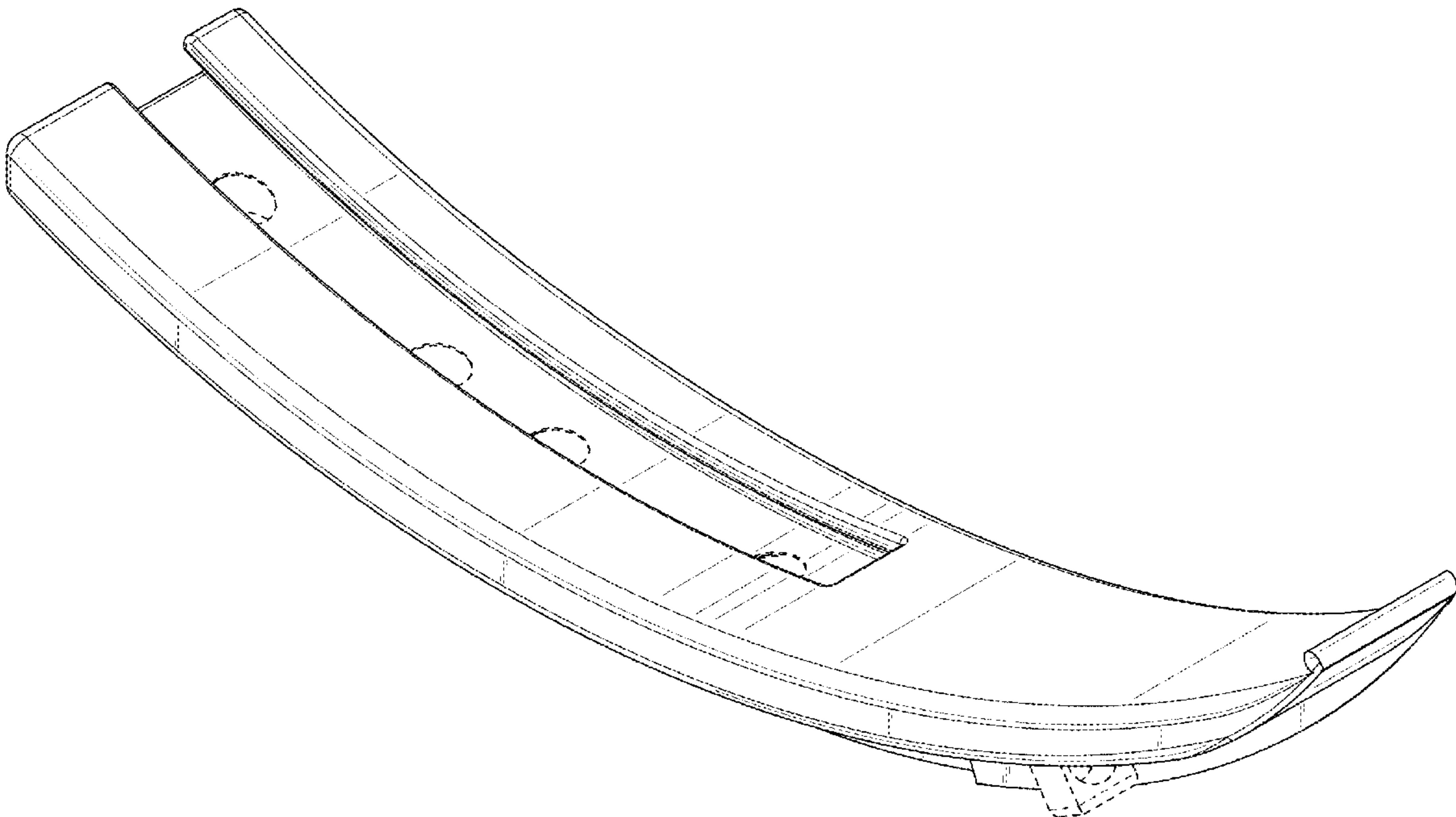
The ornamental design for an intubation