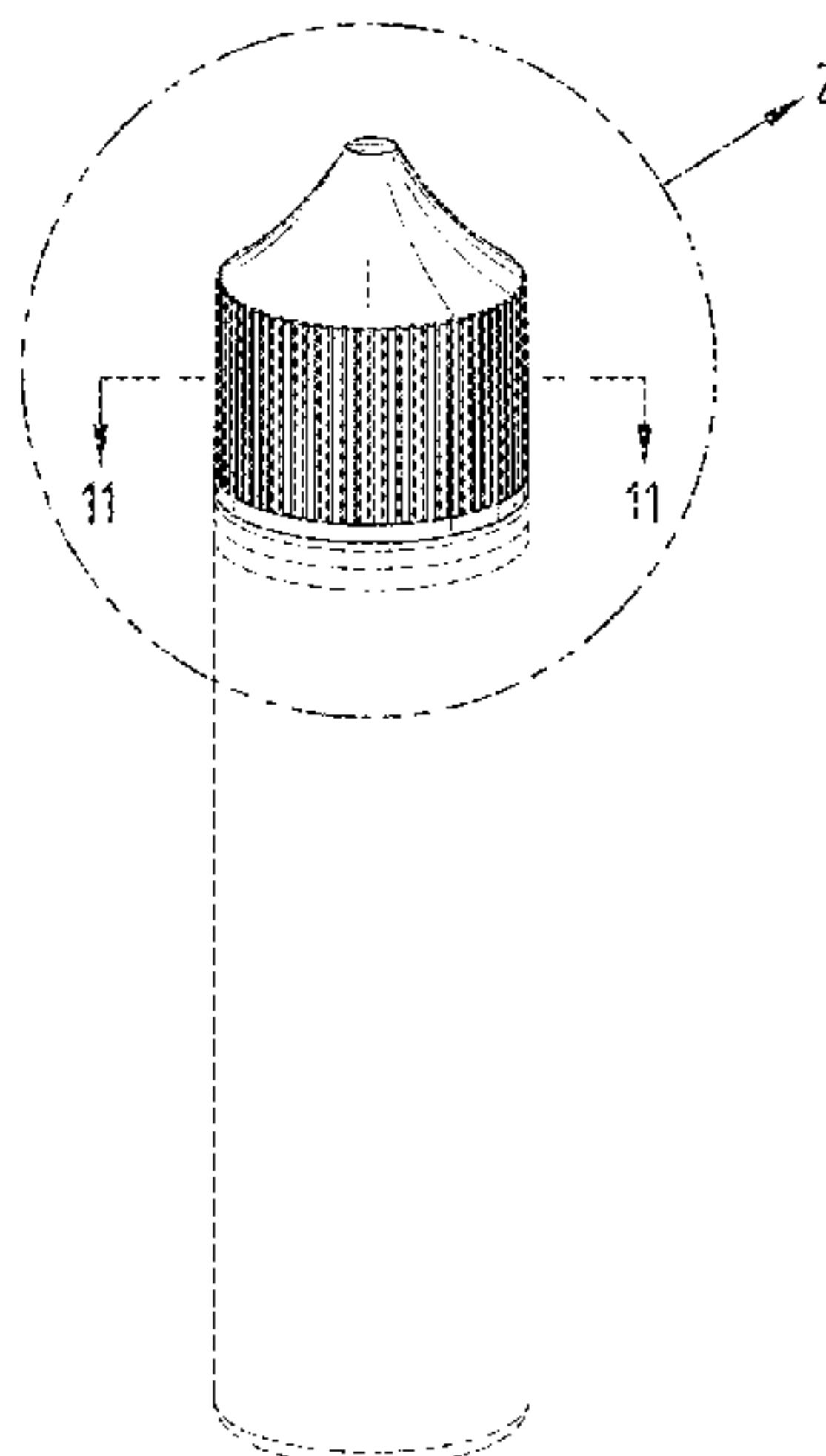

DESCRIPTION

None of the broken lines form any part of the claimed design.

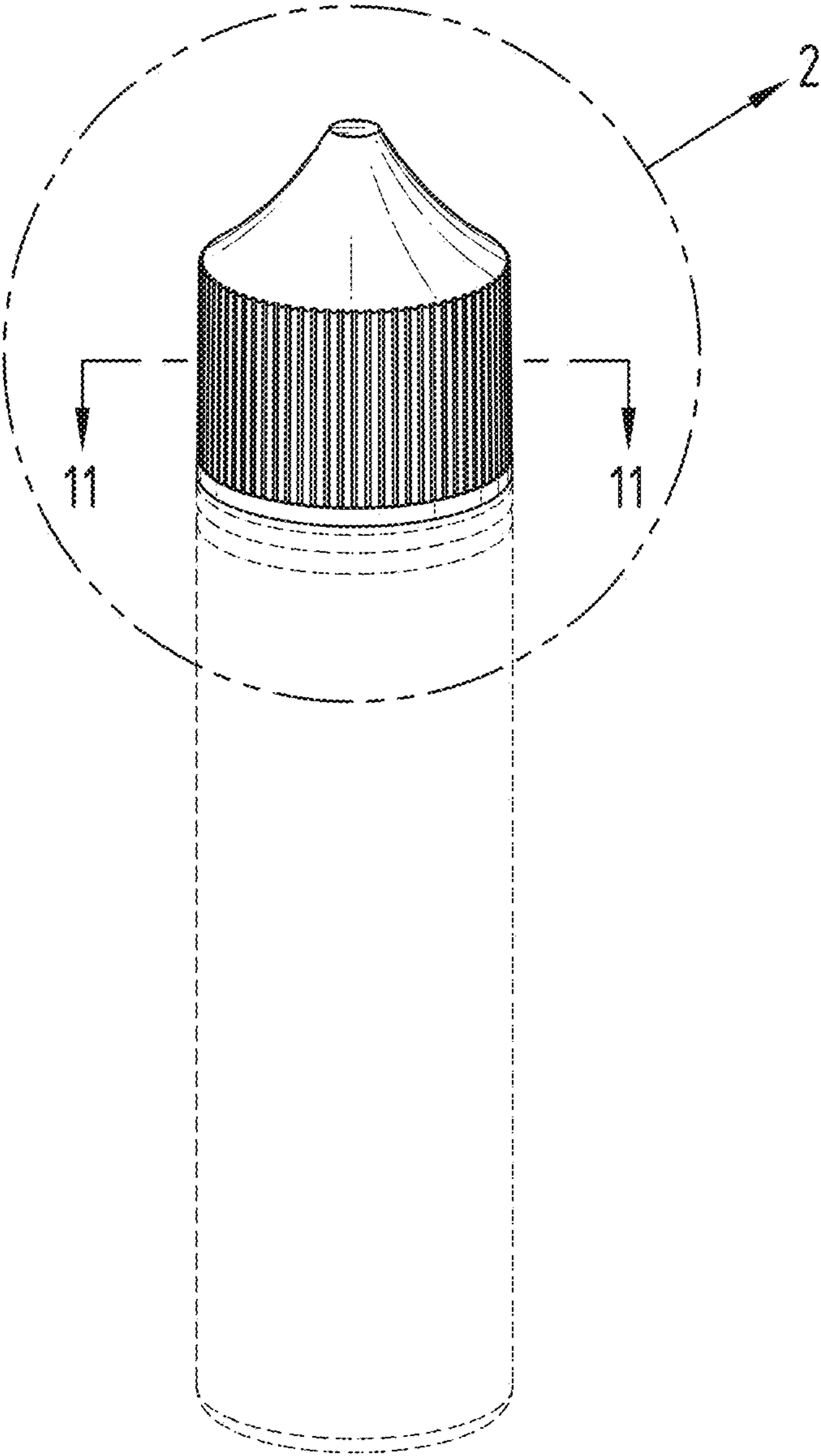

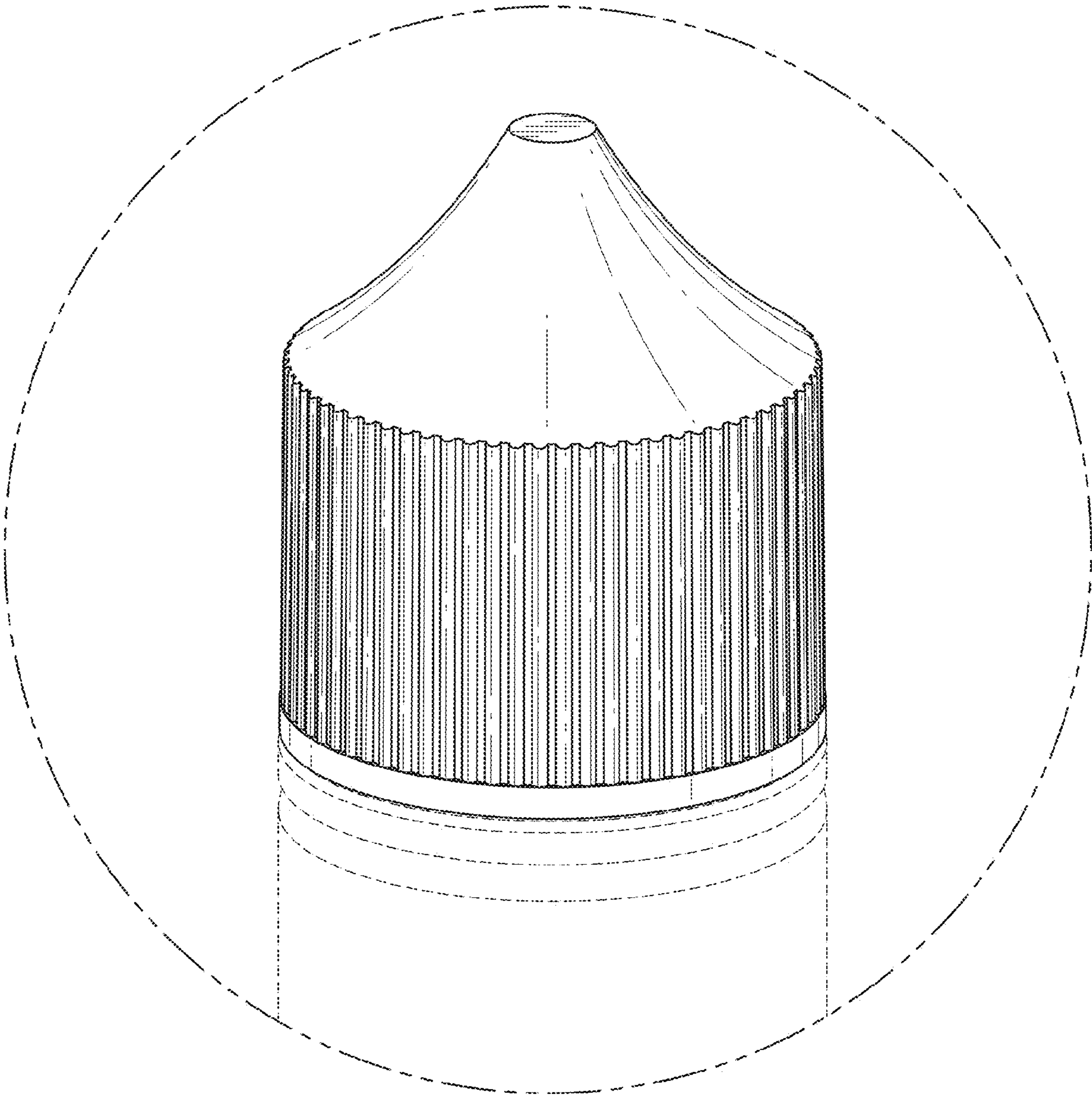


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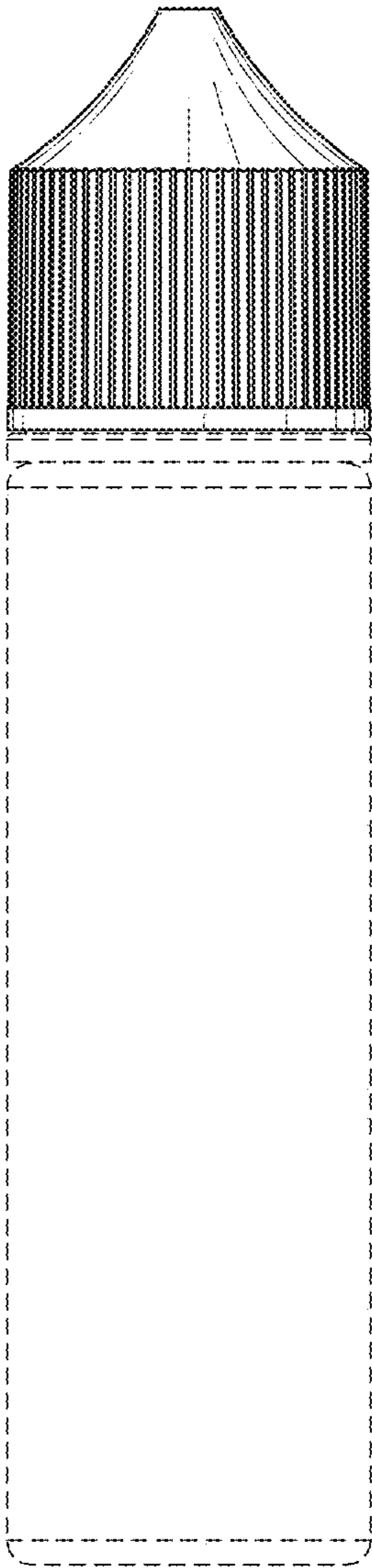


