FIG. 3 is a first side view thereof, the opposing side being a mirror image;

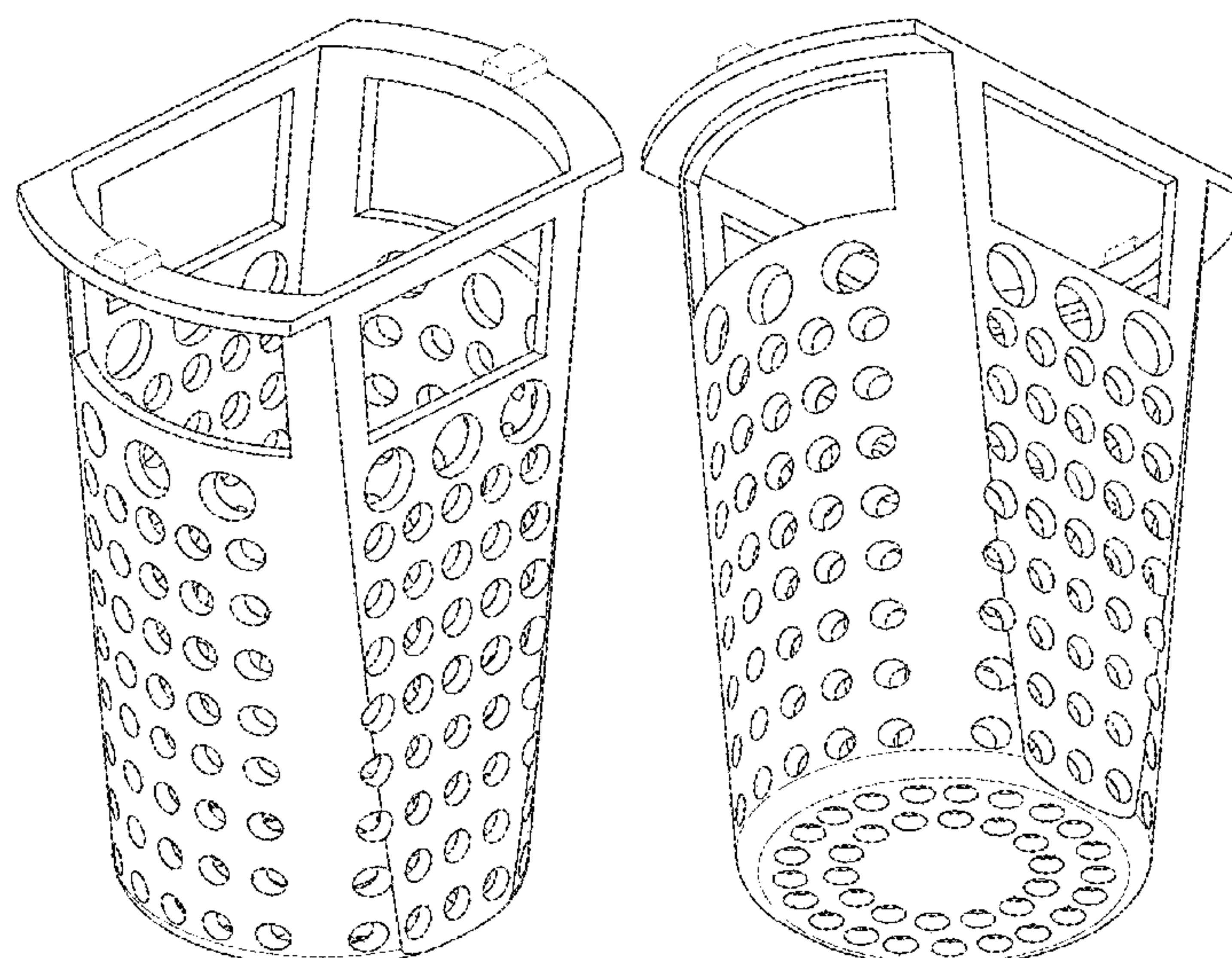
