We claim the ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

FIG. 5 is a front view of the chair of FIG. 4.

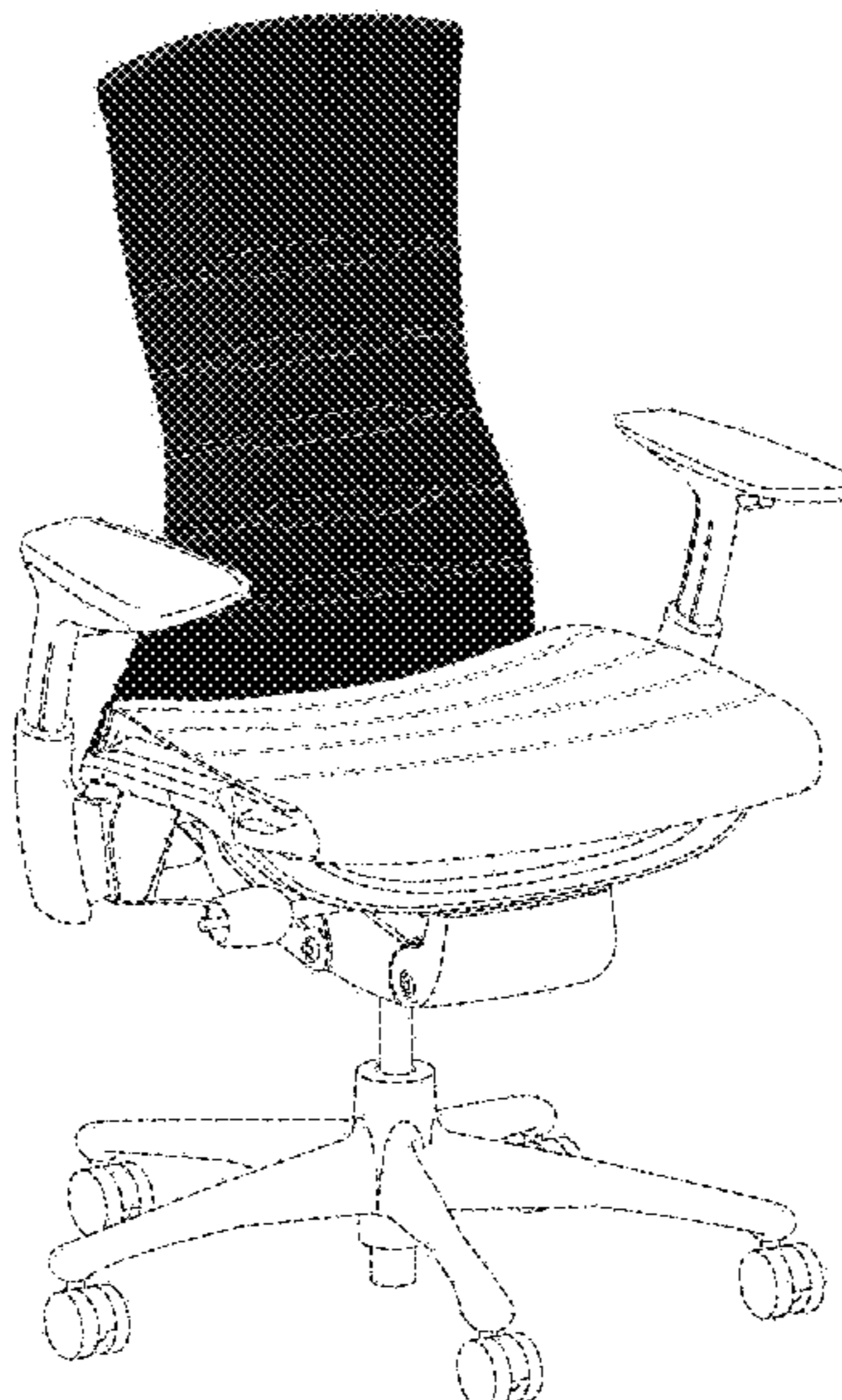
FIG. 6 is a perspective view of another