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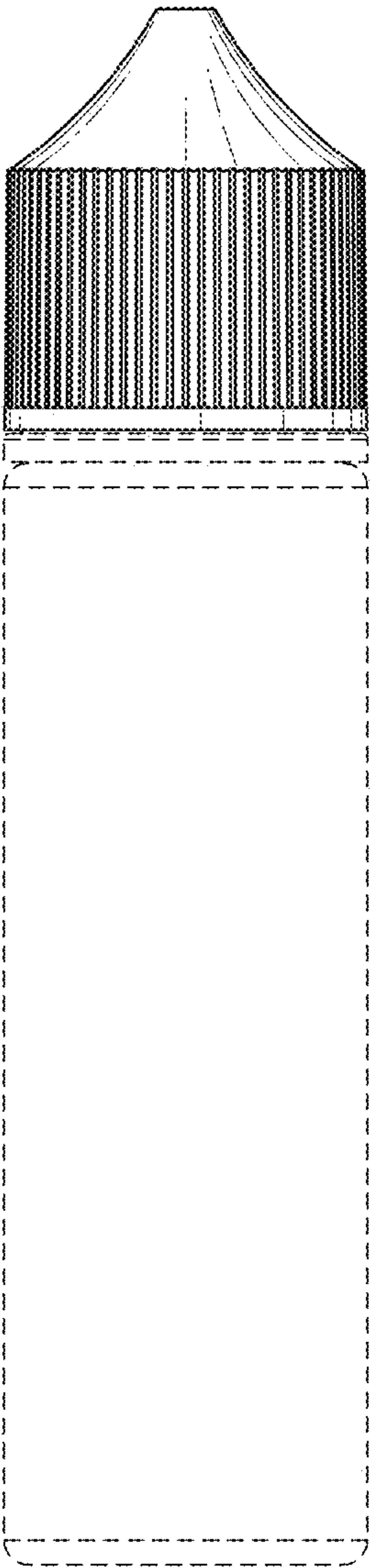

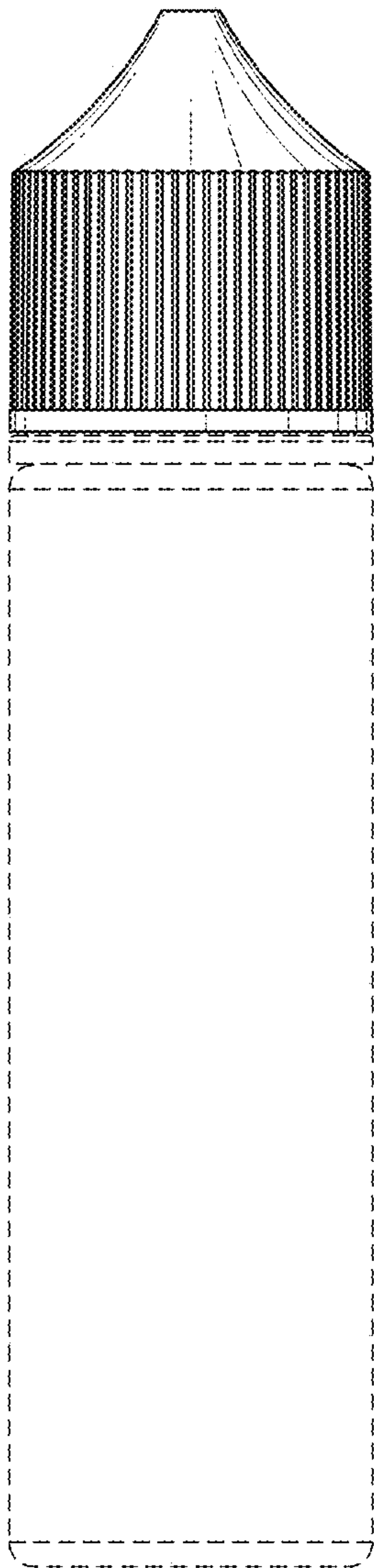

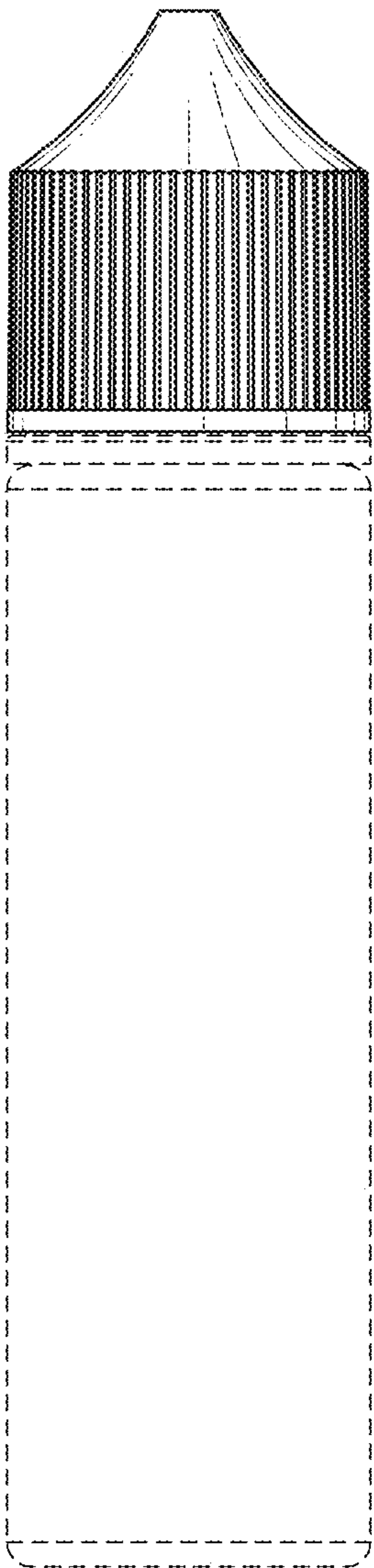


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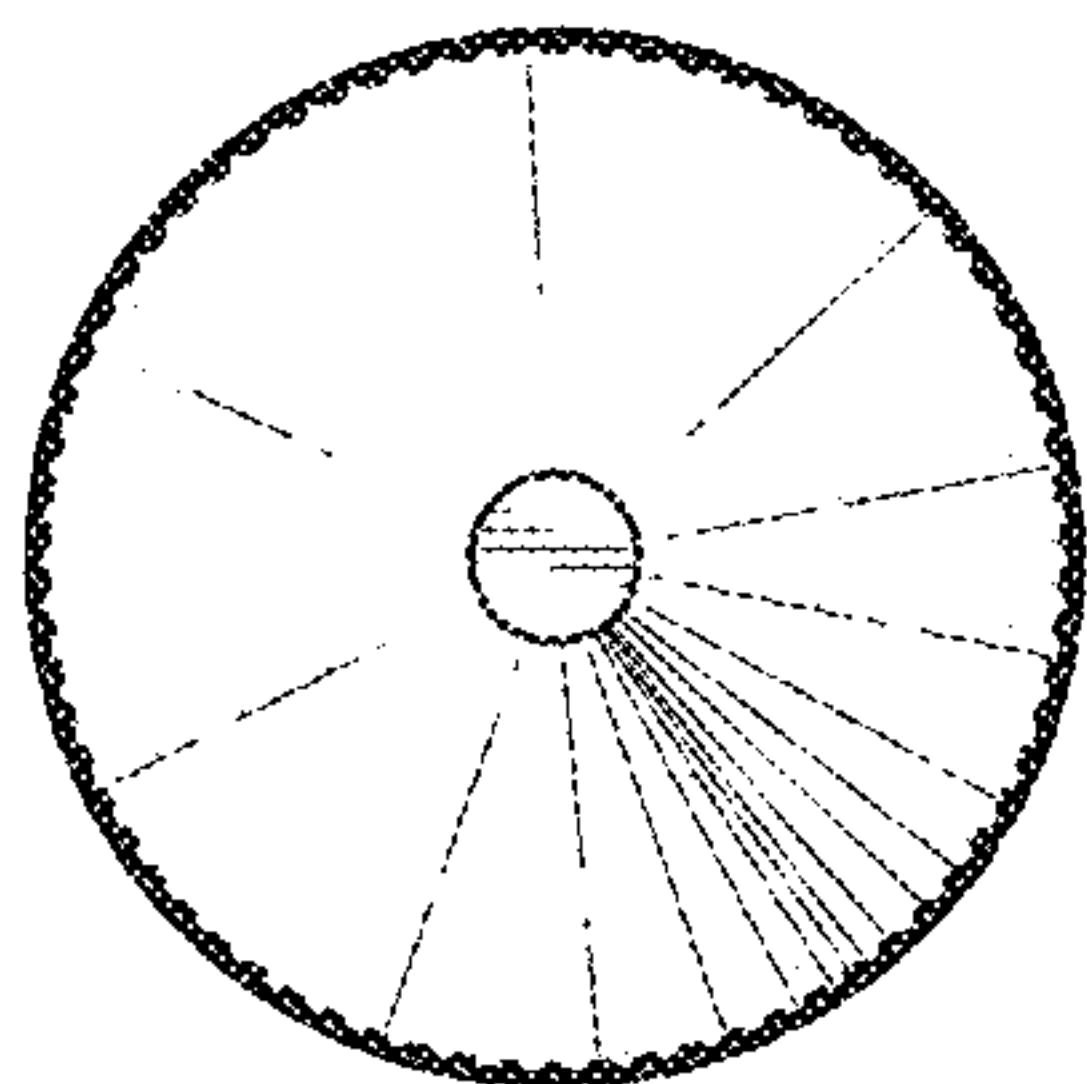

