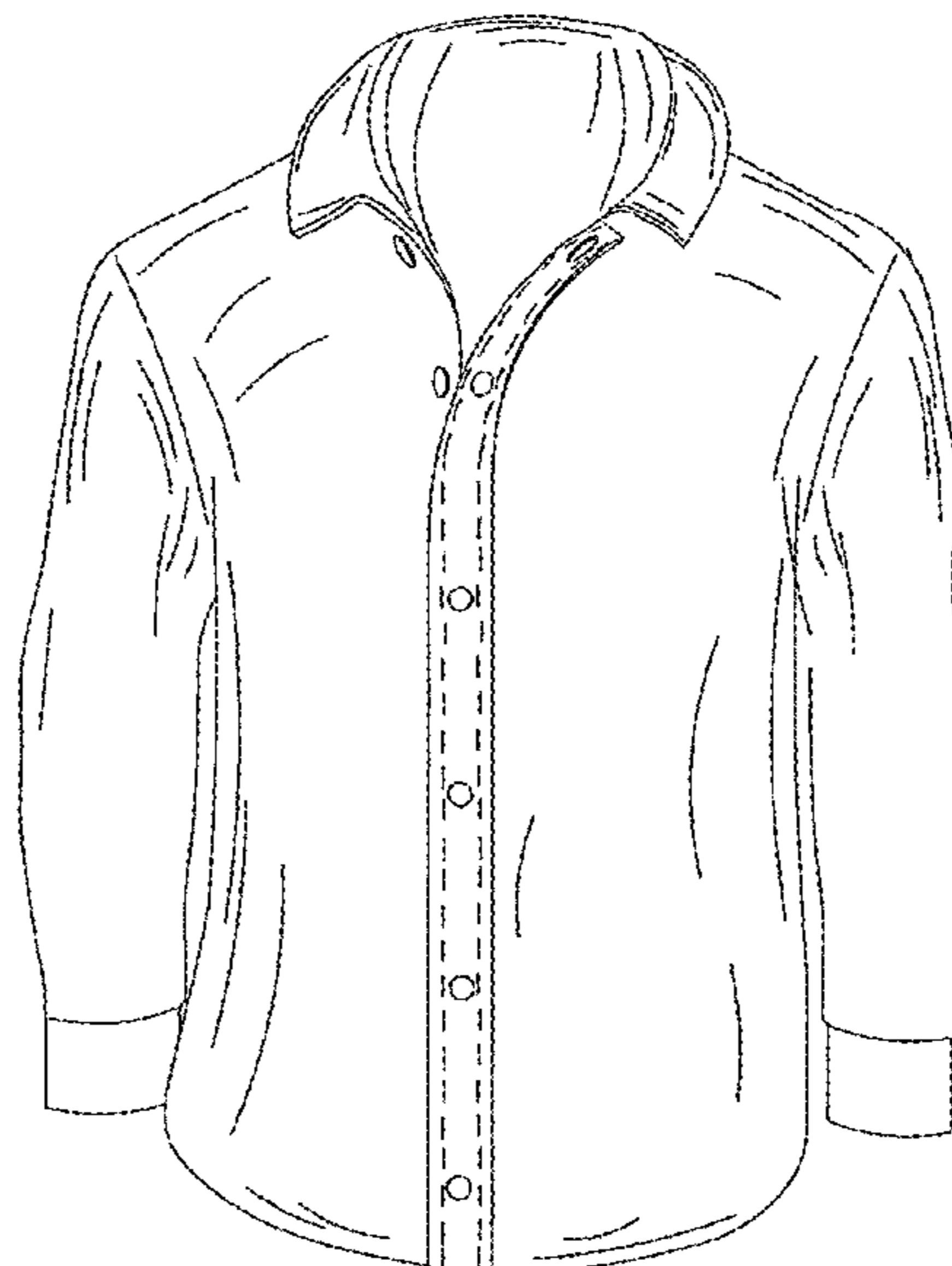

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is front perspective view showing the long sleeve shirt of the present invention, shown with the top button unbuttoned;  
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof with the top button buttoned;  
FIG. 3 is front perspective view with the top two buttons unbuttoned, the remaining buttons are non-functioning buttons applied to a fake placket;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a right side elevation thereof; and,  
FIG. 8 is a a bottom plan elevation thereof.  
