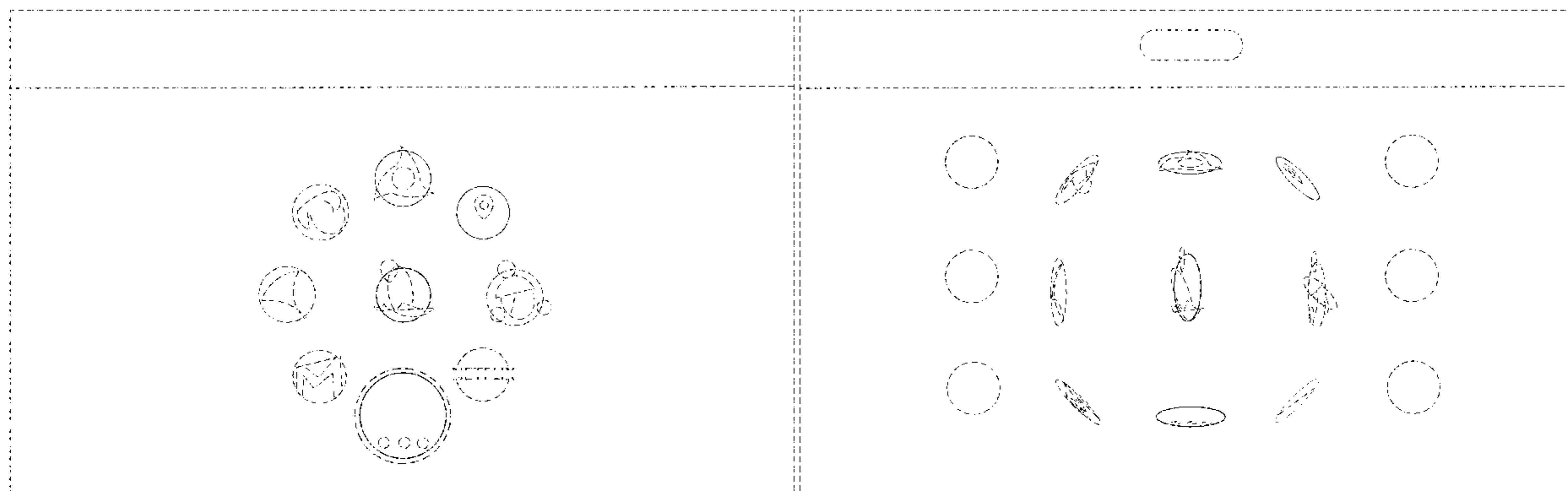
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display panel portion with an animated icon, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first image in a sequence for a display panel portion with an animated icon, showing our new design. FIG. 2 is a second image in the sequence thereof. FIG. 3 is a third image in the sequence thereof. FIG. 4 is a fourth image in the sequence thereof. FIG. 5 is a fifth image in the sequence thereof. FIG. 6 is a sixth image in the sequence thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a seventh image in the sequence thereof. The appearance of the display sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-7. The process or the period in which one image transitions to another image forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines showing a portion of a virtual reality display panel and portions of the animated computer icon in FIGS. 1-7 form no part of the claimed design.

