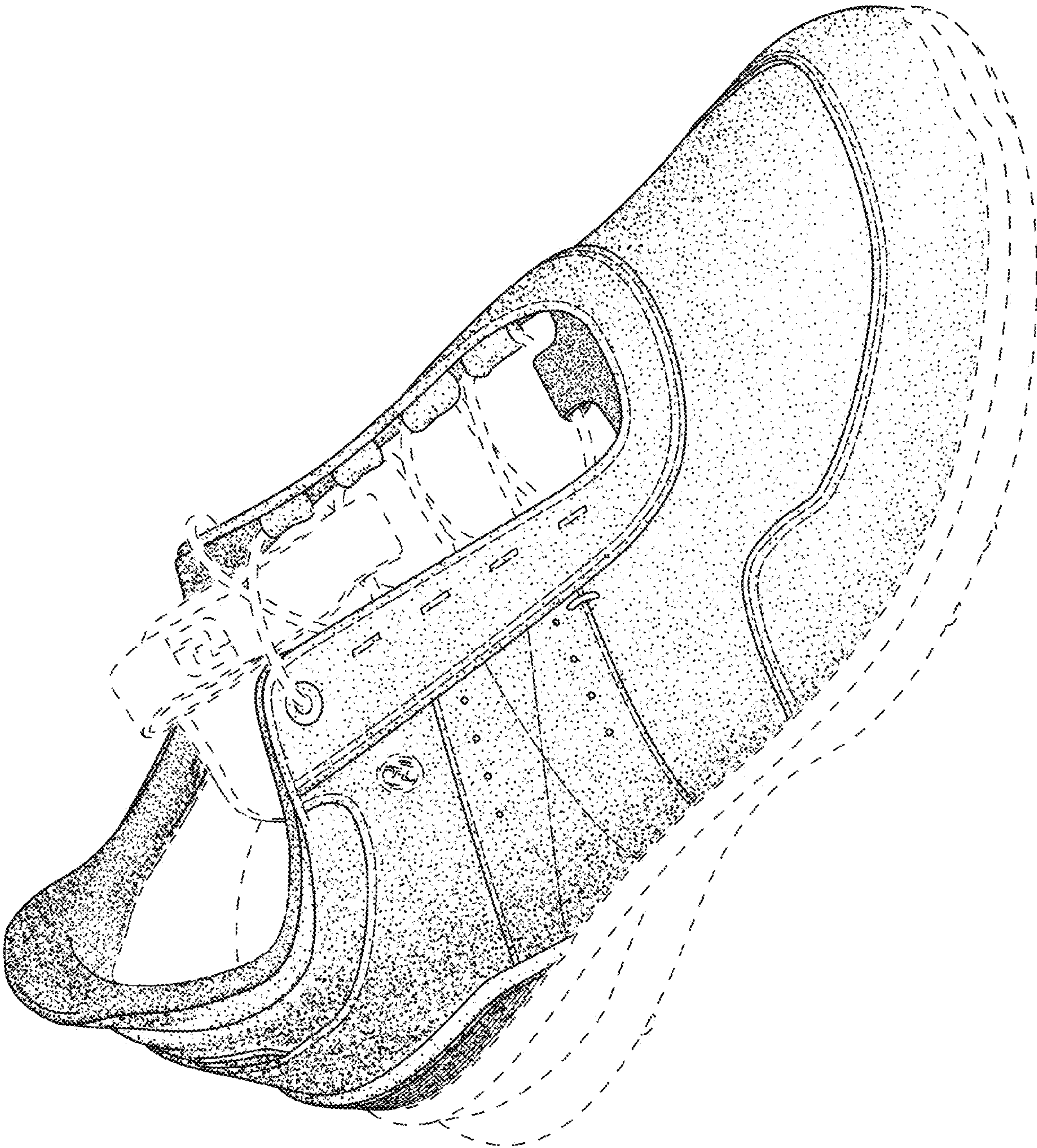

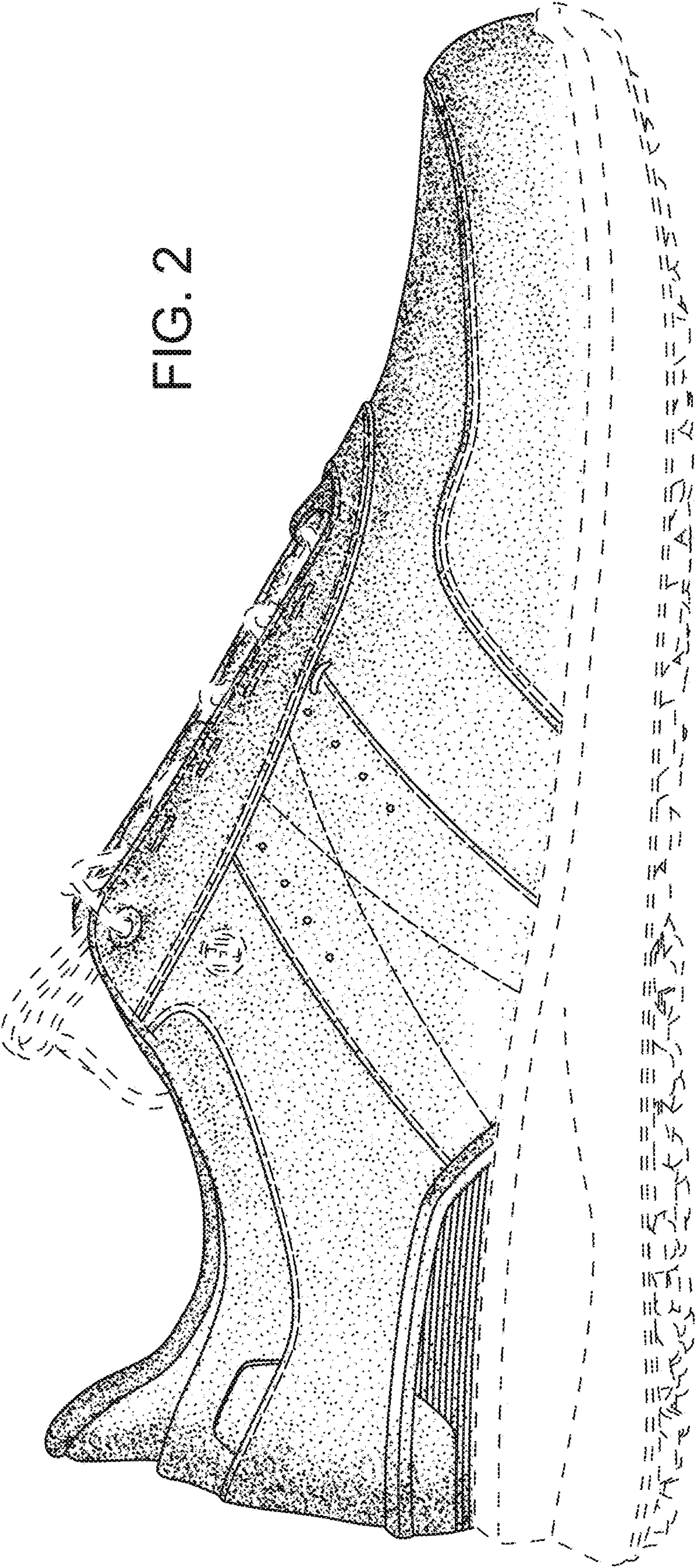