The broken lines in the drawings illustrate portions of the shirt that form no part of the claimed design.

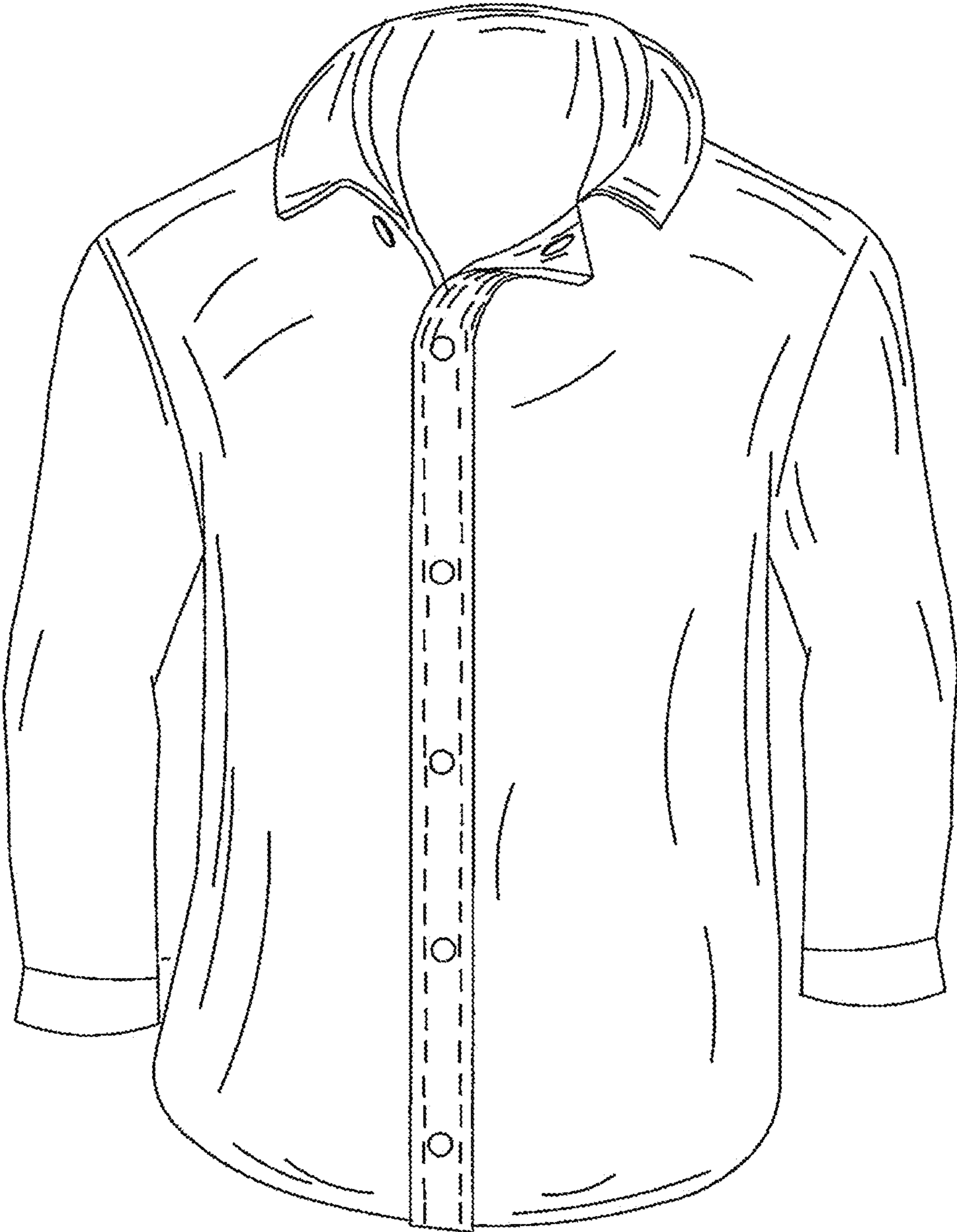

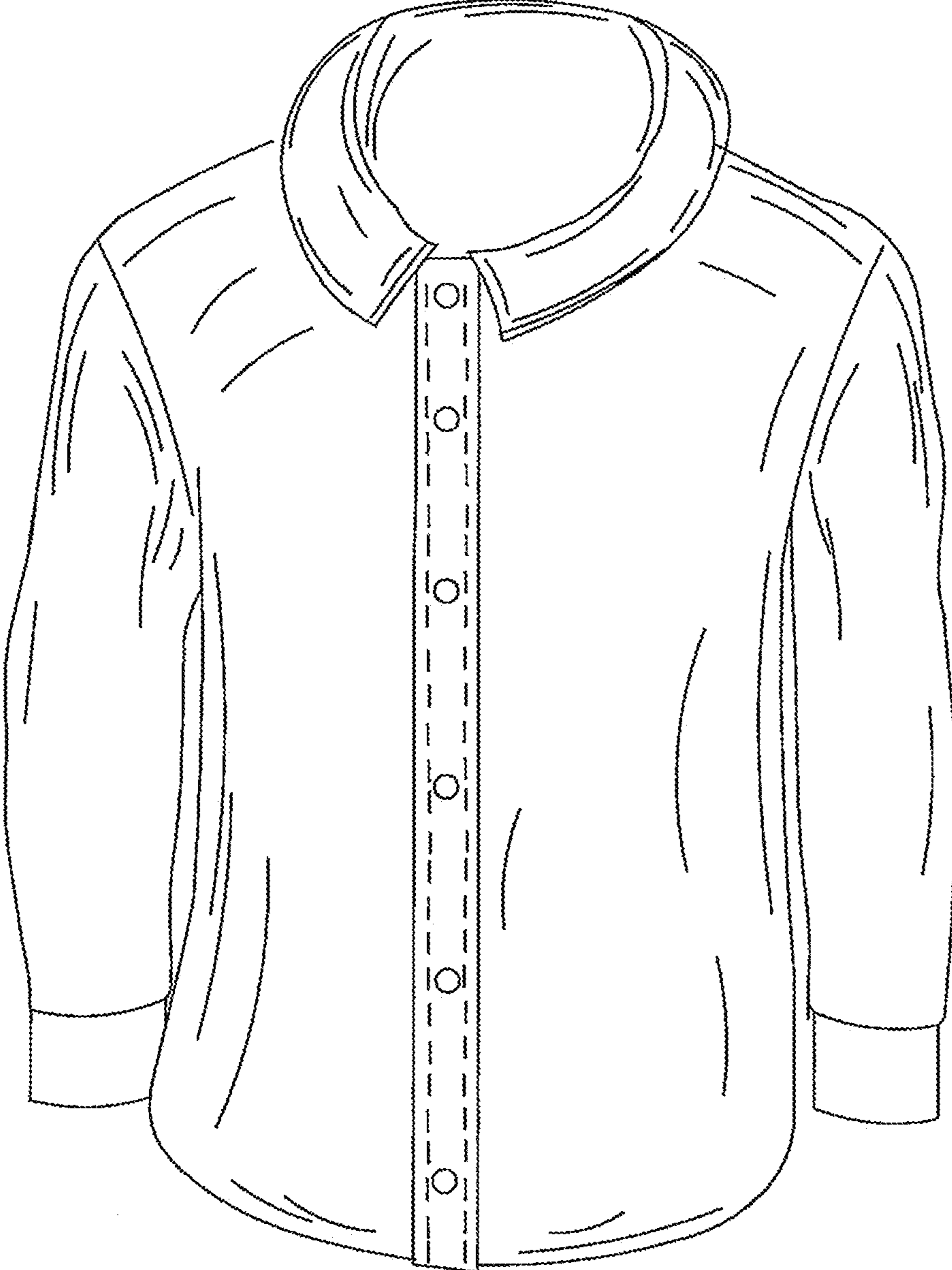

