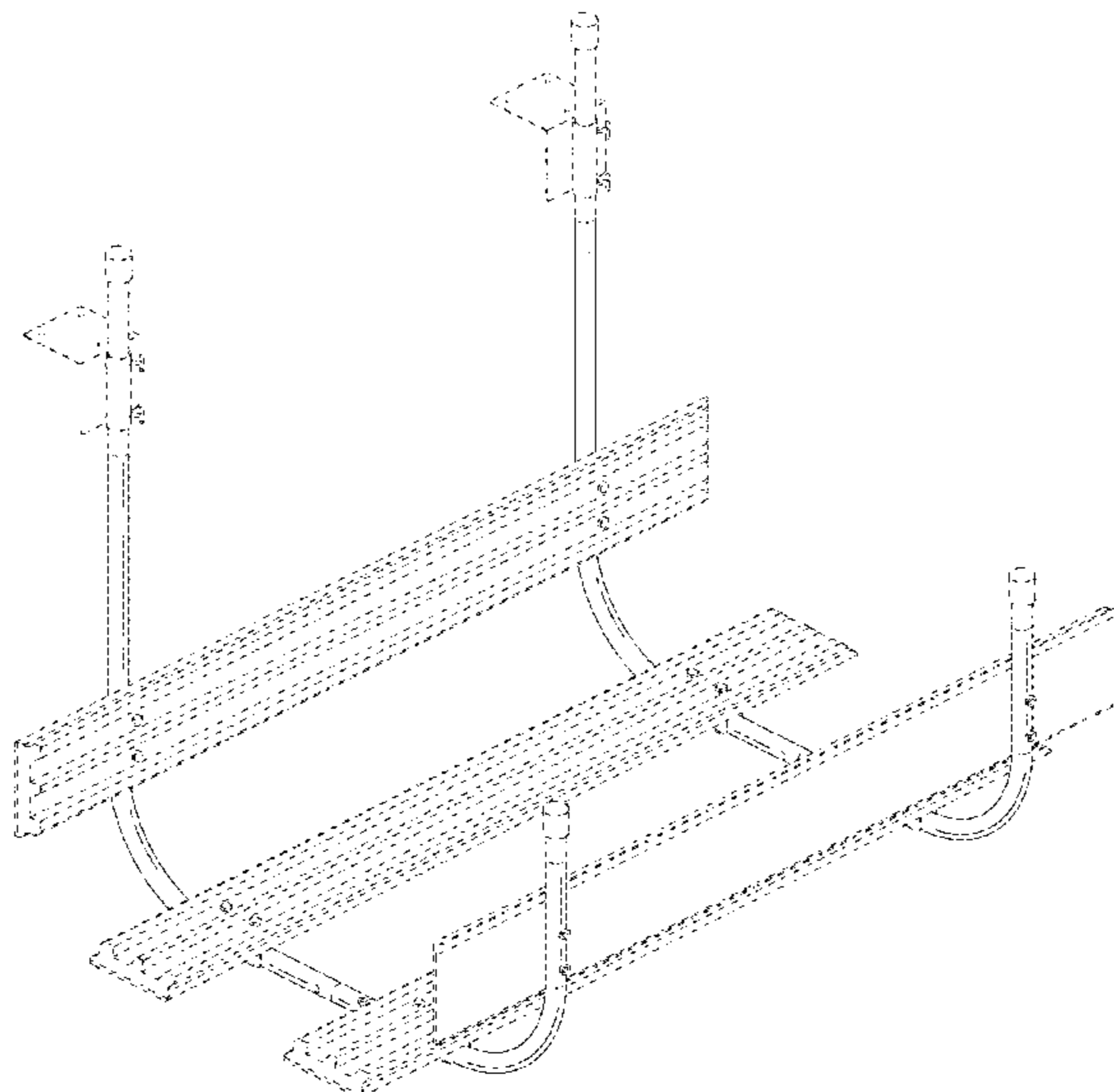
The ornamental design for a kayak dock, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a kayak dock according to our new and ornamental design; FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The evenly-spaced broken lines depict portions of the kayak dock that form no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot broken lines represent the boundary of the claimed design and form no part of the claimed design. In the drawings, there are two symbolic break lines along the two lengths of the article. The break lines and any portion between the break lines form no part of the claimed design.

