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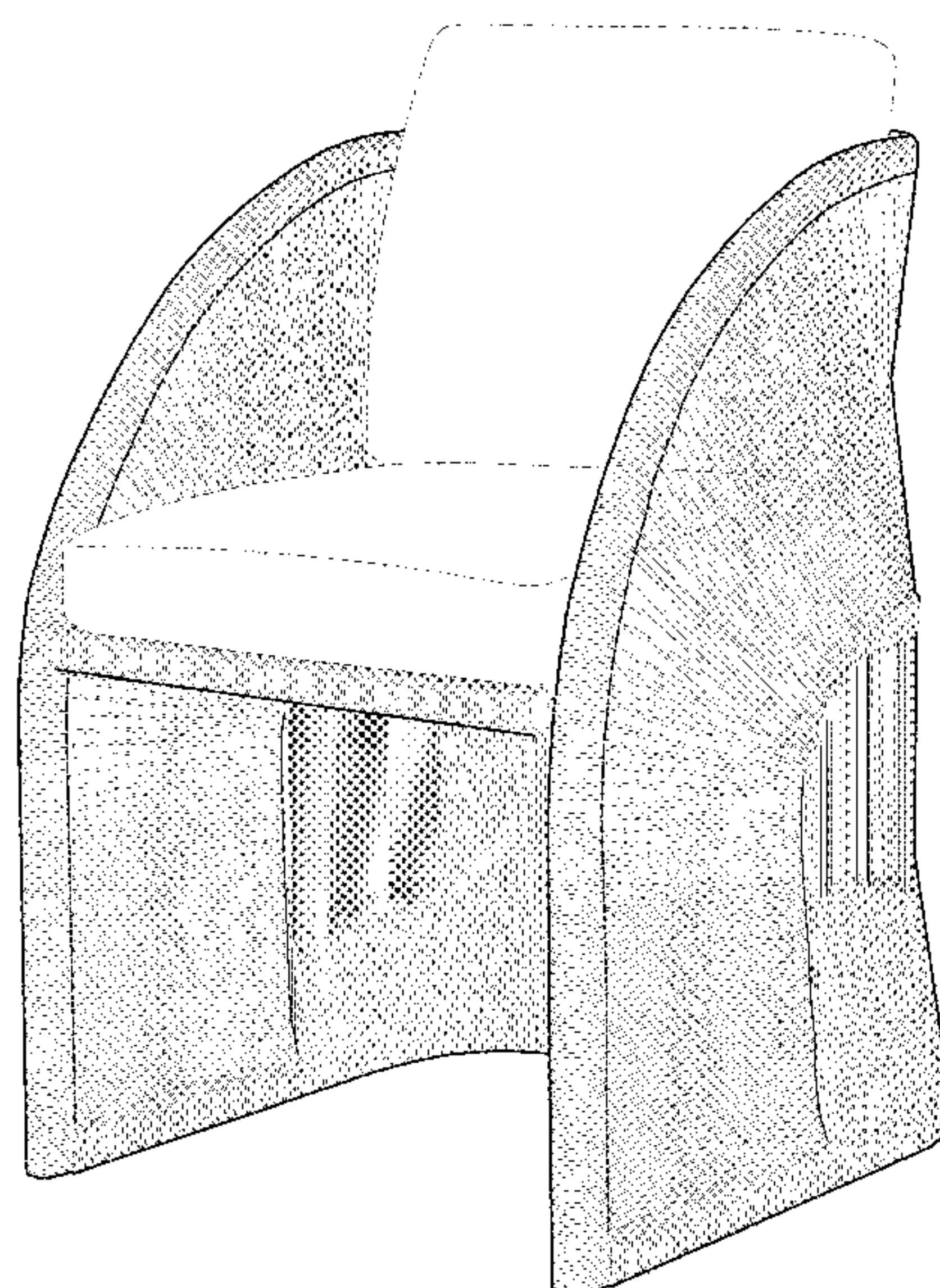
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a first embodiment of a seat showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a front right perspective view of a second embodiment of a seat showing my new design;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 9 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 10 is a rear elevation view thereof.
The broken lines represent environmental subject matter and portions of the seat that form no part of the claimed design. The second embodiment is shown with a symbolic break line and those portions of the article between the break line form no part of the claimed design.