blade, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an intubation blade in accordance with the new design;

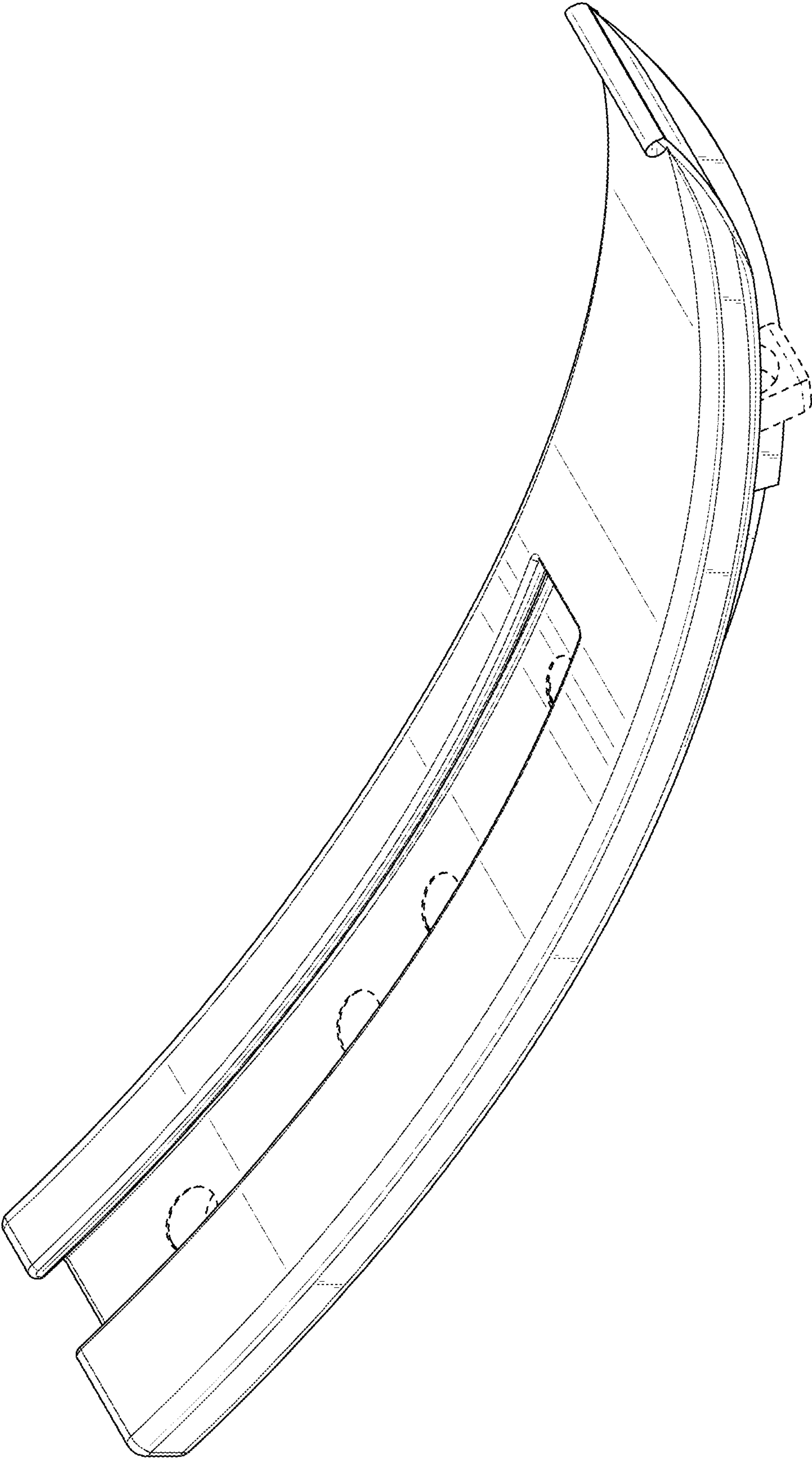

