DESCRIPTION

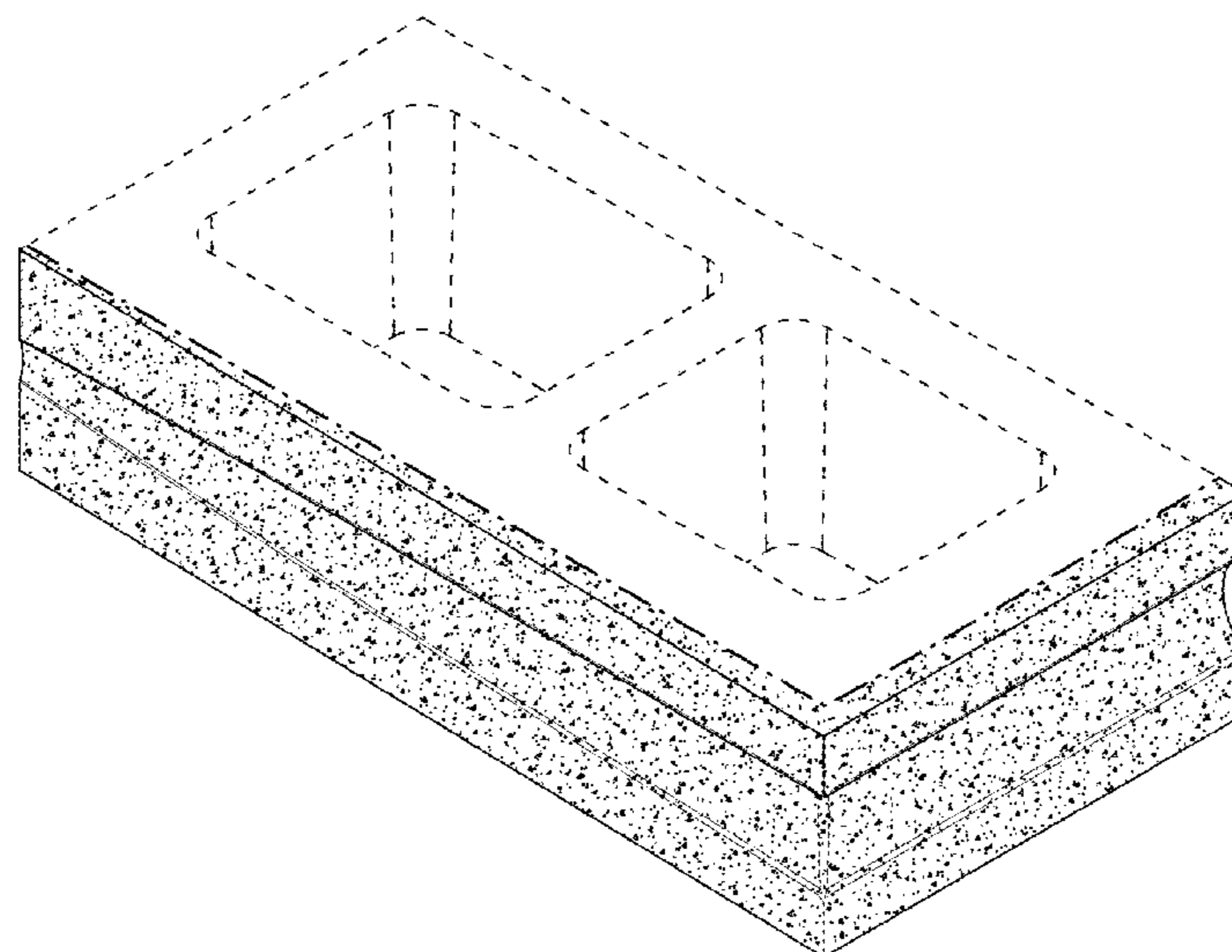

The dot-dash broken lines depict the bounds of the claim and form no part of the claimed design. The dashed broken lines depict portions of the molded surface of a concrete product that form no part of the claimed design.

