FIG. 3 is a bottom rear perspective view thereof;

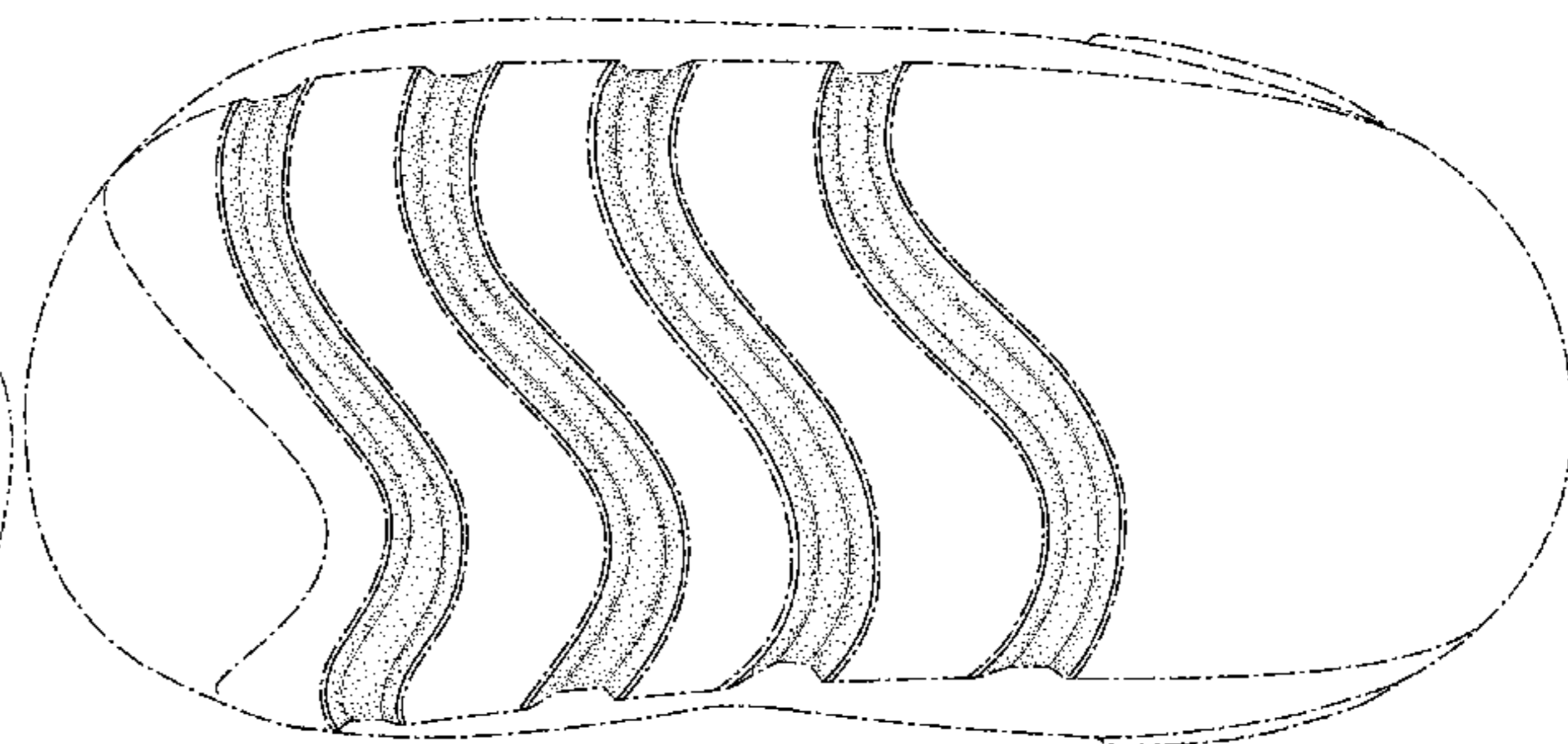
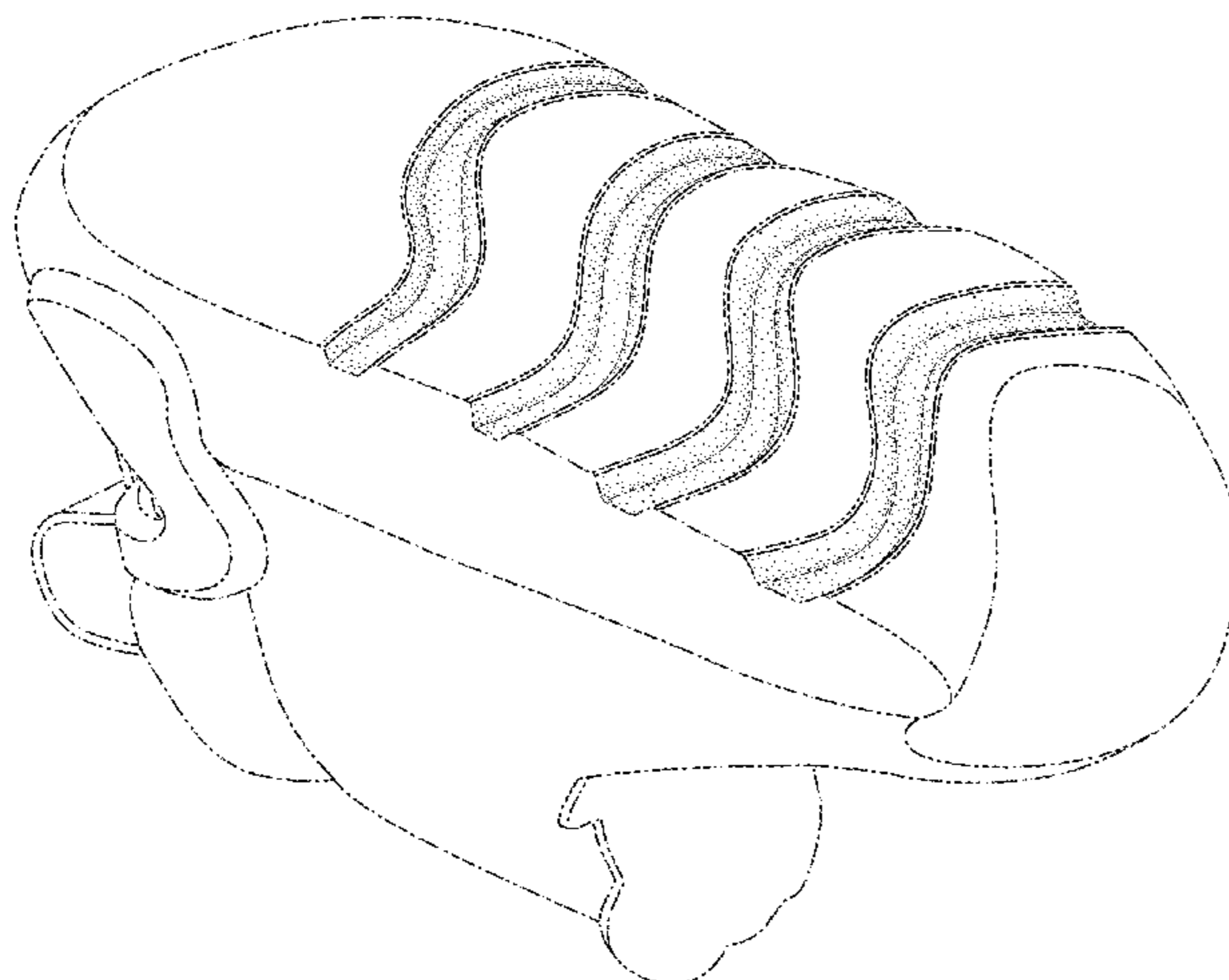