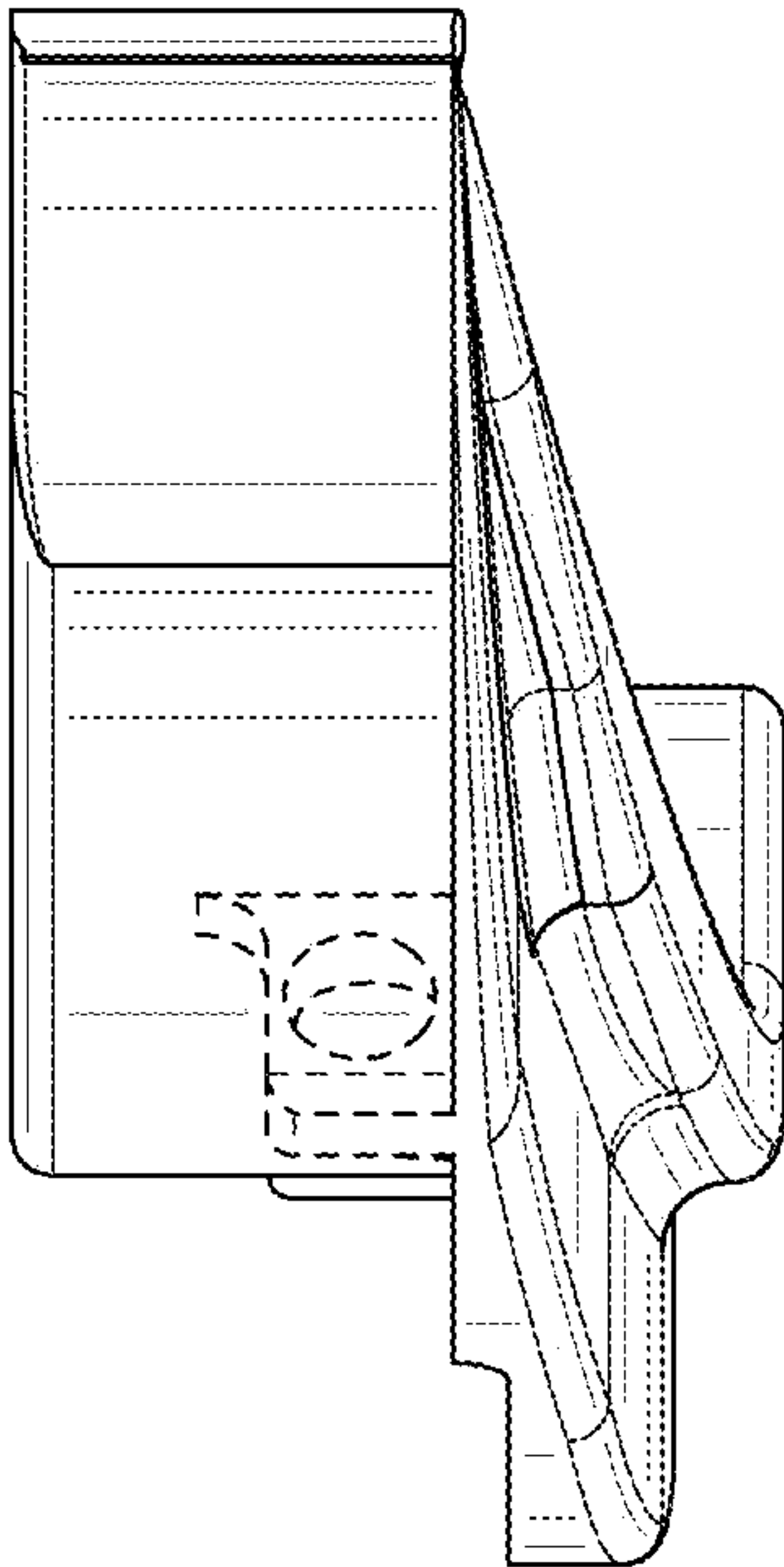

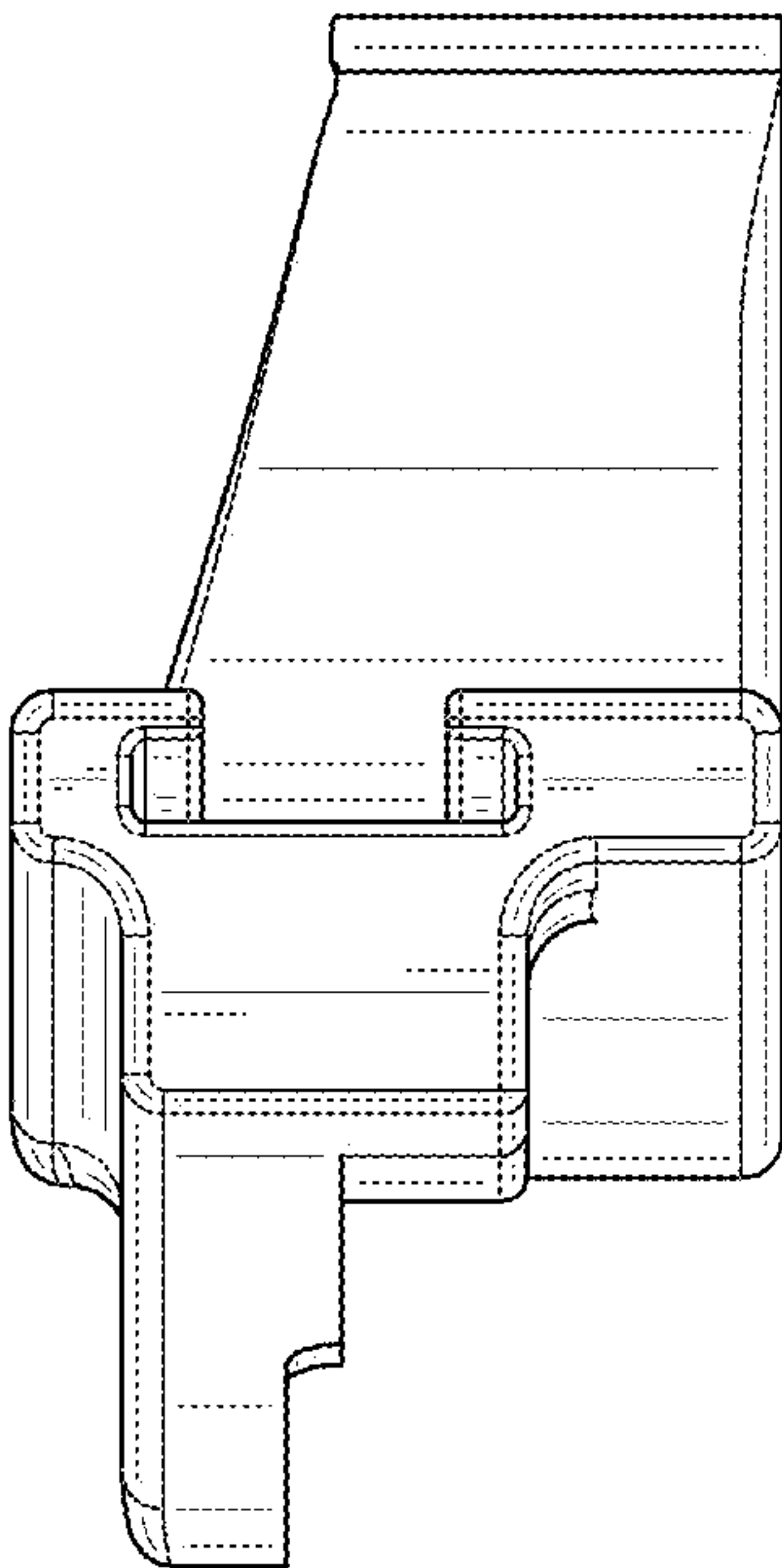

