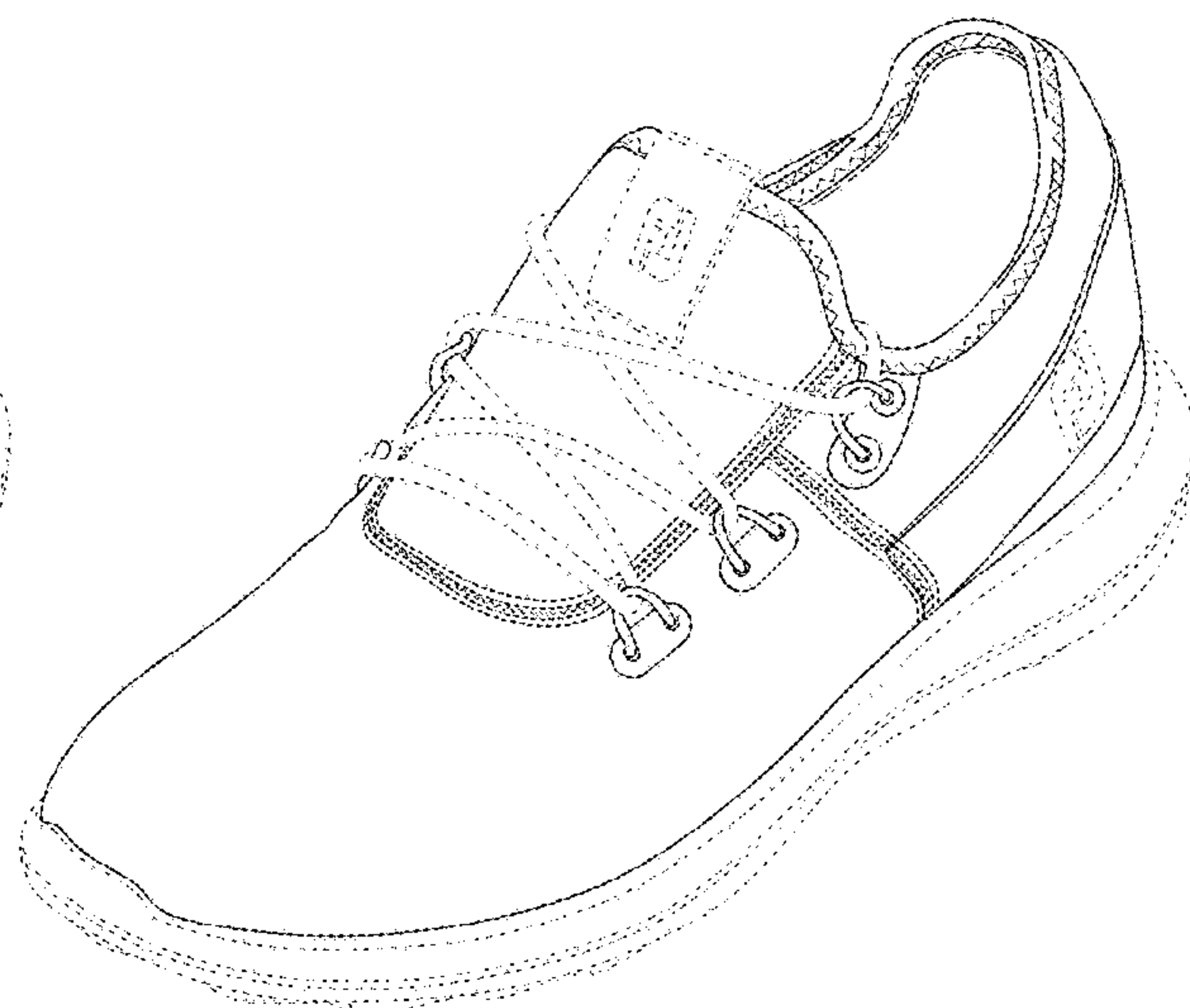
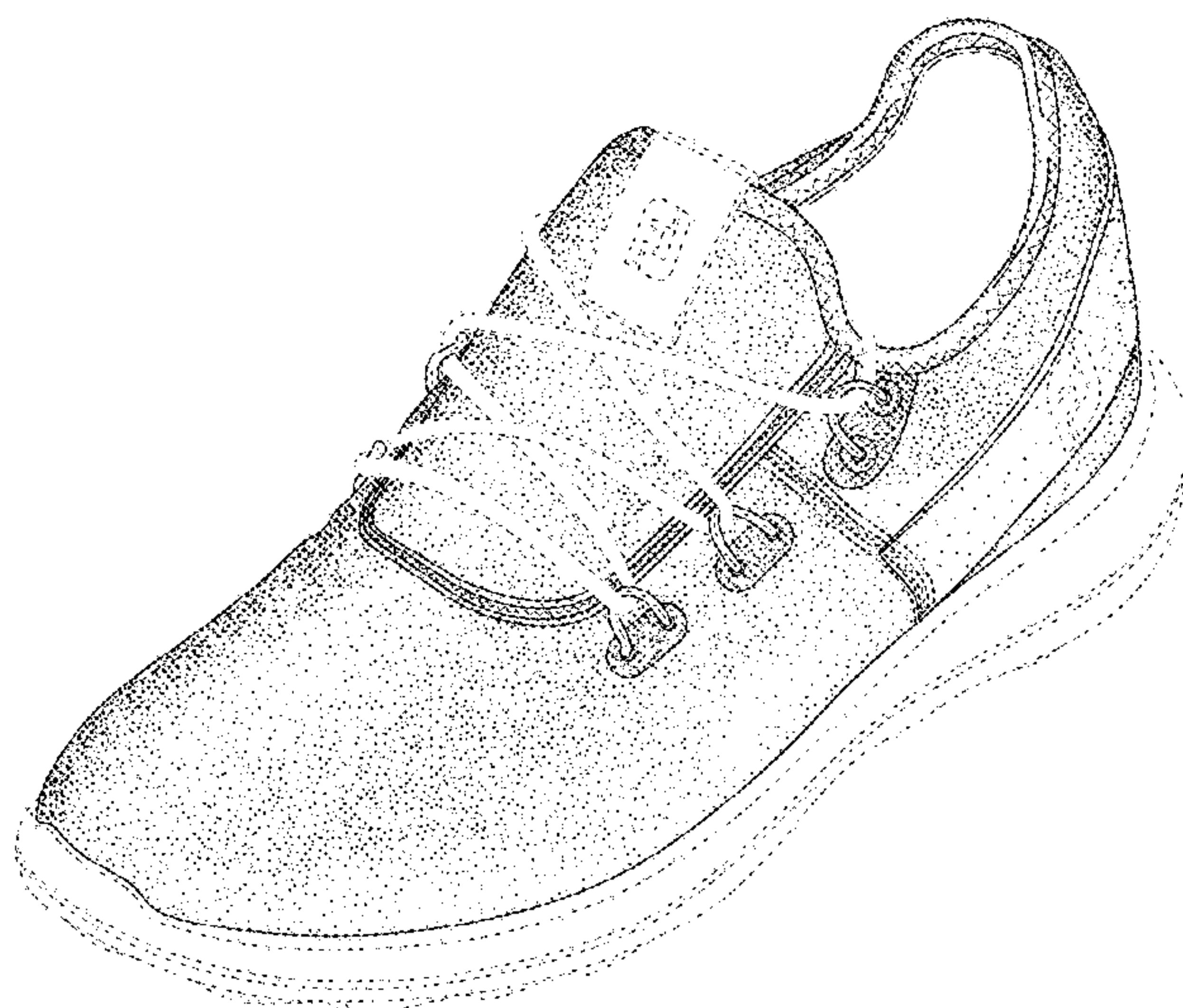
The ornamental design for a golf shoe upper, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a first embodiment of a golf shoe upper, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a medial side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a lateral side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view of thereof;  
 FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
 FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of a golf shoe upper, showing my new design;  
 FIG. 9 is a medial side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 10 is a lateral side elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 11 is a front elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 12 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
 FIG. 13 is a top plan view thereof; and,  
 FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view thereof.

