DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right perspective view of the claimed design for a seat;

FIG. 2 is a second top, front, right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top view thereof;

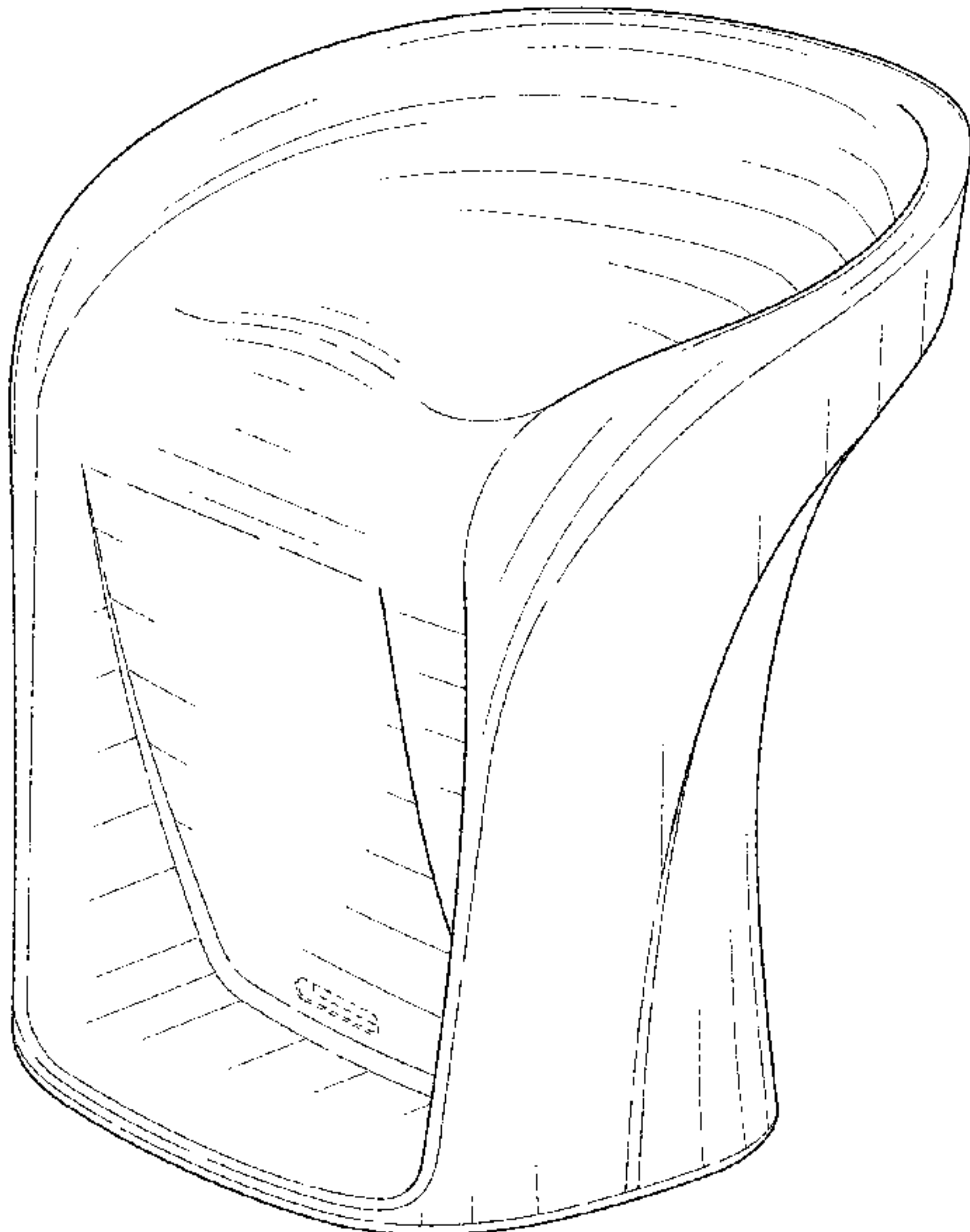
FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 9 is an enlarged, fragmentary, quarter-section view of FIG. 1, taken along cutting plane lines 9-9 shown in FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 10 is an enlarged, fragmentary, quarter-section, top, rear, right perspective view of the claimed design, taken along cutting plane lines 10-10 shown in FIG. 8.

The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area depict boundaries of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The broken lines showing the remainder of the seat depict environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design. The unshaded regions within the shaded area that are demarcated by broken lines form no part of the claimed design. The cutting plane lines, section lines and break lines in FIGS. 7-10 are drafting conventions and form no part of the claimed design.

