FIG. 11 is a reference view showing the state of use that the stand has been separated from the bottom bar of the display part.

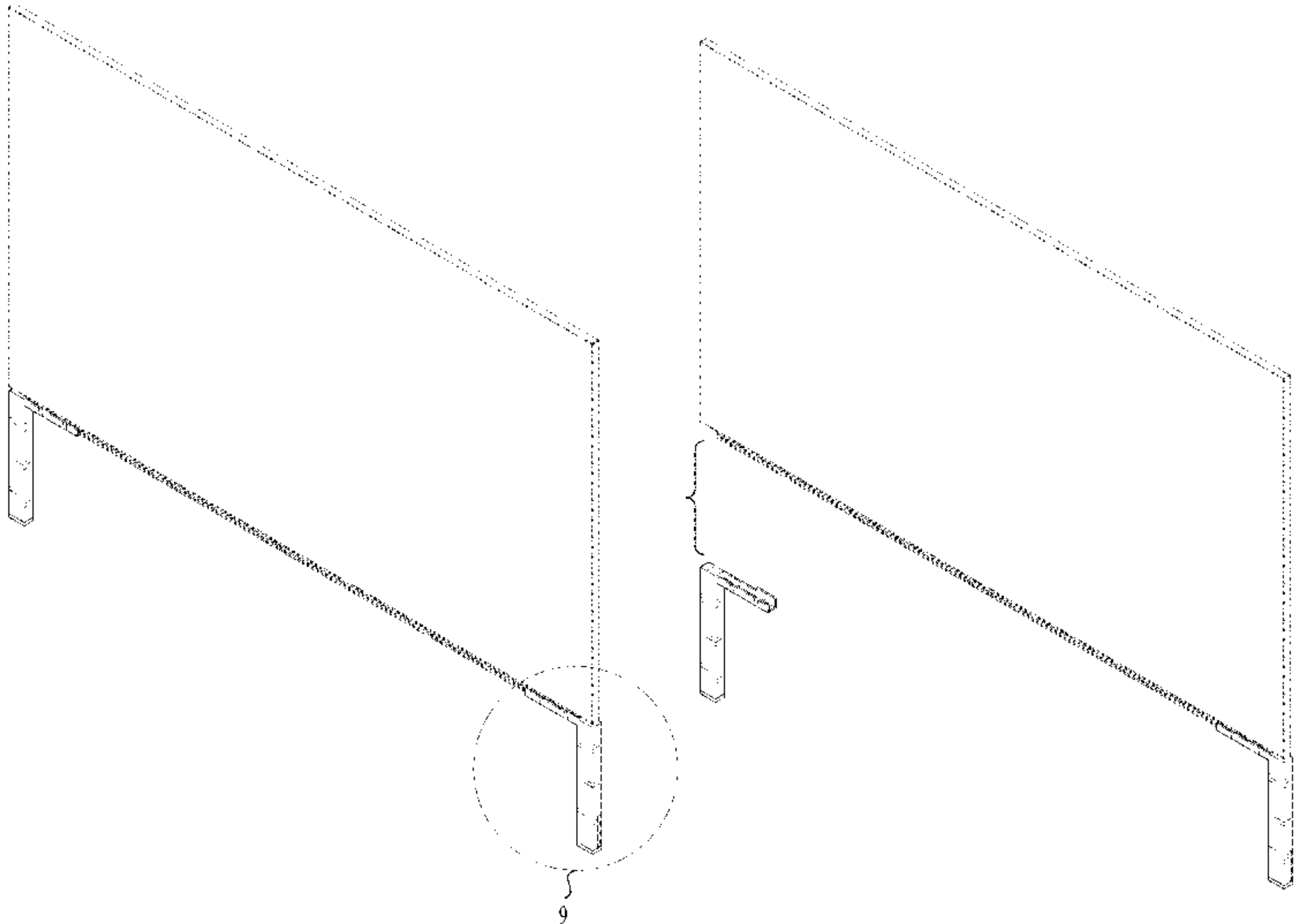

