DESCRIPTION

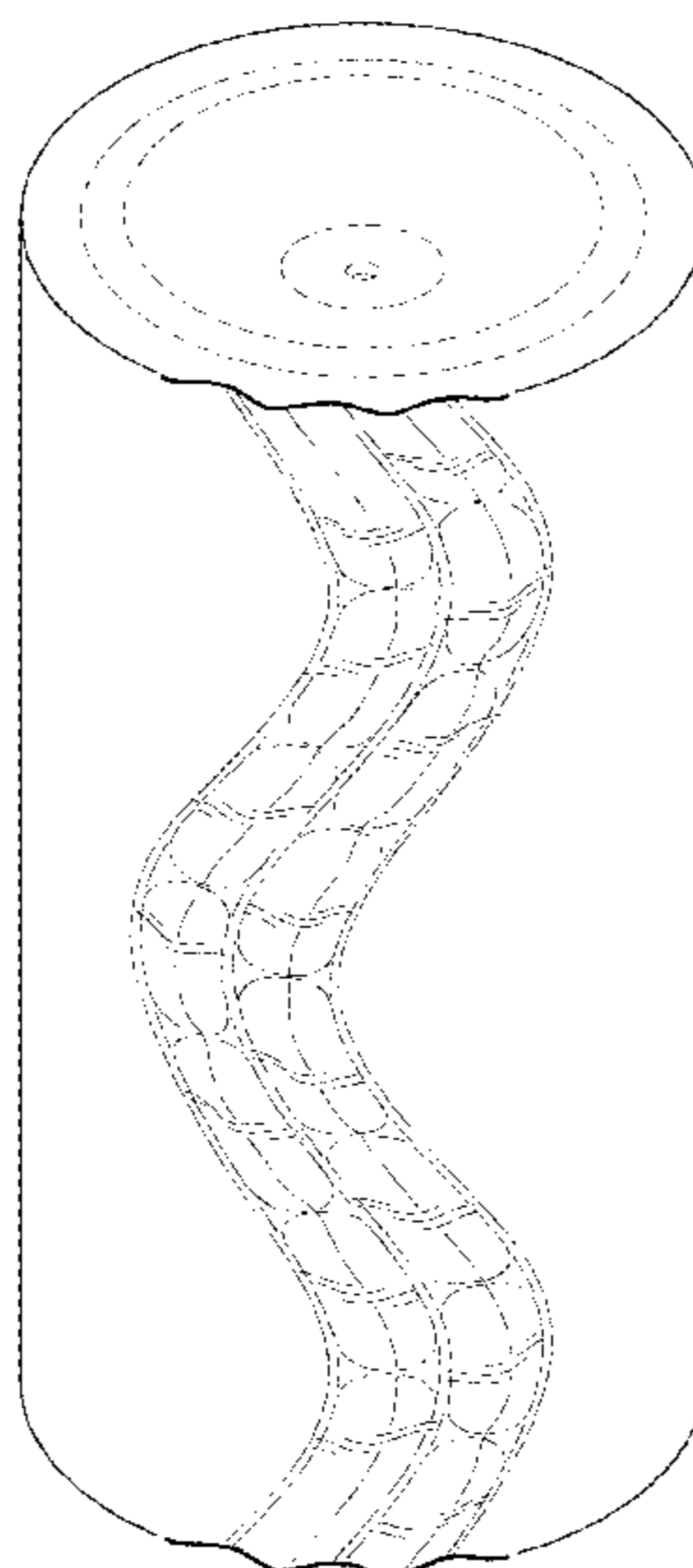