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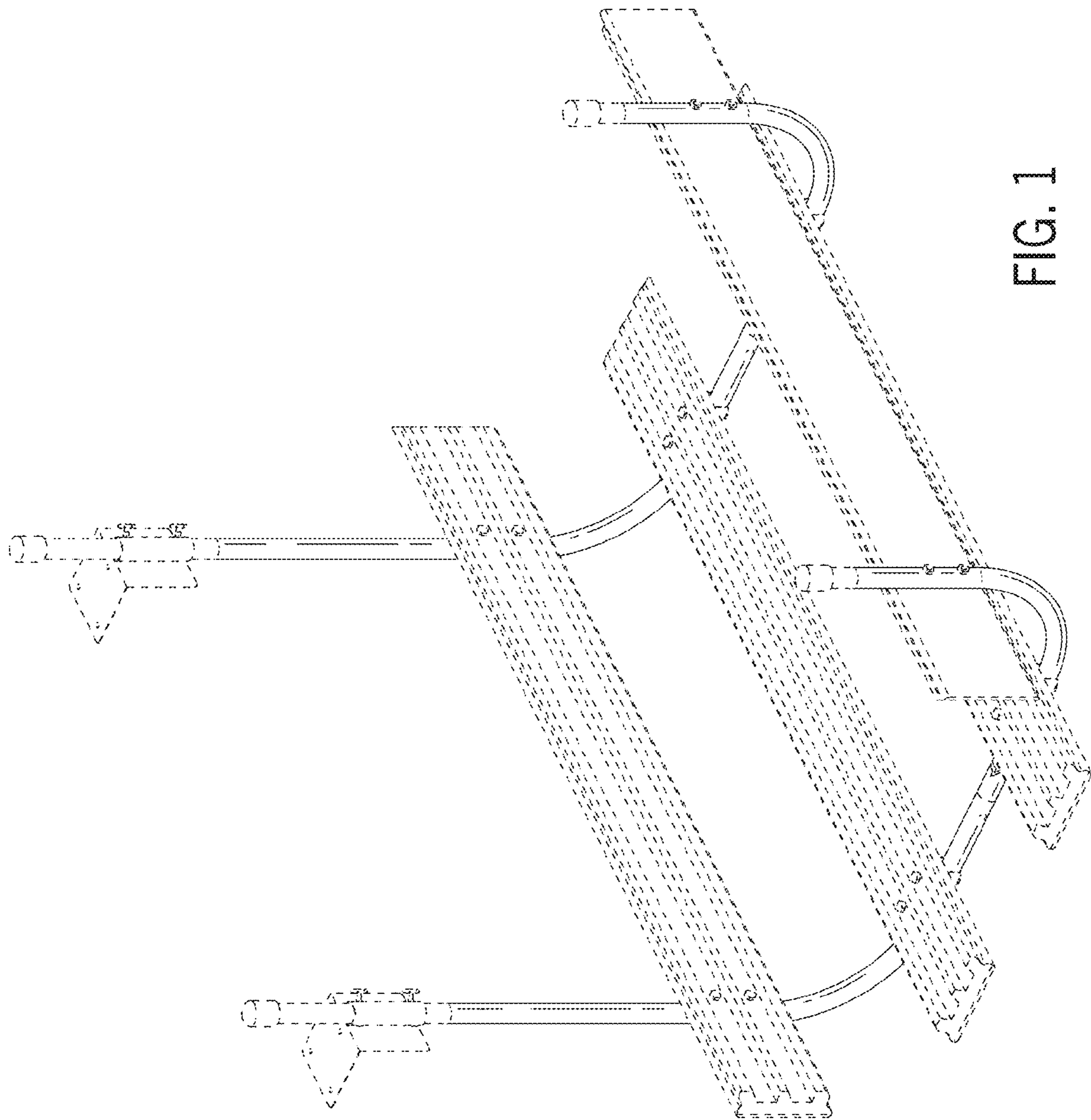