chair embodying the invention; and,

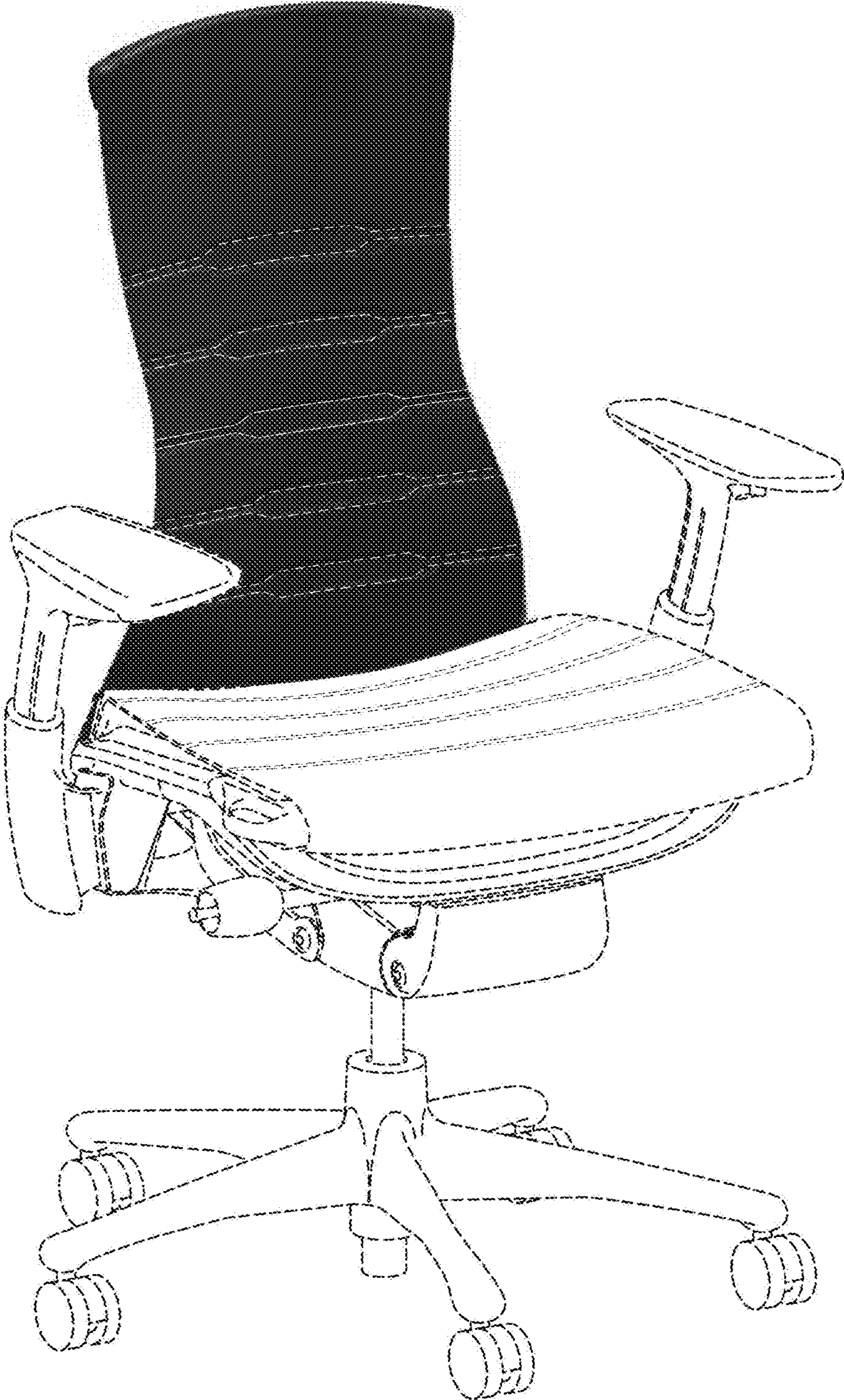