FIG. 4 is a bottom front perspective view of a shoe showing an alternate embodiment of my new design;

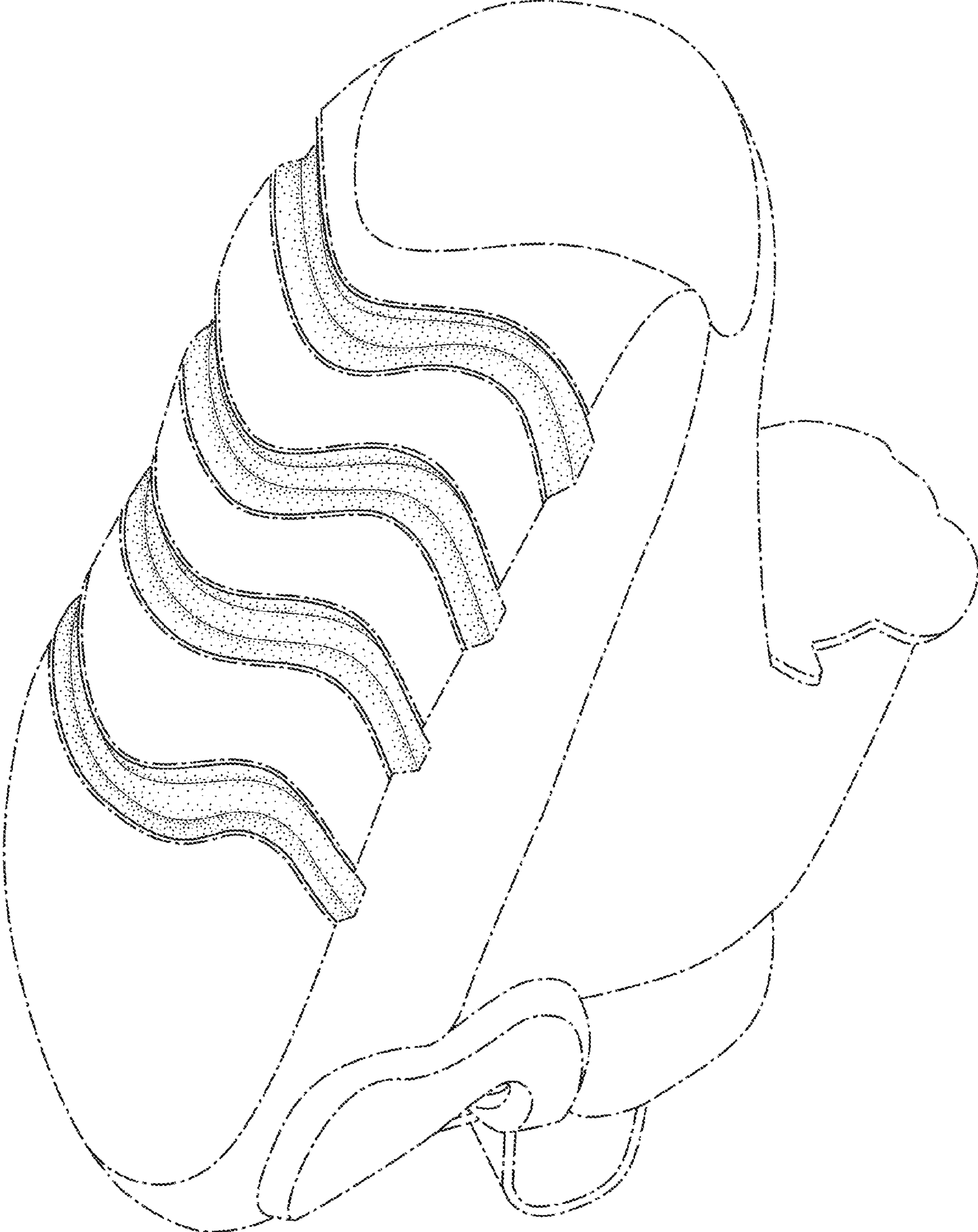