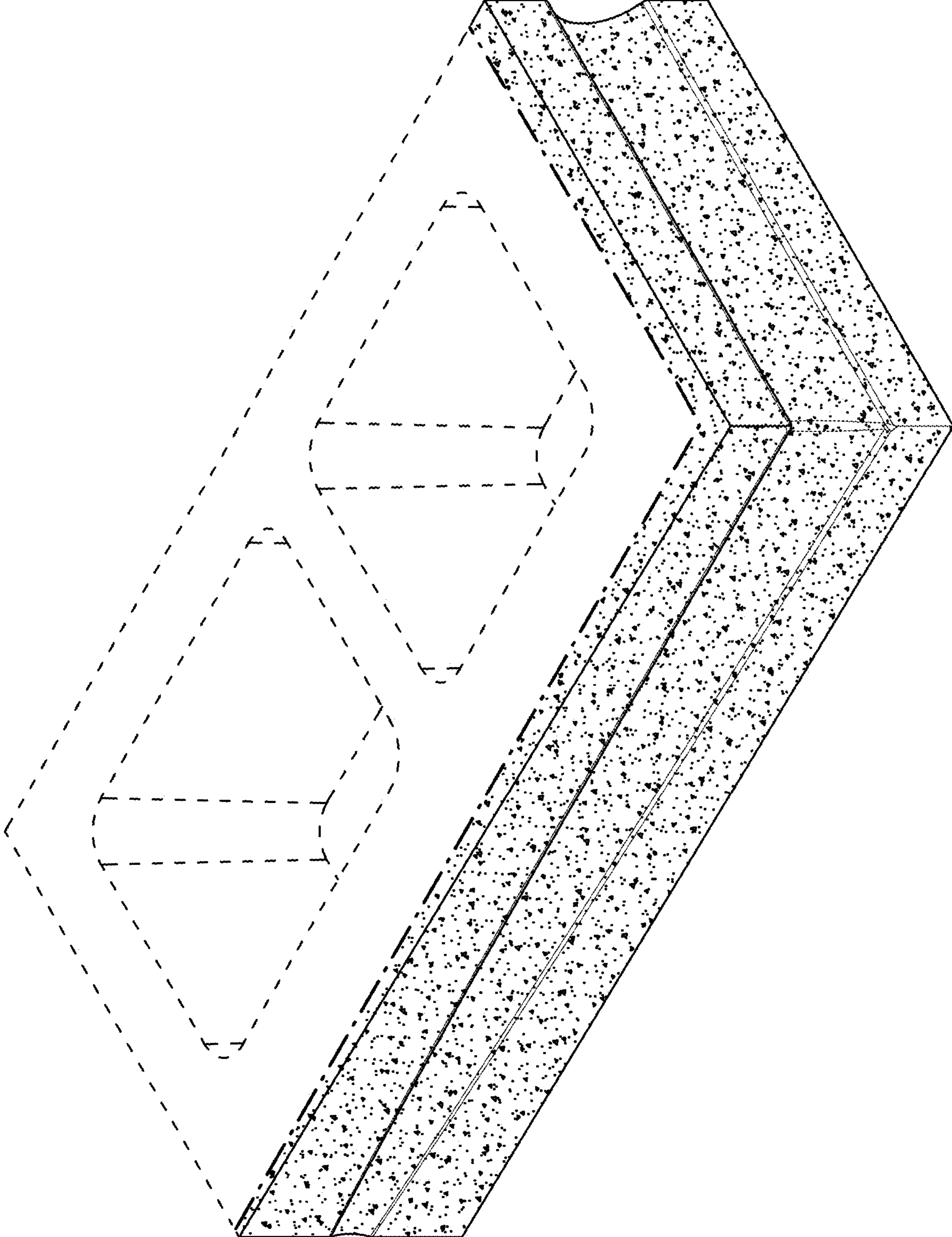

