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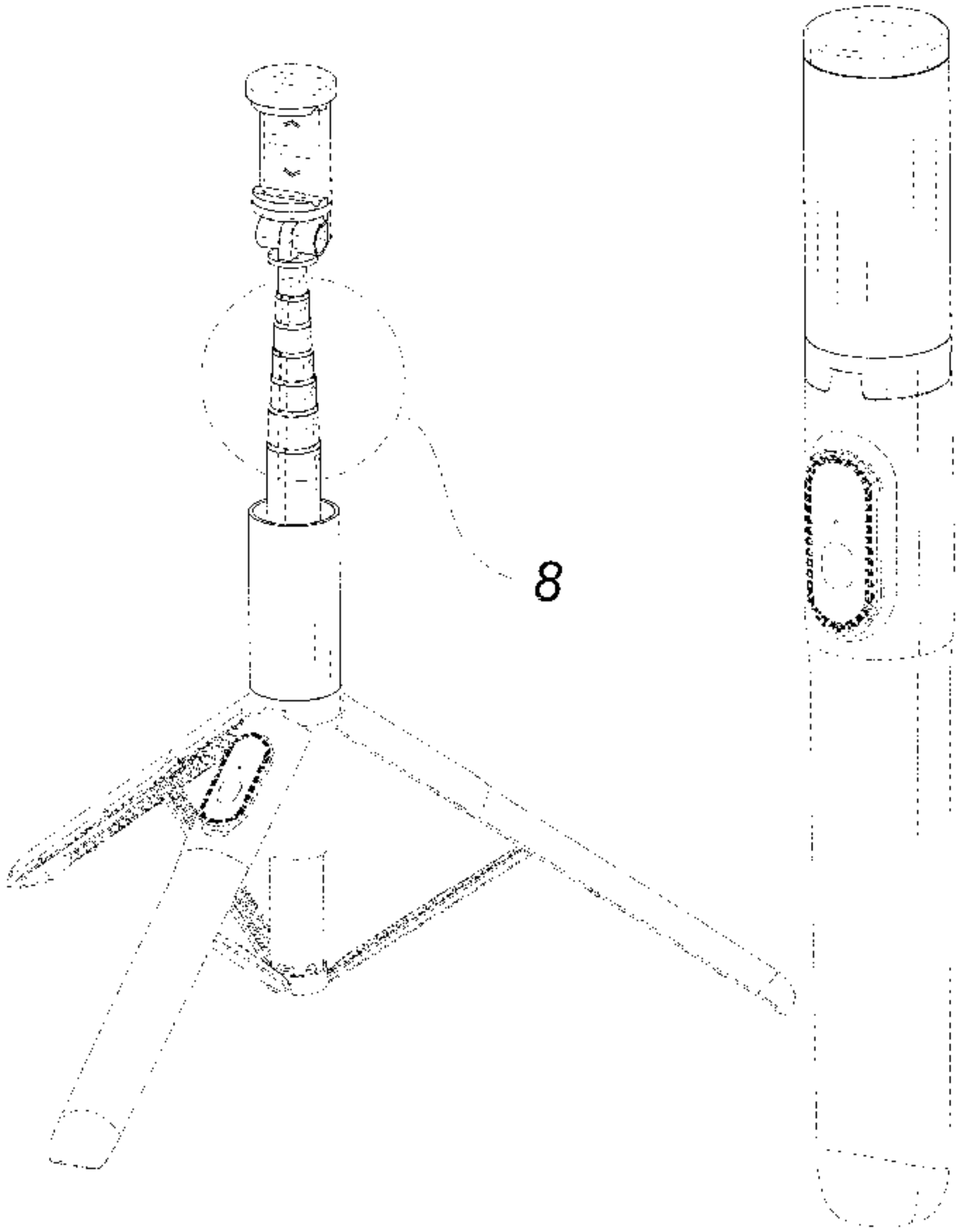
(57) CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