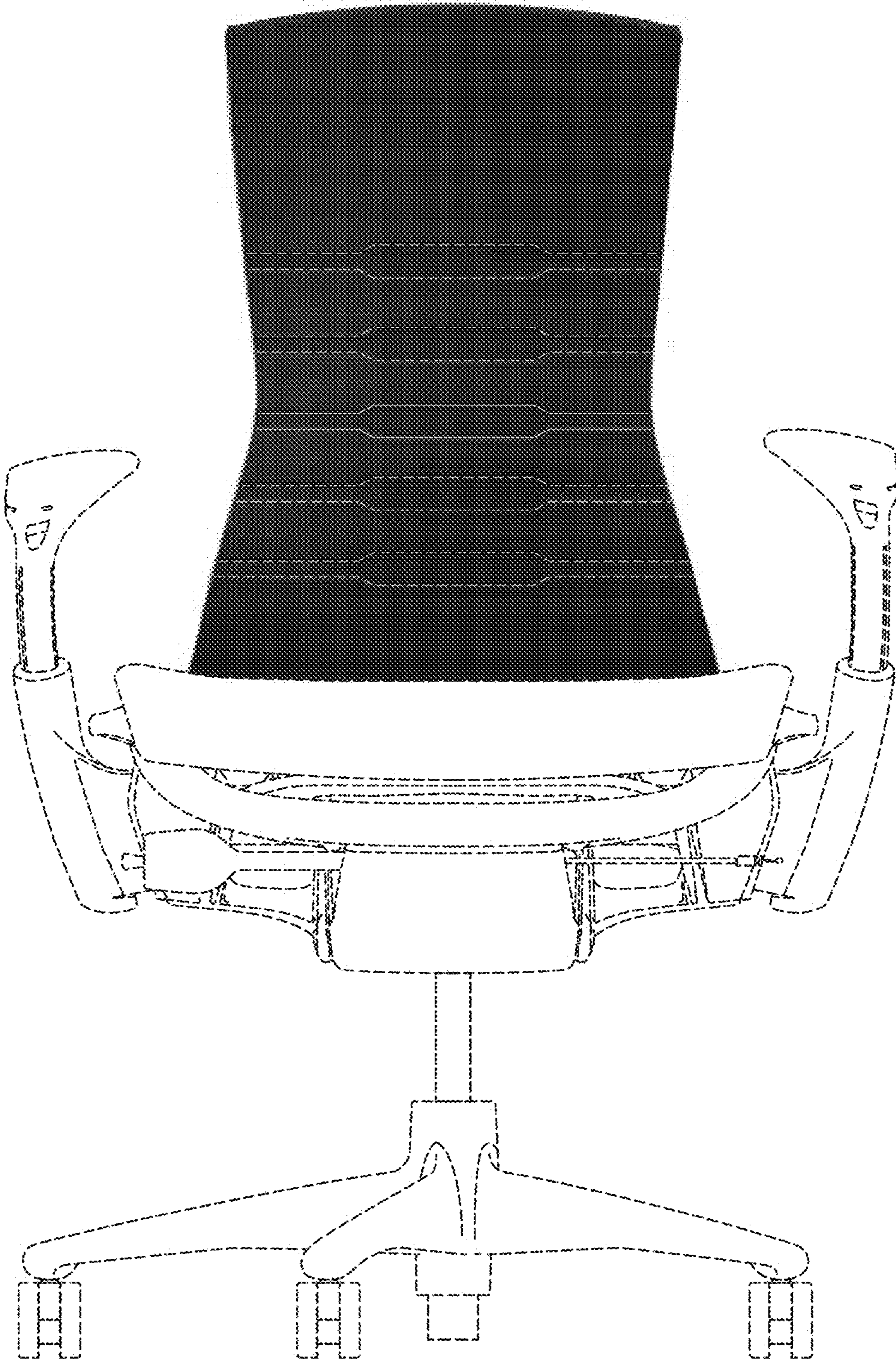

