DESCRIPTION

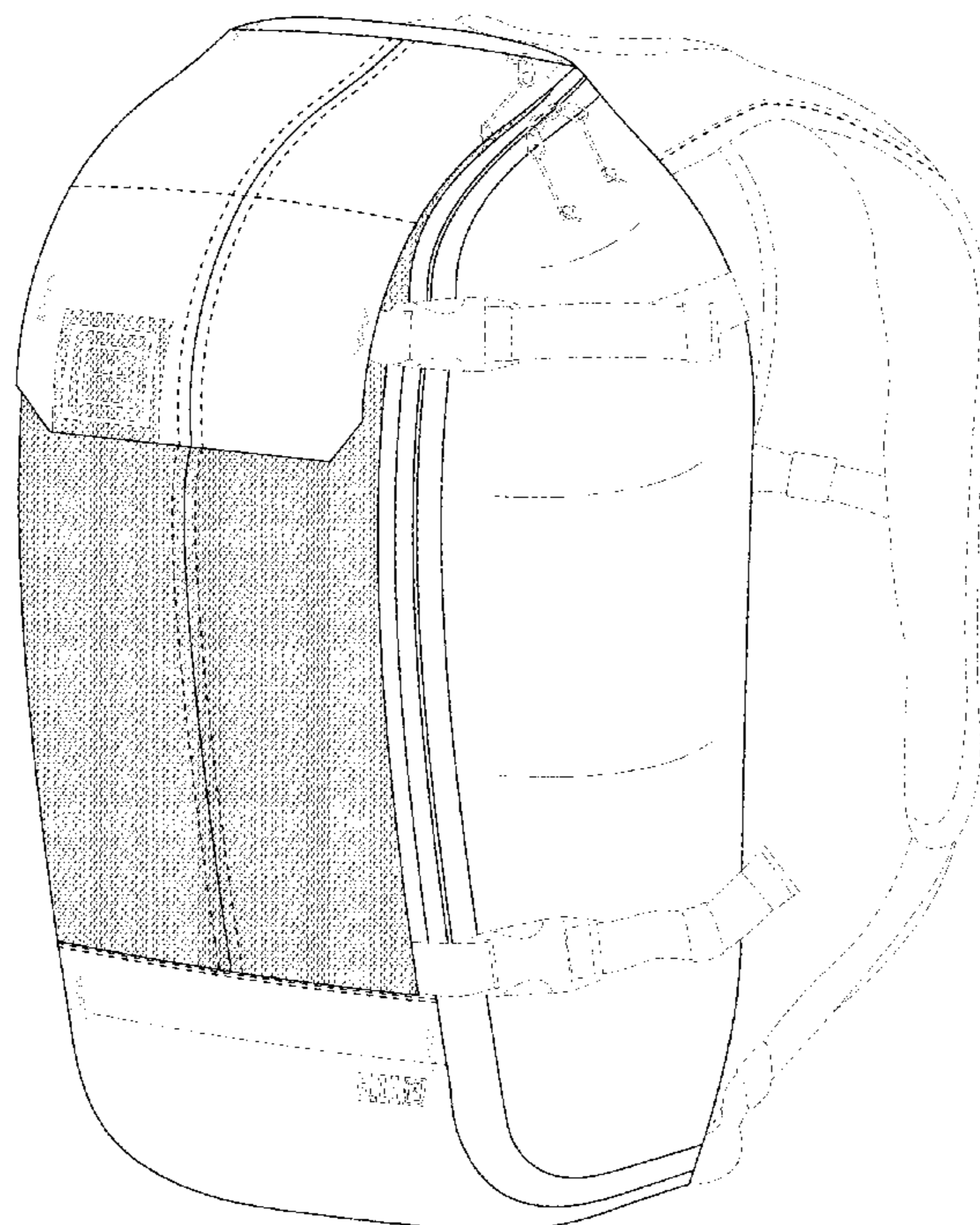
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a backpack, which embodies our design.