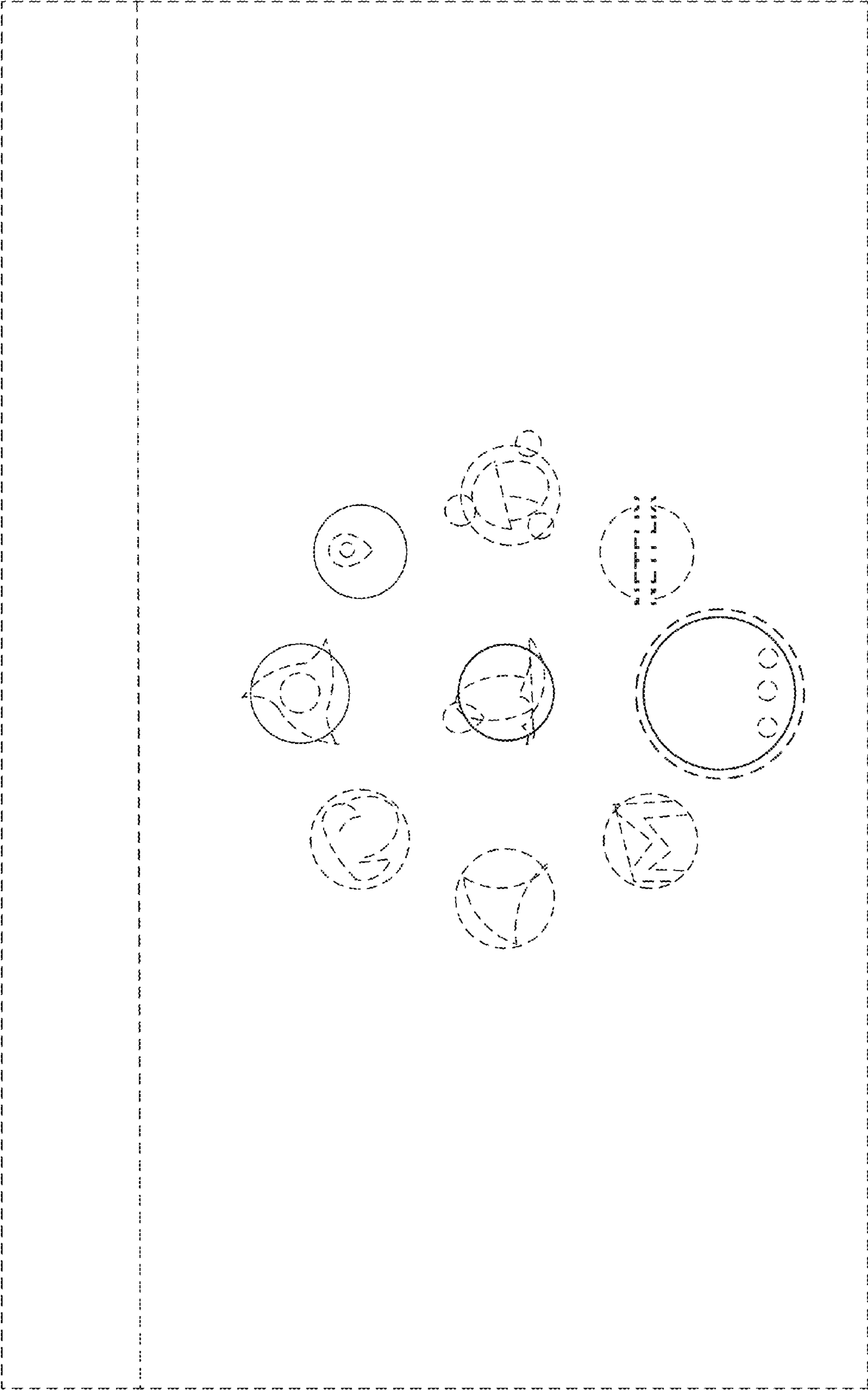