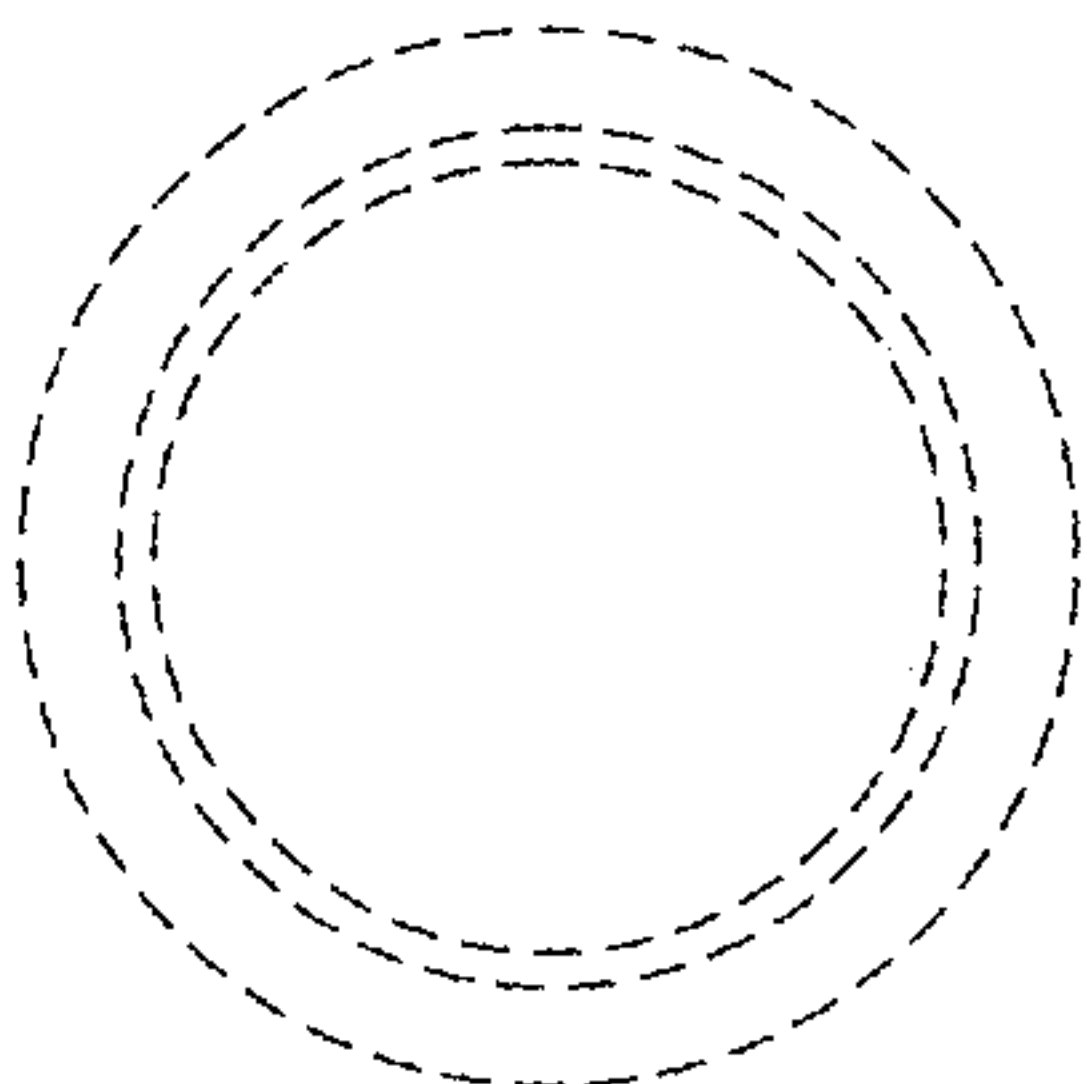

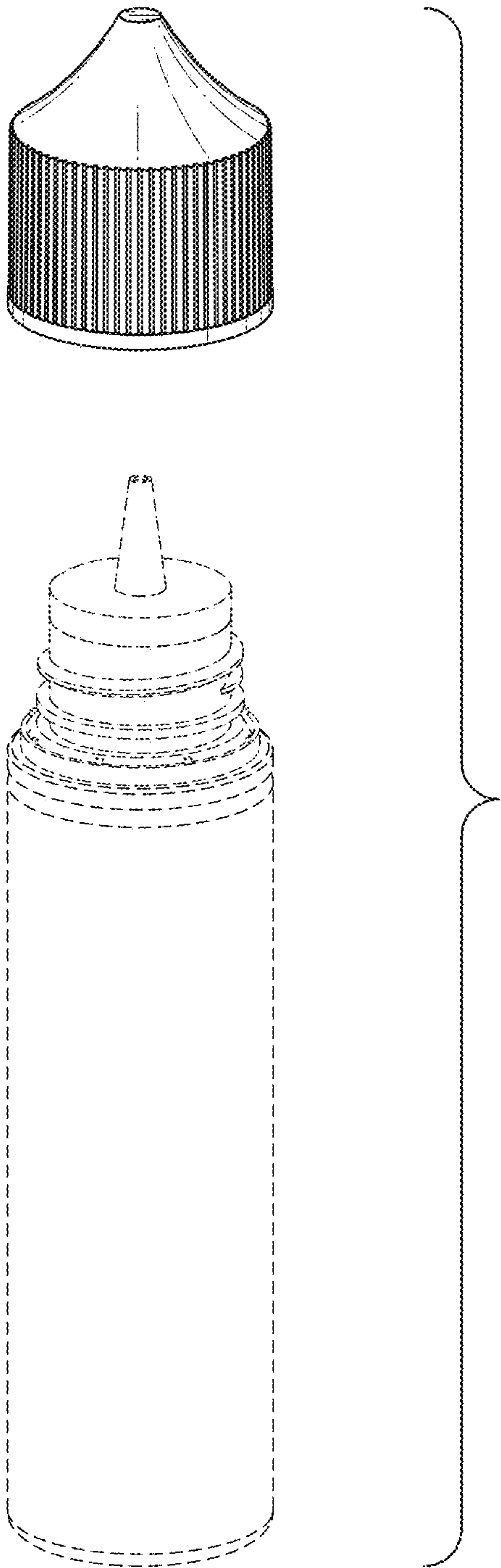

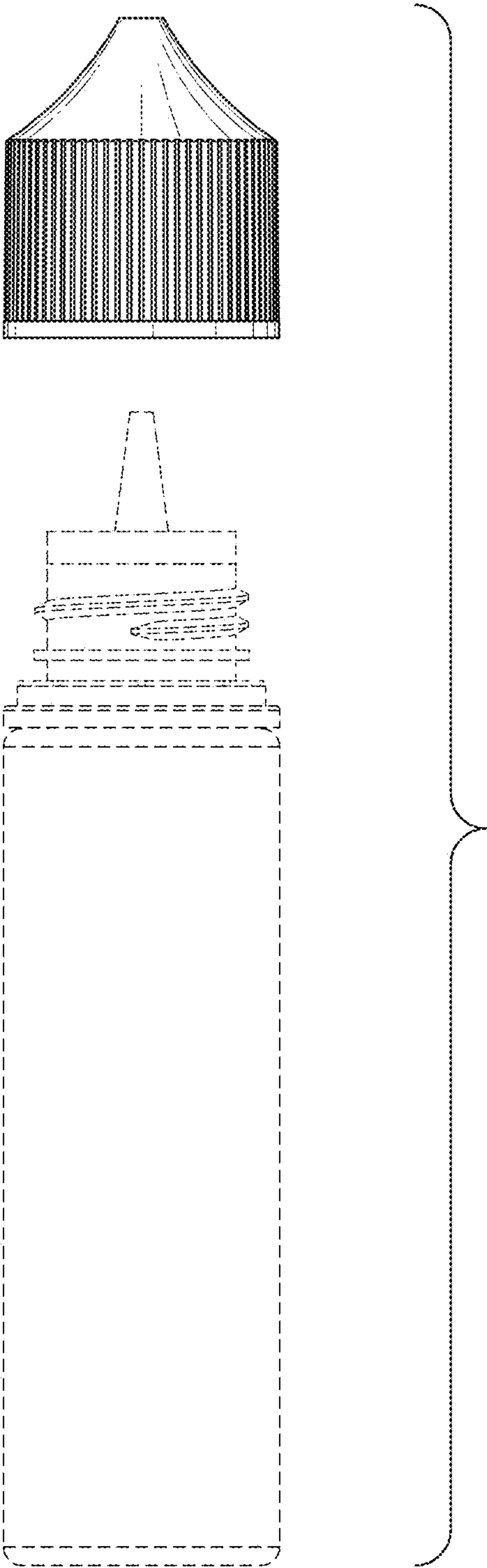

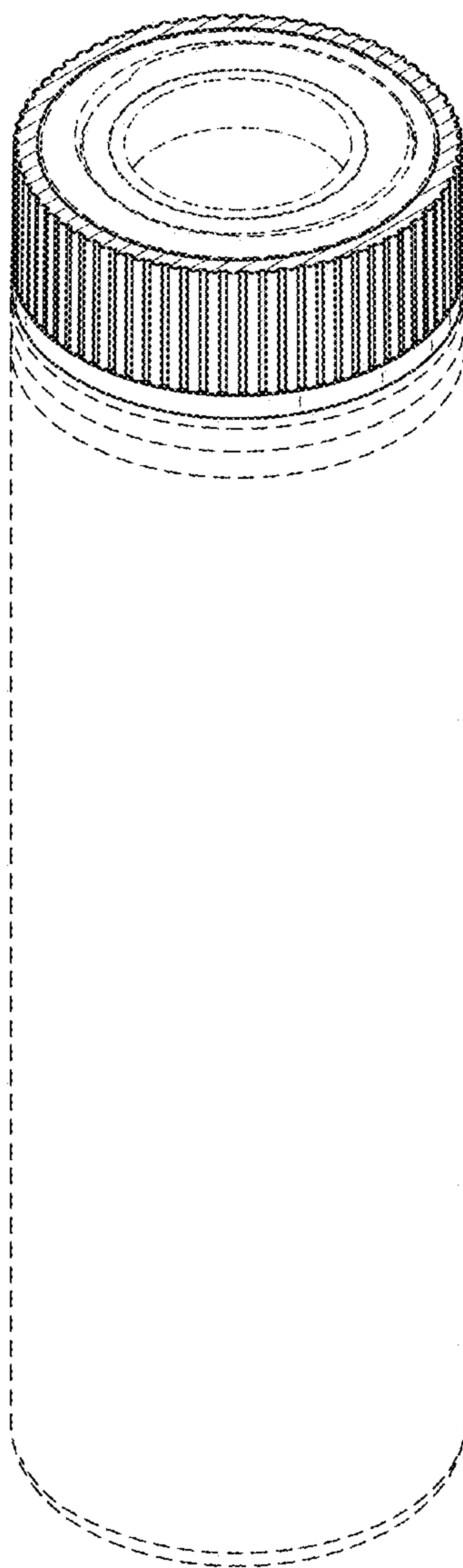