a selfie stick tripod showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left elevational view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image of FIG. 5;
FIG. 6 is a top side view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a partial enlarged view of FIG. 1;
FIG. 9 is a partial enlarged view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 10 is a partial enlarged view of FIG. 3; and,

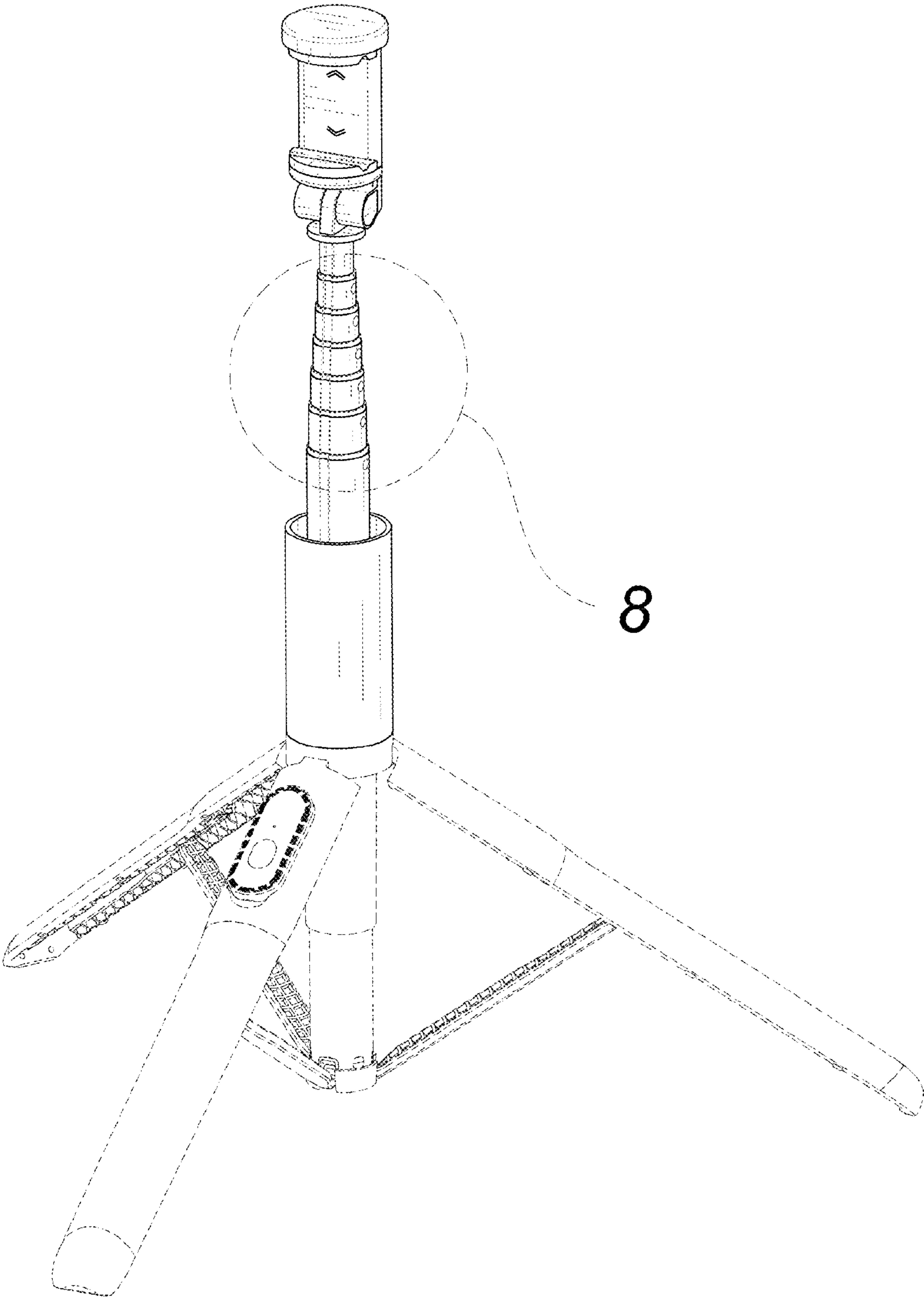

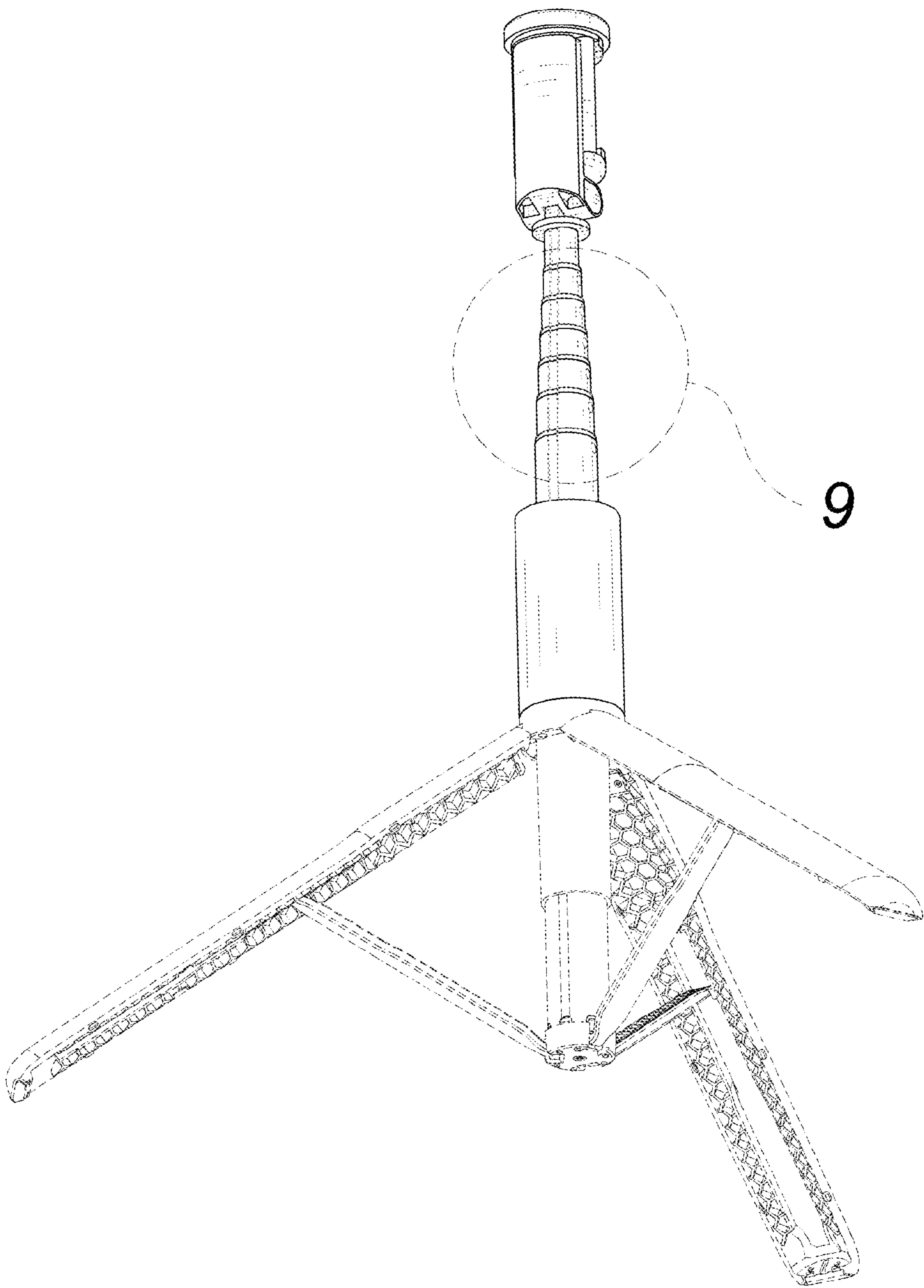

