FIG. 5 illustrates a right side view of the card reader of FIG. 1.

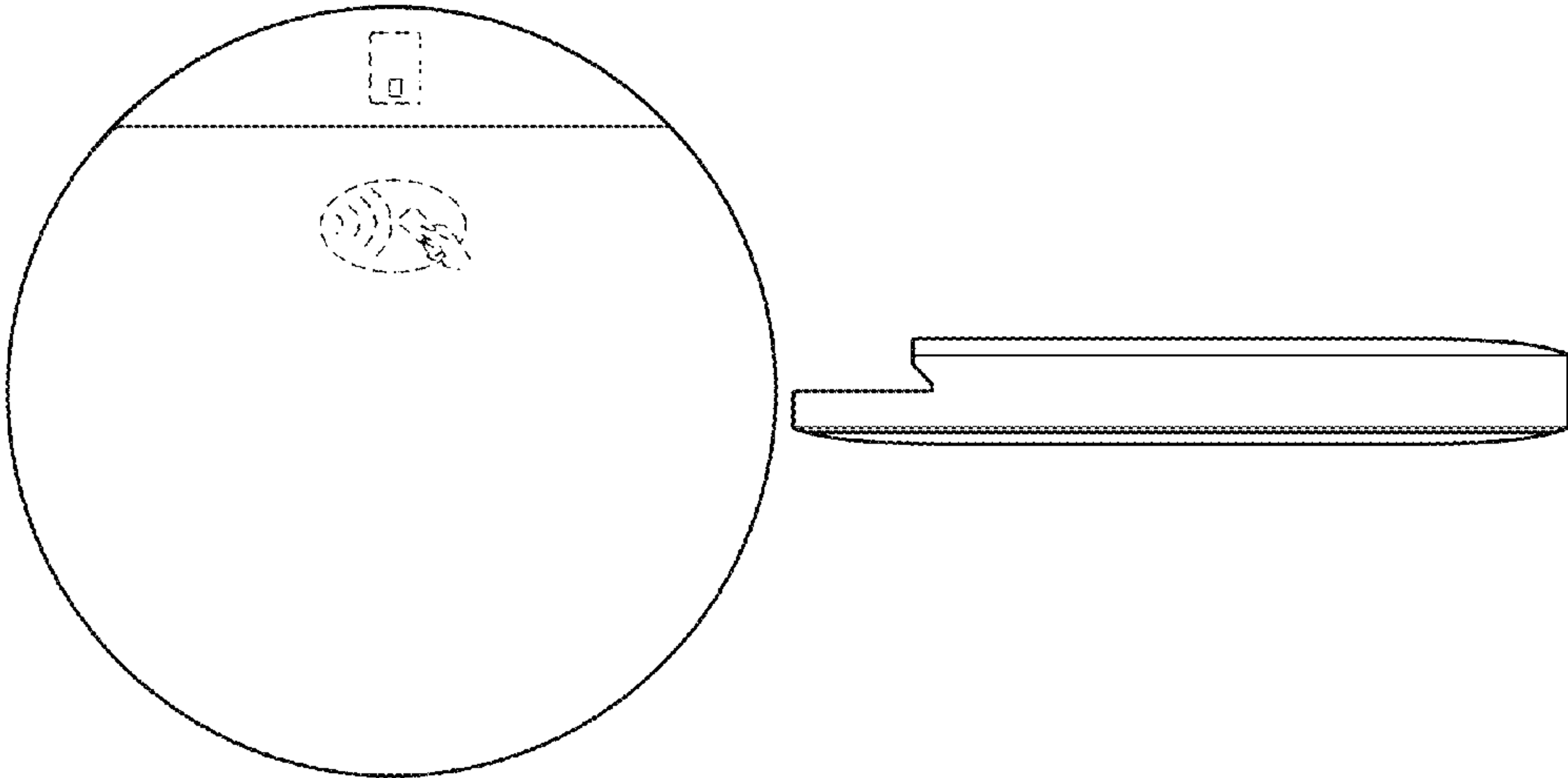
FIG. 6 illustrates a front view of the card reader of FIG. 1.