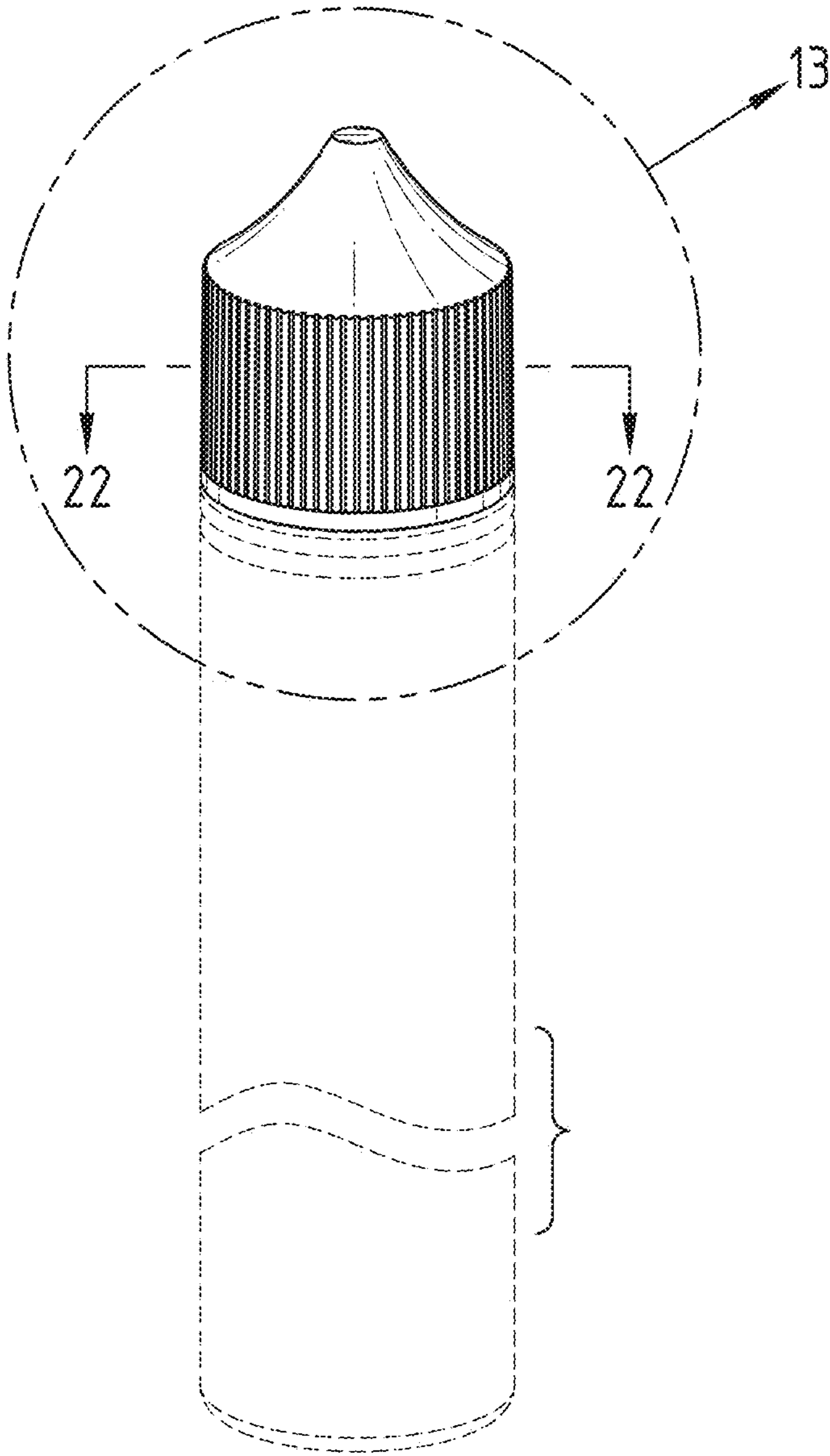

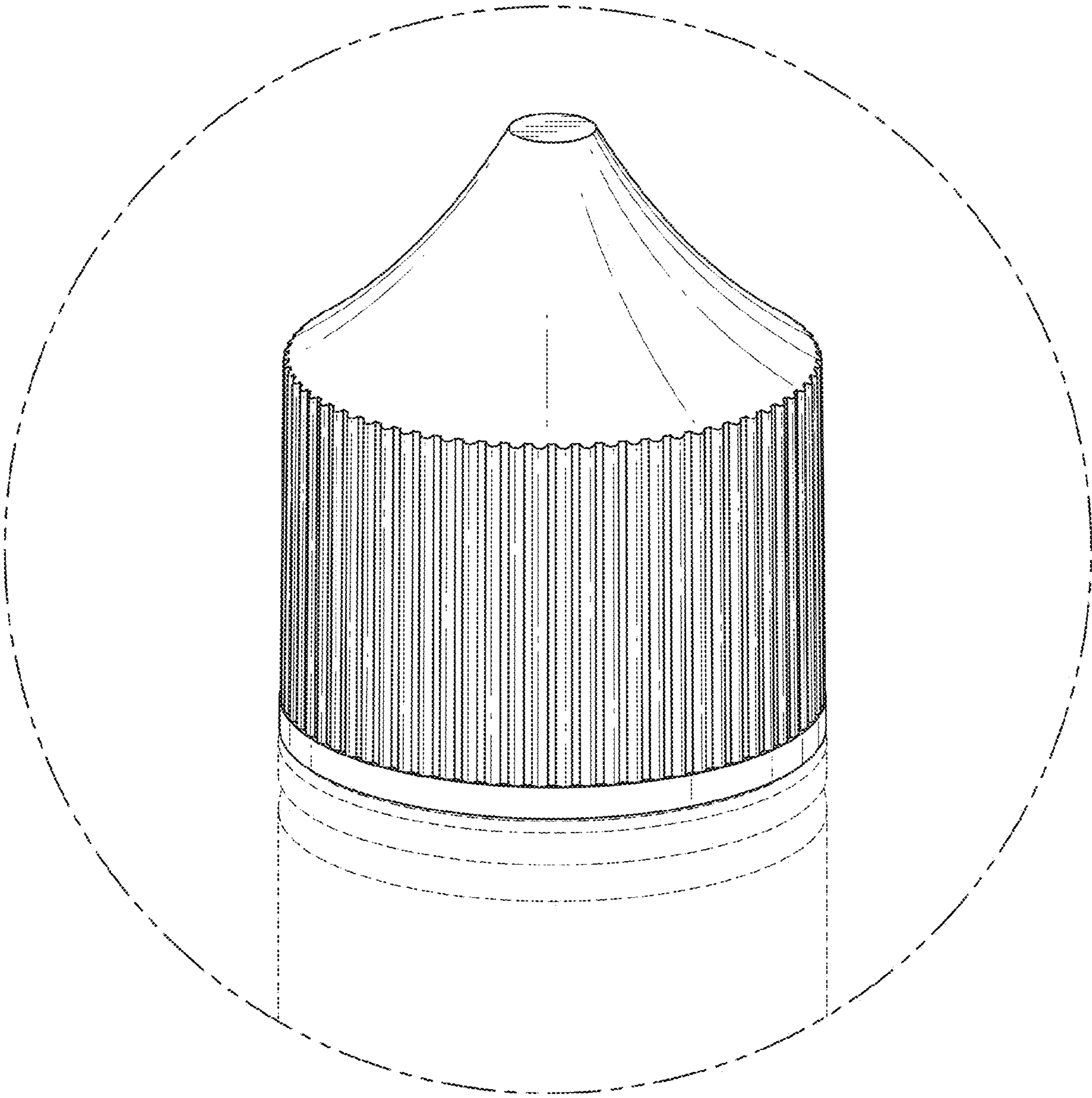

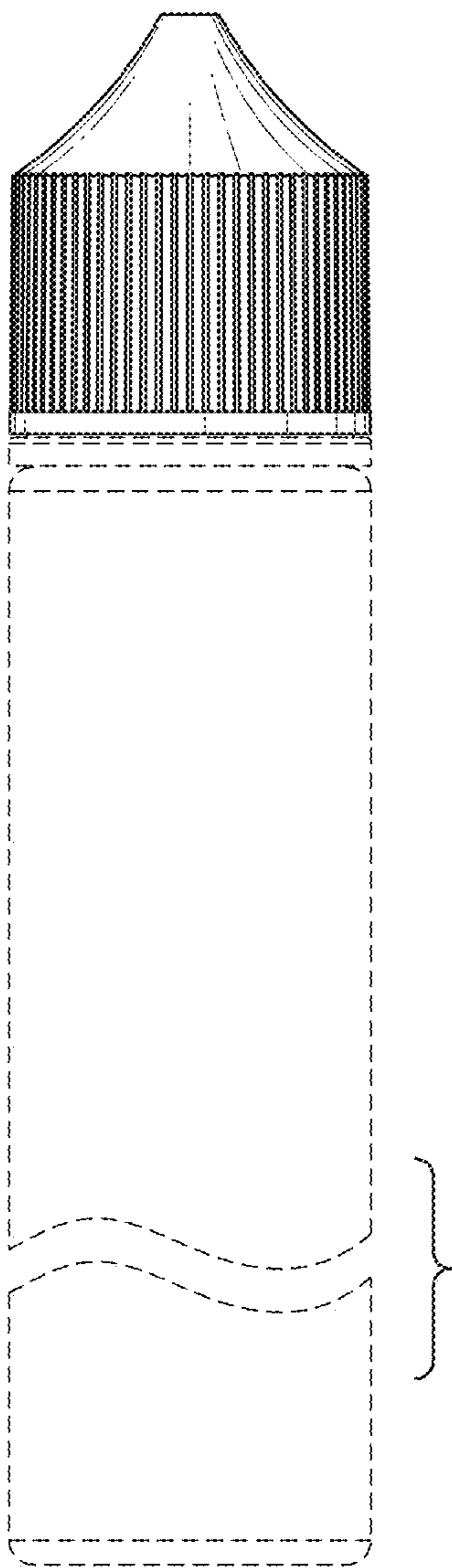

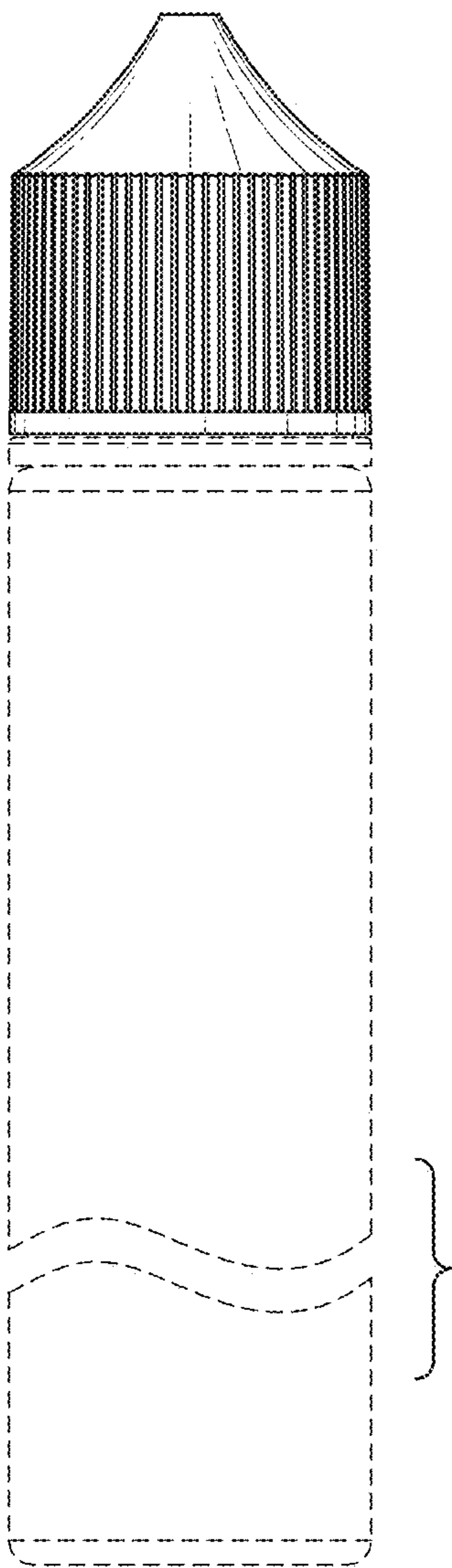

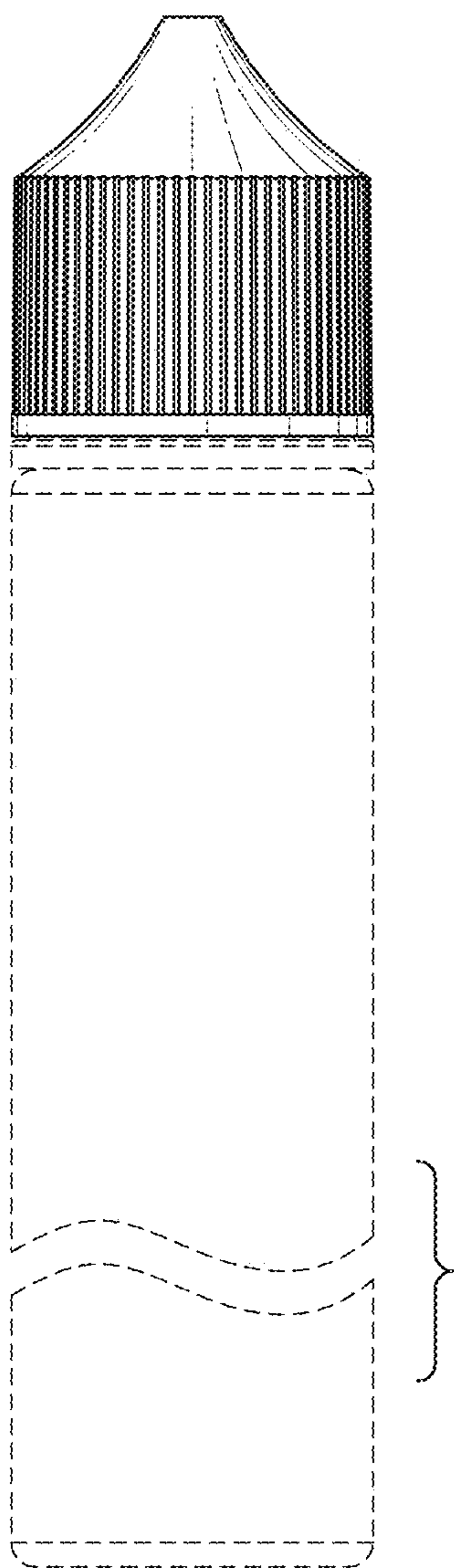