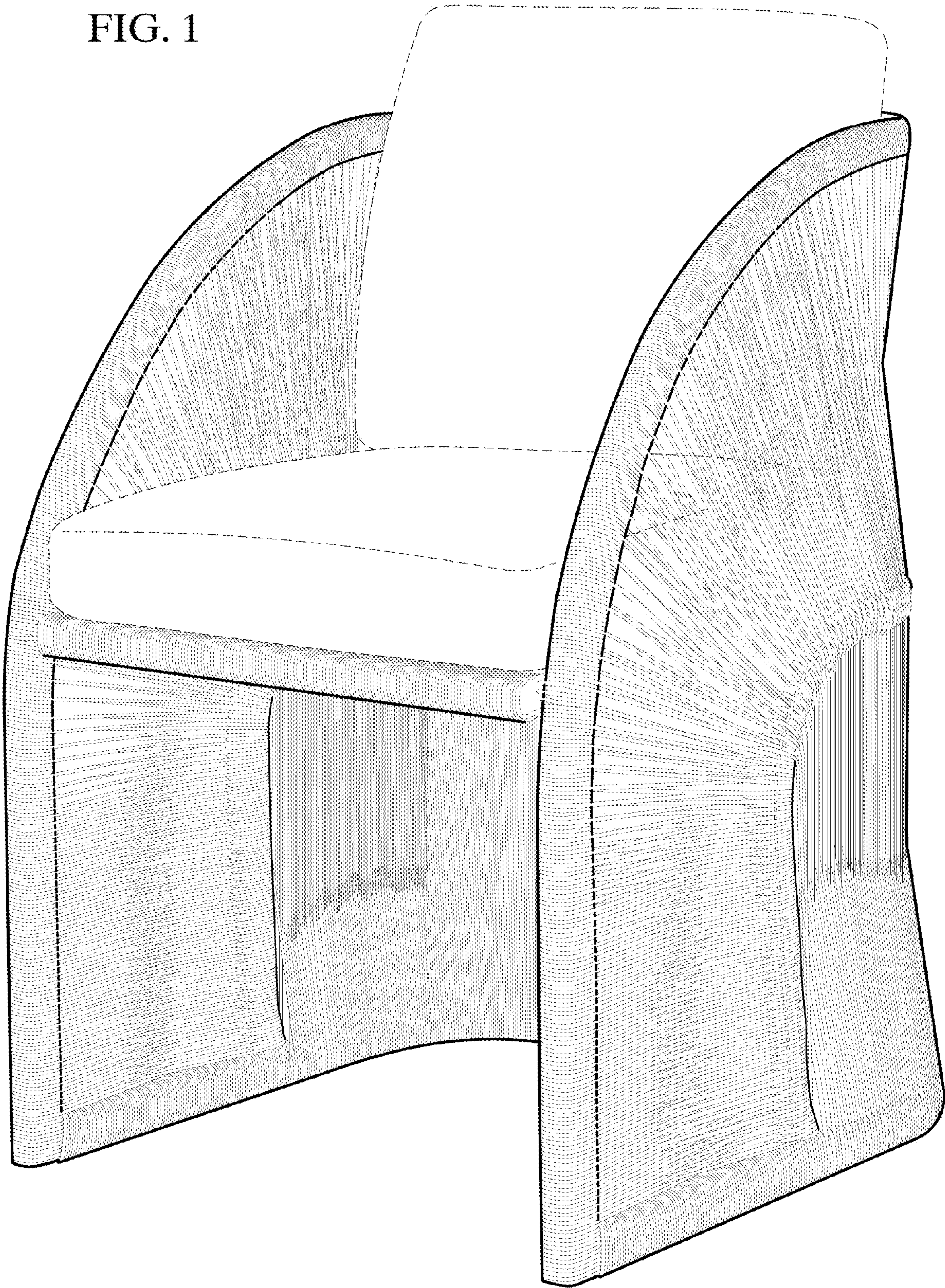