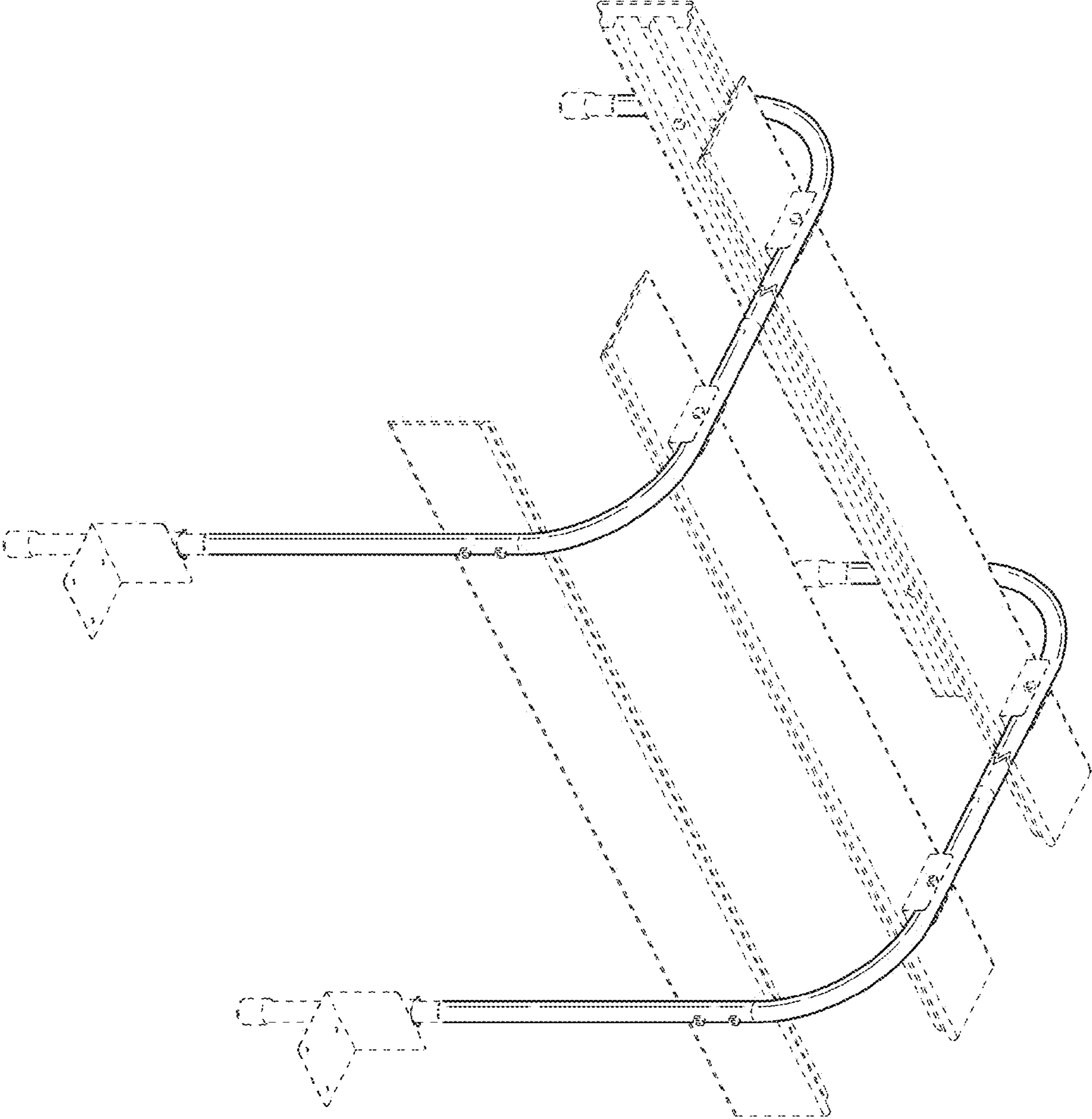

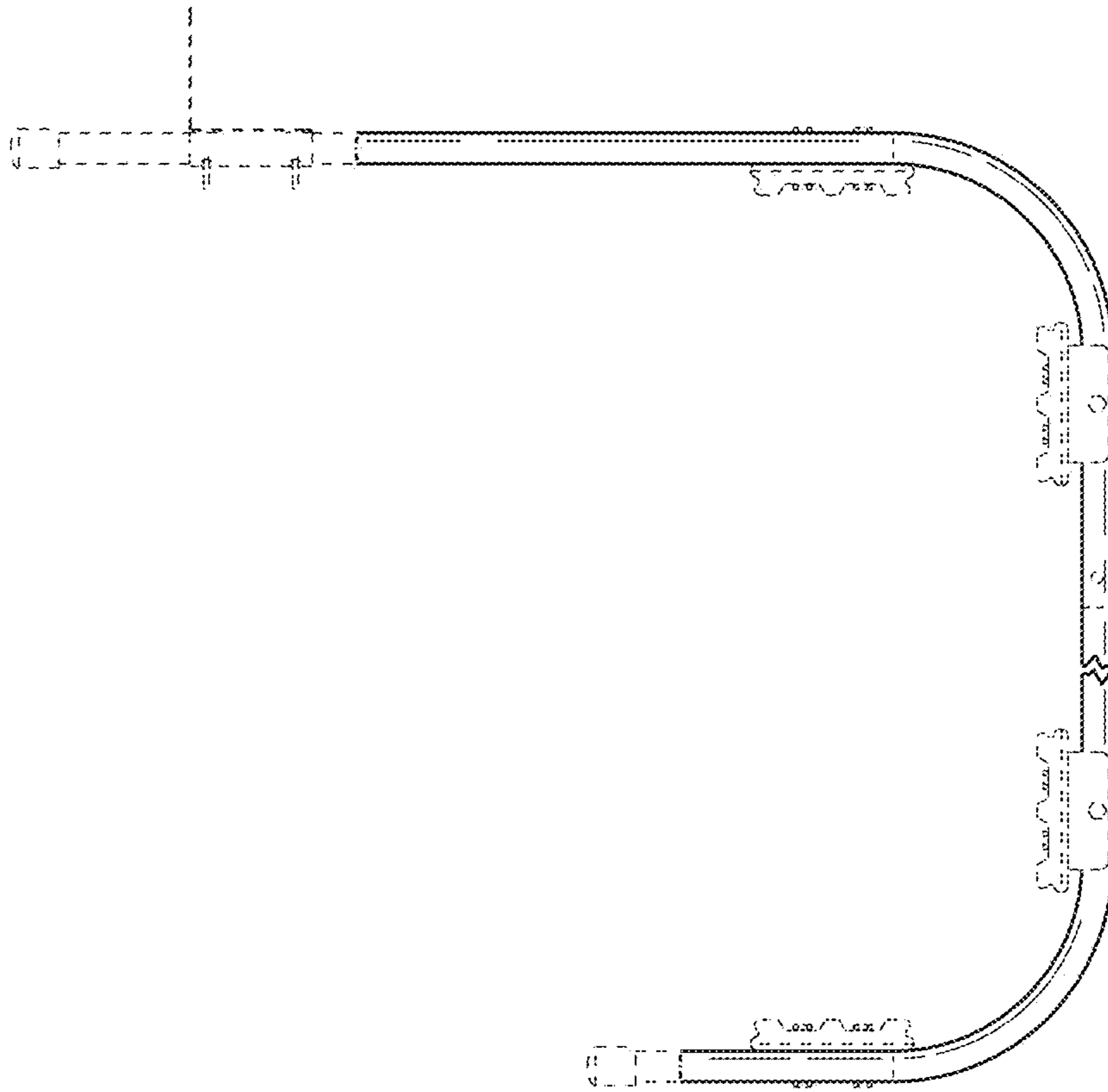