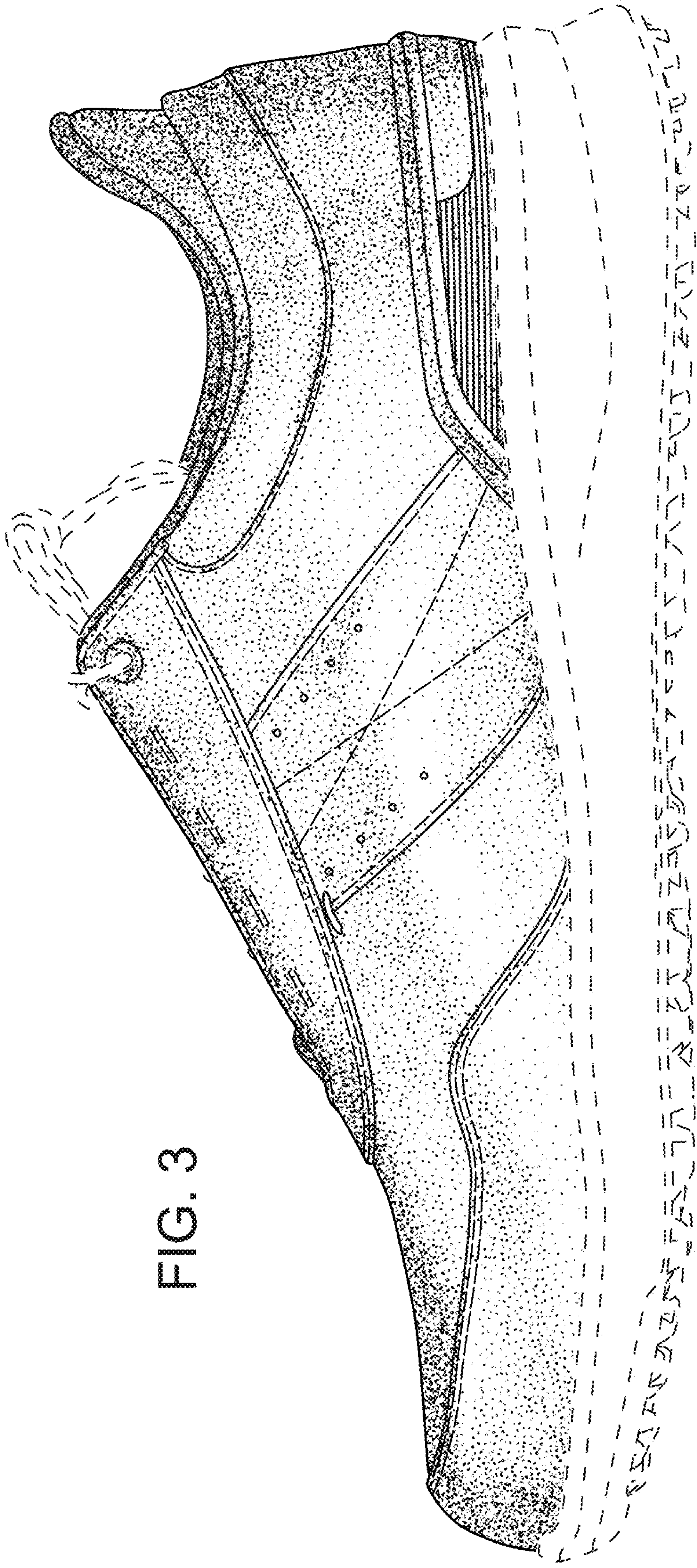

