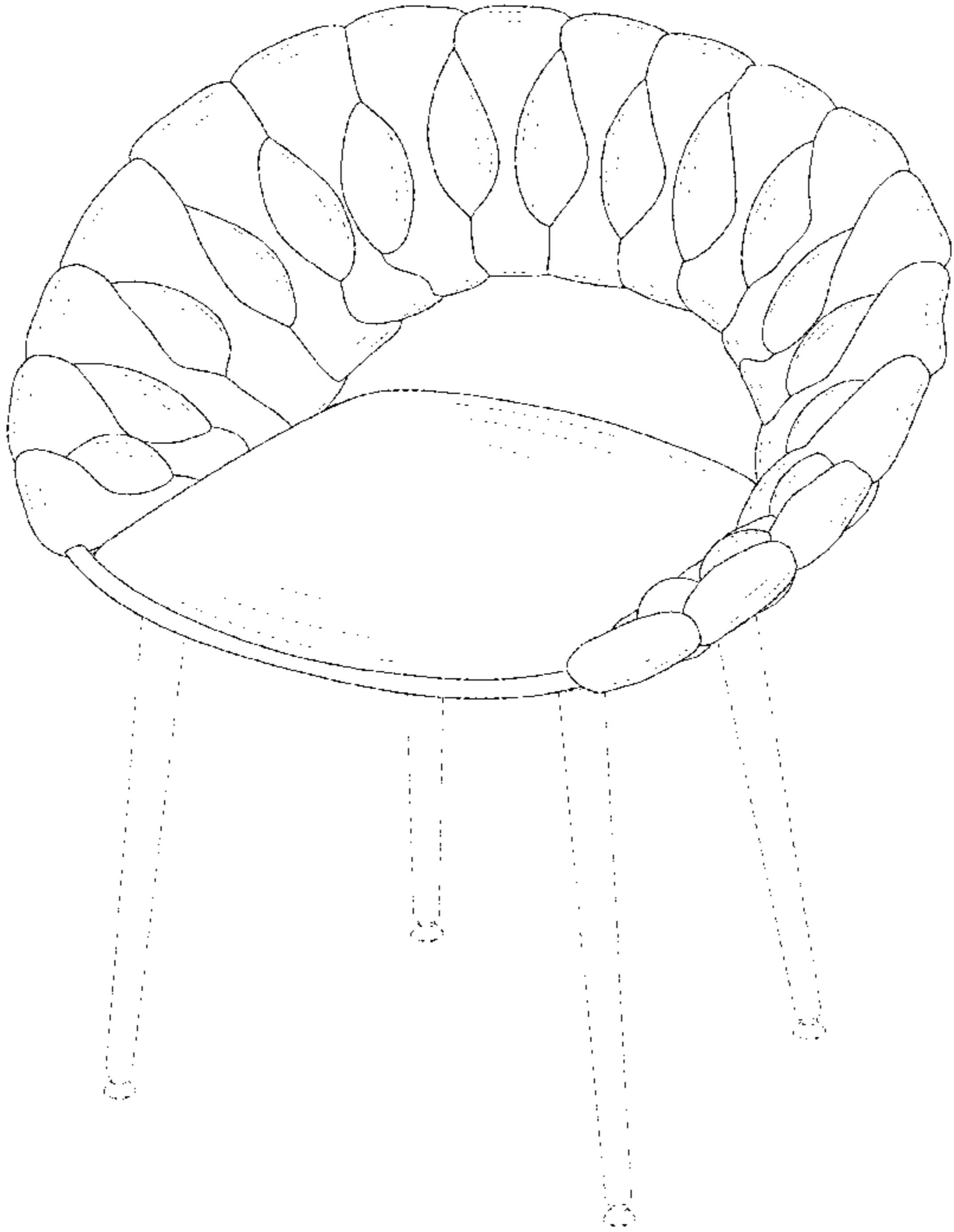

