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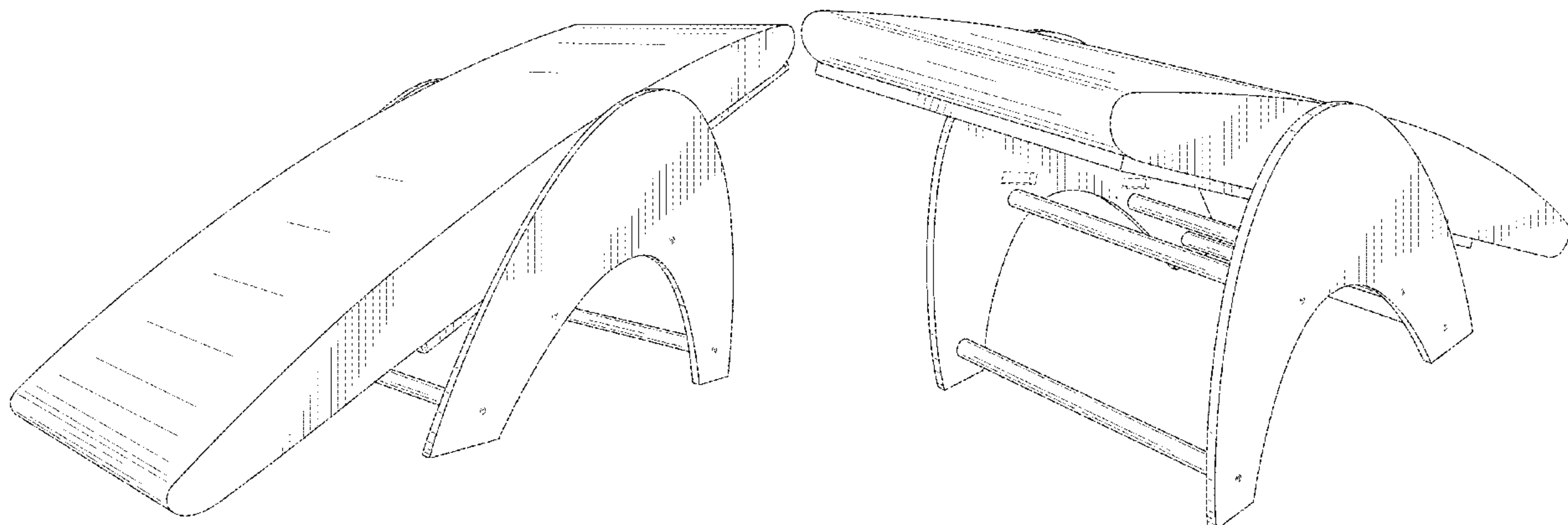