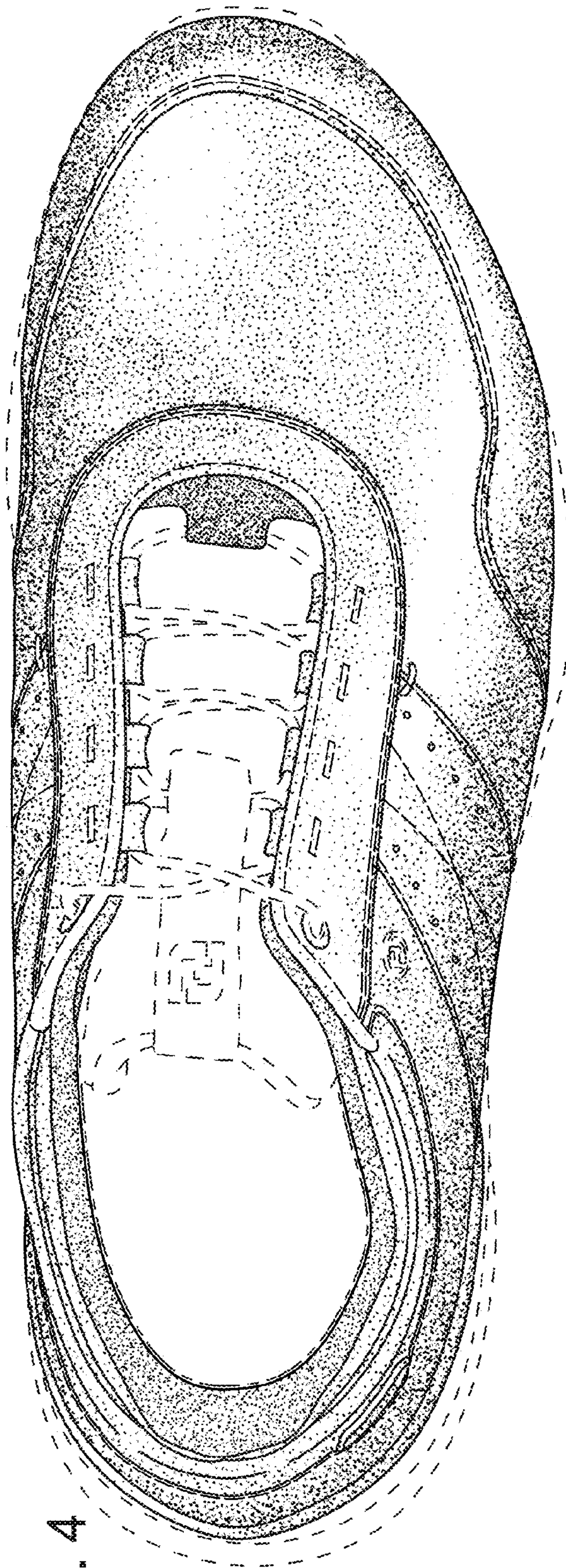

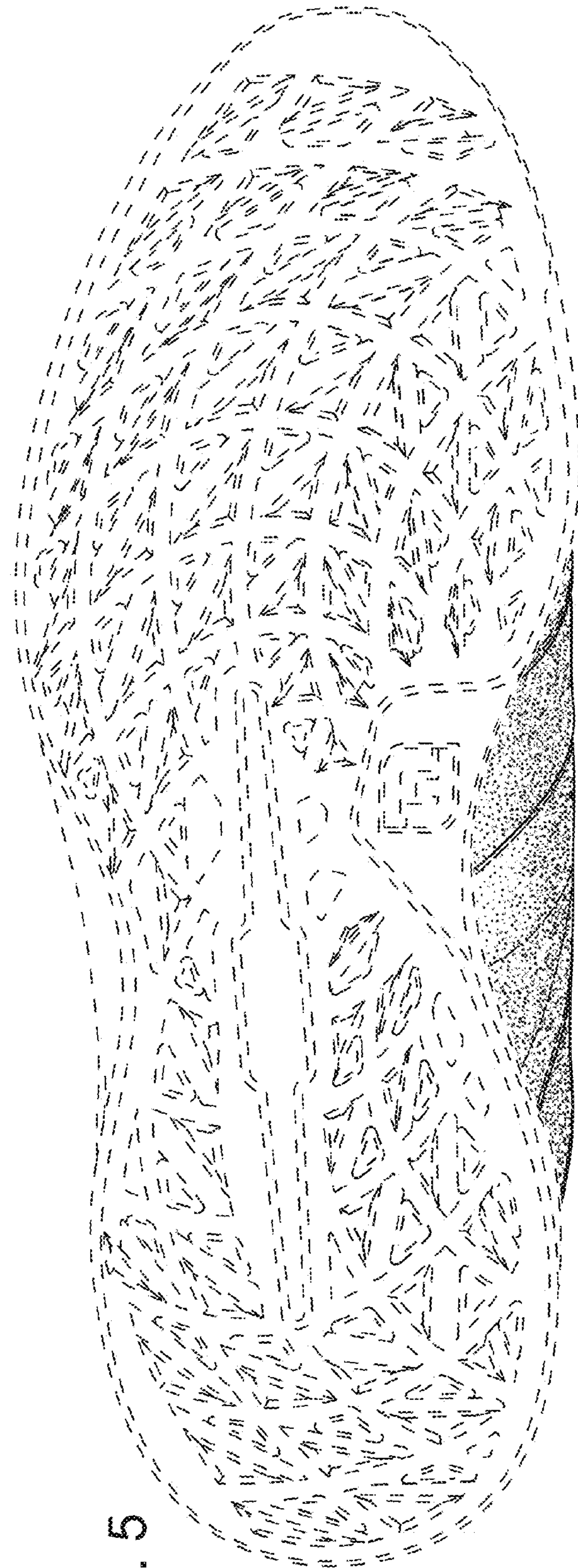