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

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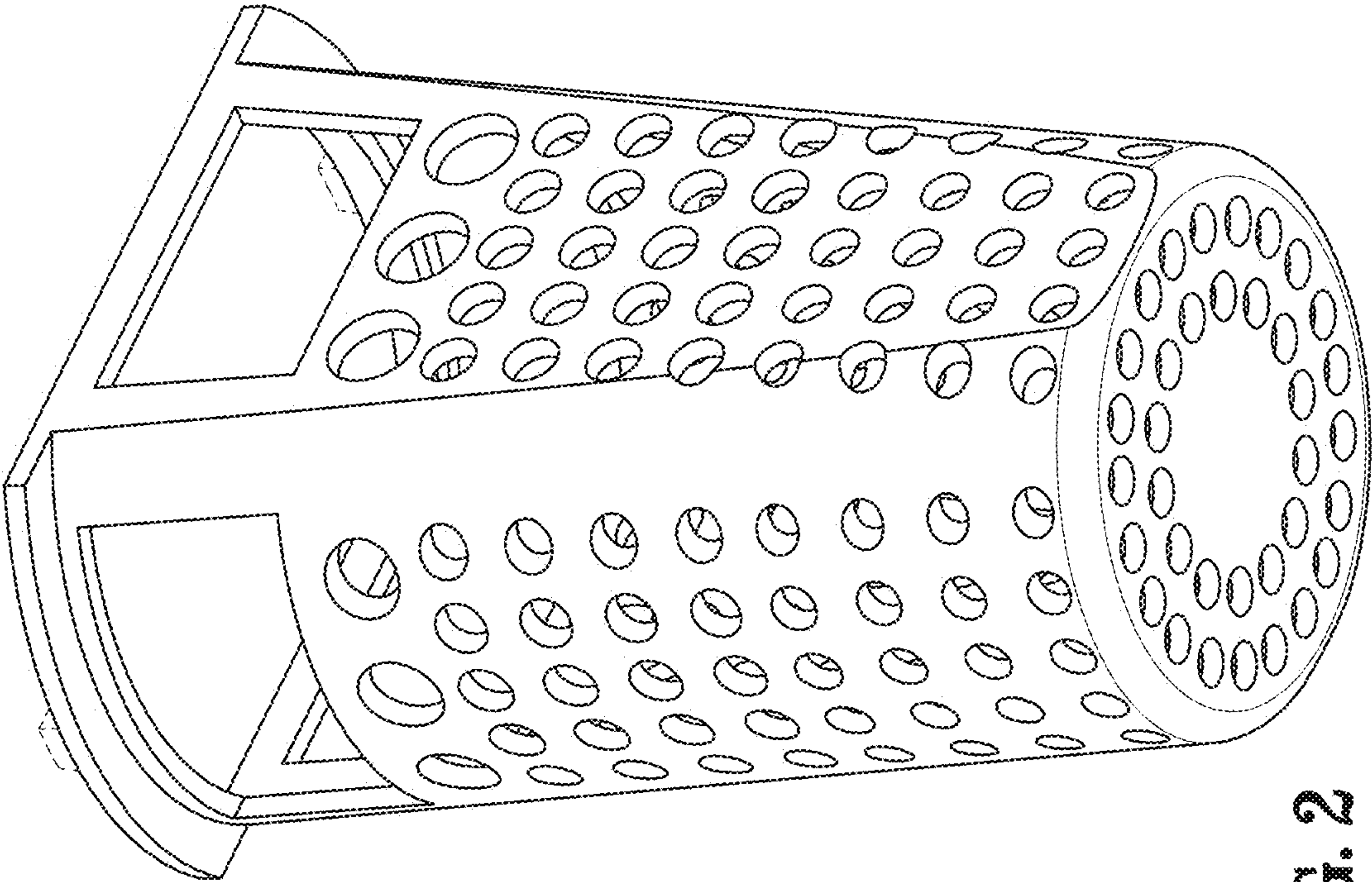