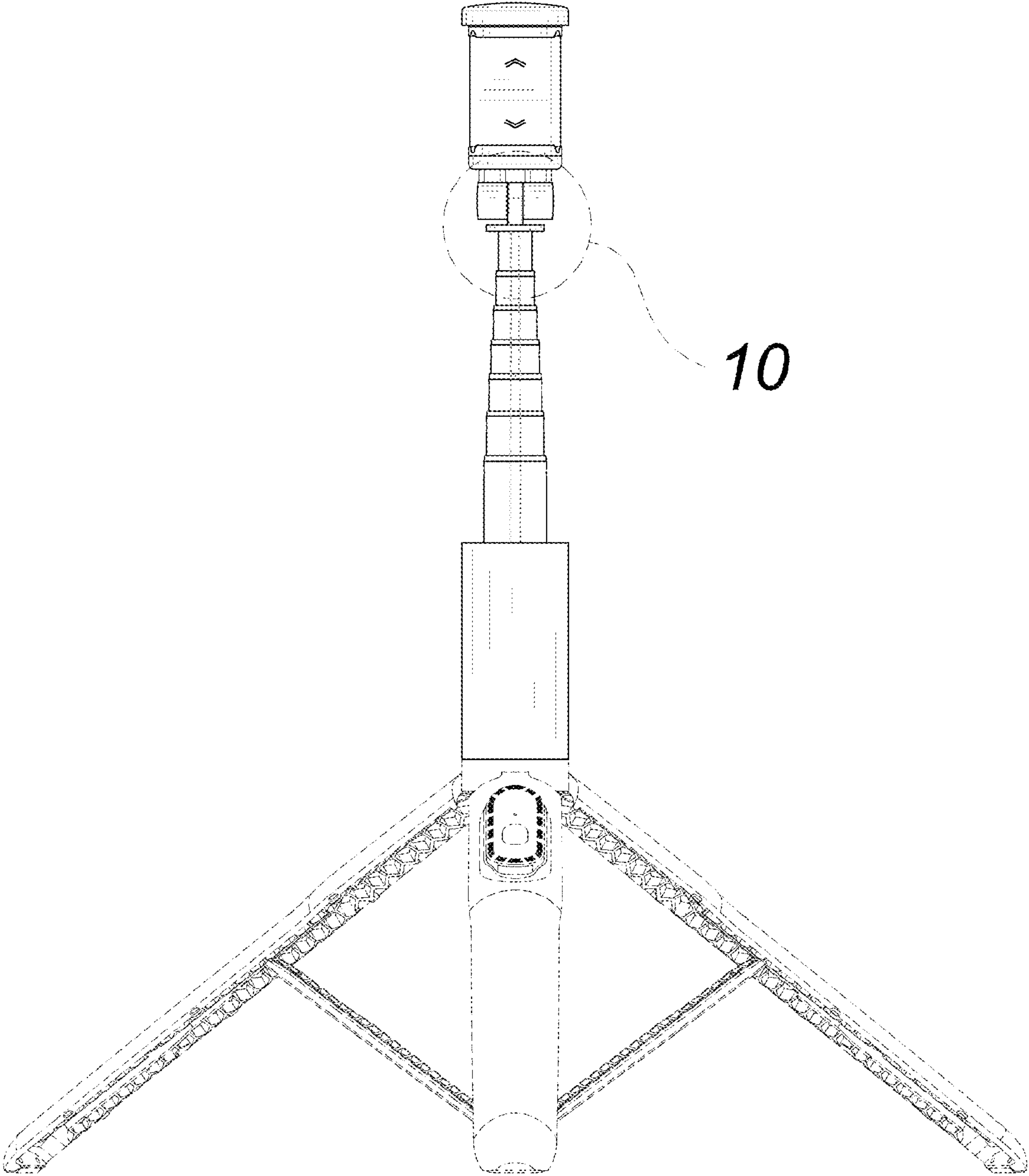

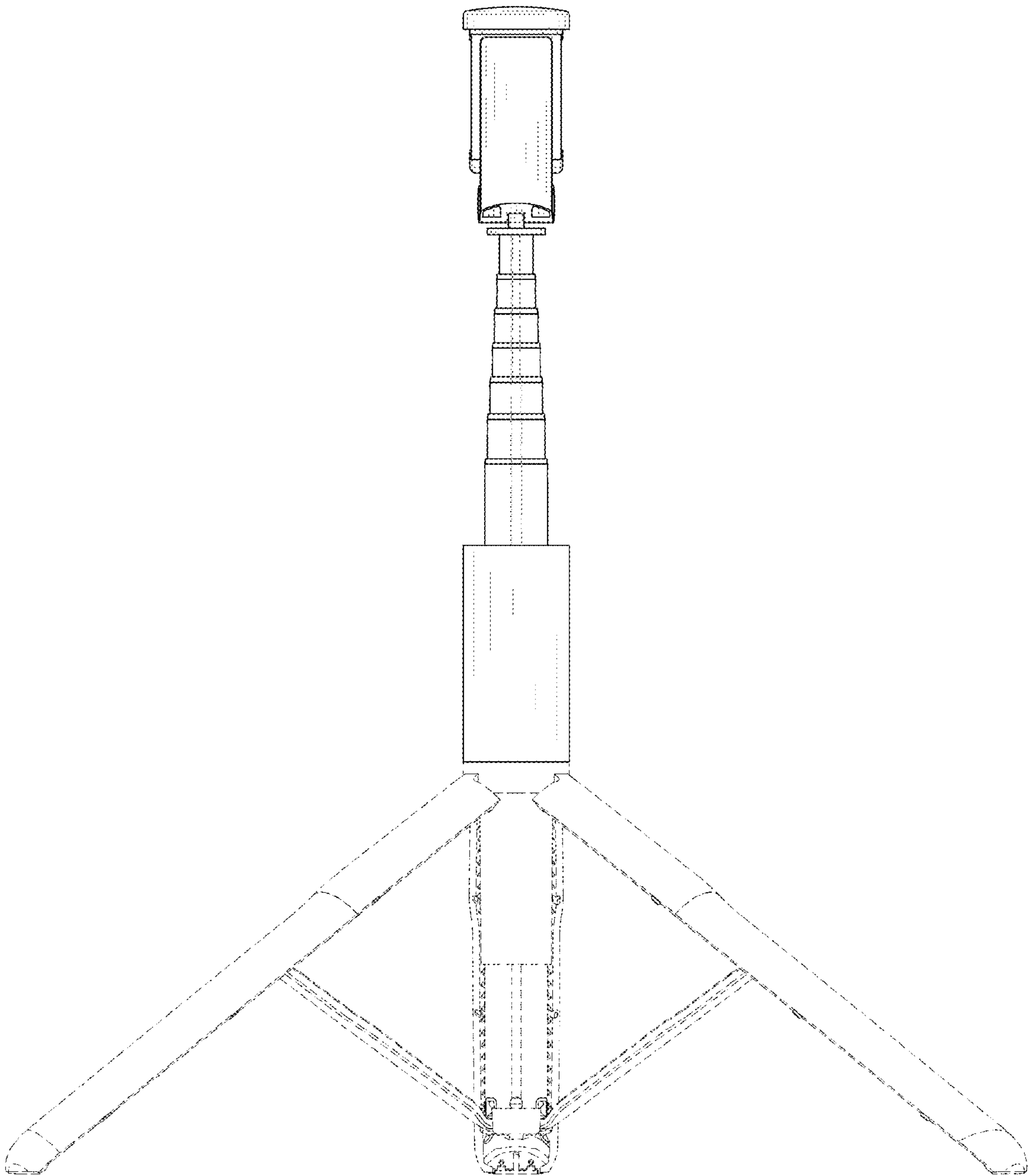

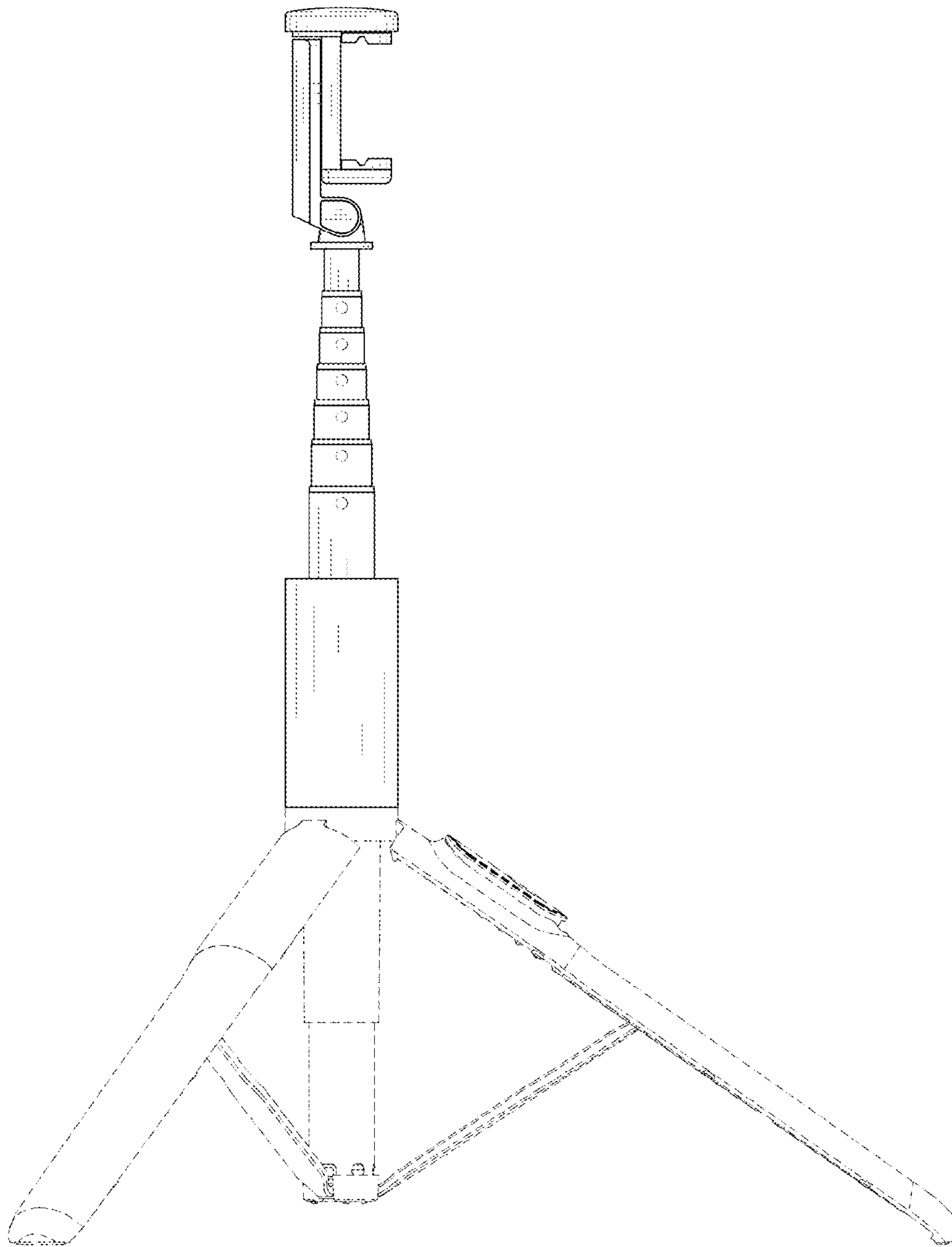

