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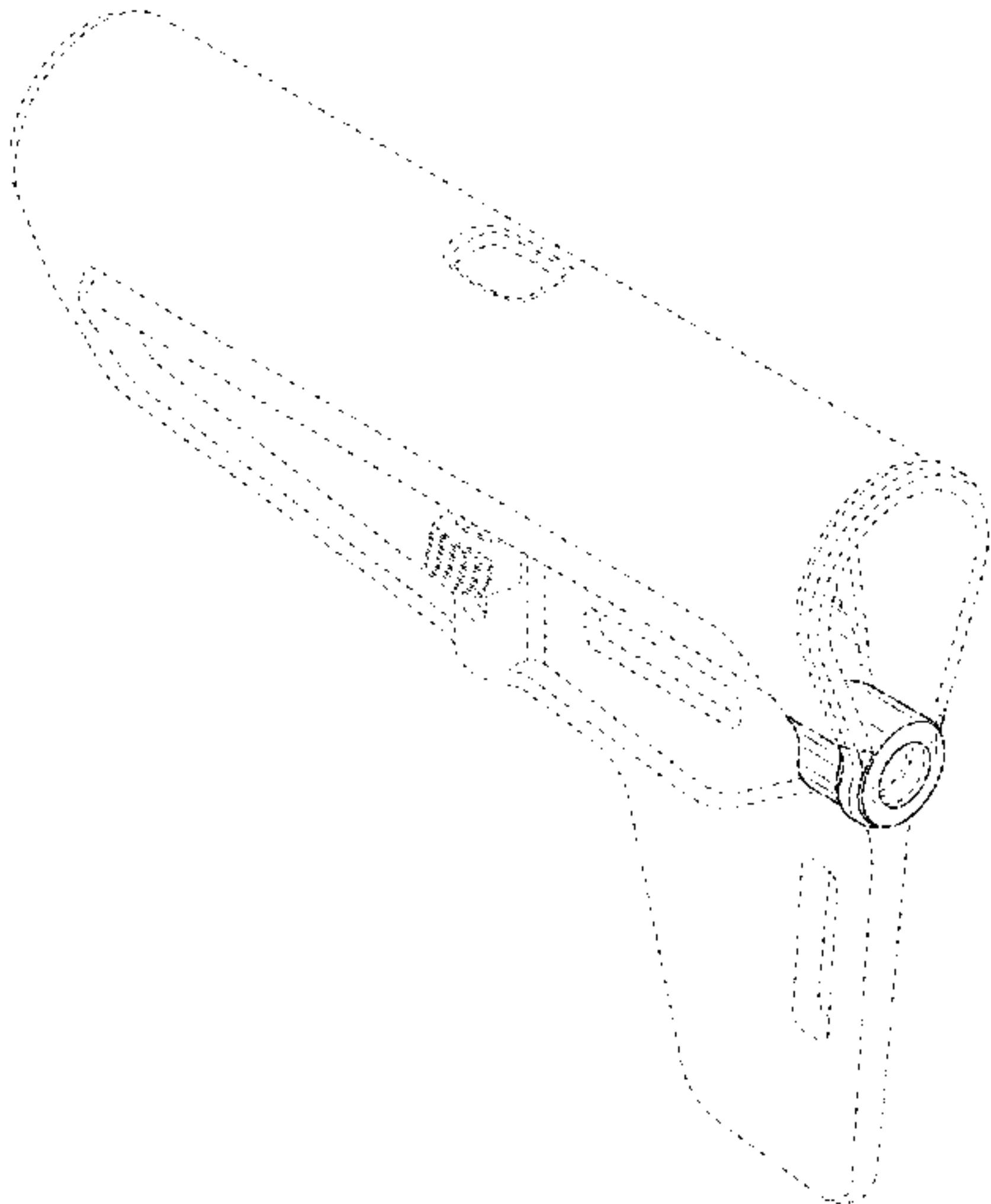
(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a firearm accessory mount, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left, rear, top perspective view of the firearm accessory mount;  
FIG. 2 is a left elevation view of the firearm accessory mount;  
FIG. 3 is a right elevation view of the firearm accessory mount;  
FIG. 4 is a top view of the firearm accessory mount;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the firearm accessory mount;  
FIG. 6 is a front elevation view of the firearm accessory mount; and,  
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of the firearm accessory mount.  