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of a dog ramp showing my design;

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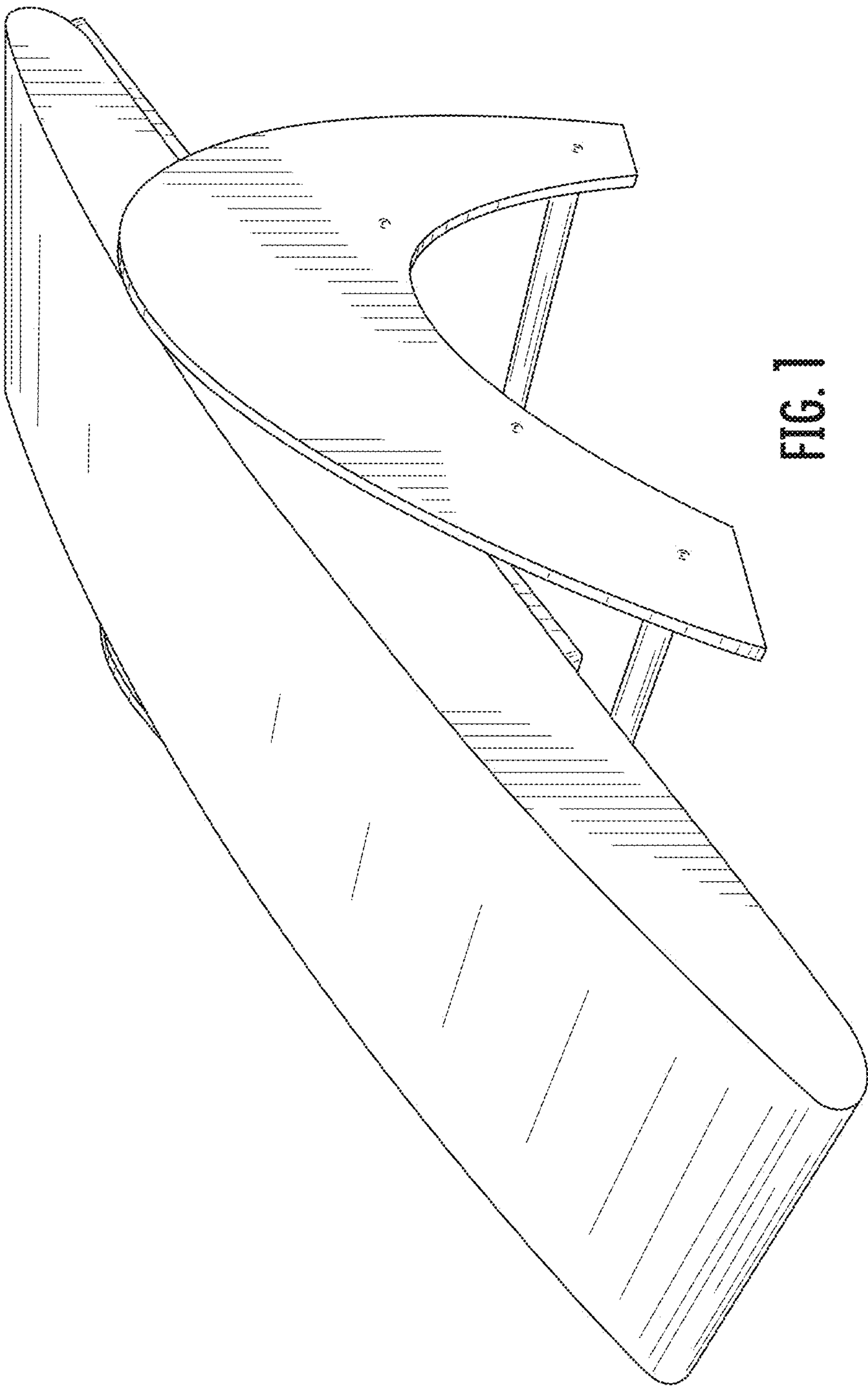

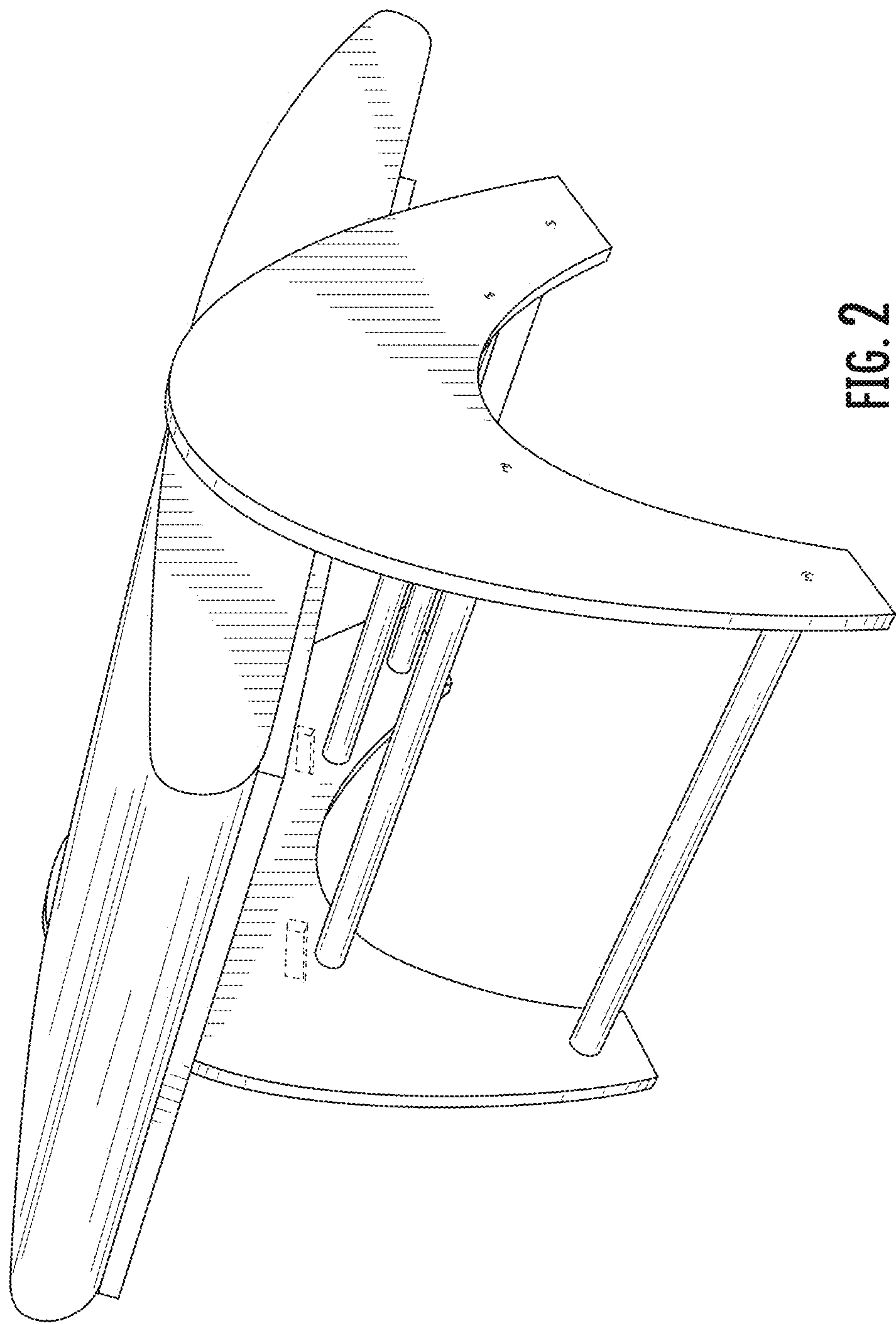