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a massage roller, showing my new design;

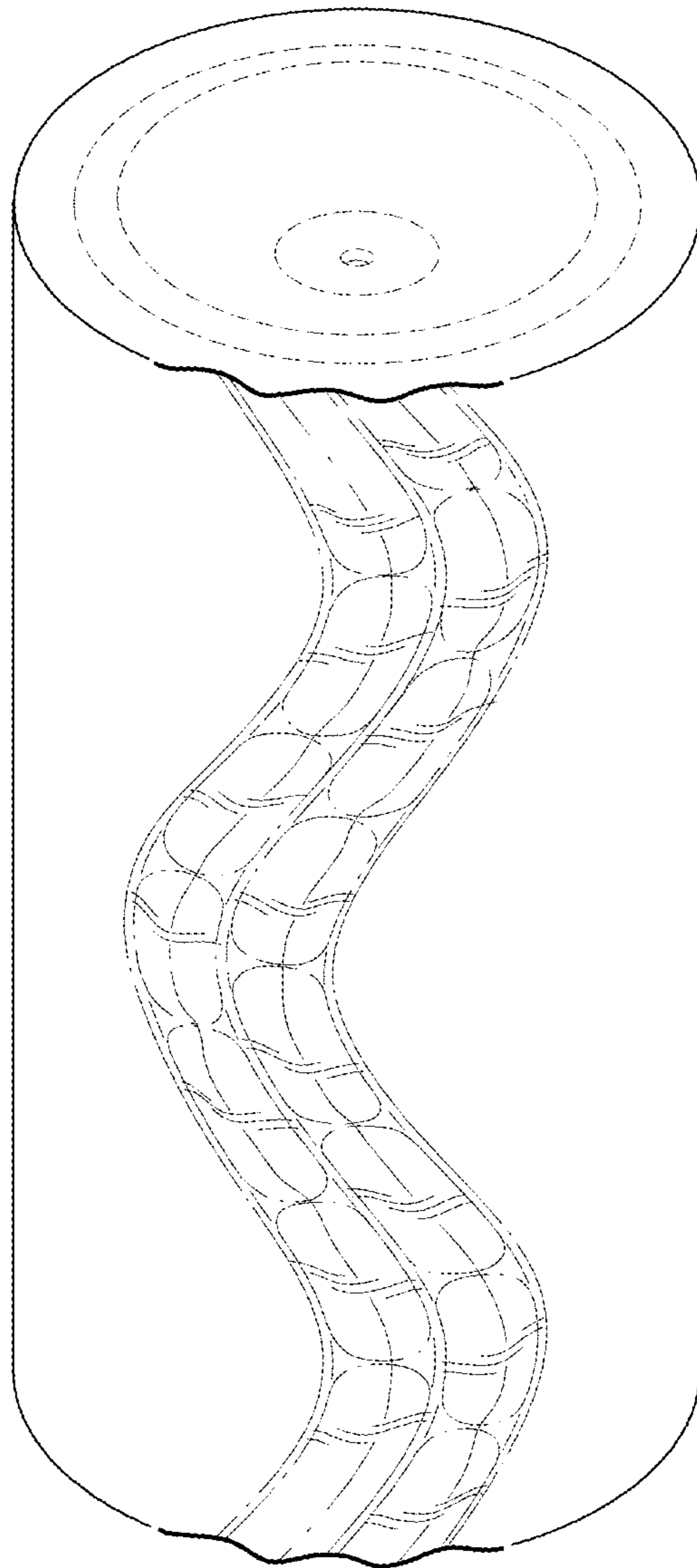

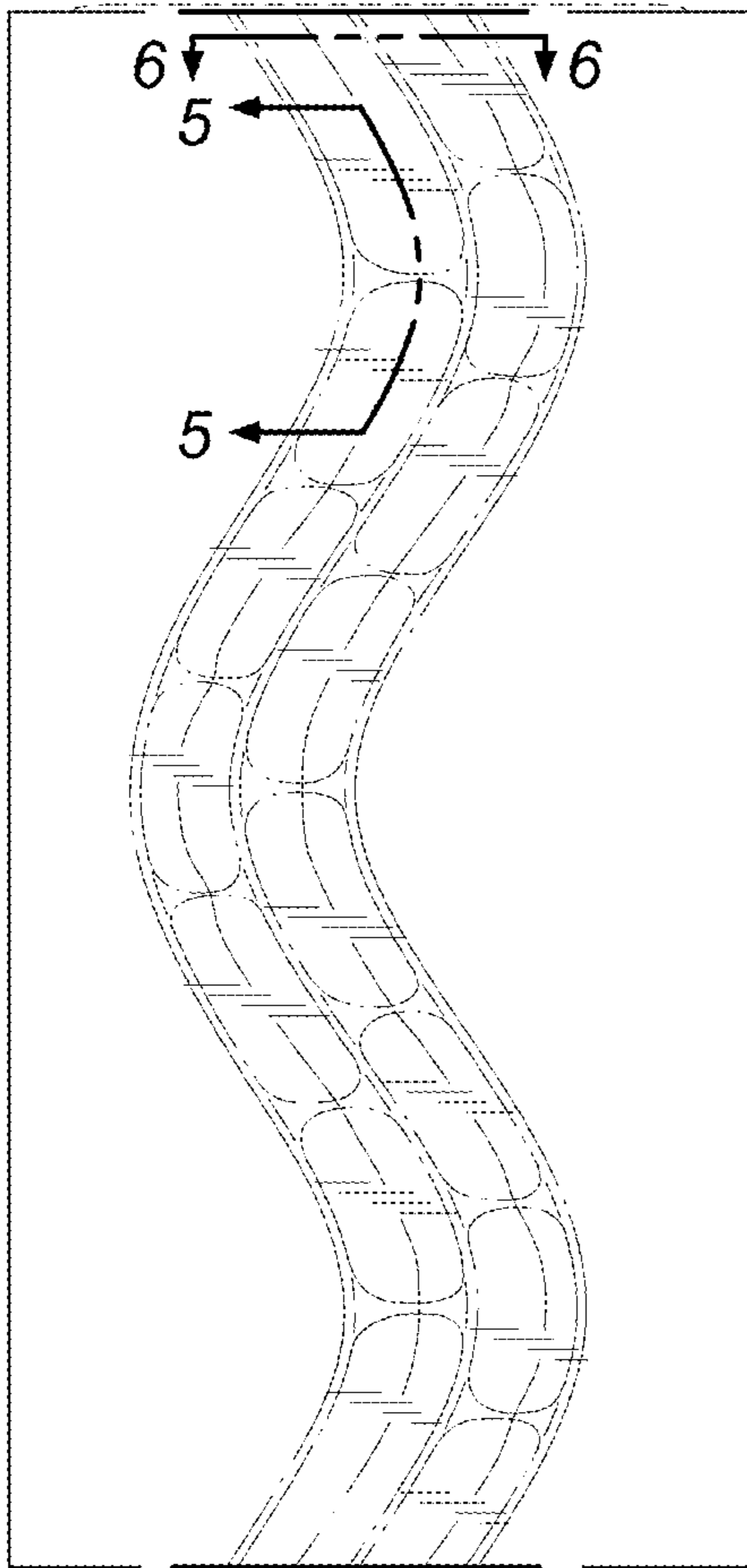