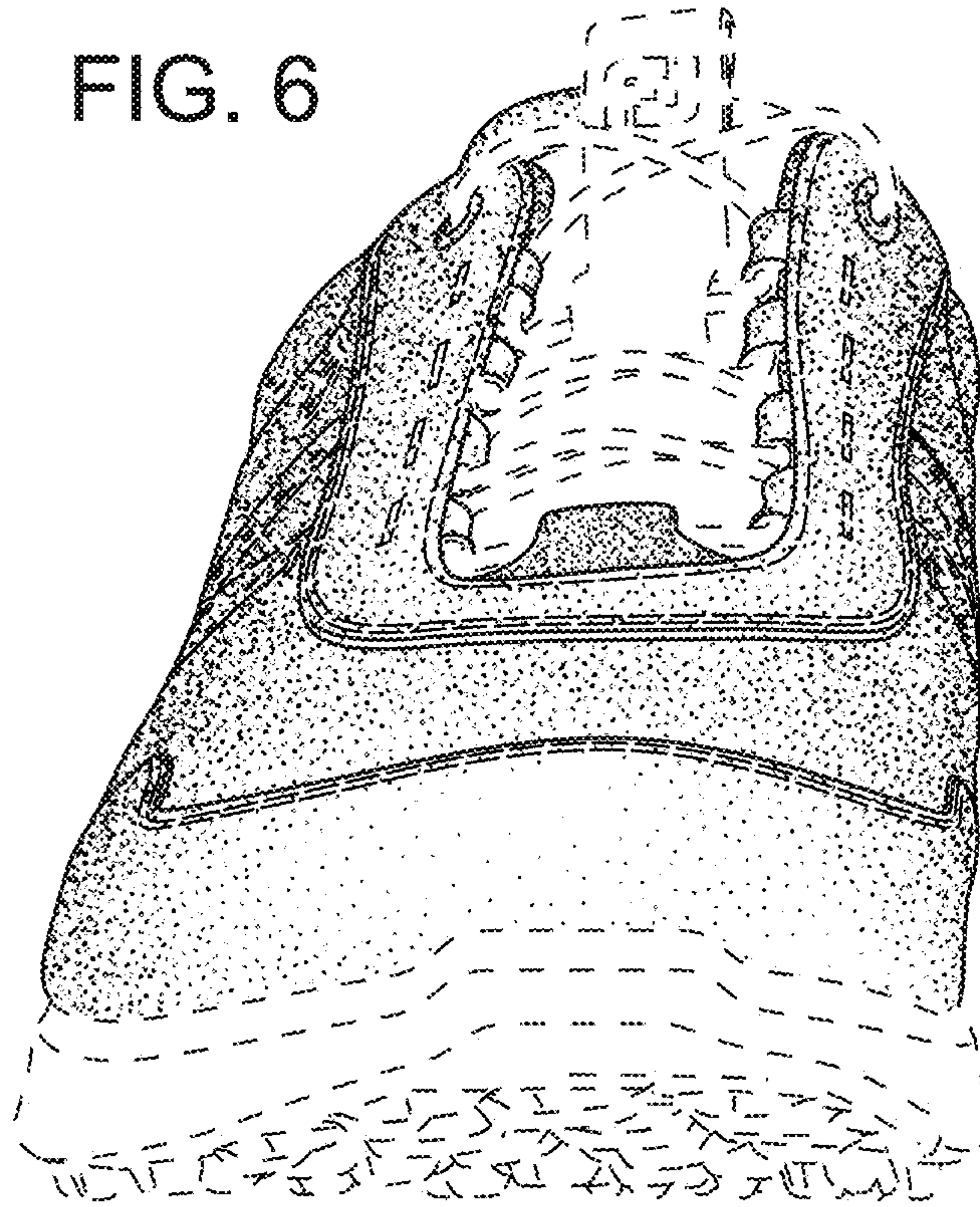
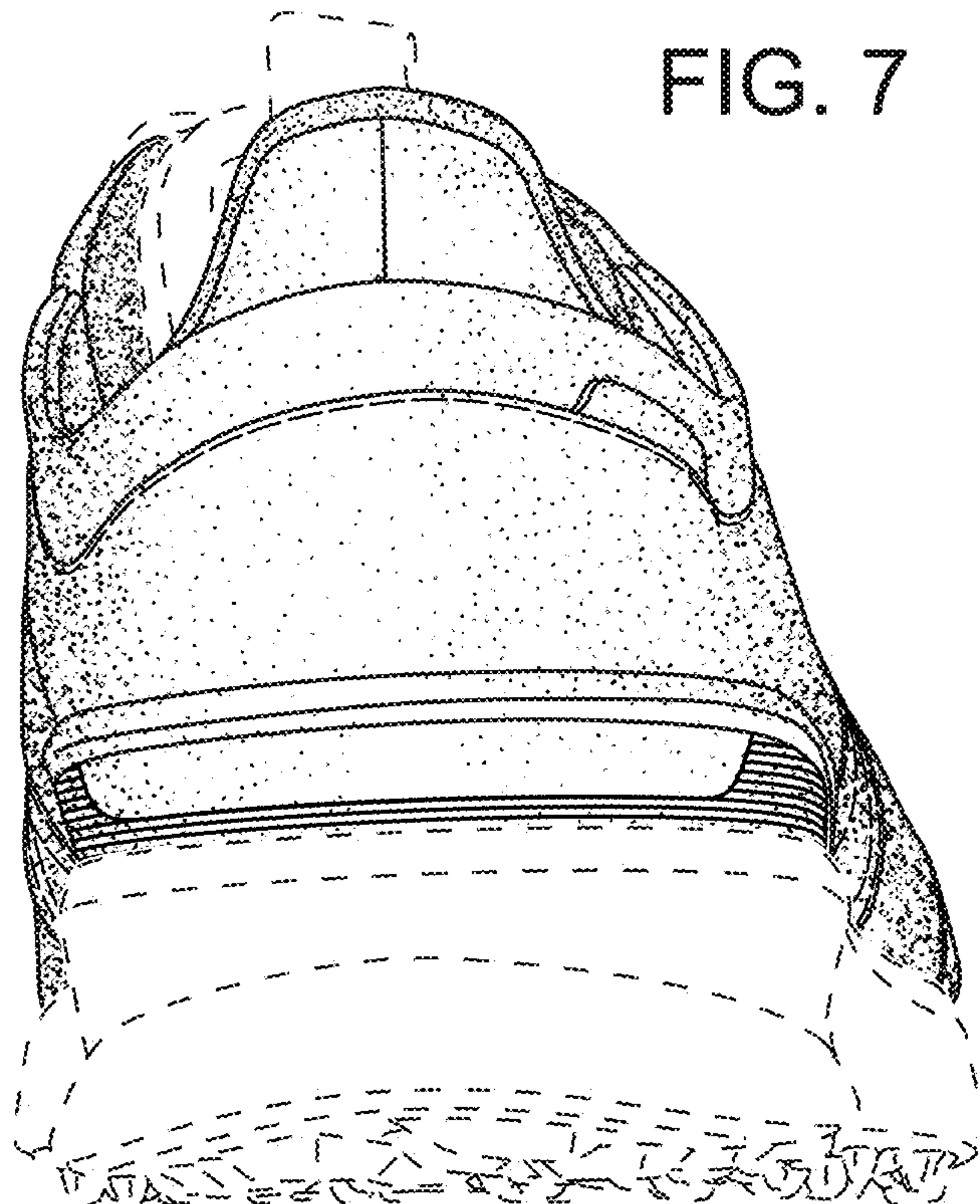