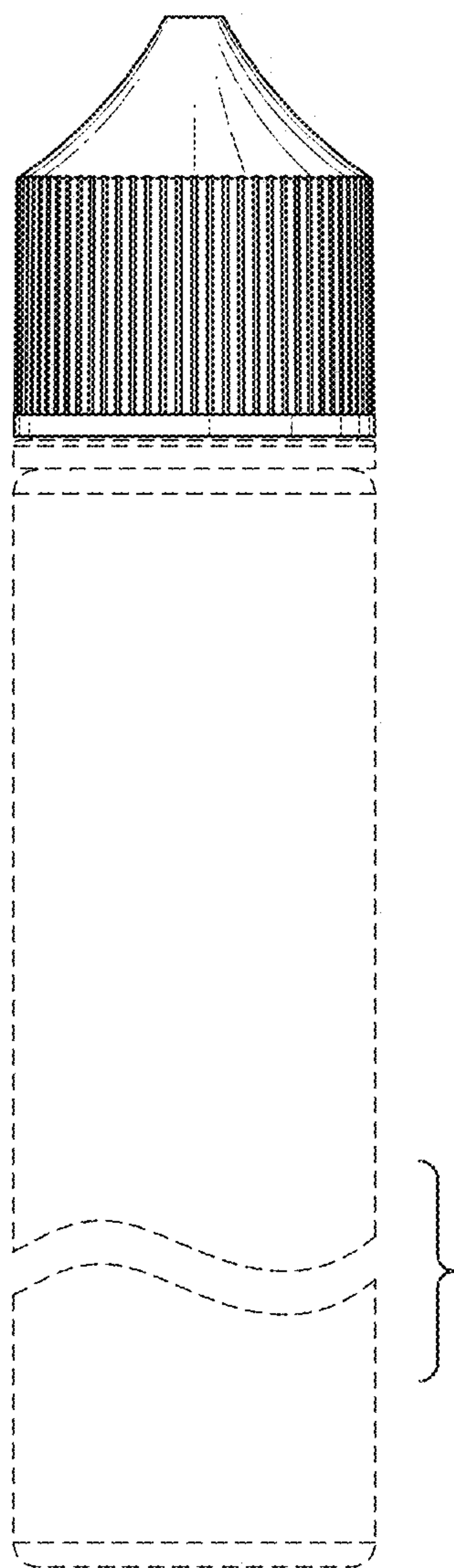

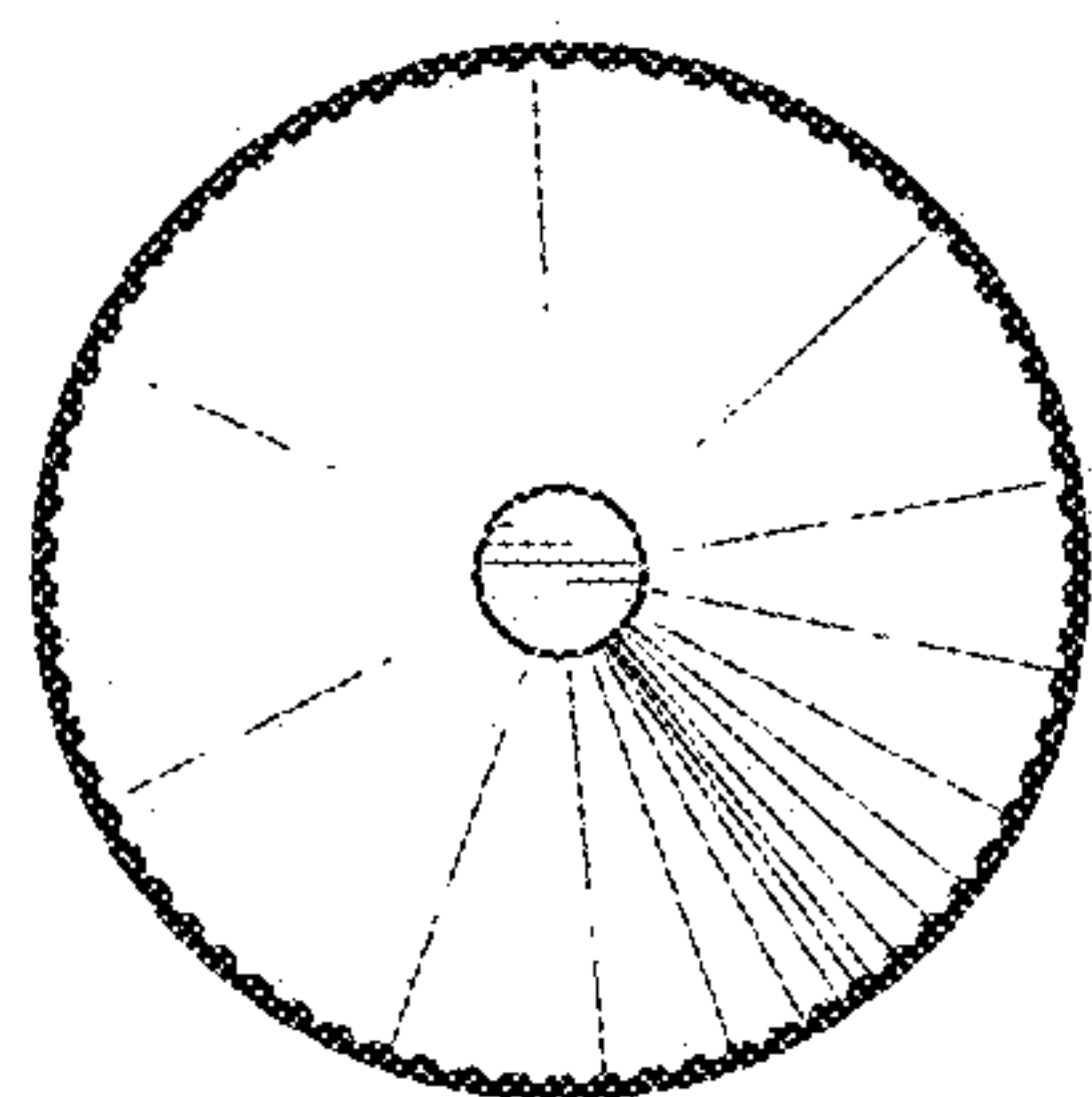

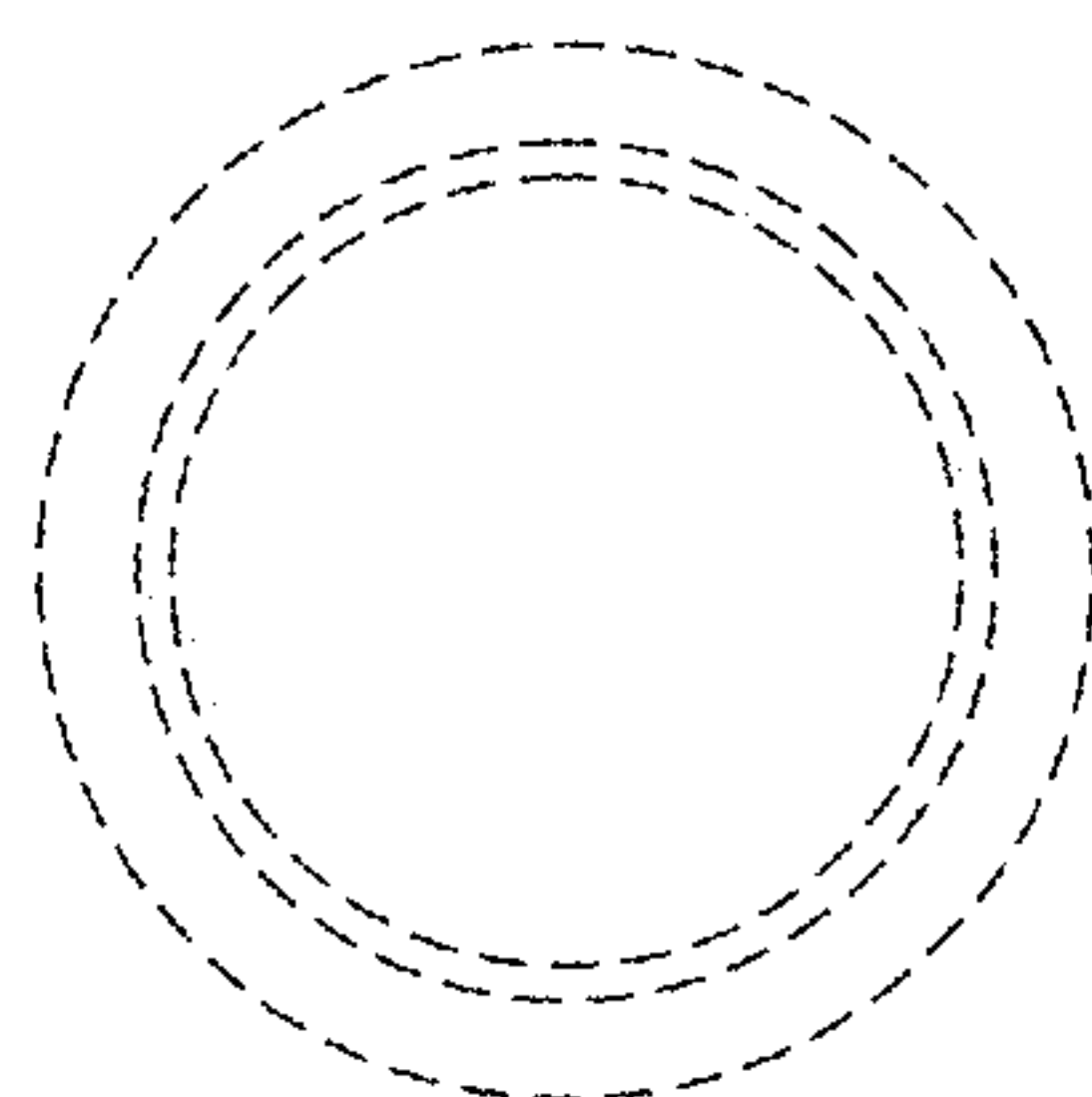

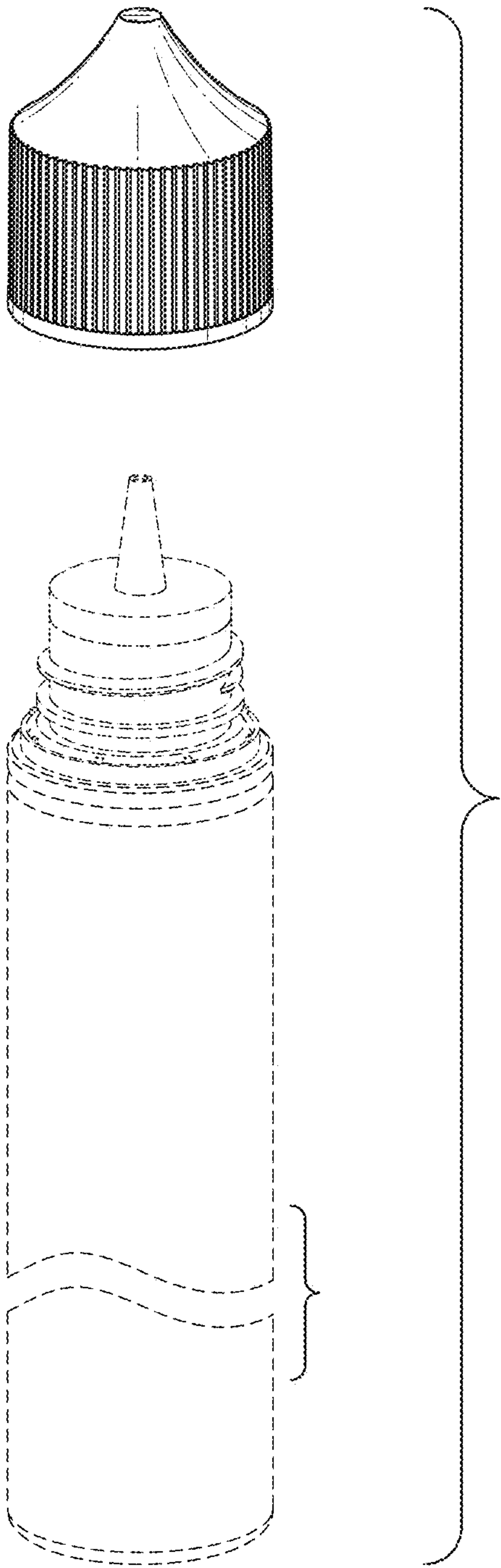