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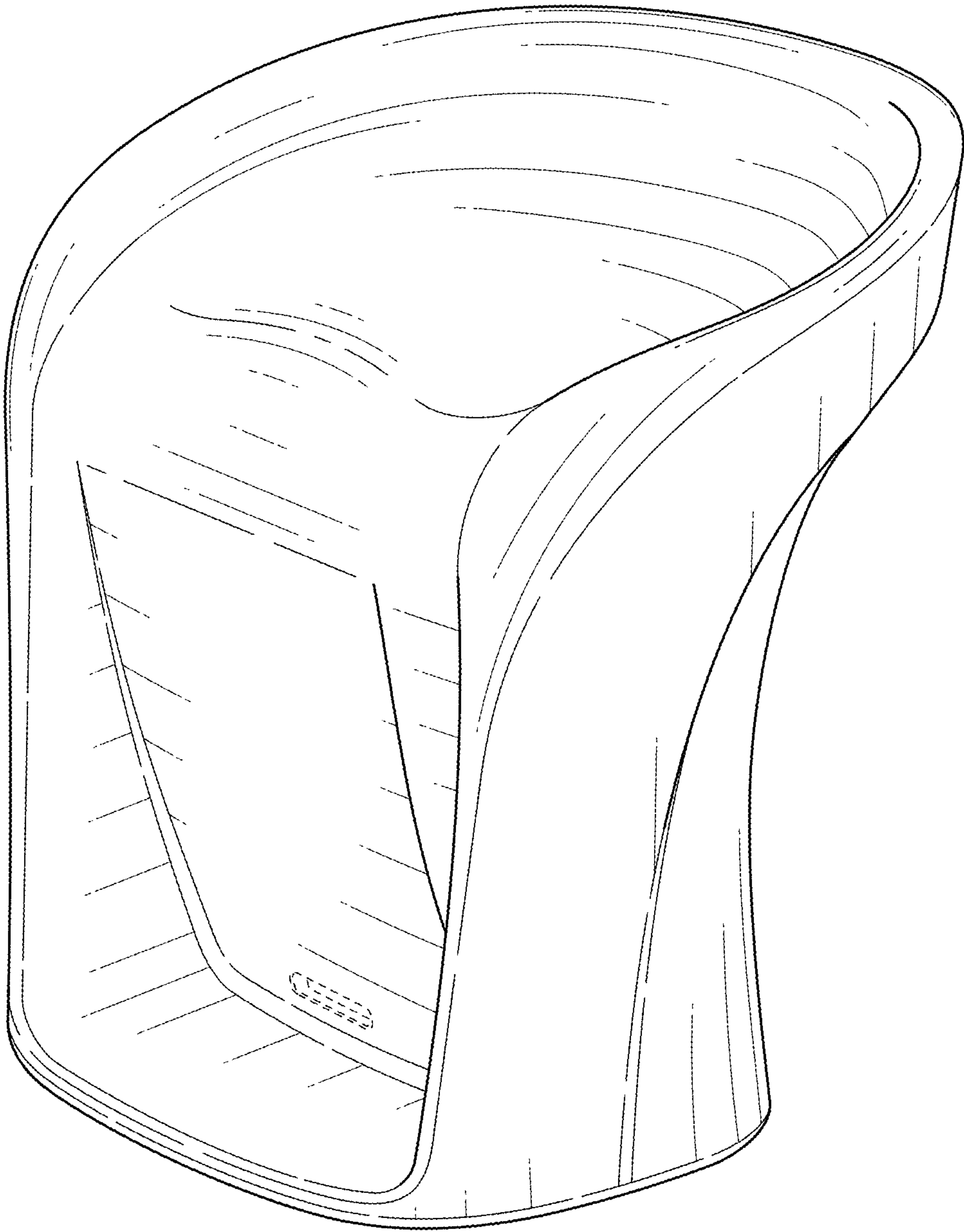

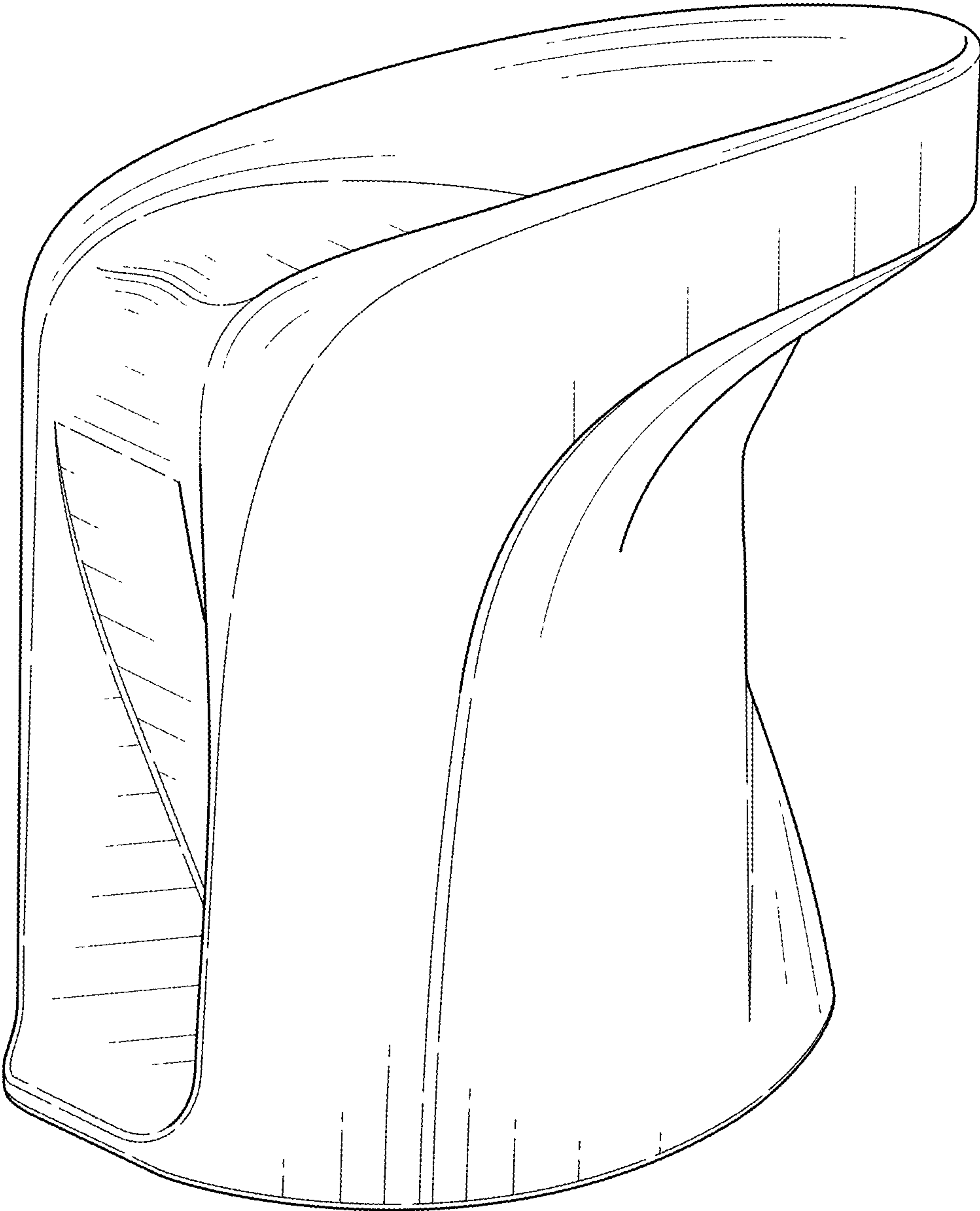

