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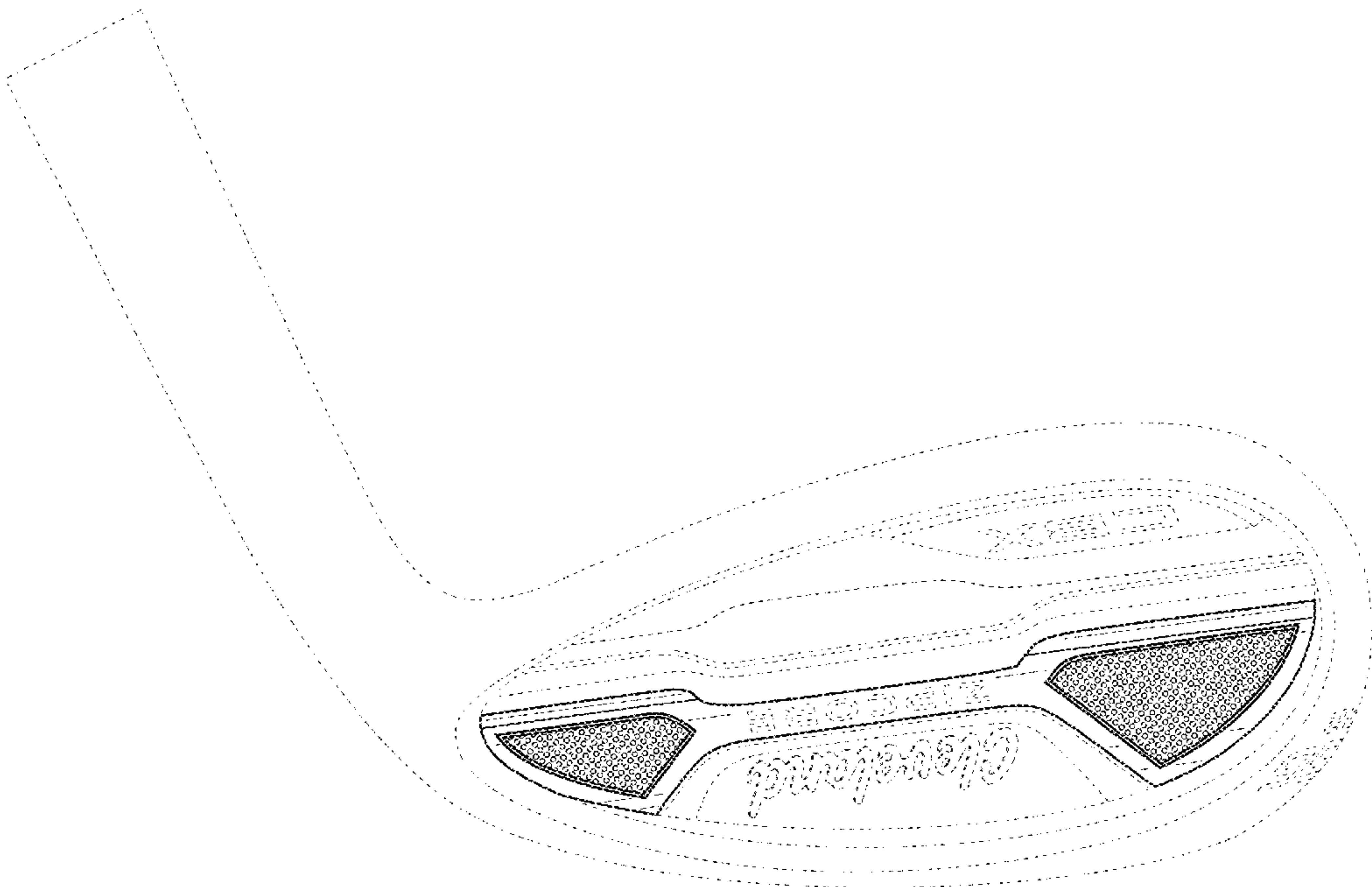

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, toe-side, top perspective view of a golf club head, showing the new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a heel-side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a top, toe-side, rear elevational view thereof.