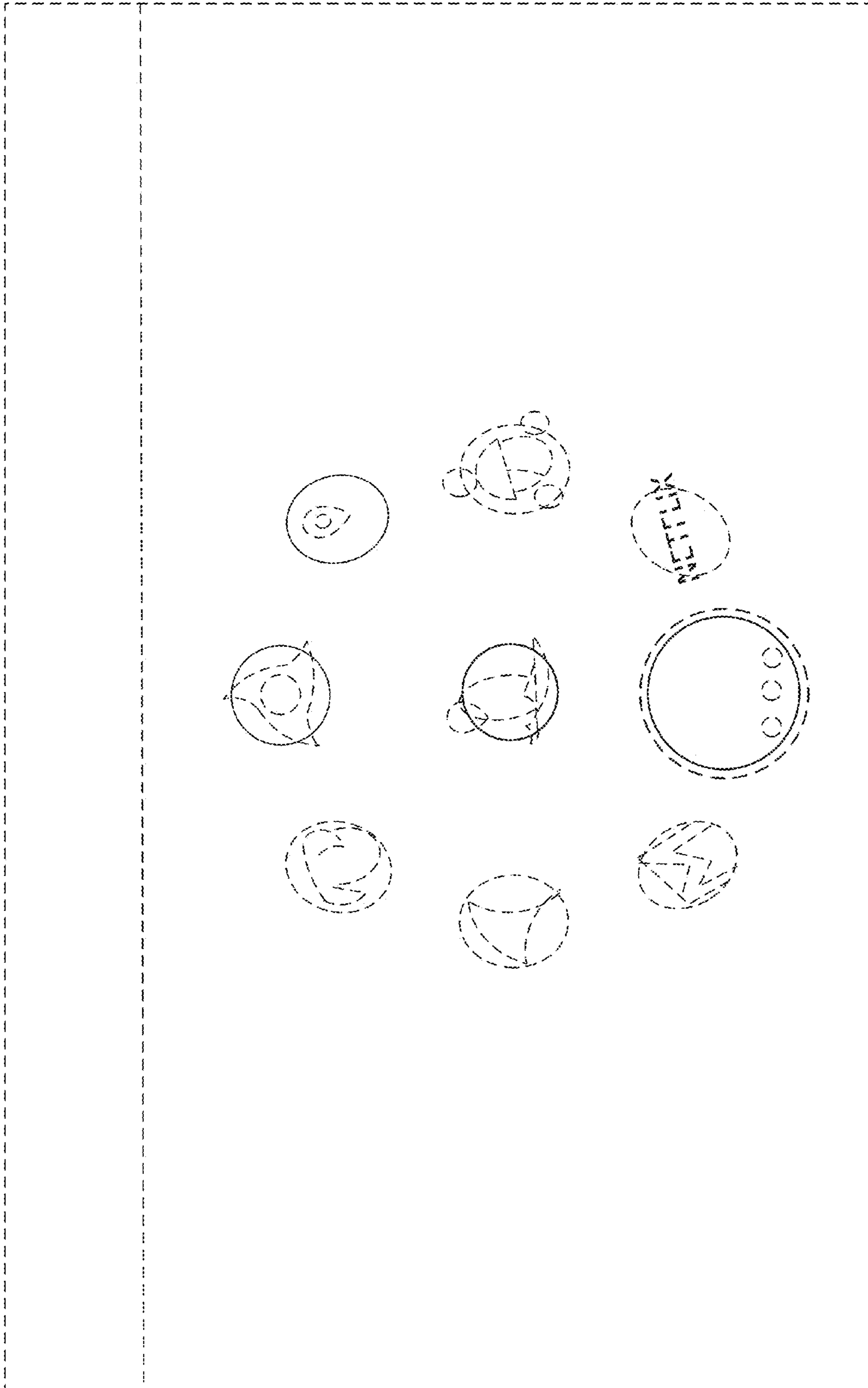

