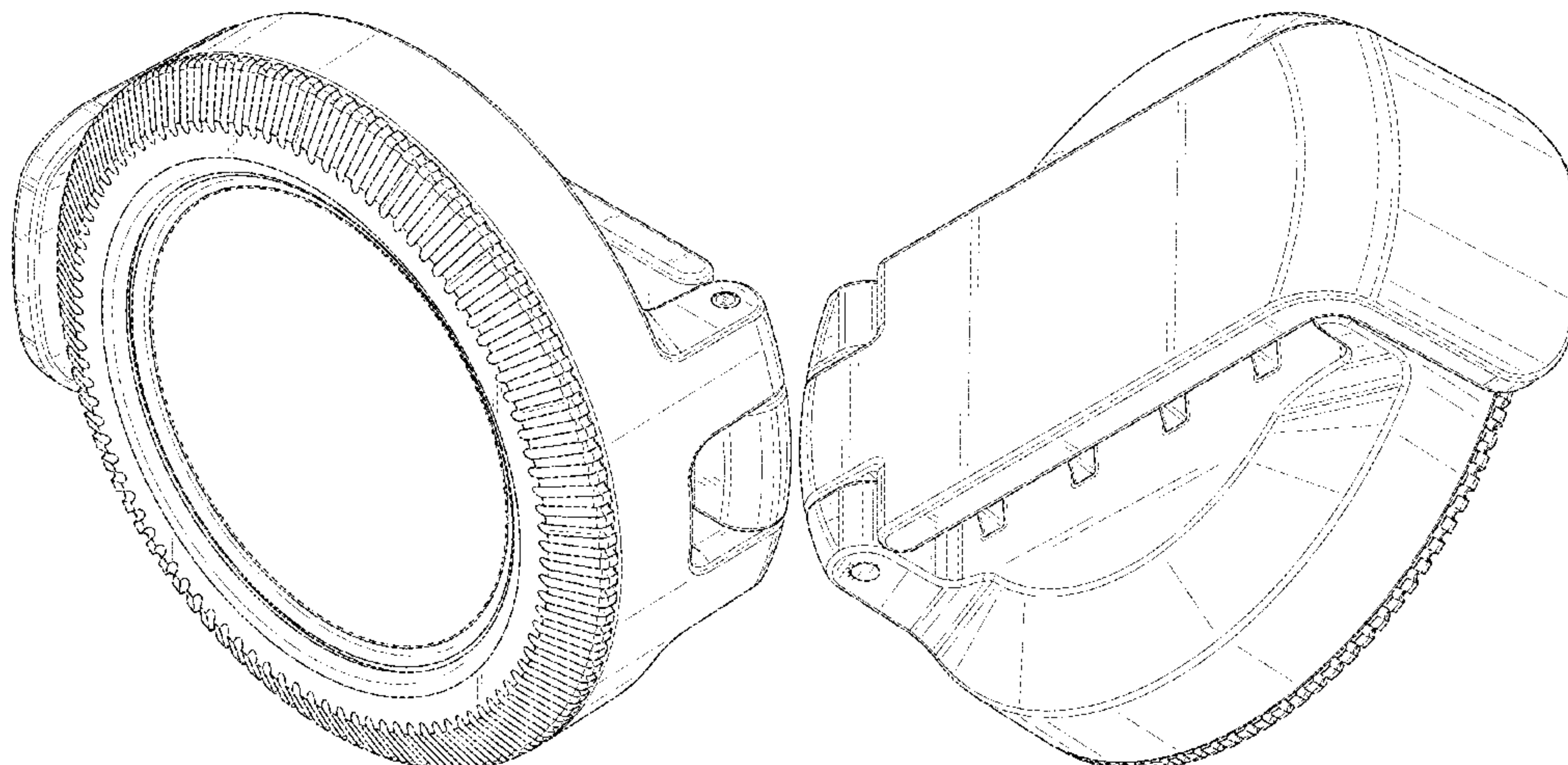


FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view of the protection case for an electronic tracking device of FIG. 9.

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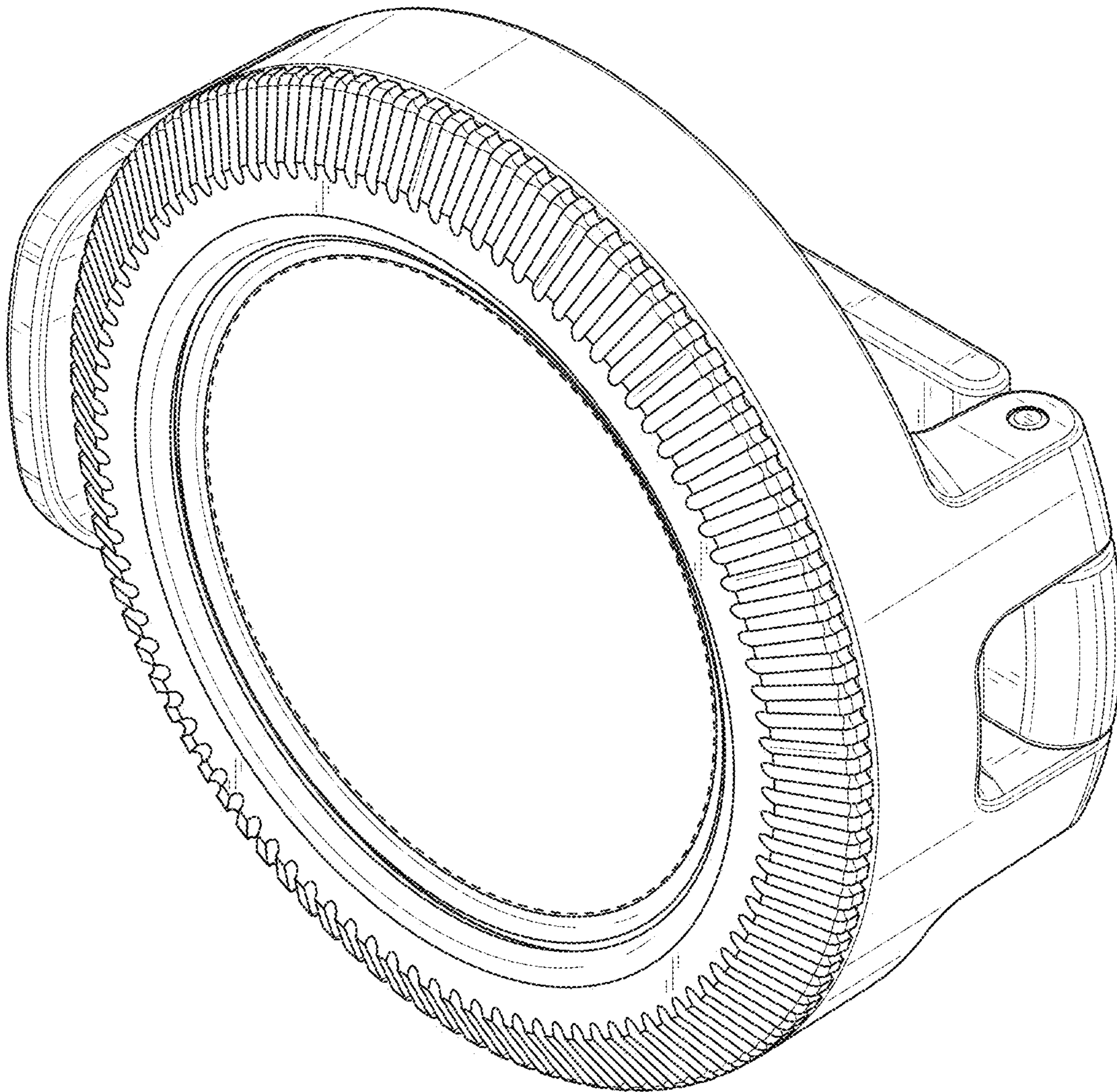