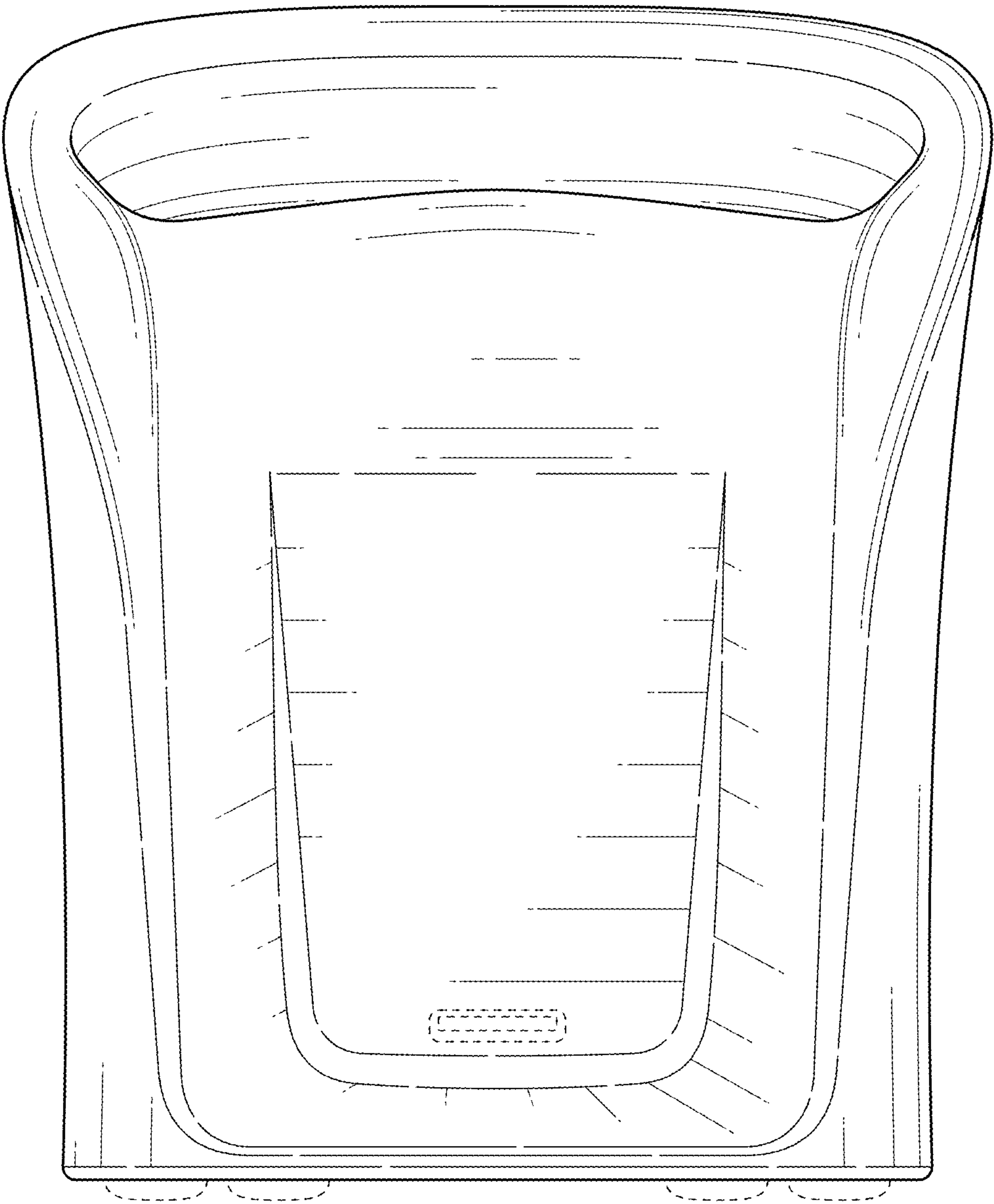

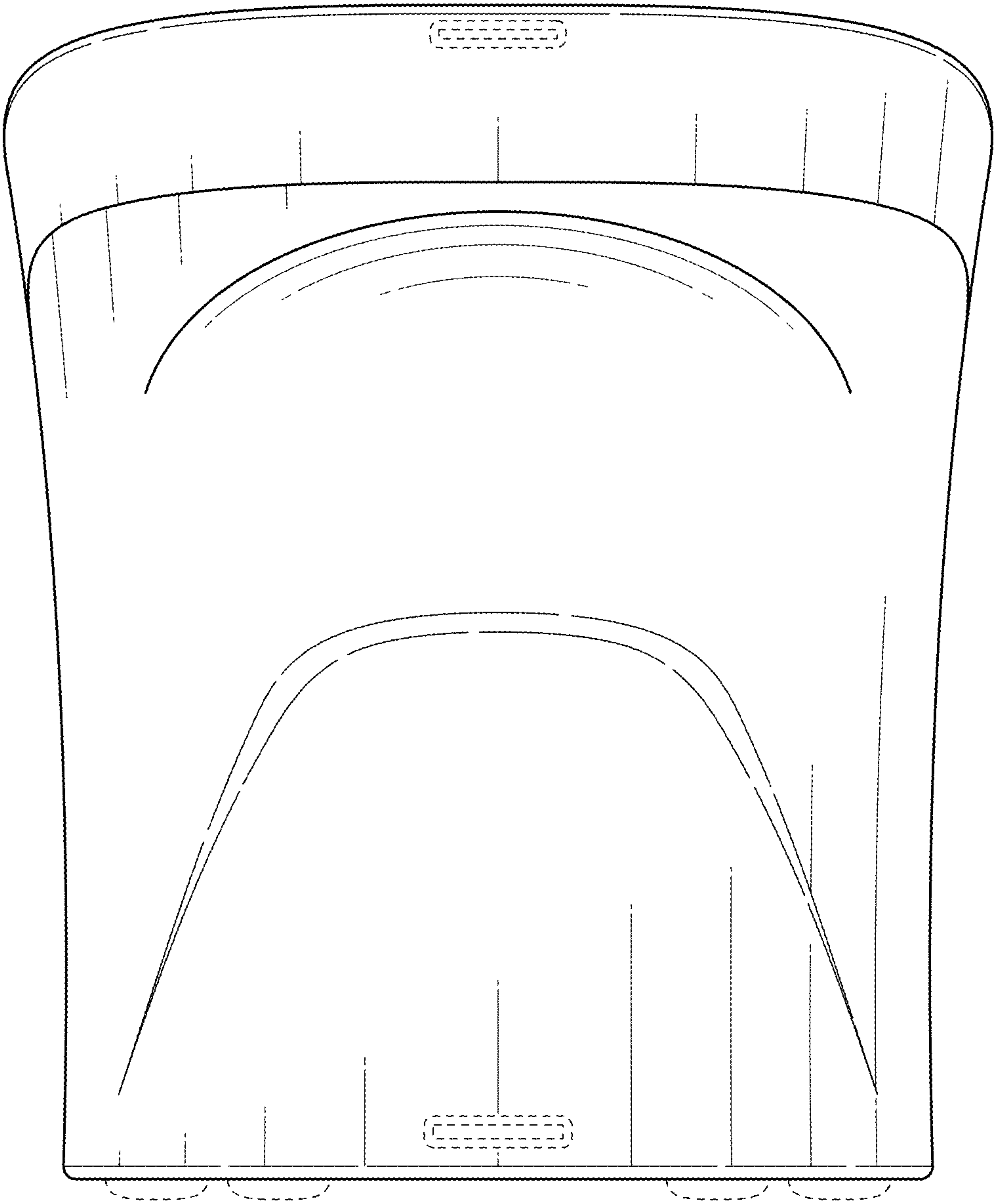

