(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen with changeable graphical user interface, as shown and described.

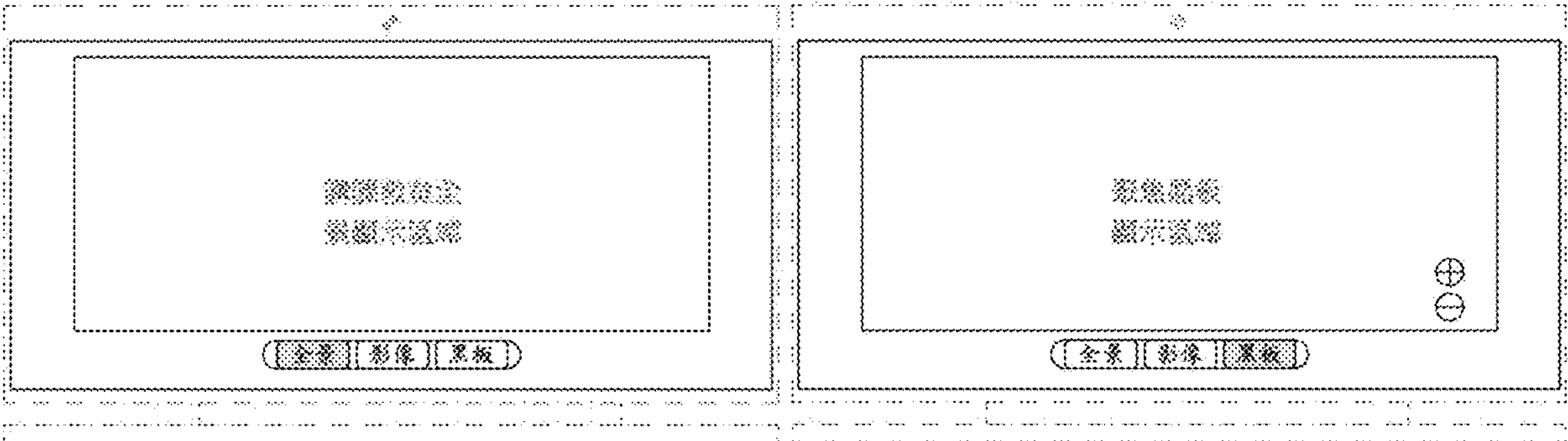
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a first image in a sequence for a display screen with changeable graphical user interface, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a second image thereof; and,
FIG. 3 is a third image thereof.

The appearance of the transitional image sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-3. The process or period in which one image transitions to another image forms no part of the claimed design.

The dot-dash broken lines in the figures illustrate an electronic device having a display screen, and form no part of the claimed design. Similarly, the remaining broken lines represent features of the graphical user interface that form no part of the claimed design.