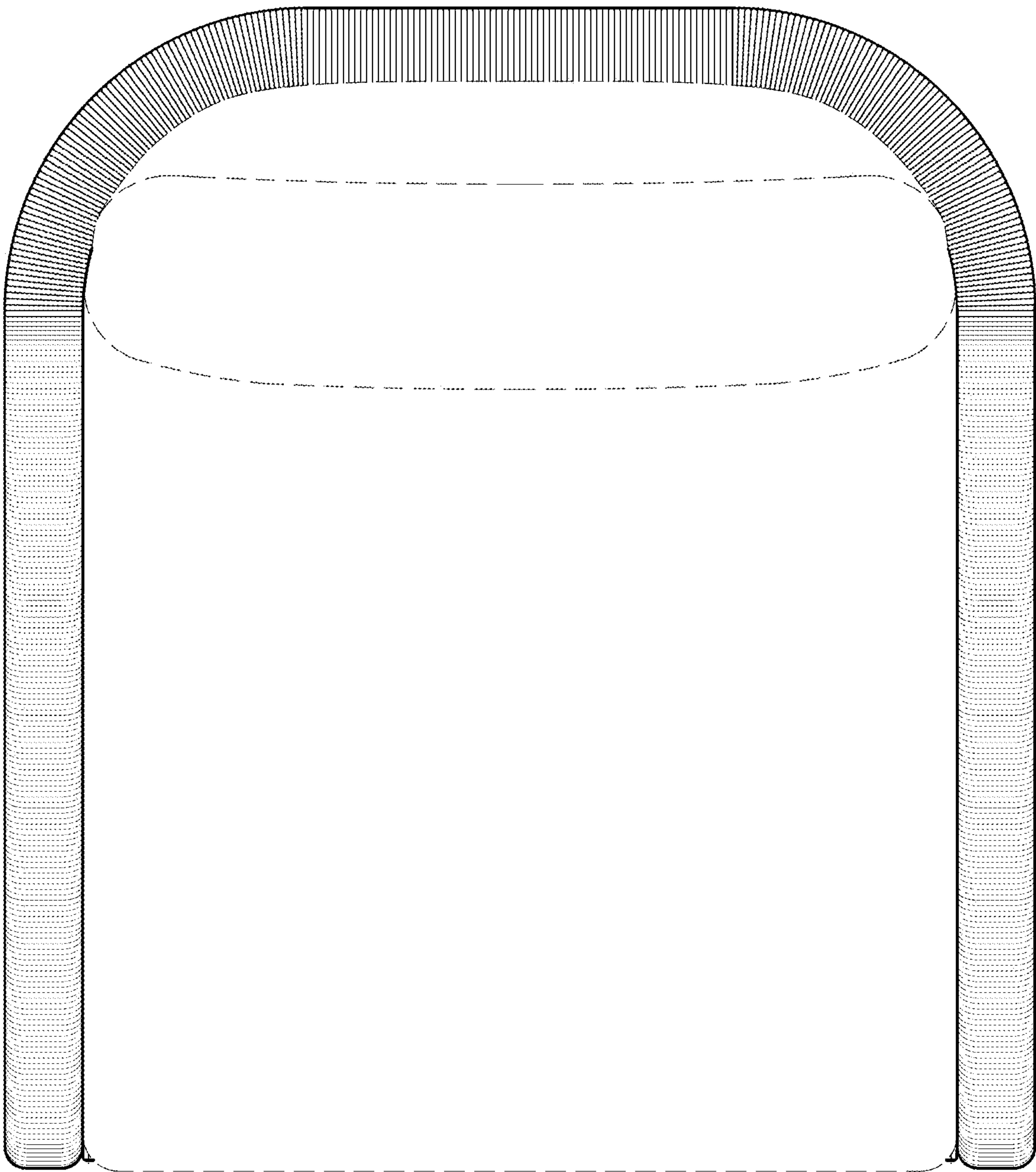

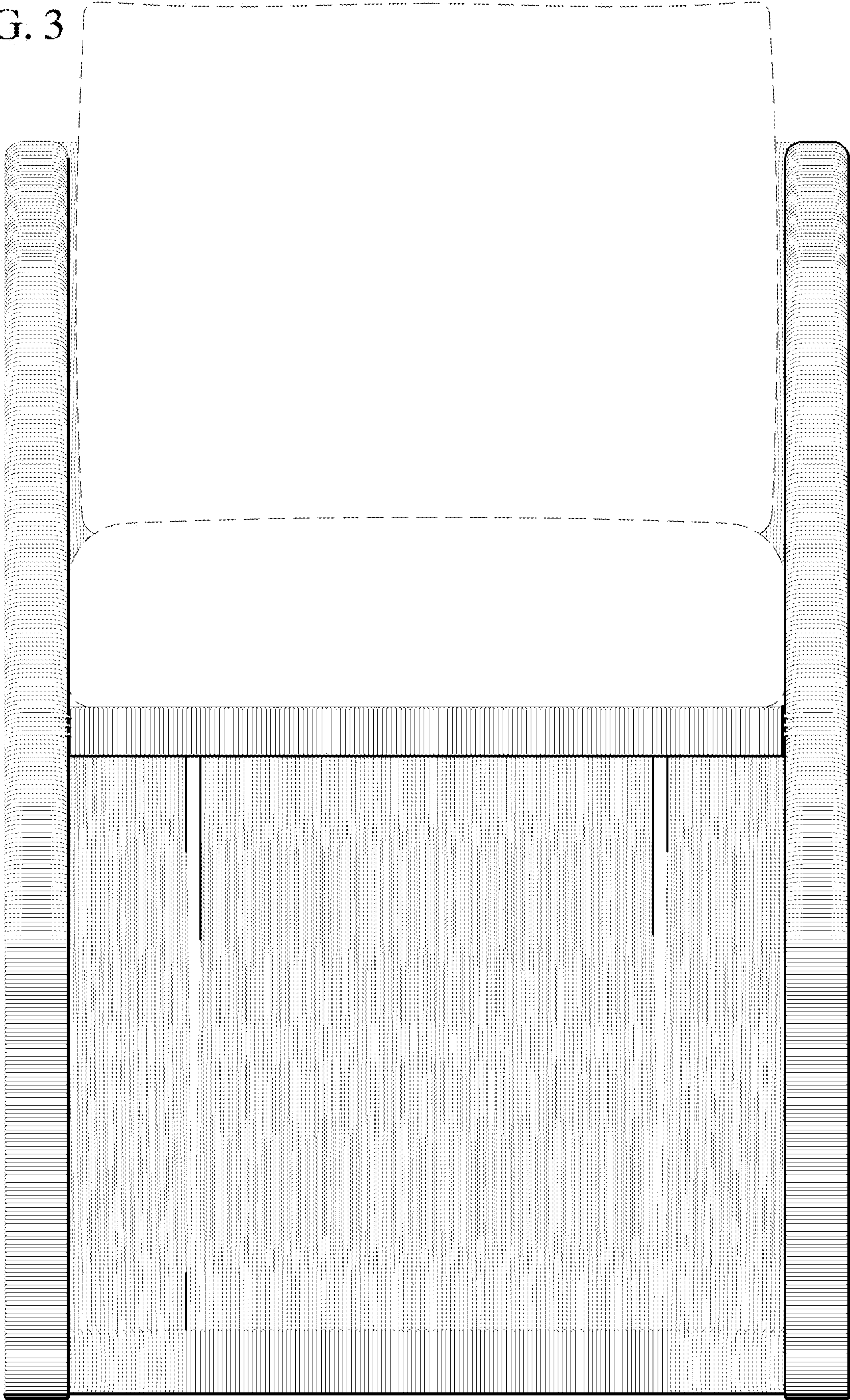