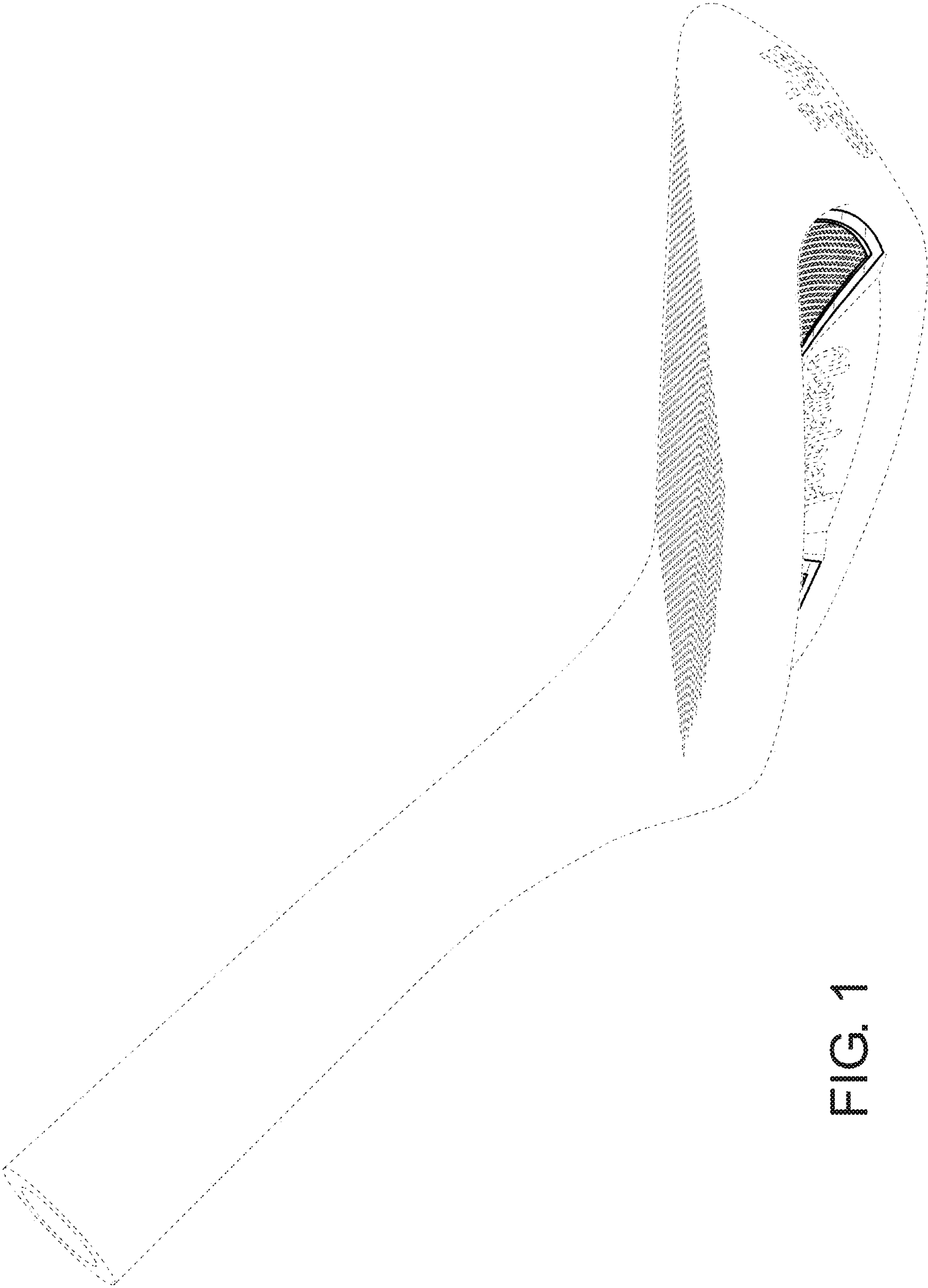