The shade lines in the Figures show contour and not surface ornamentation.

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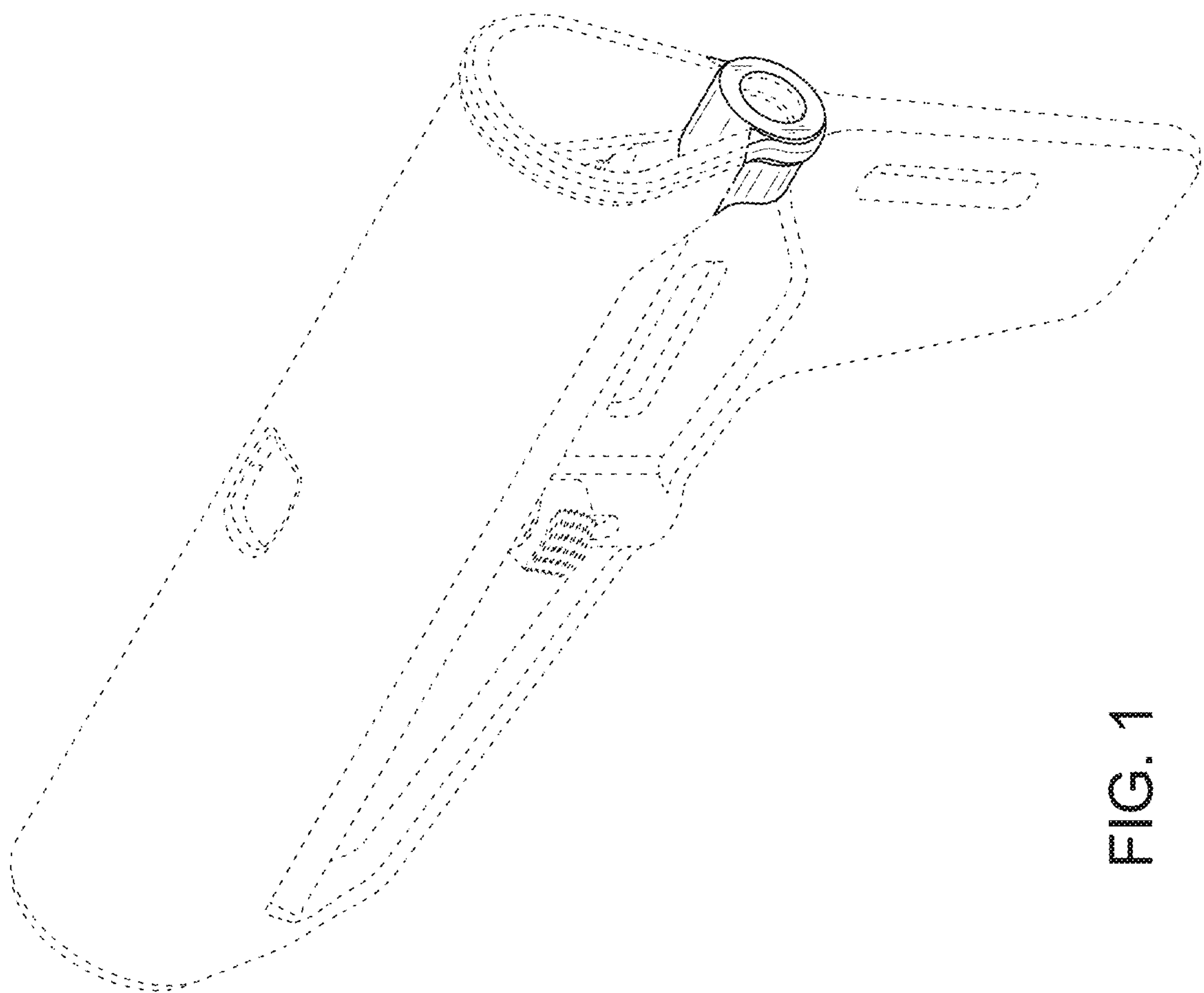