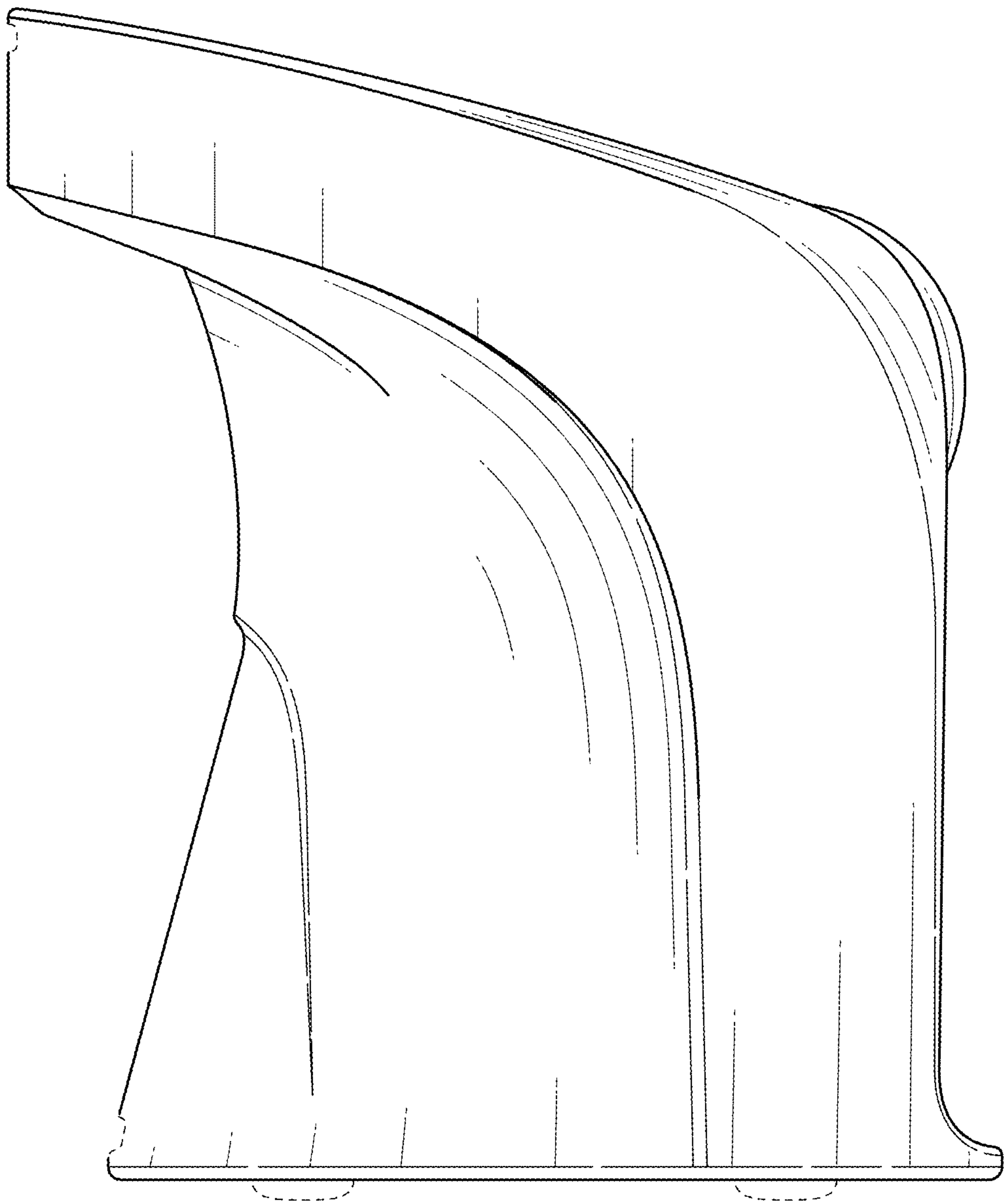