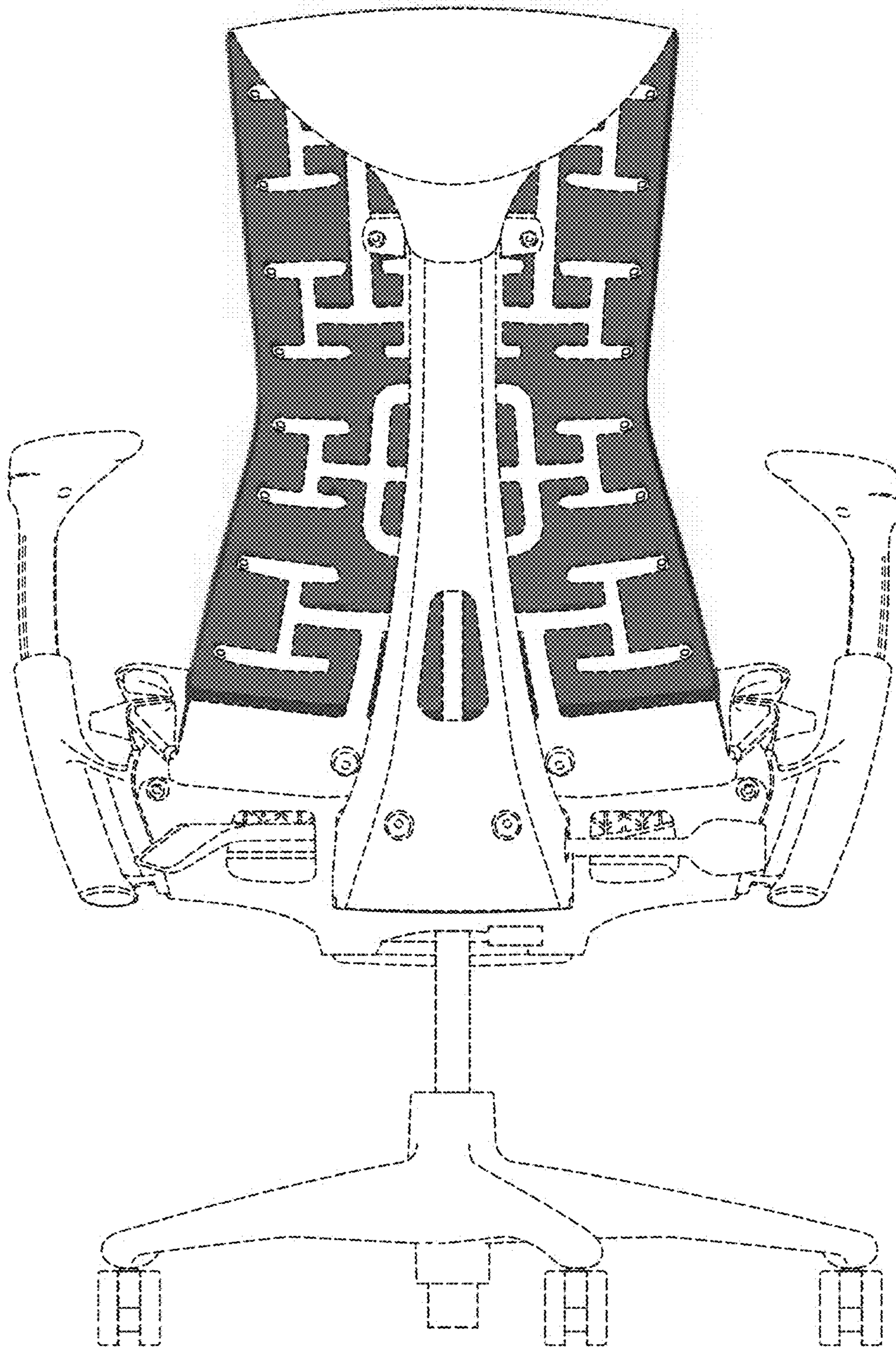

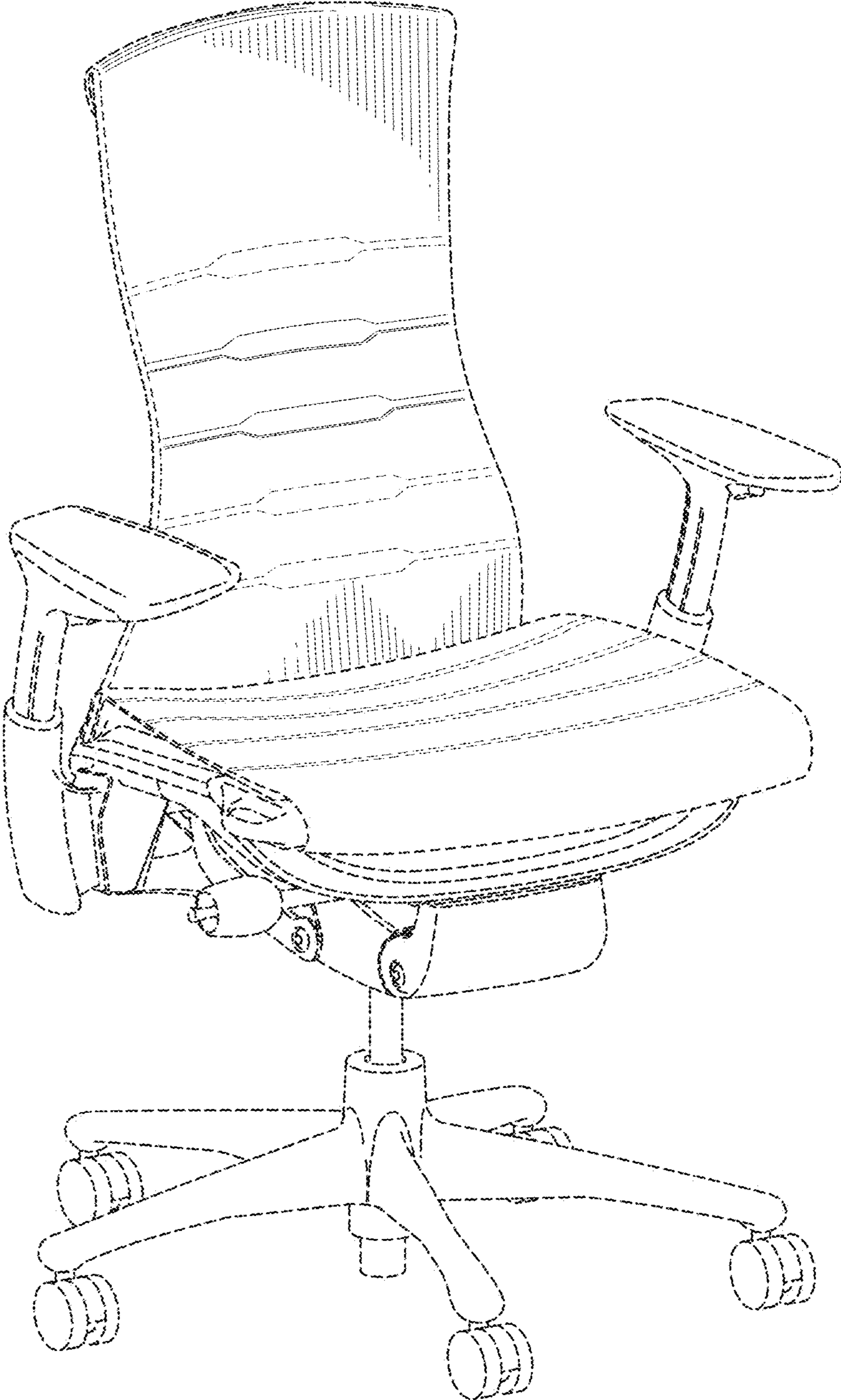

