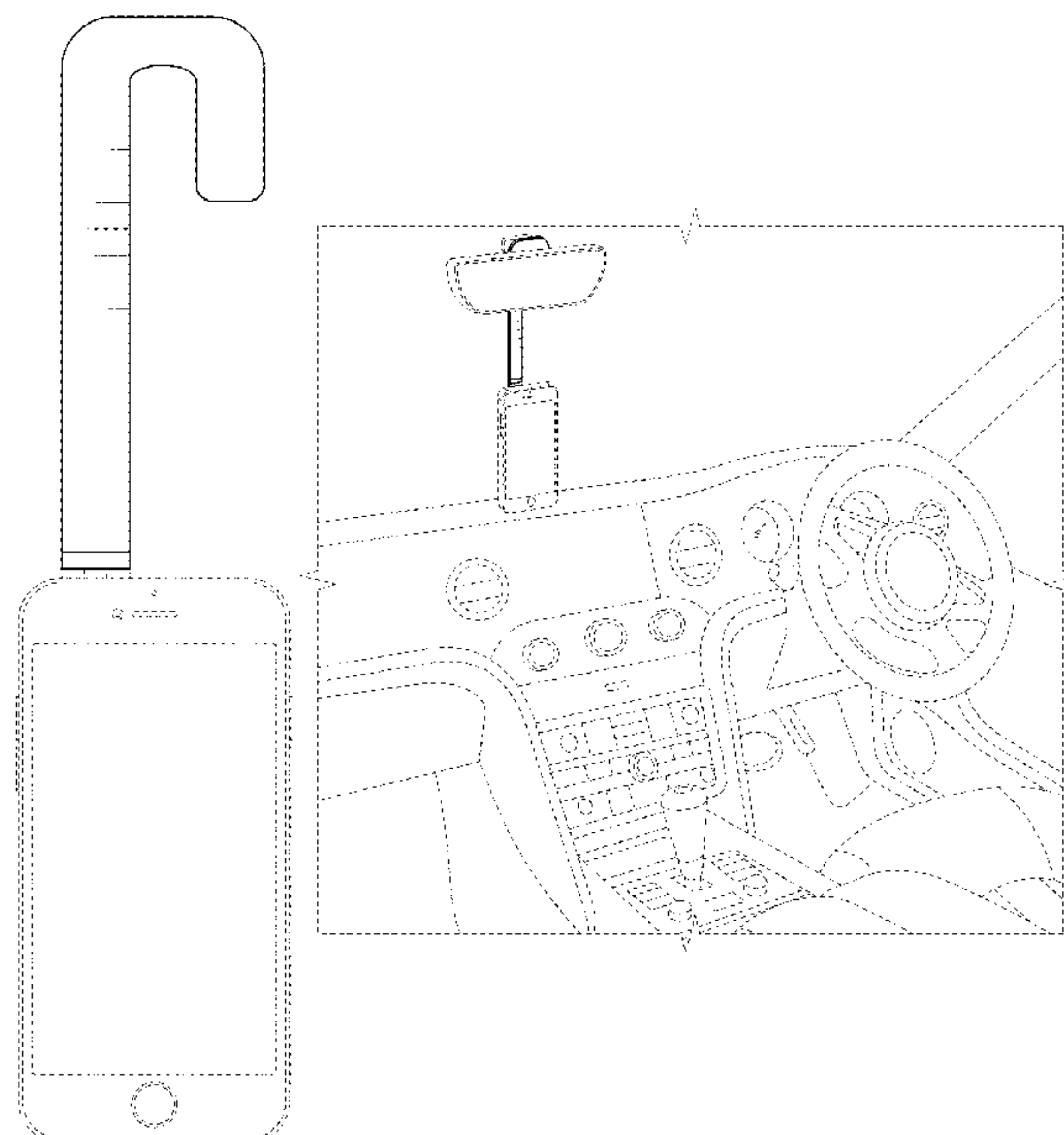
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a phone hanging device, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a phone hanging device;
FIG. 2 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right-side view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left-side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the phone hanging device of
FIG. 1 shown in an environment of use.
The dash-dot-dash broken lines represent boundaries and
form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dash broken
lines between the solid lines of the phone hanging device
depict portions of the article that form no part of the claimed
design. The dash-dash broken lines in FIGS. 1-7 showing a
phone and phone case and the broken lines in FIG. 8
showing the interior of a car illustrate an environment of use
and form no part of the claimed design.