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dining chair, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image of FIG. 5;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

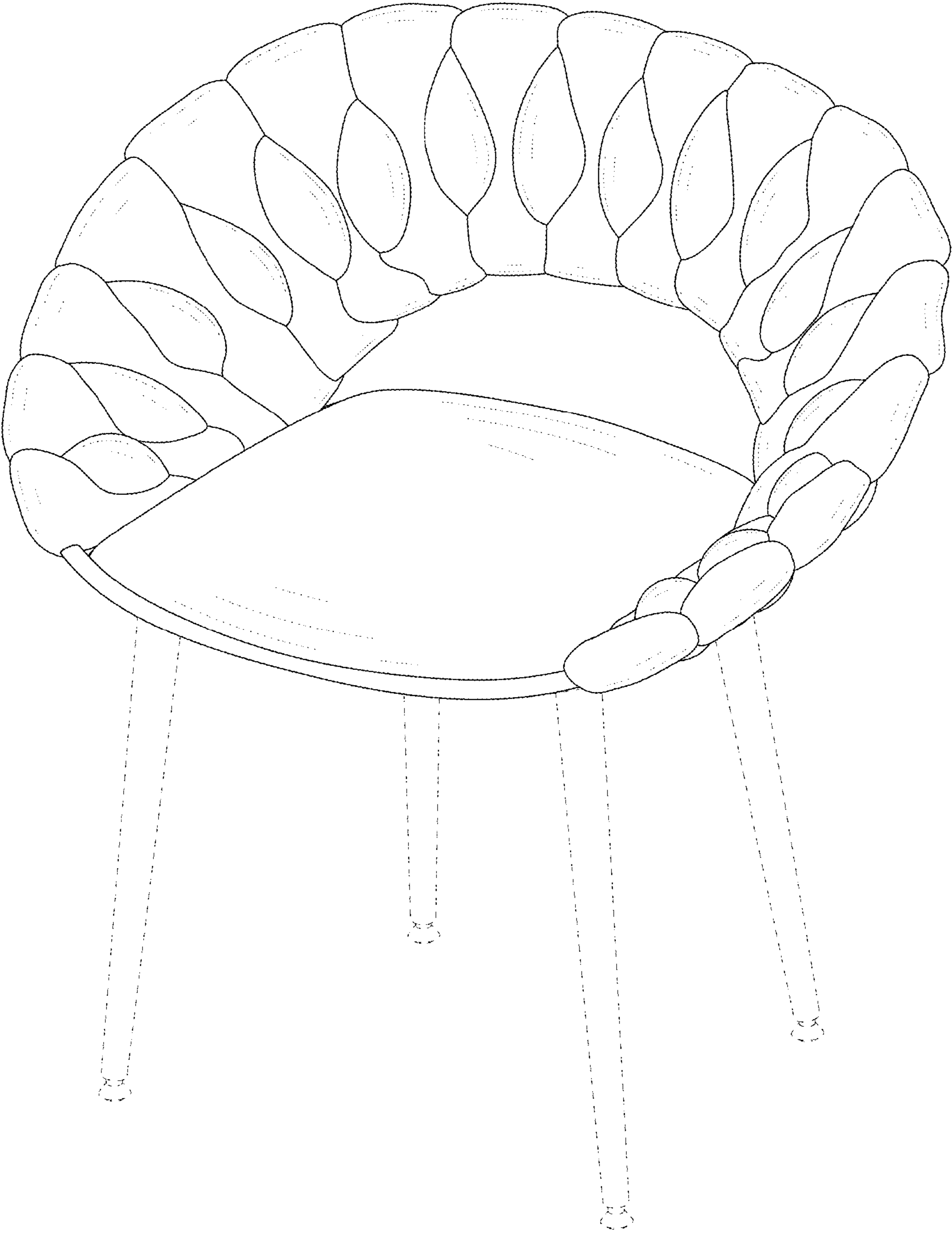