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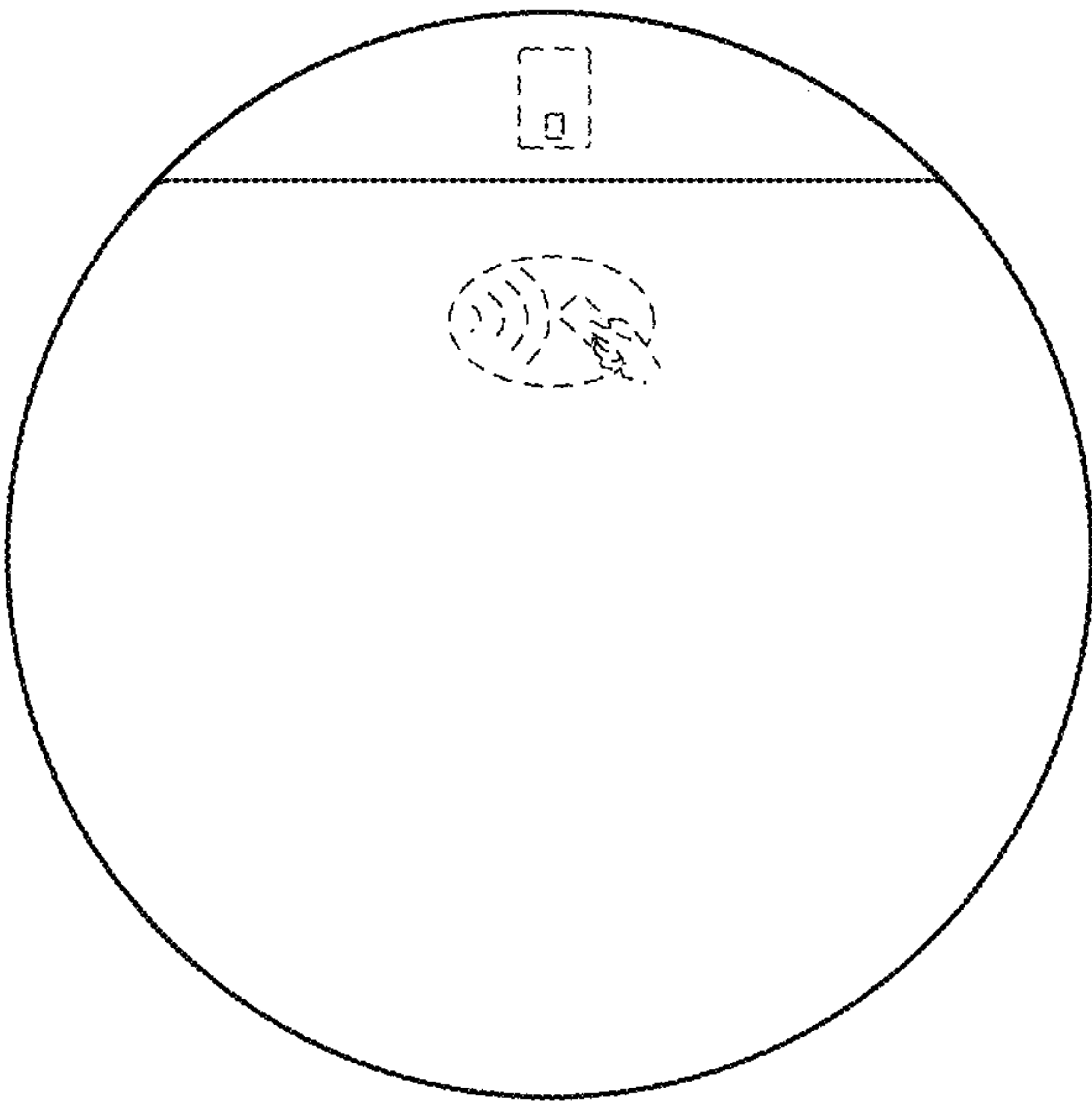

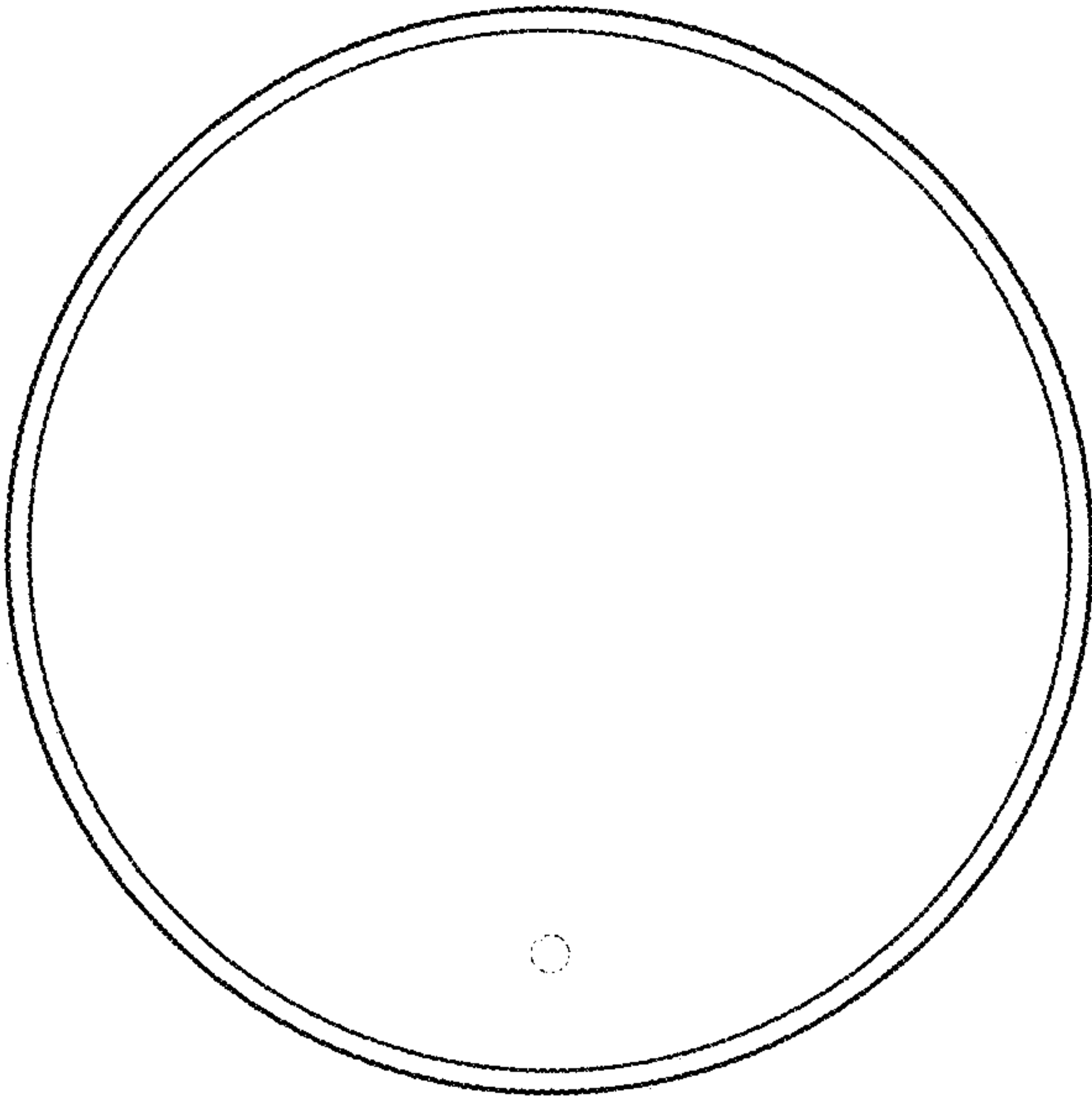