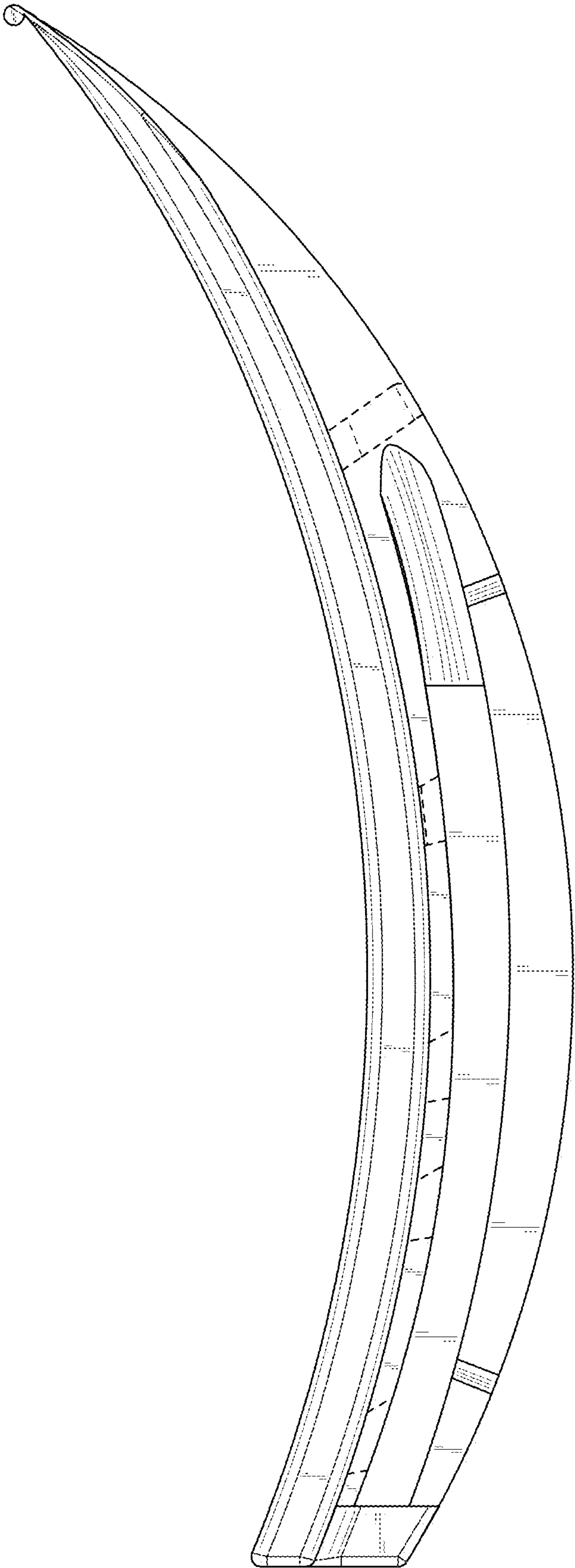

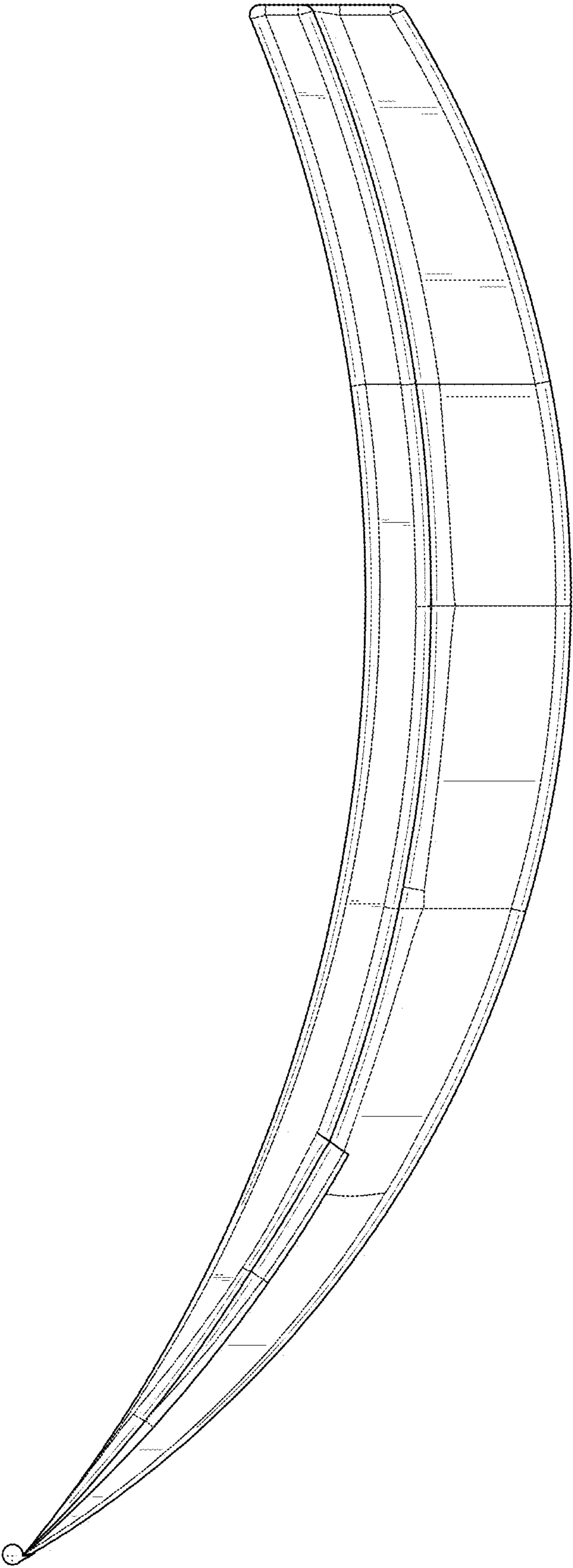