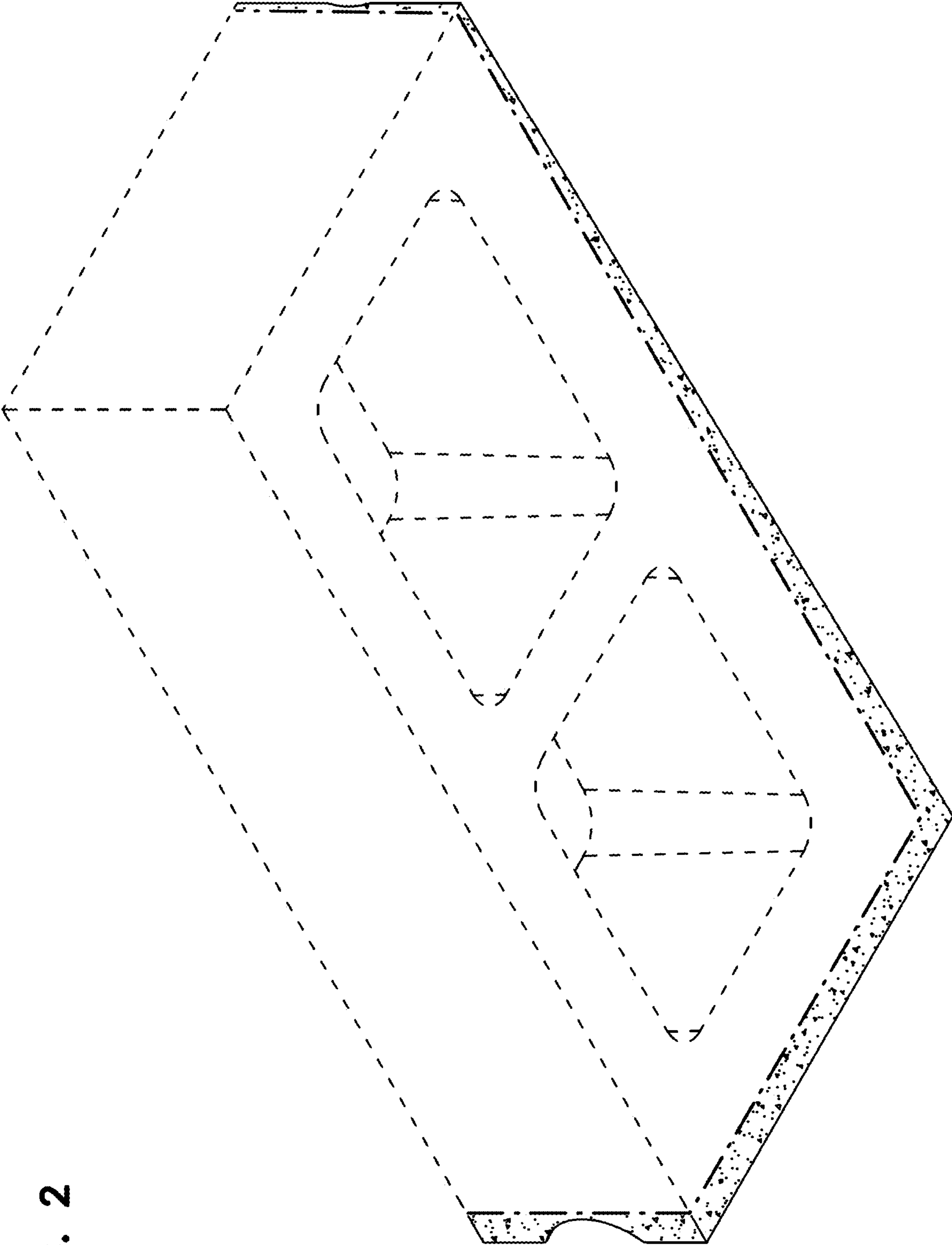

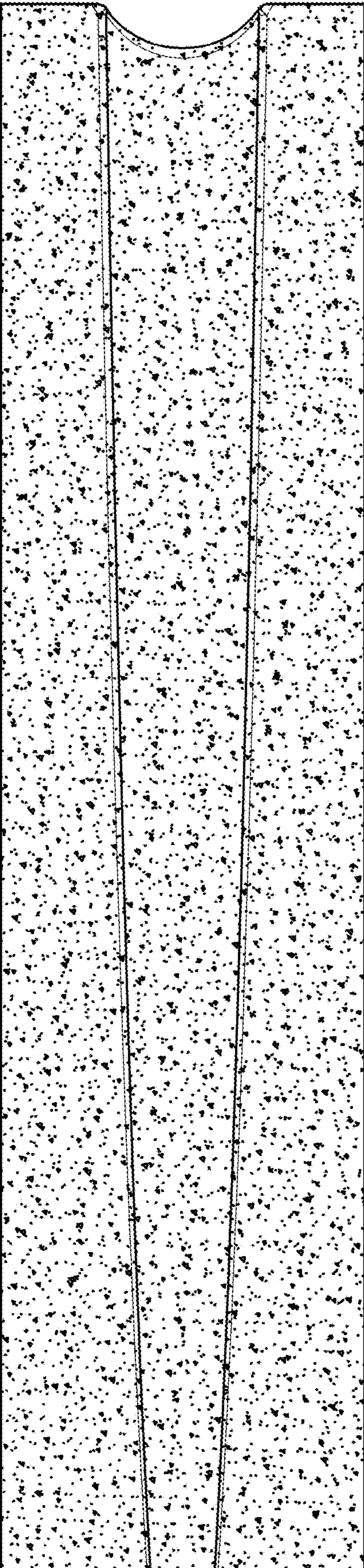