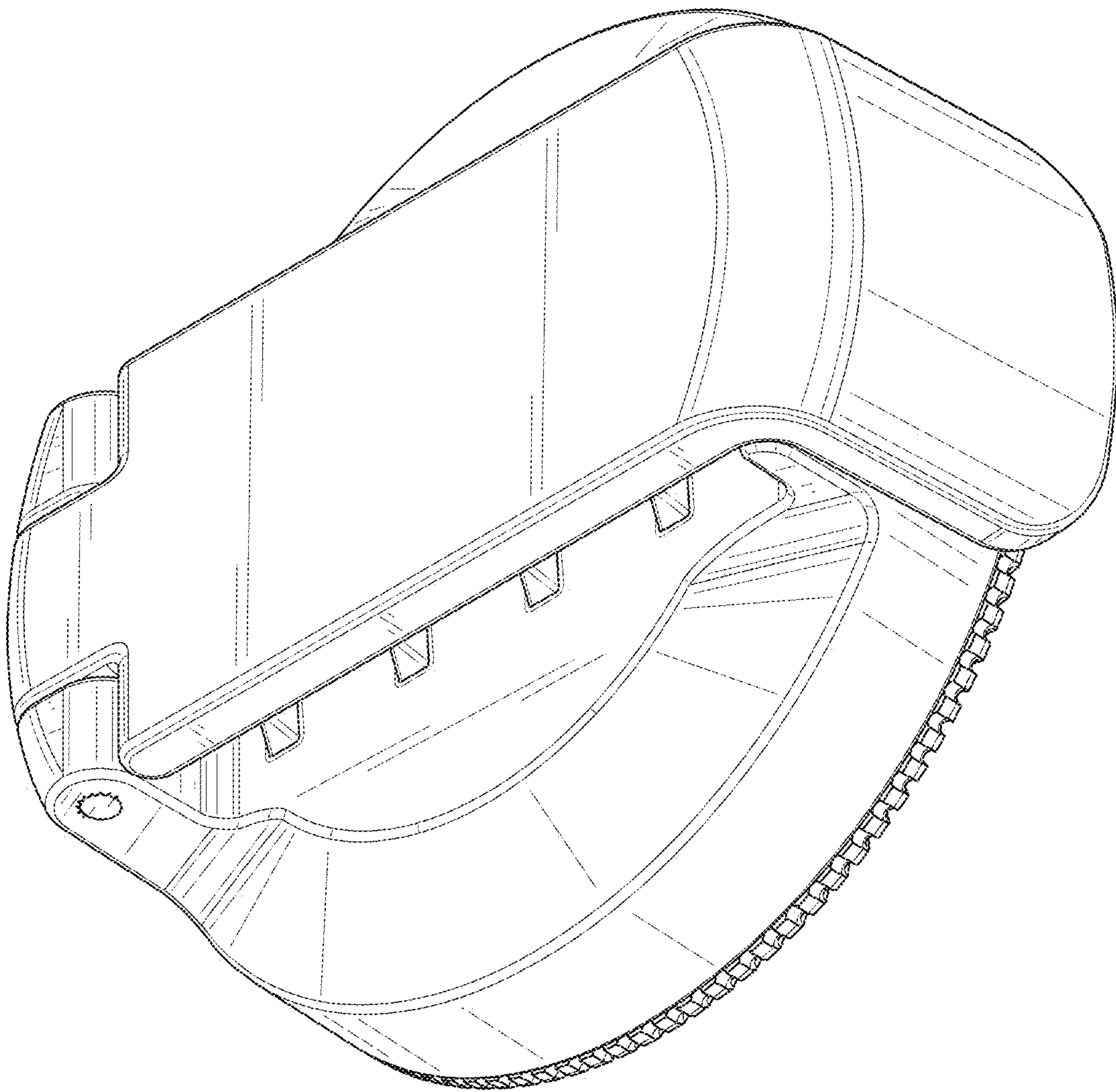

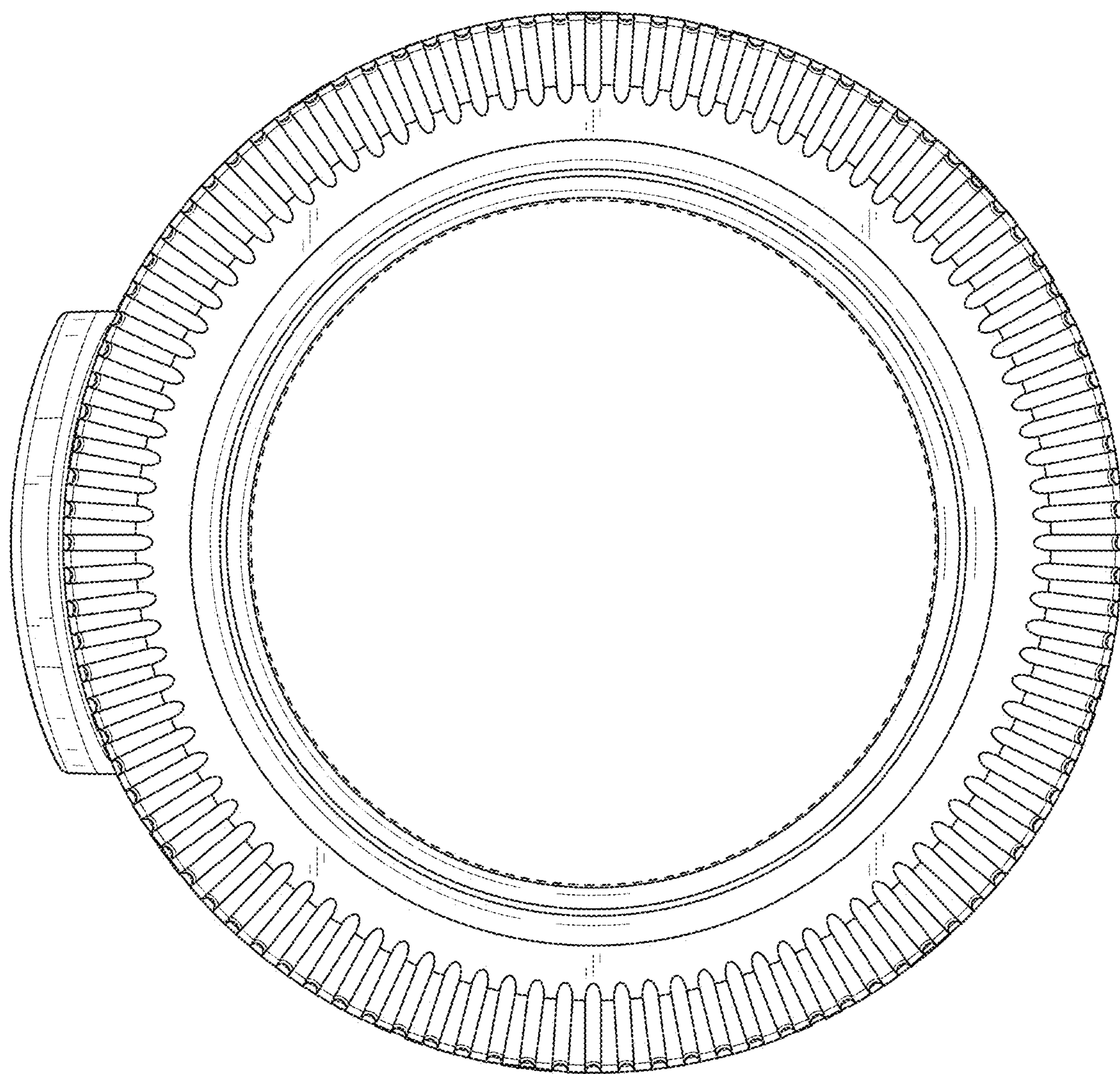