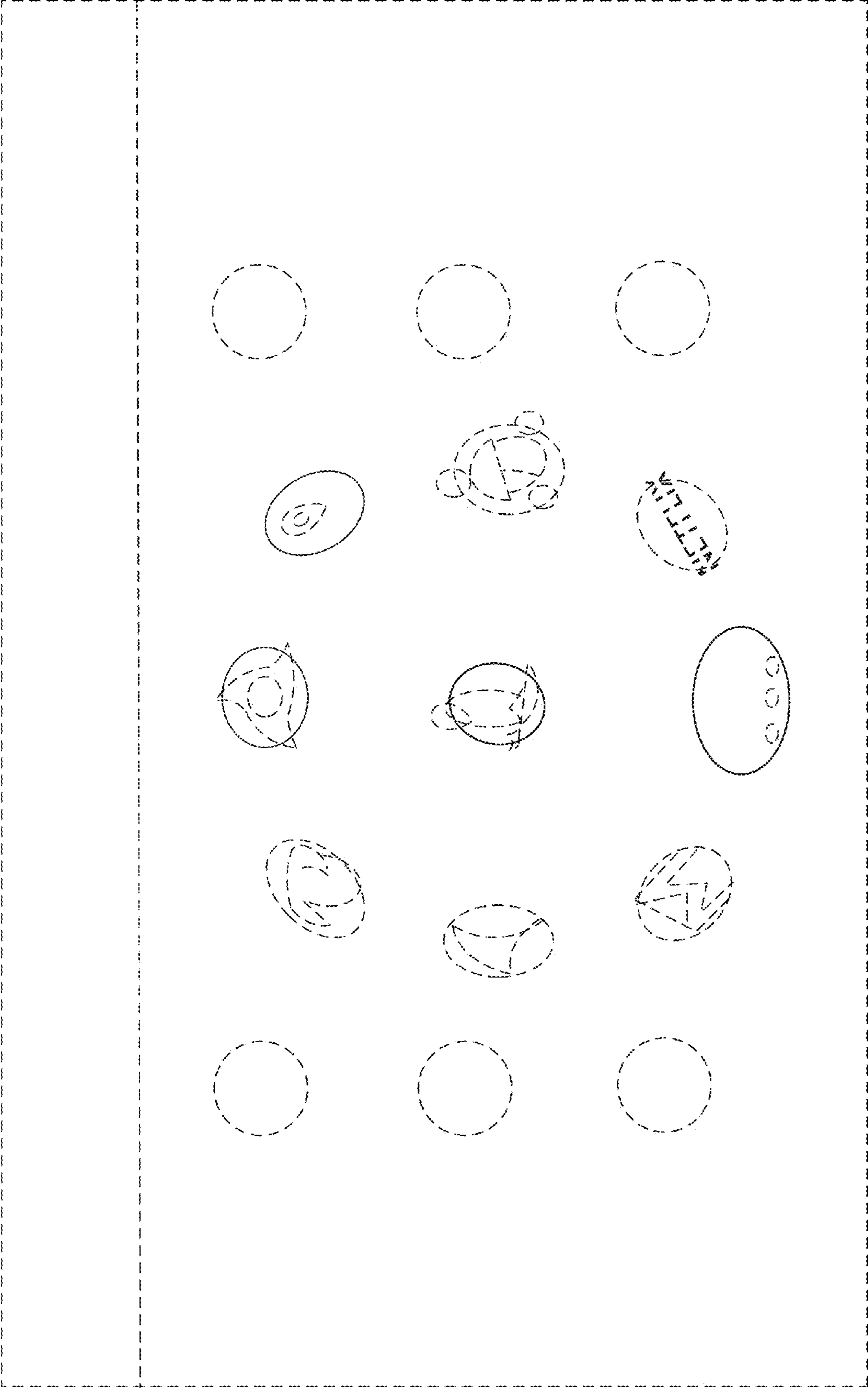