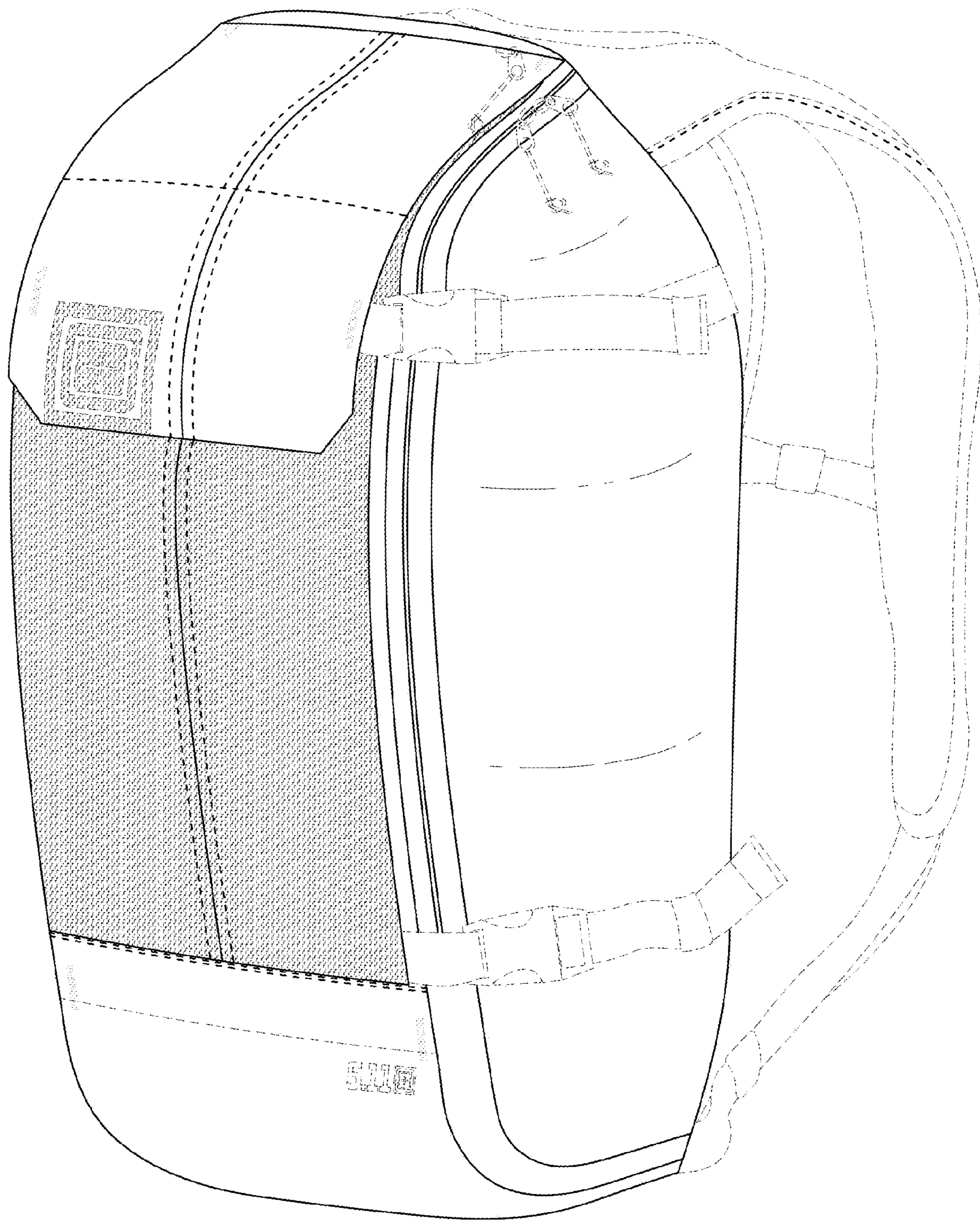