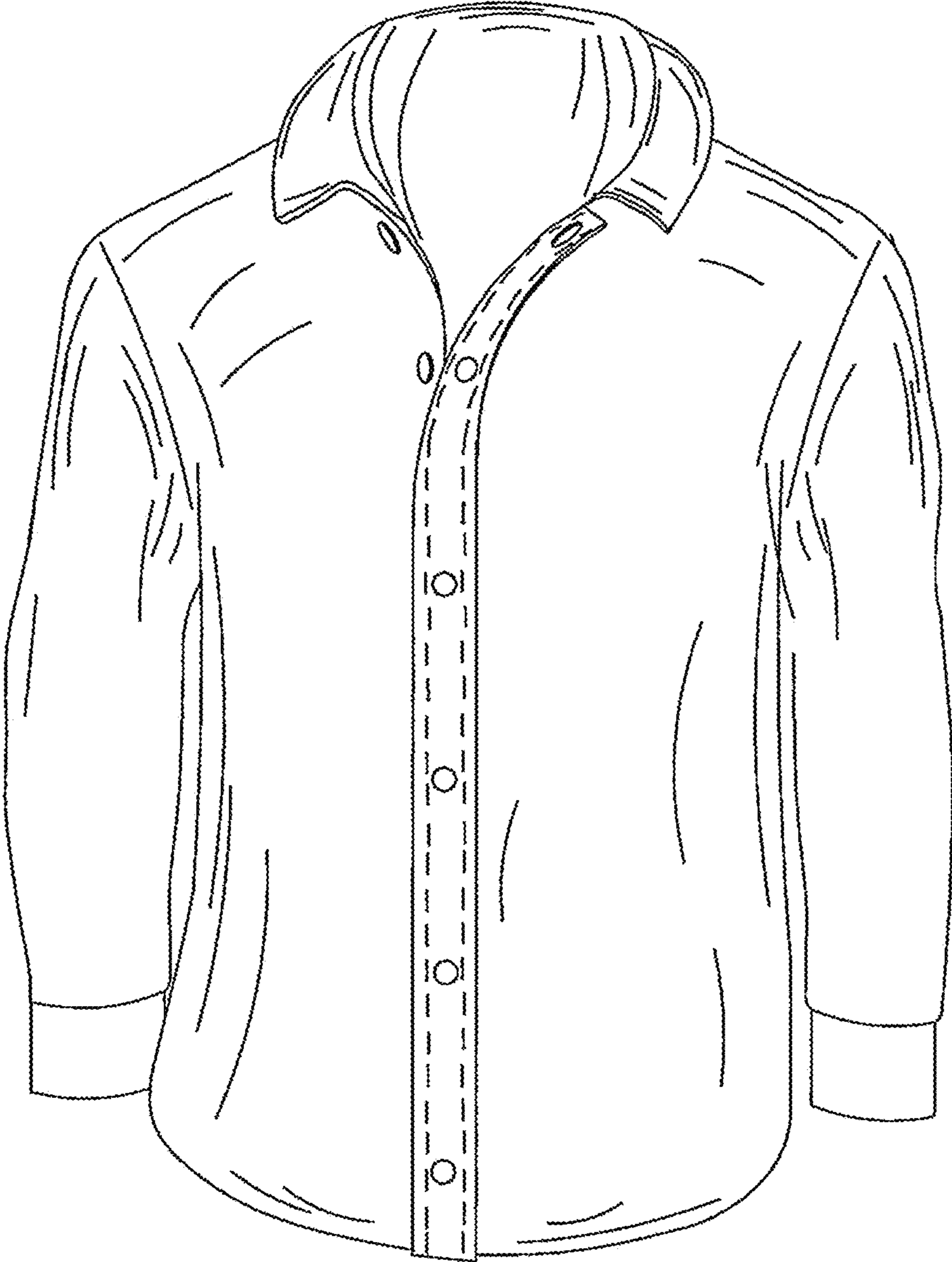