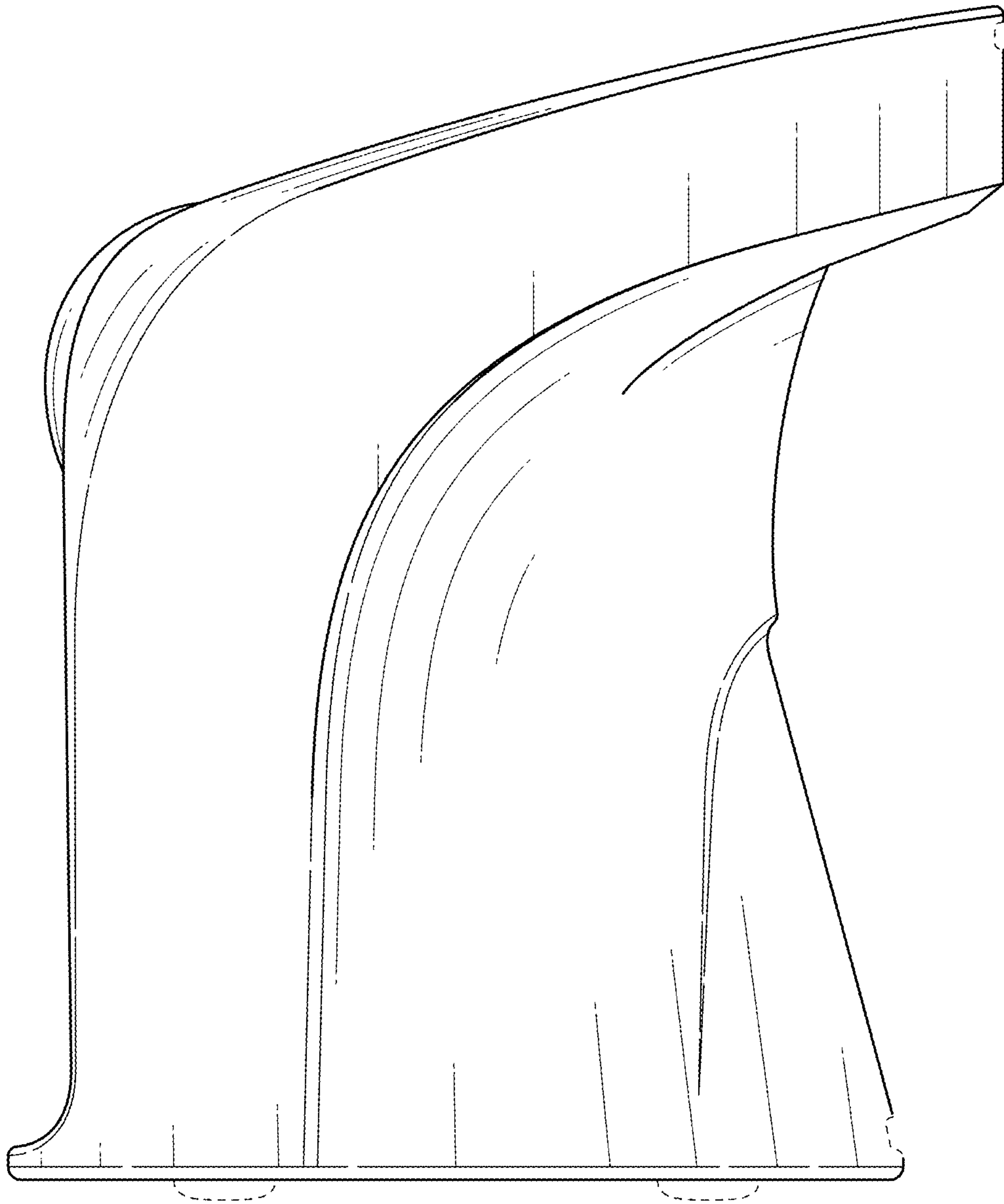

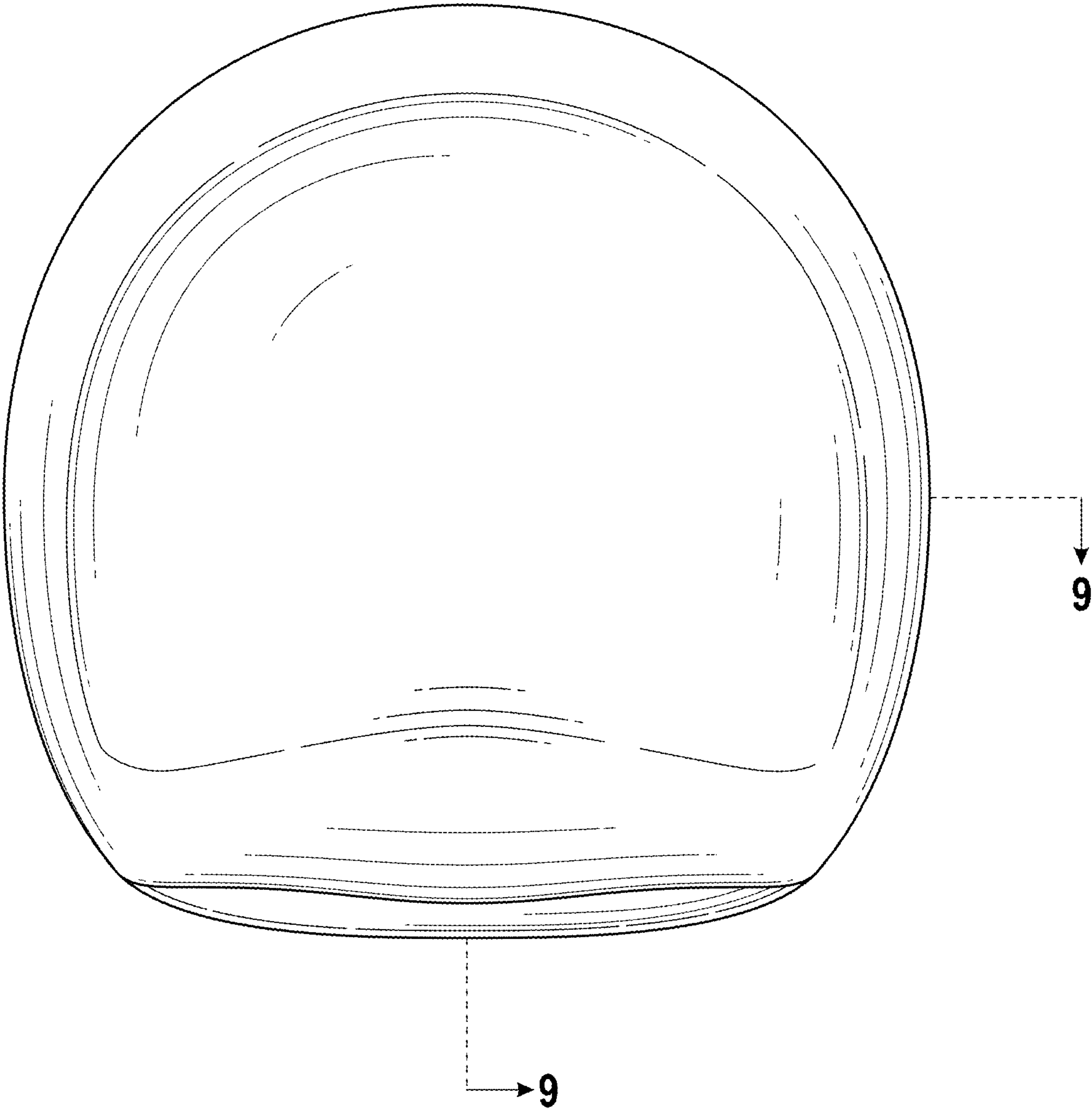