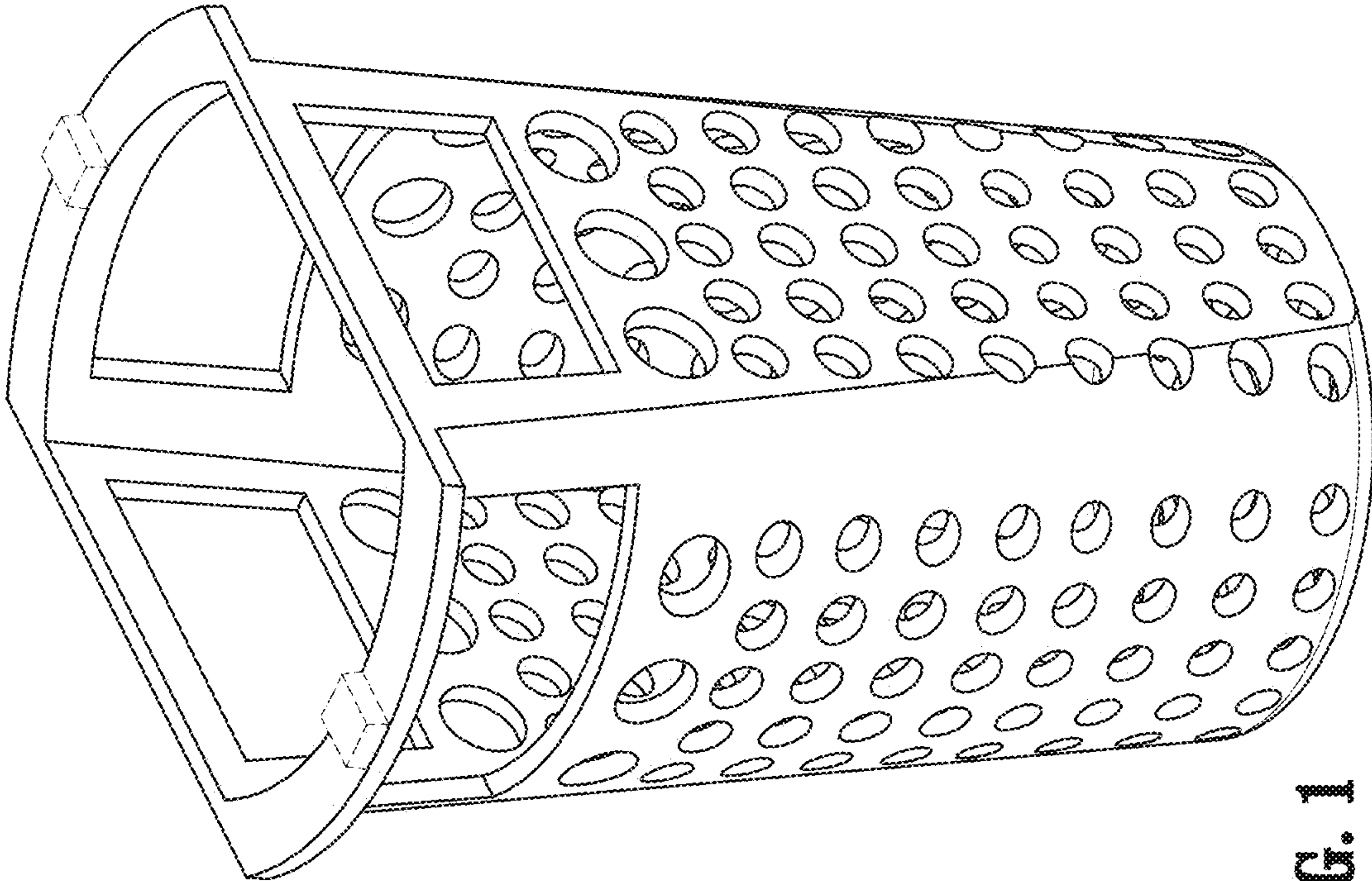

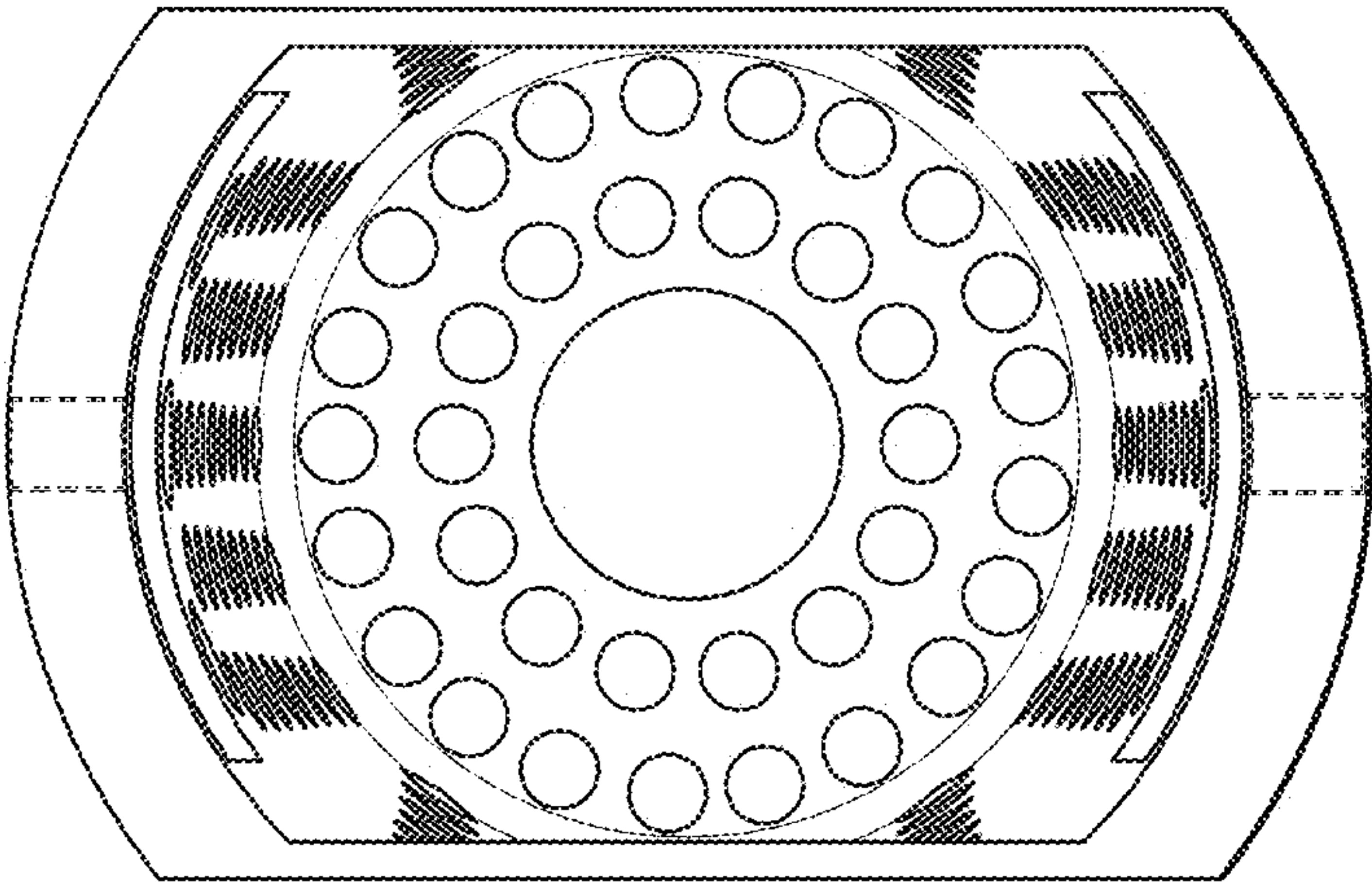