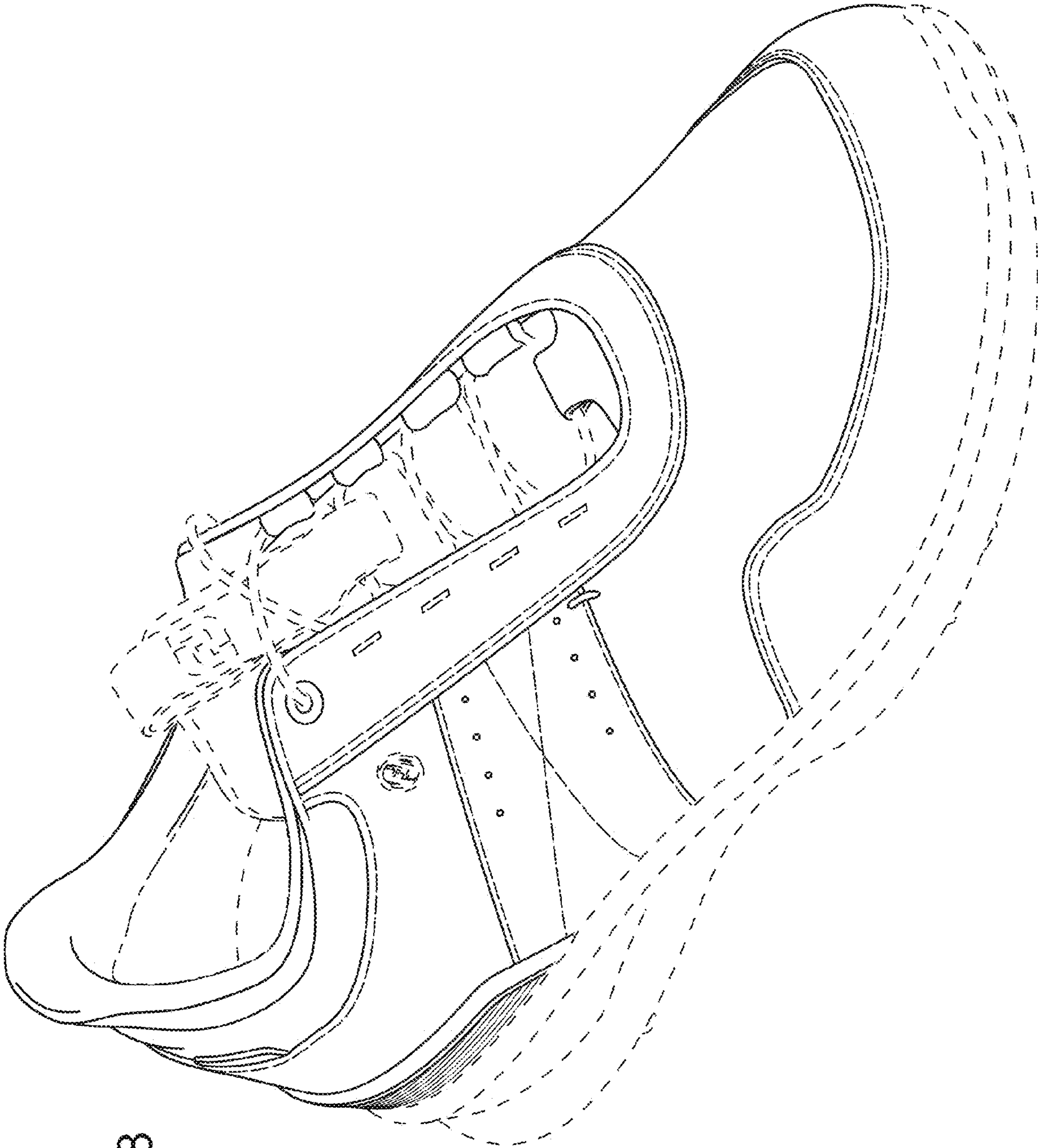