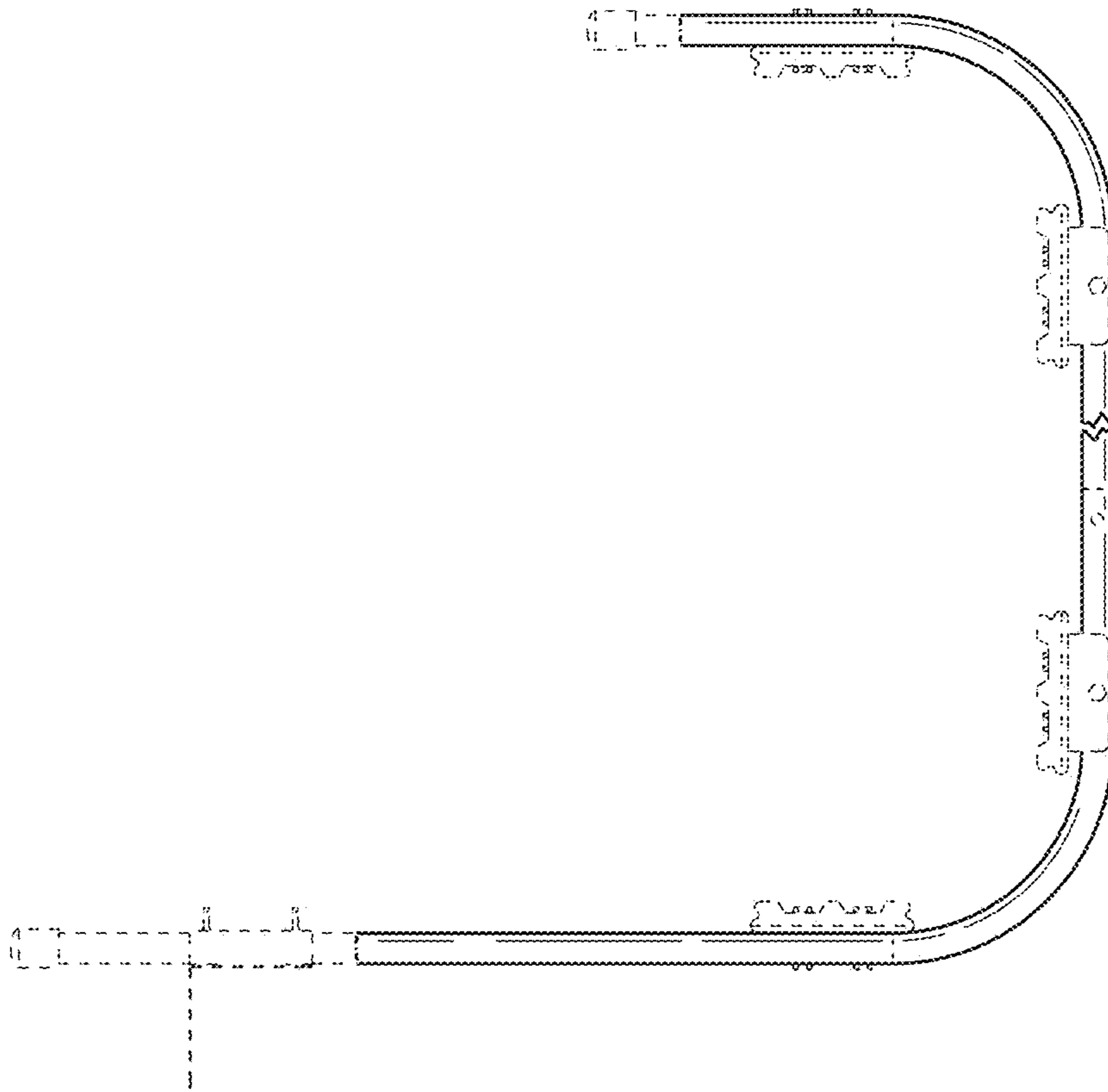

