FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

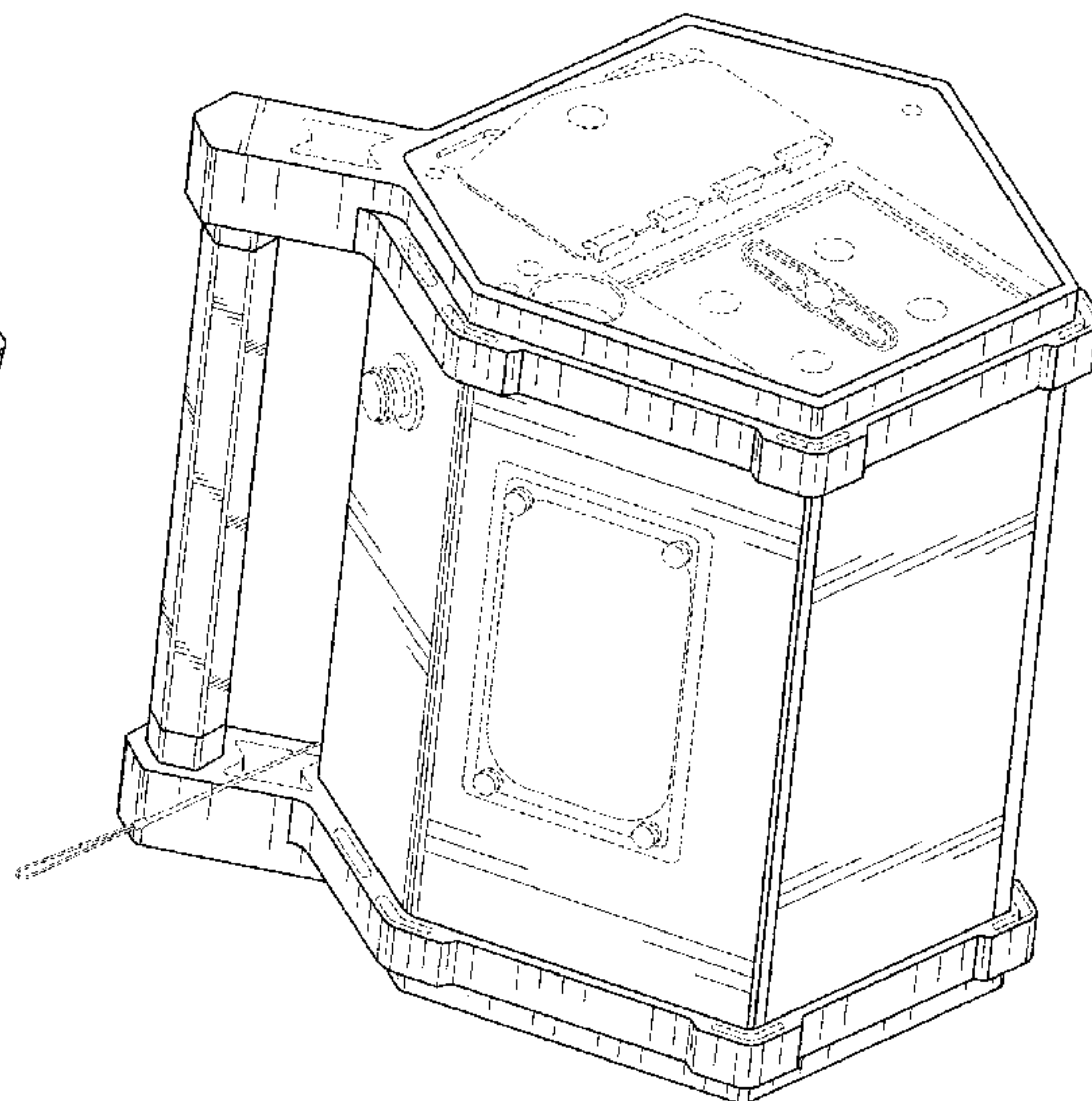
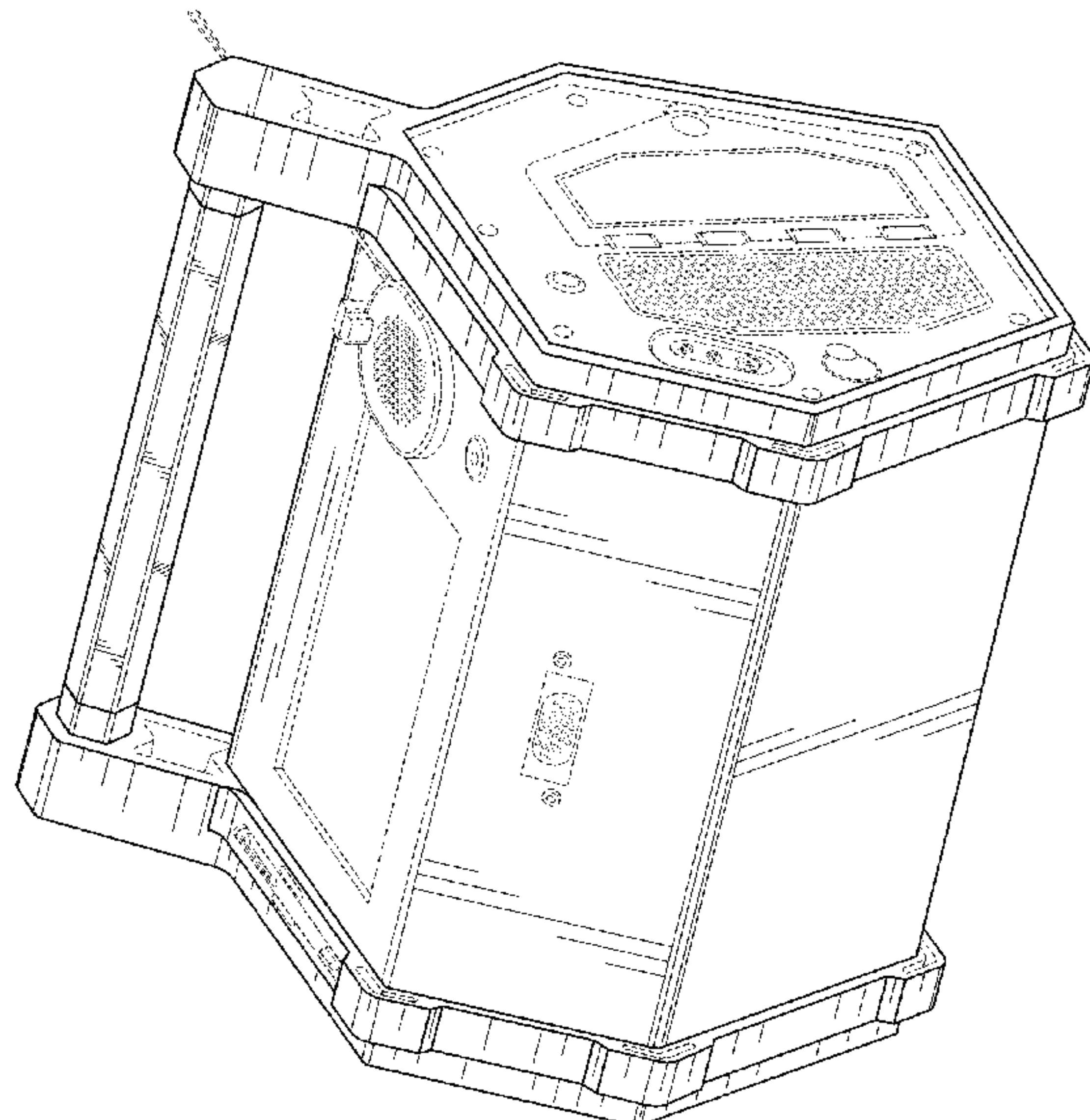