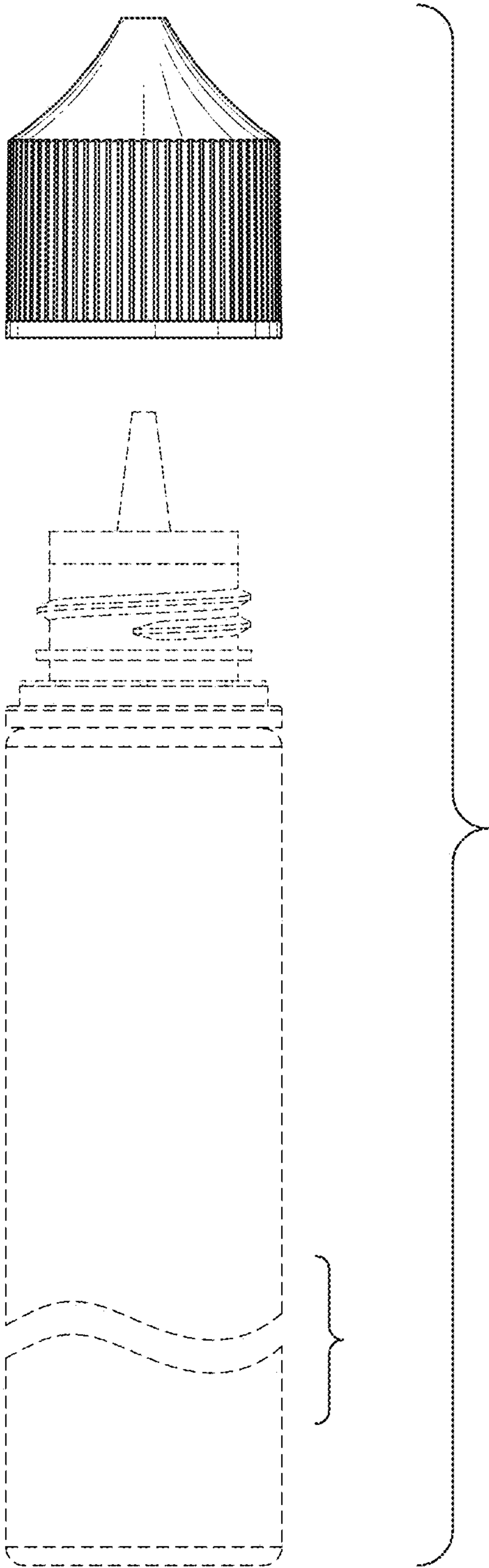

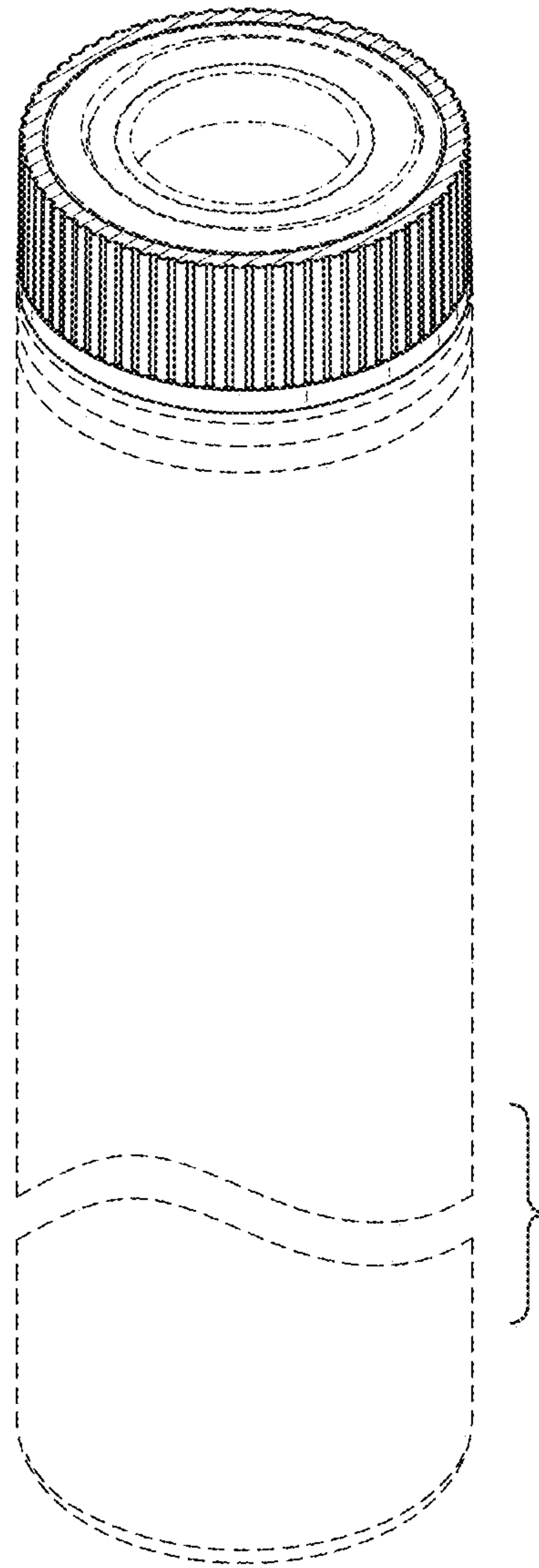

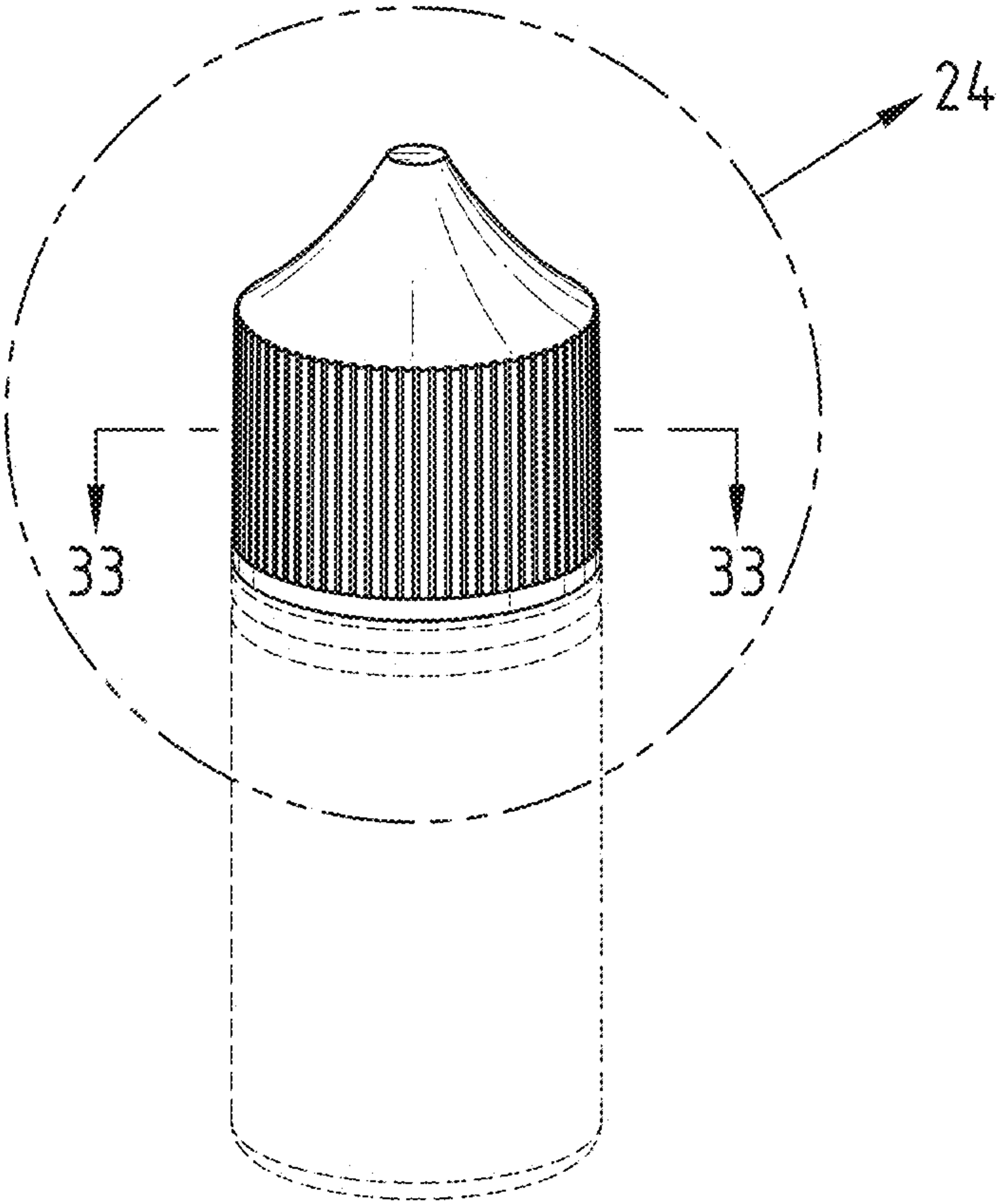

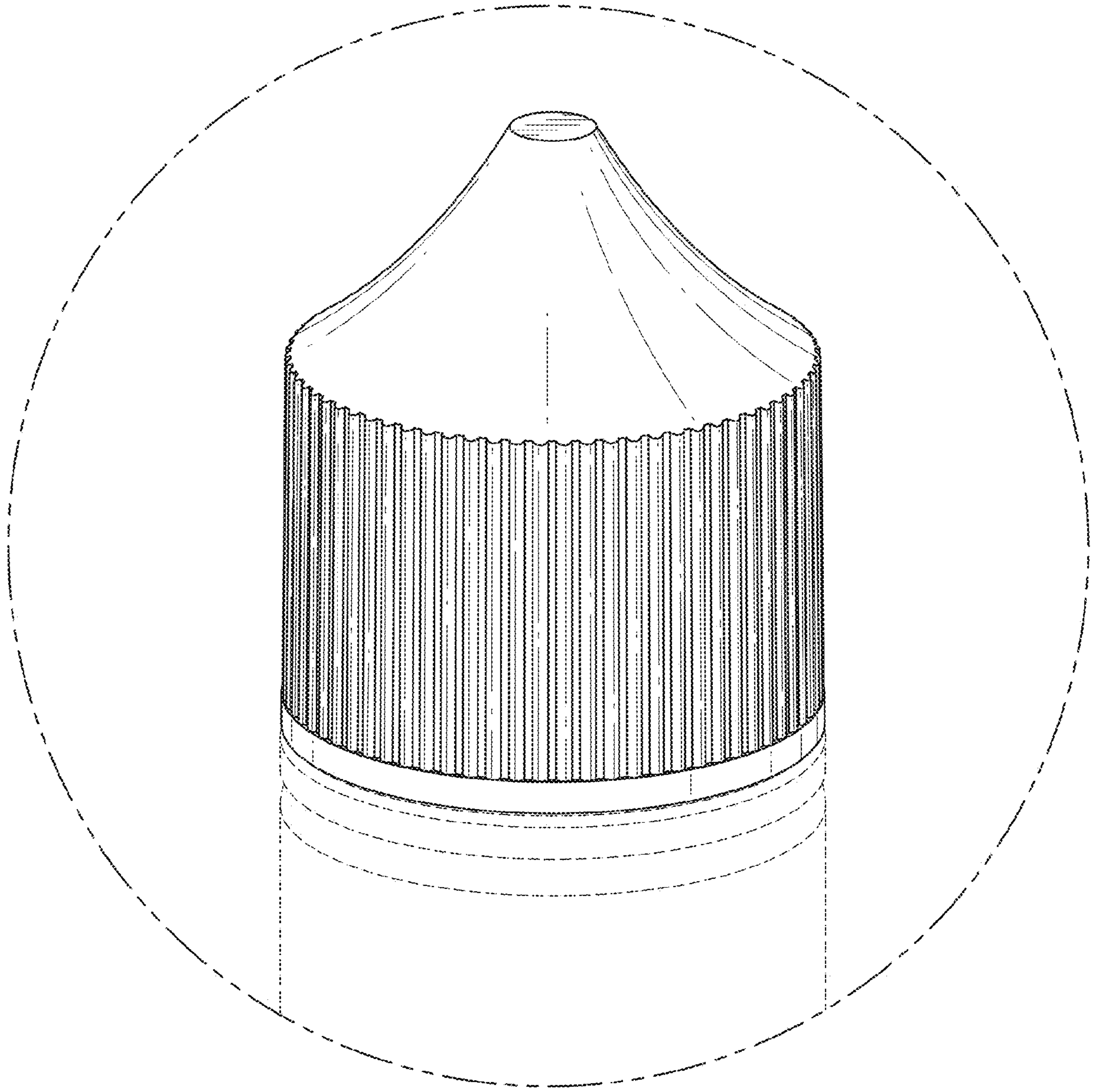