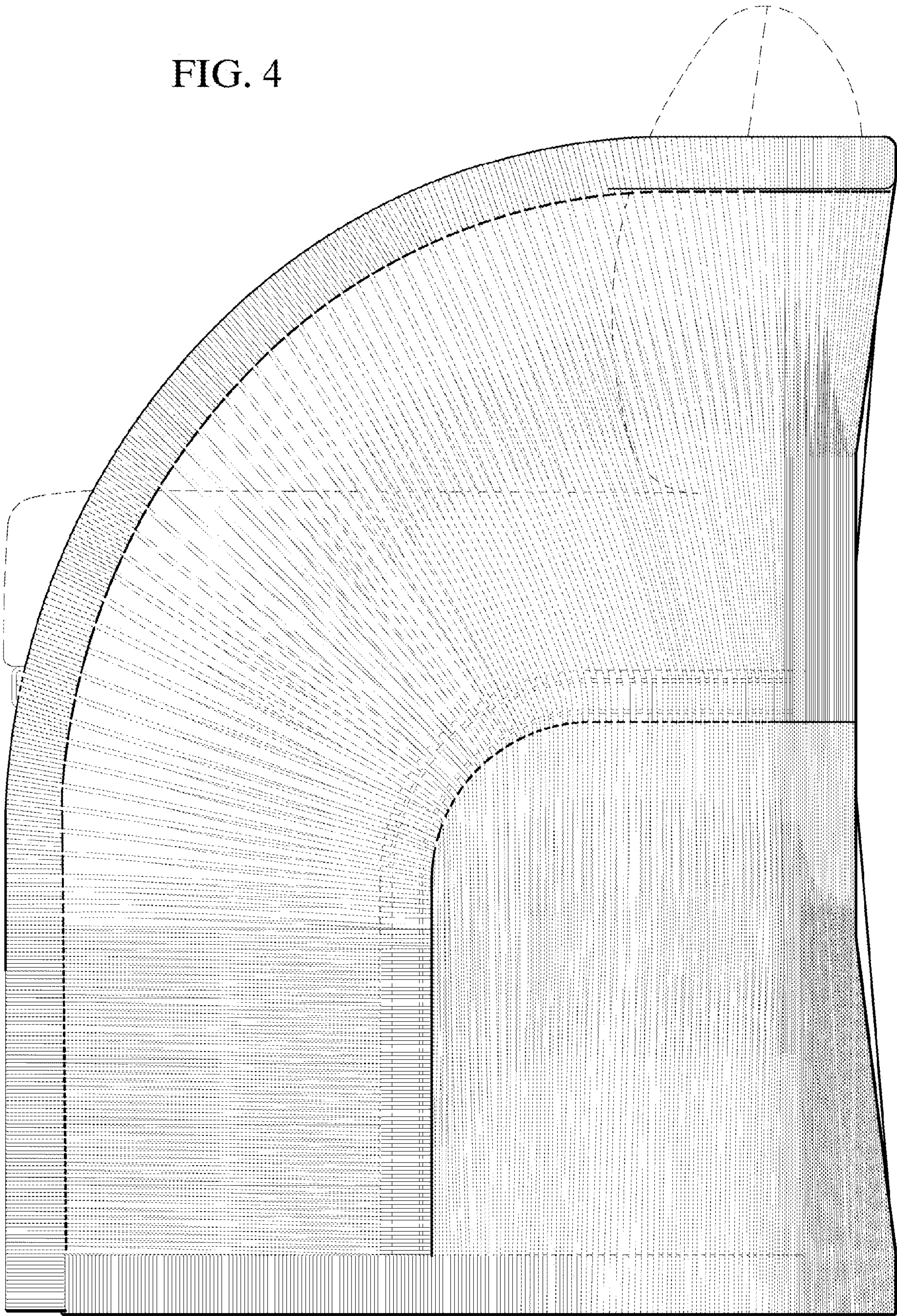