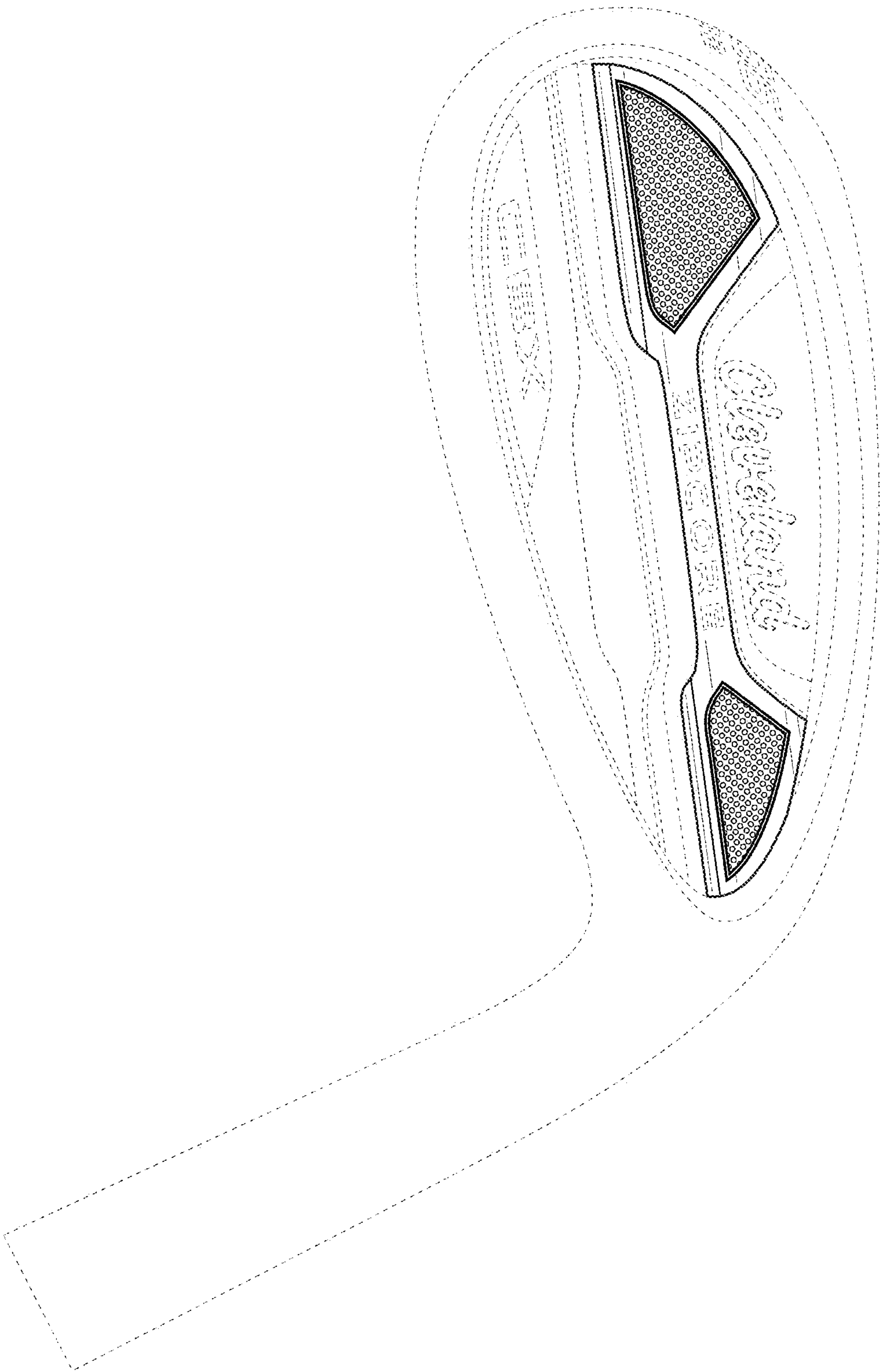