In FIGS. 1-14, the broken lines on the top surface of the shoe form no part of the claimed design. Also, the broken lines showing a shoe outsole including logo and traction members on the bottom surface of the shoe form no part of the claimed design.

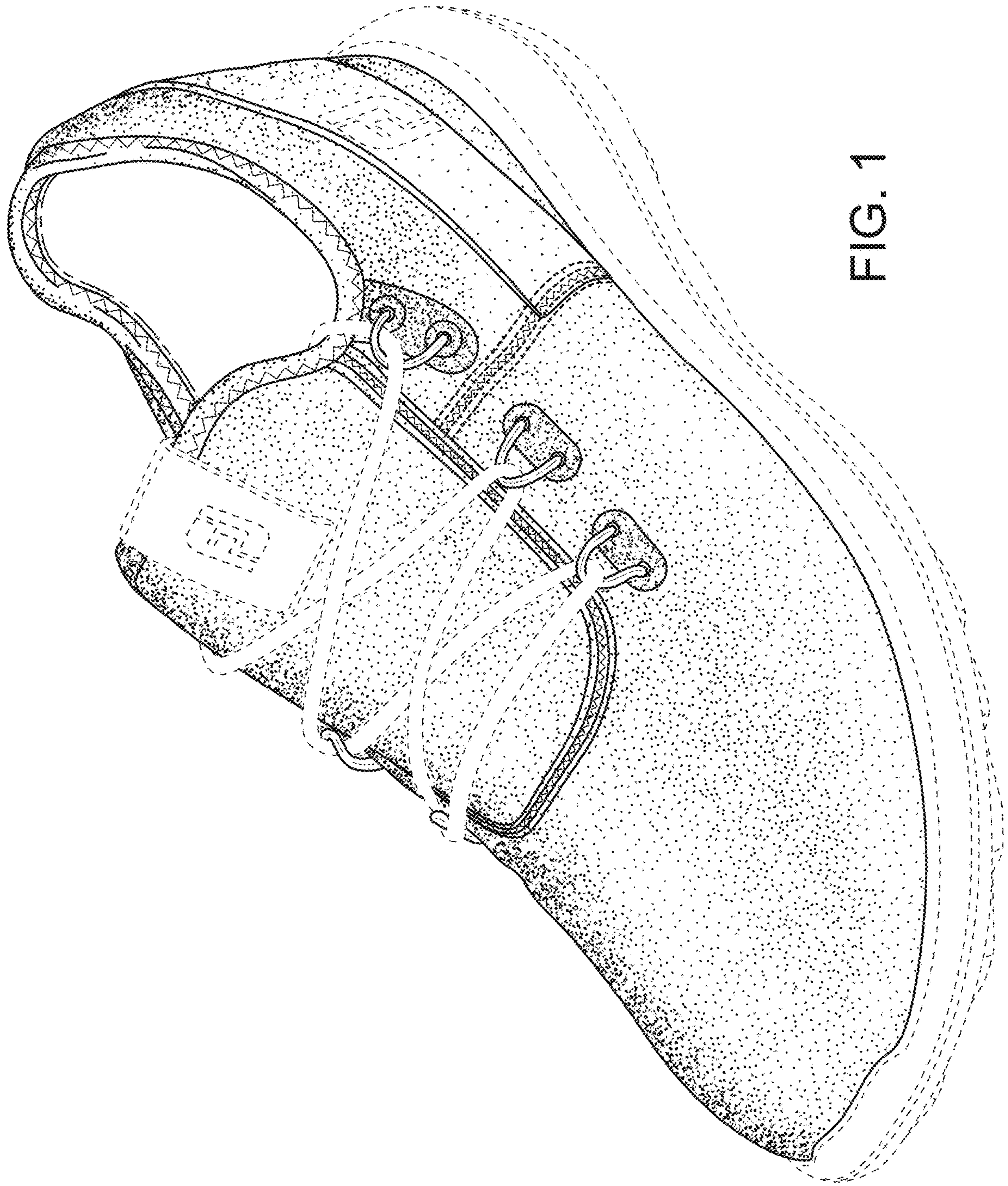

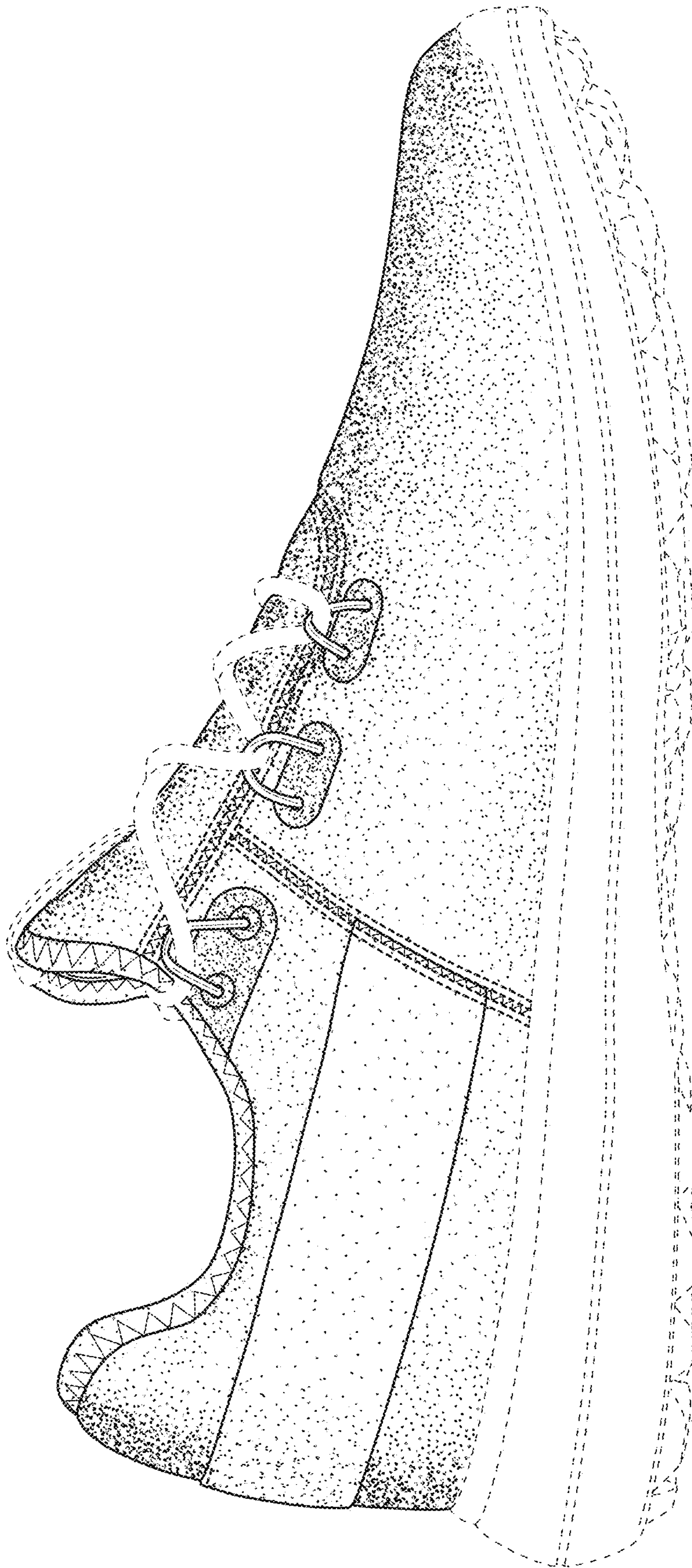

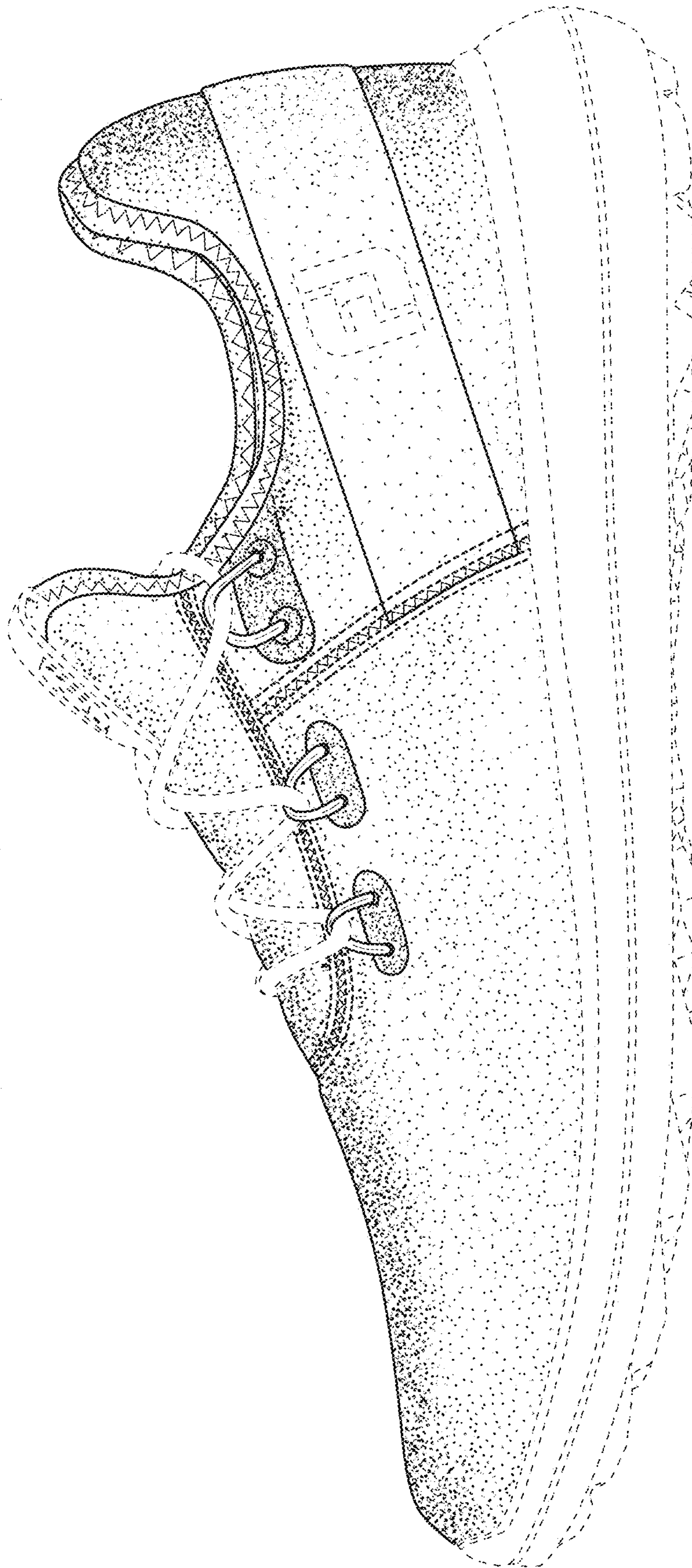