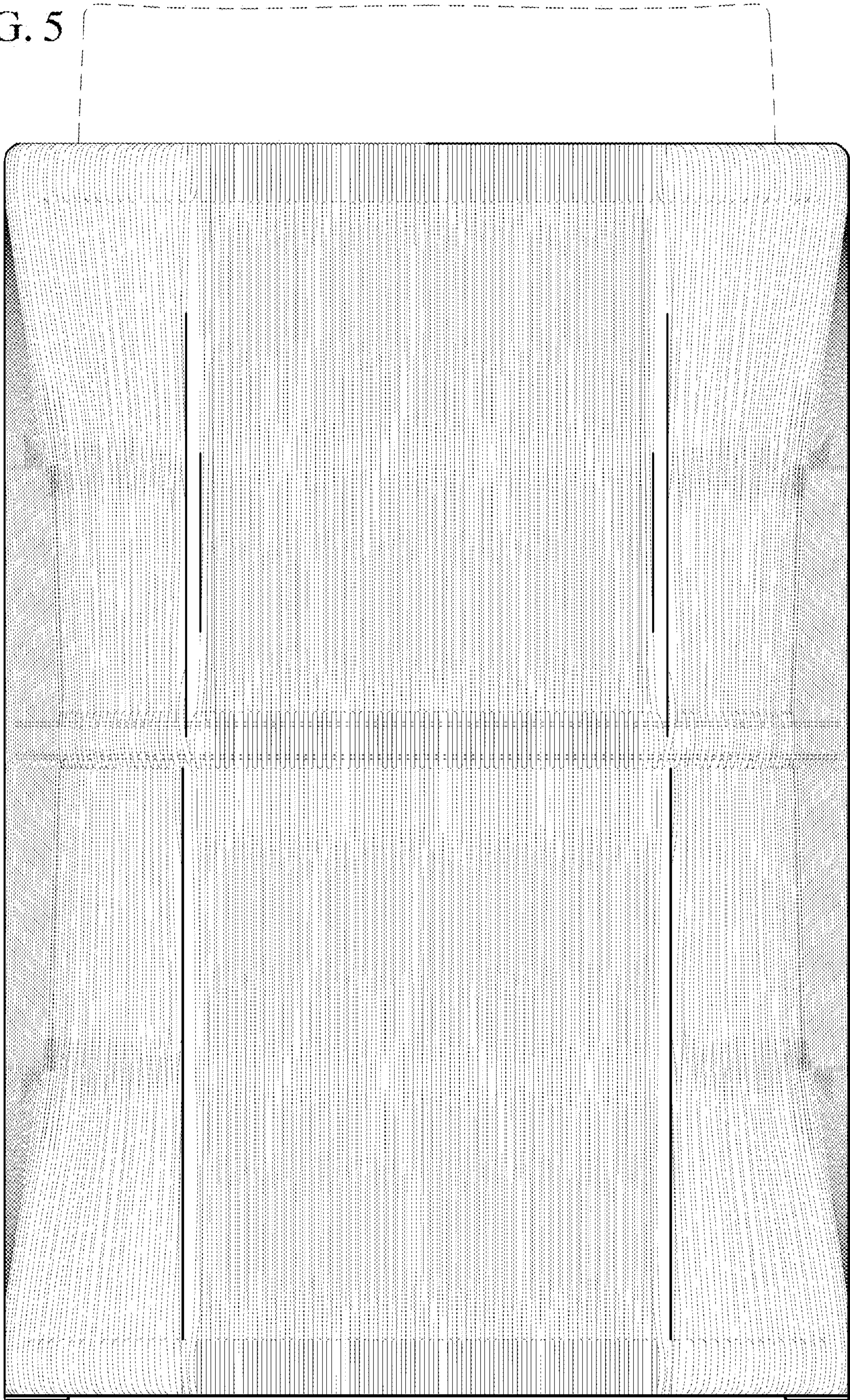