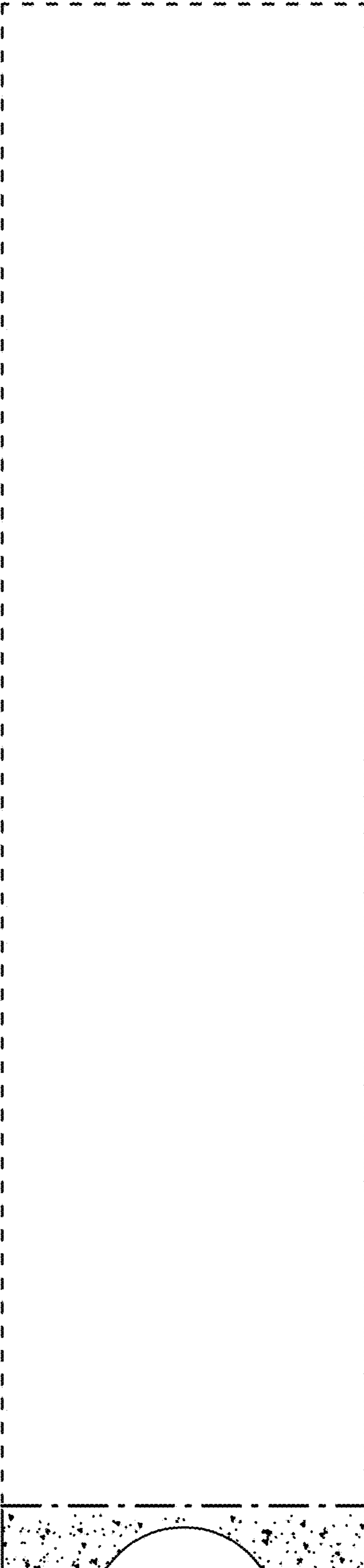