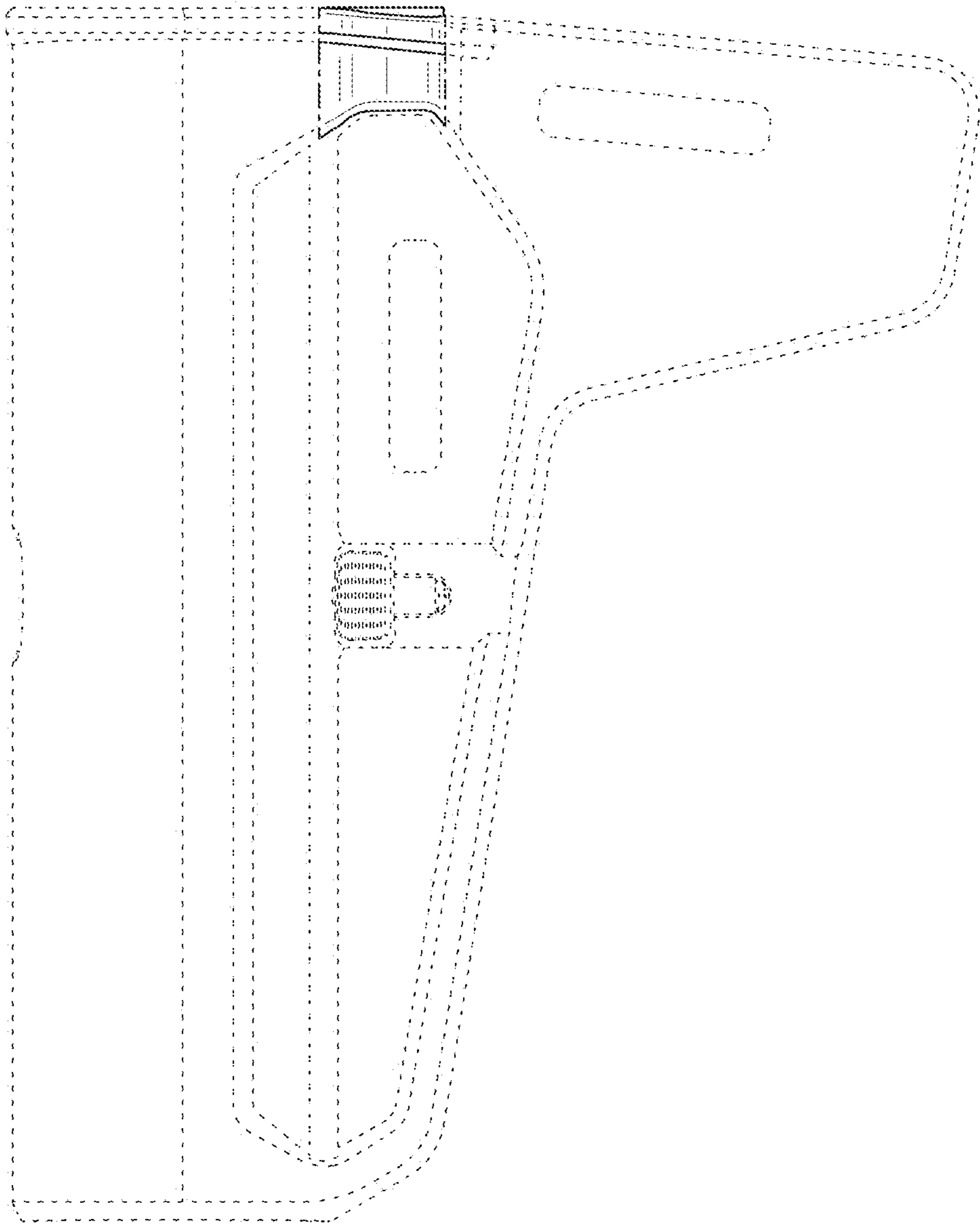

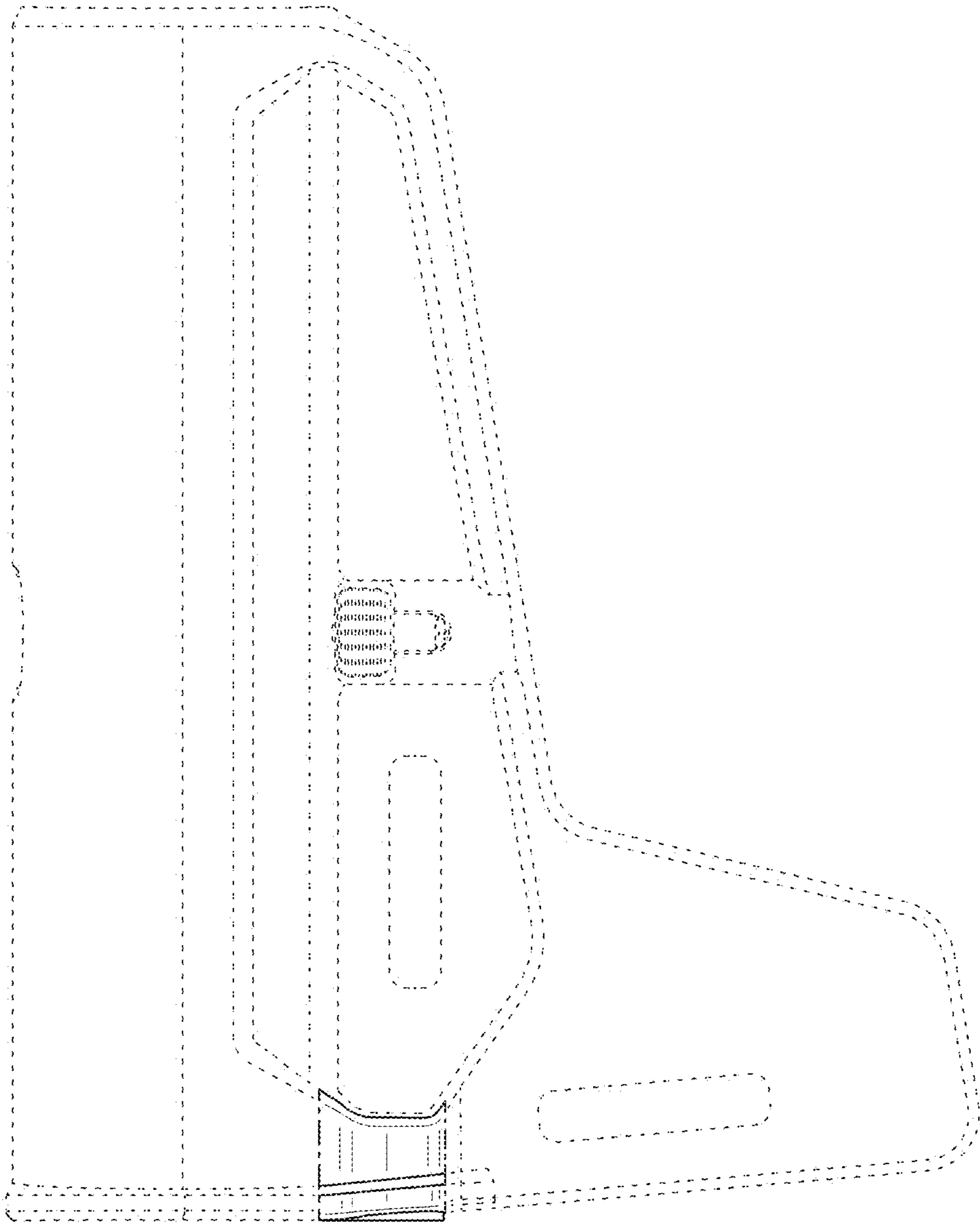