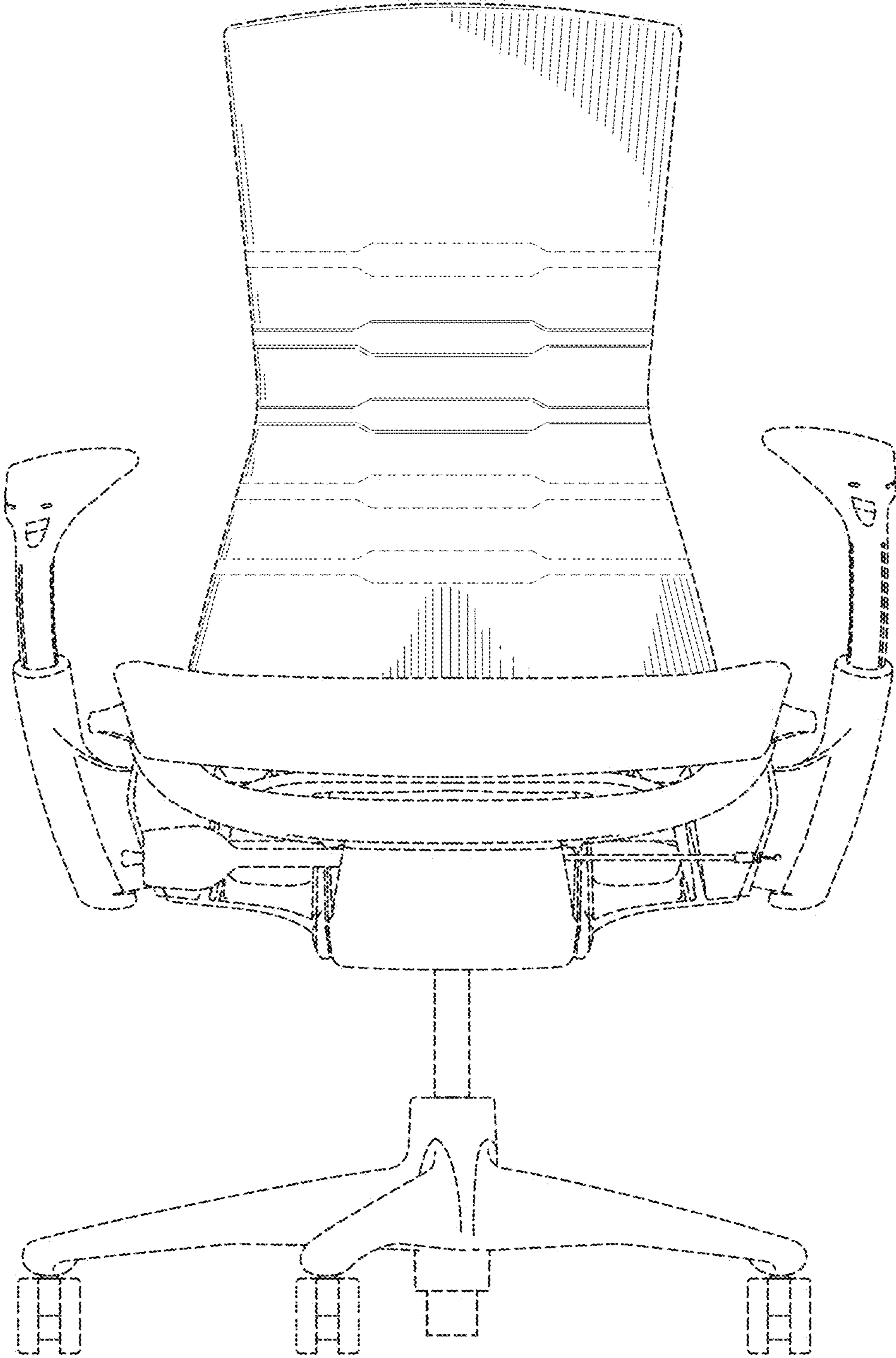