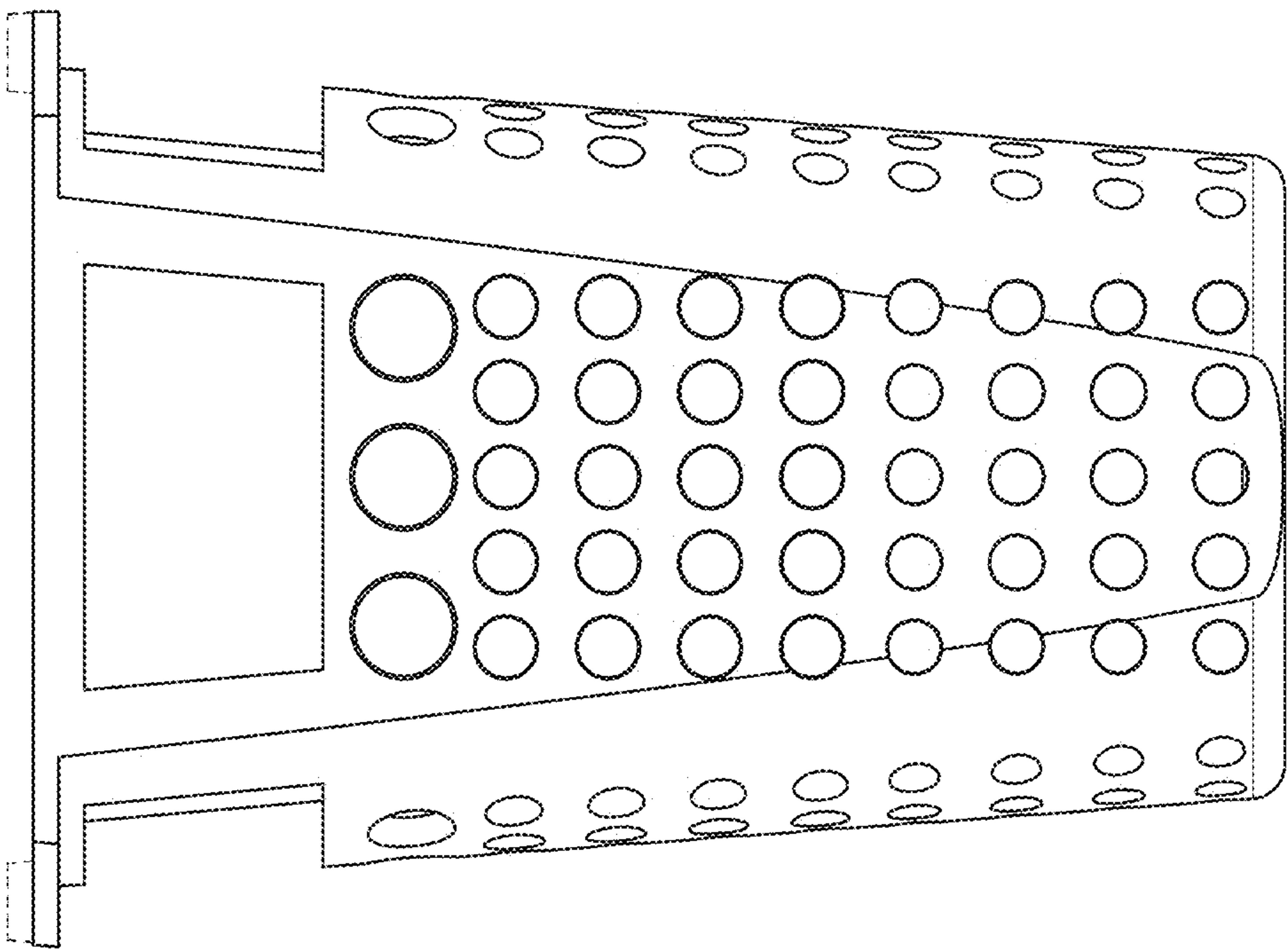