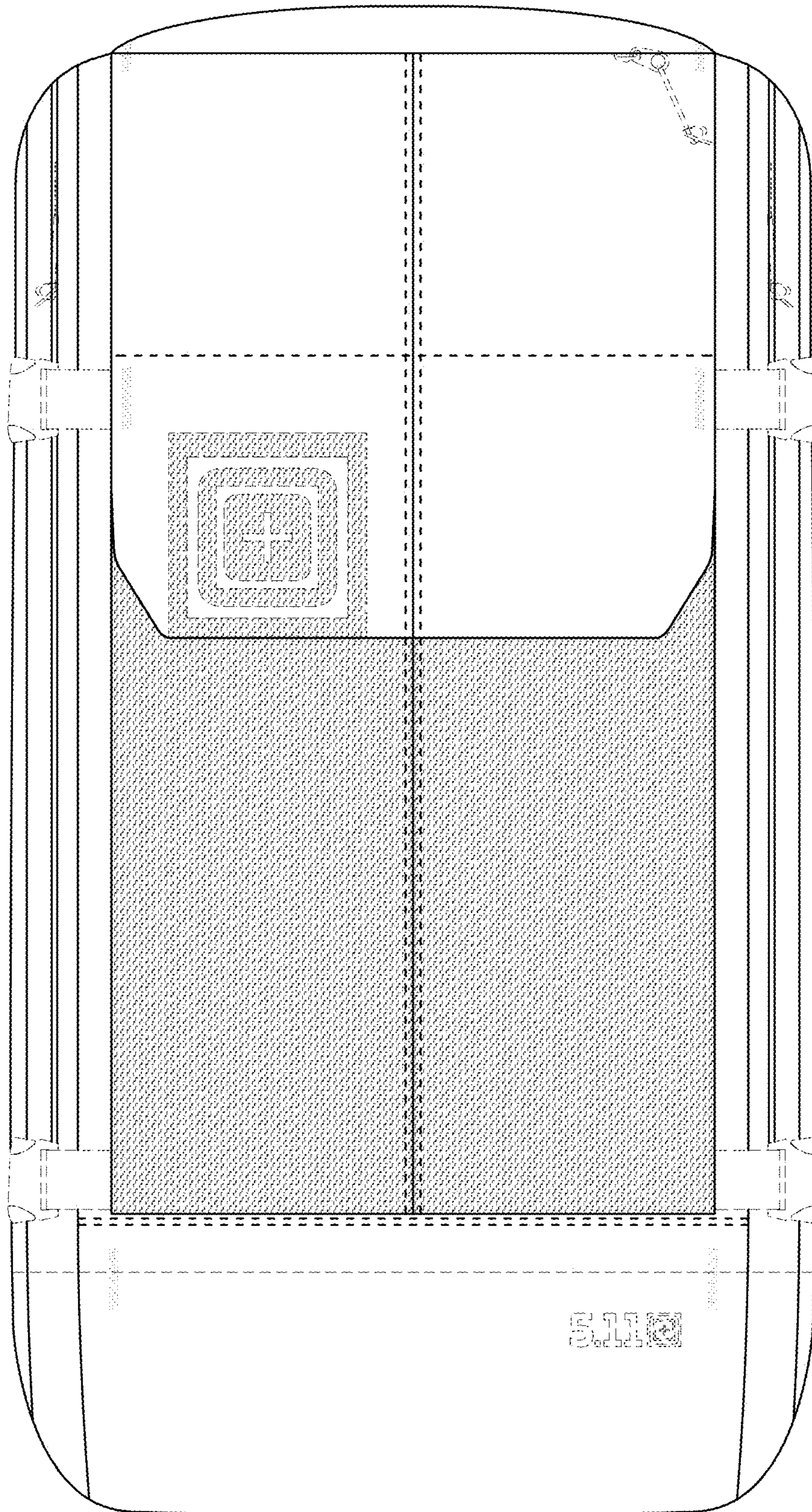