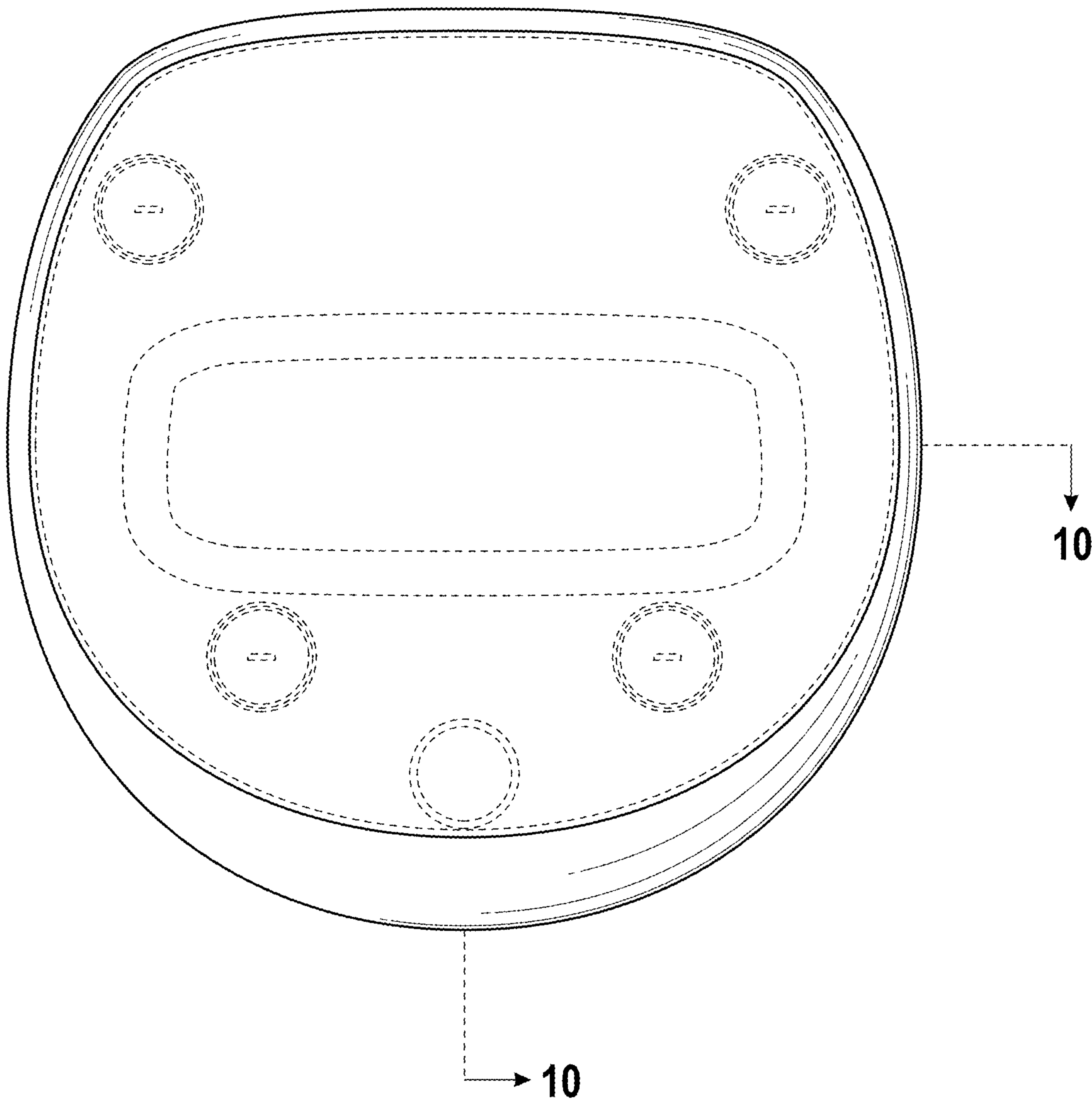