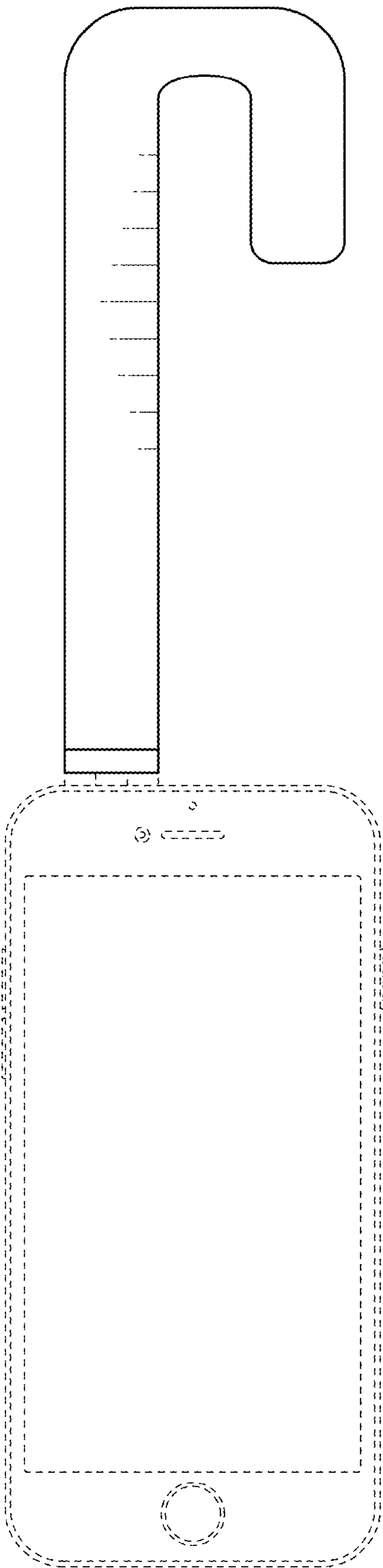

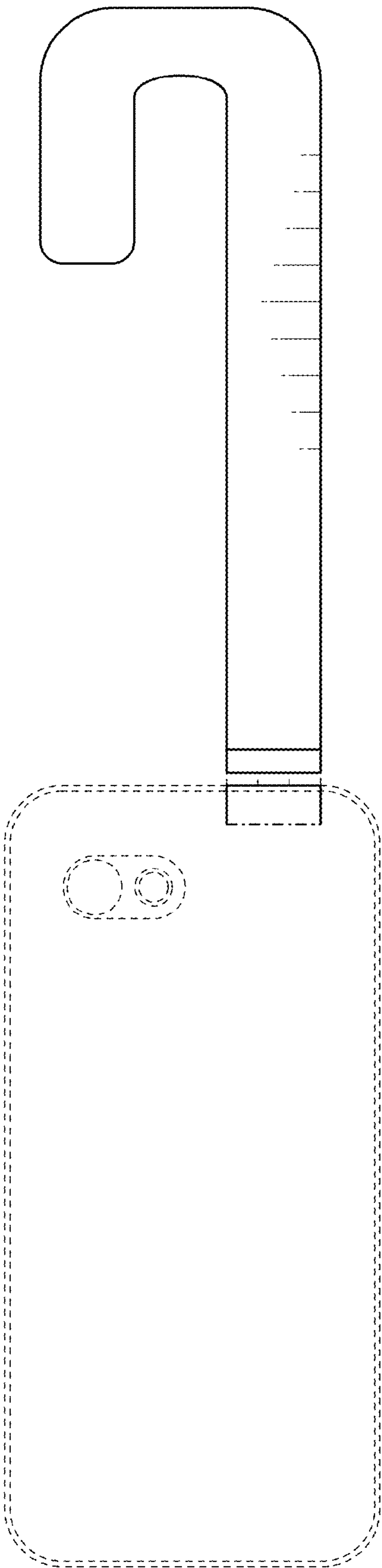

