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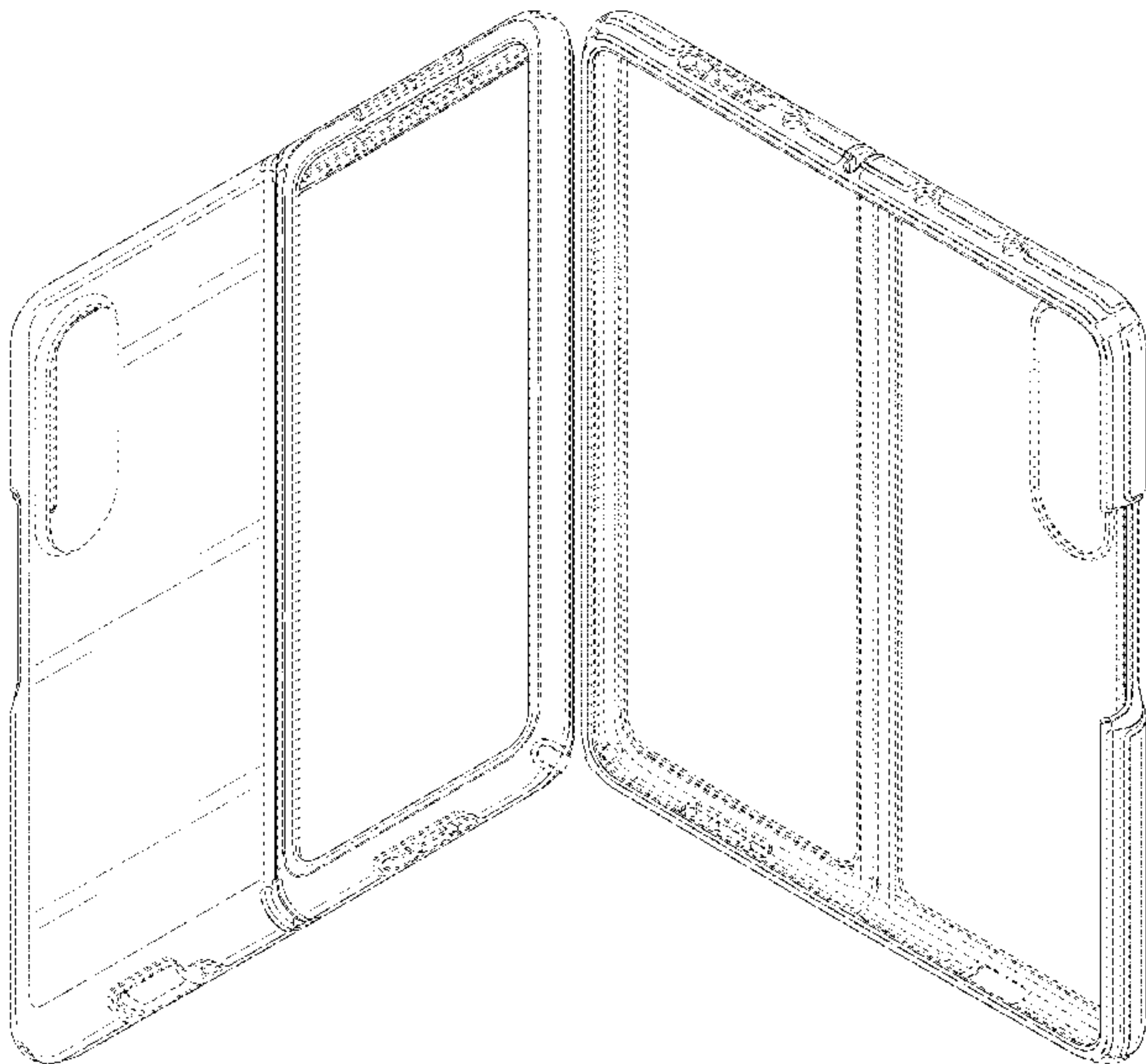
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a foldable case for an electronic device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

This application is related to application Ser. No. 29/803,068, entitled Foldable Case for an Electronic Device, filed on Aug. 10, 2021, the disclosure of which is incorporated herein by reference.
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the foldable case for an electronic device according to our new design;