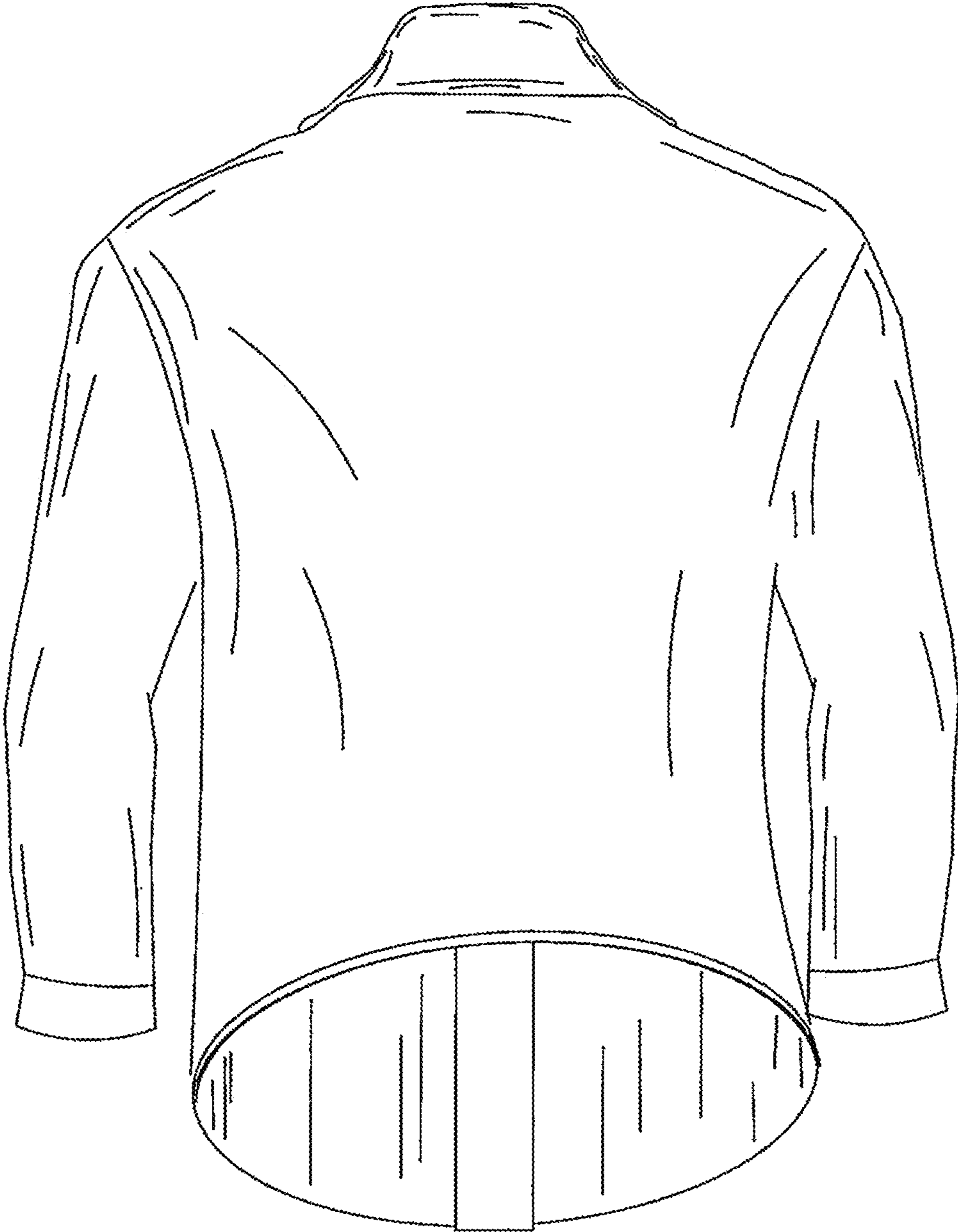

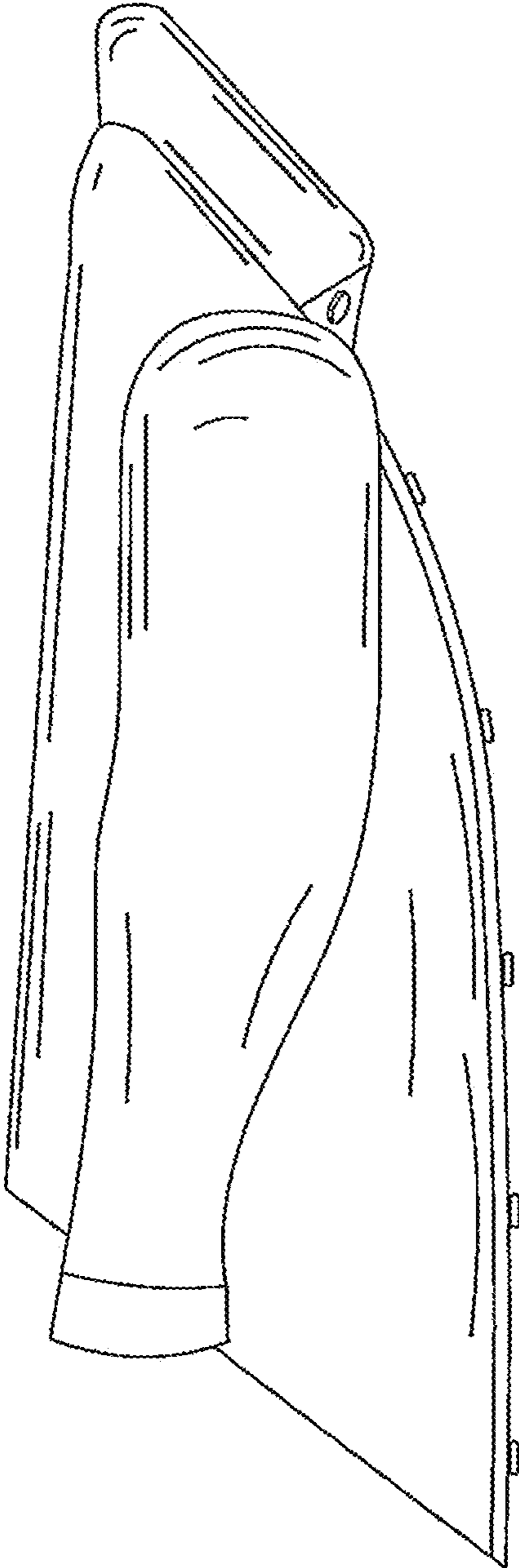