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;

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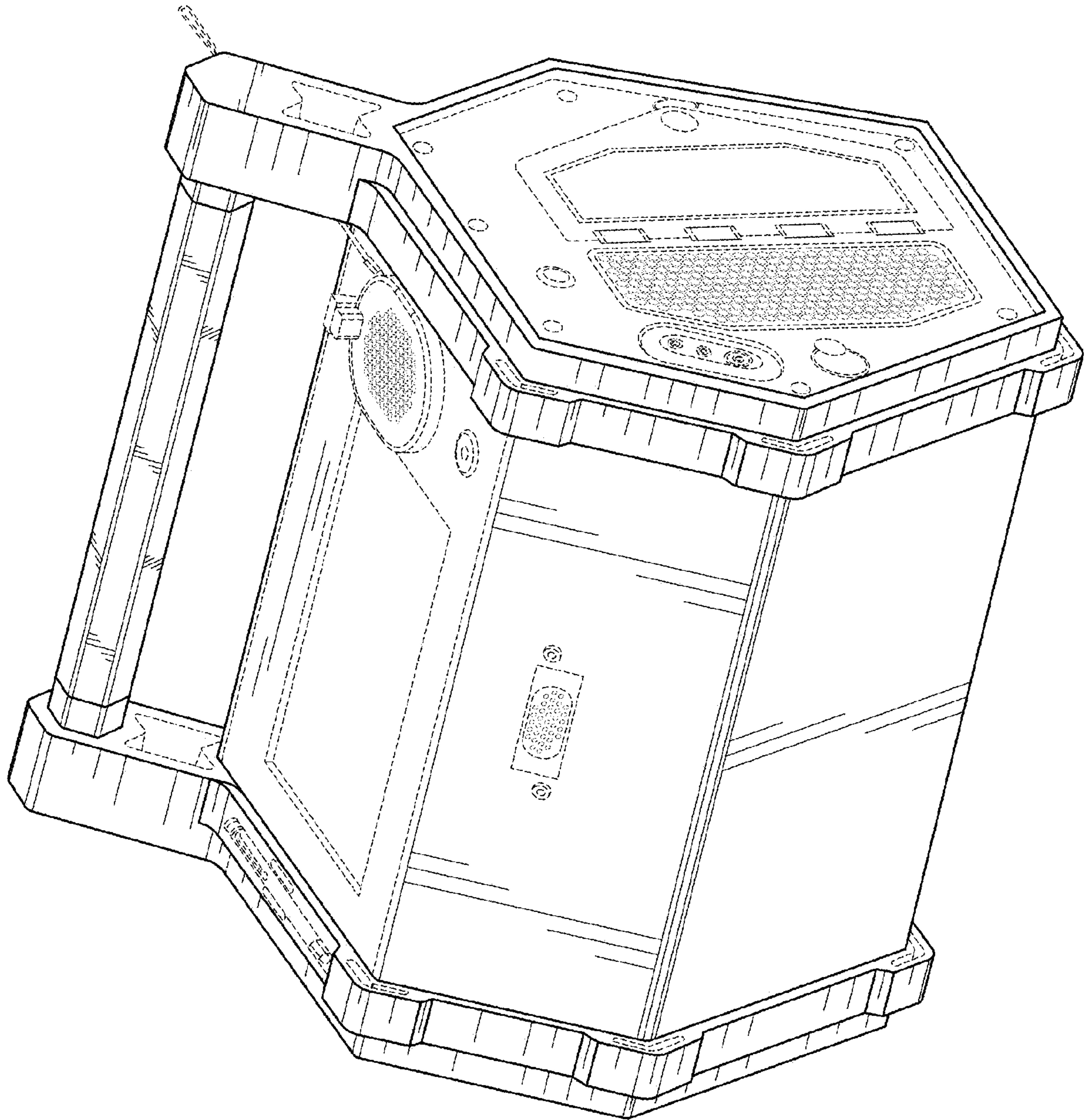