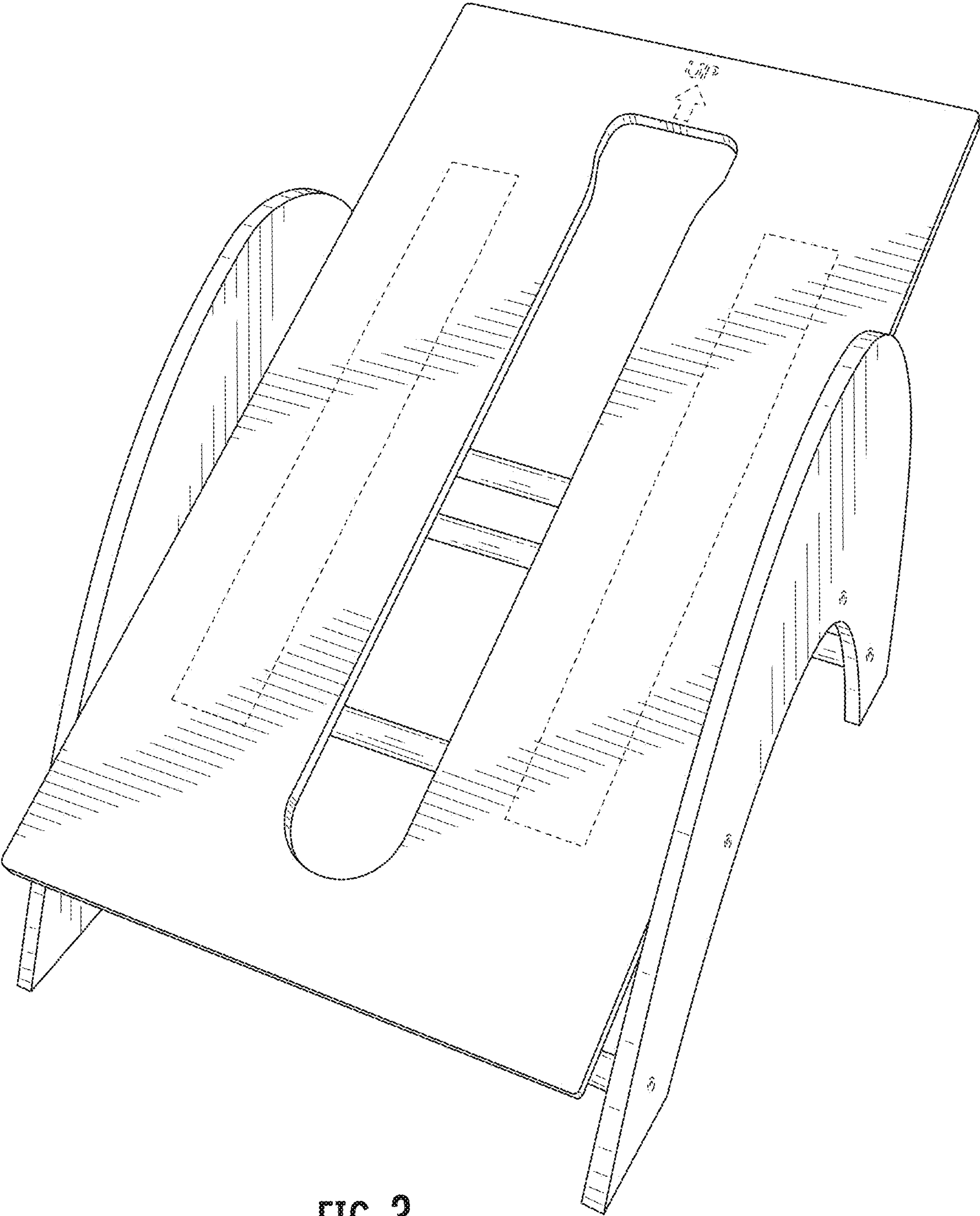

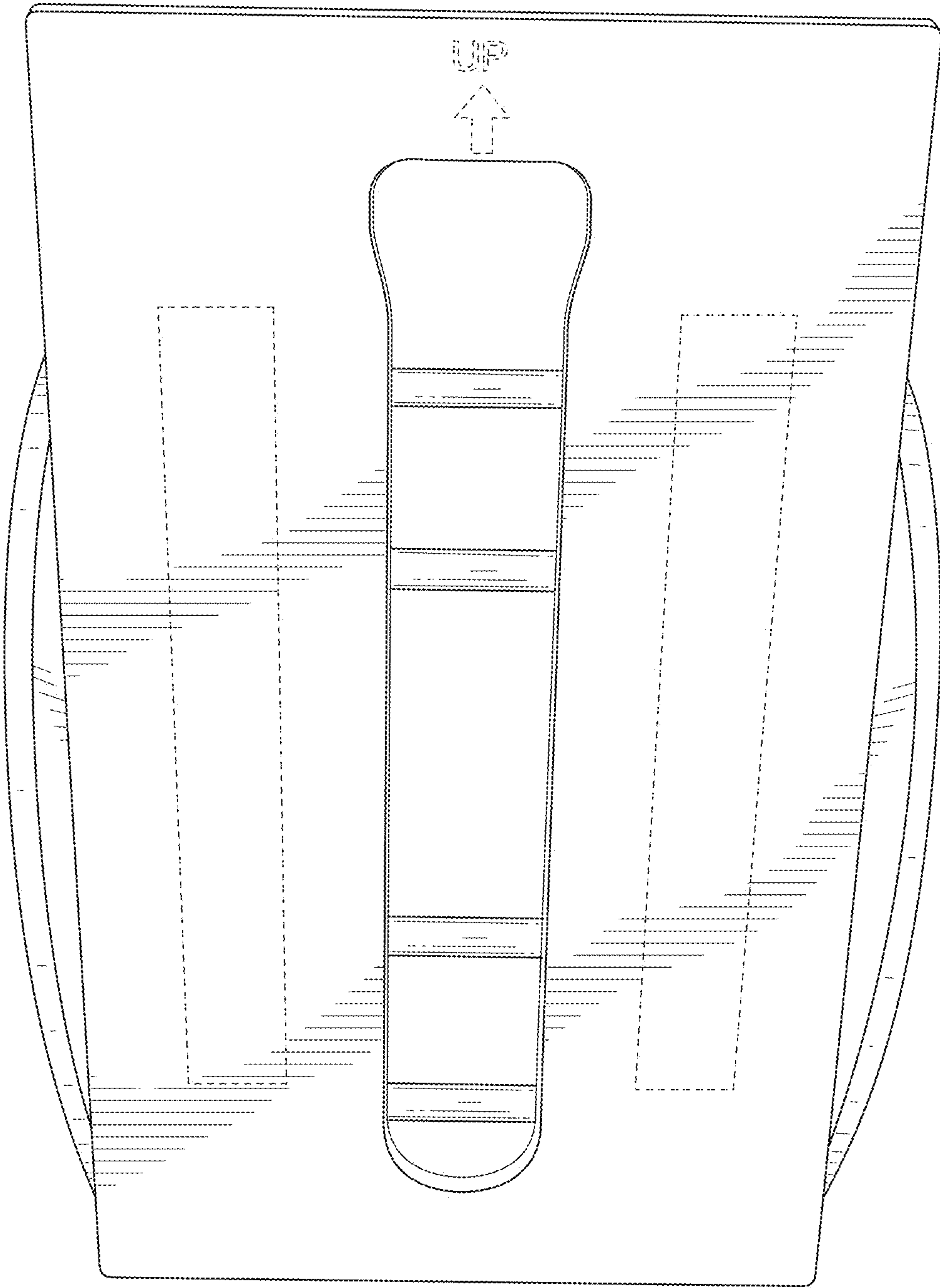