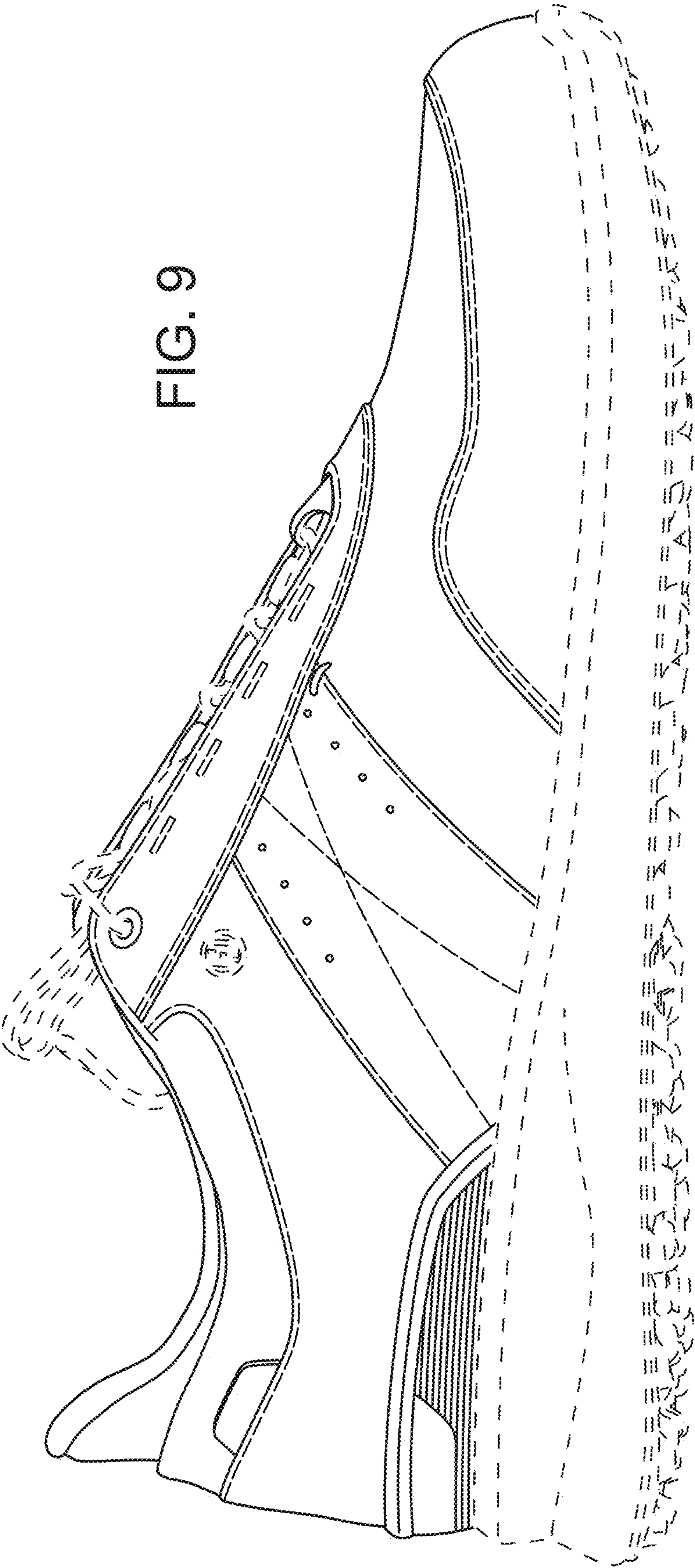

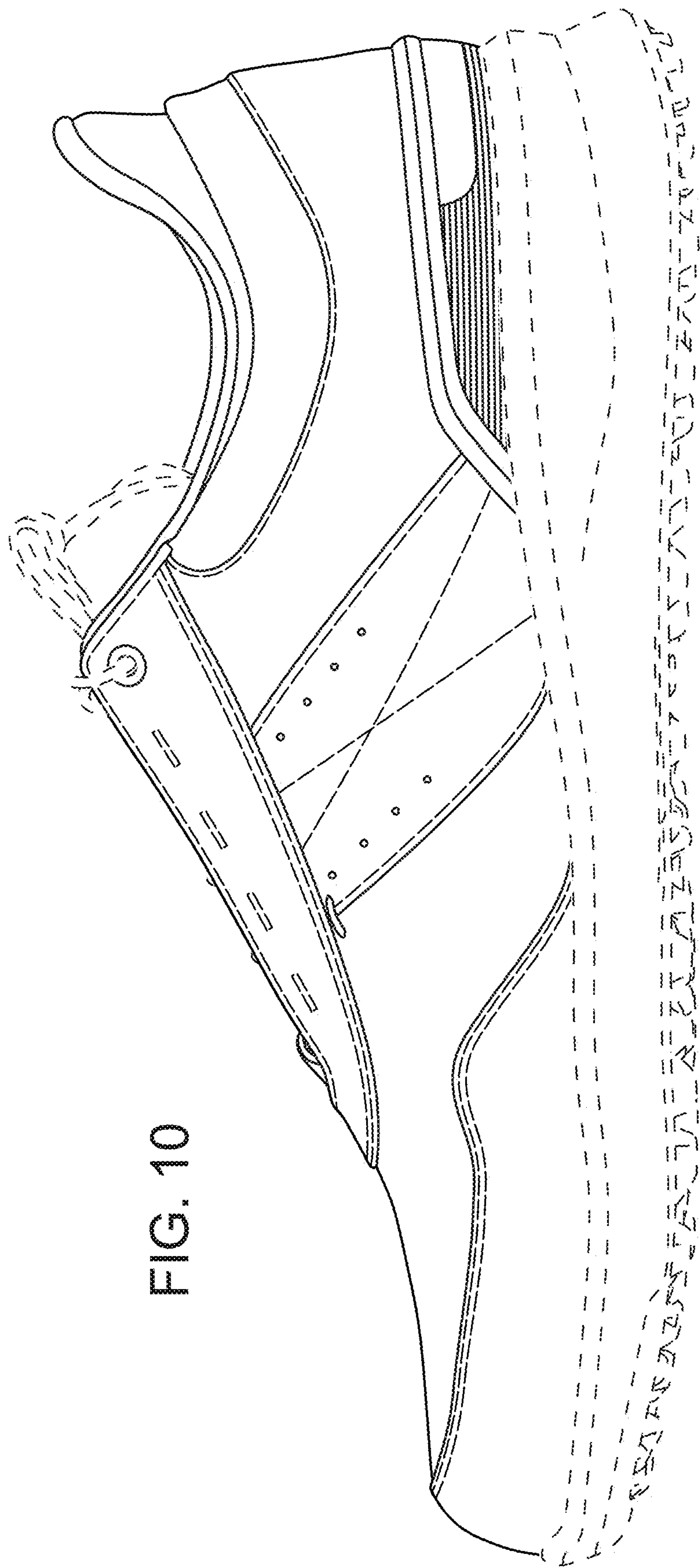