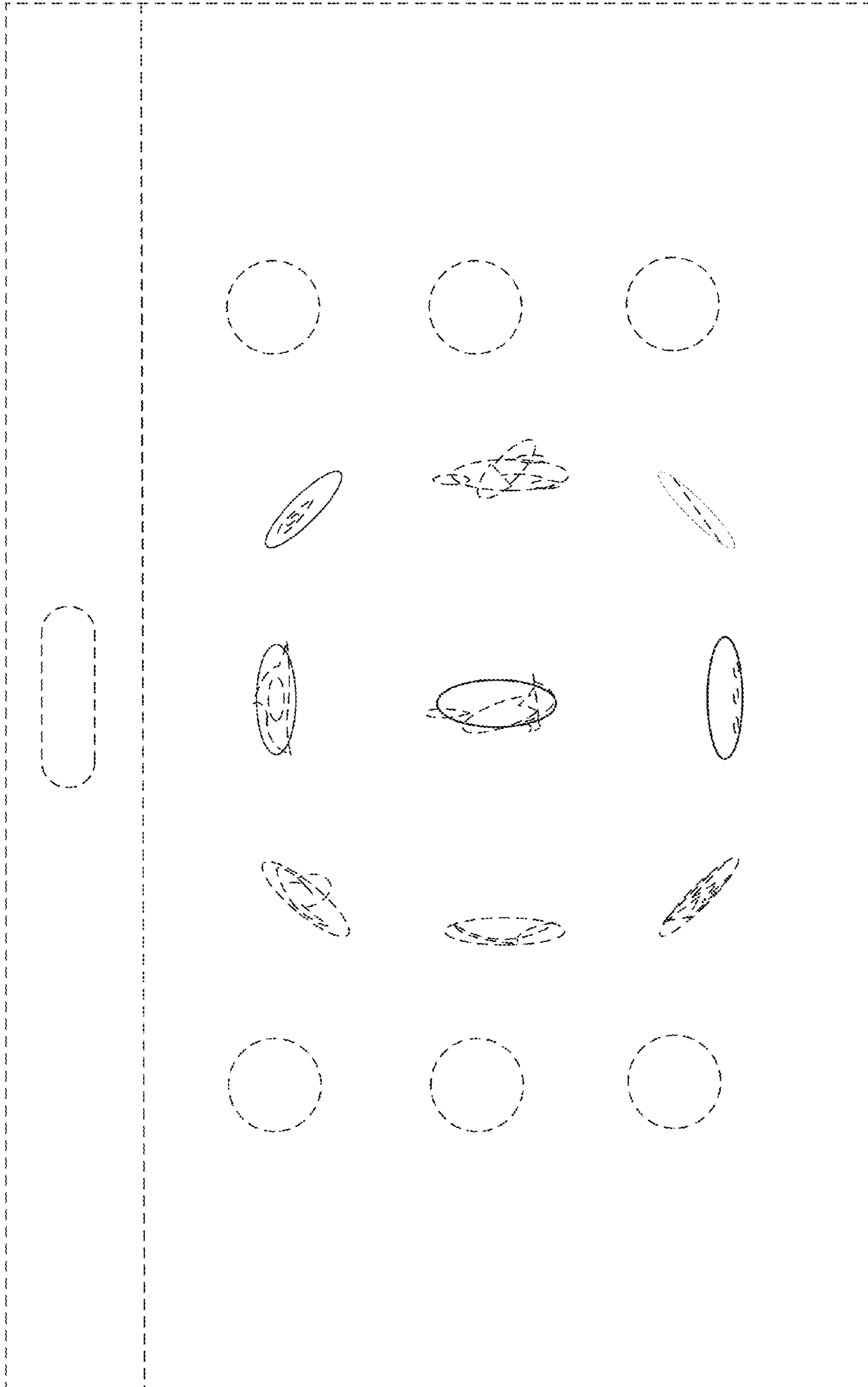

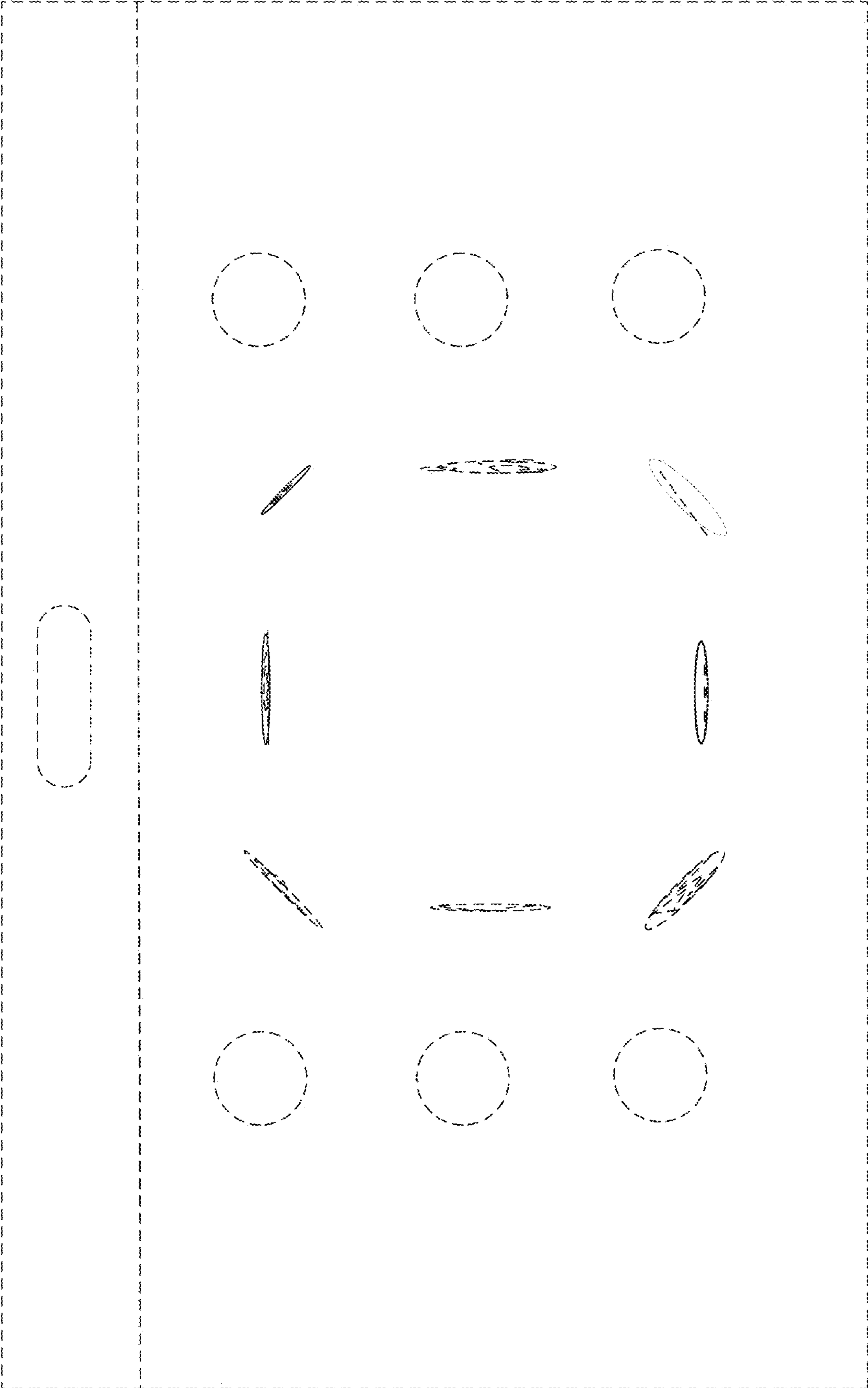