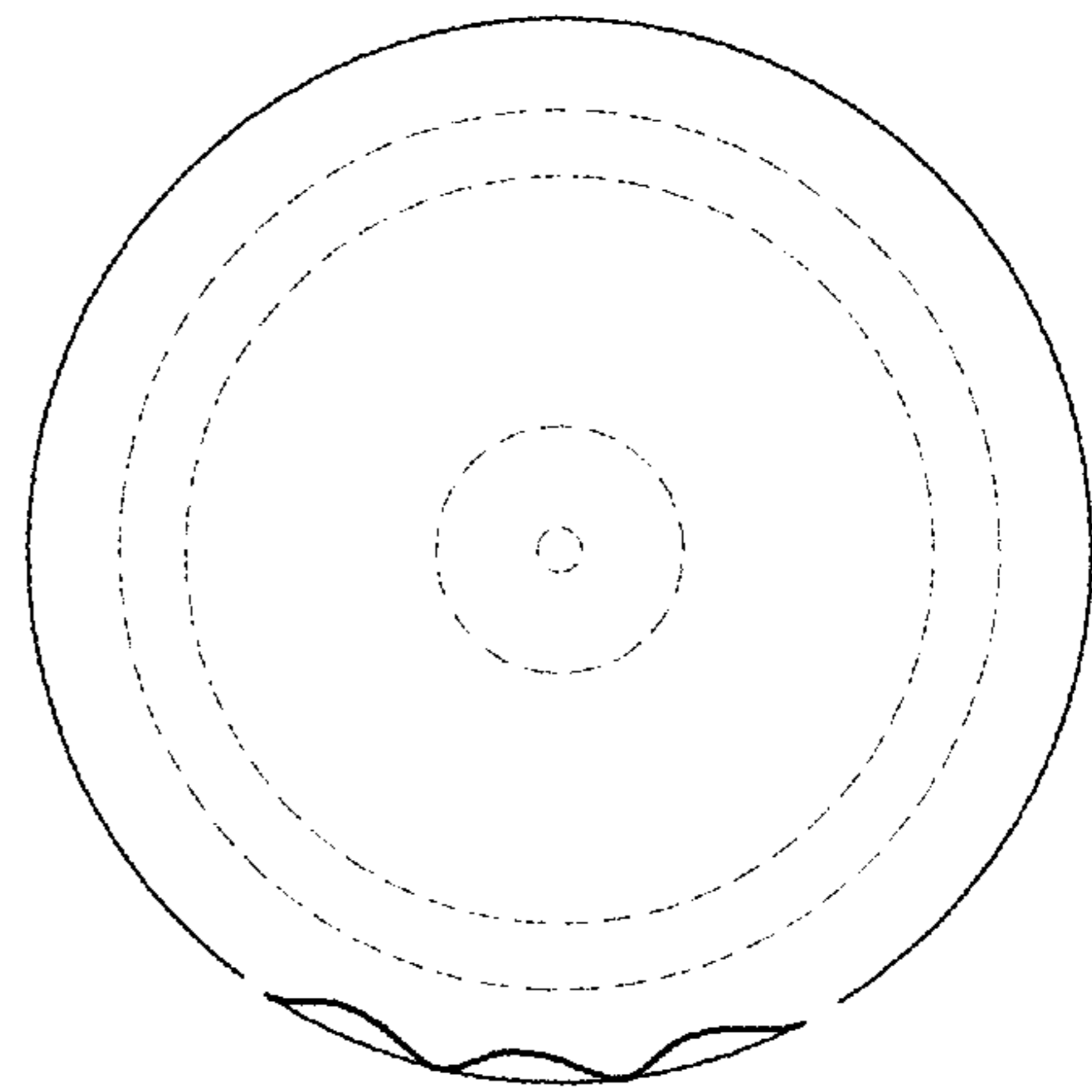

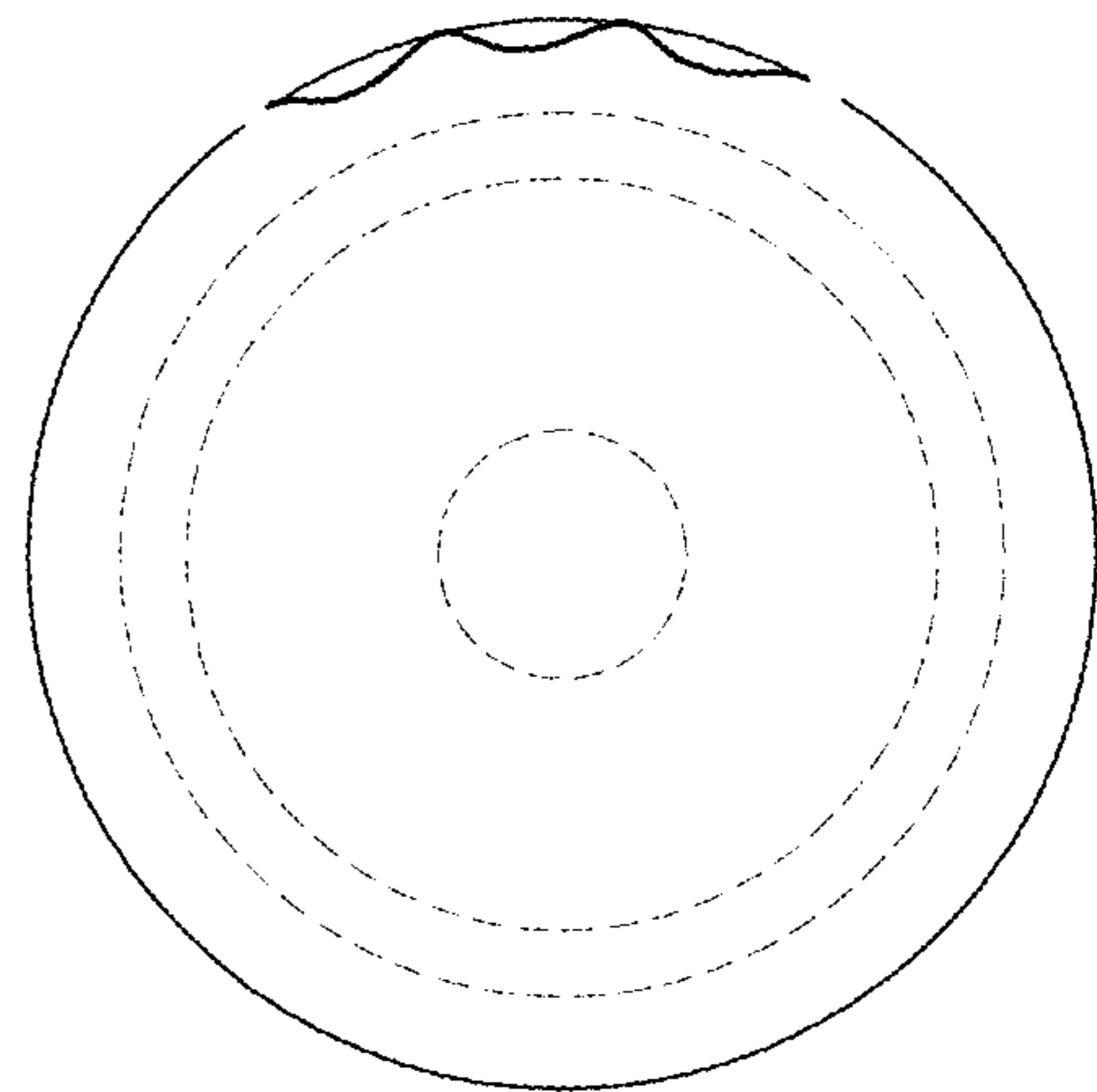