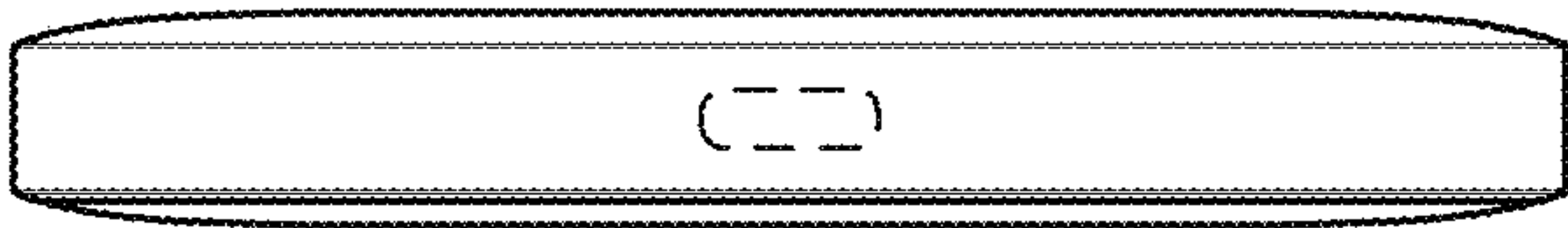

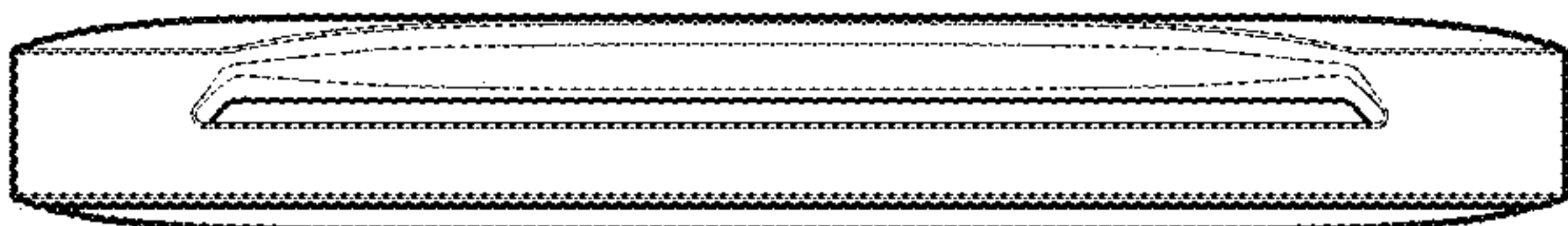