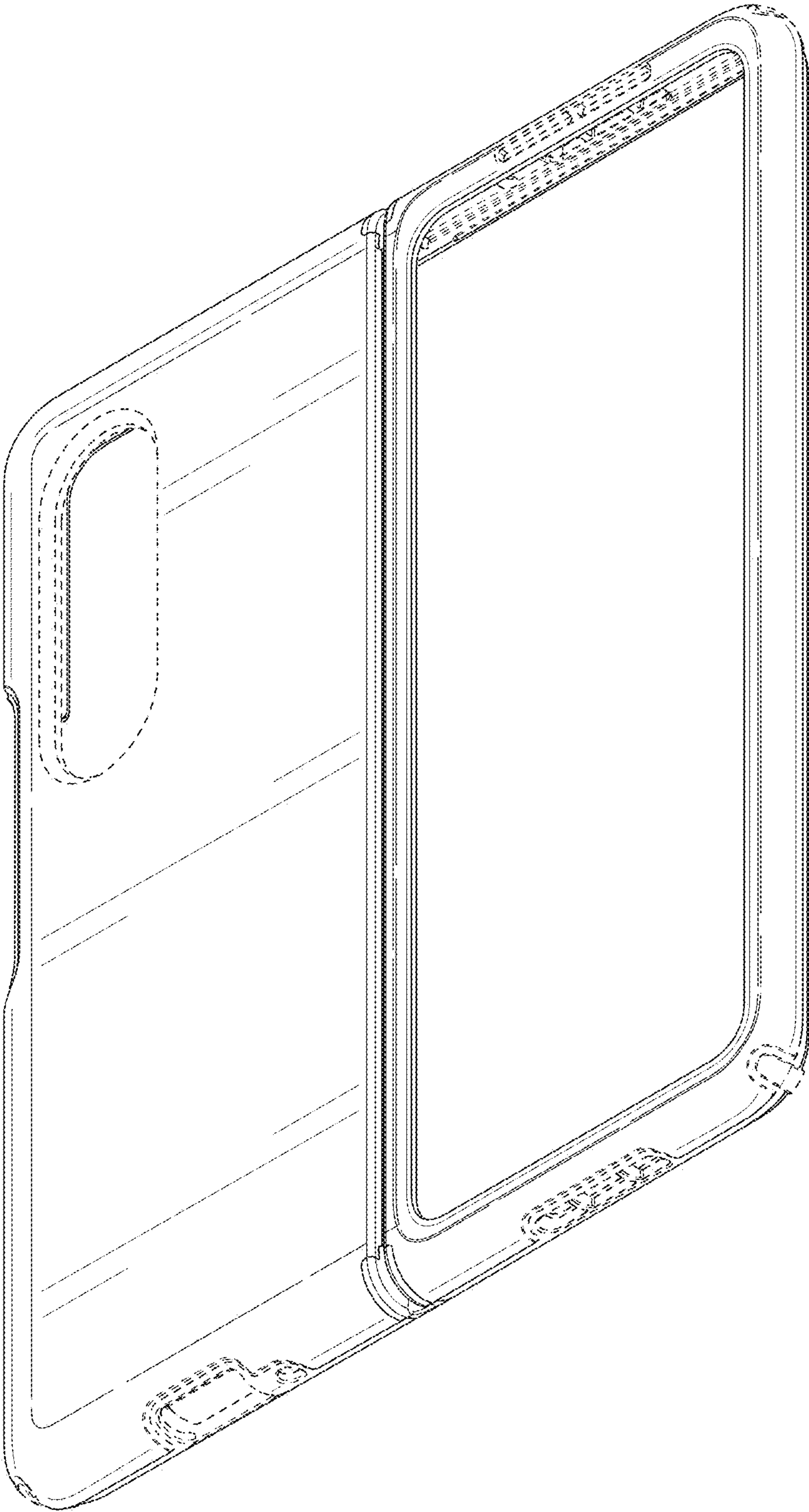

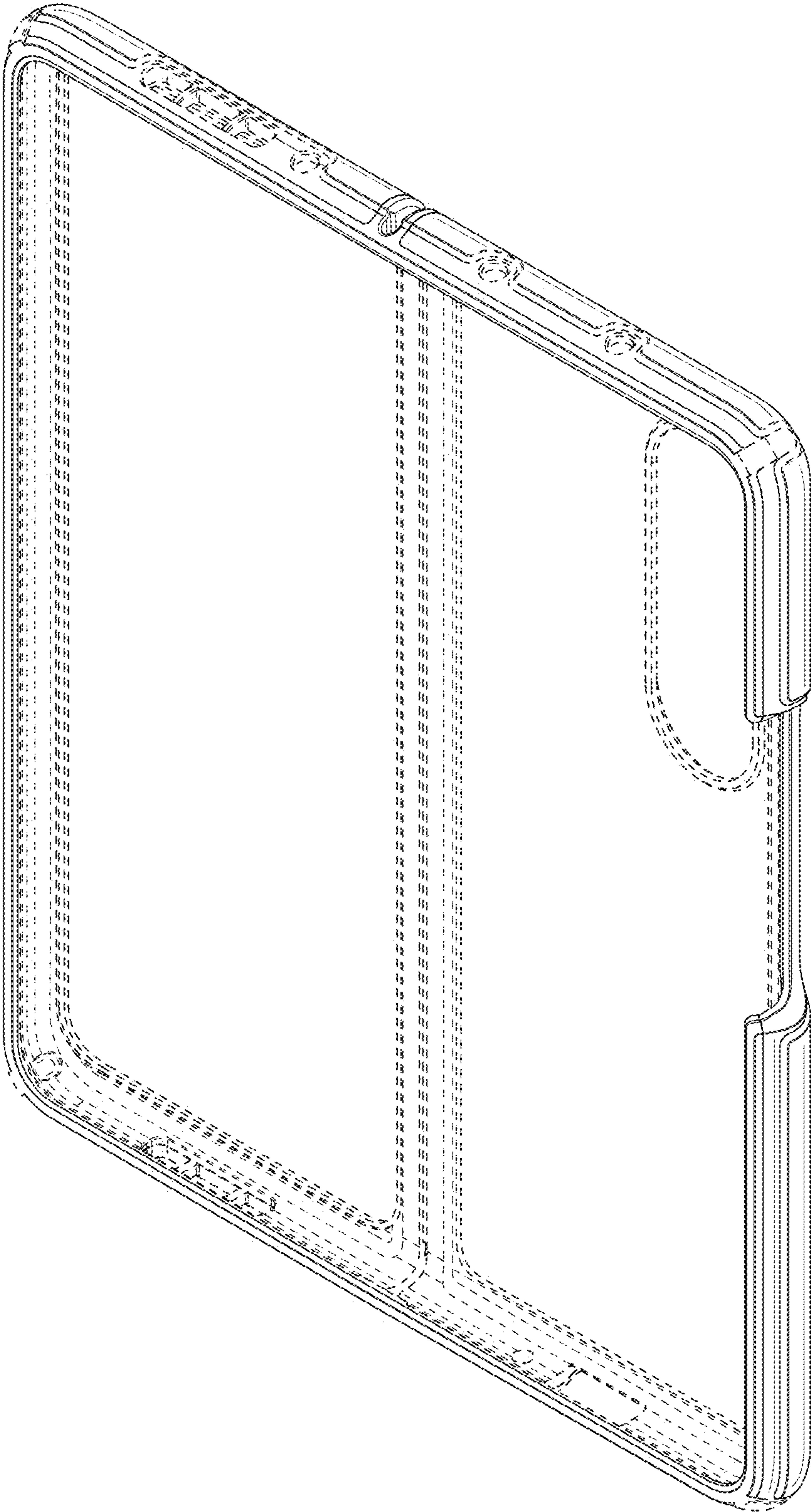