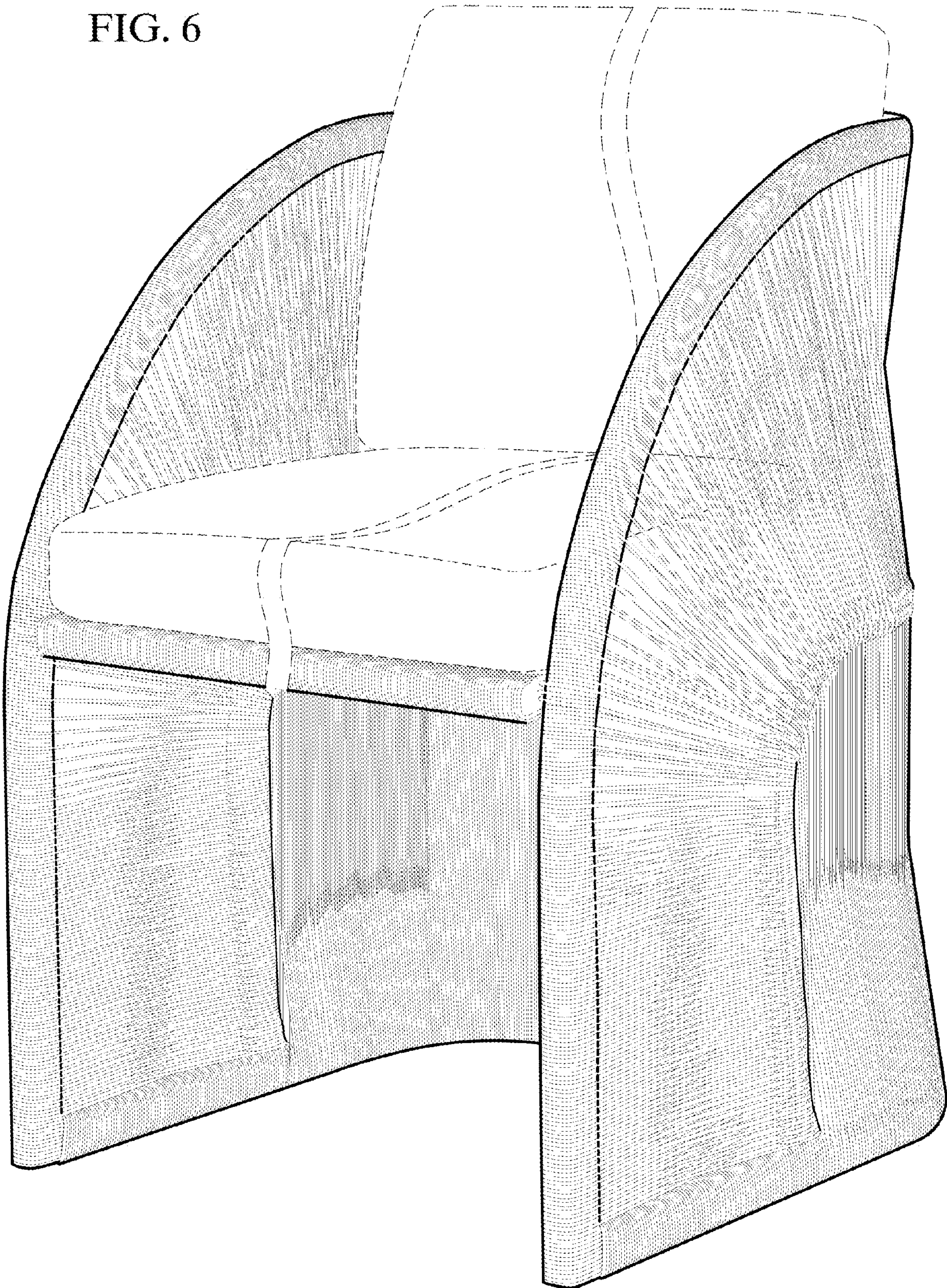