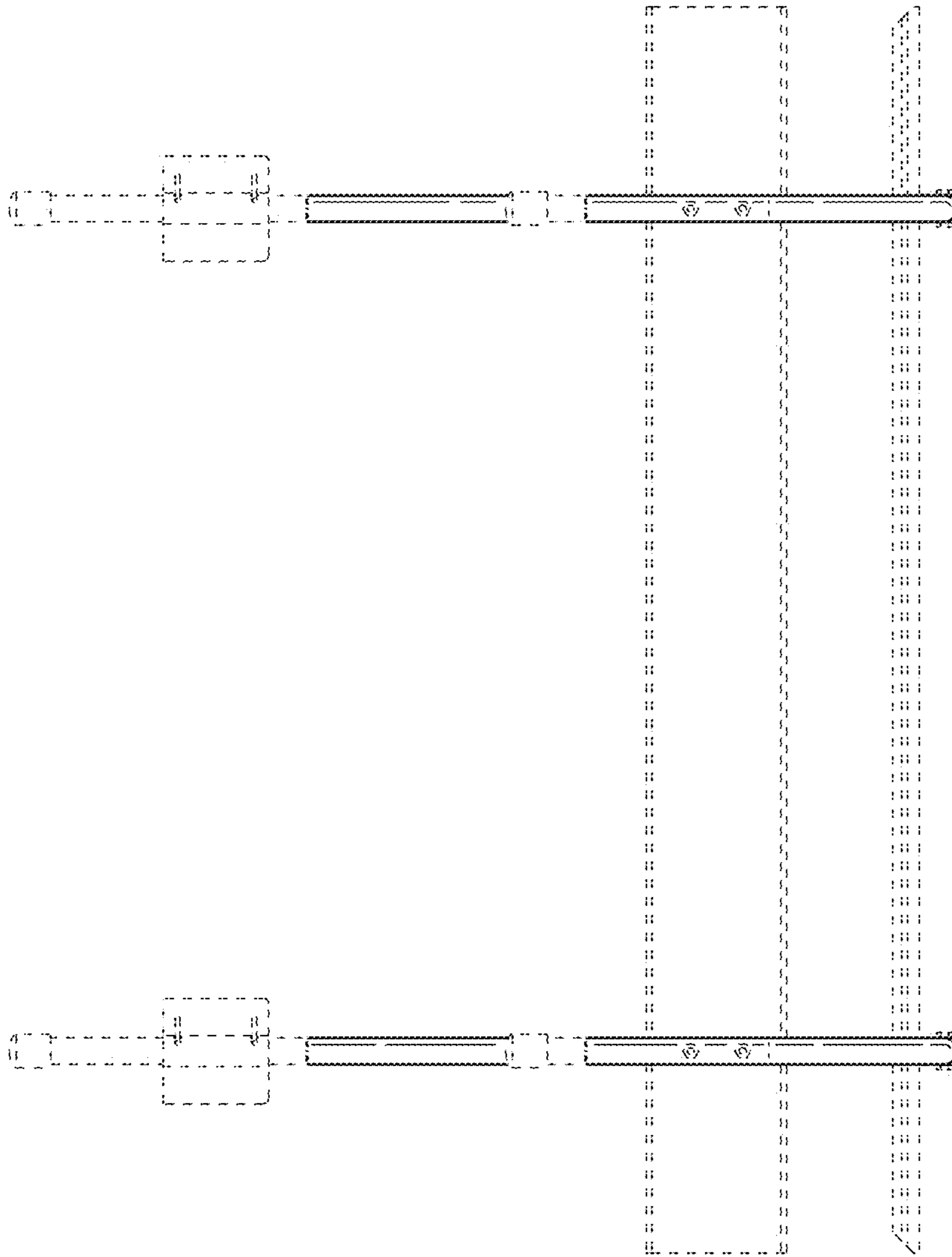