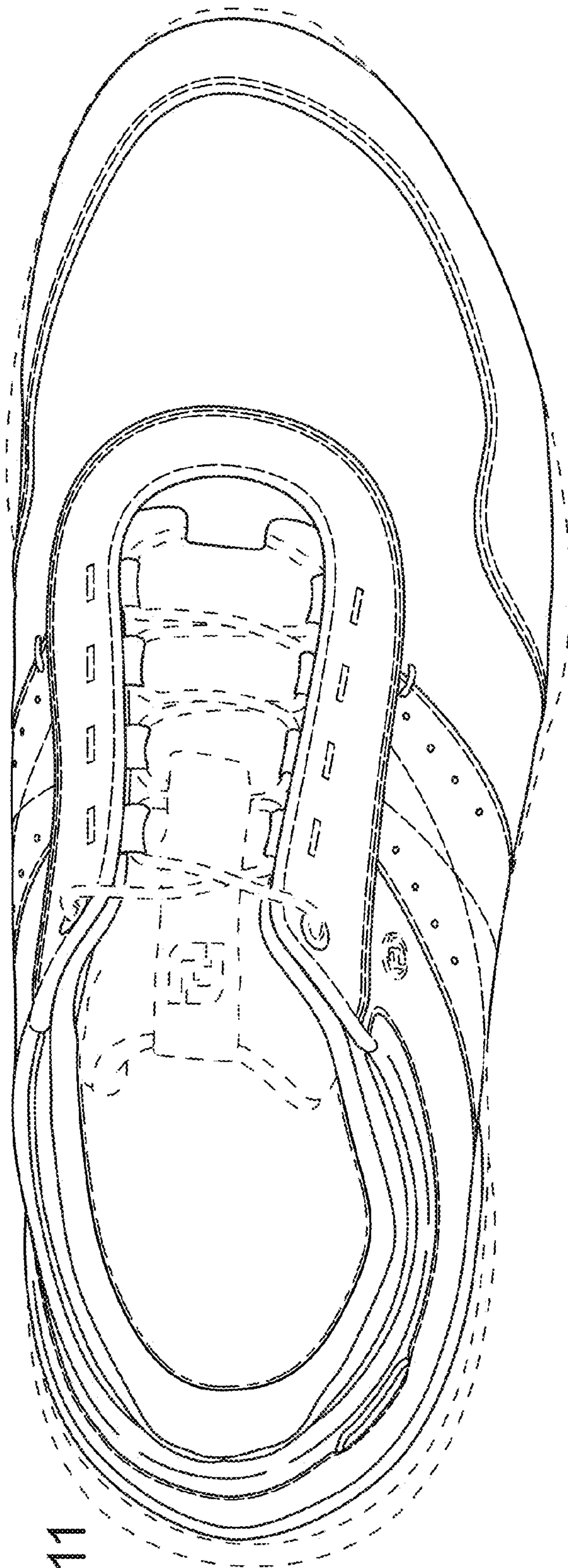