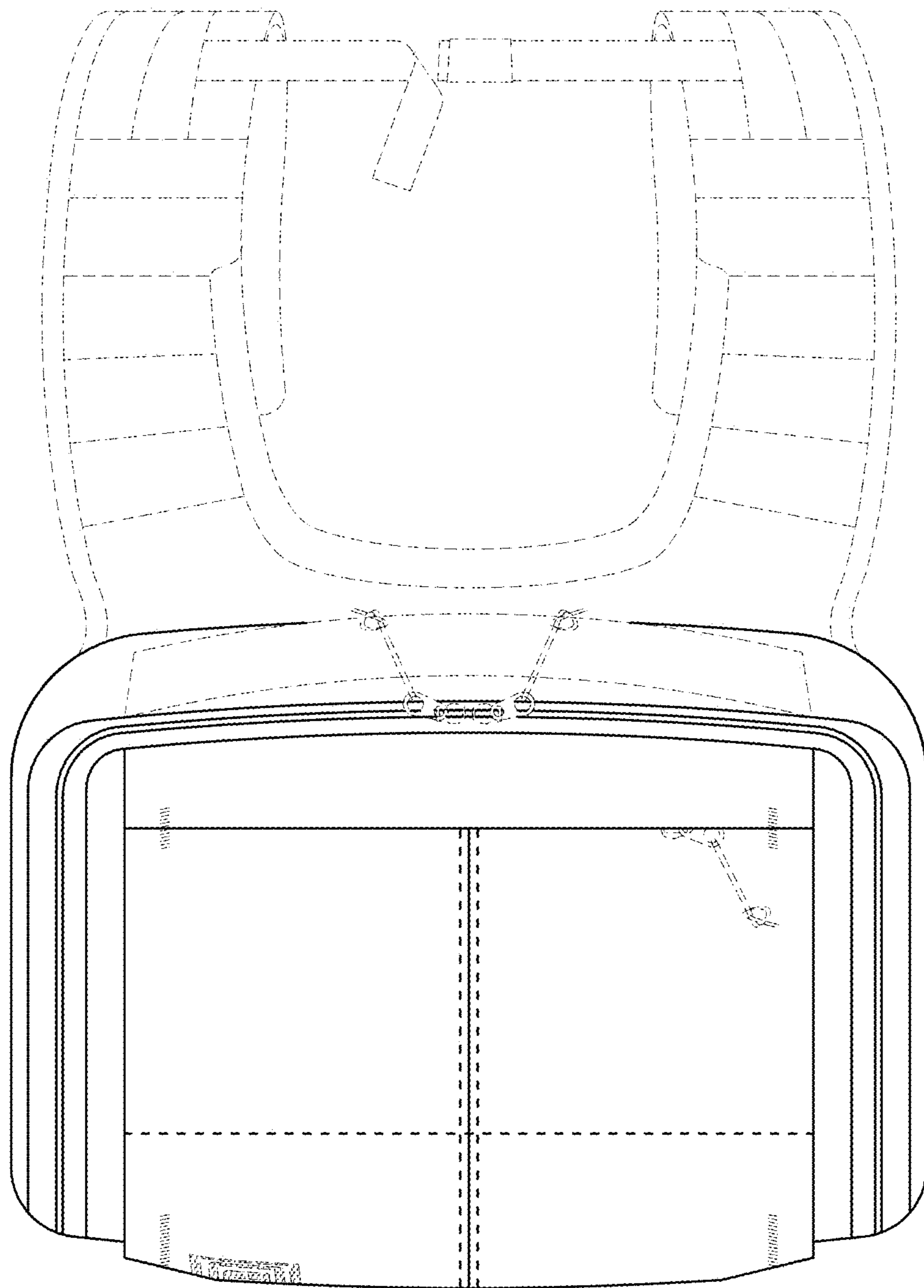