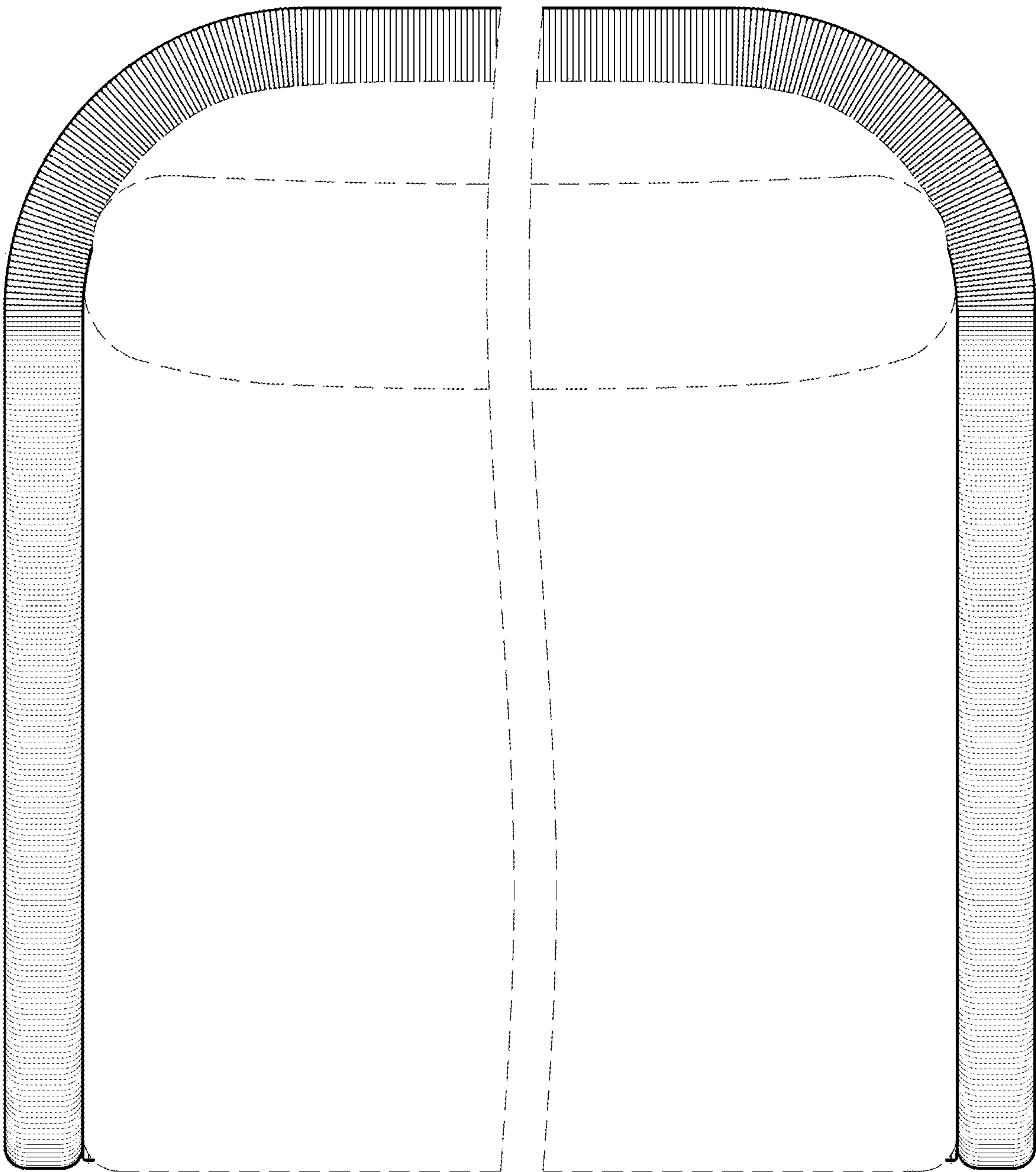

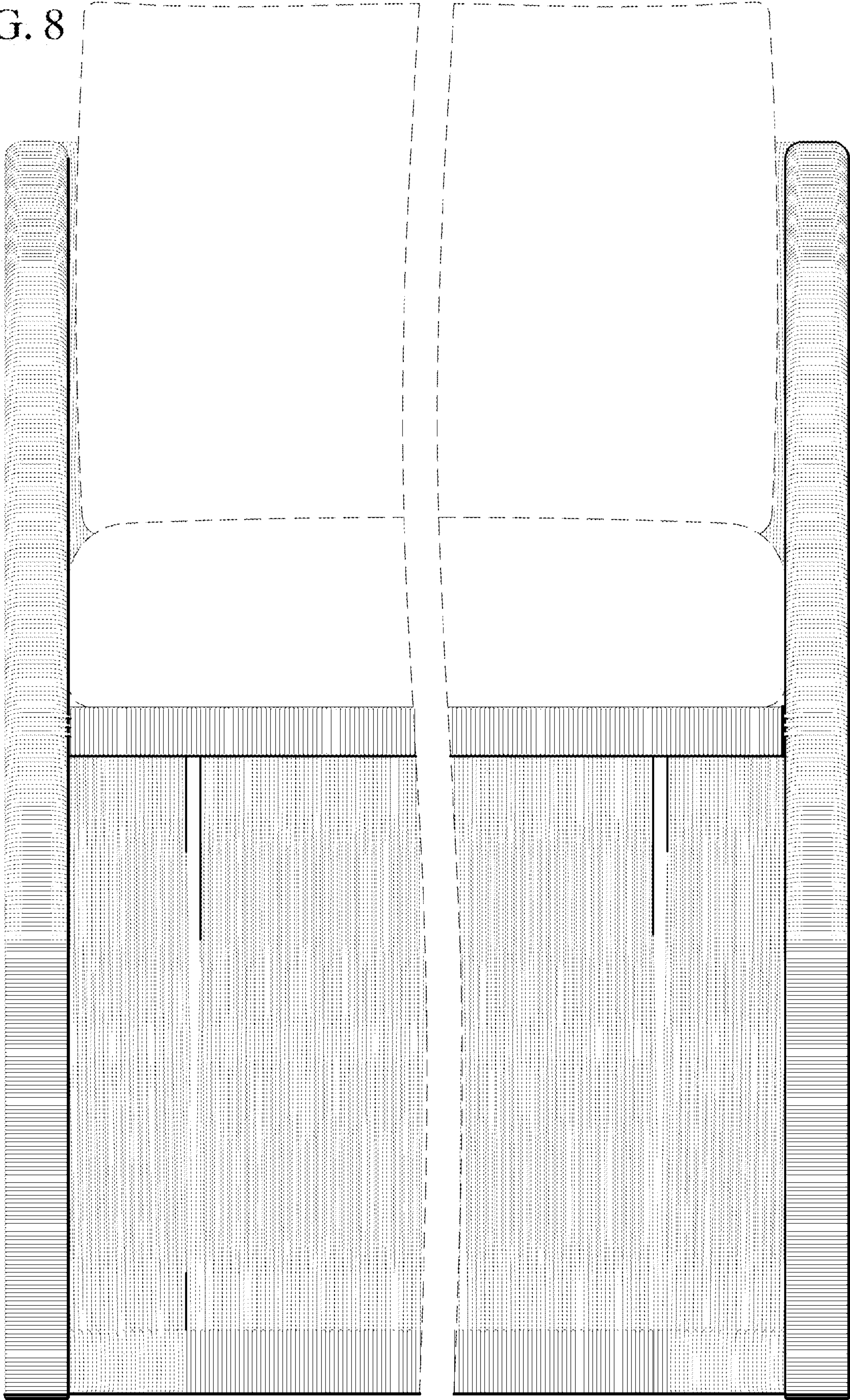