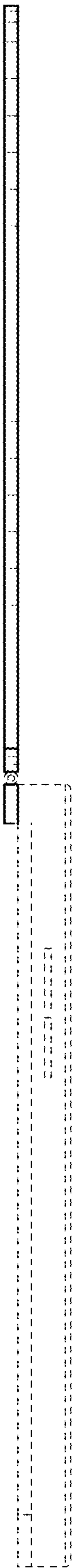

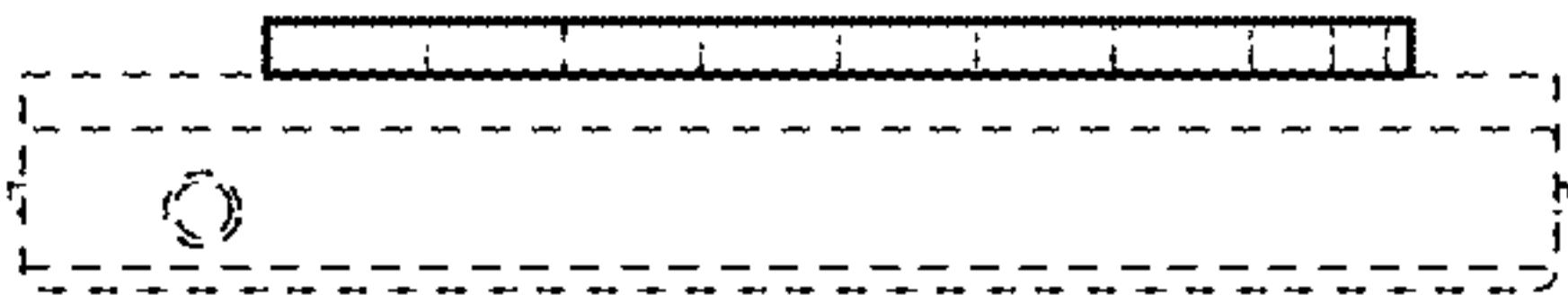

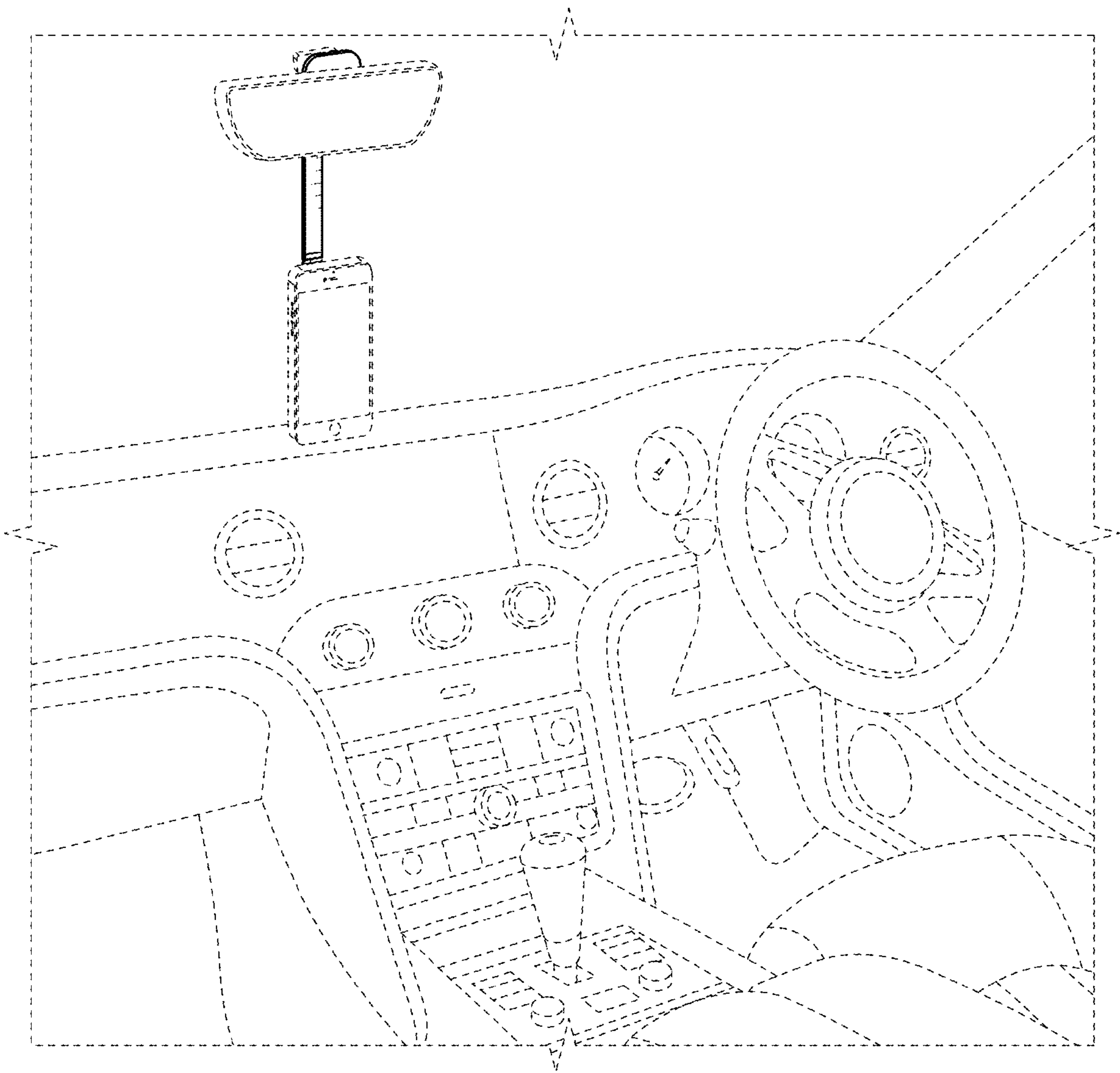
