(57) **CLAIM**

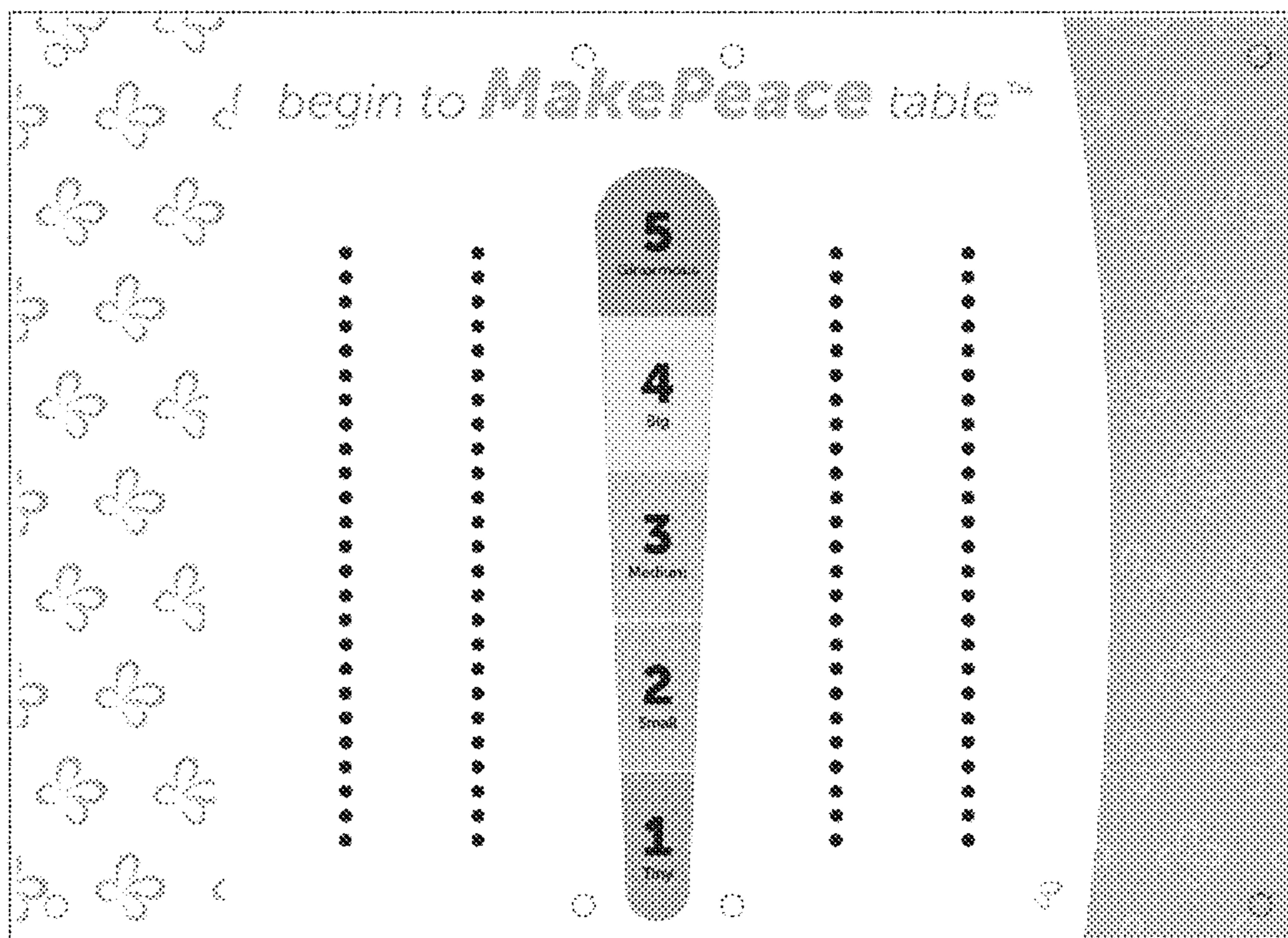
The ornamental design for a conflict resolution board, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front plan view of a first embodiment of a conflict resolution board for displaying emotions indicators; FIG. 2 is a top edge elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear plan view thereof; and, FIG. 4 is a front plan view of a second embodiment of a foldable conflict resolution board.