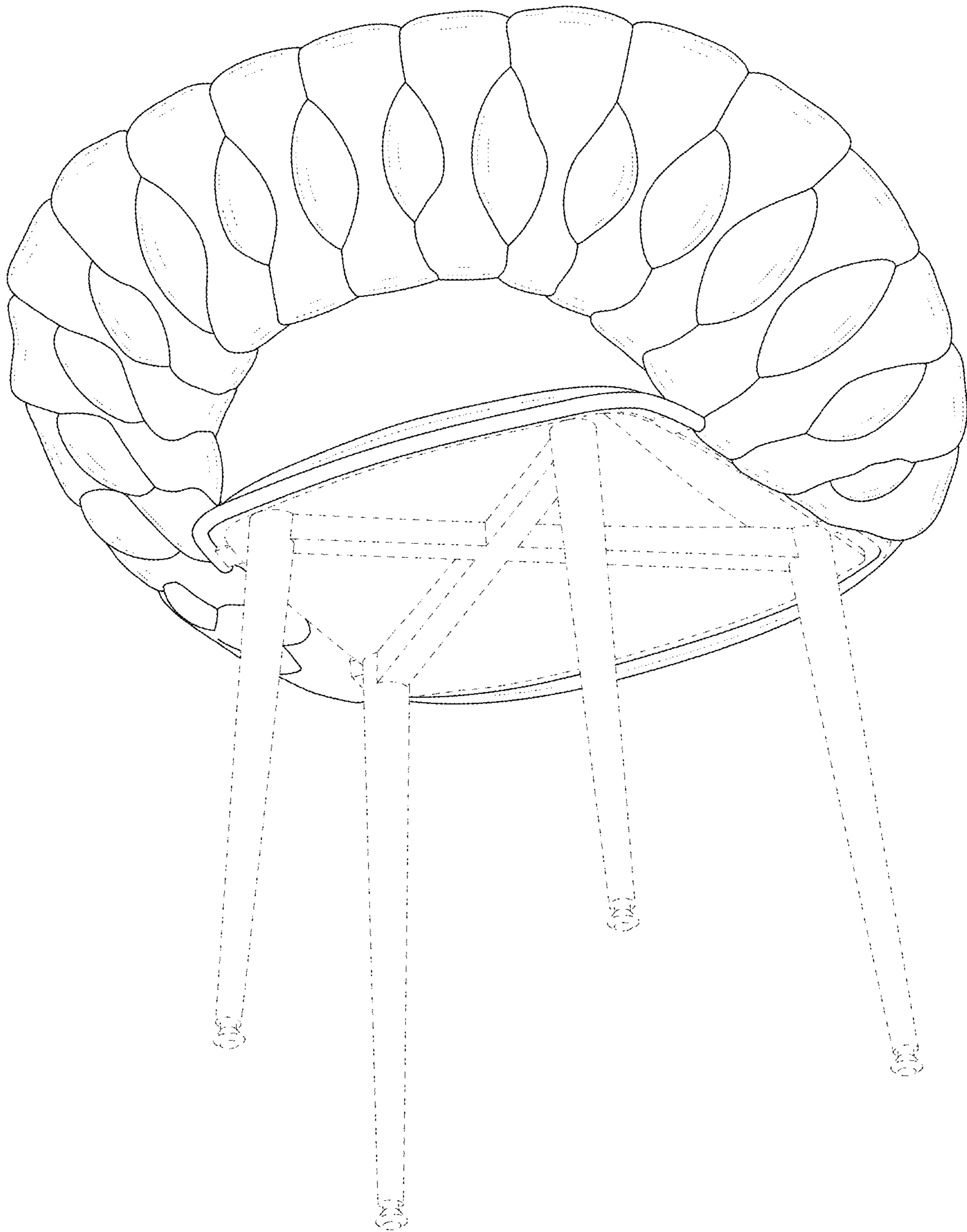