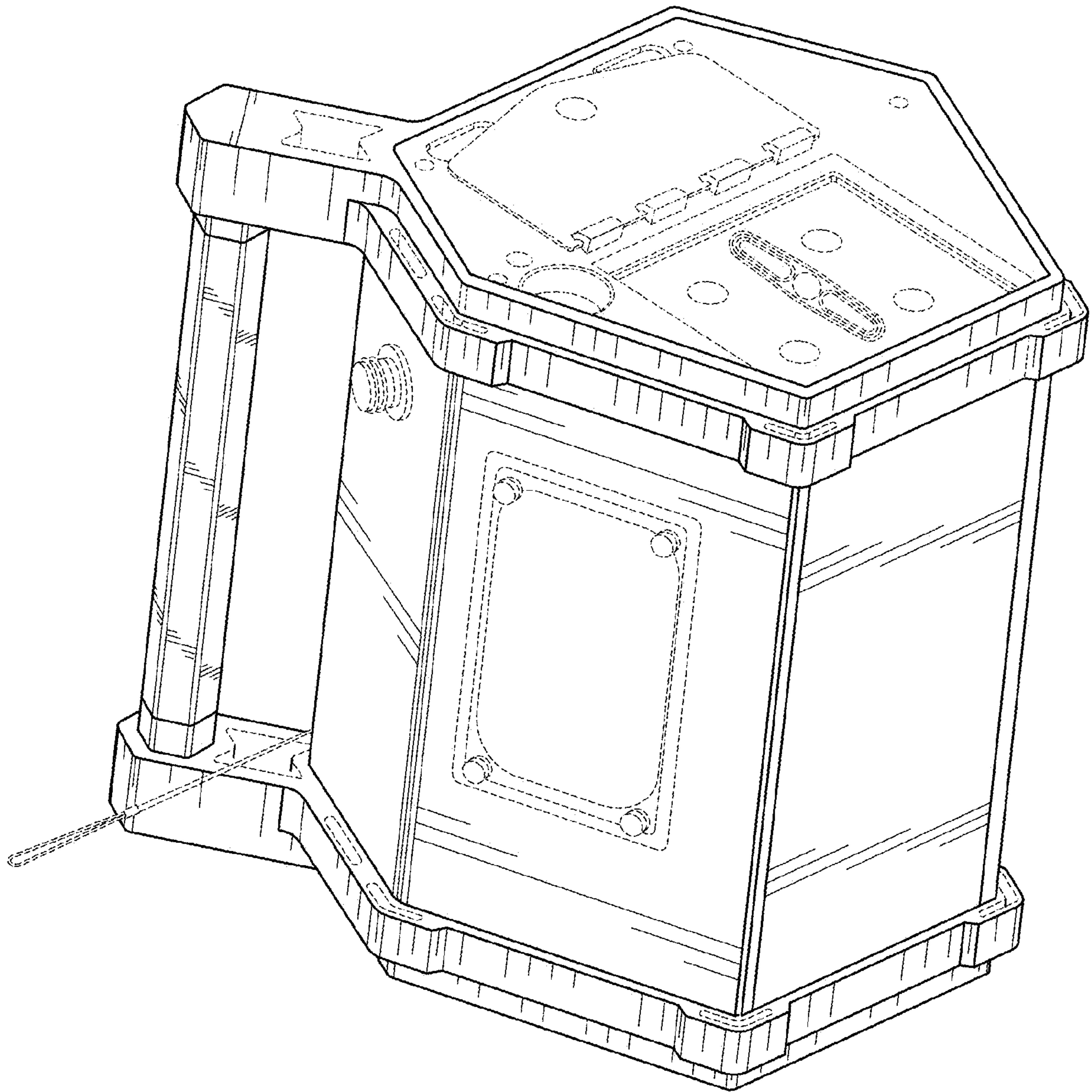

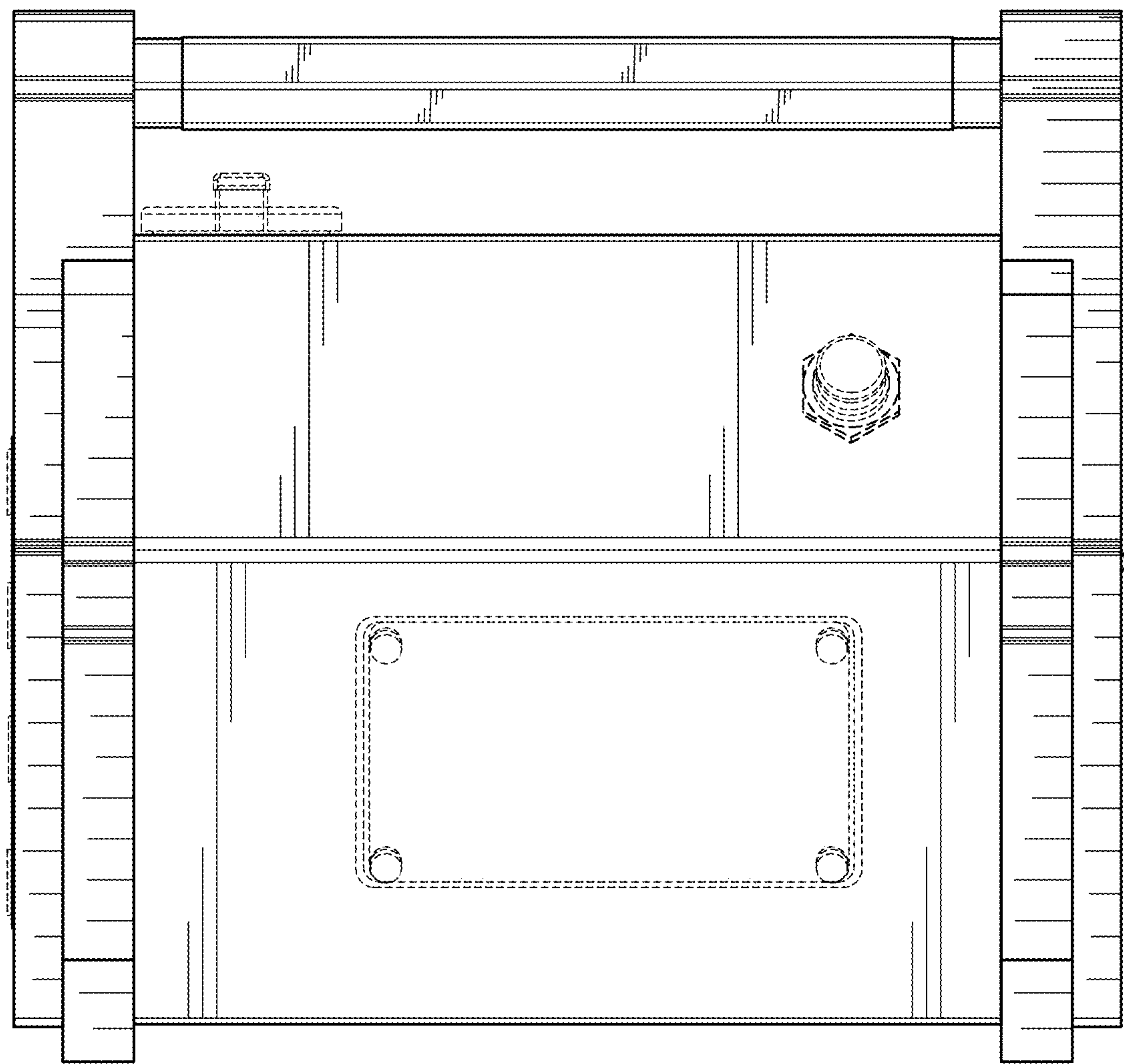