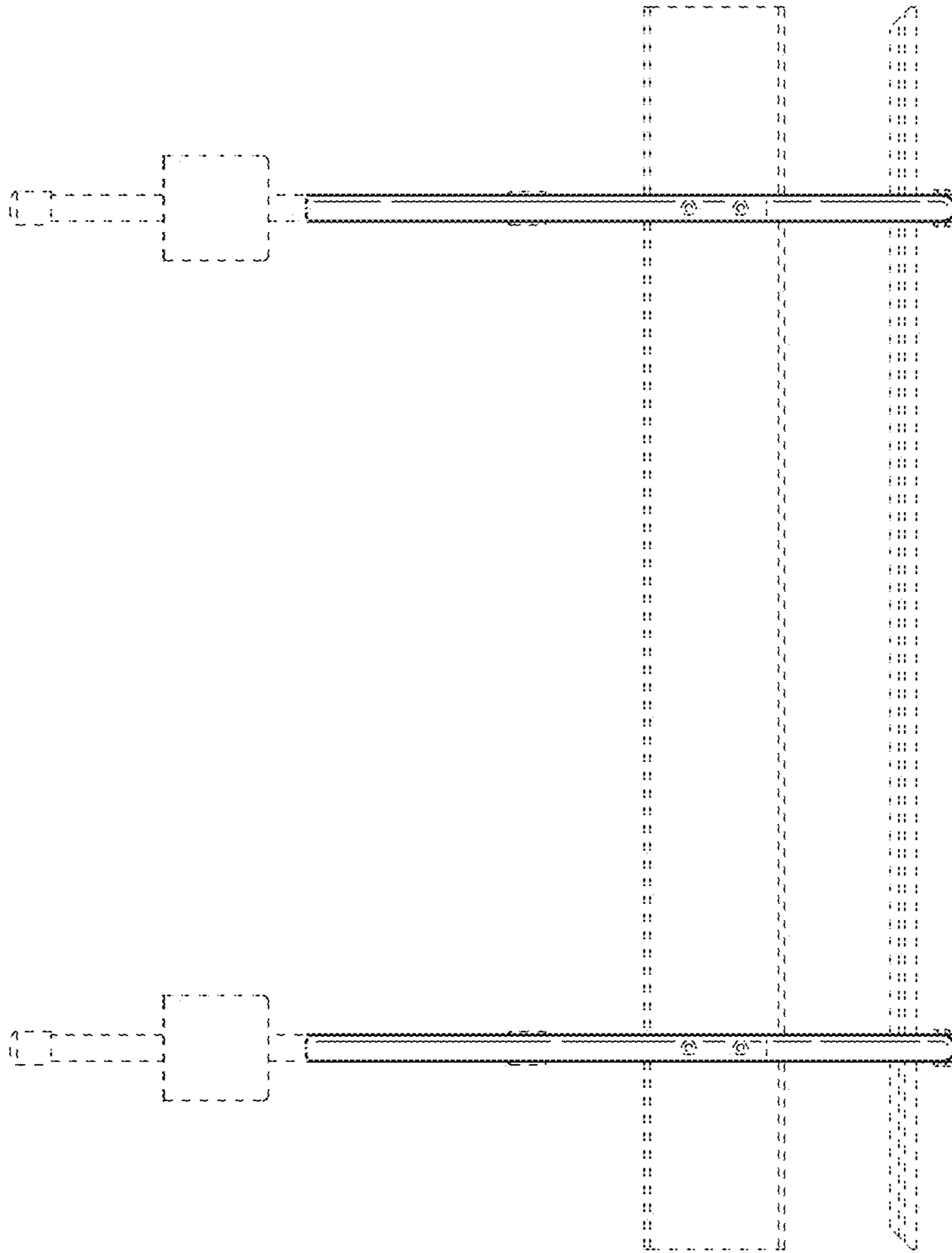

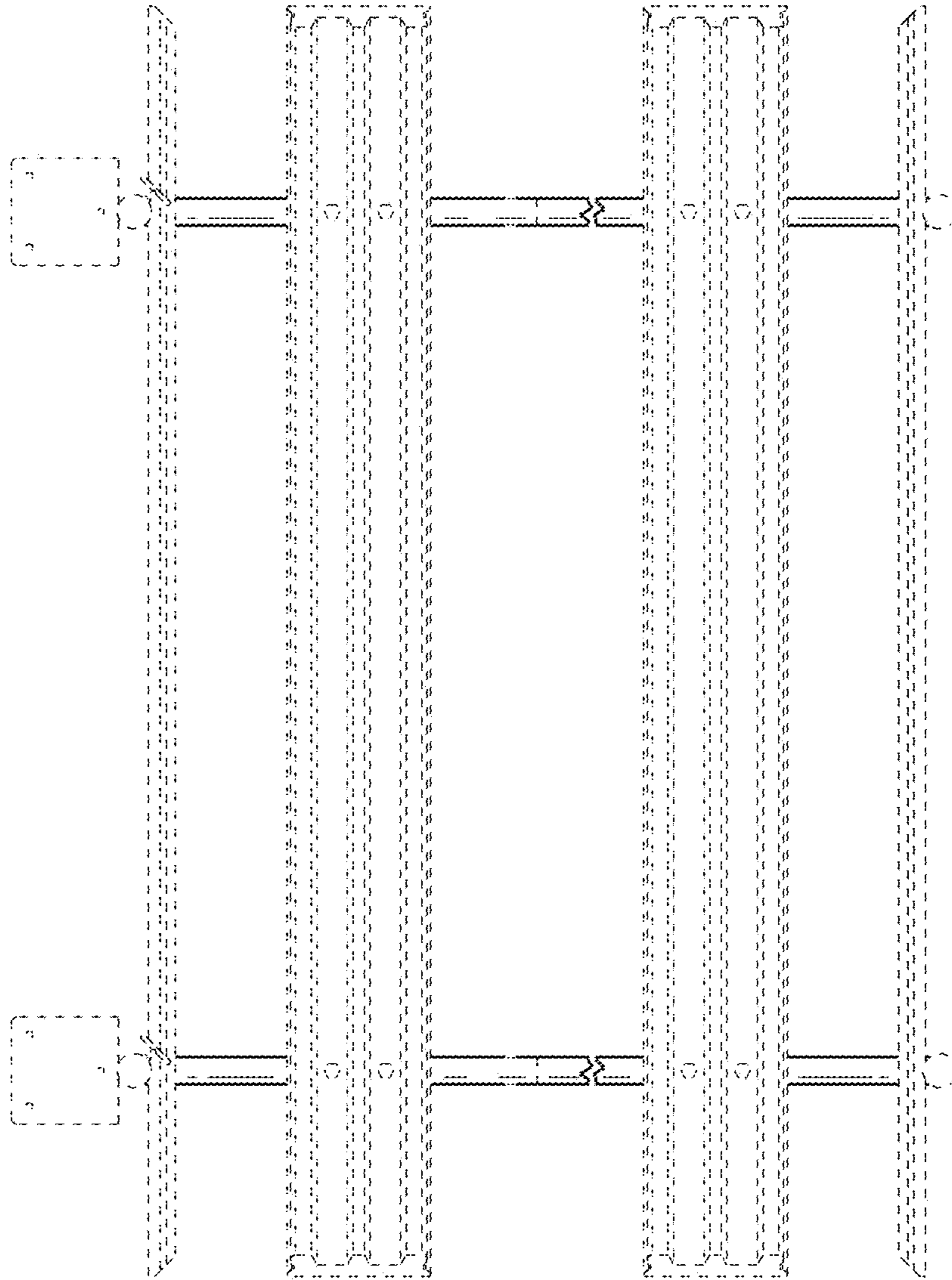