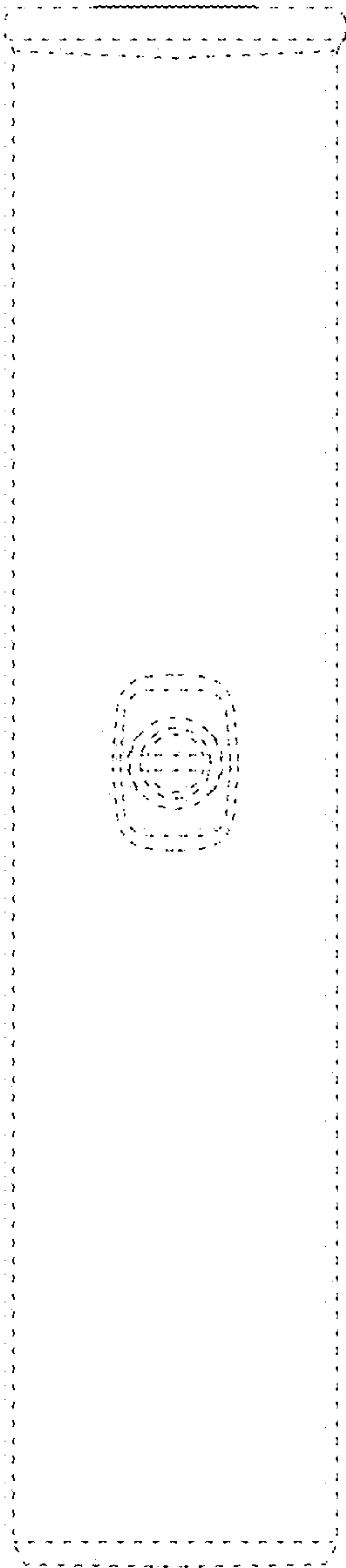

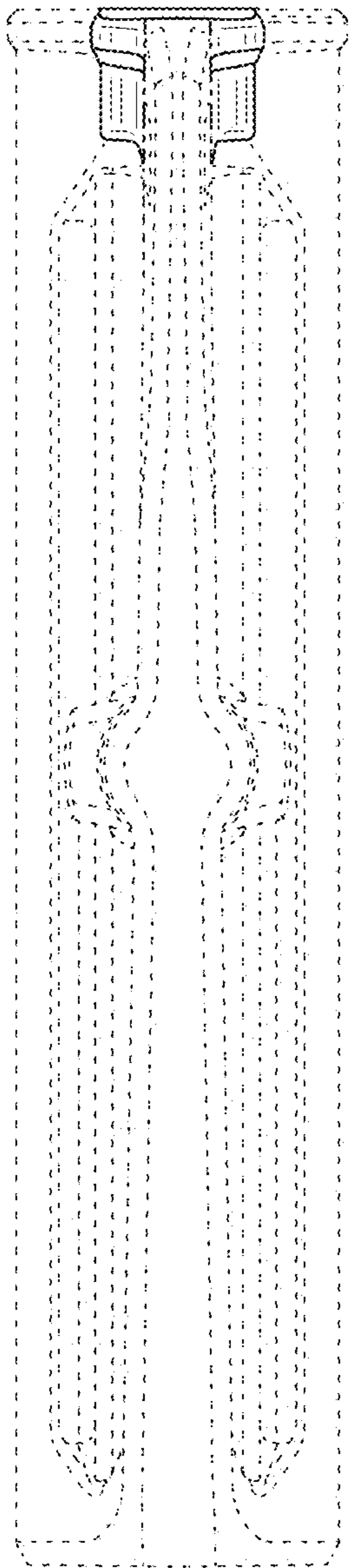