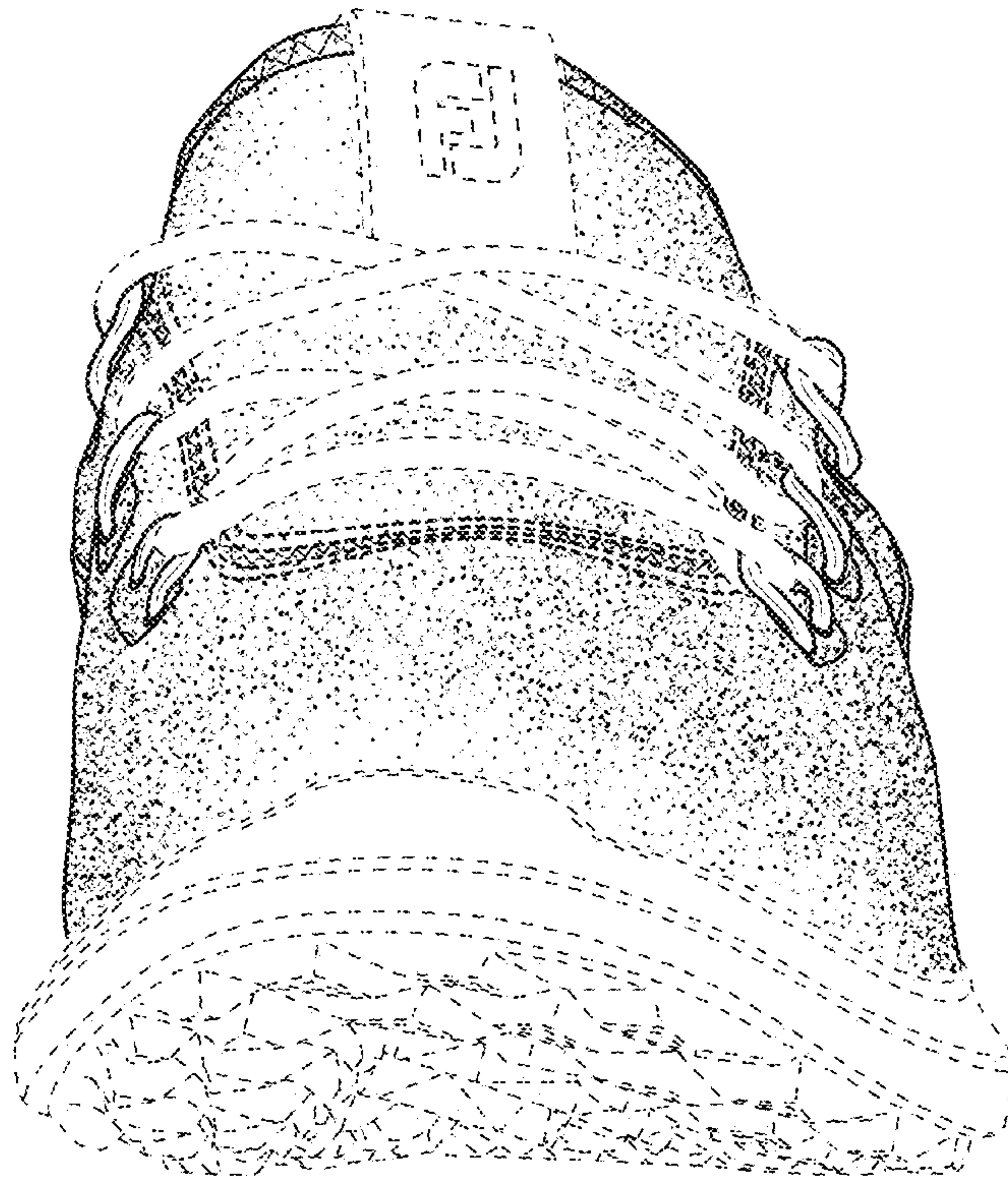

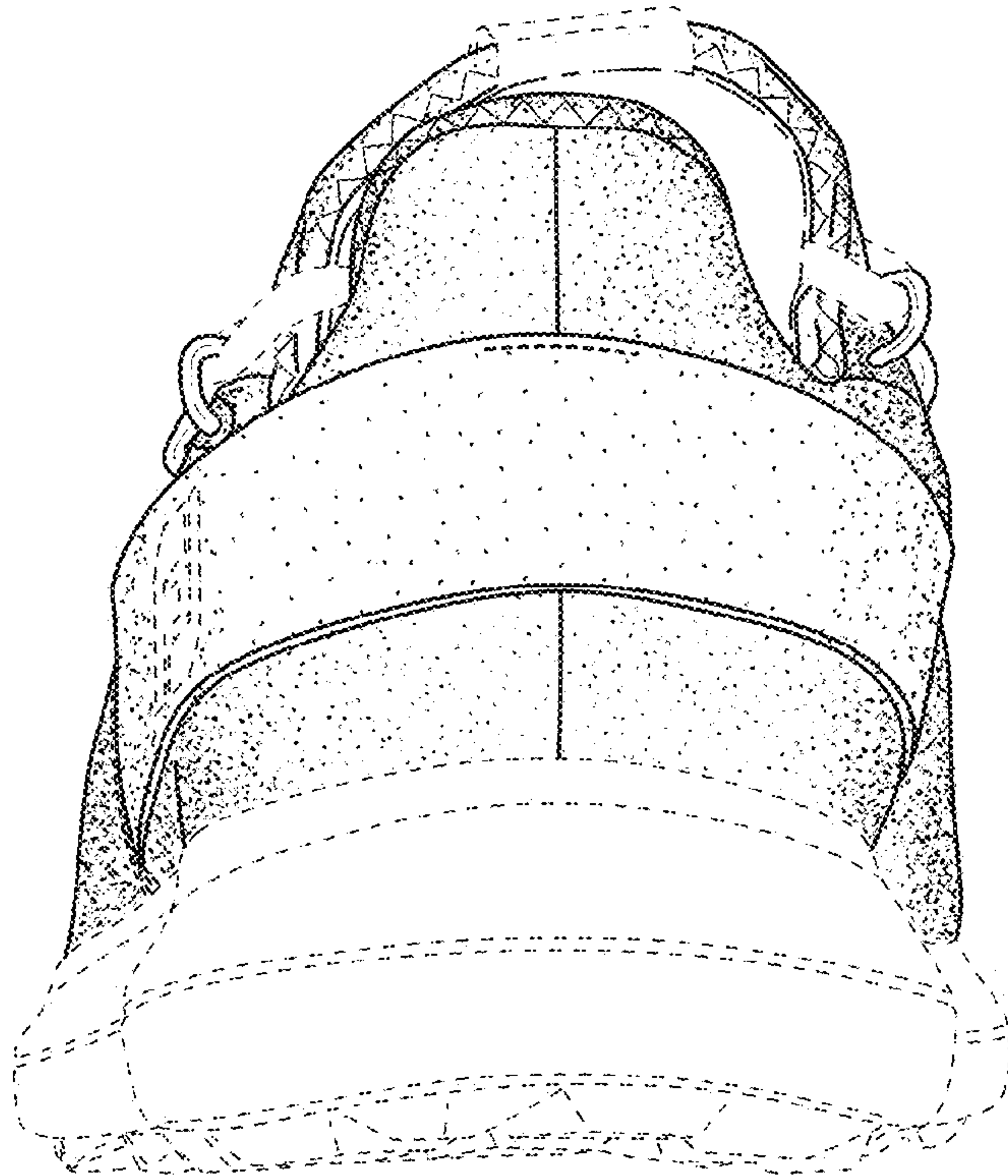