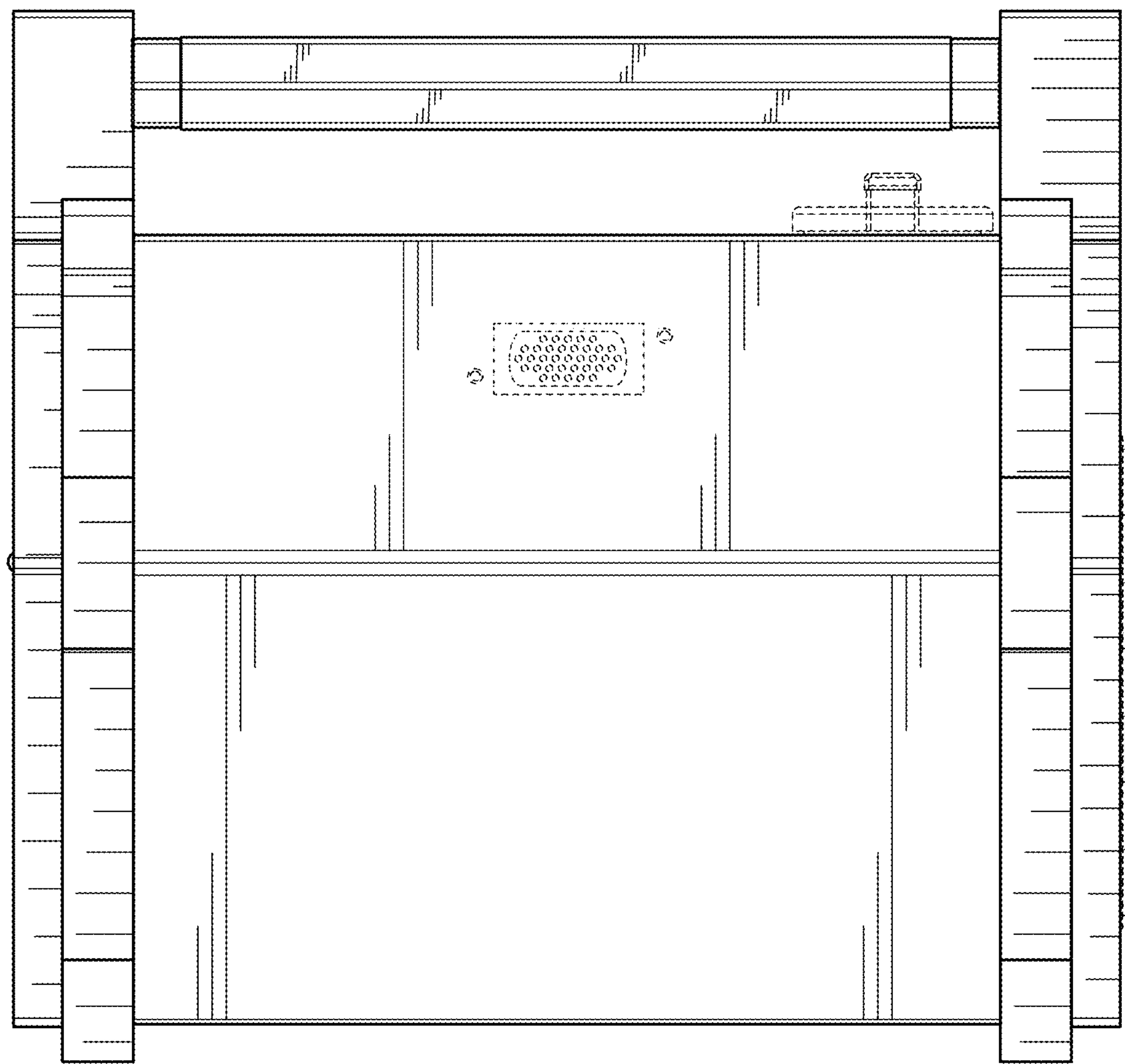

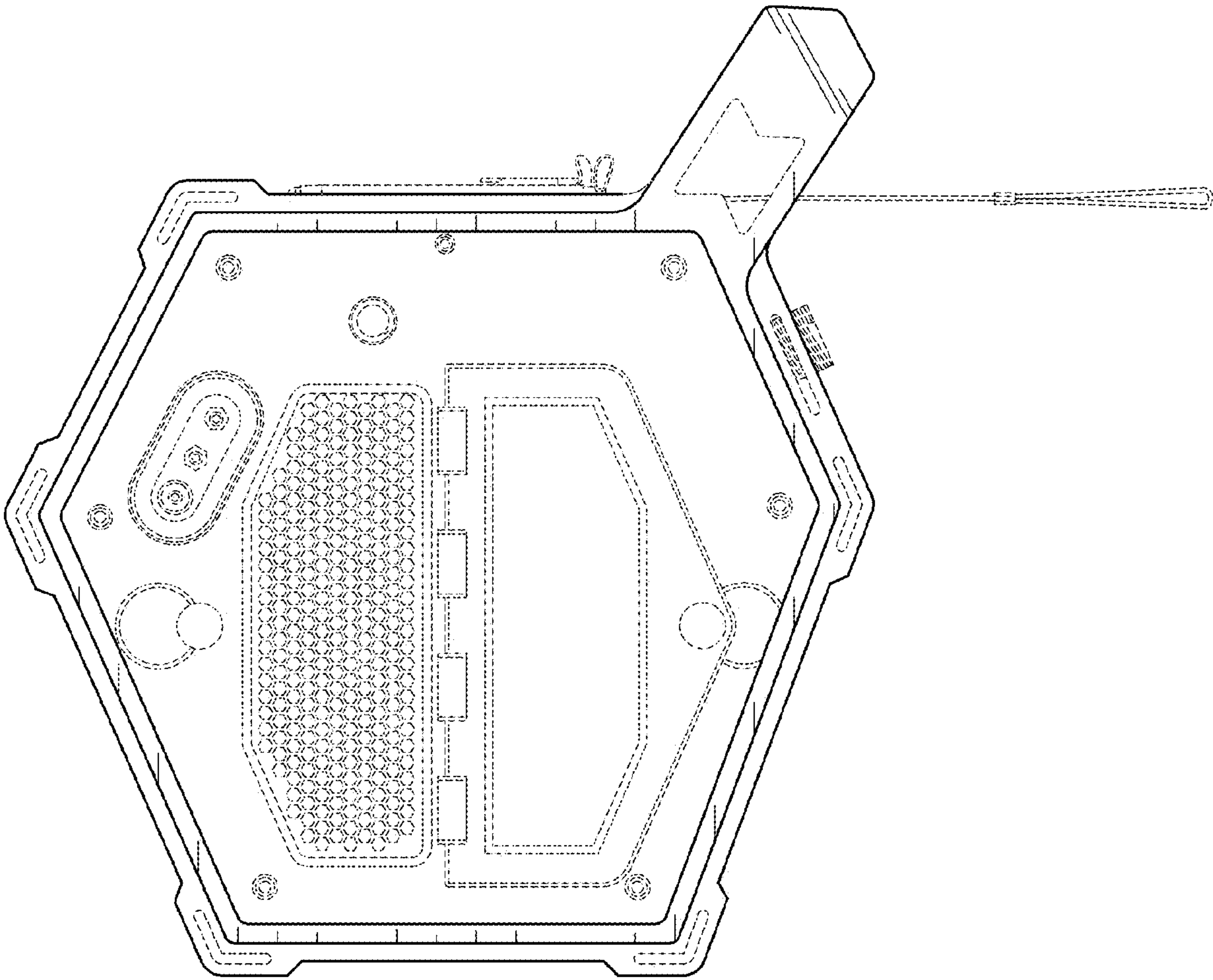