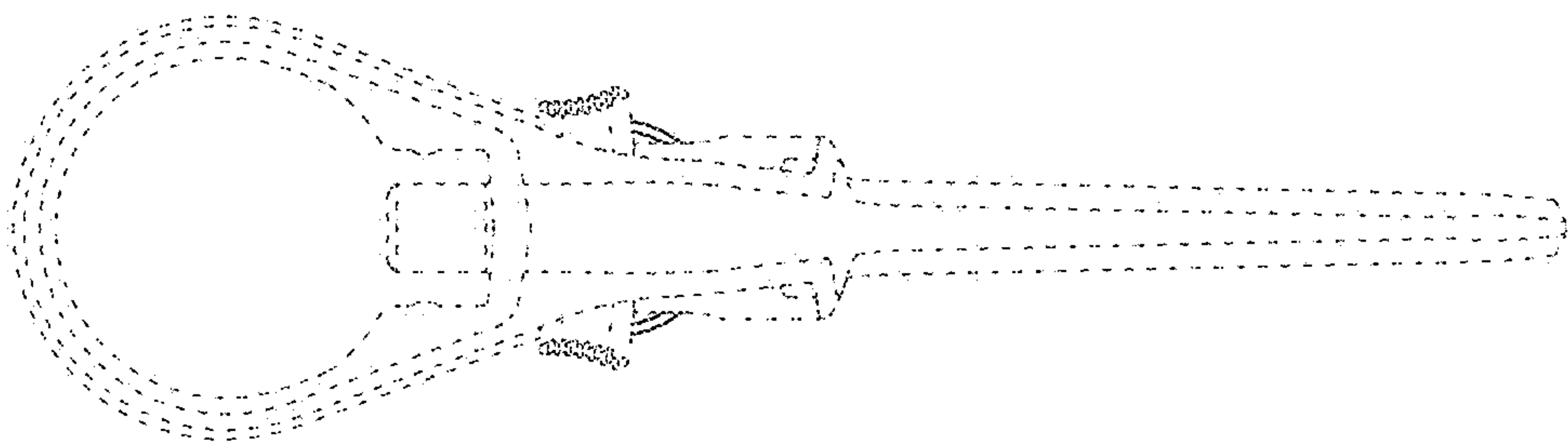

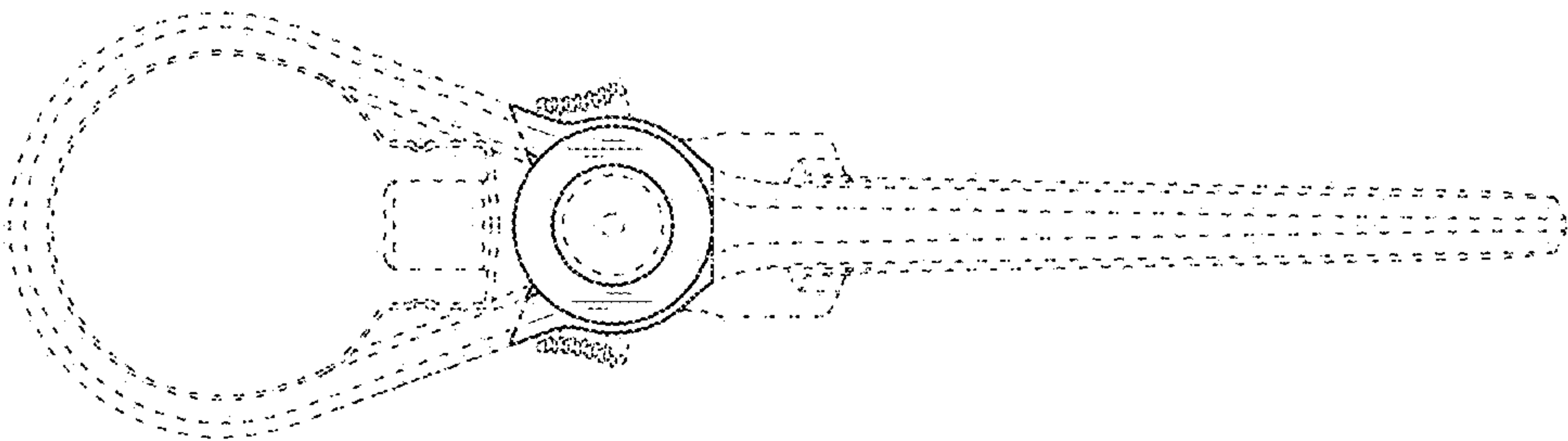