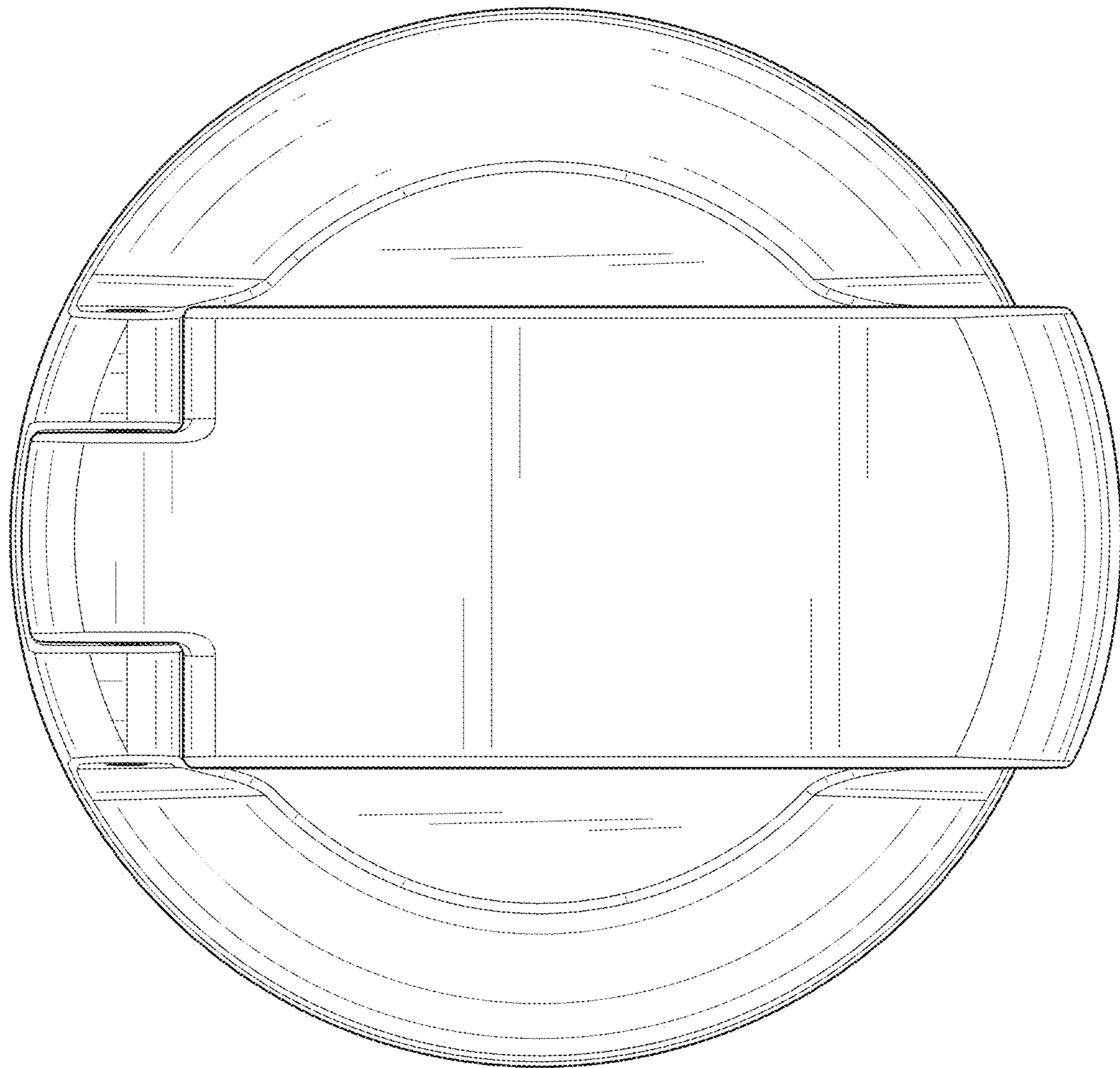

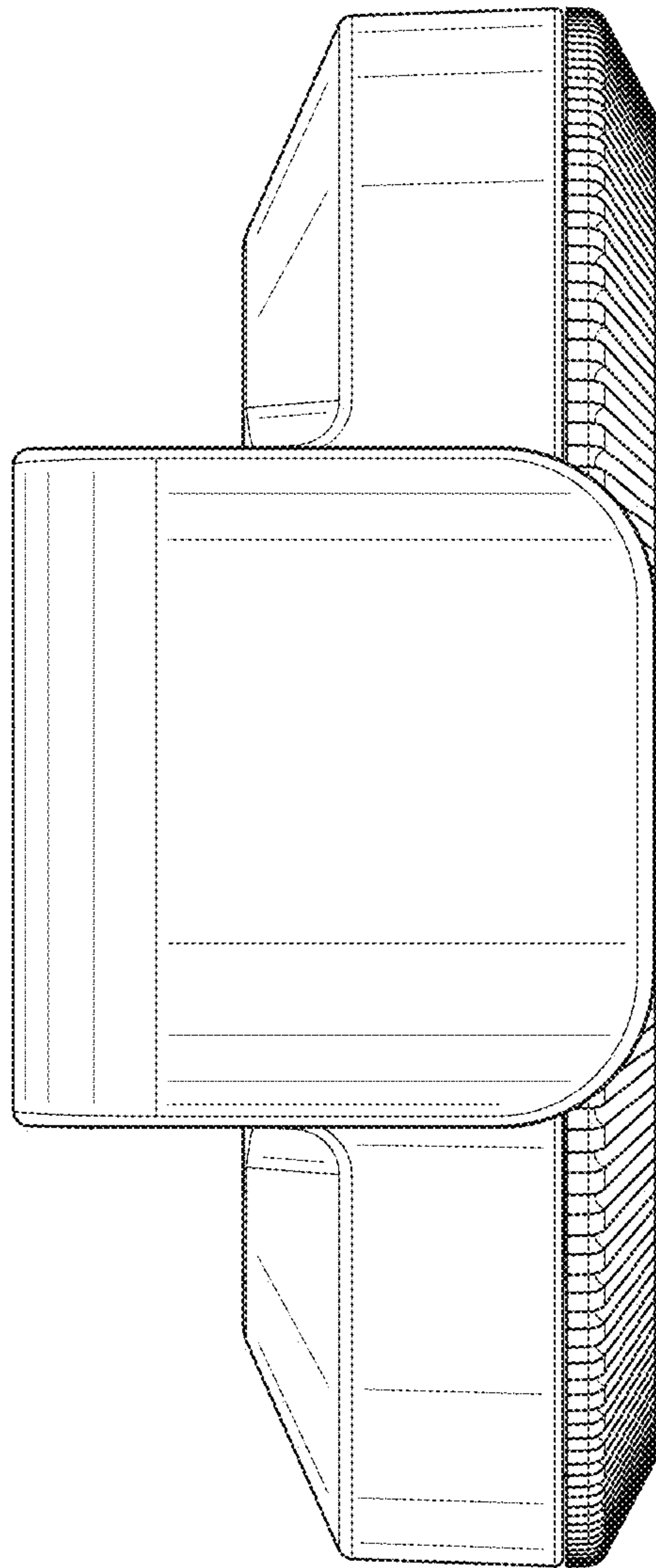