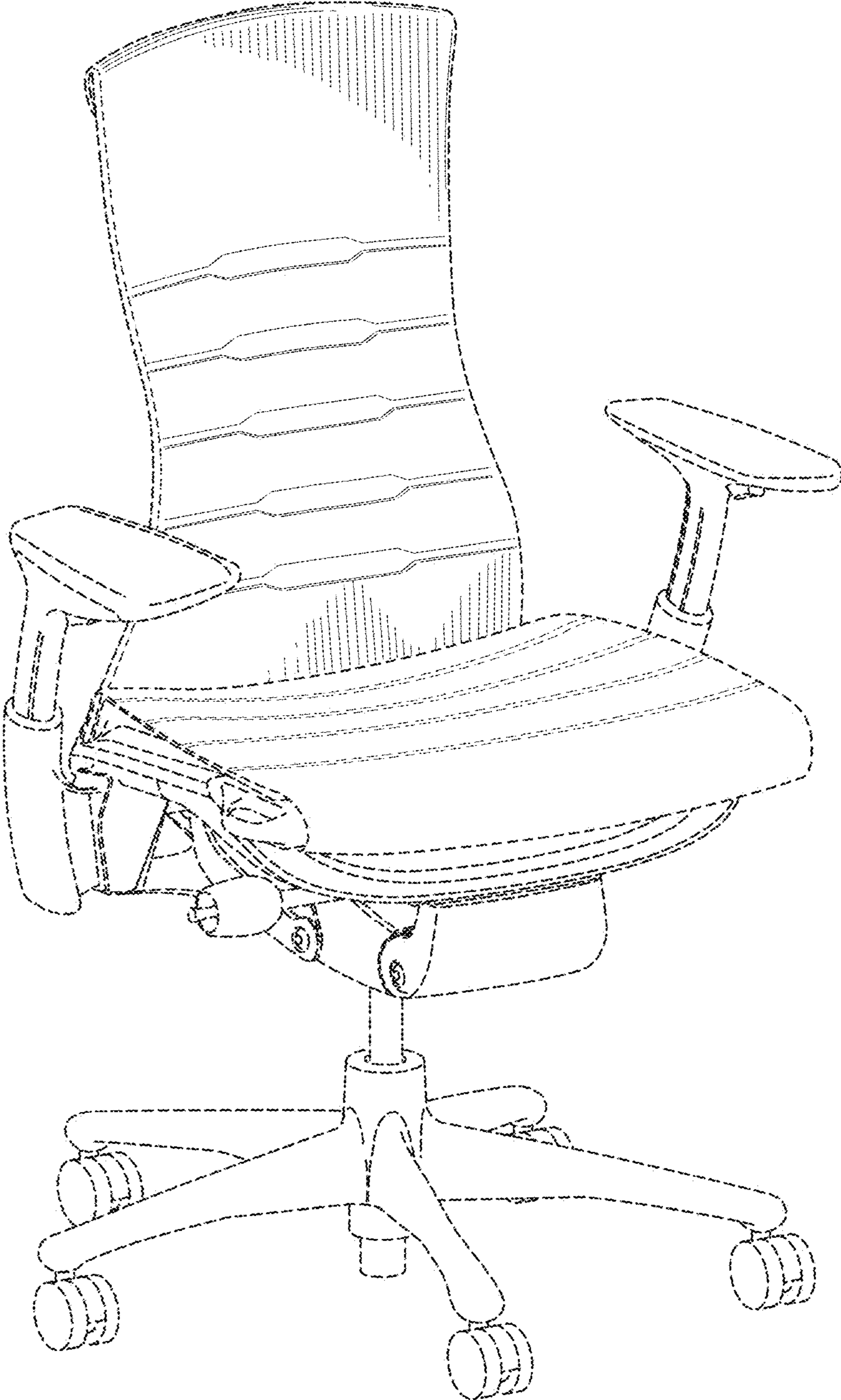

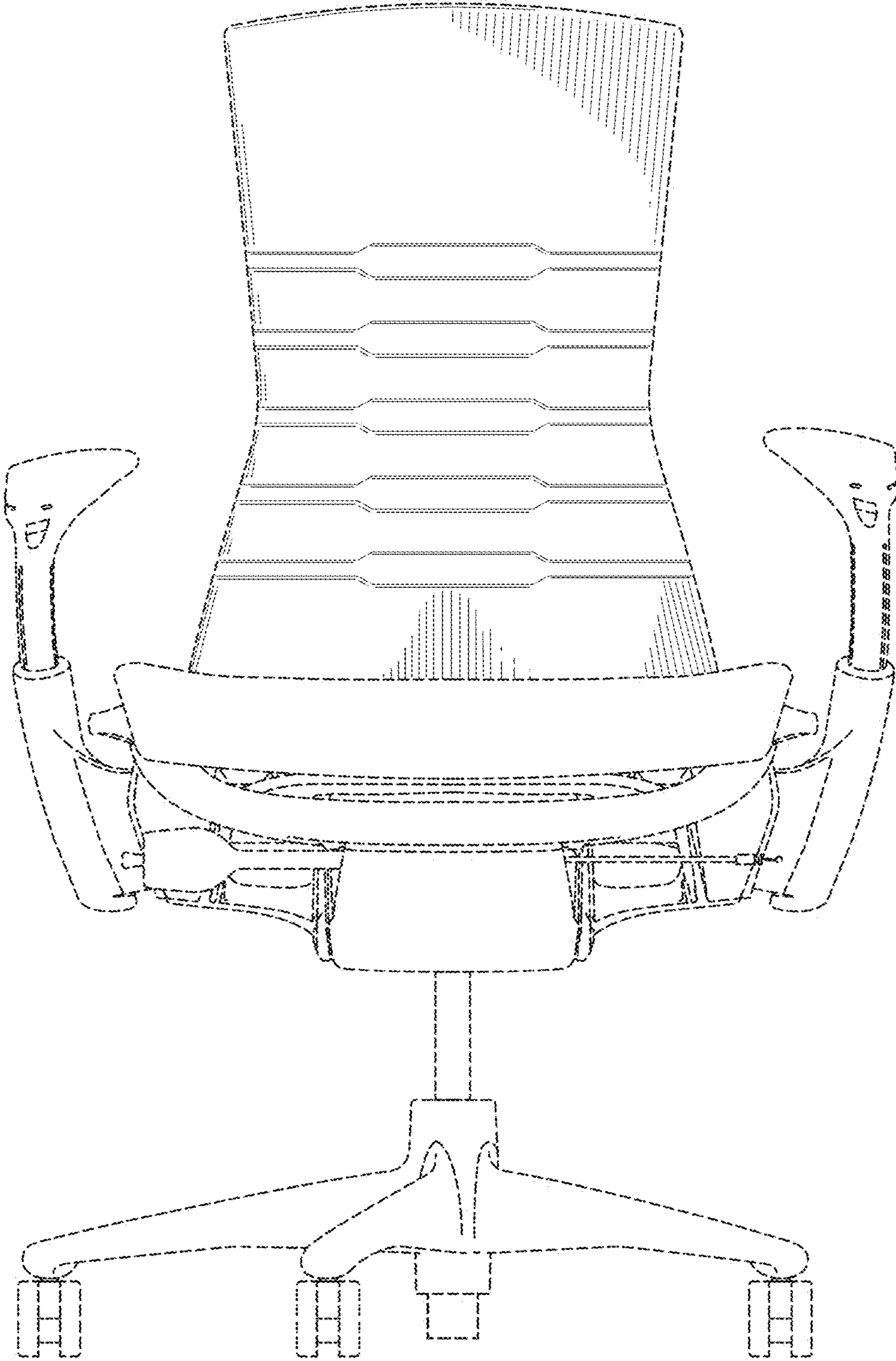