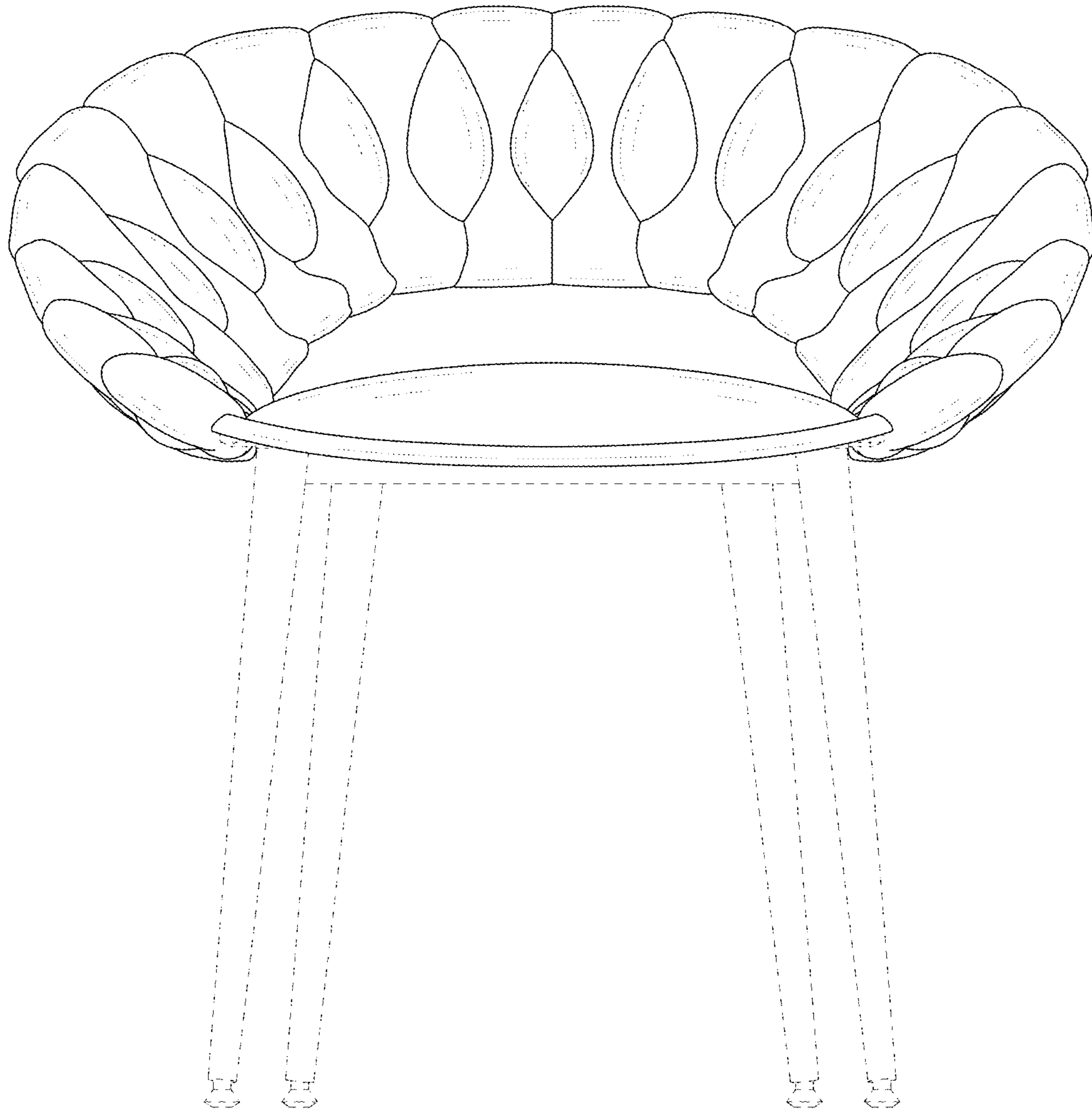

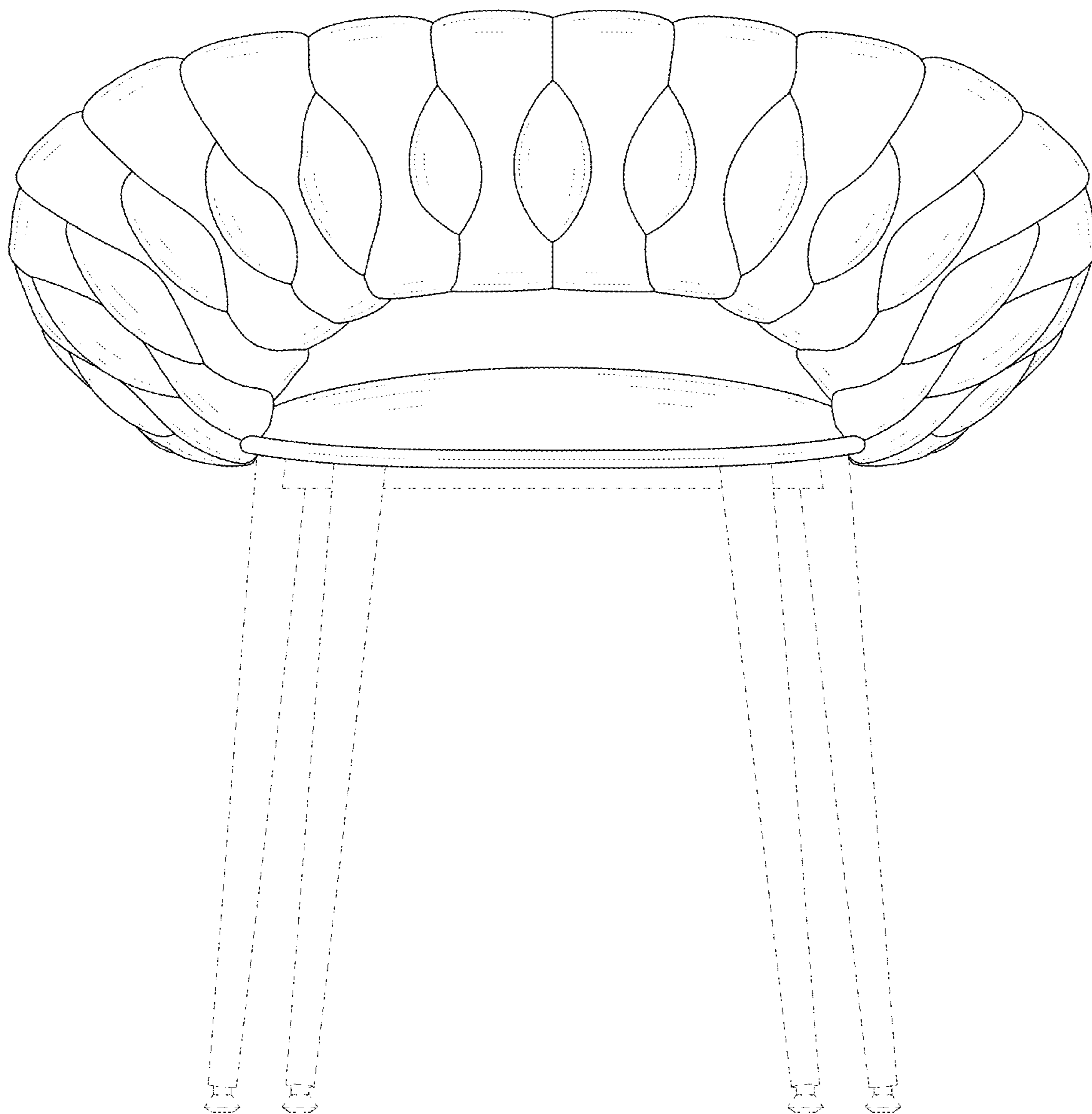

