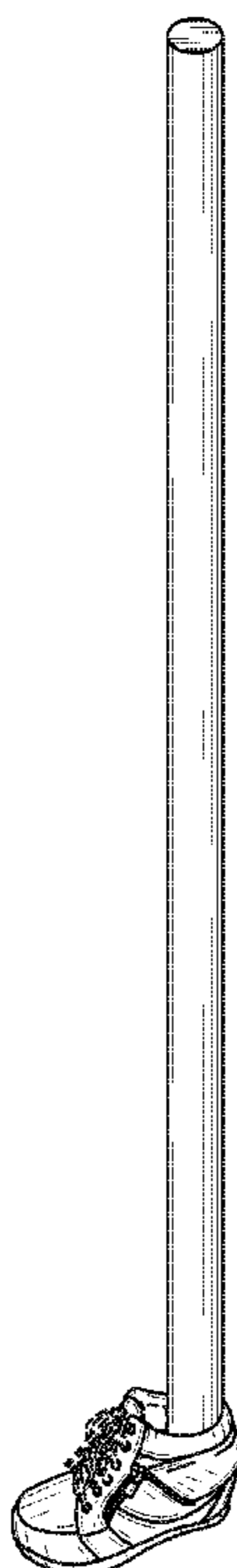
The ornamental design for a walking cane, as shown and described.

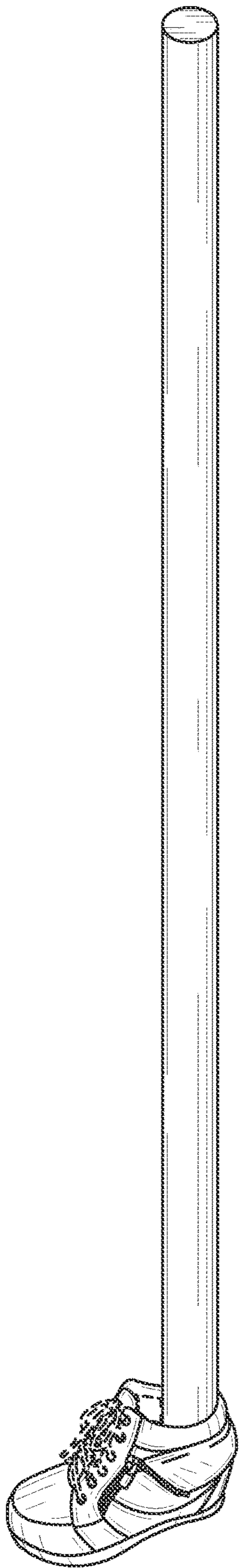
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof.

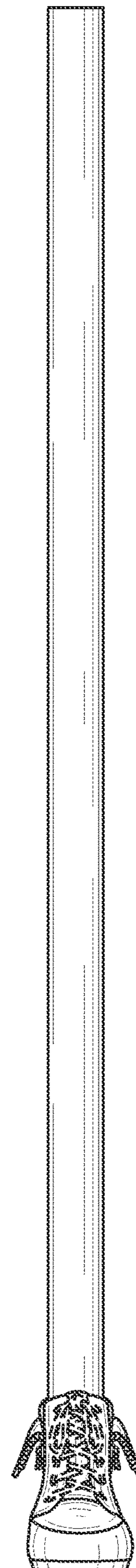
The broken lines depict portions of the article that form no part of the claimed design.

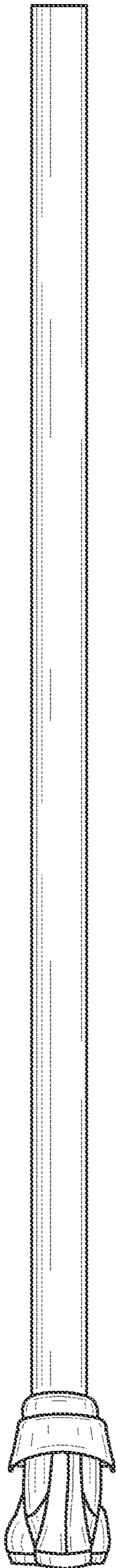




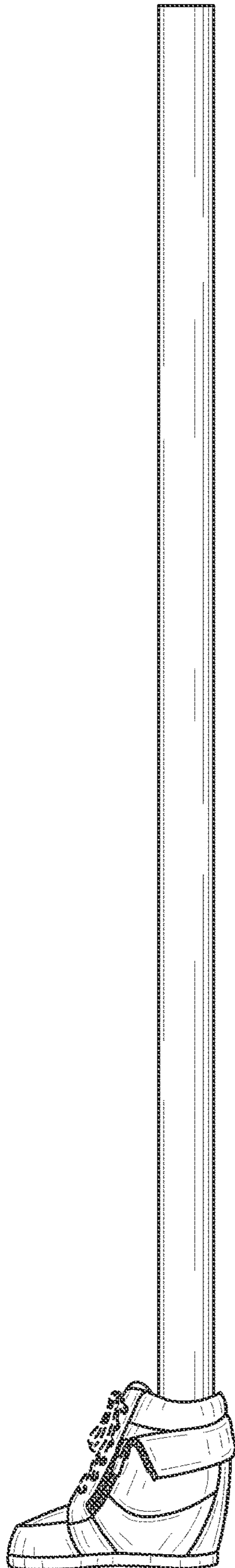

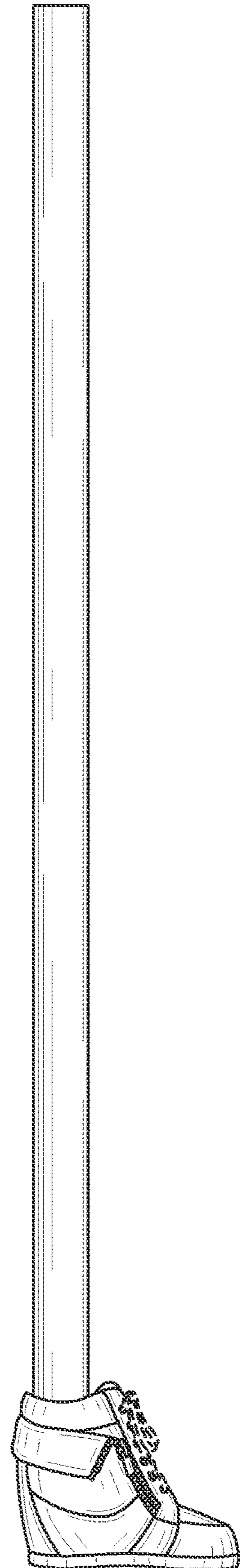