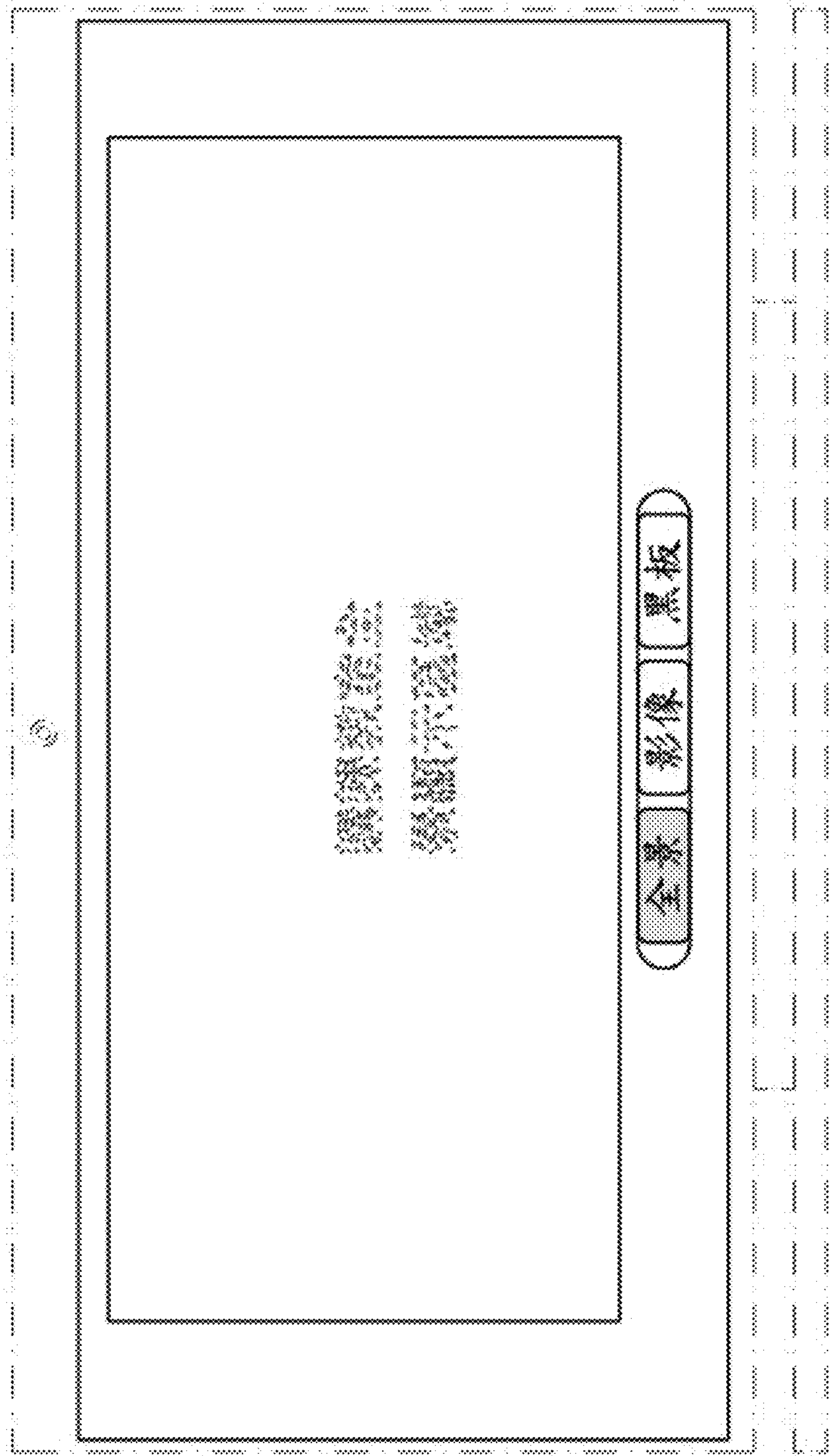