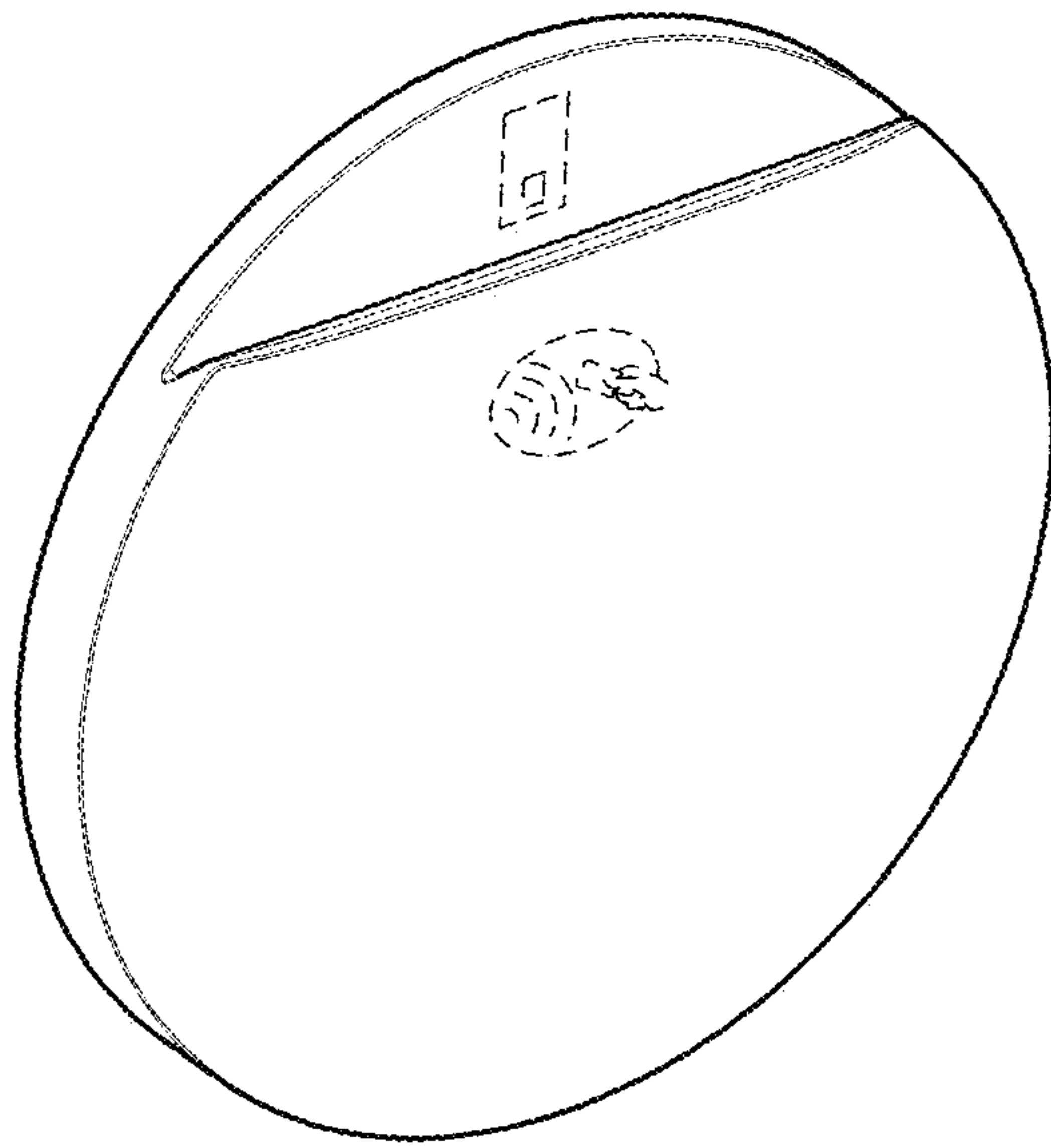