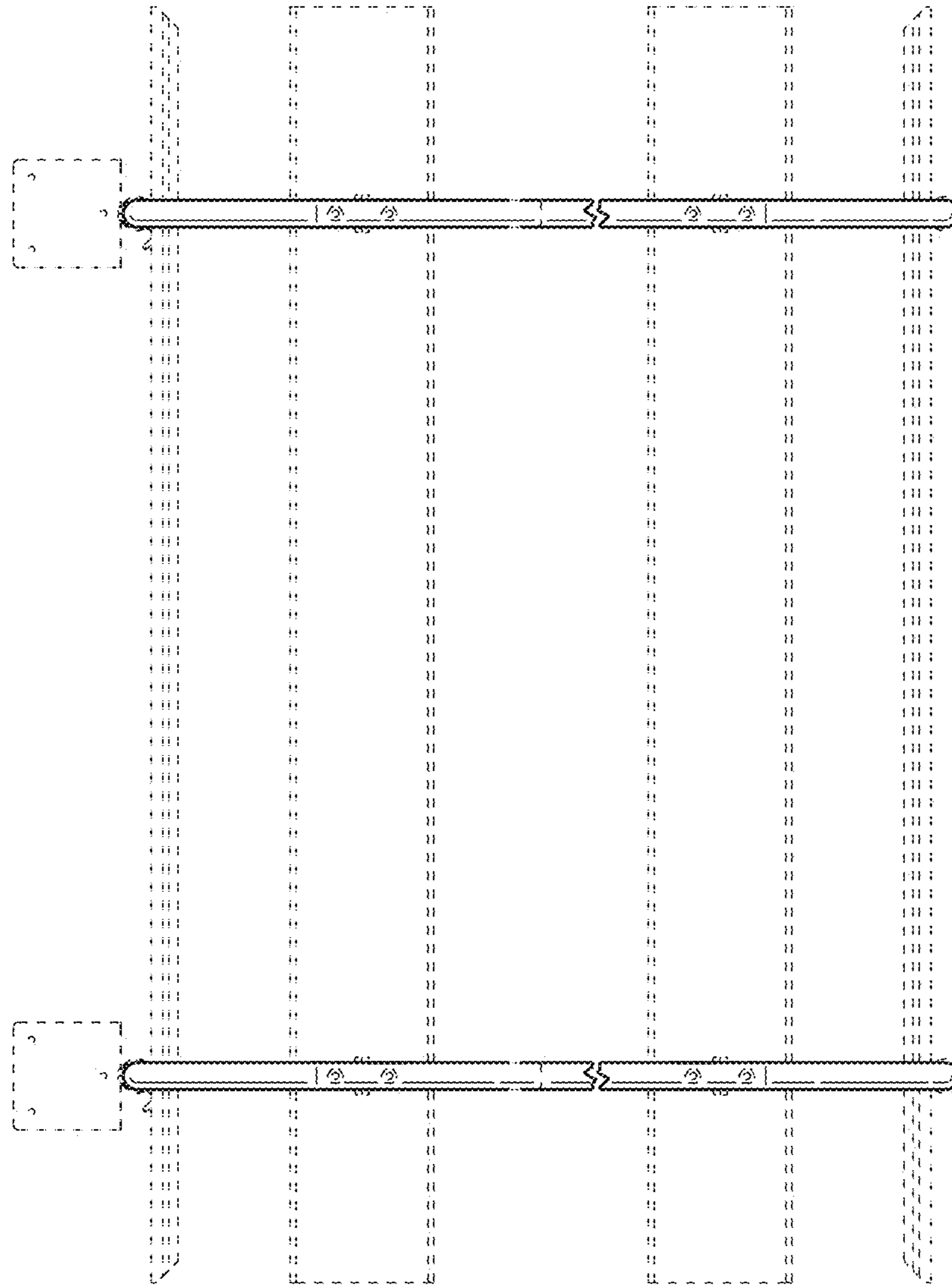