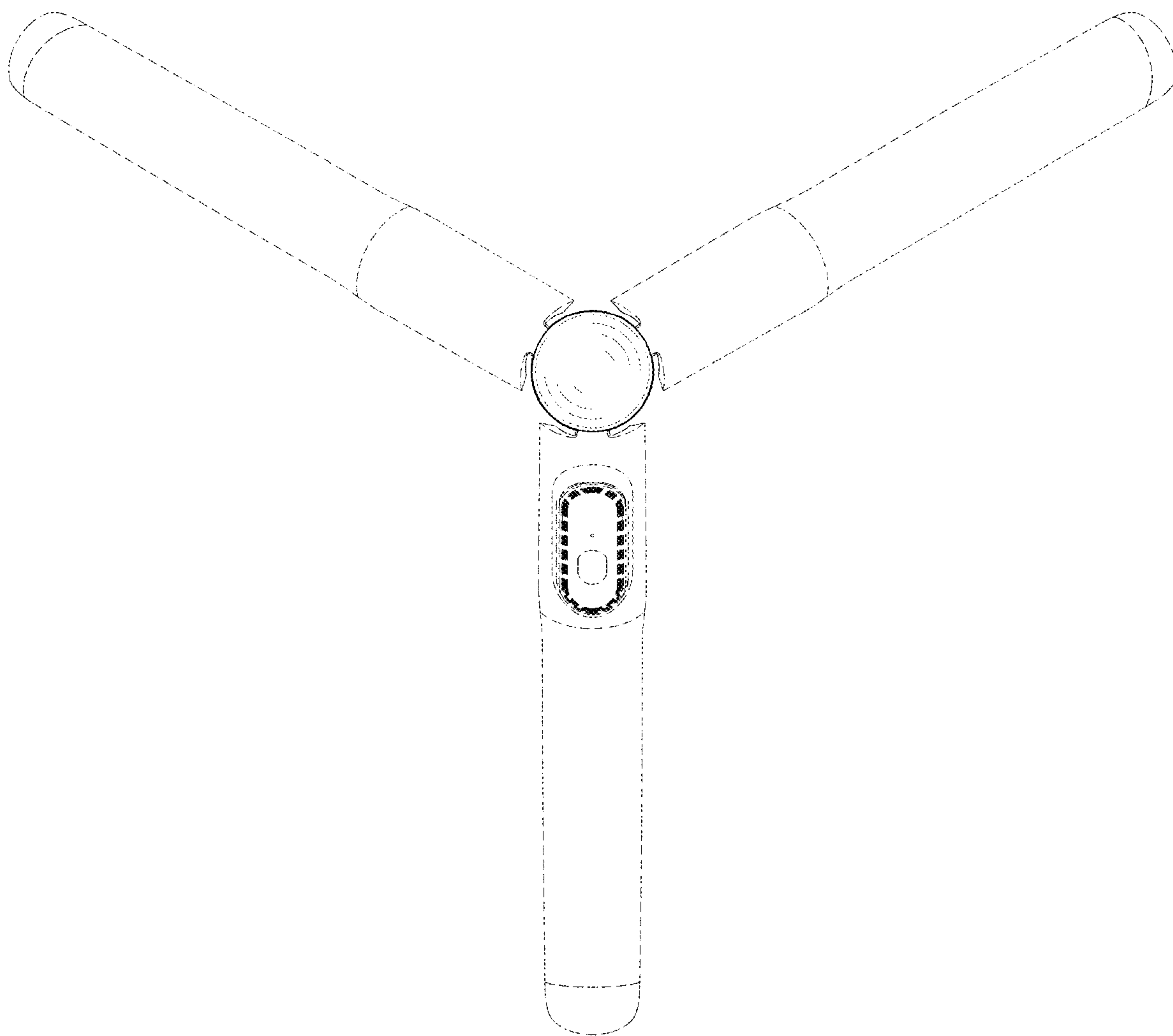

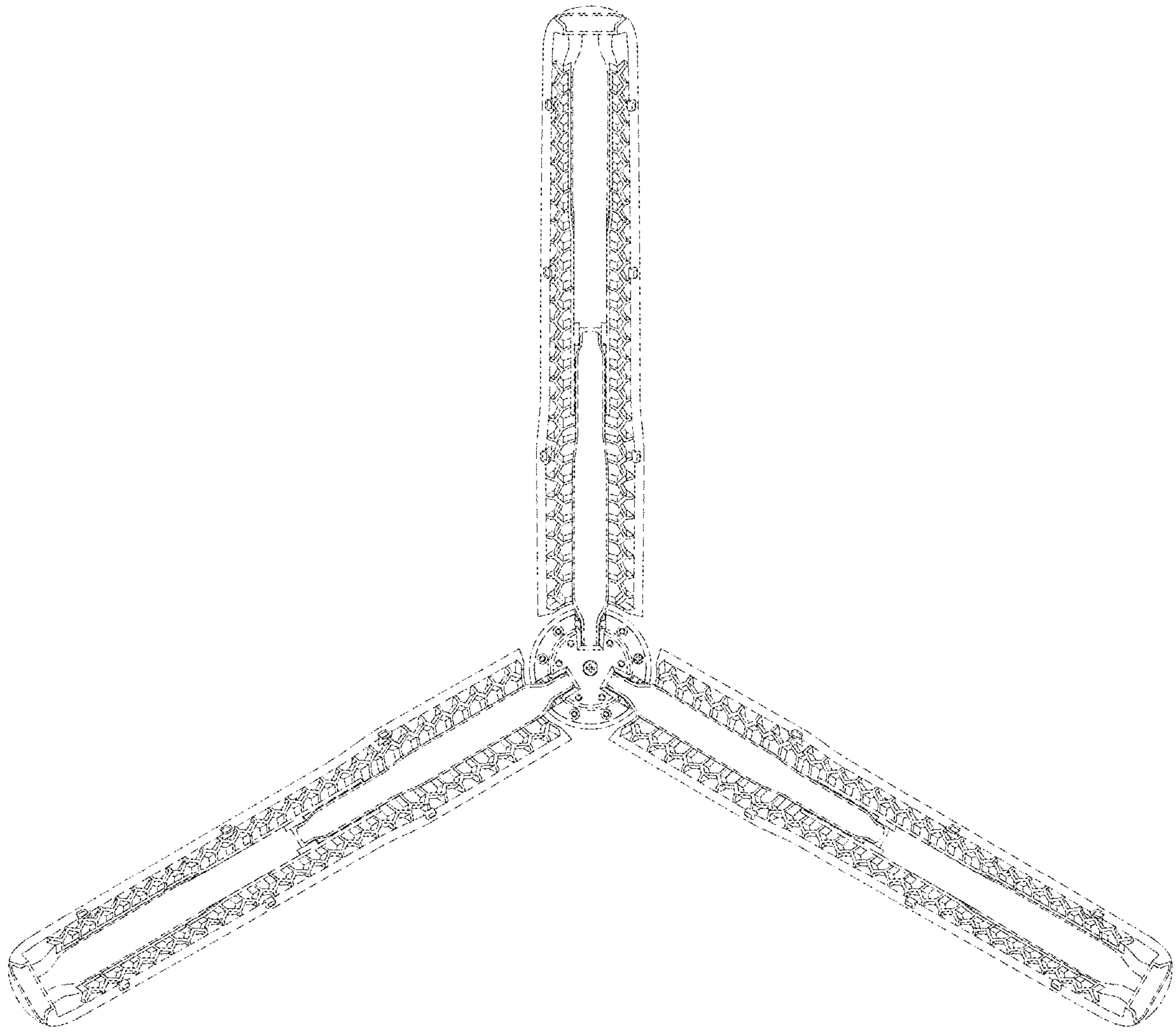

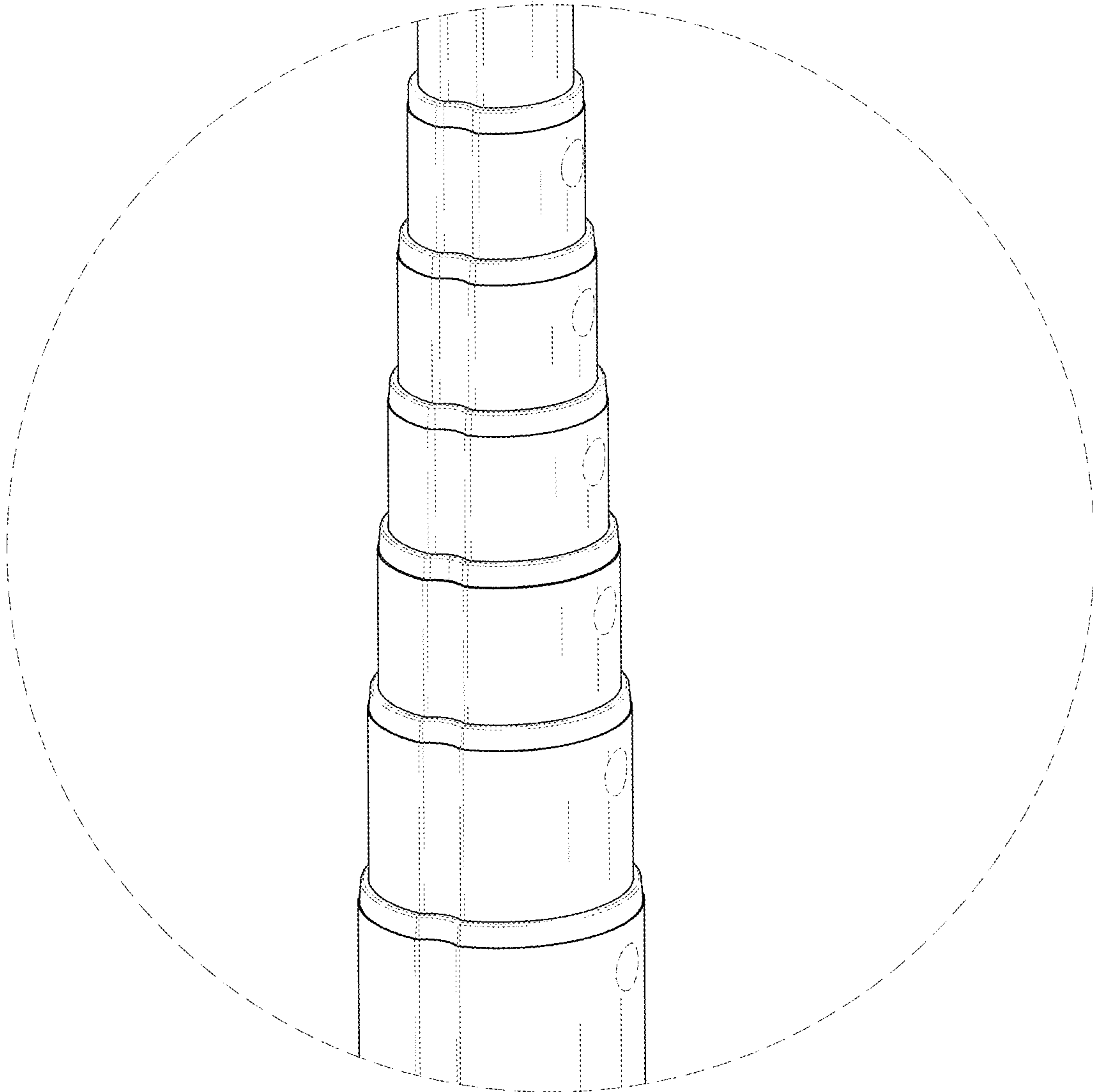