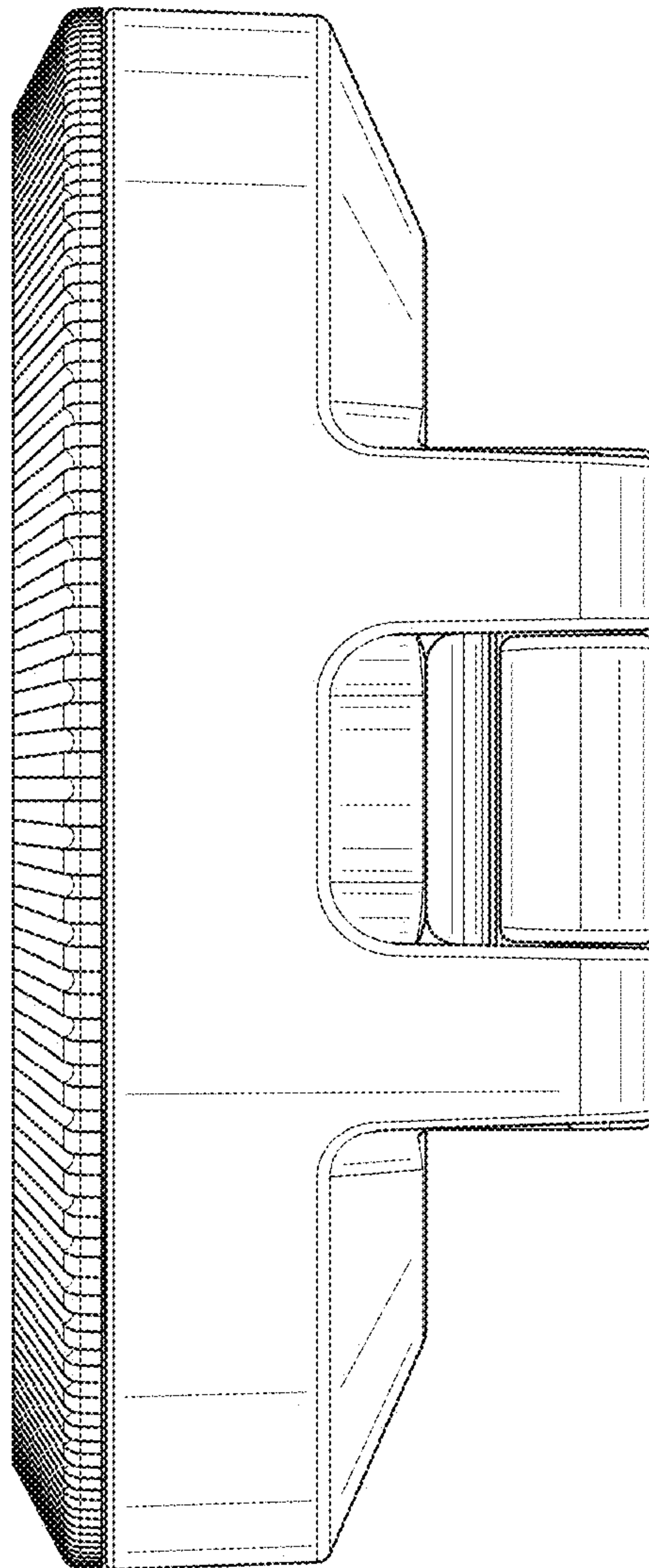

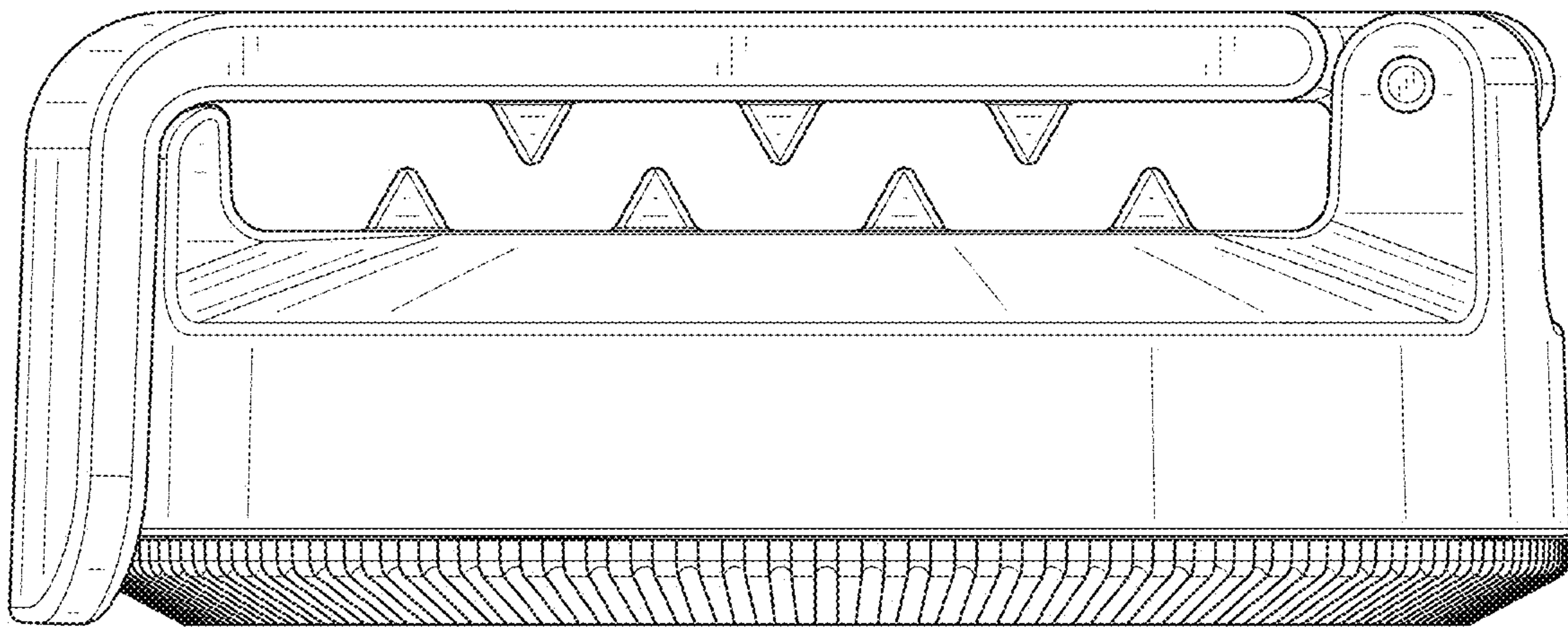