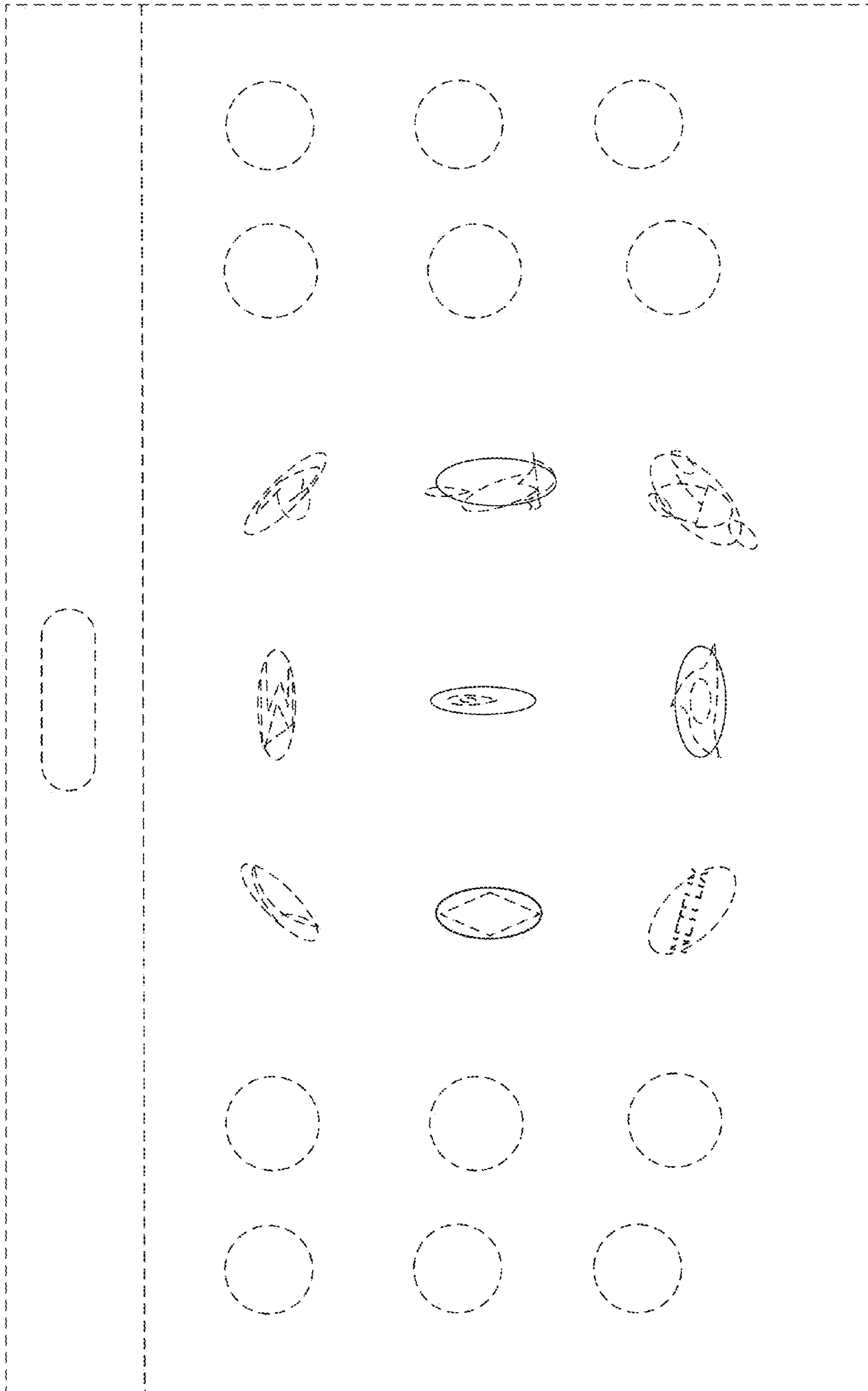