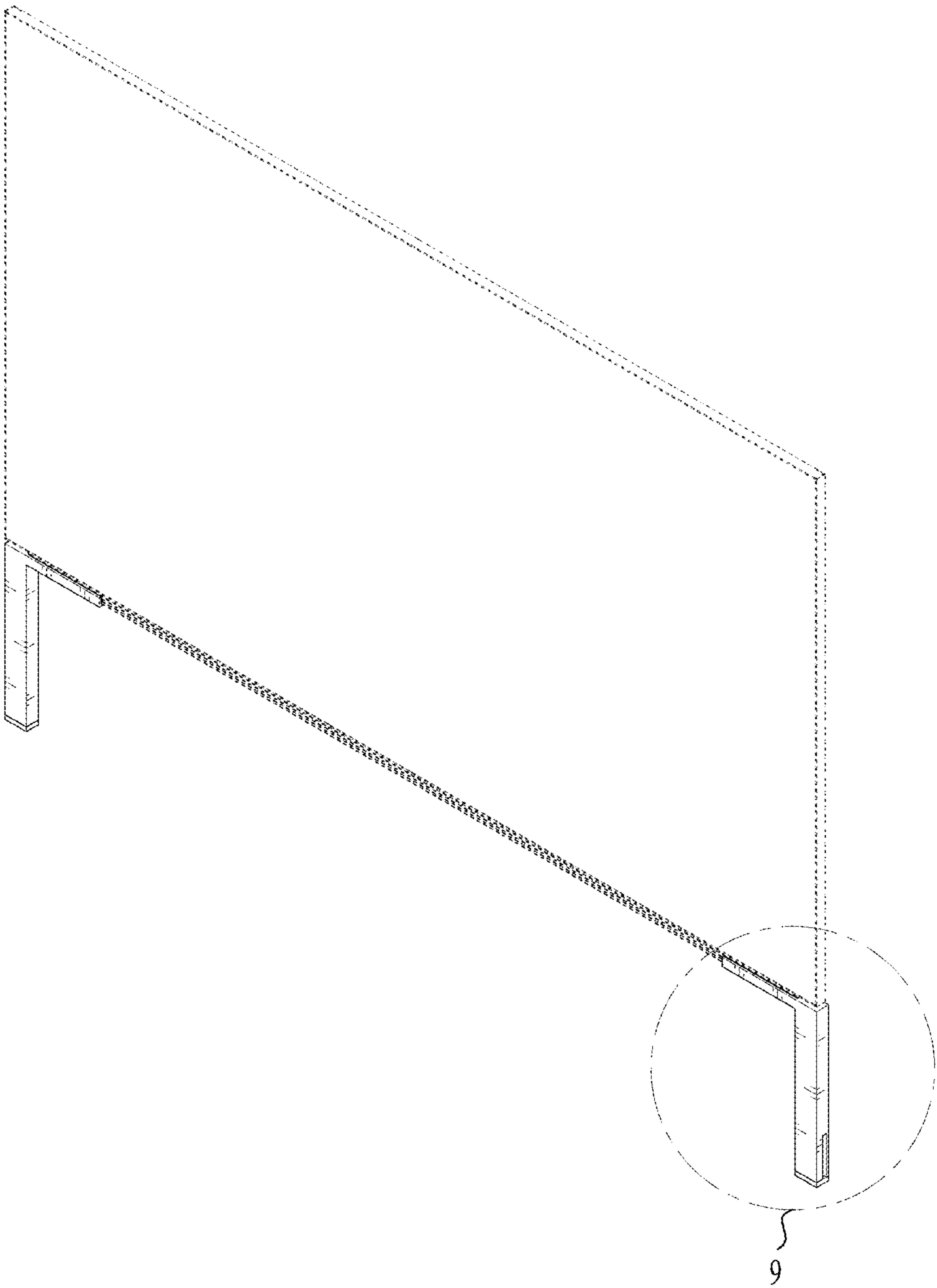

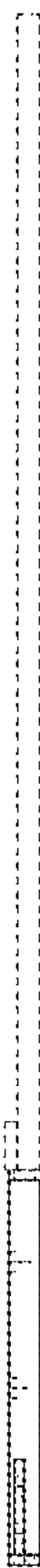

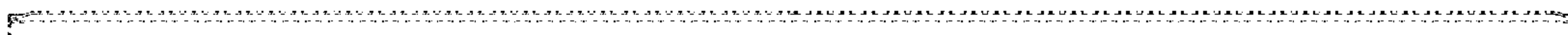