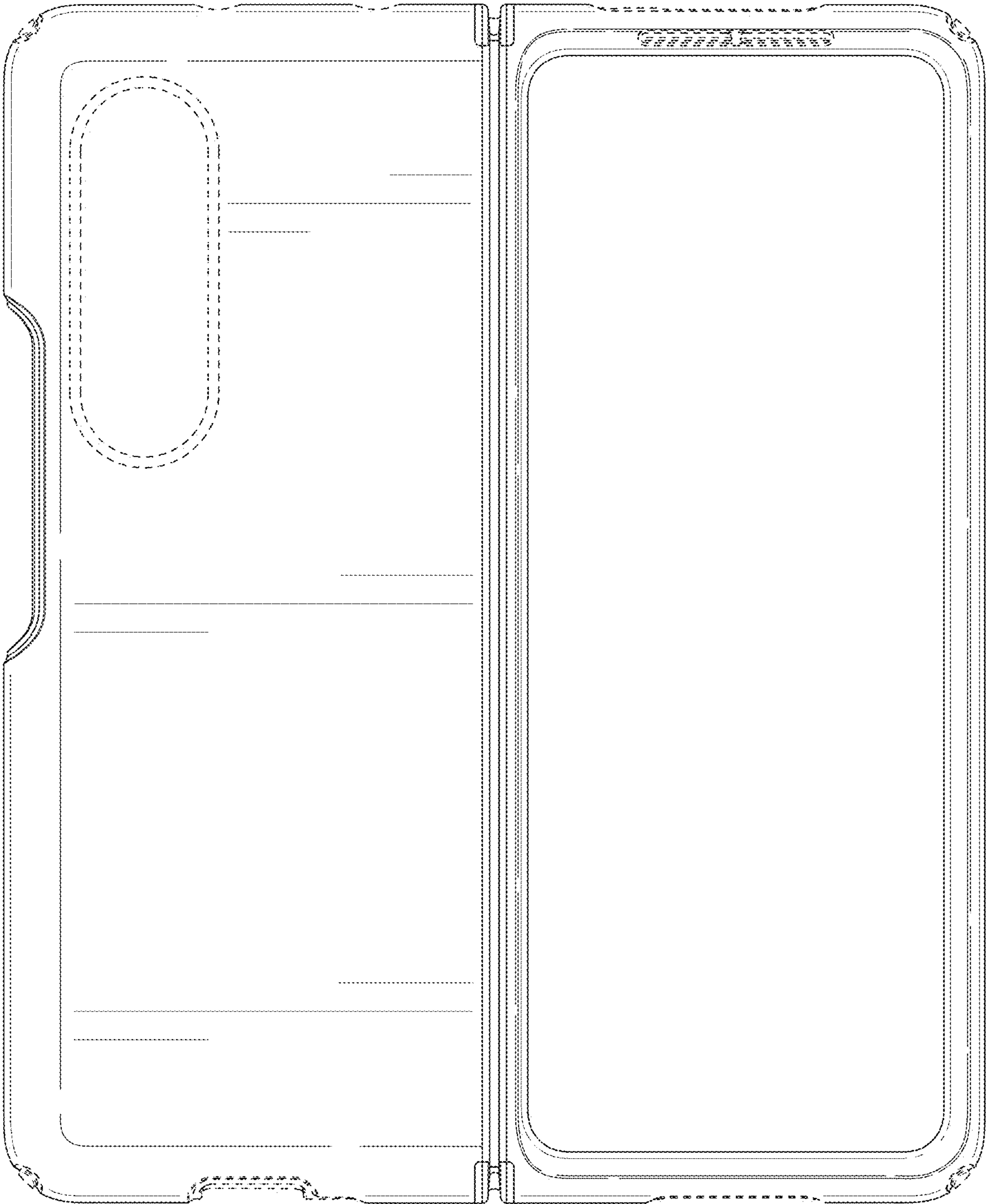

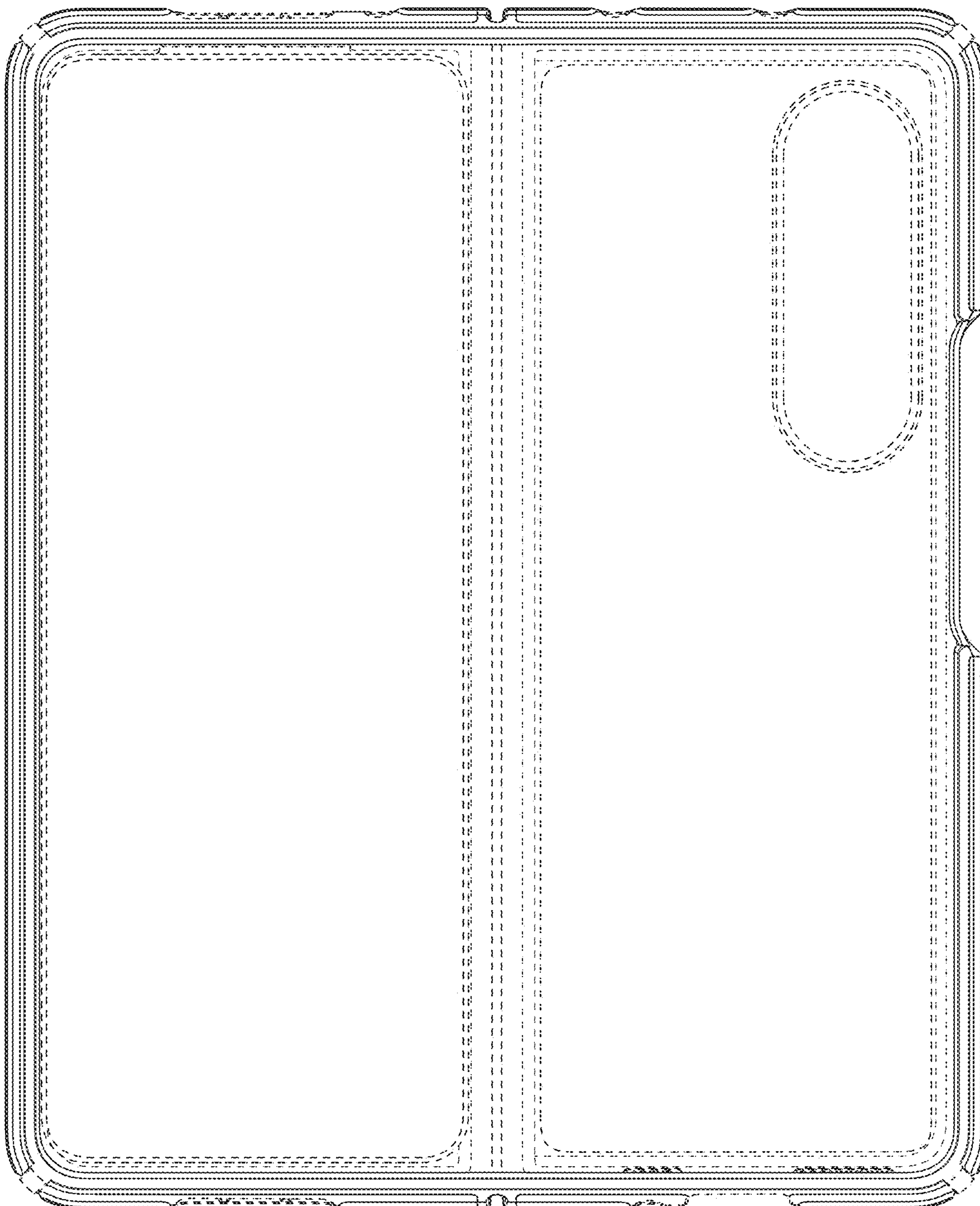