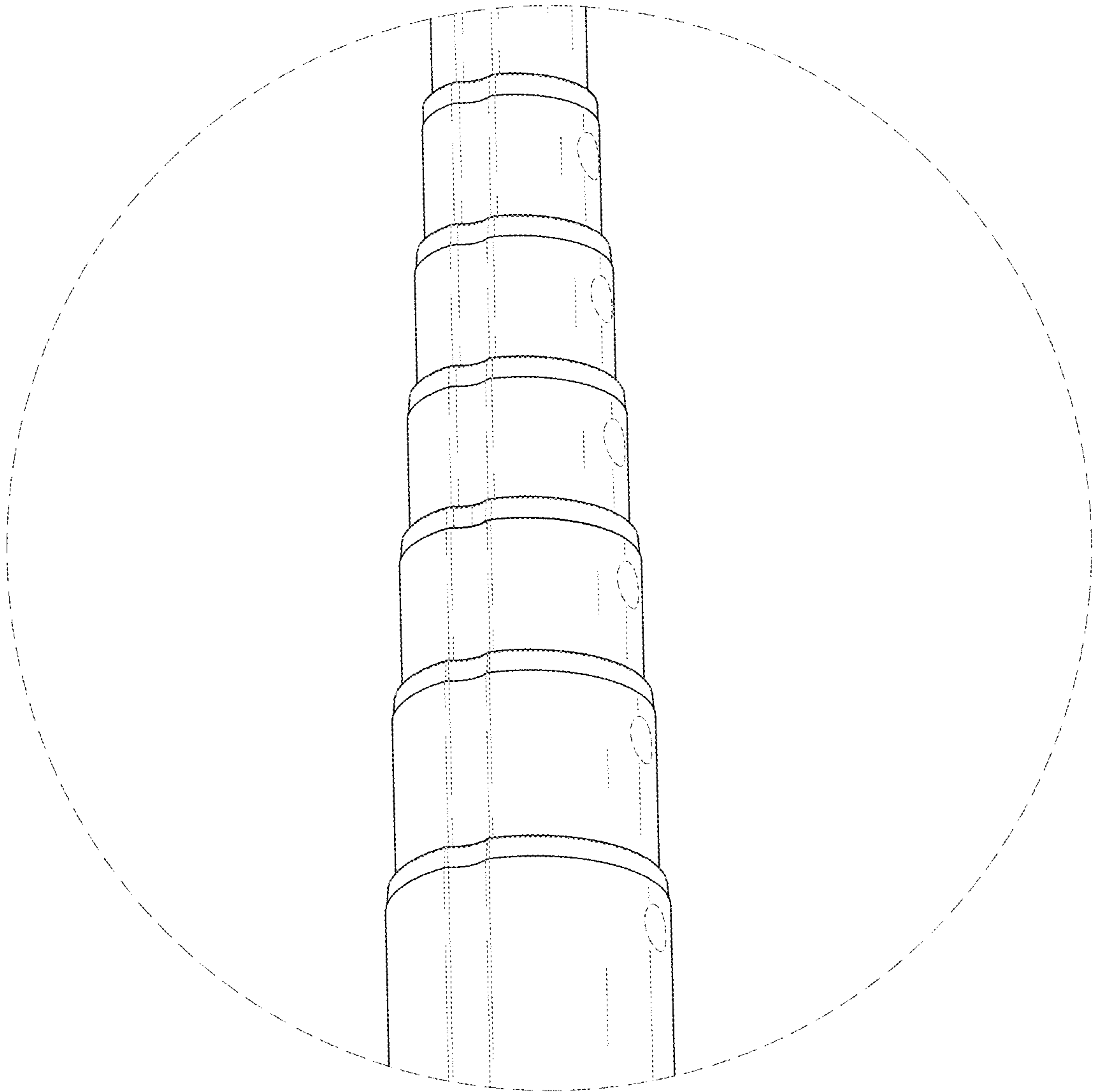

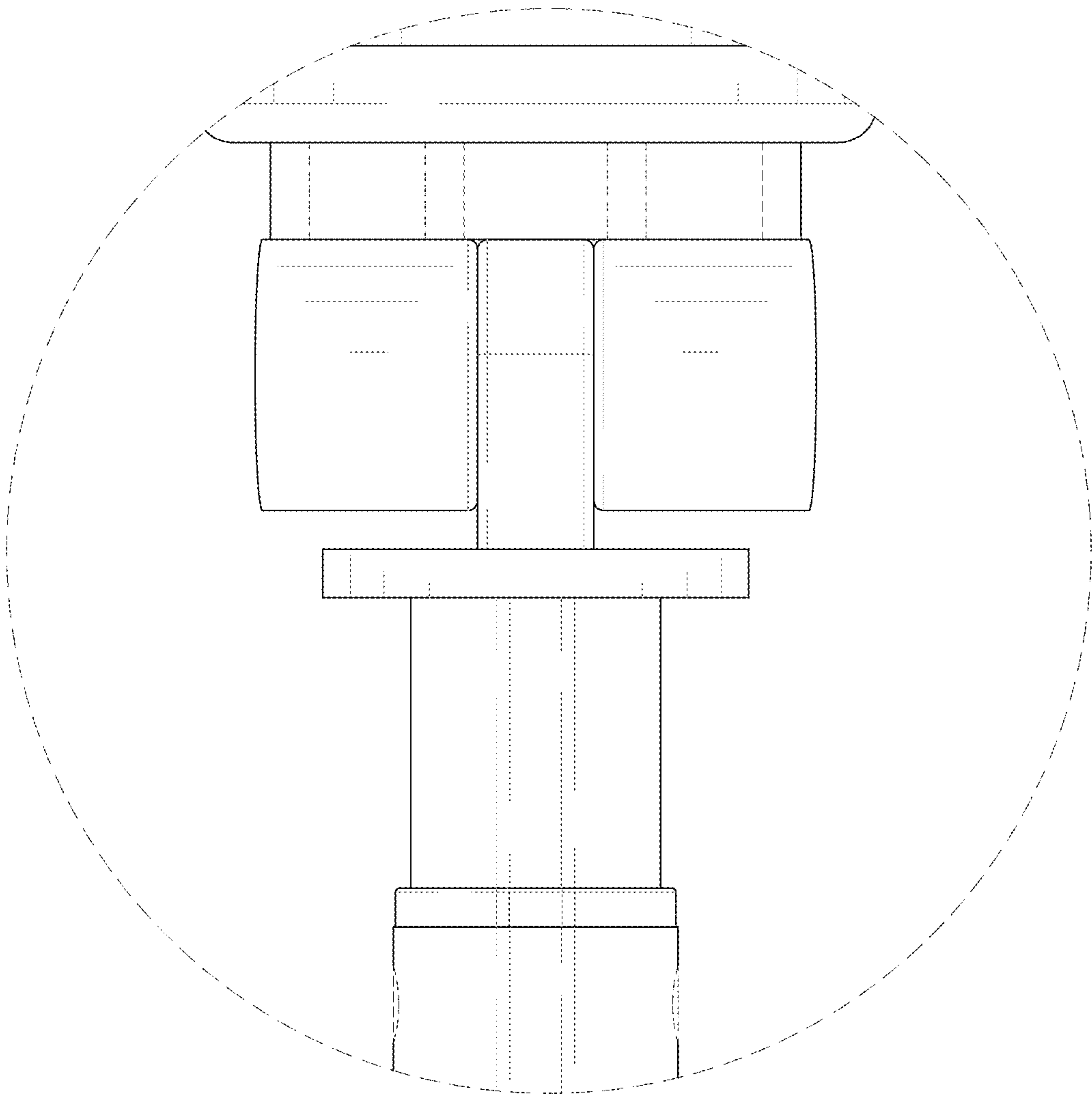

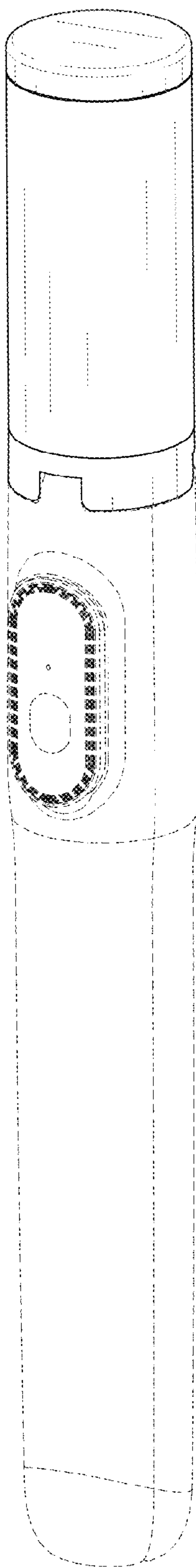