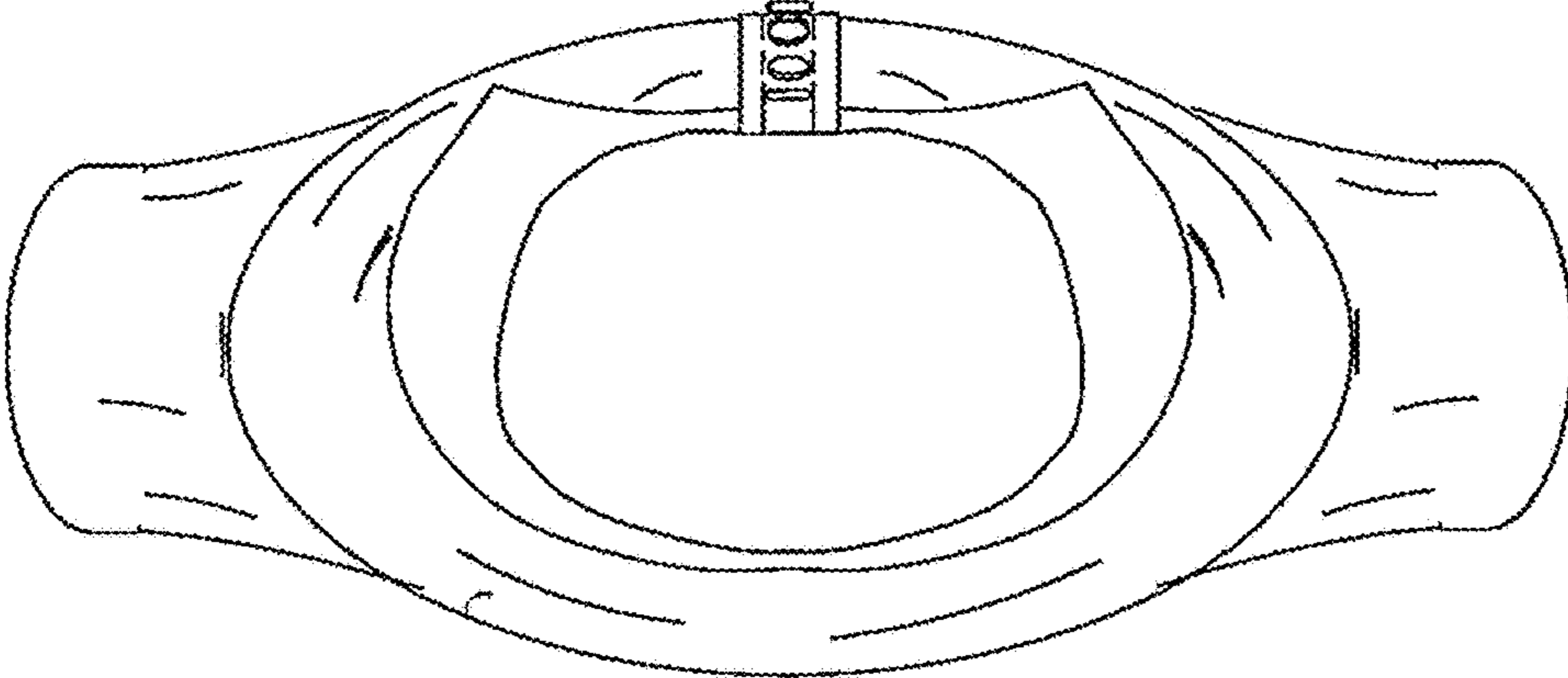