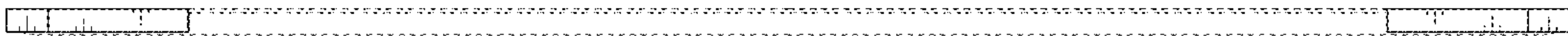

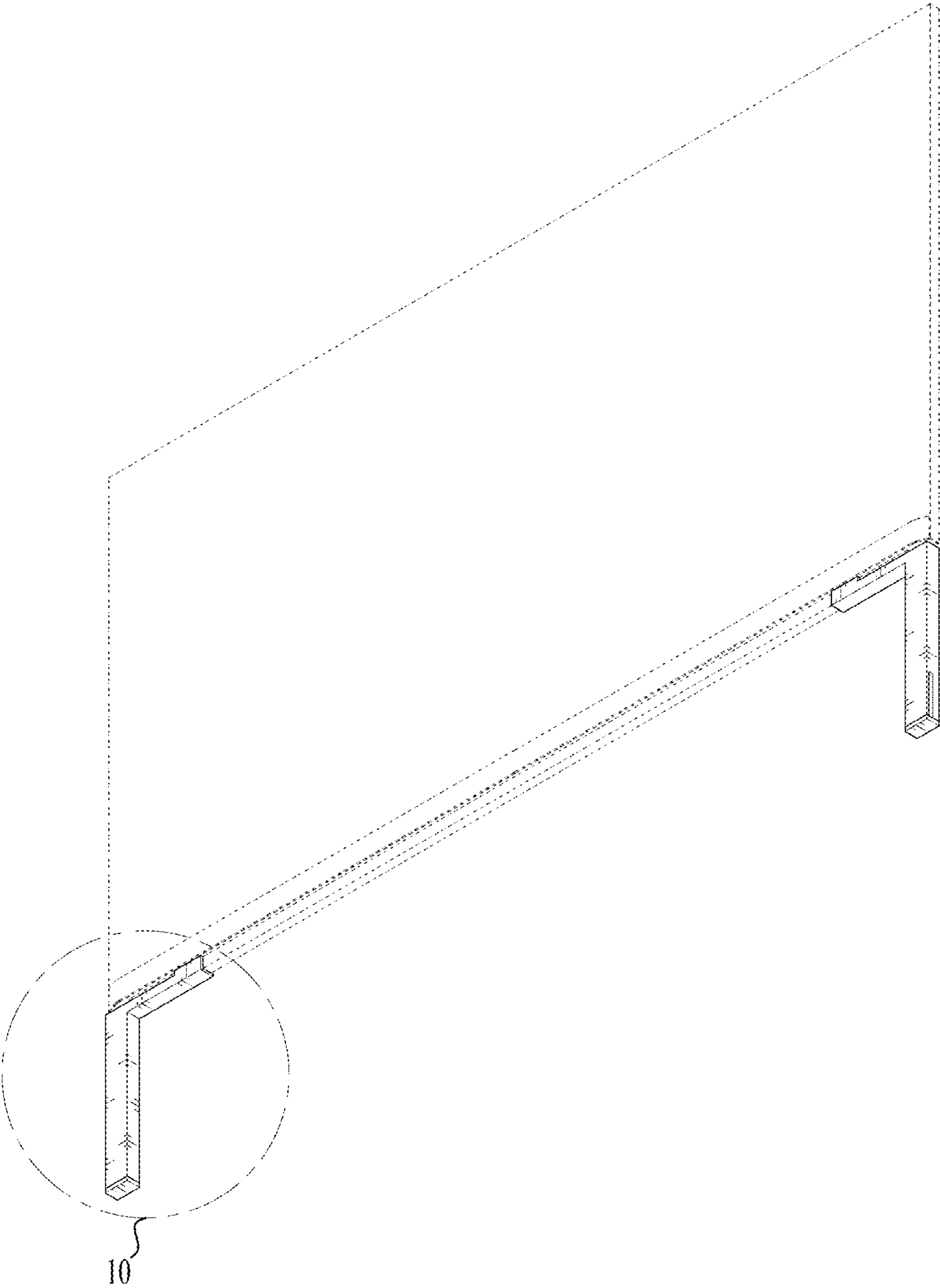