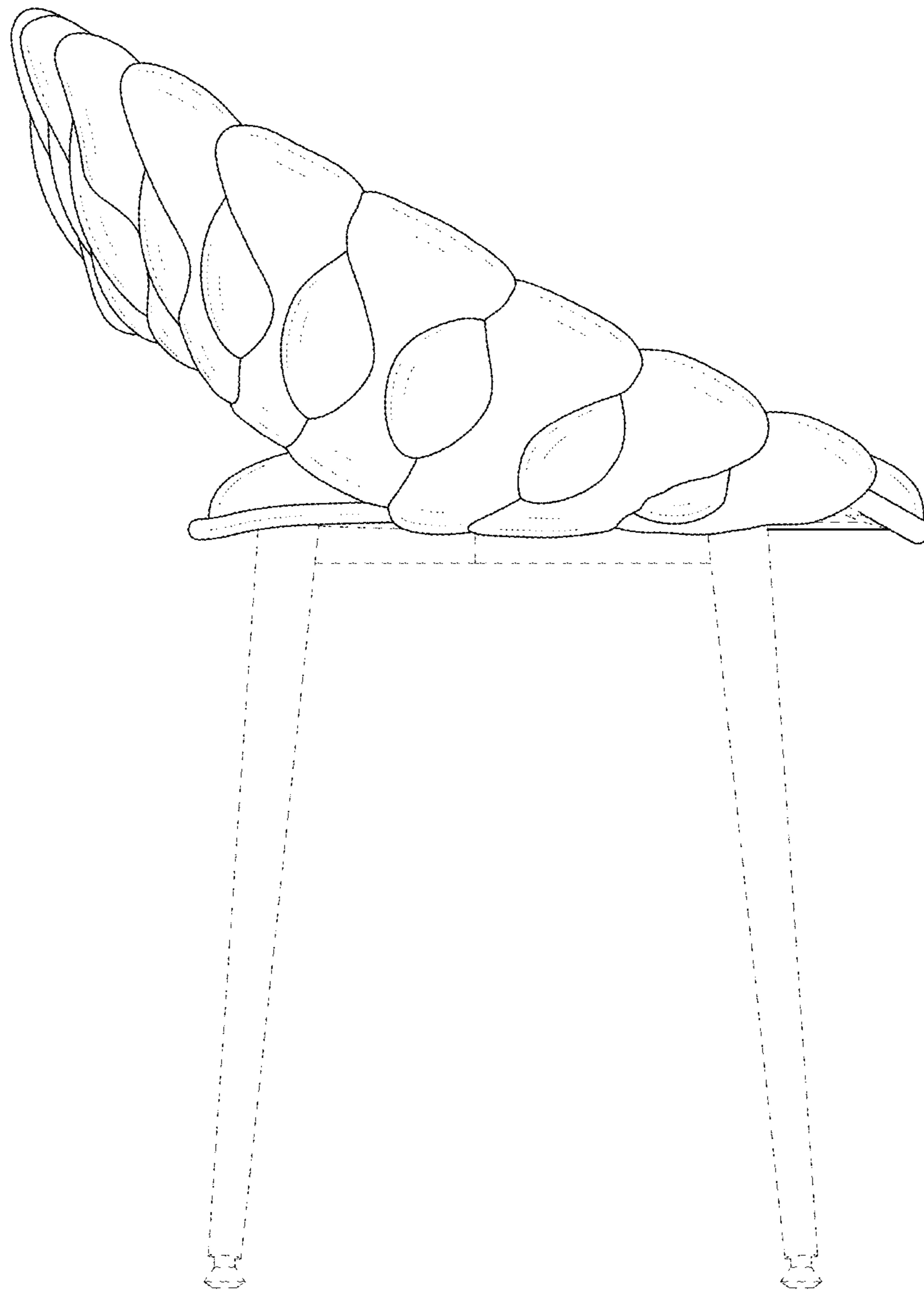