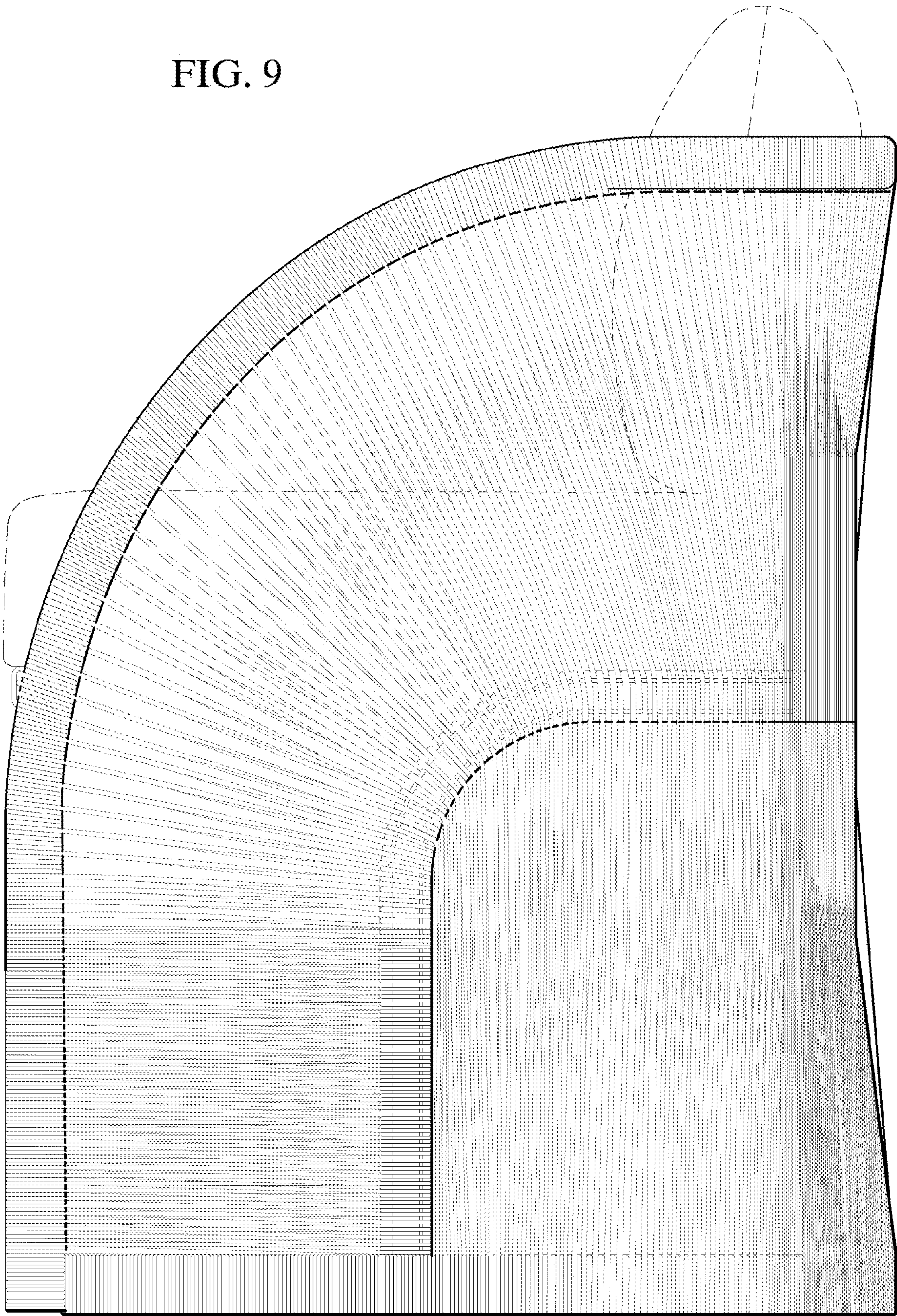