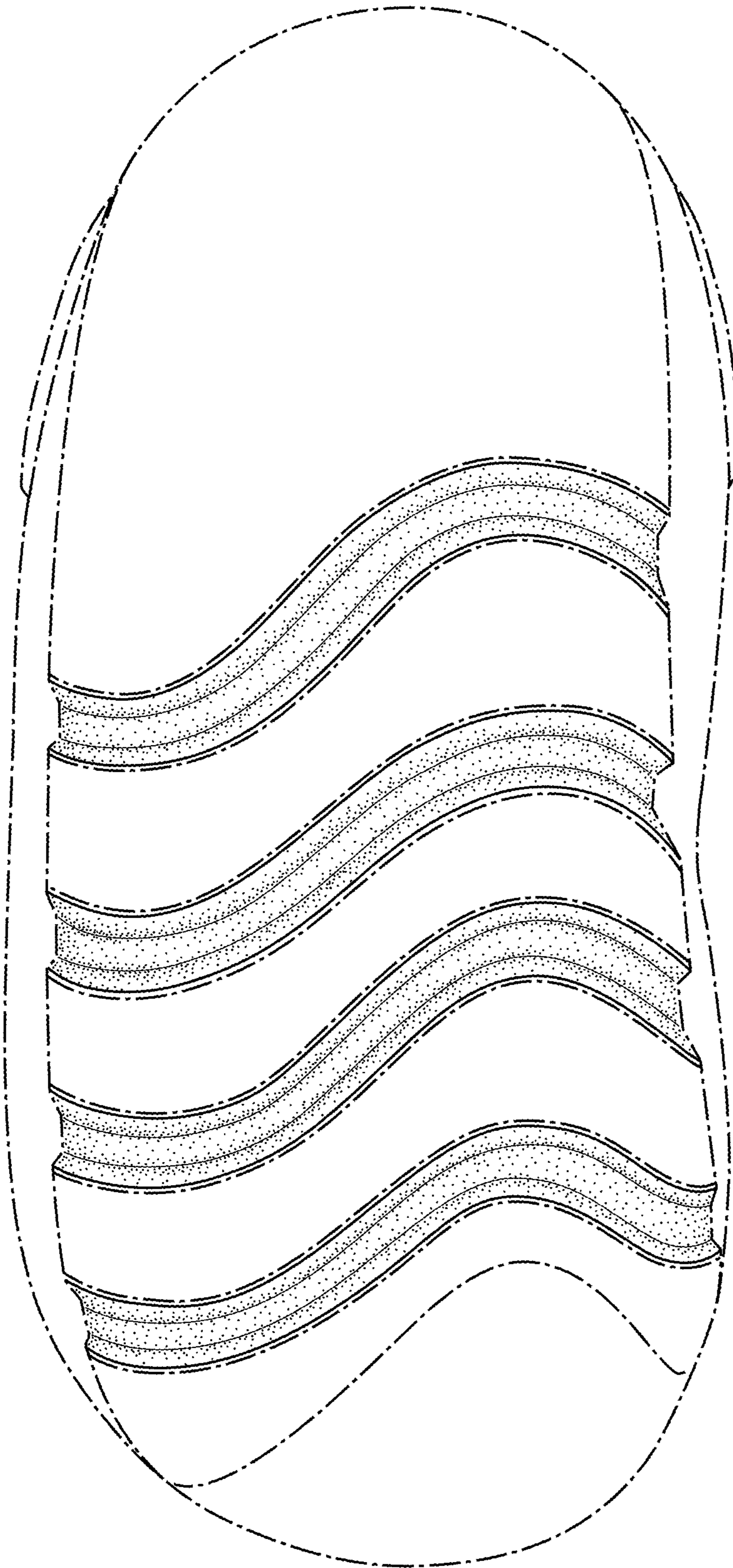

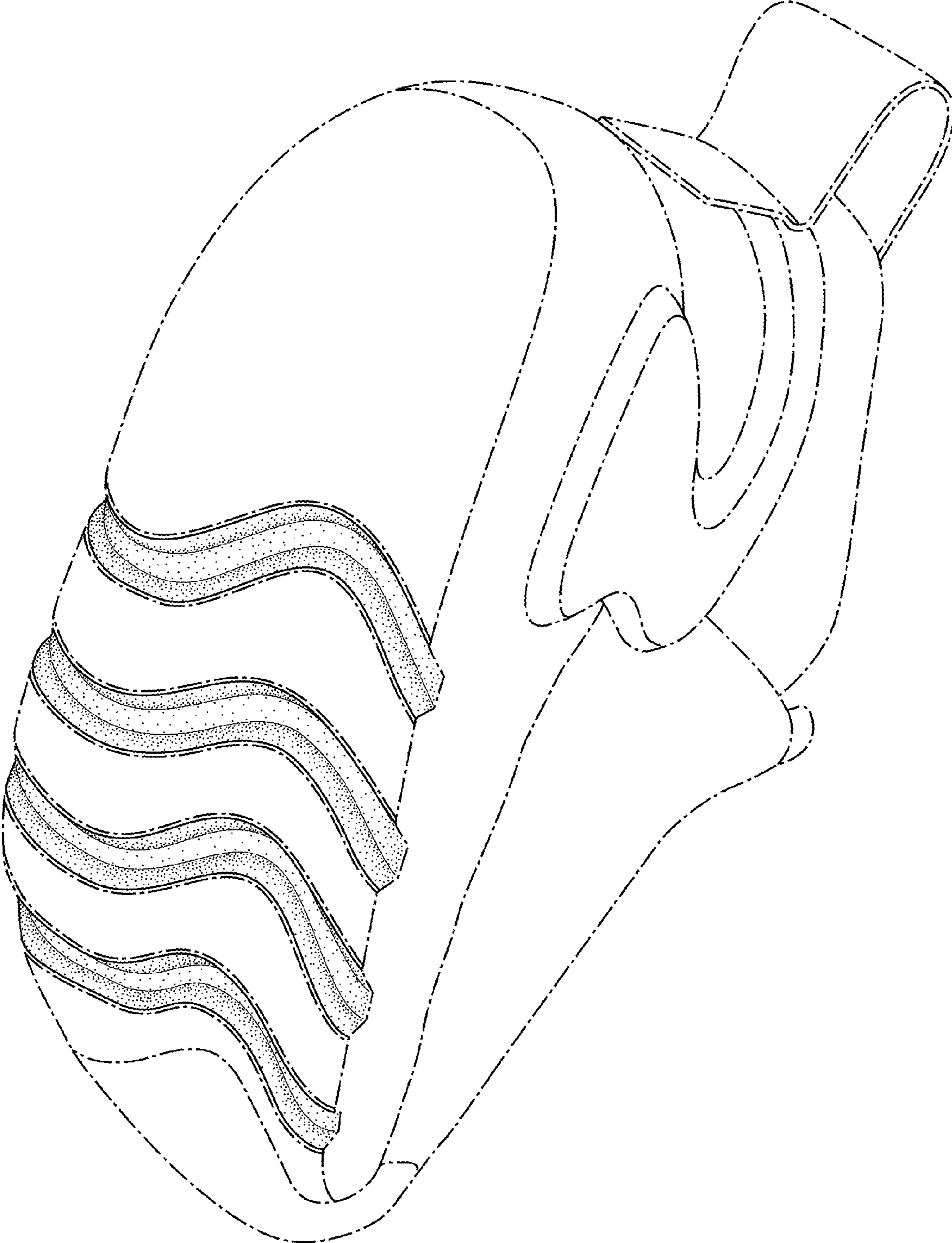