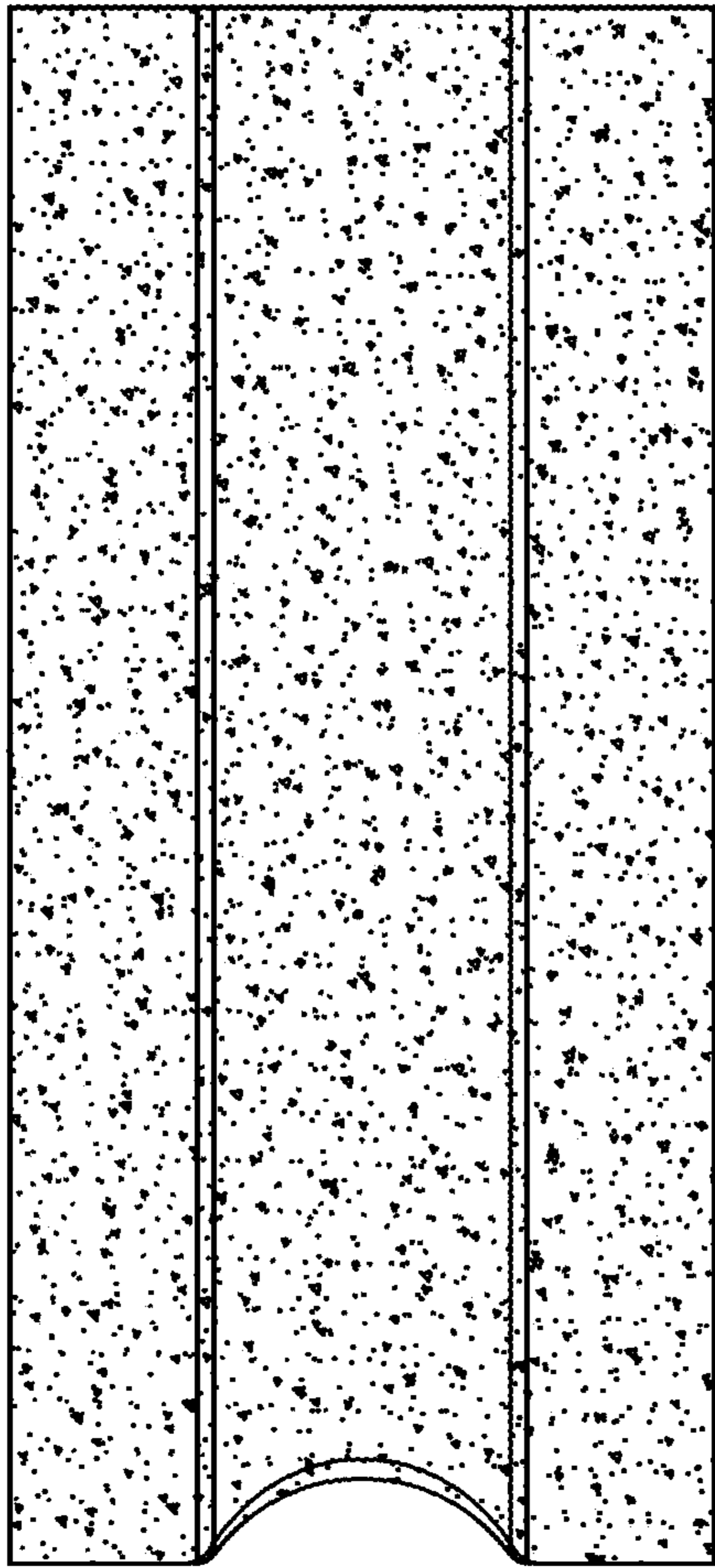

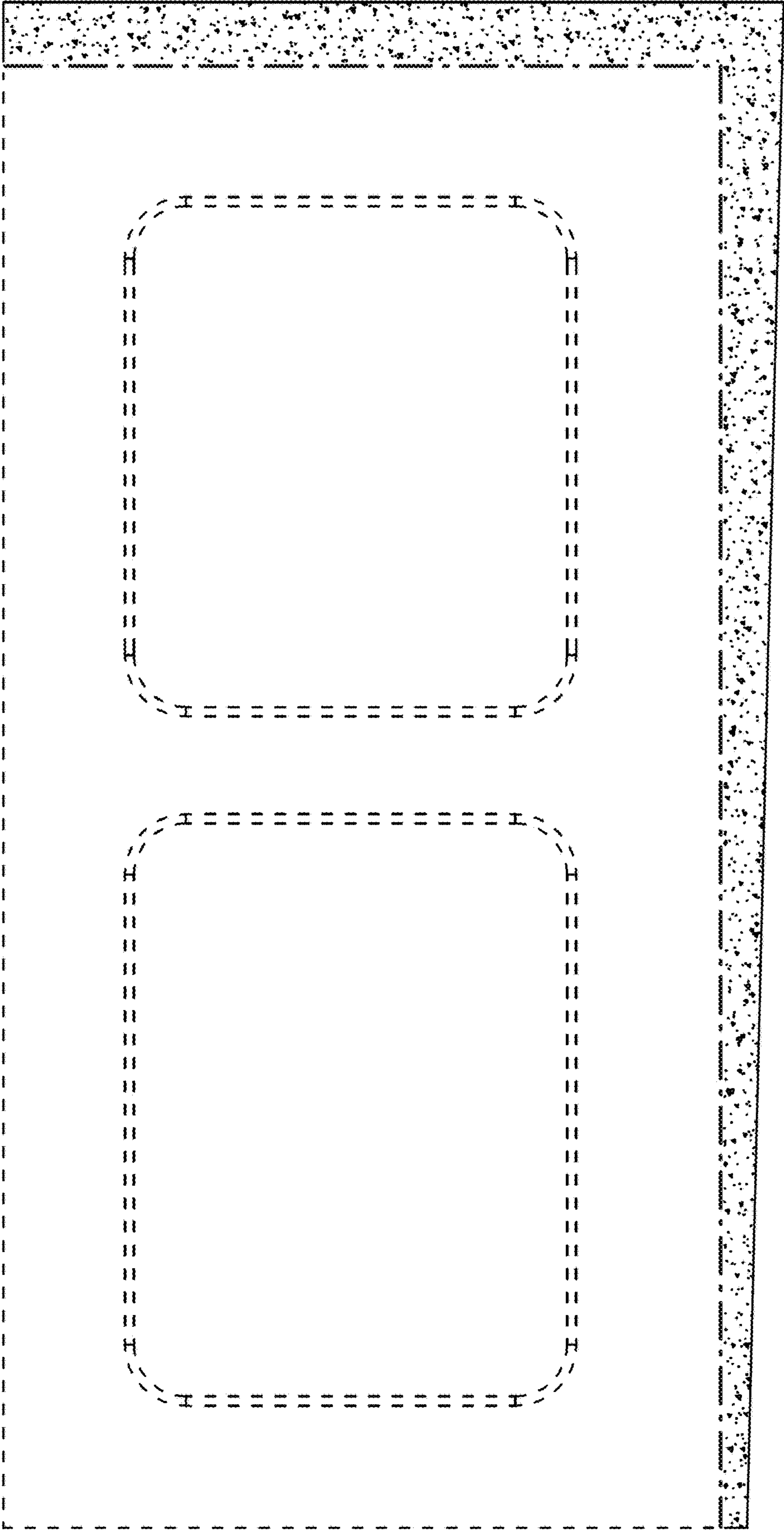