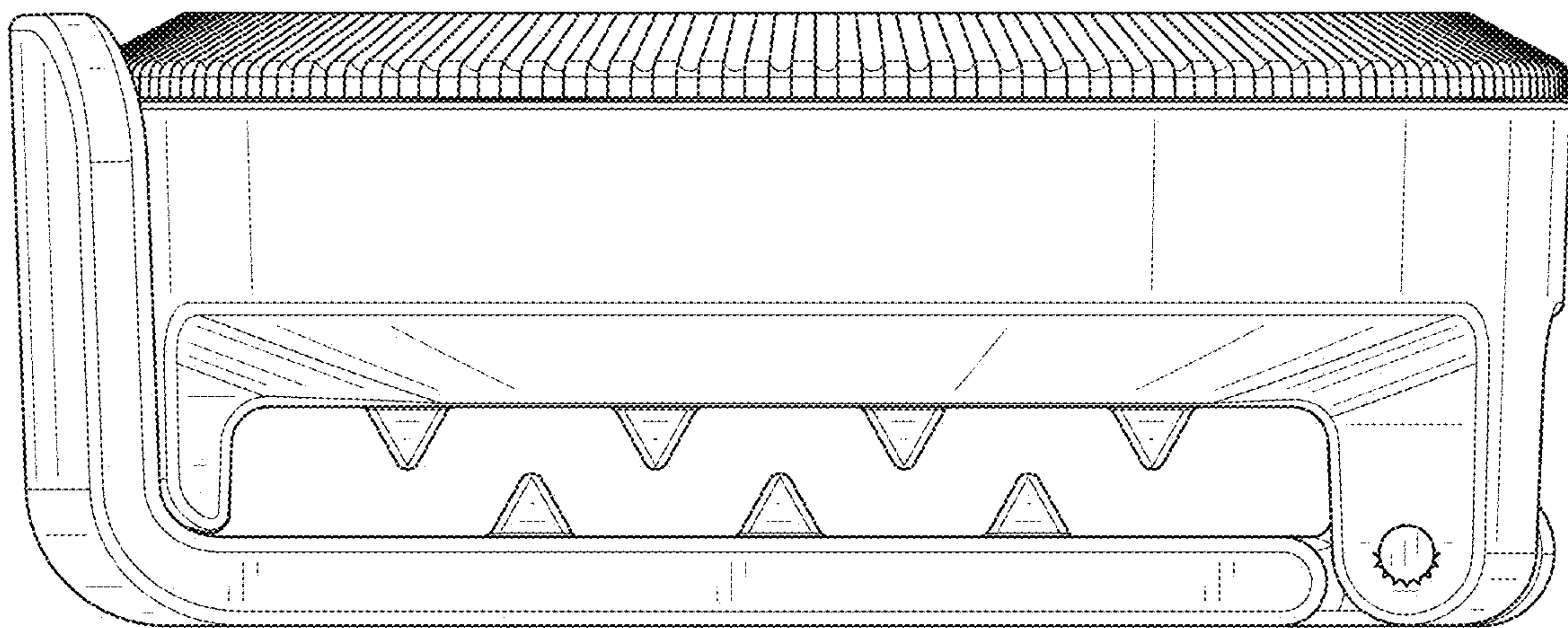

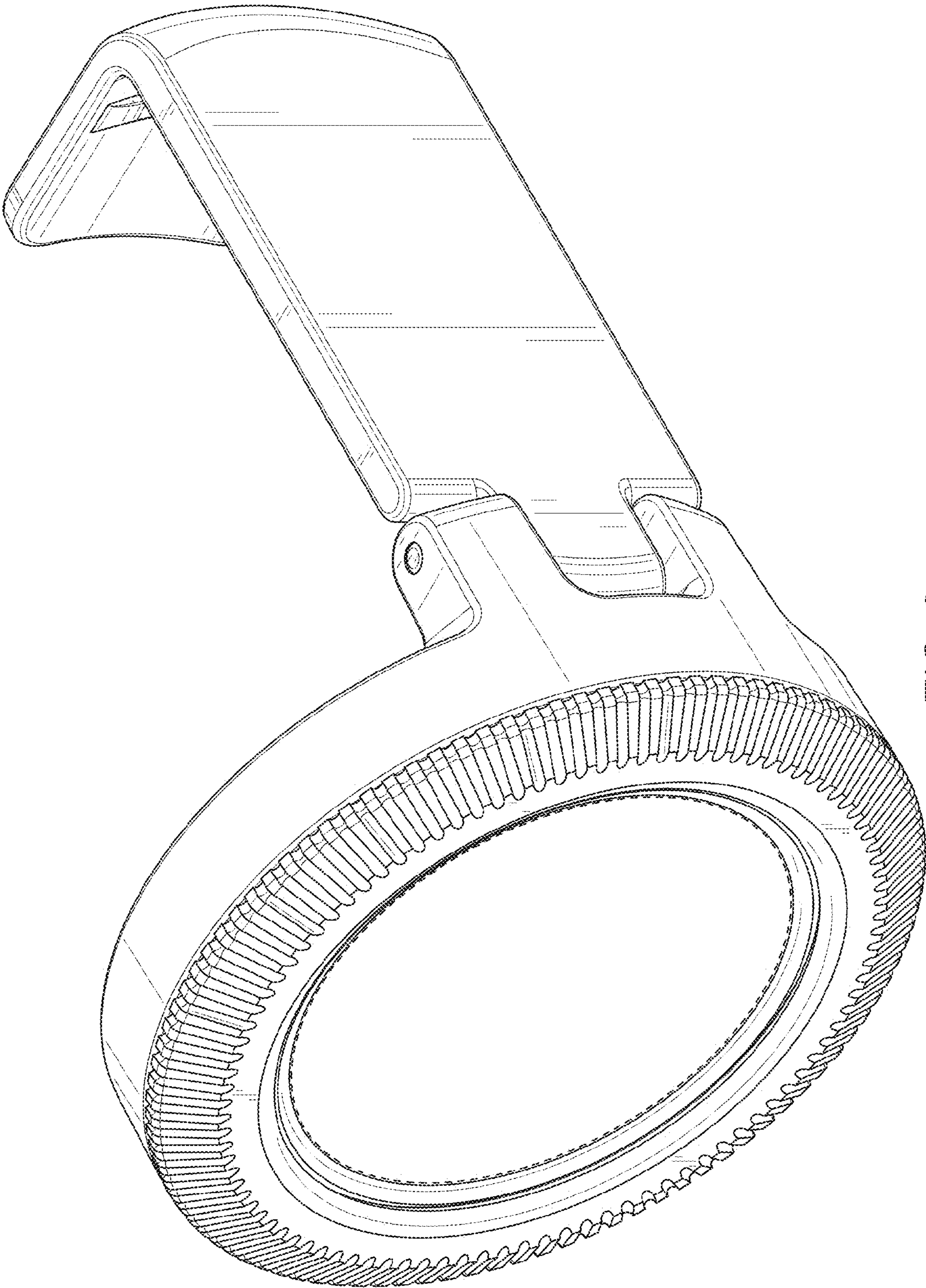

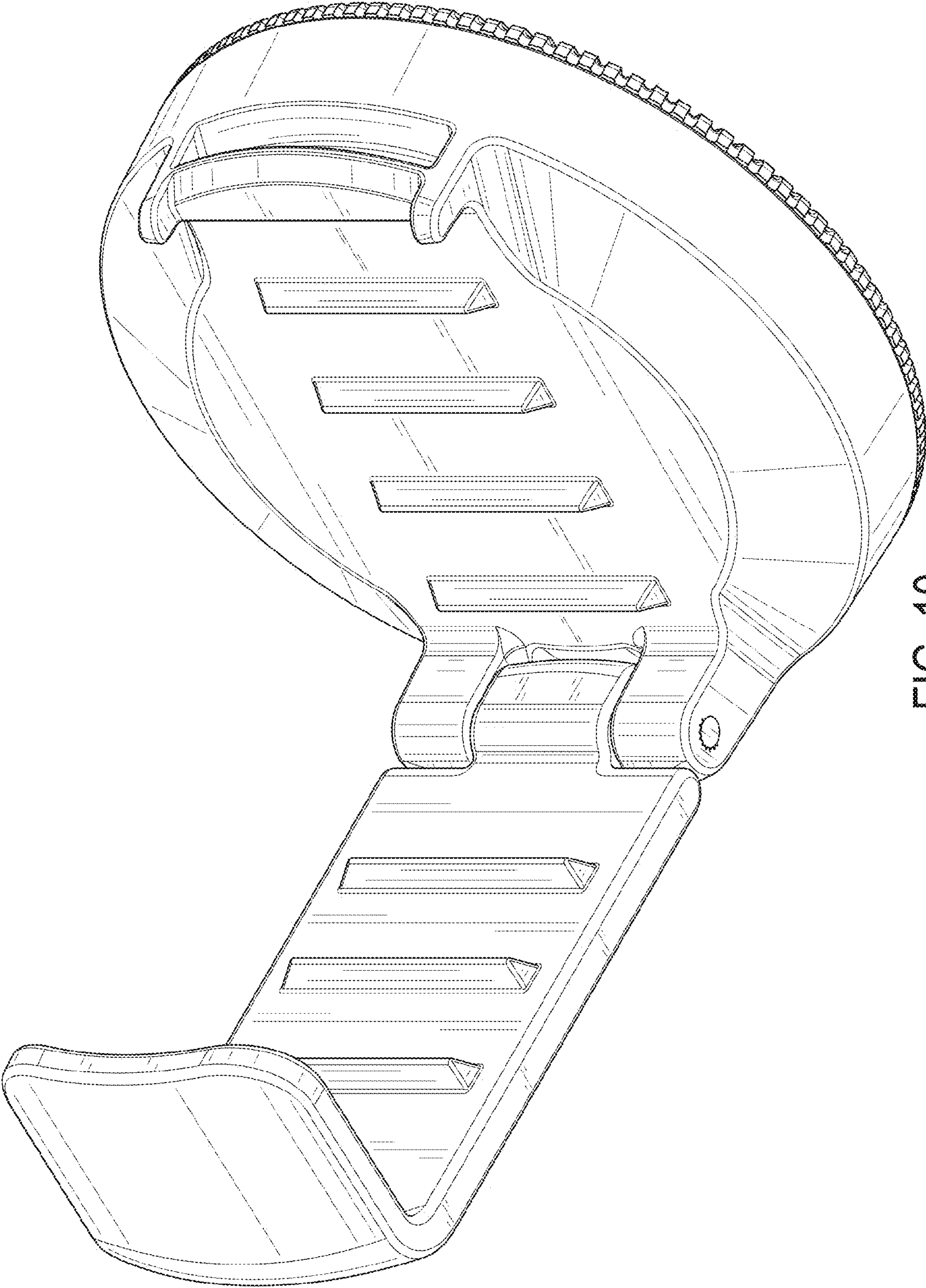