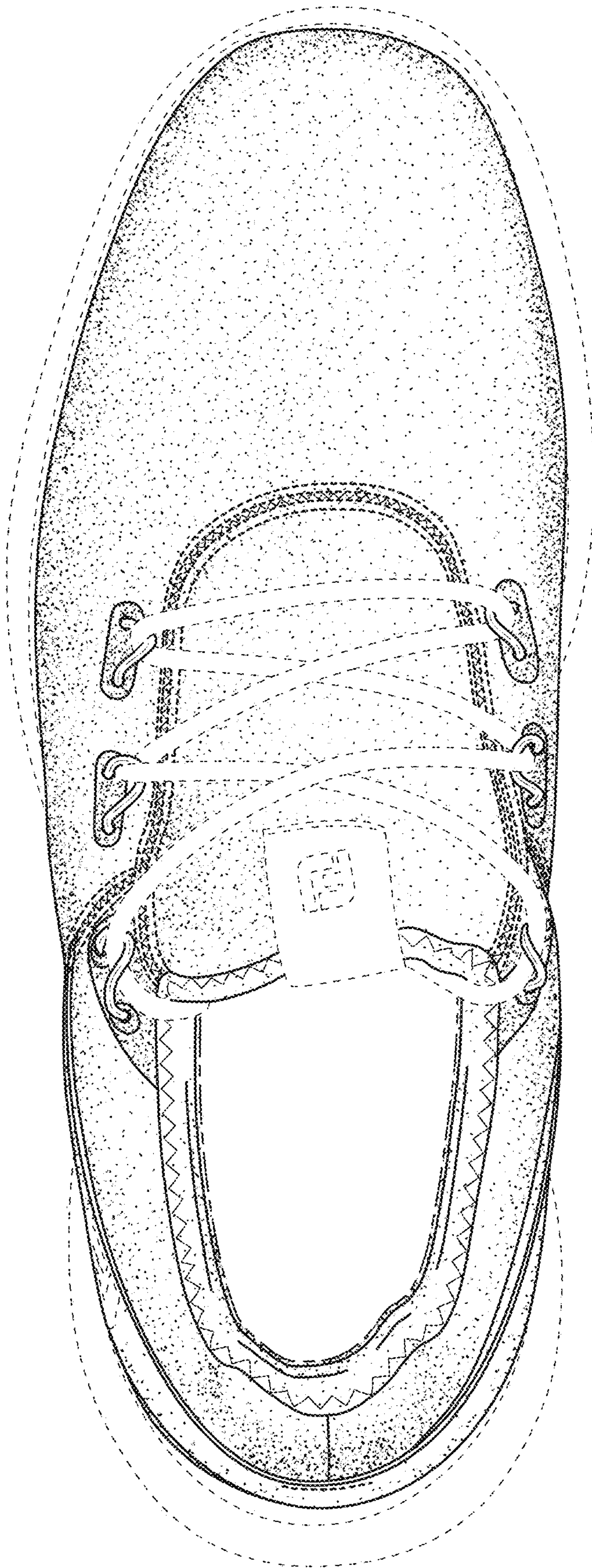

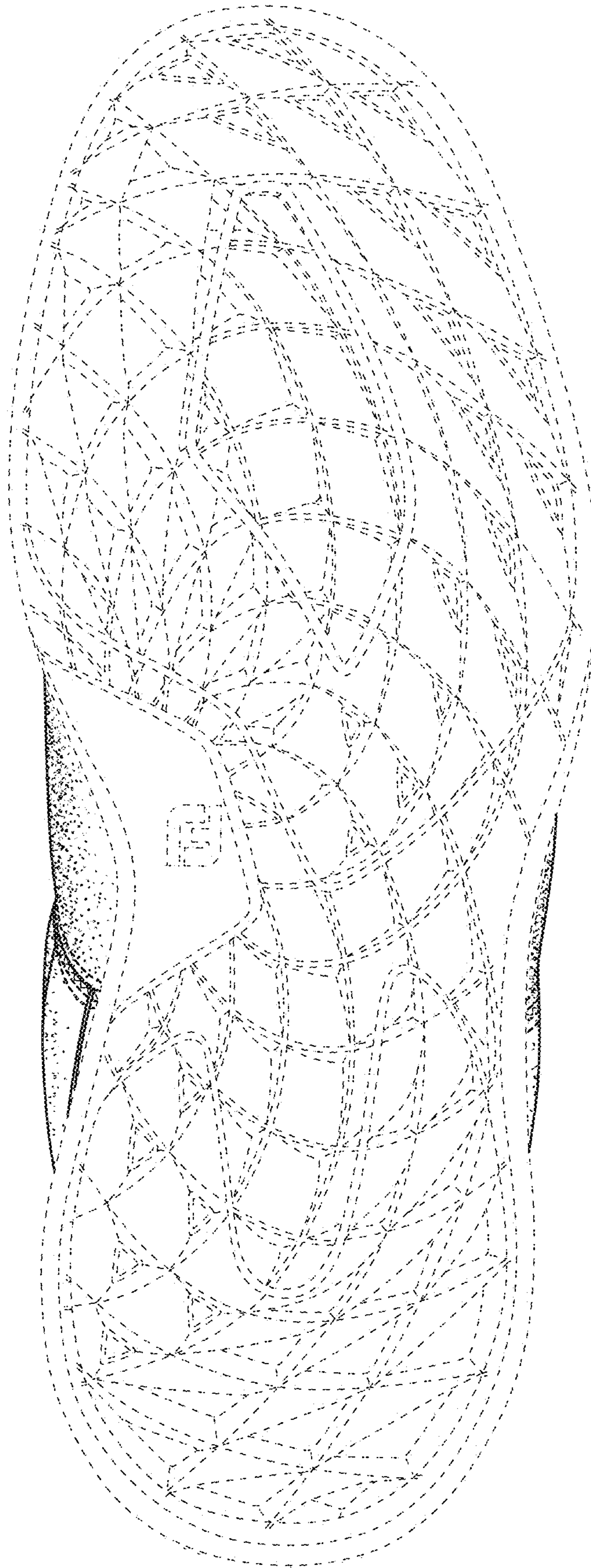

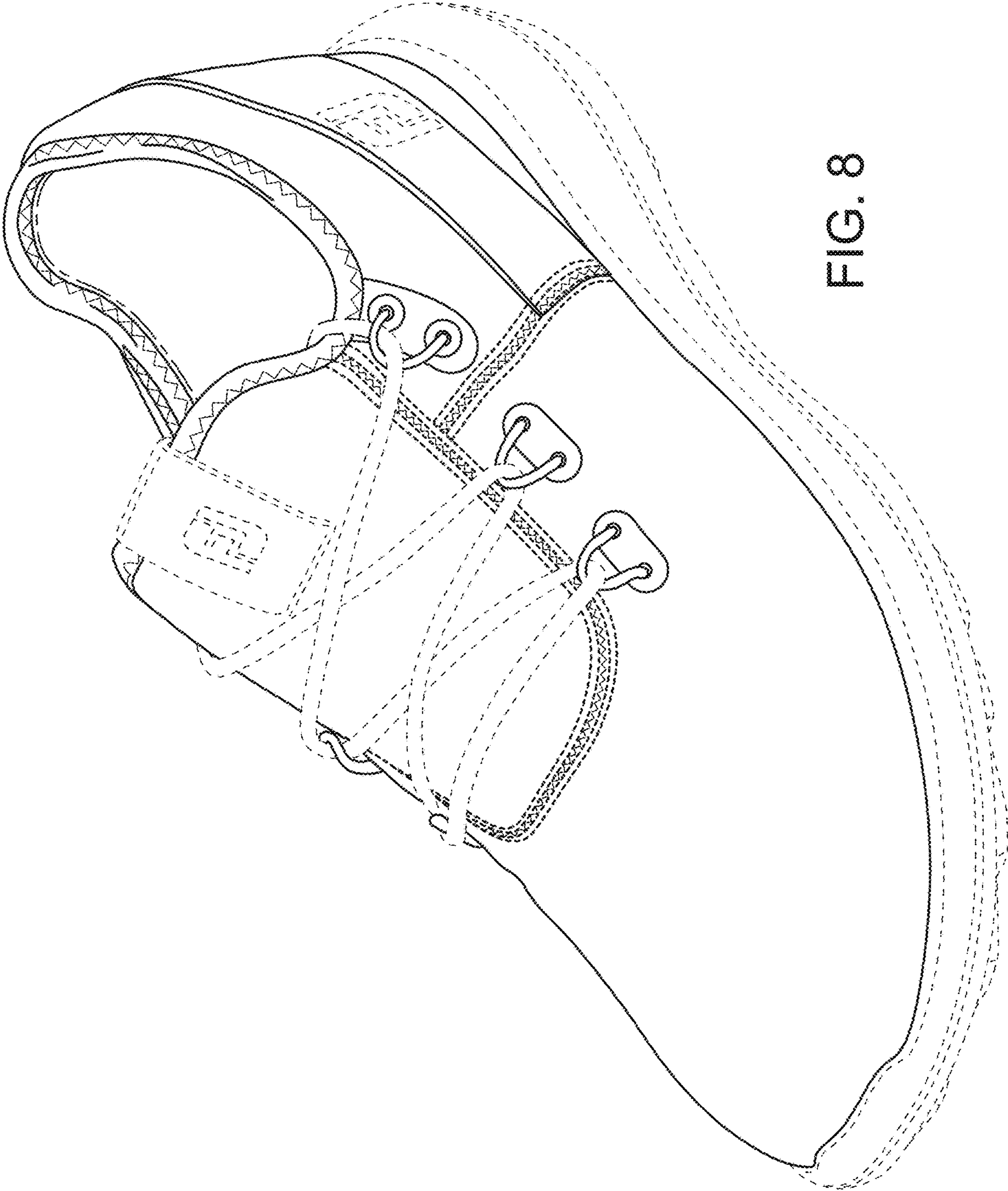