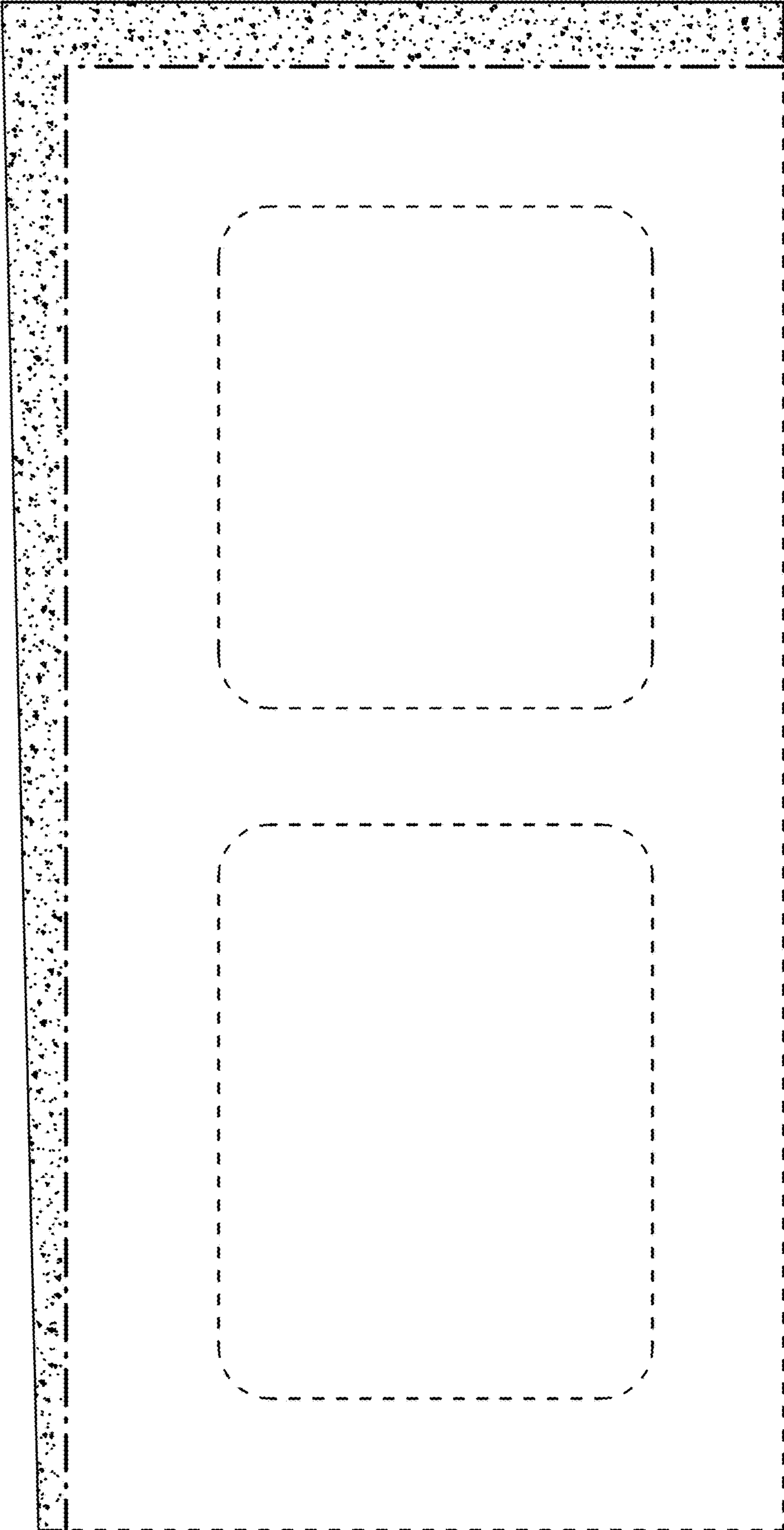