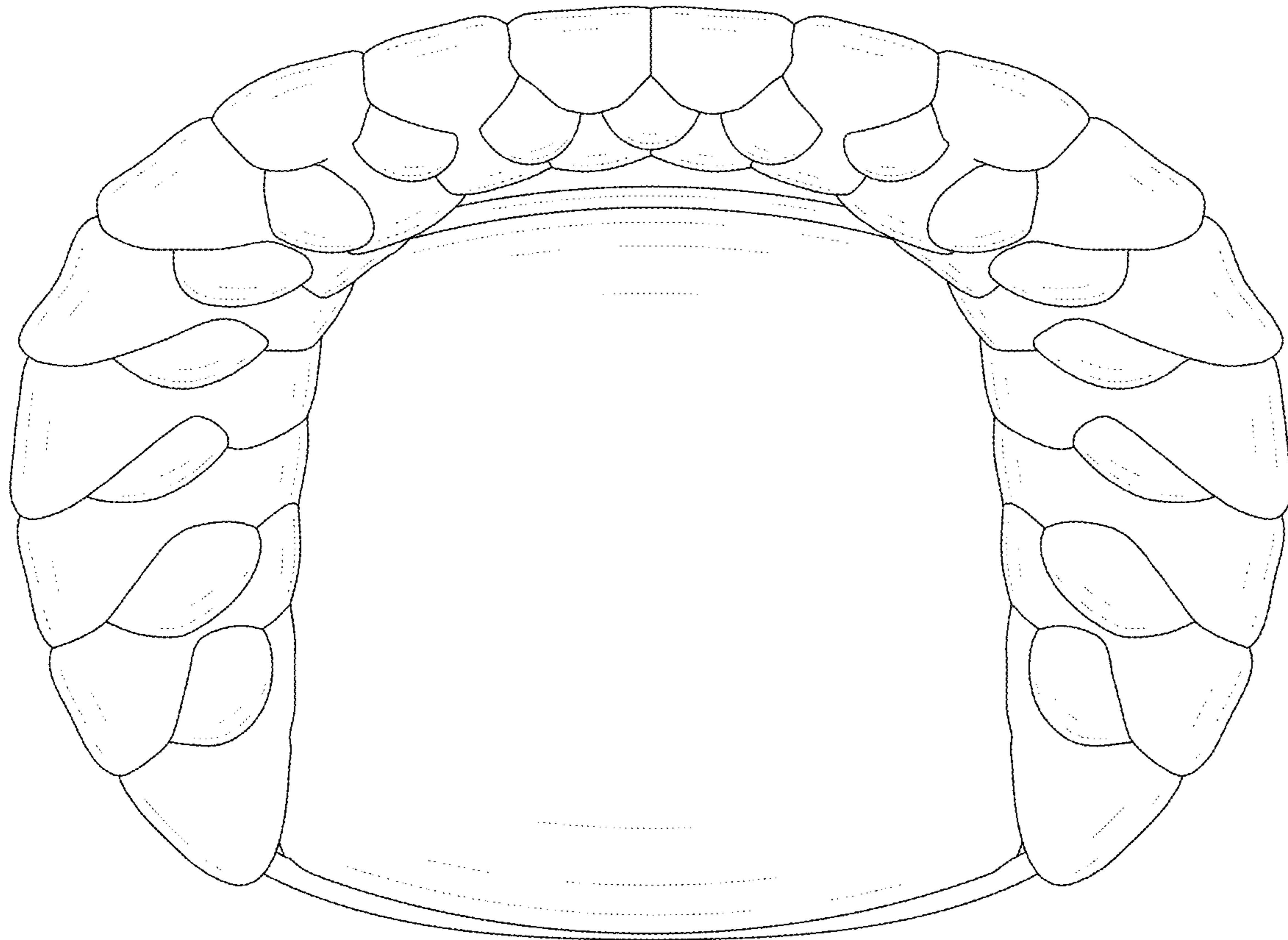

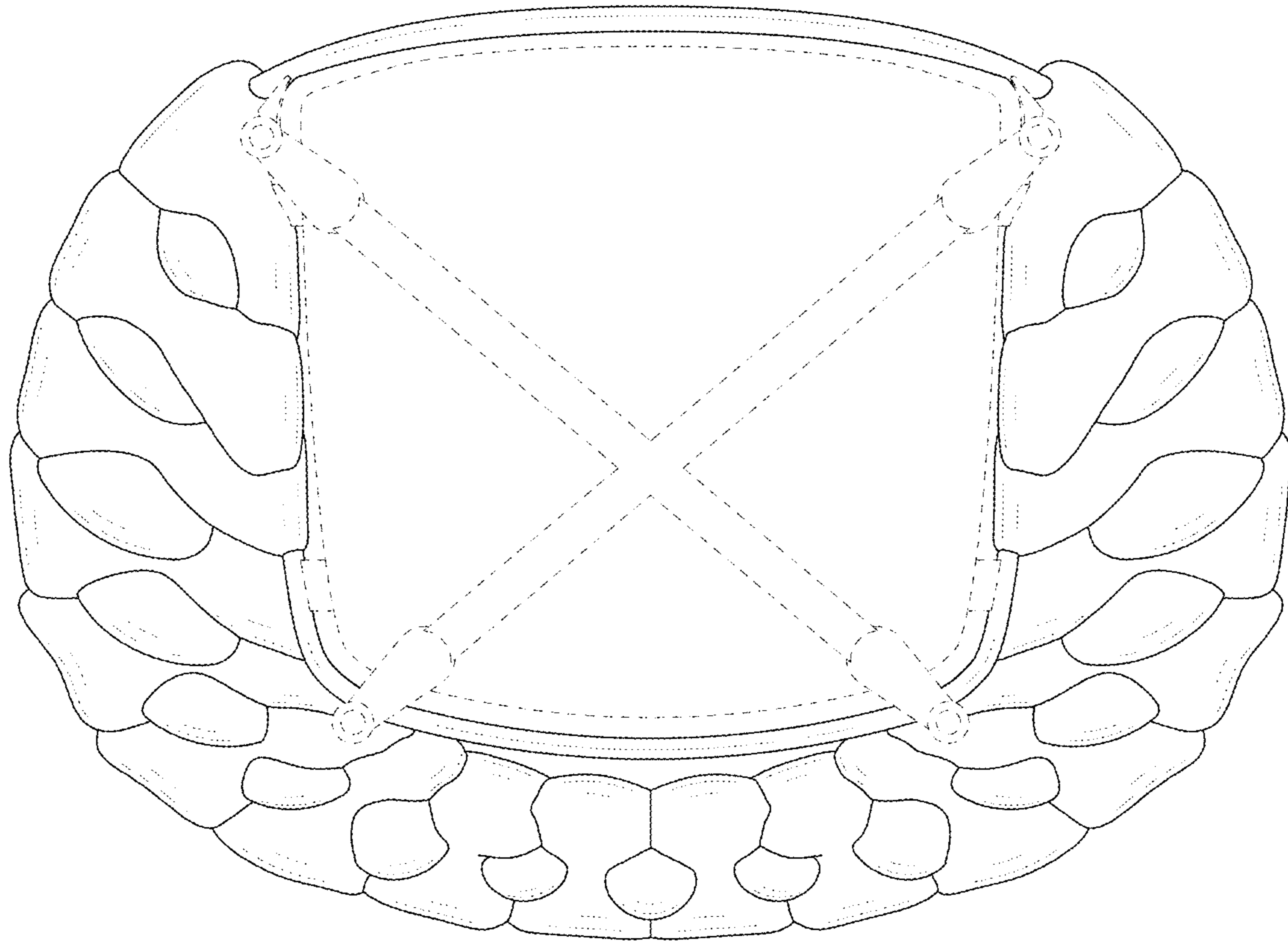