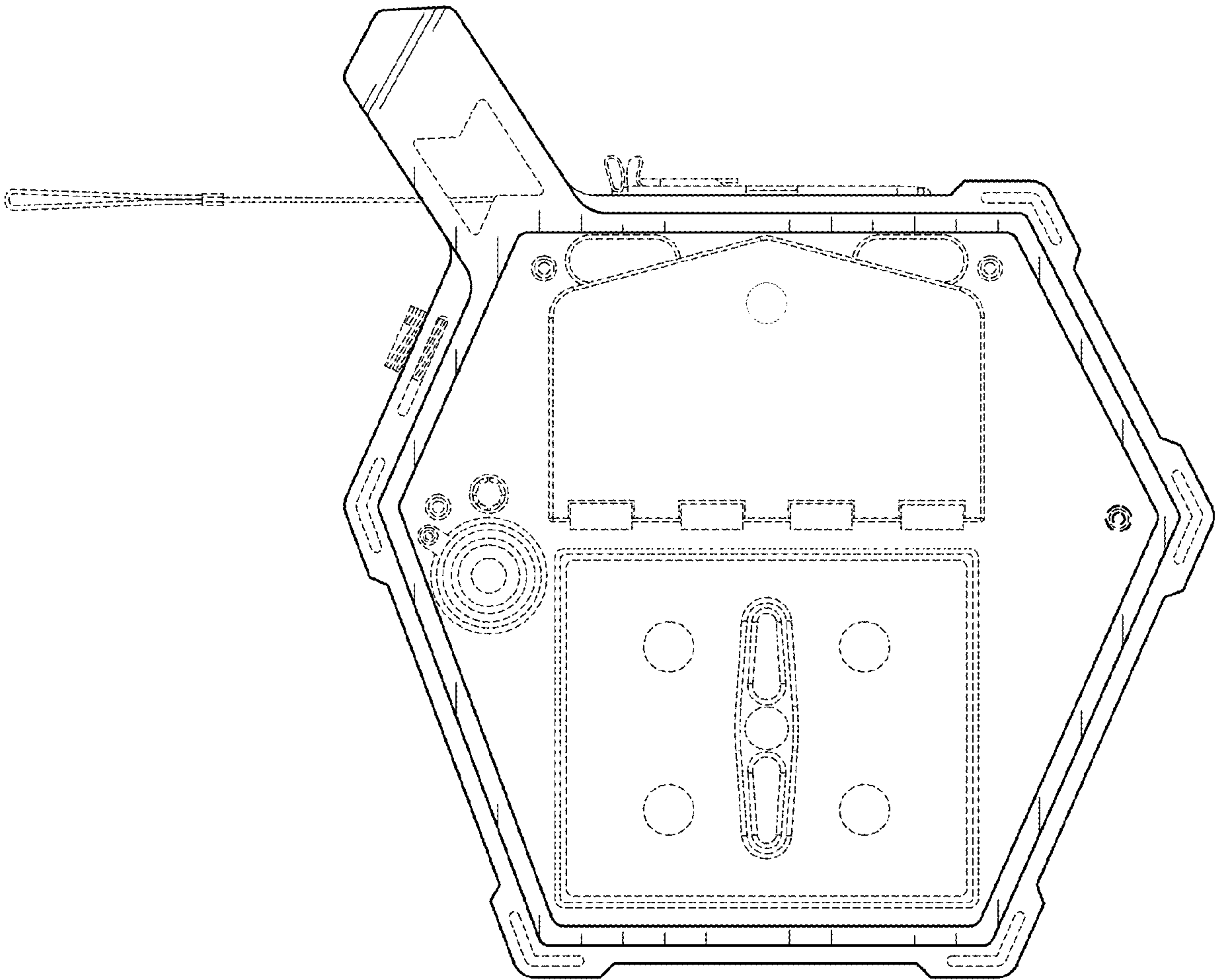