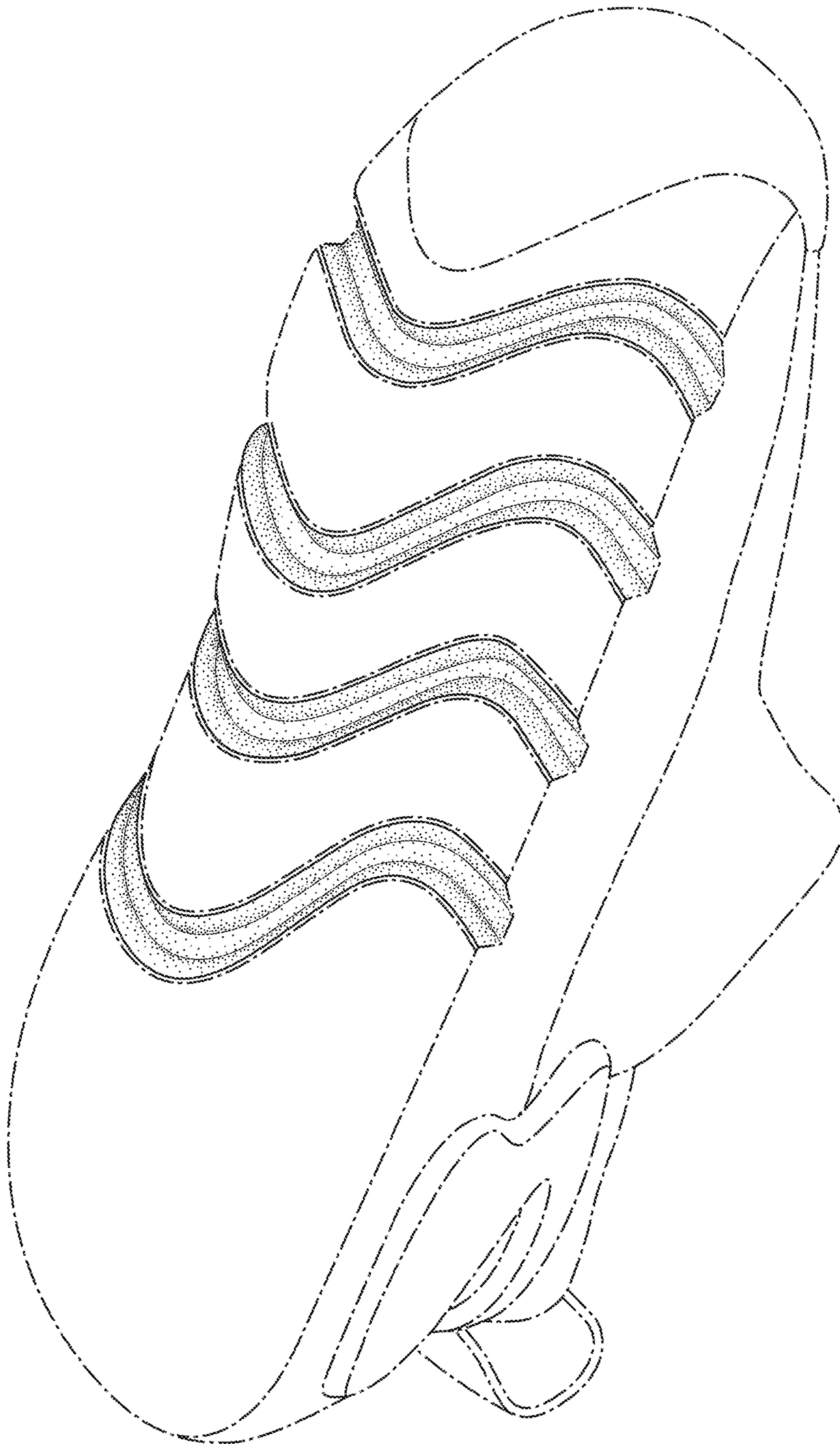