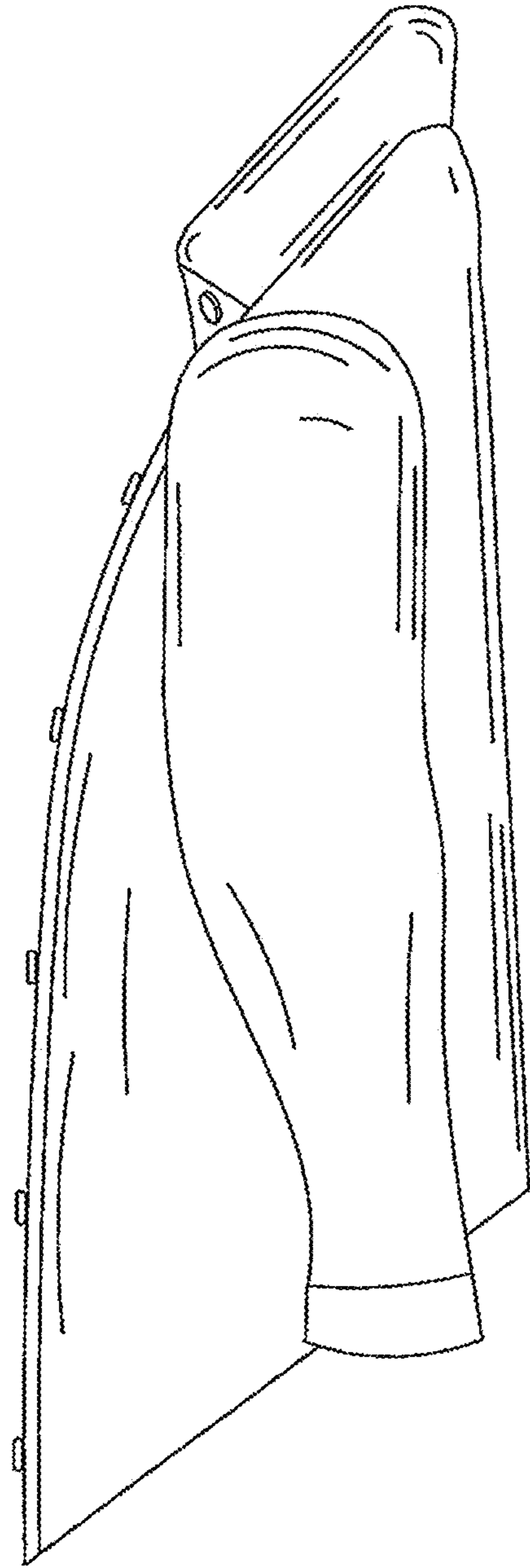
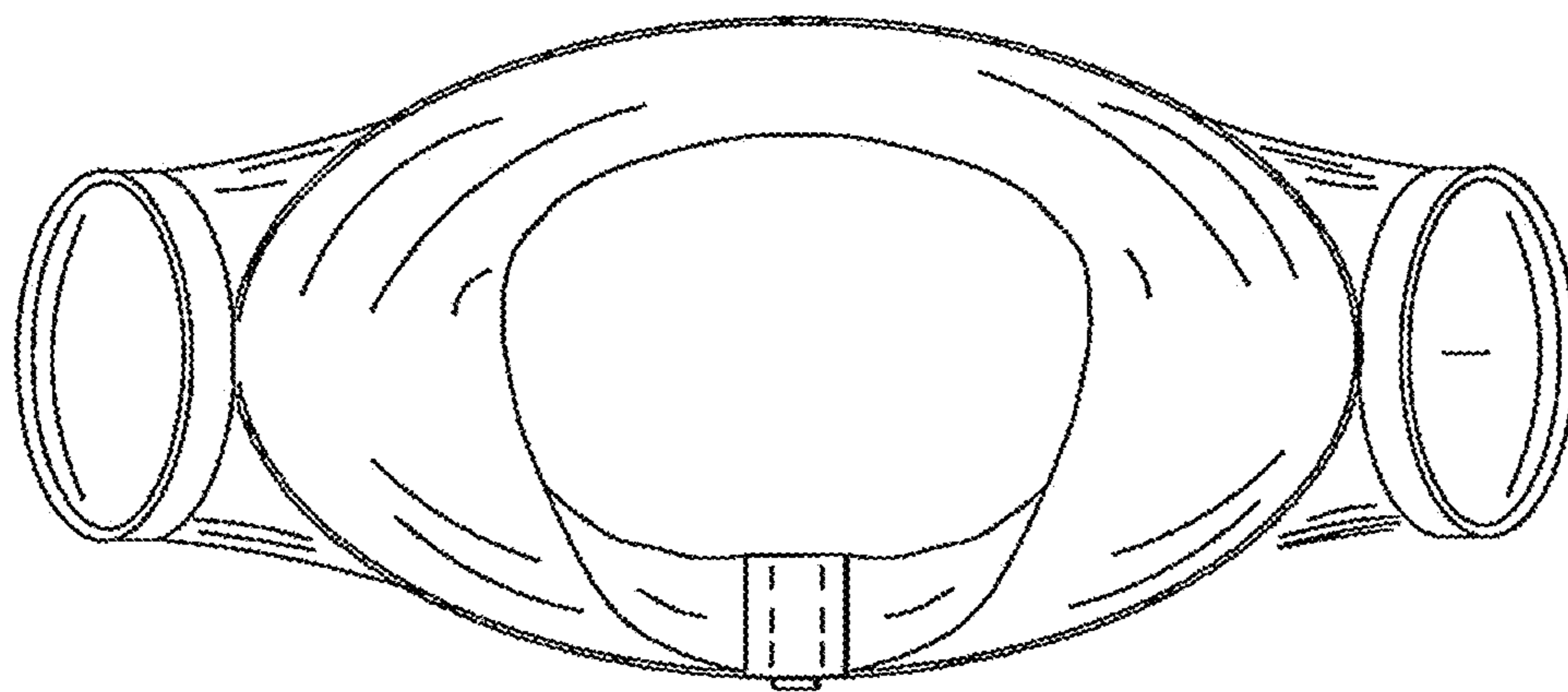