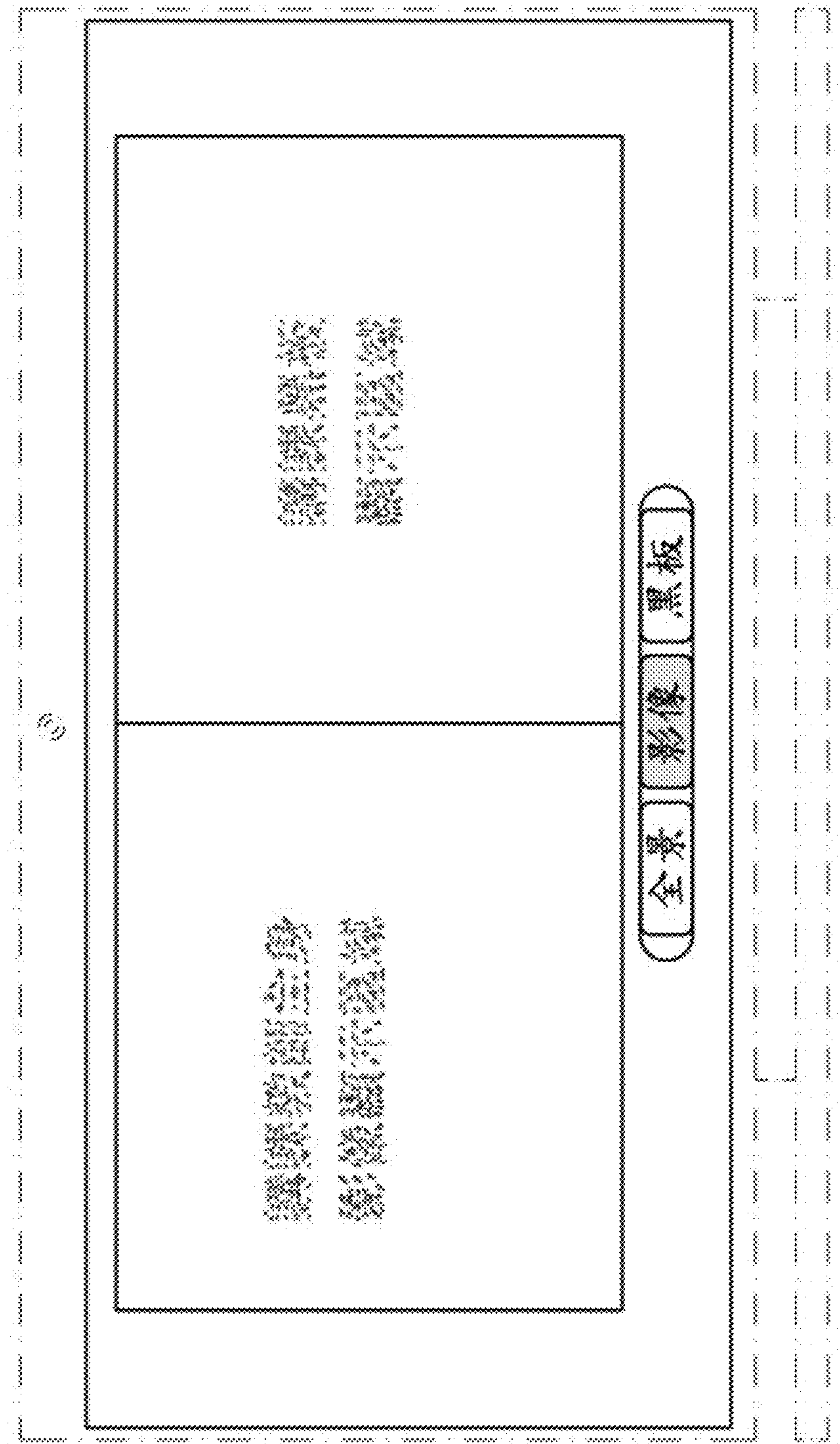

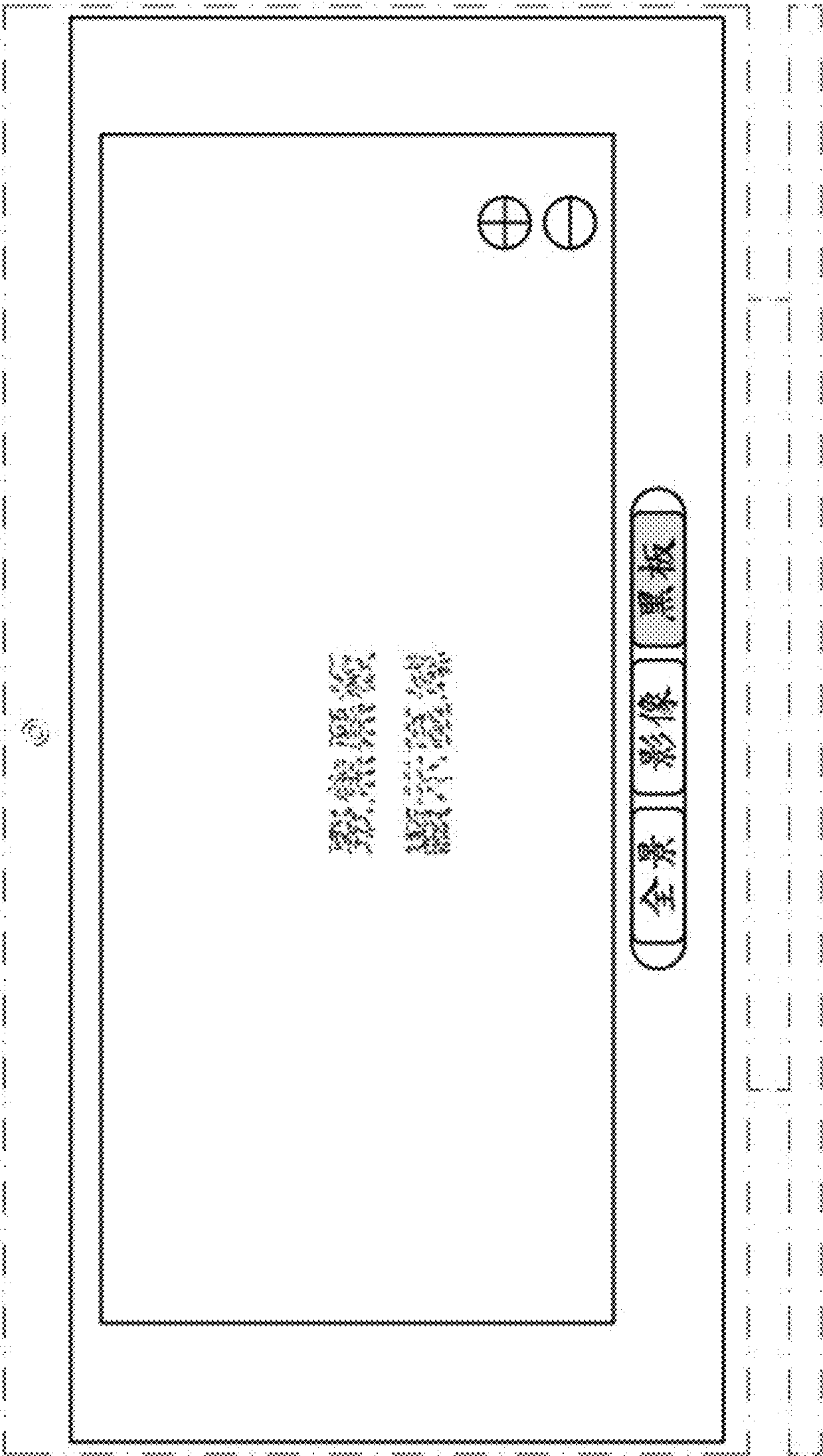