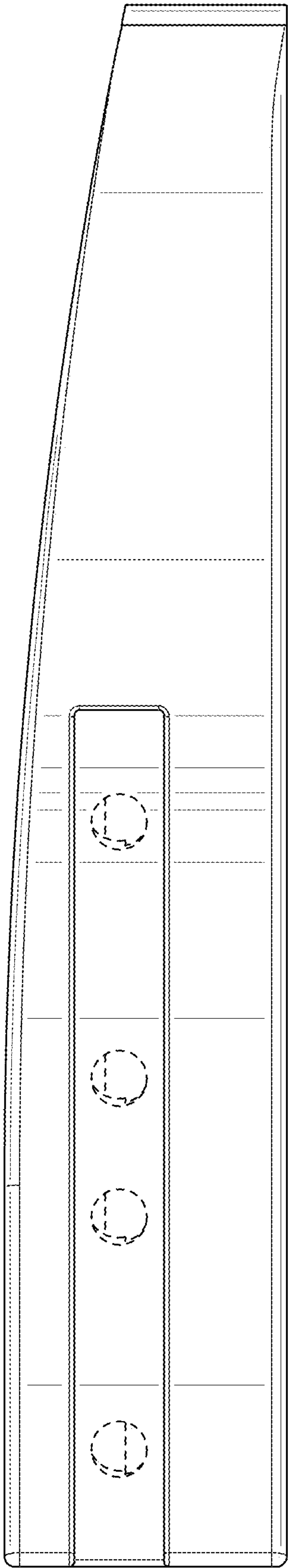

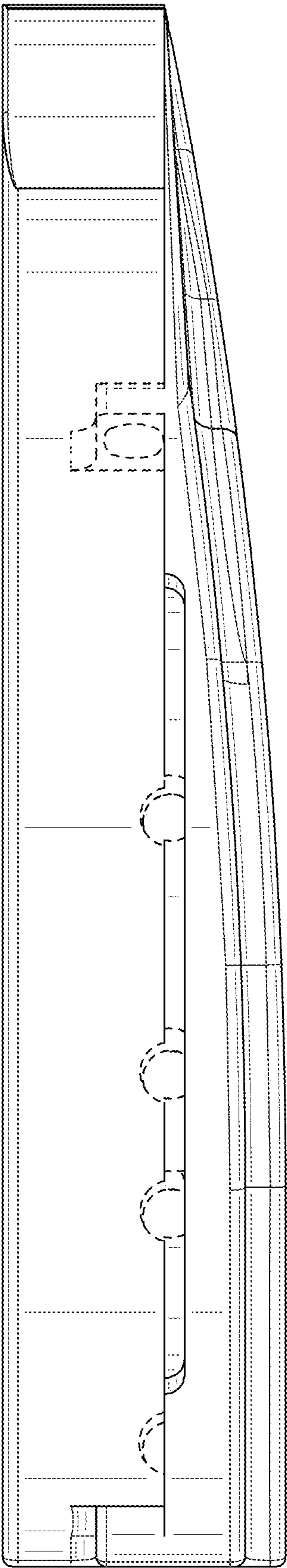