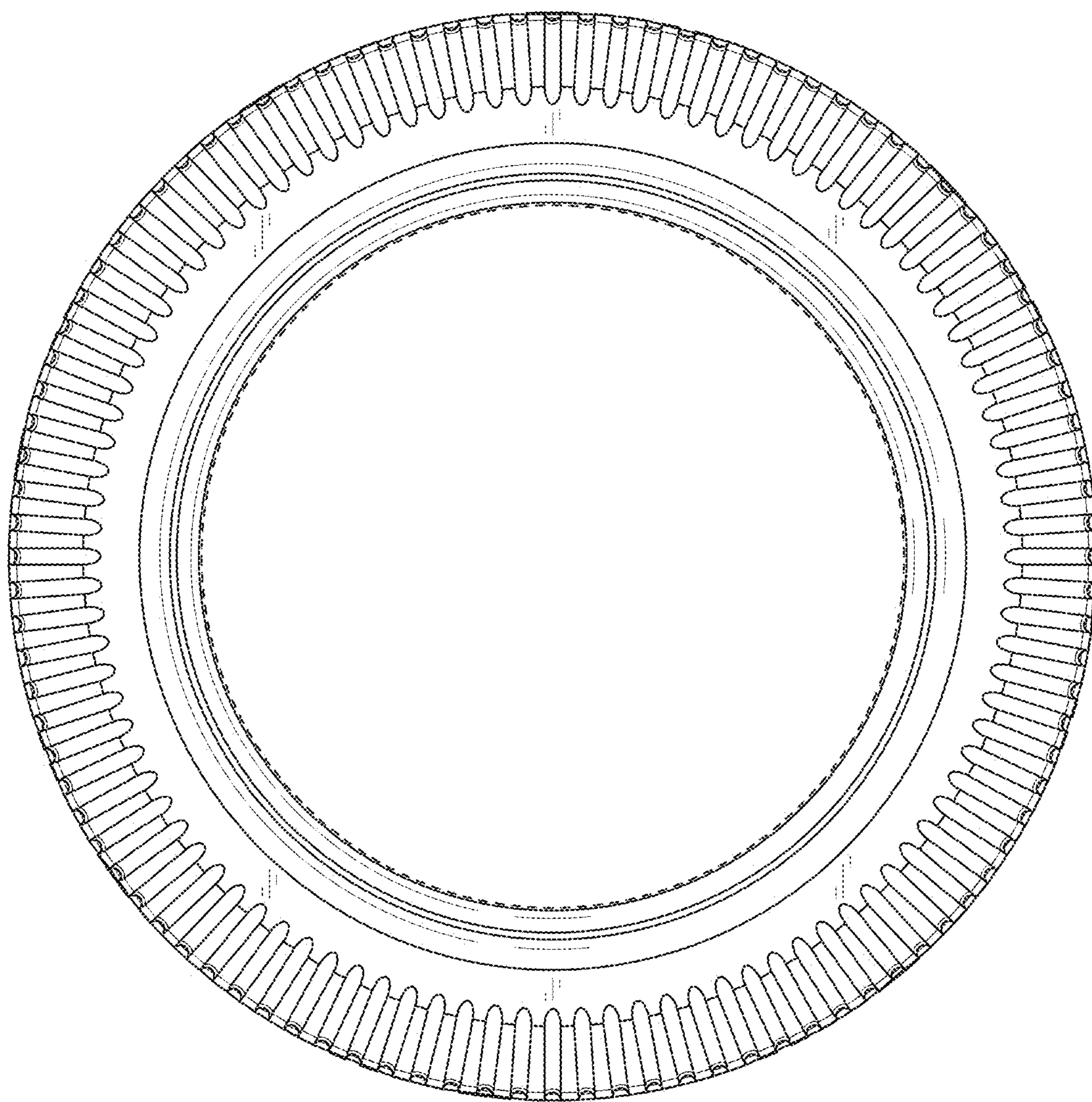

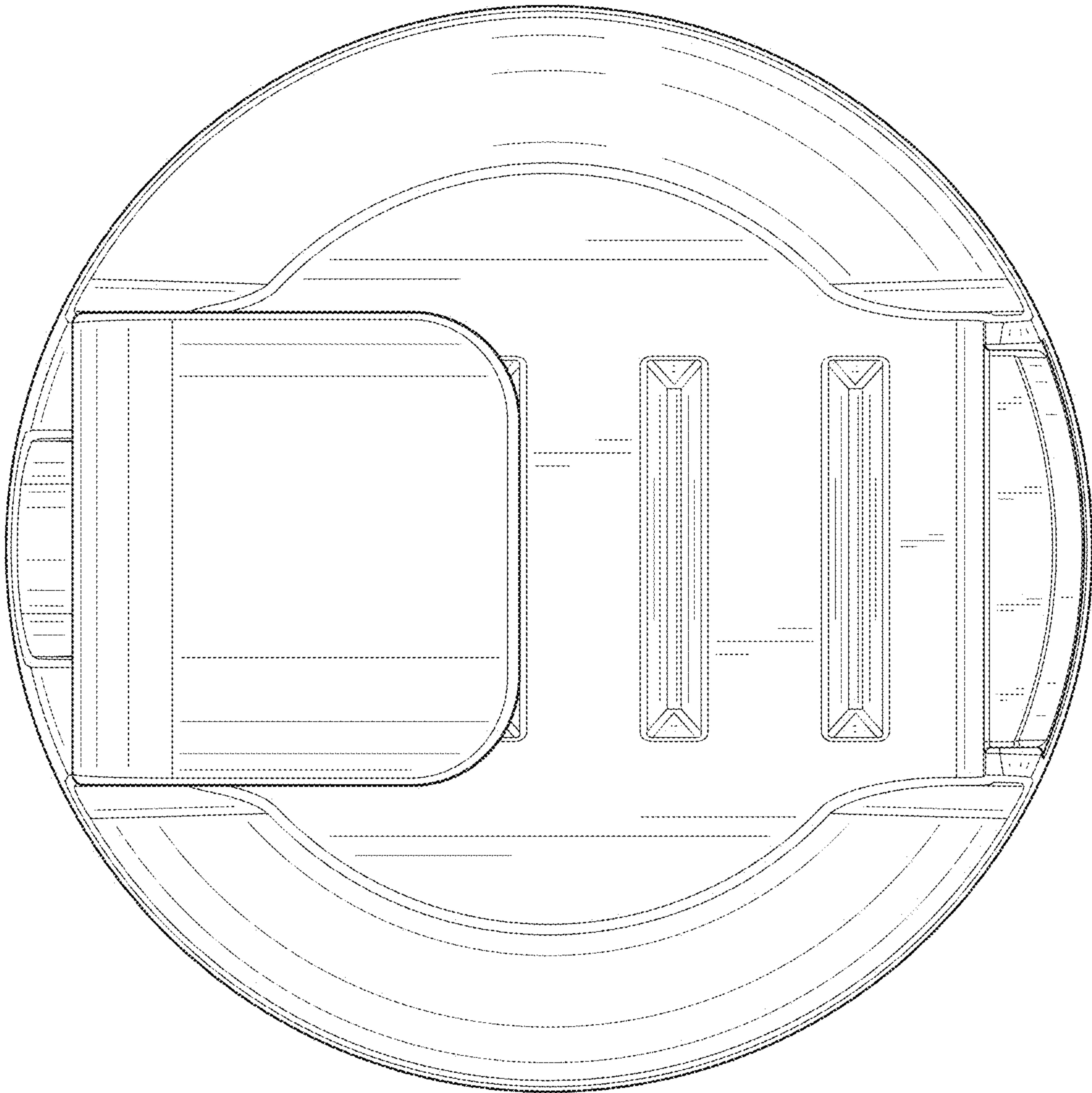