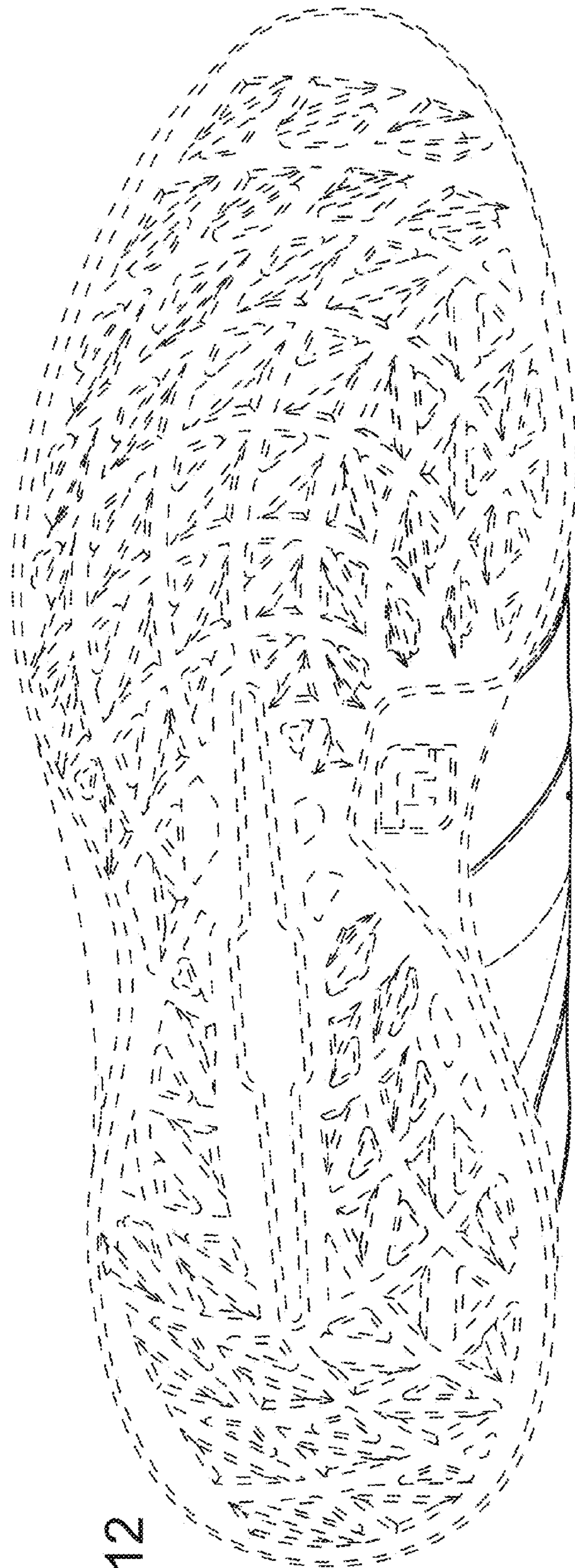

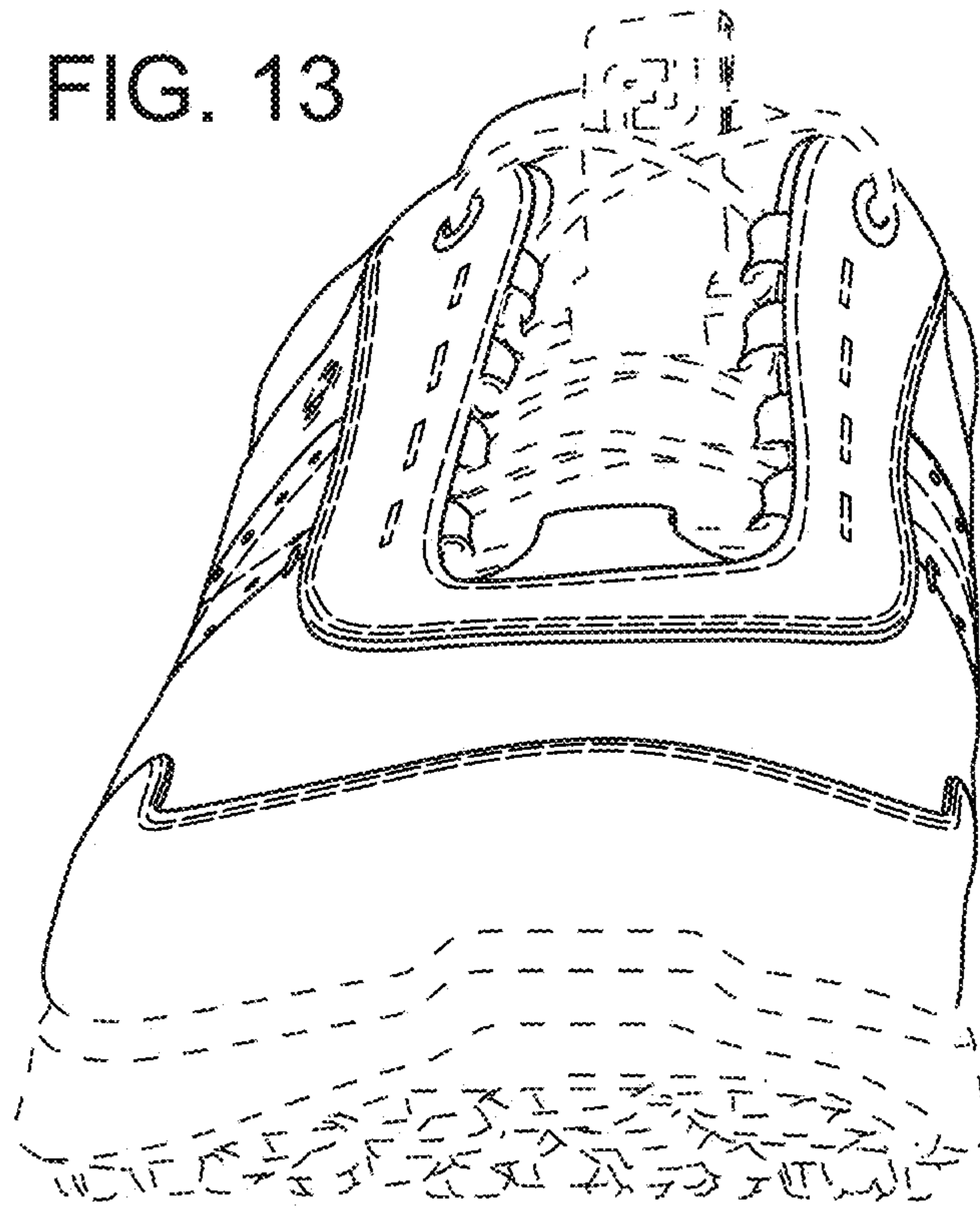