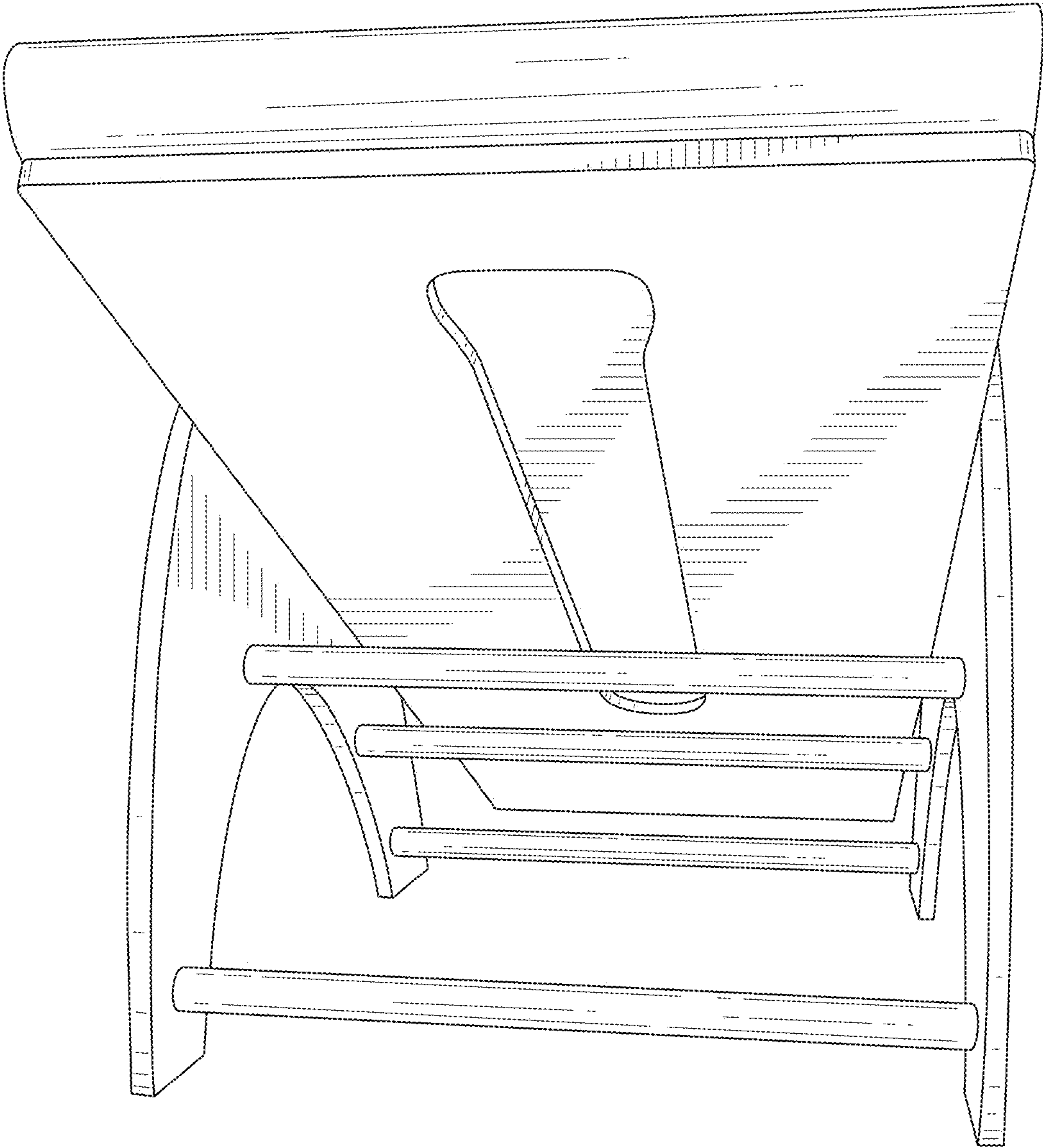

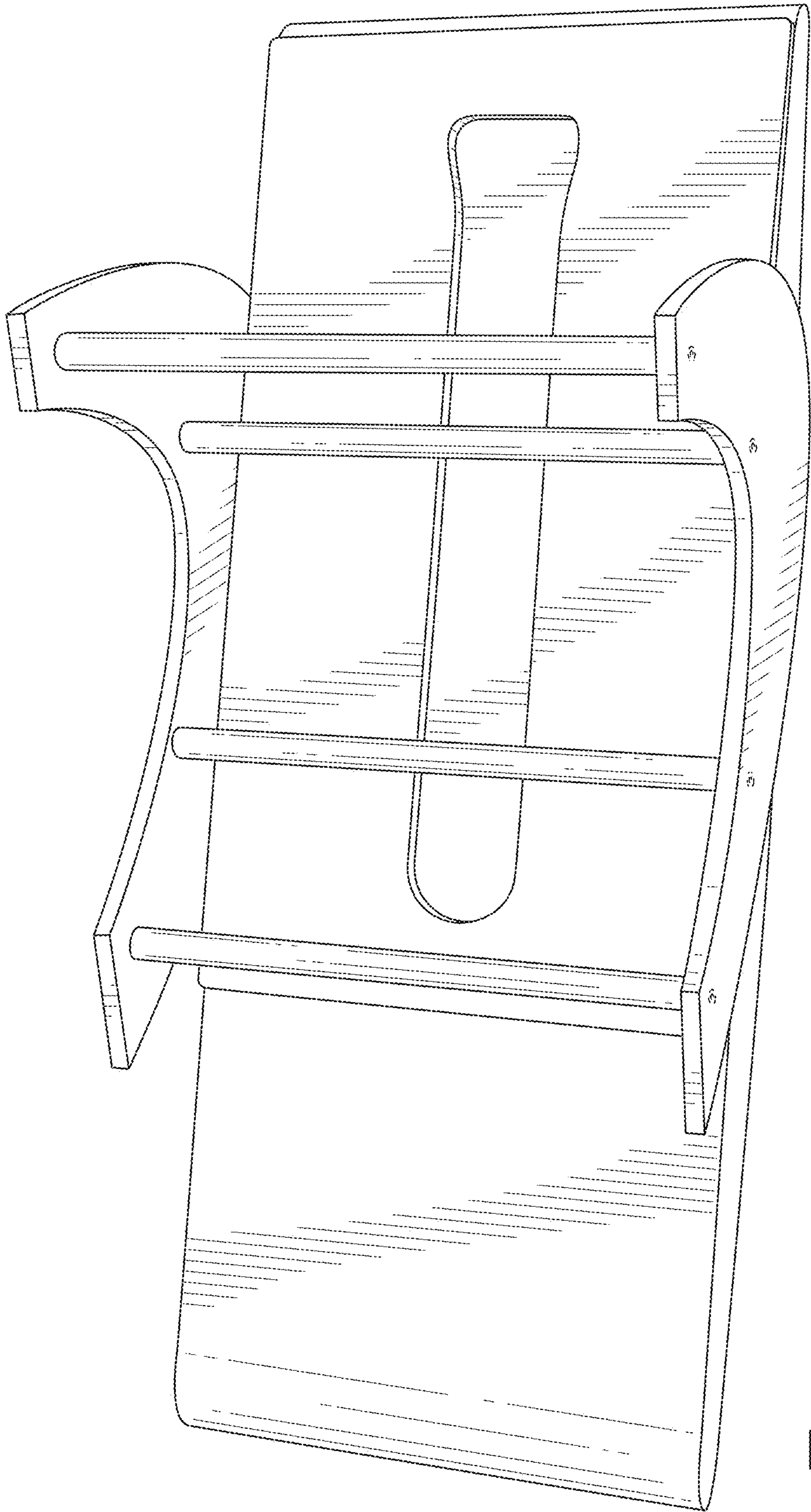