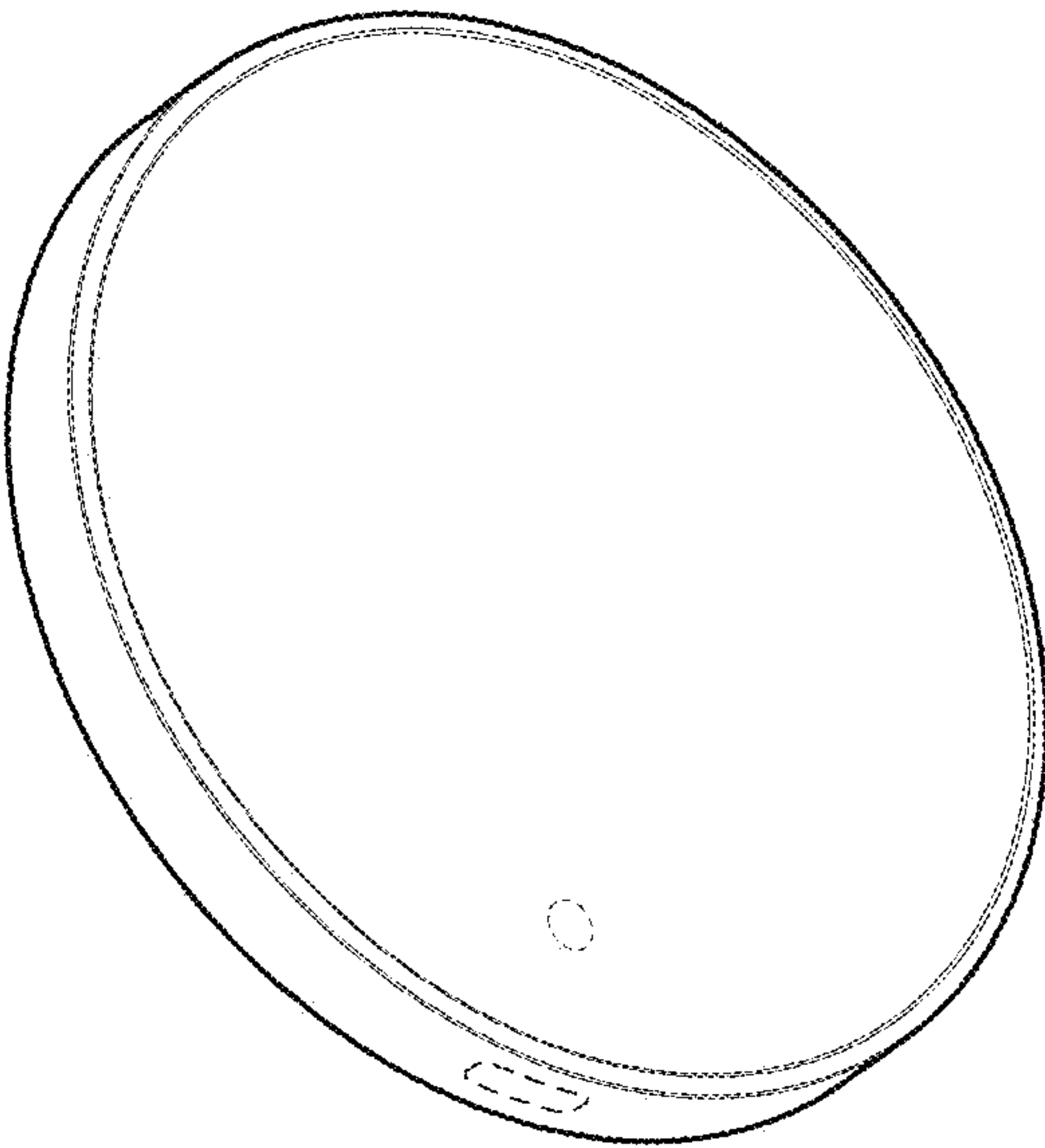

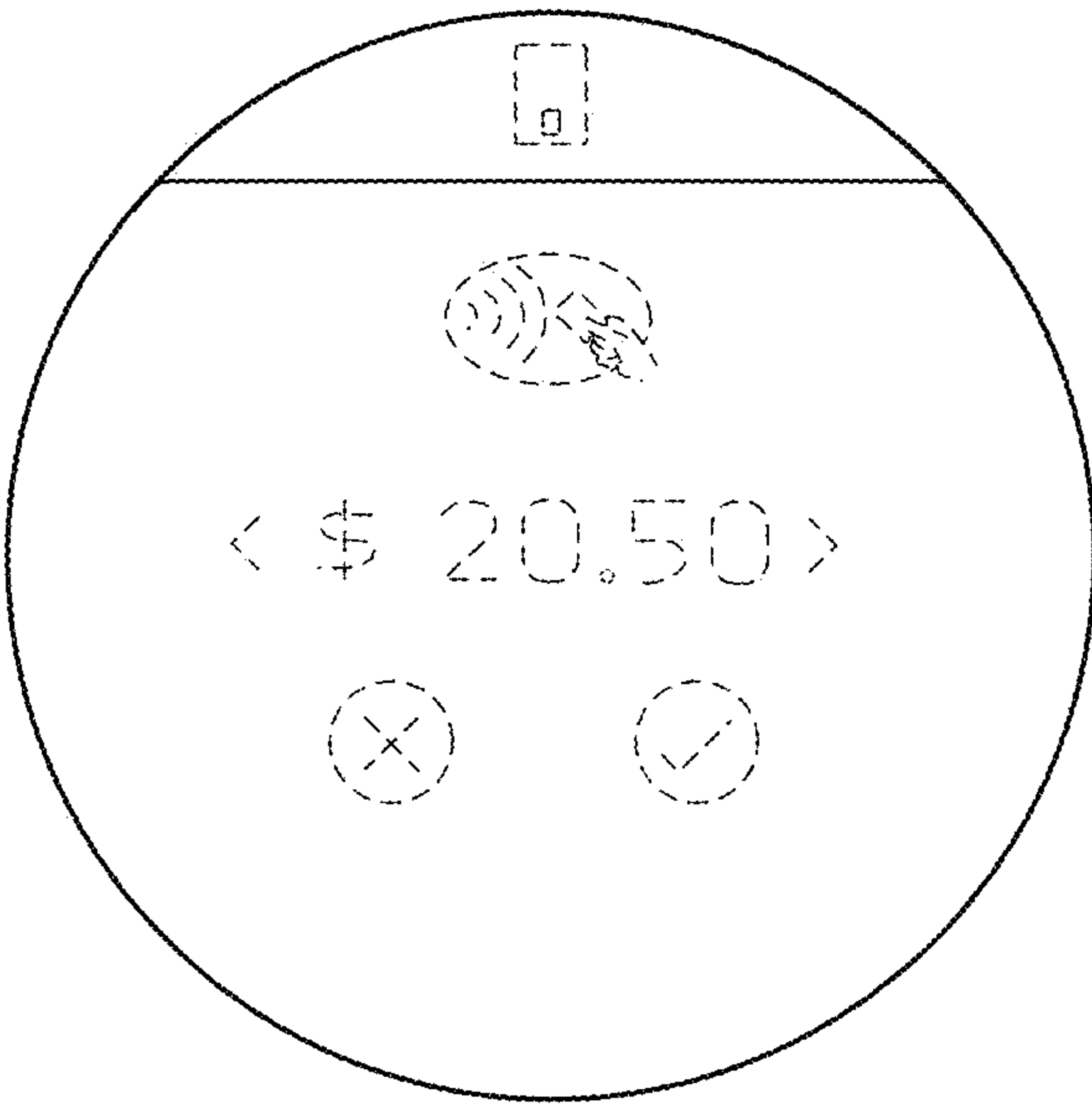