The dotted lines show the bounds of the conflict resolution board, the broken lines depicts features that form no part of the claimed design, and the dot-dash line indicates a fold line in the second embodiment. The wordmark “MAKEPEACE” forming part of the claimed design is a registered trademark of ESCSEL LLC.

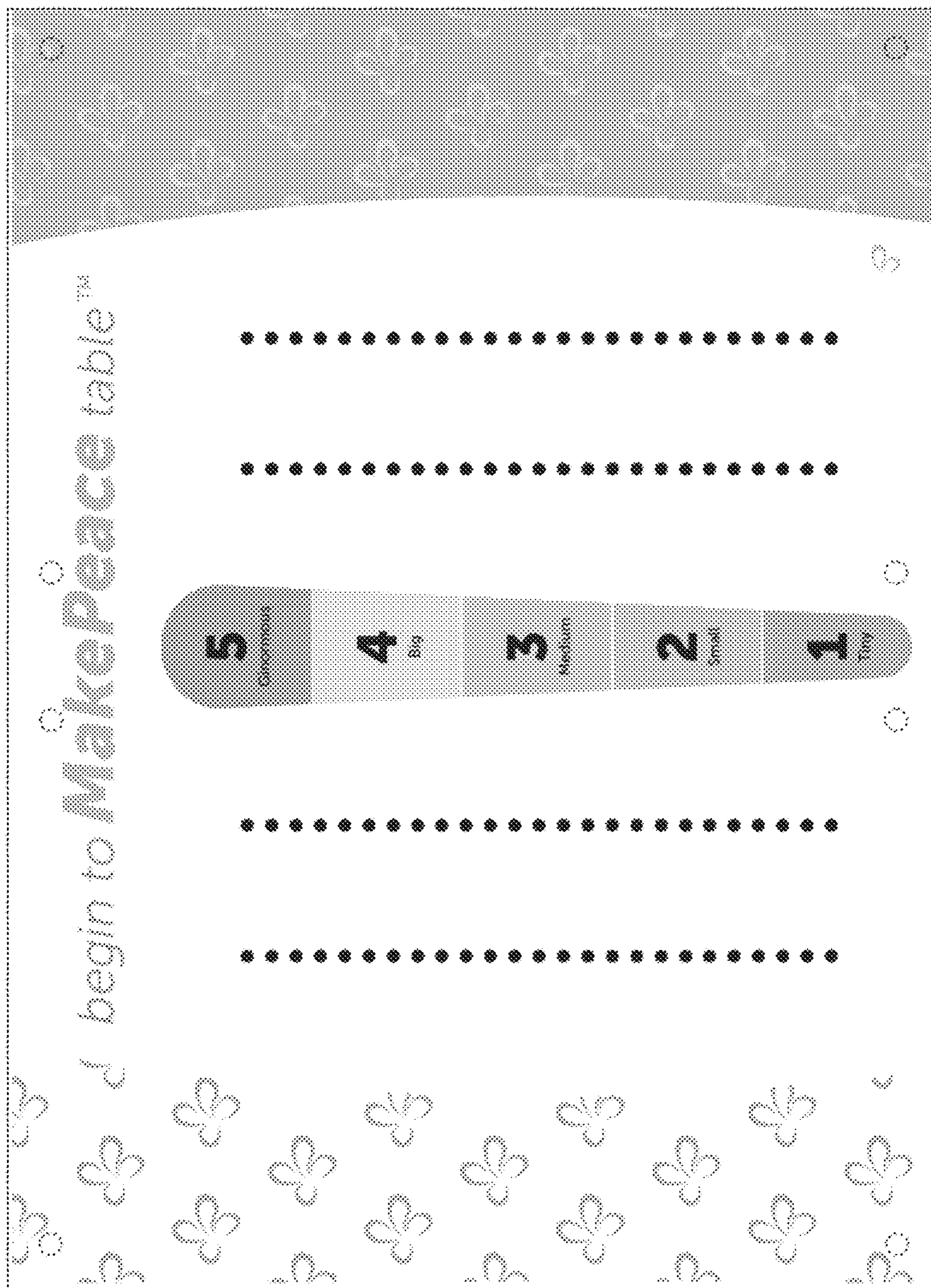

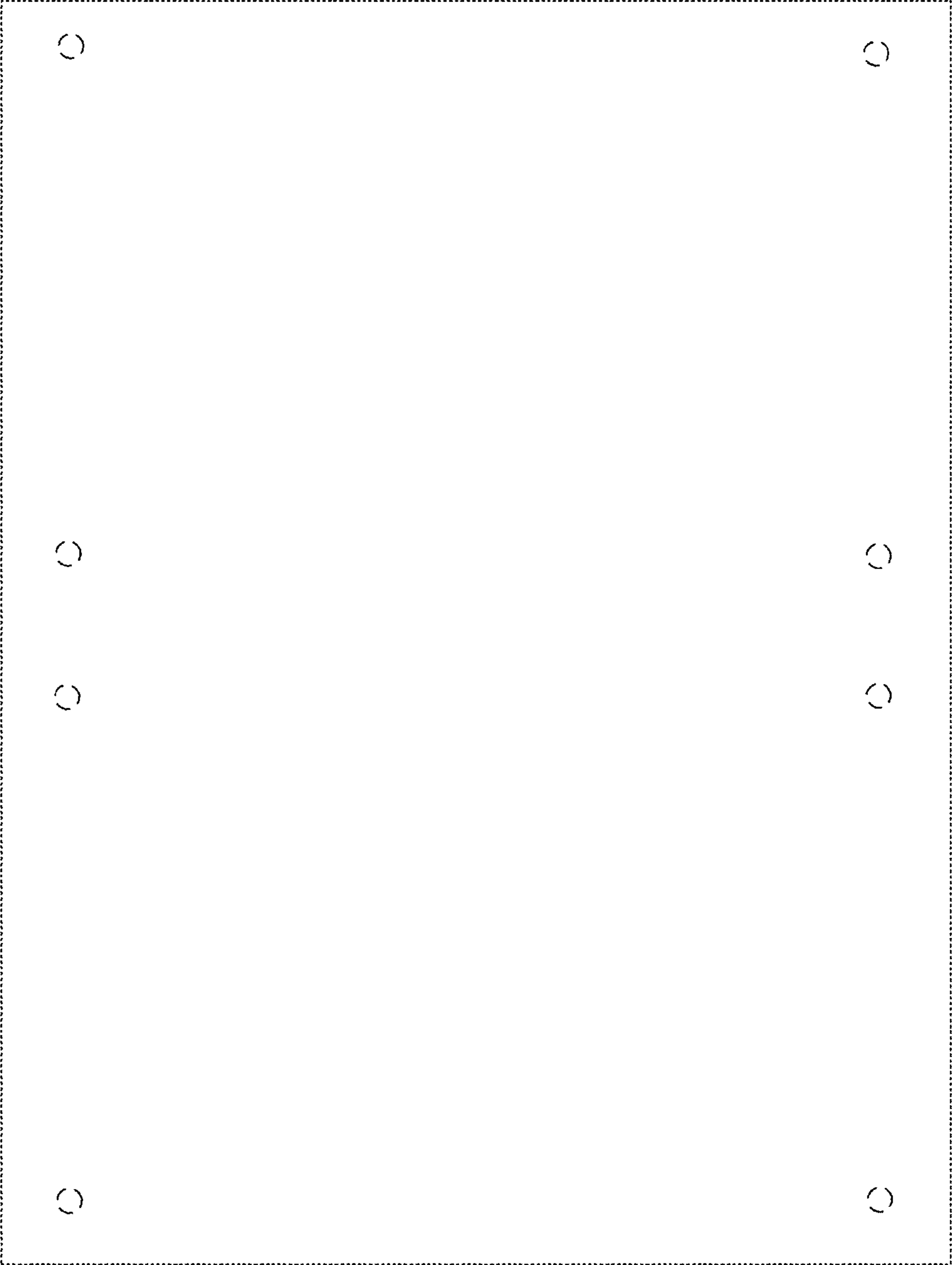

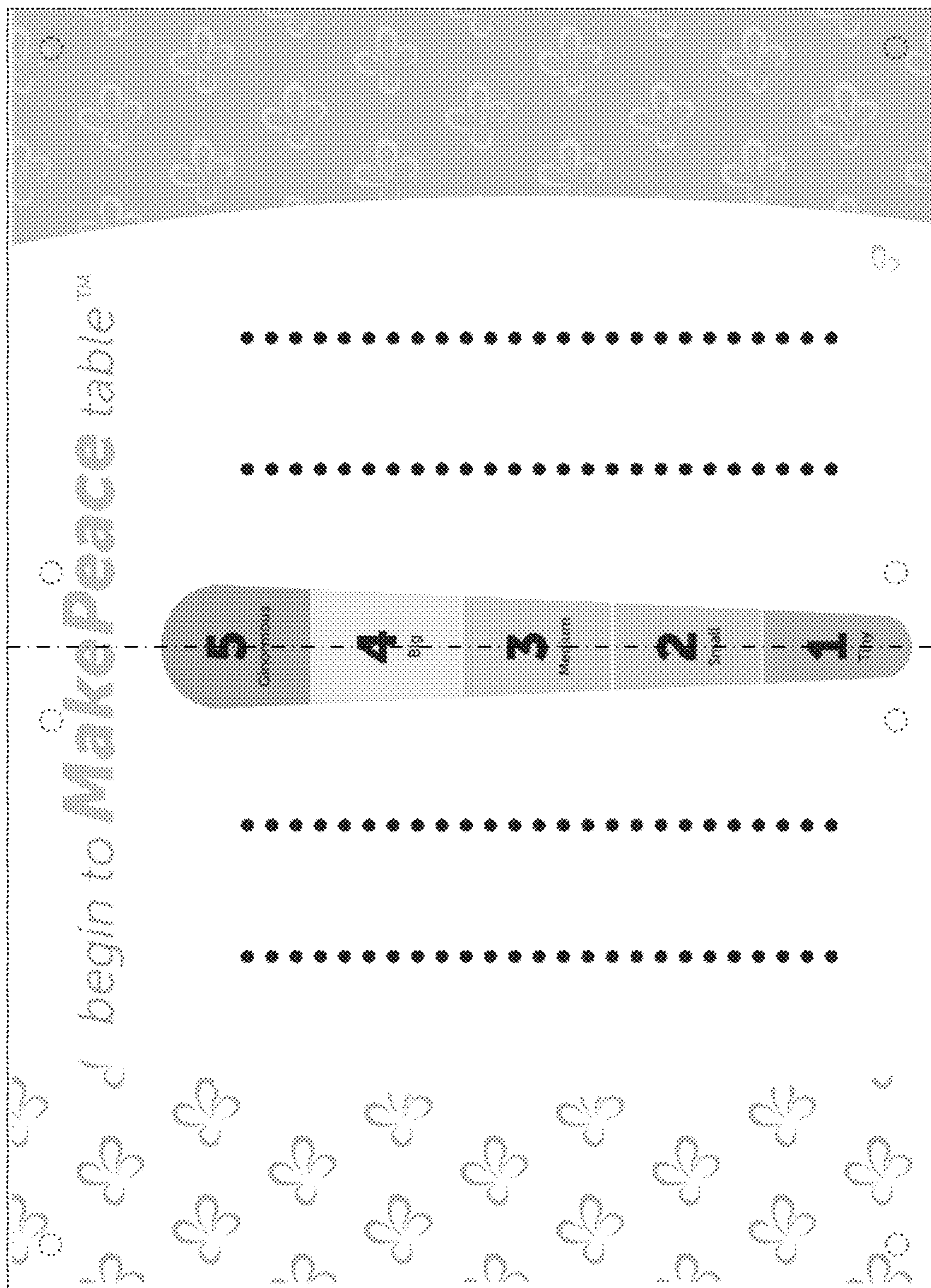