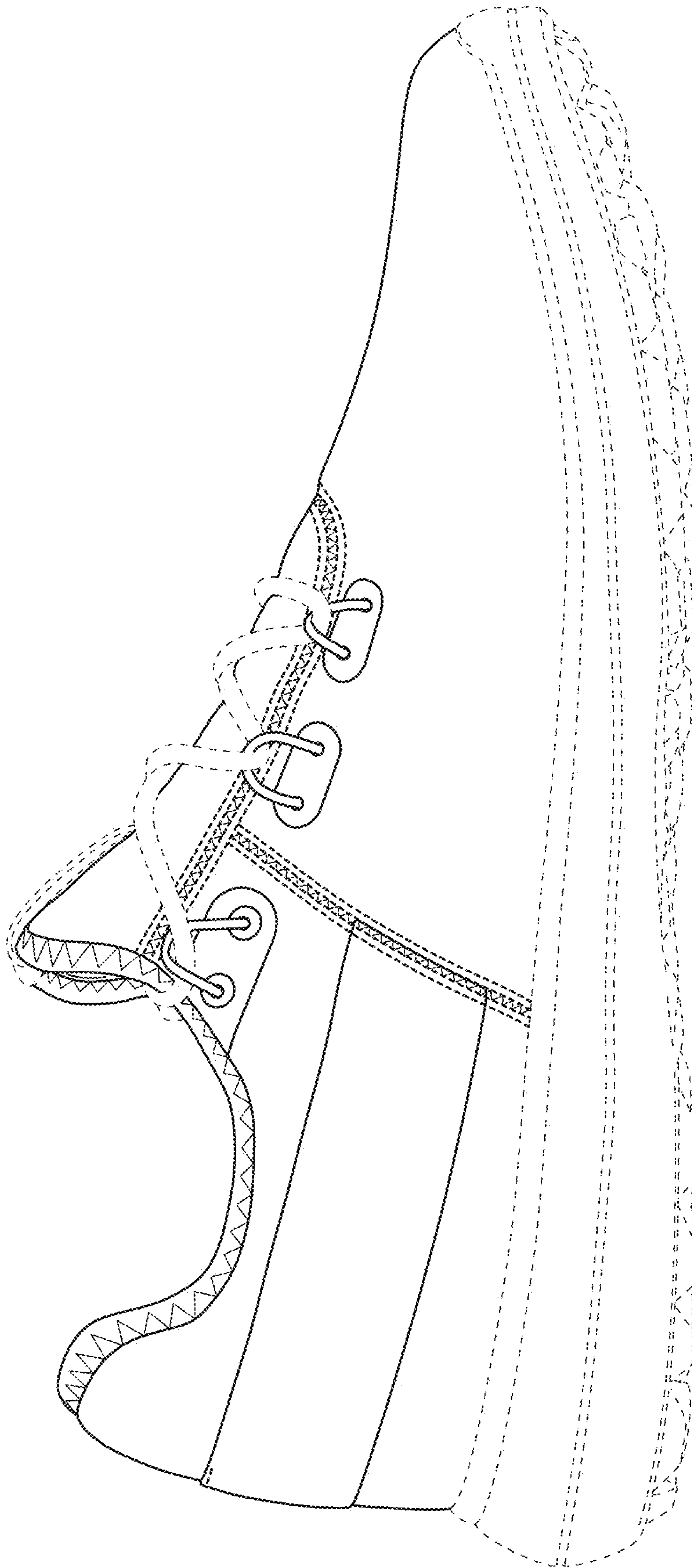

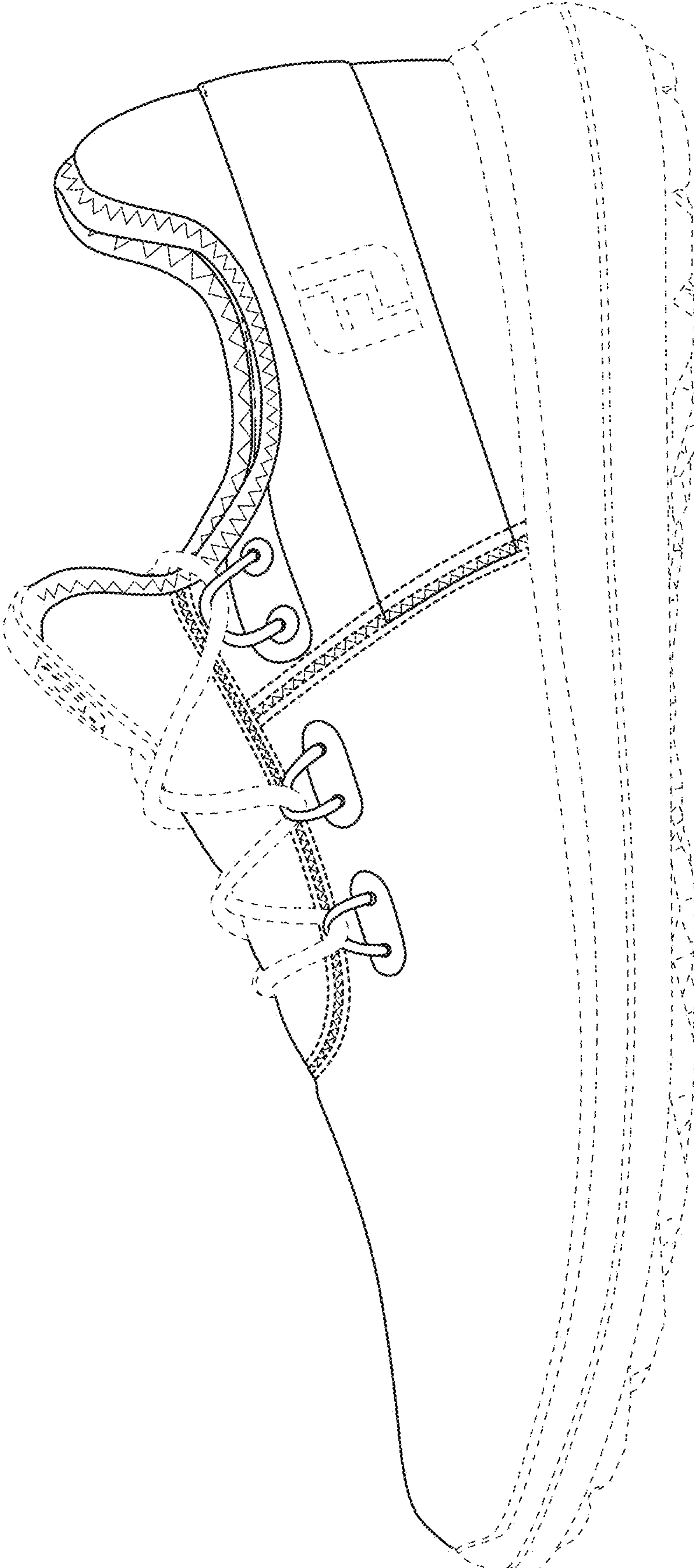

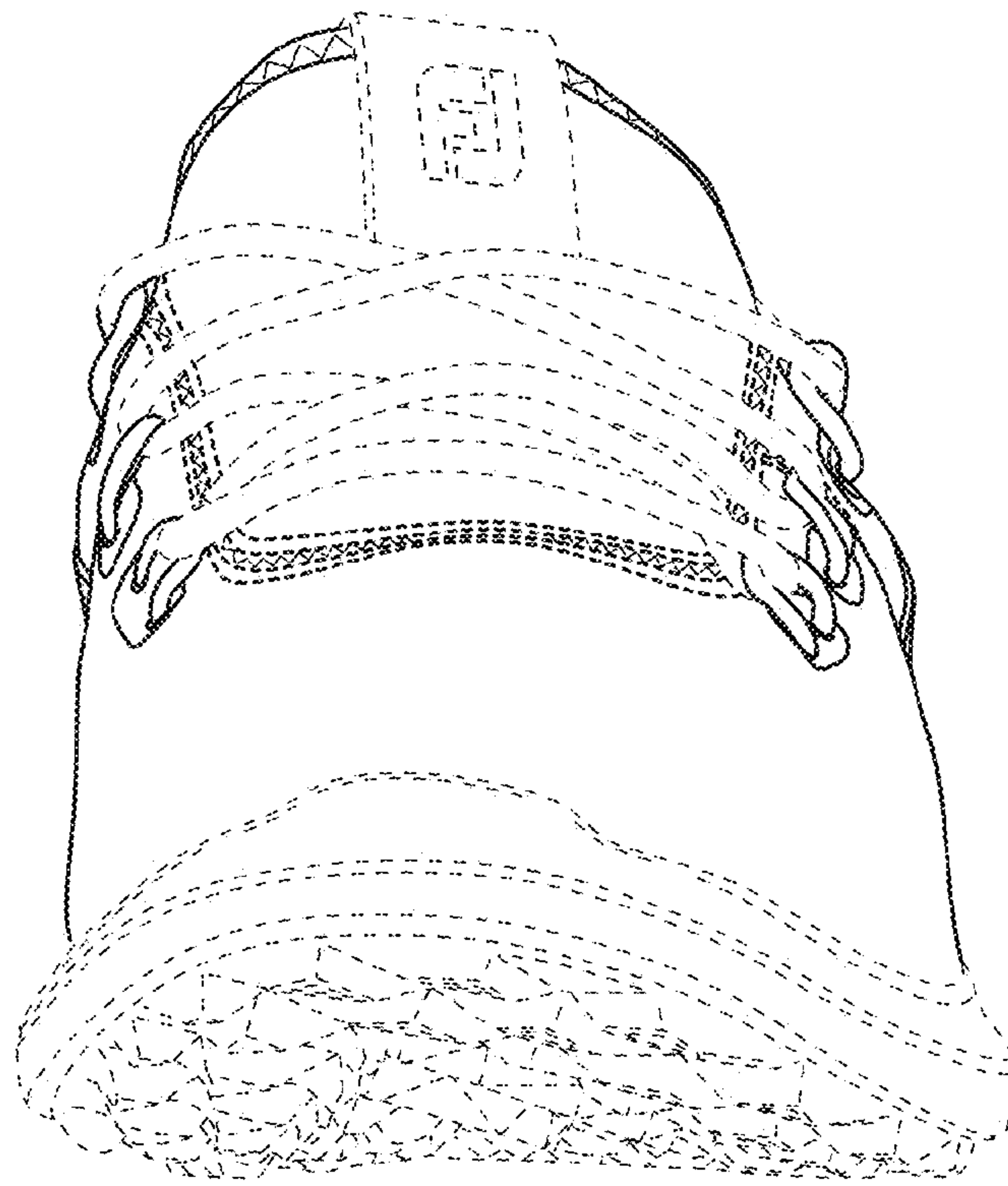