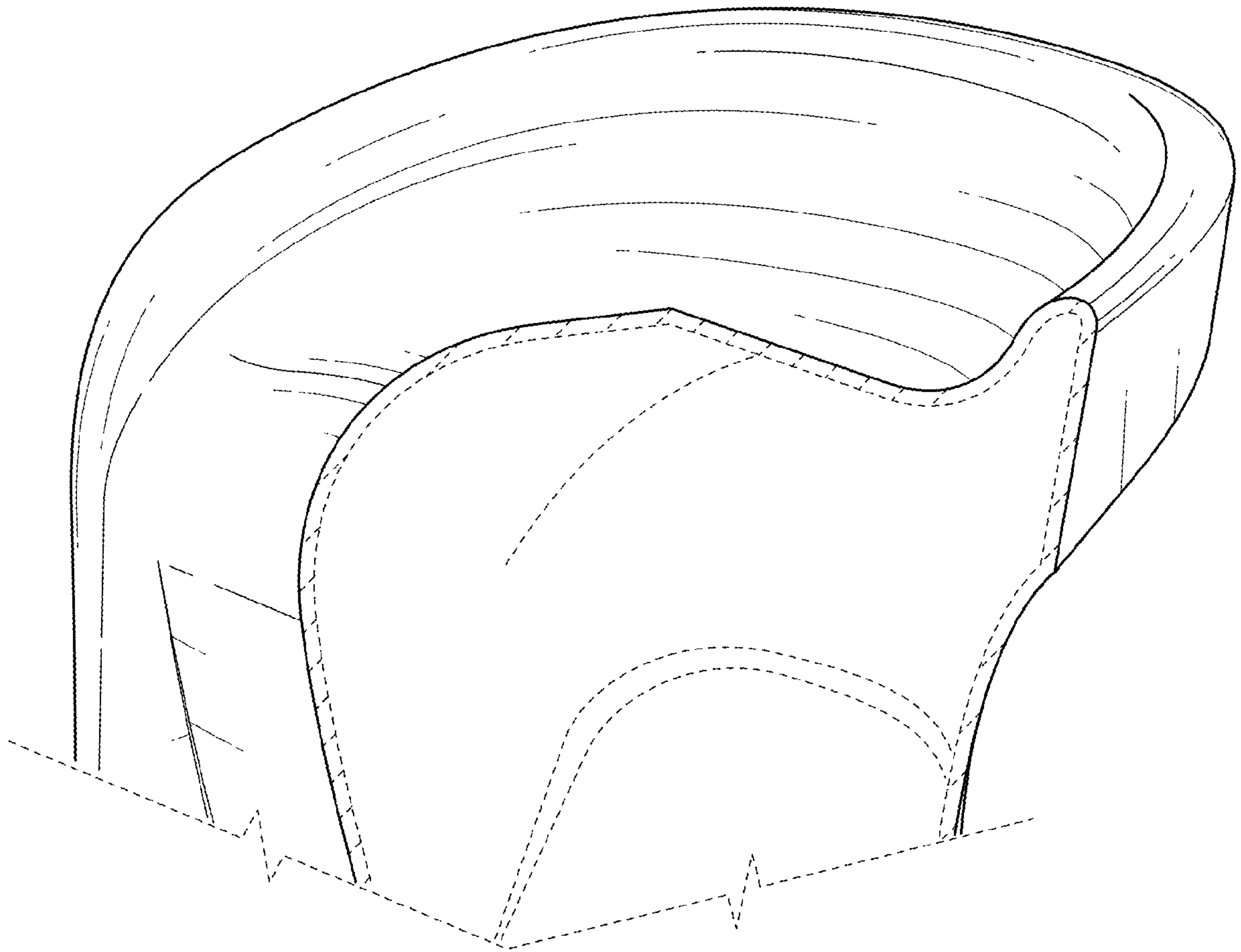

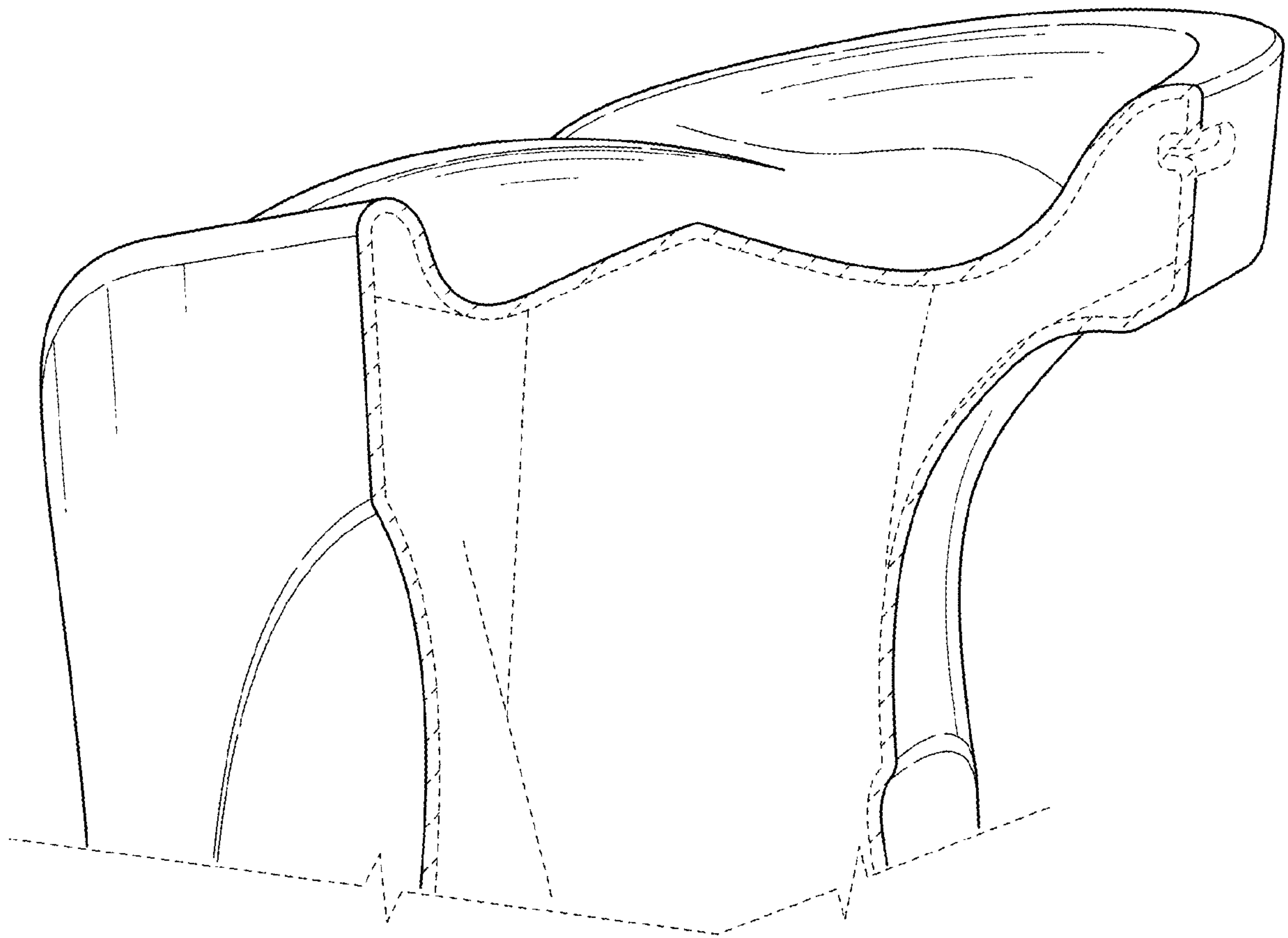