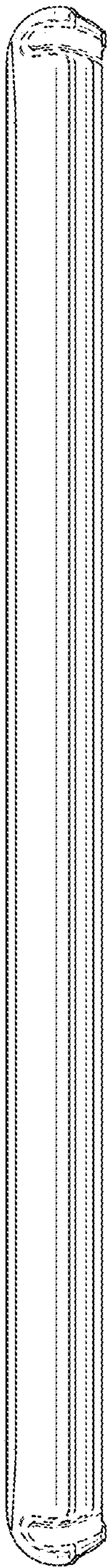

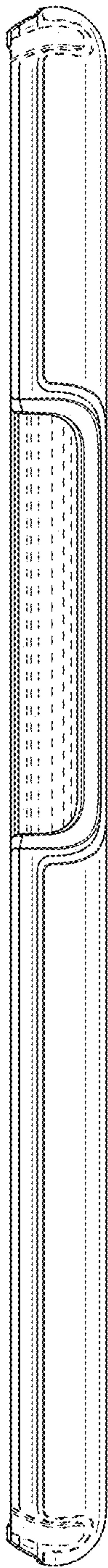

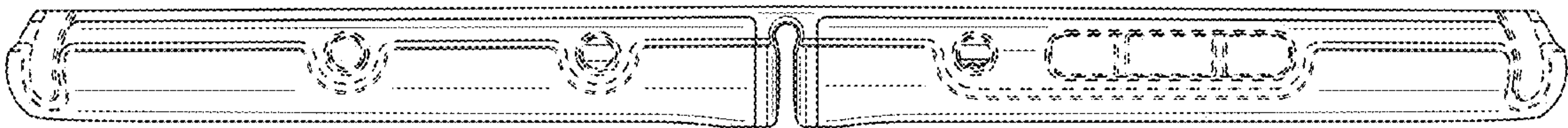

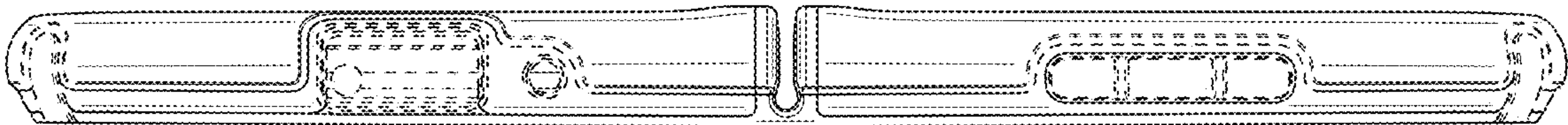