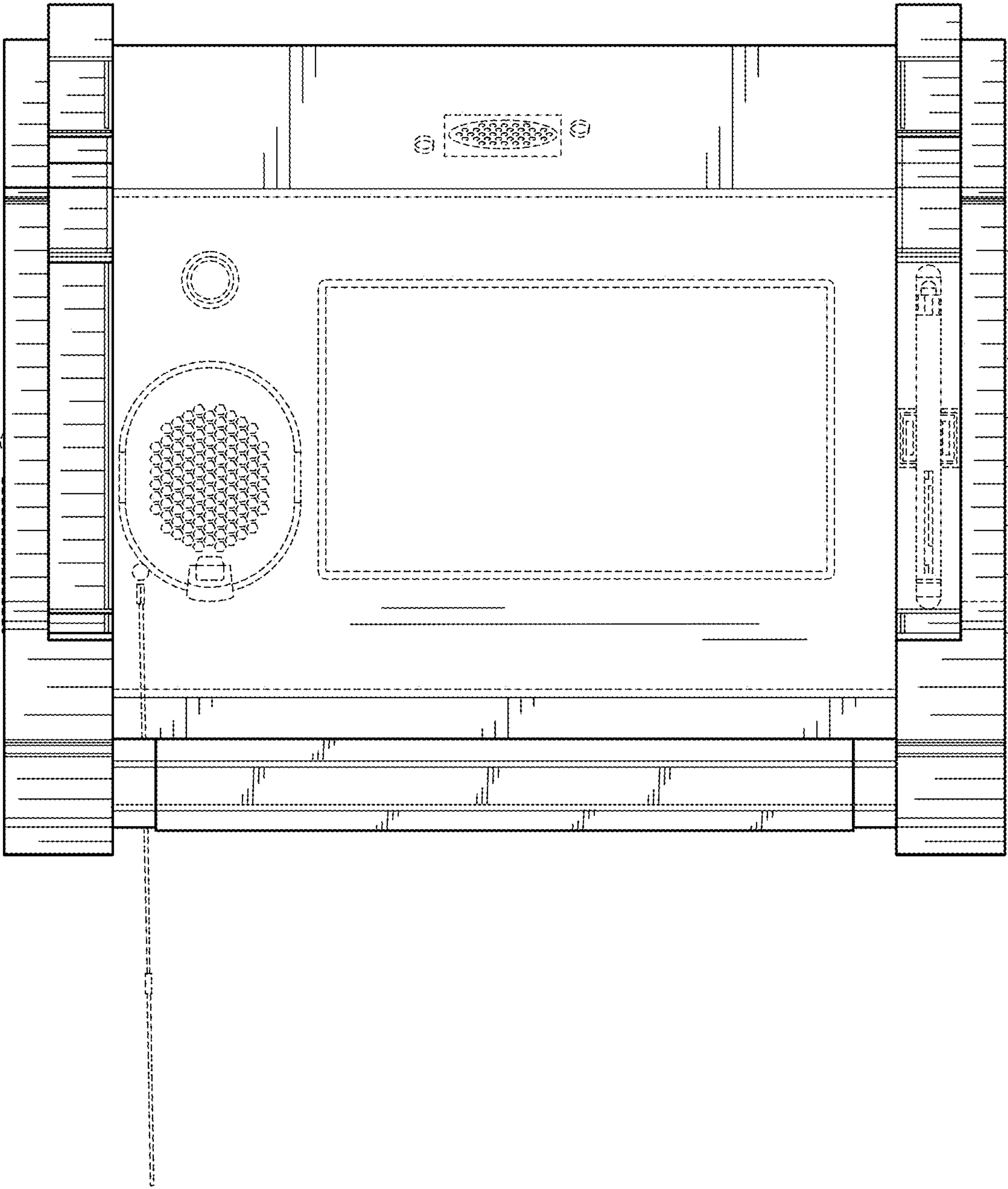

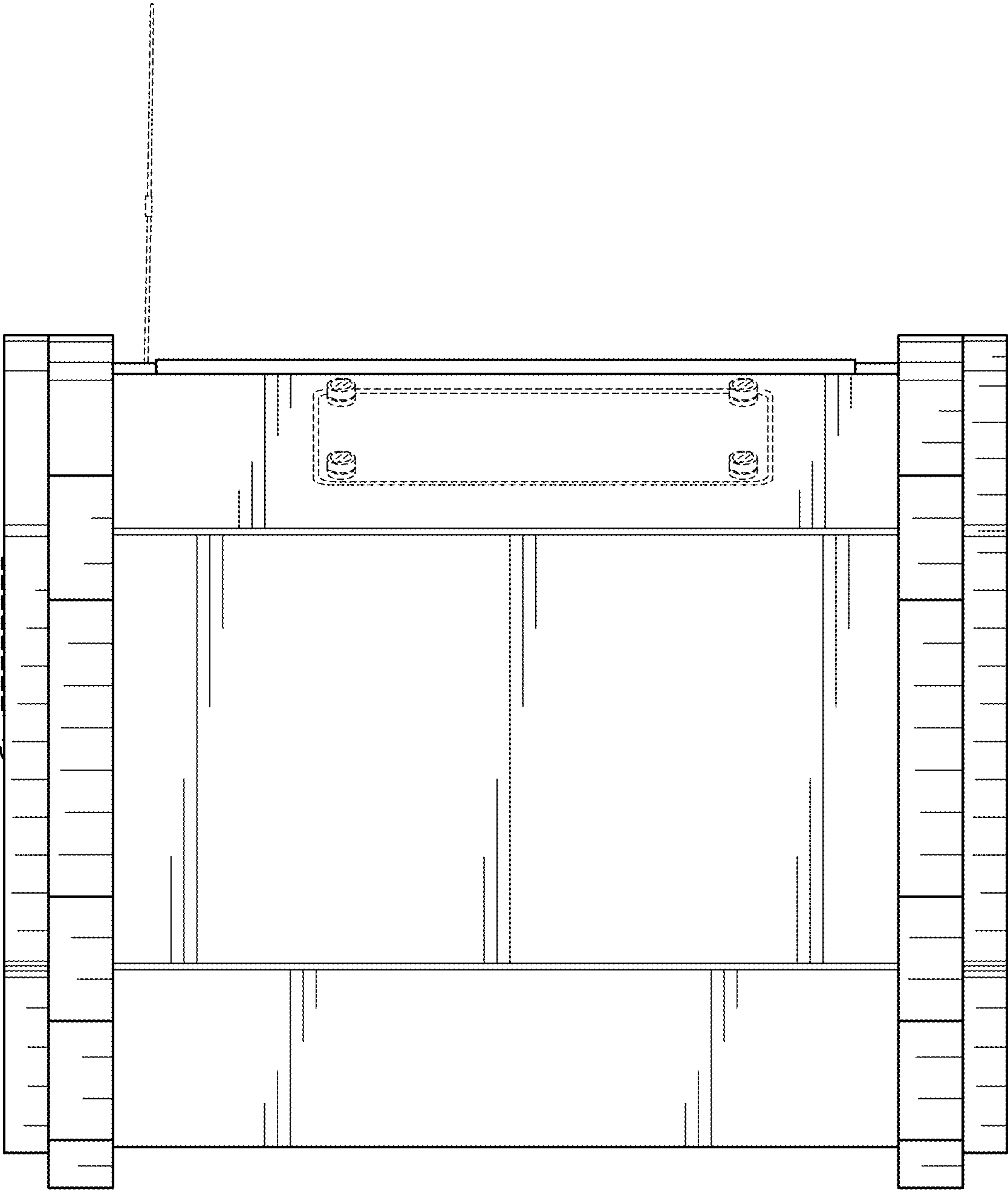