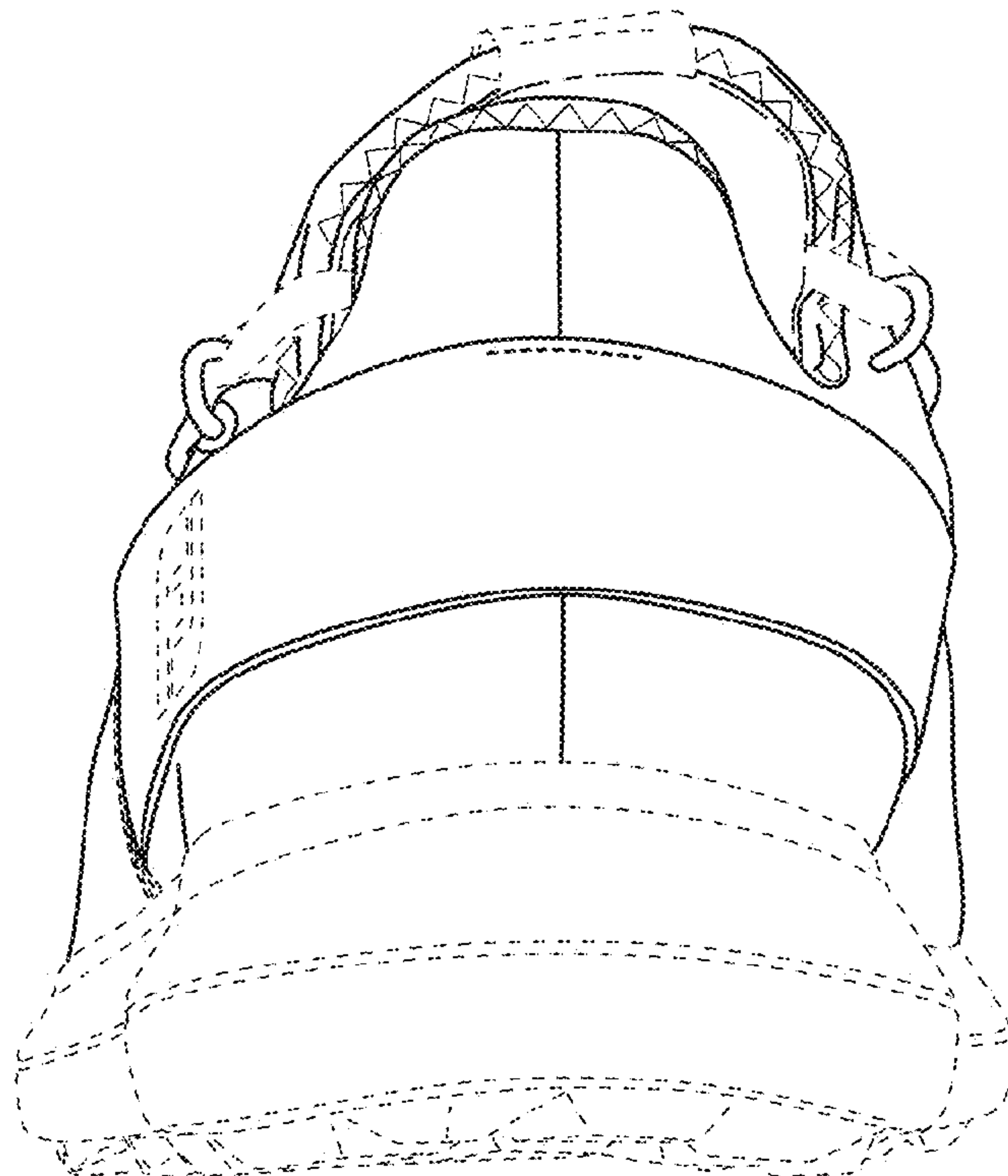

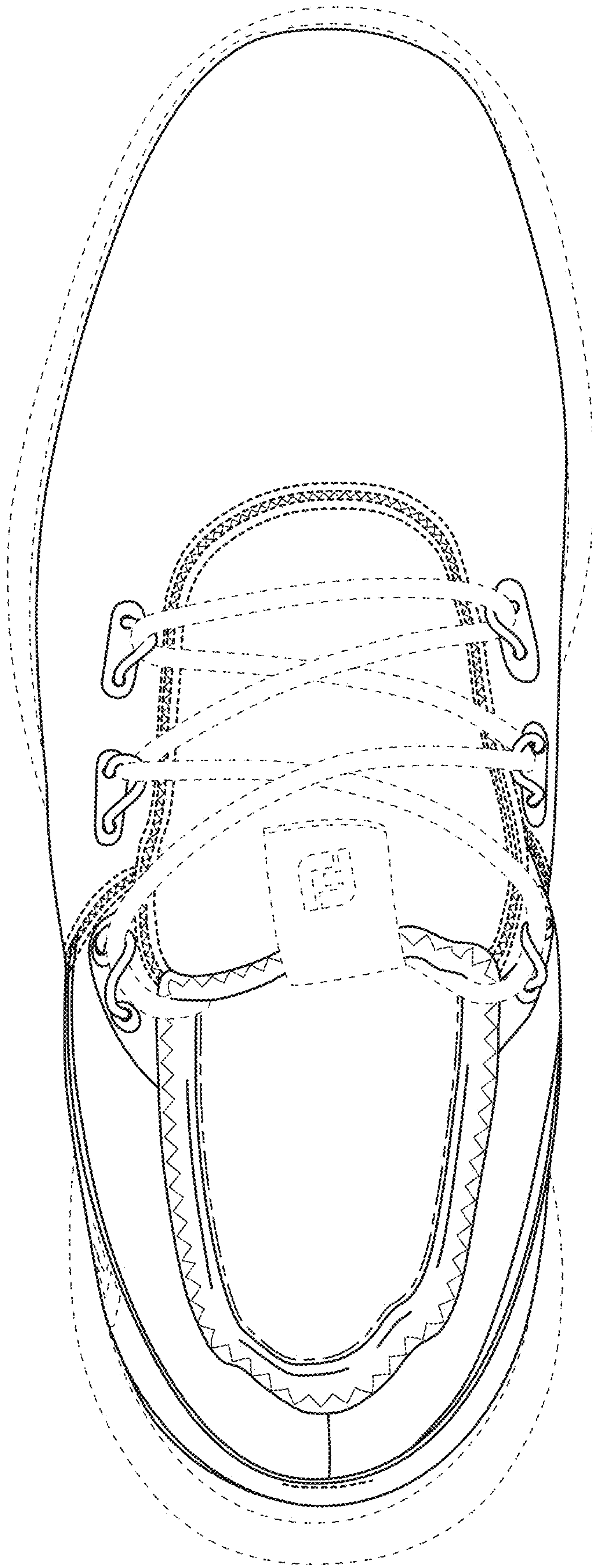

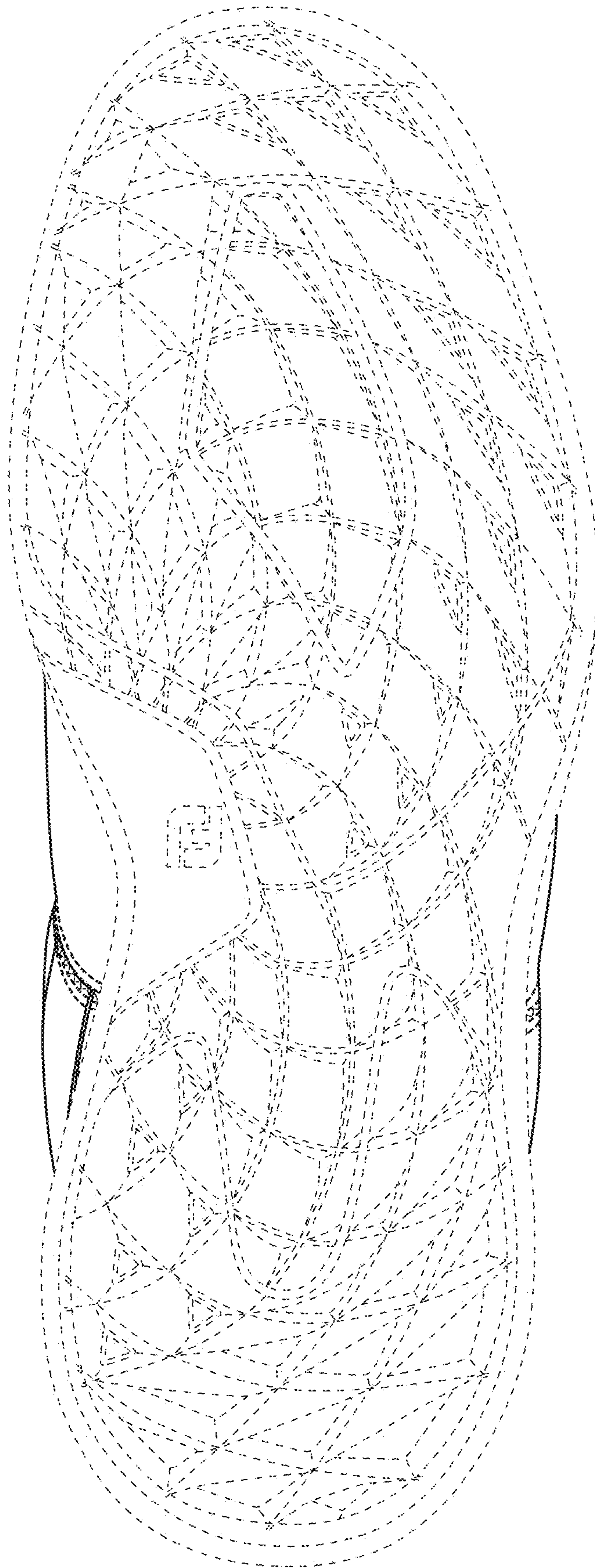