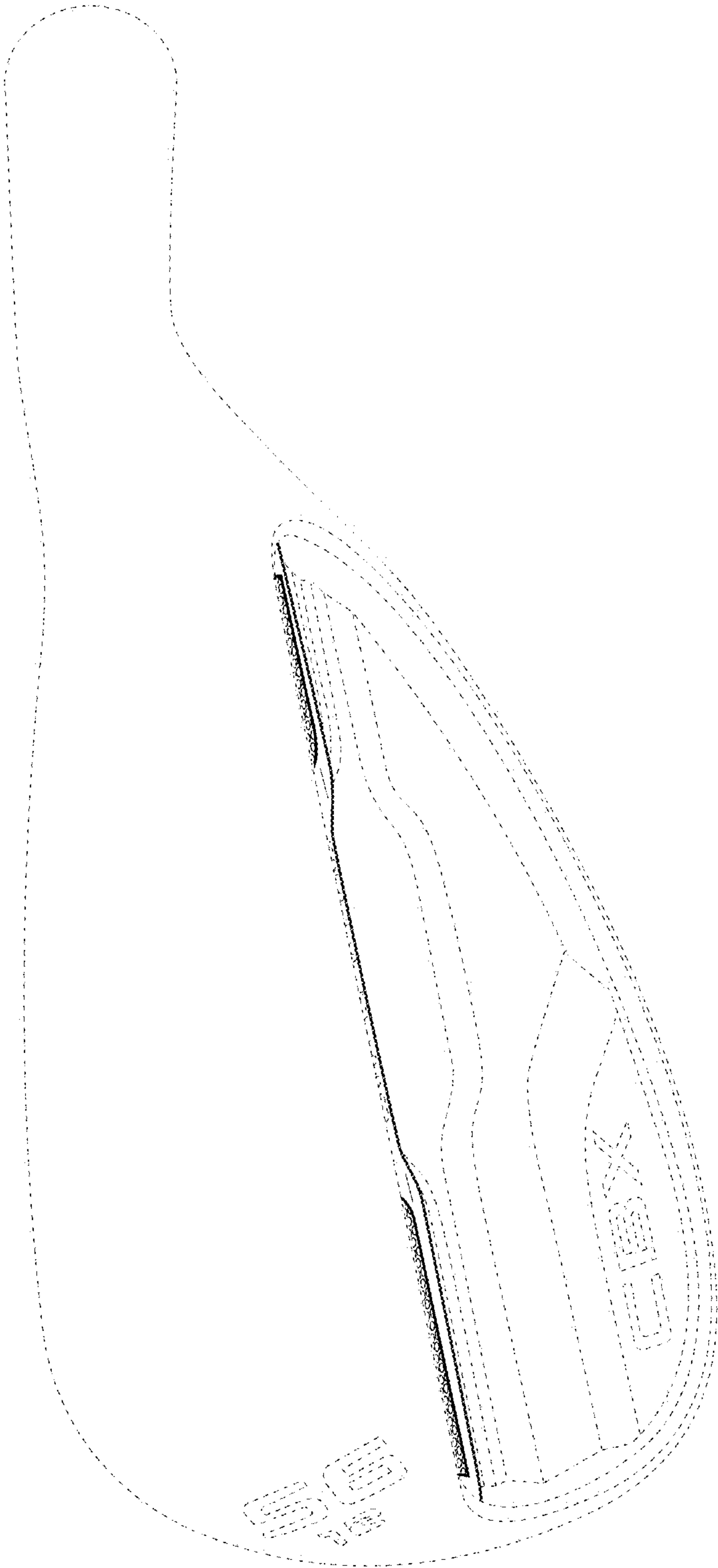