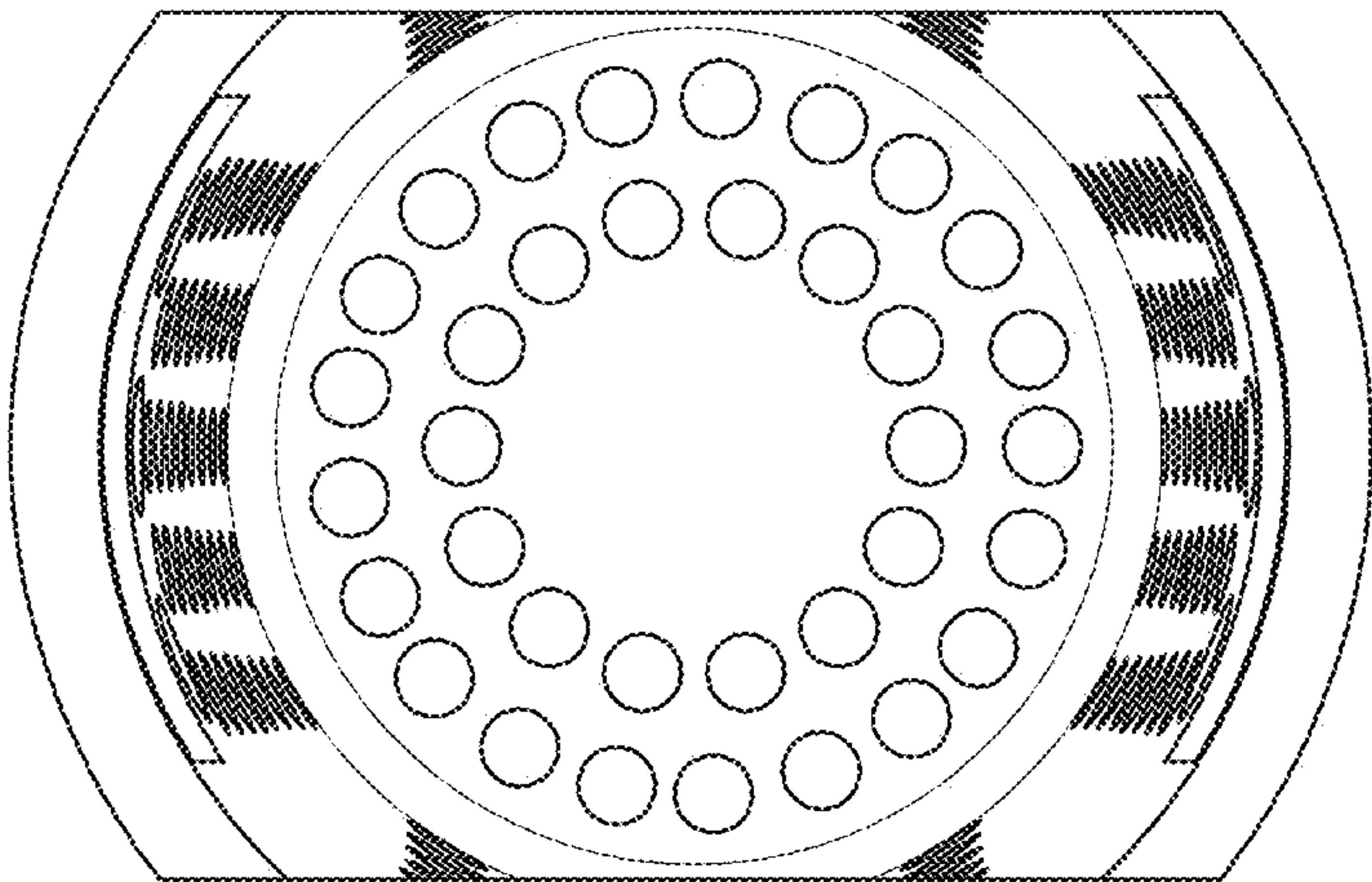

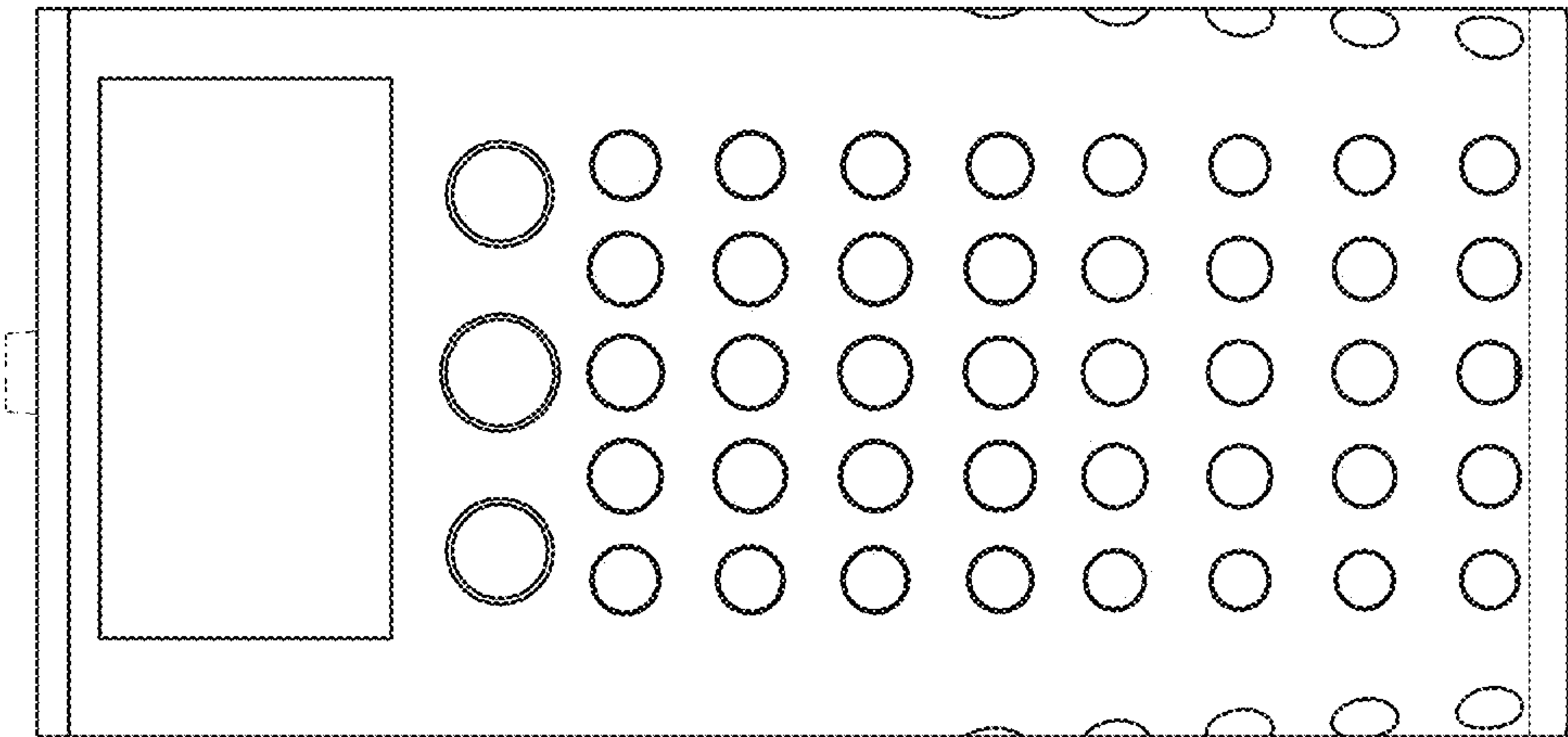