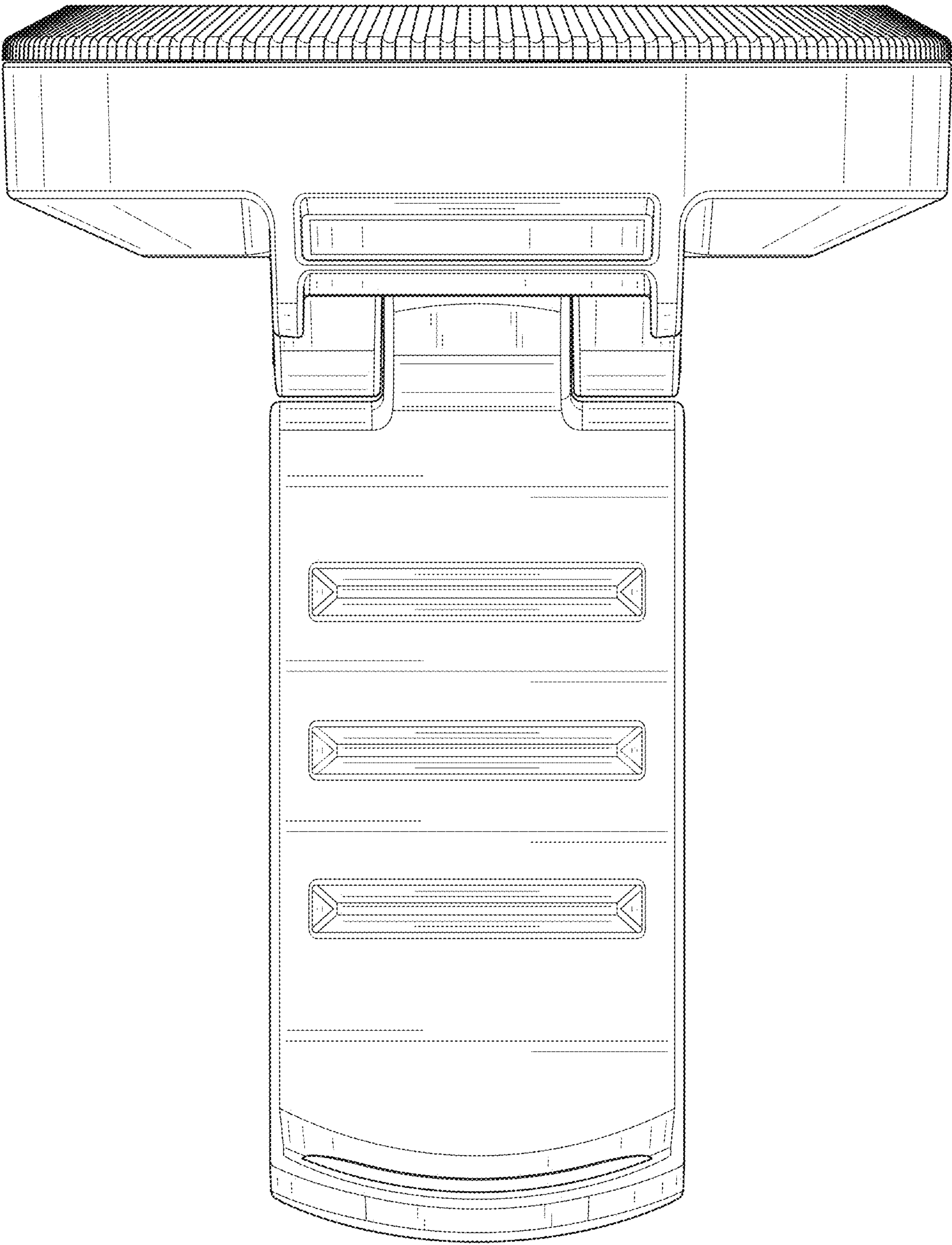

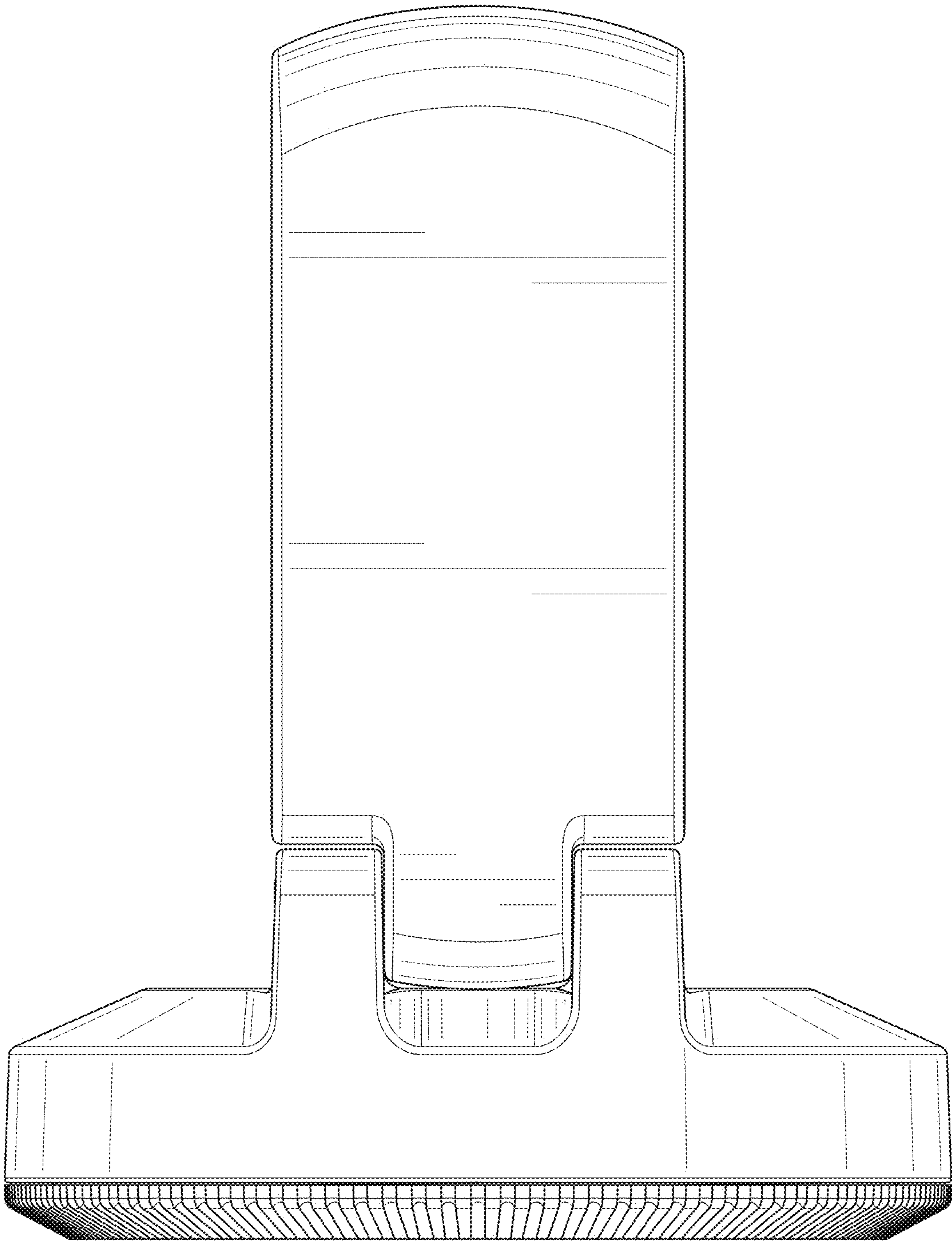