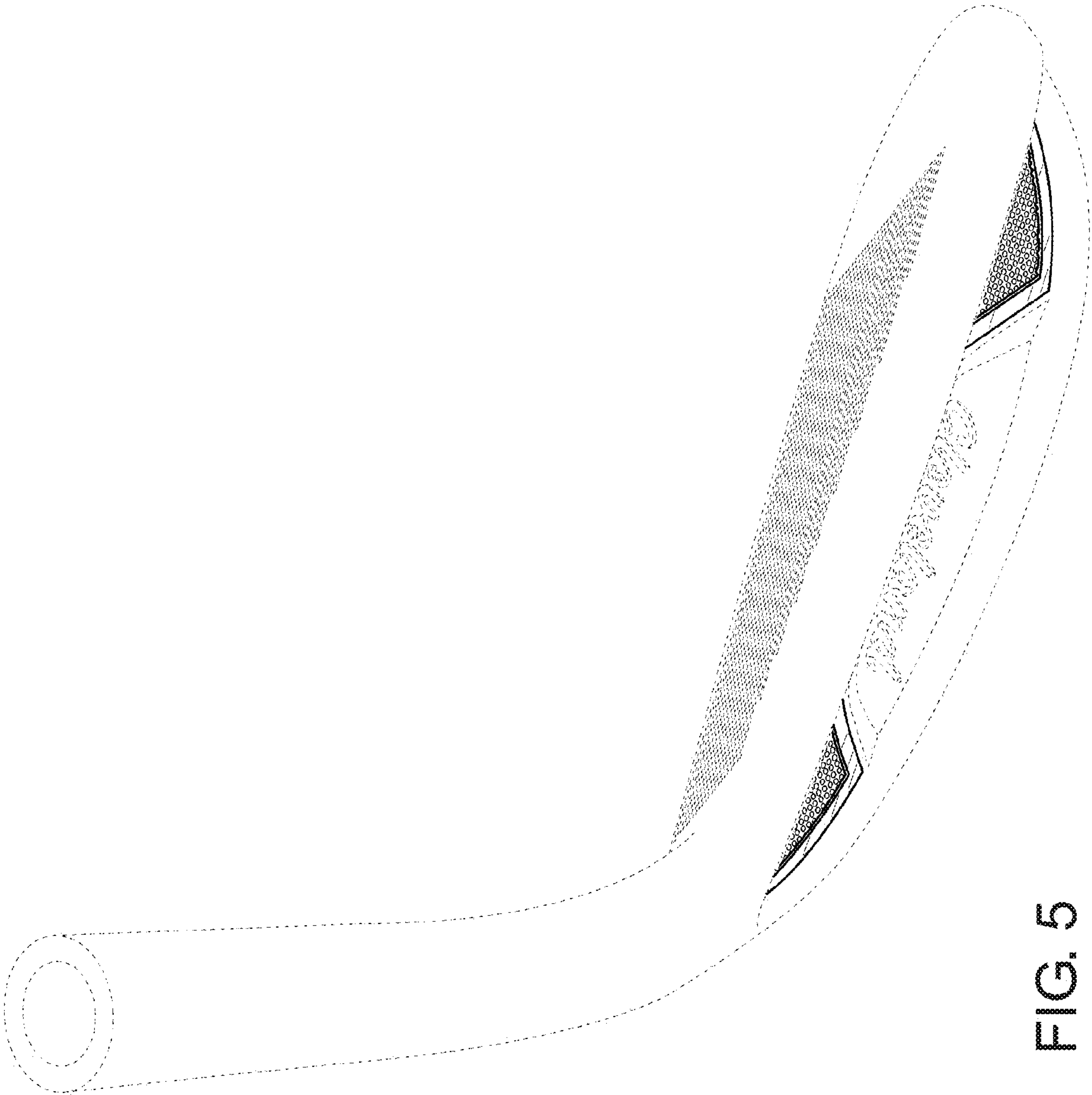