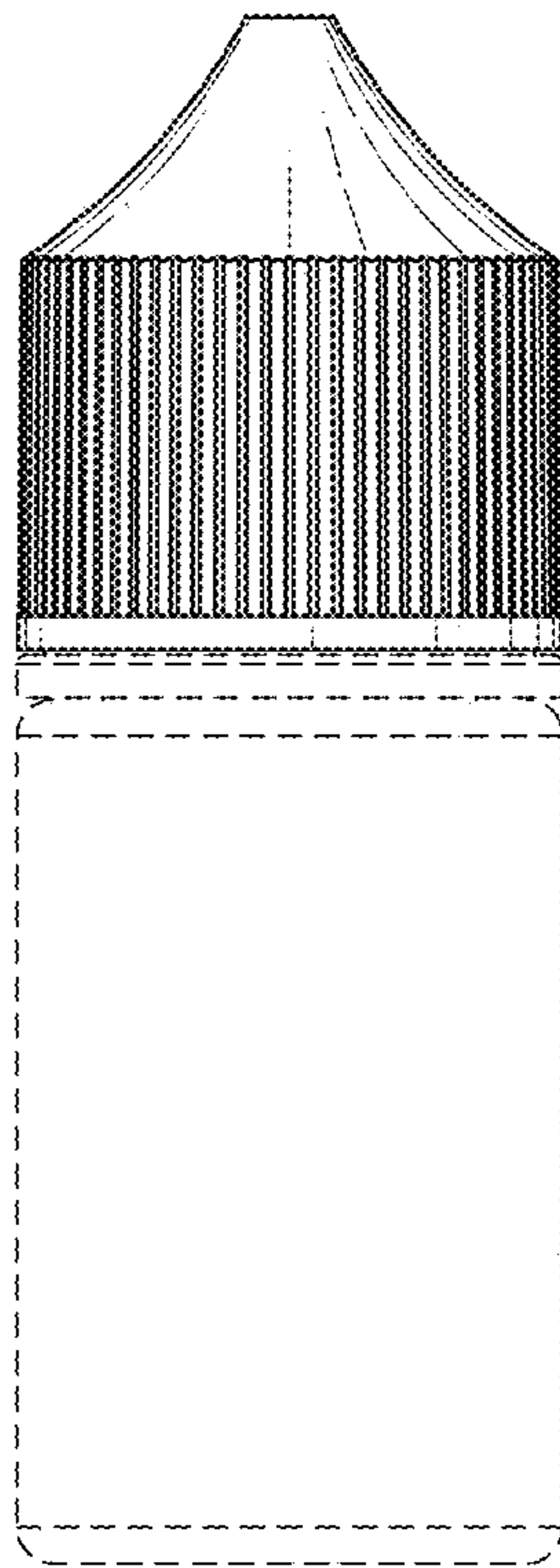

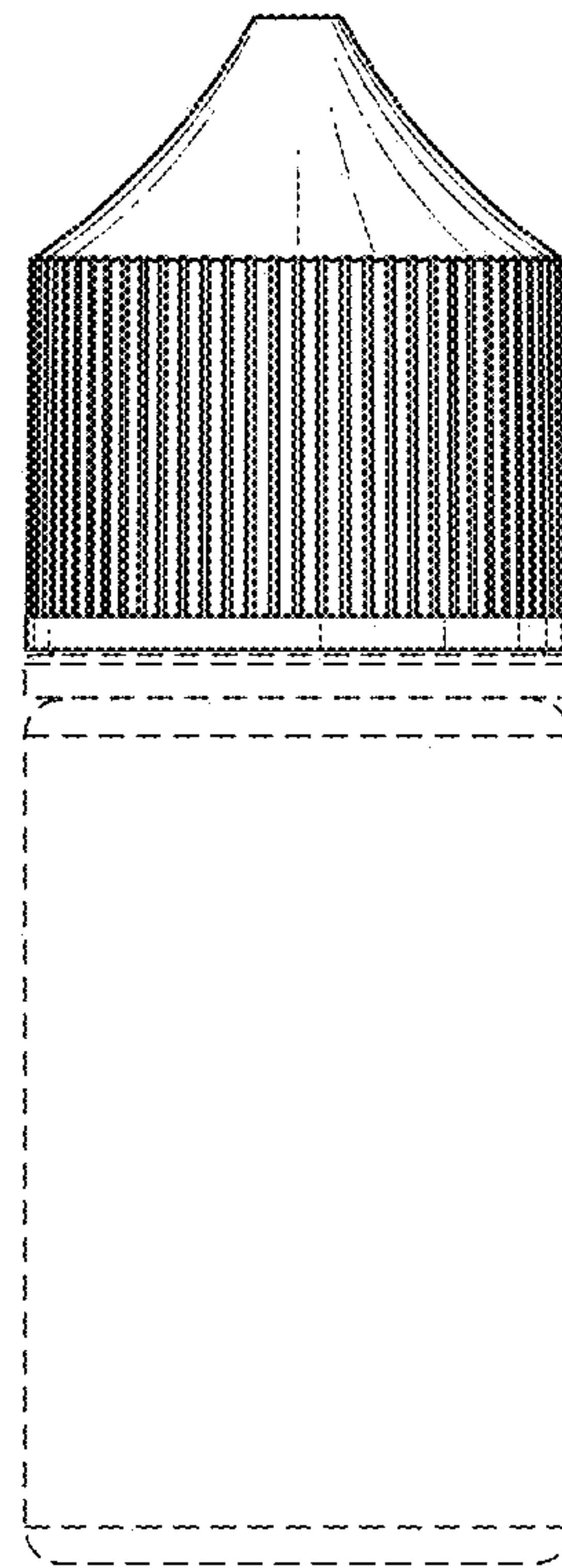

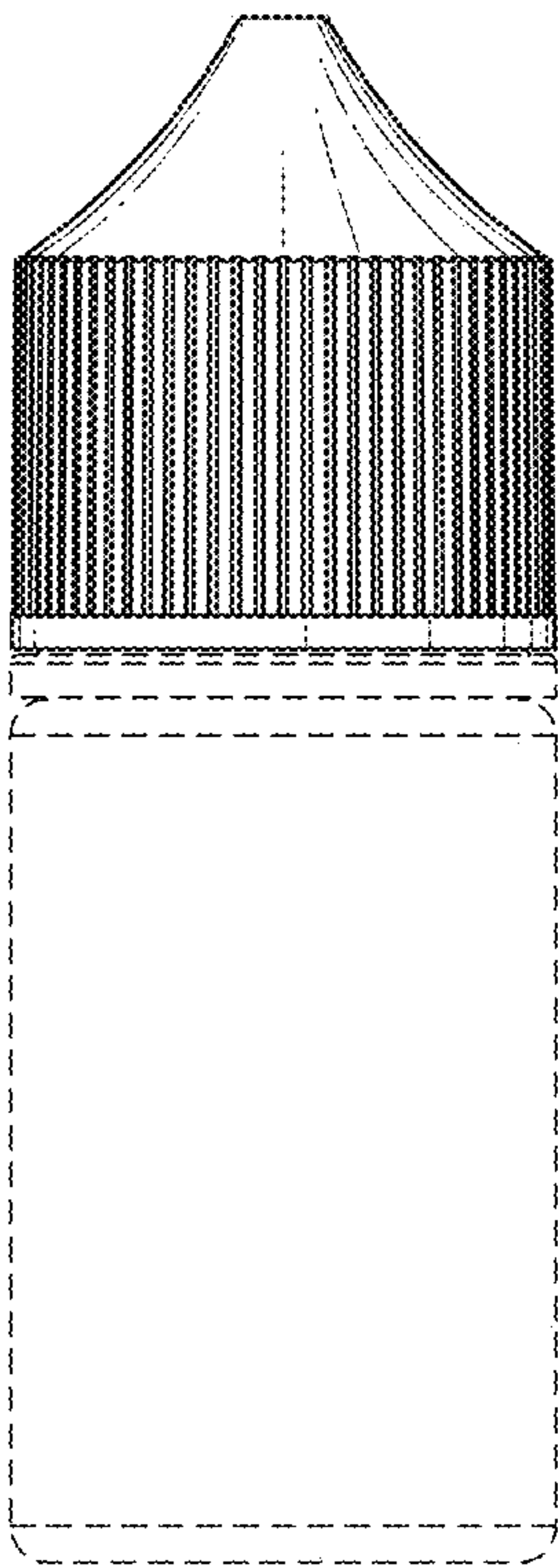

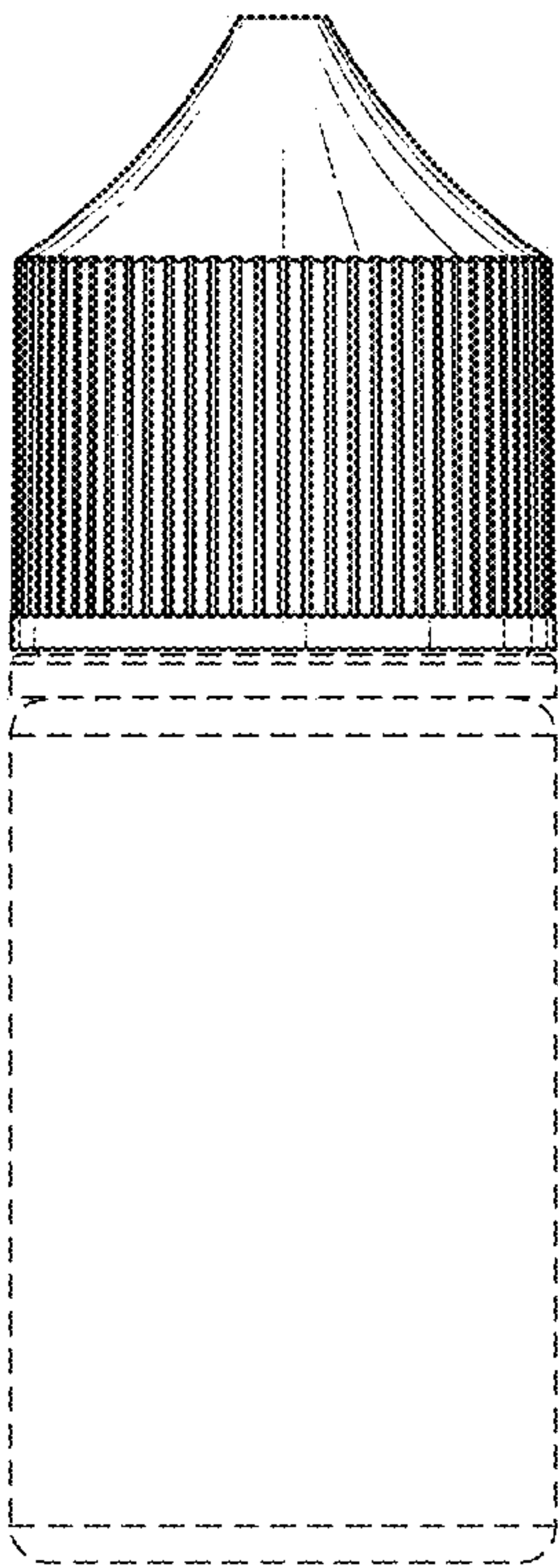

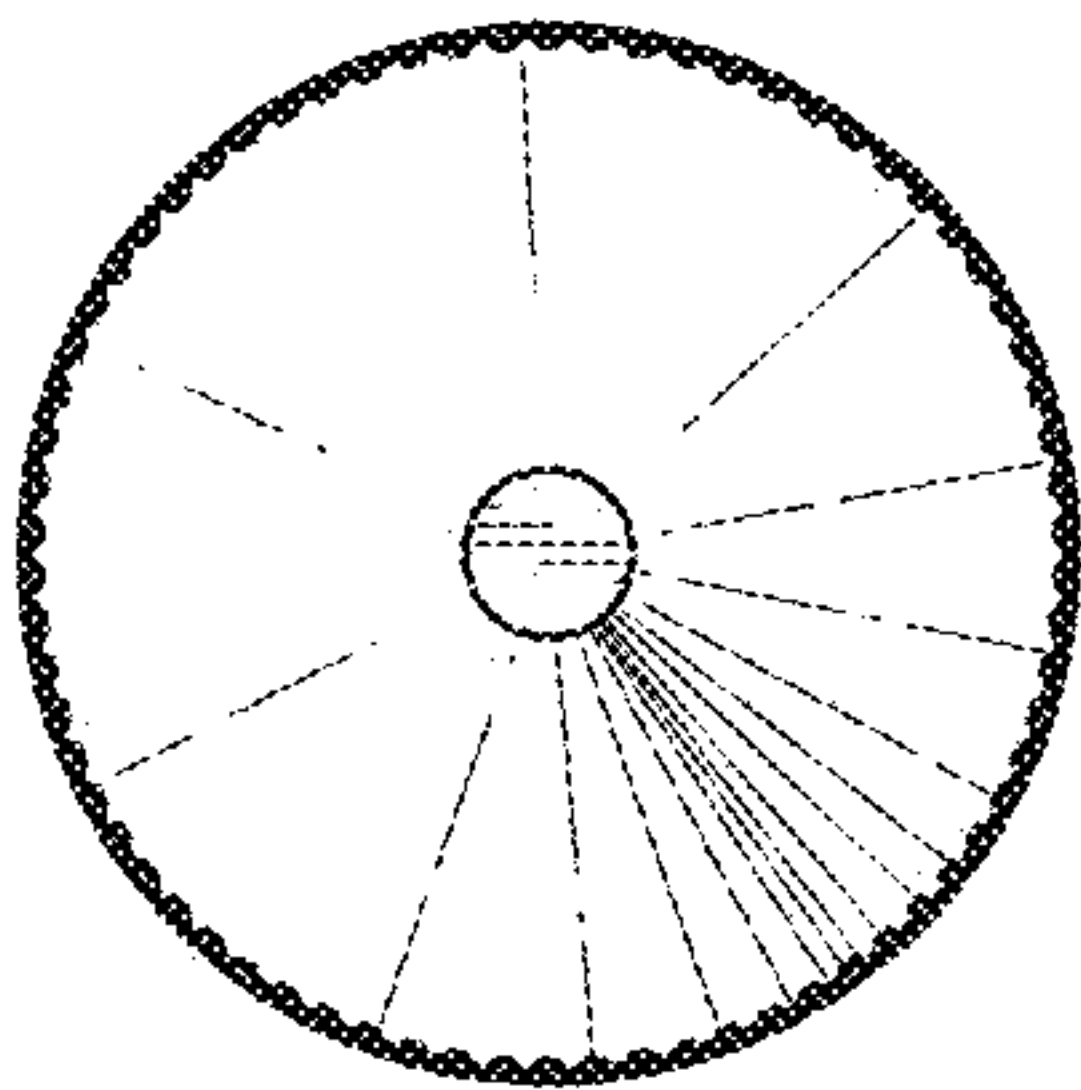