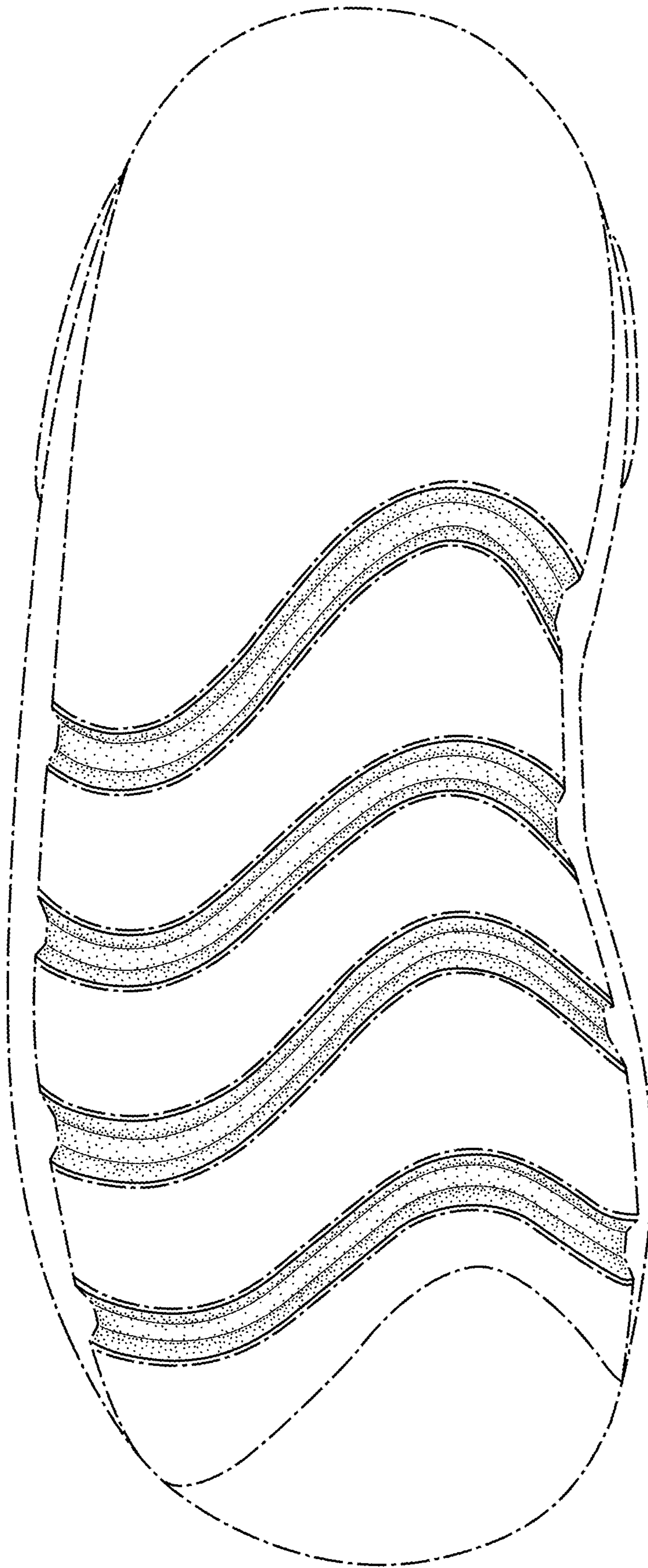

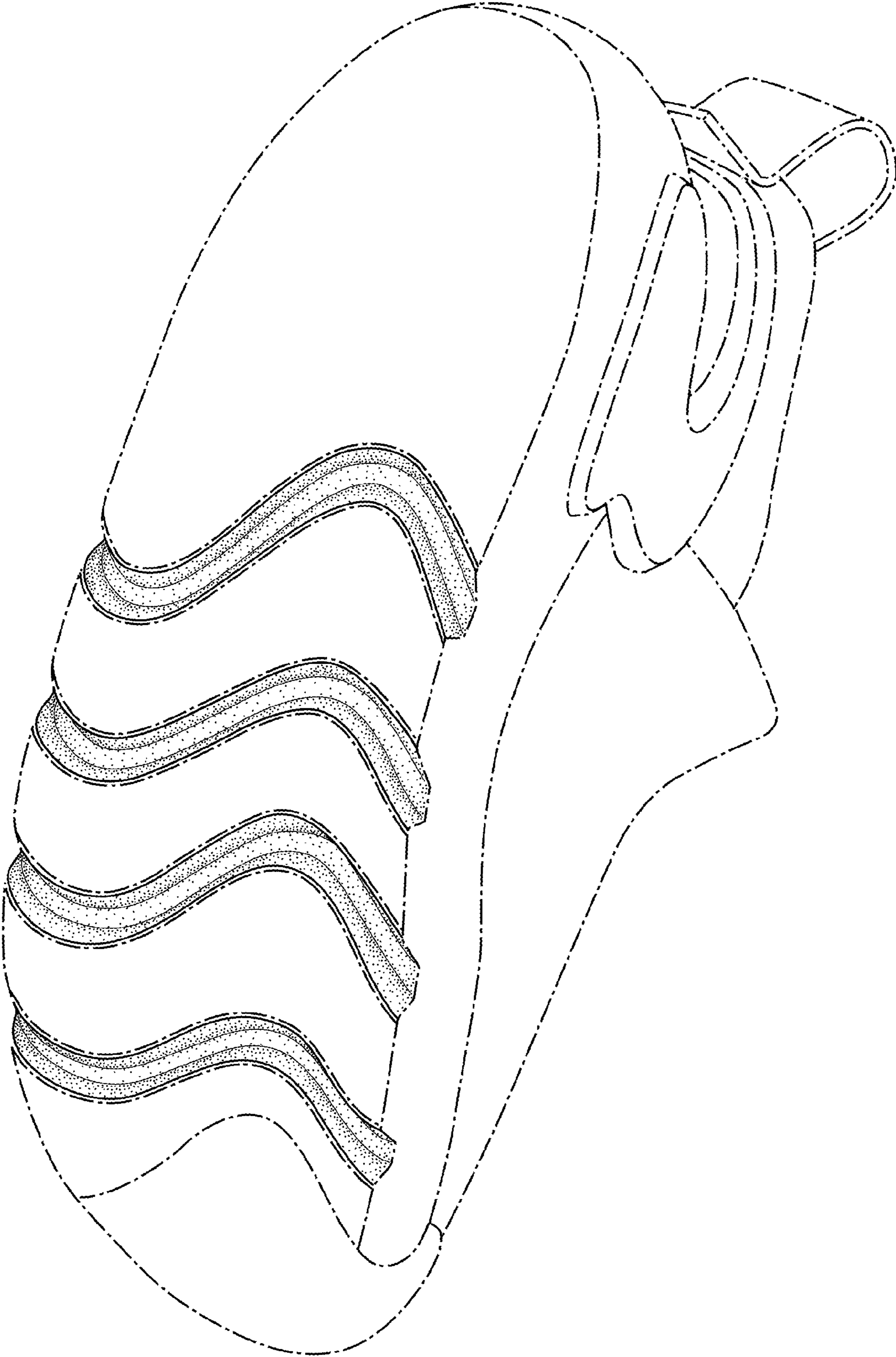