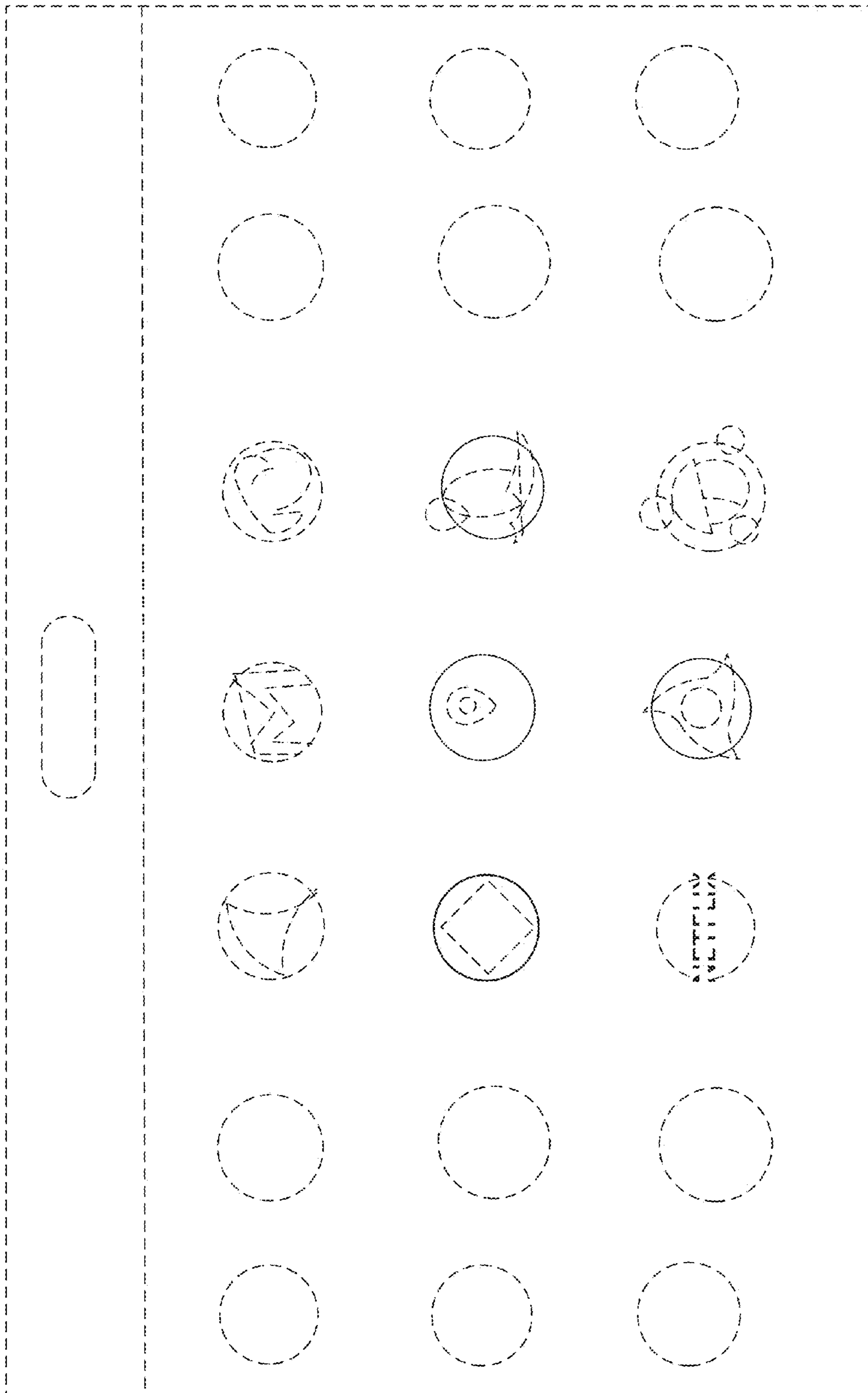