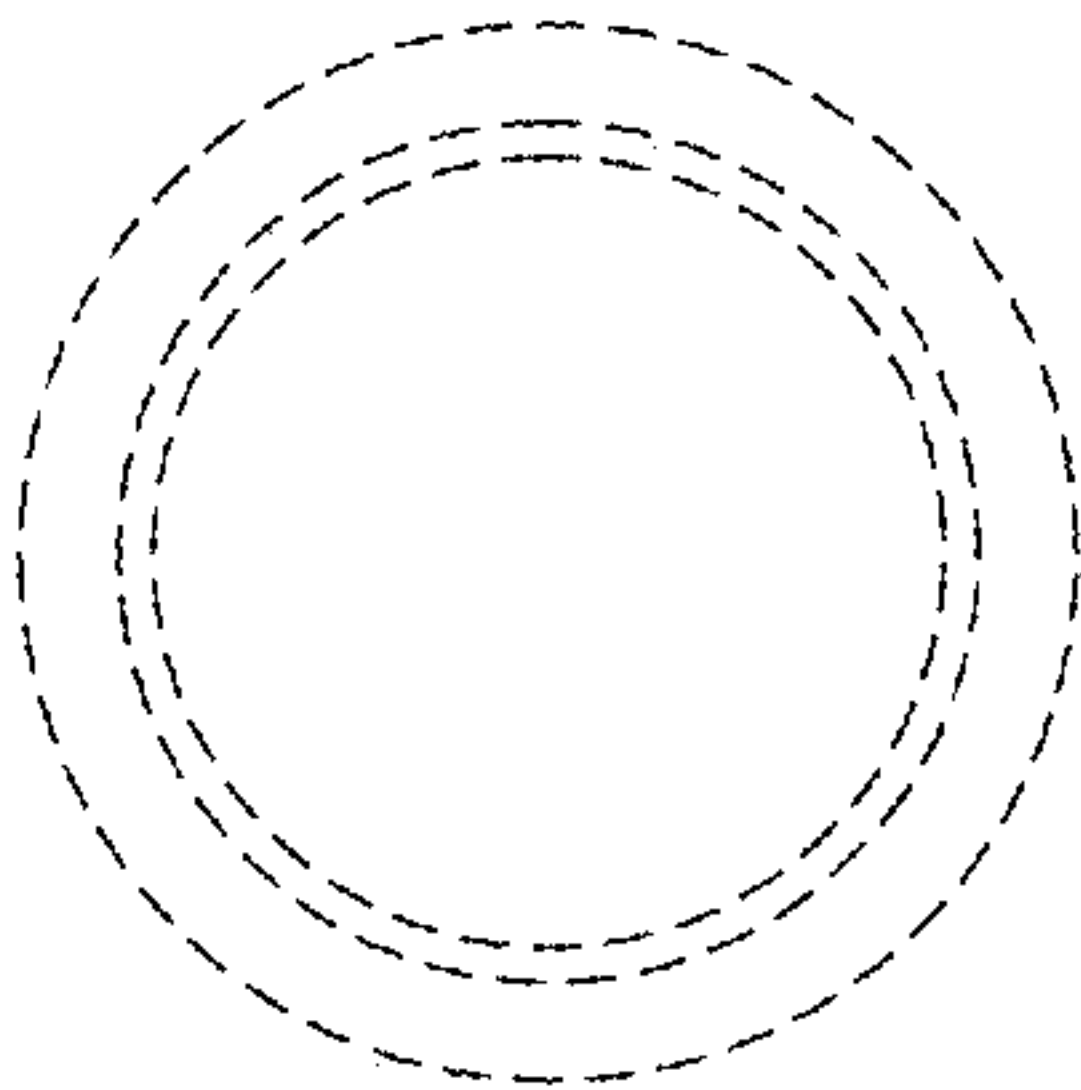

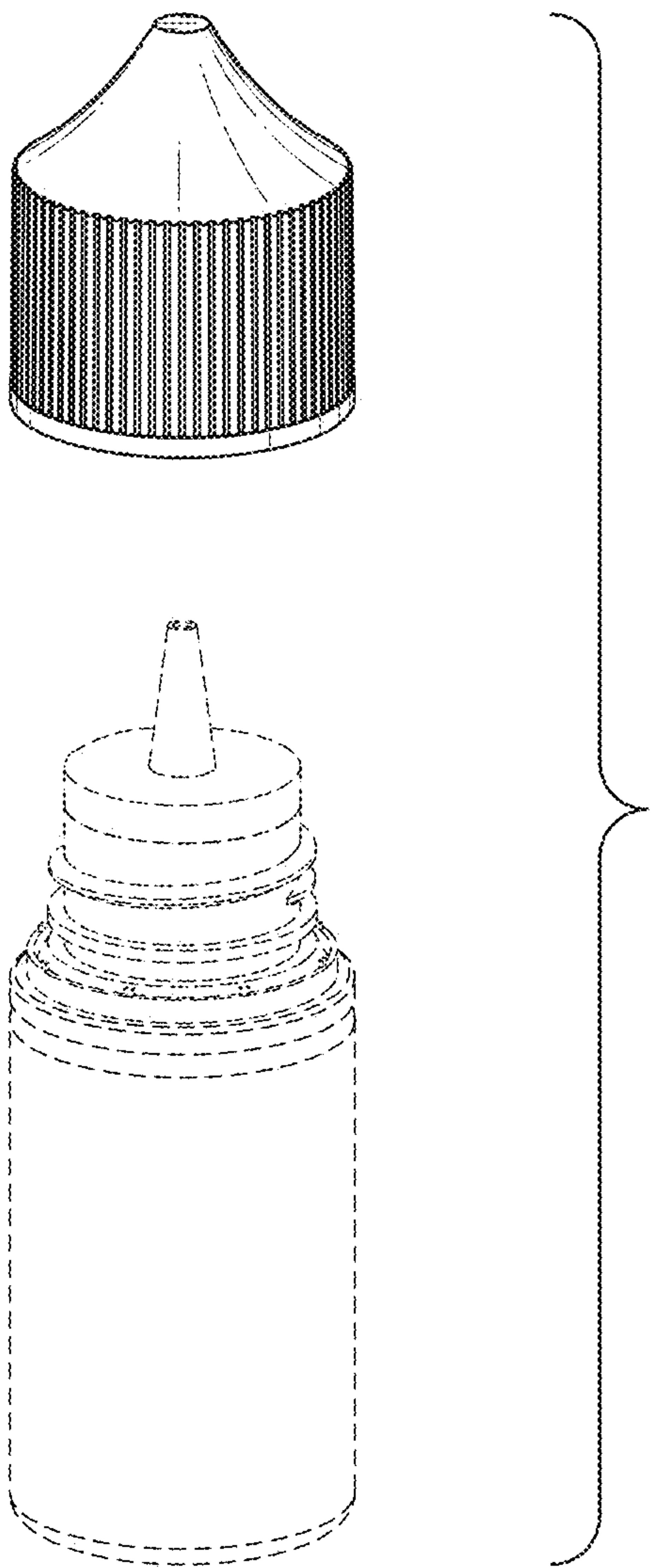

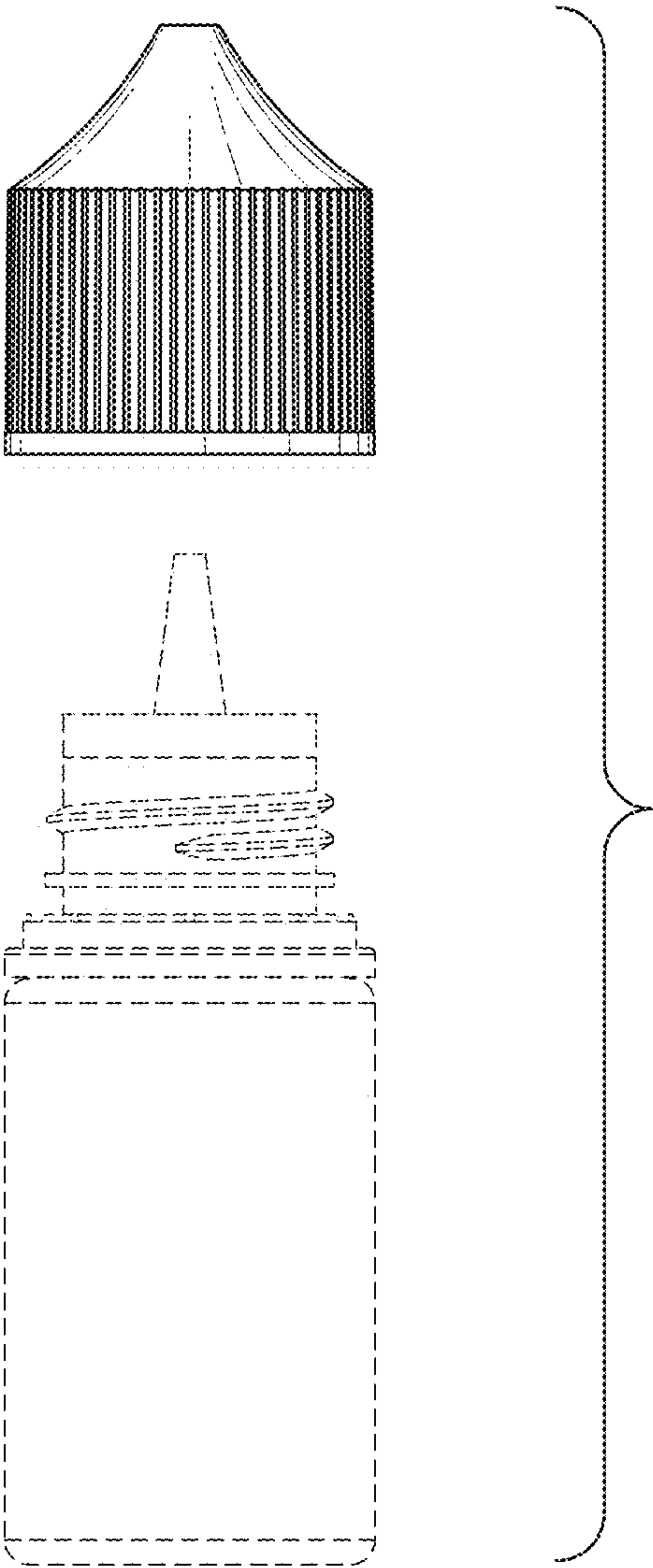

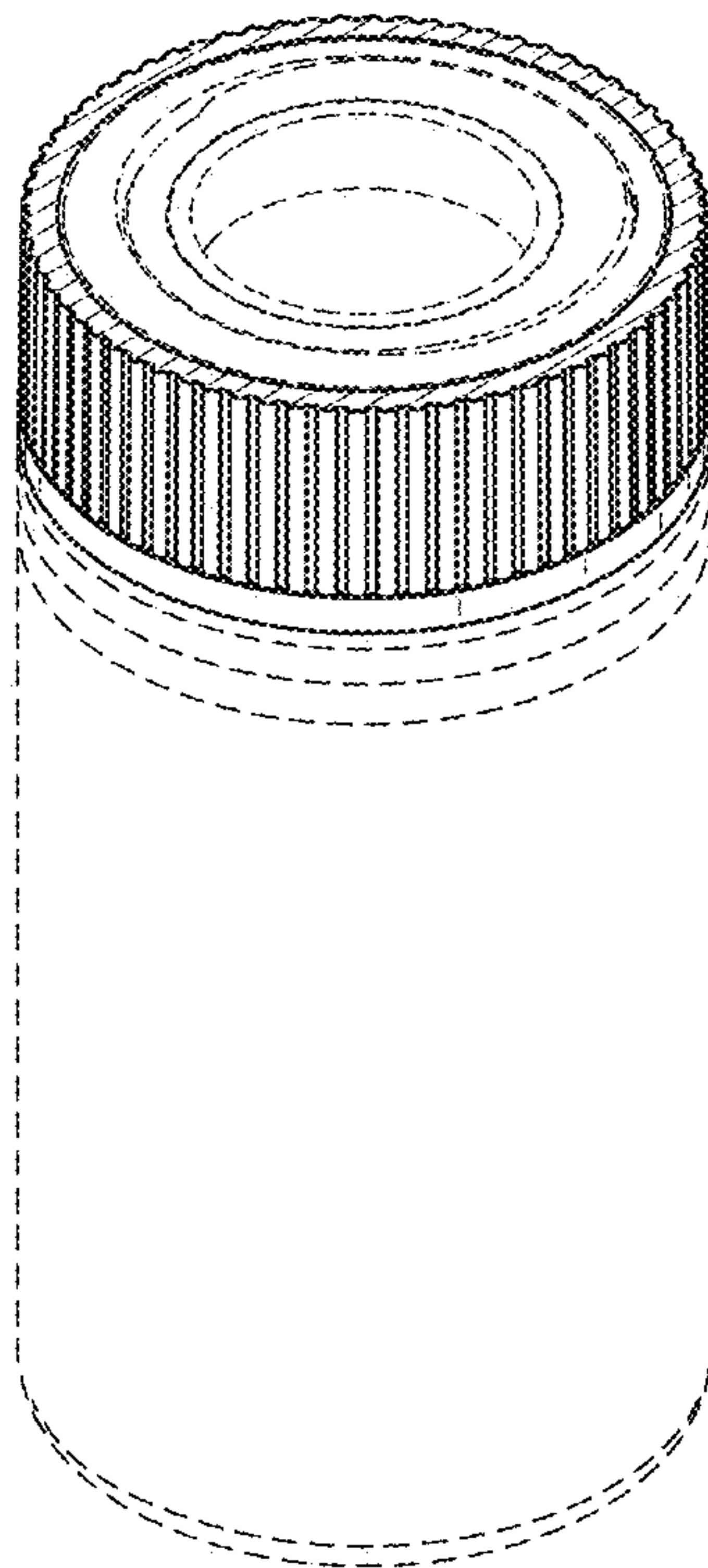