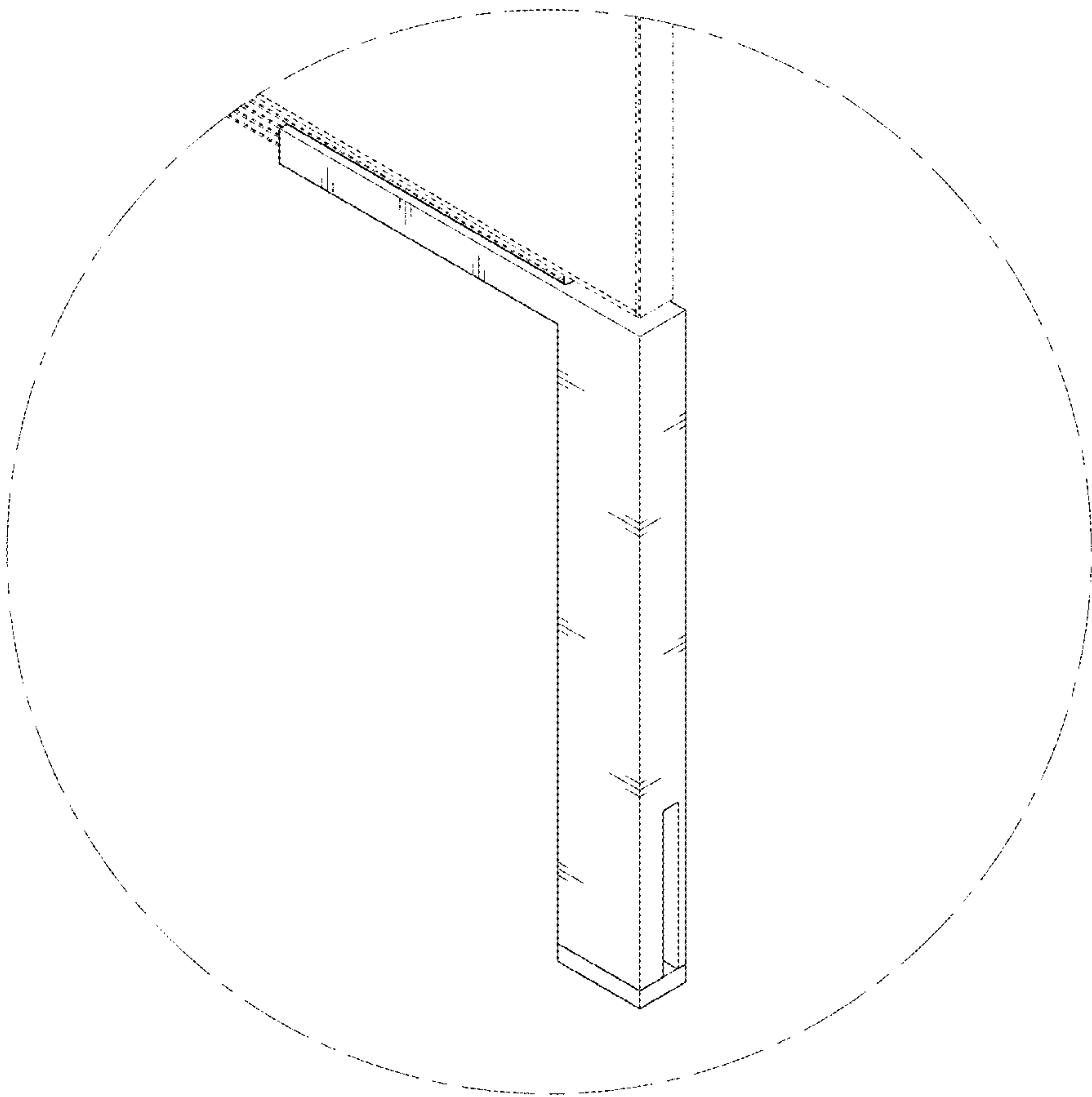

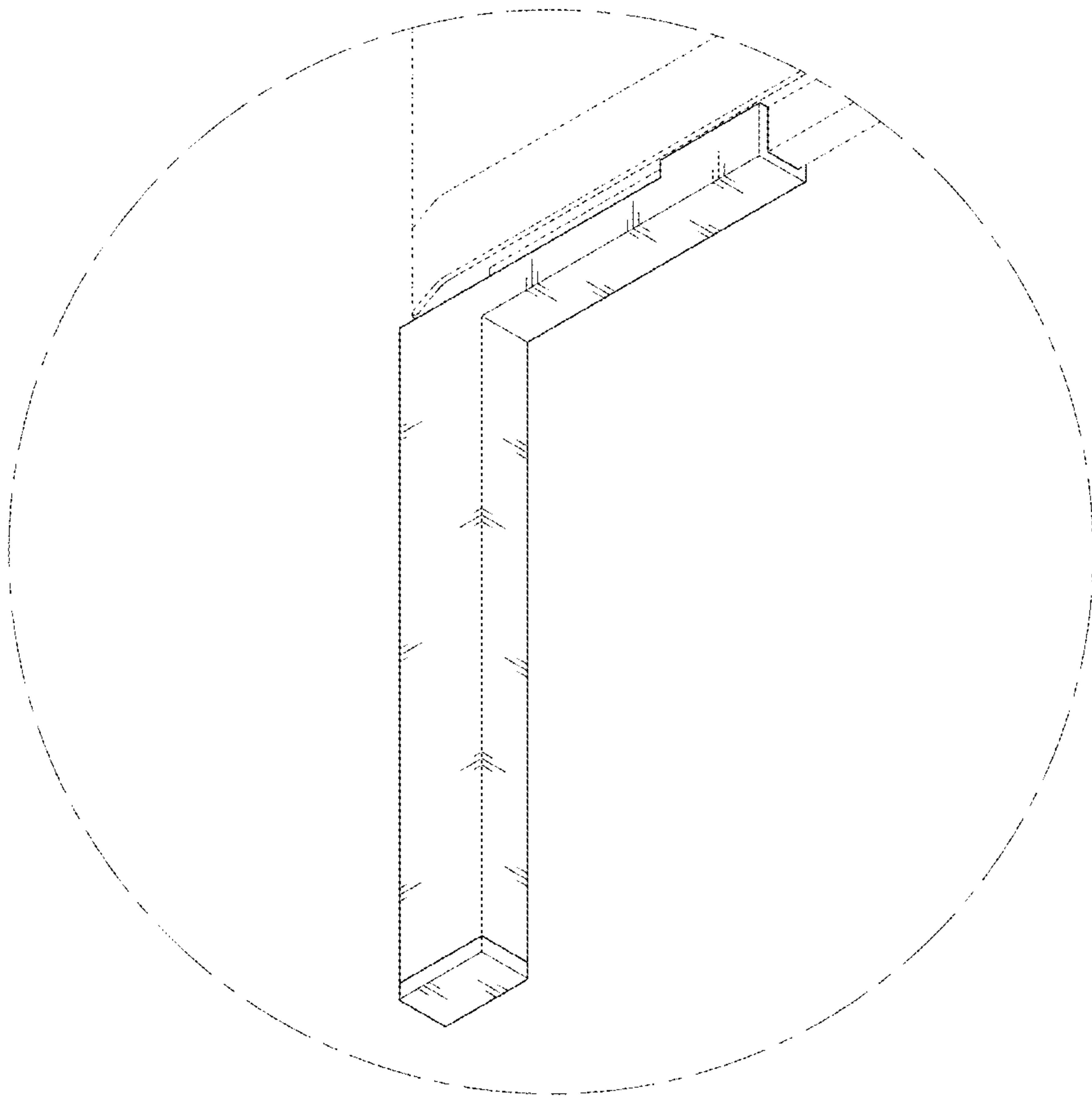