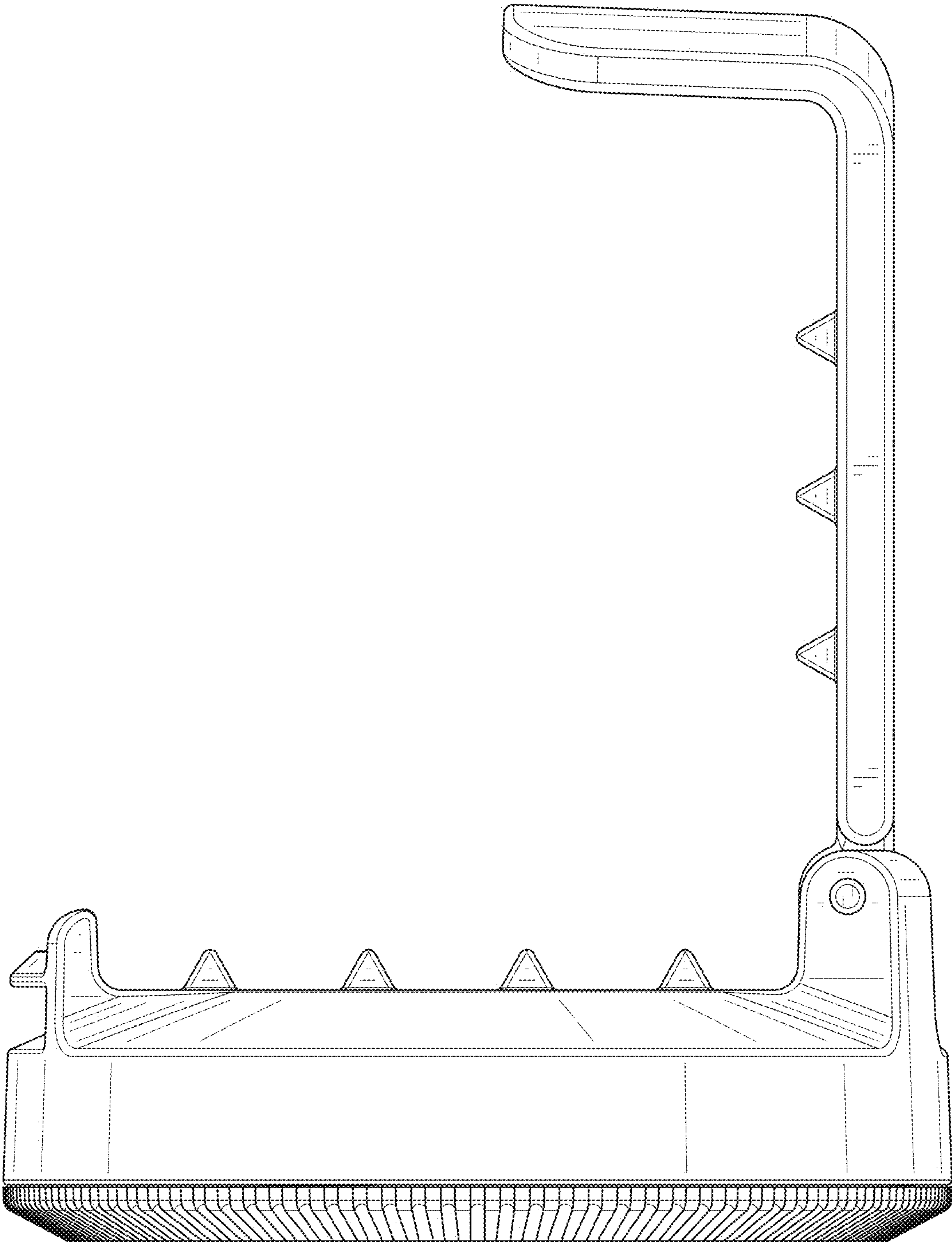

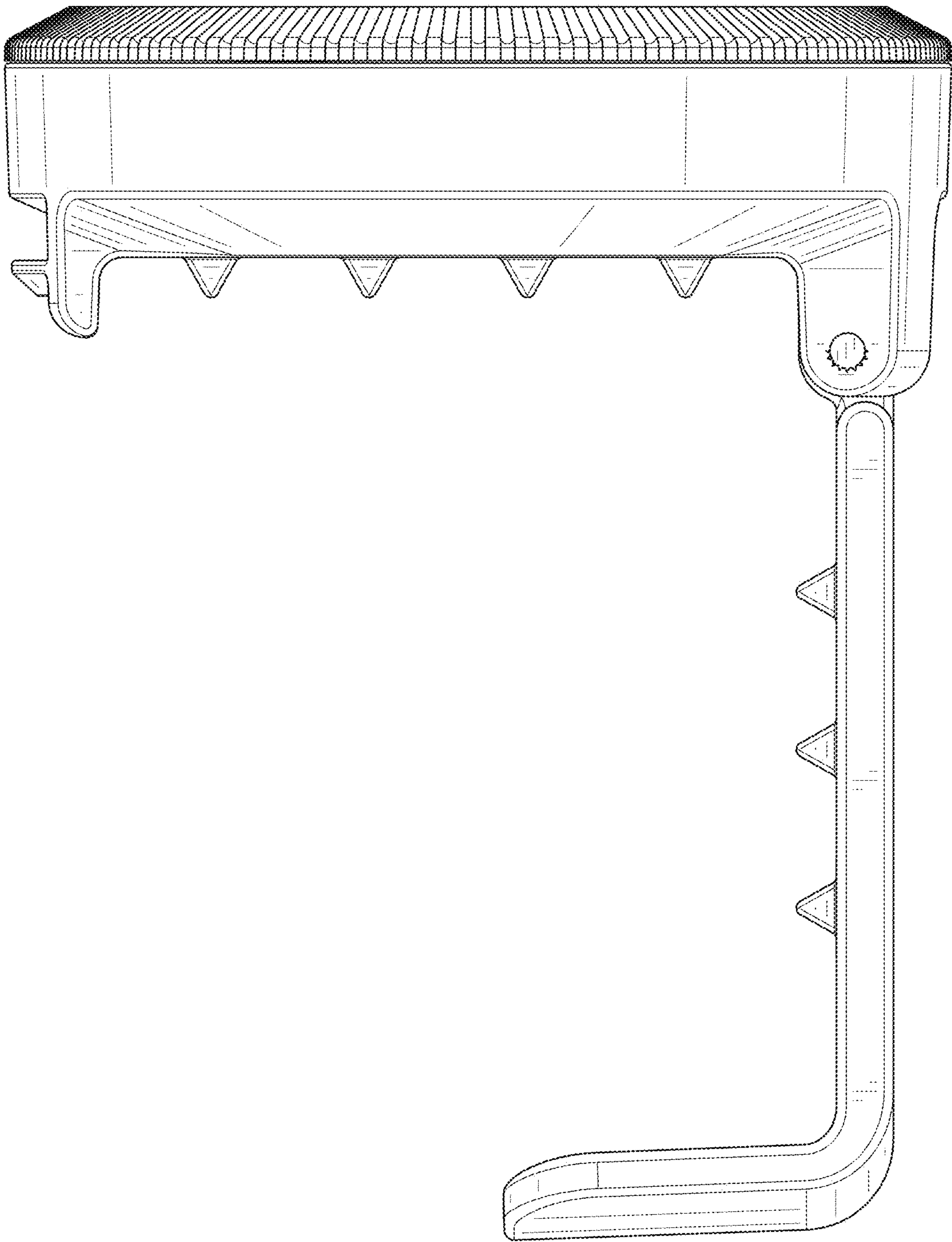