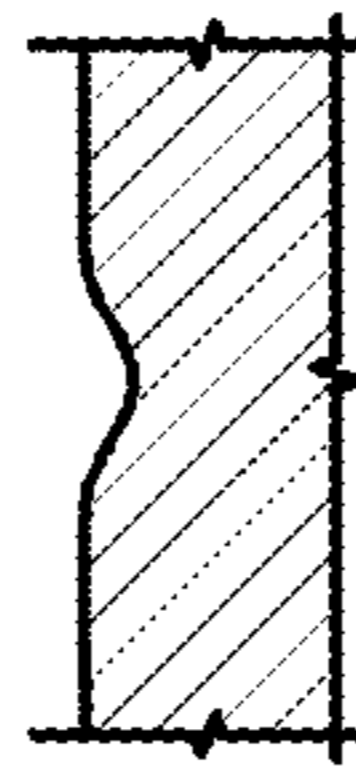

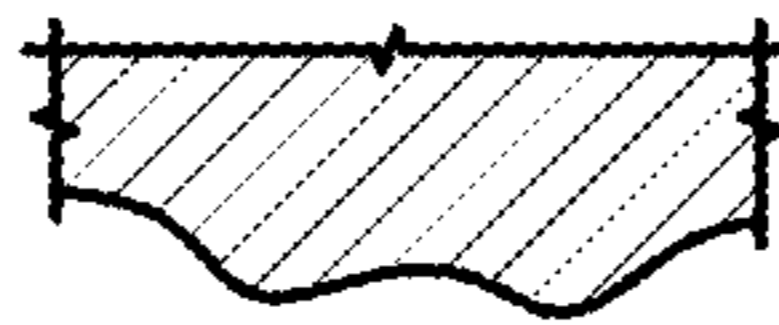
