FIG. 7 is a left elevation view of the nerve stimulator of FIG. 1;

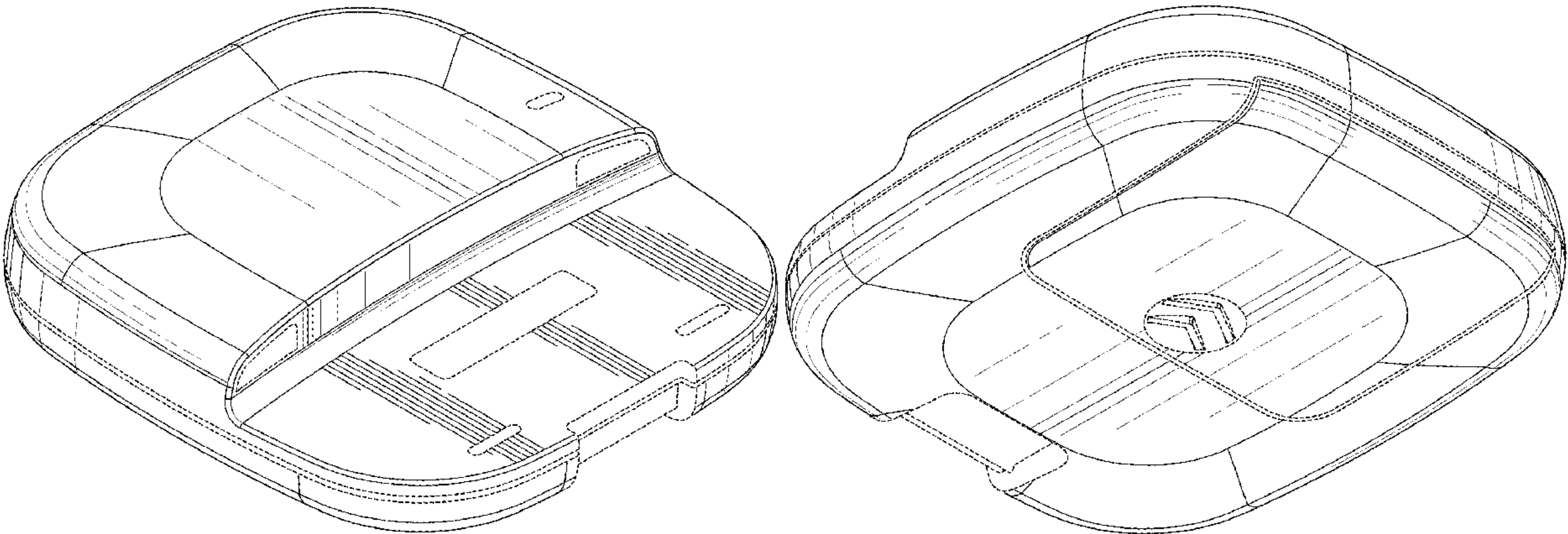
FIG. 8 is a right elevation view of the nerve stimulator of FIG. 1;

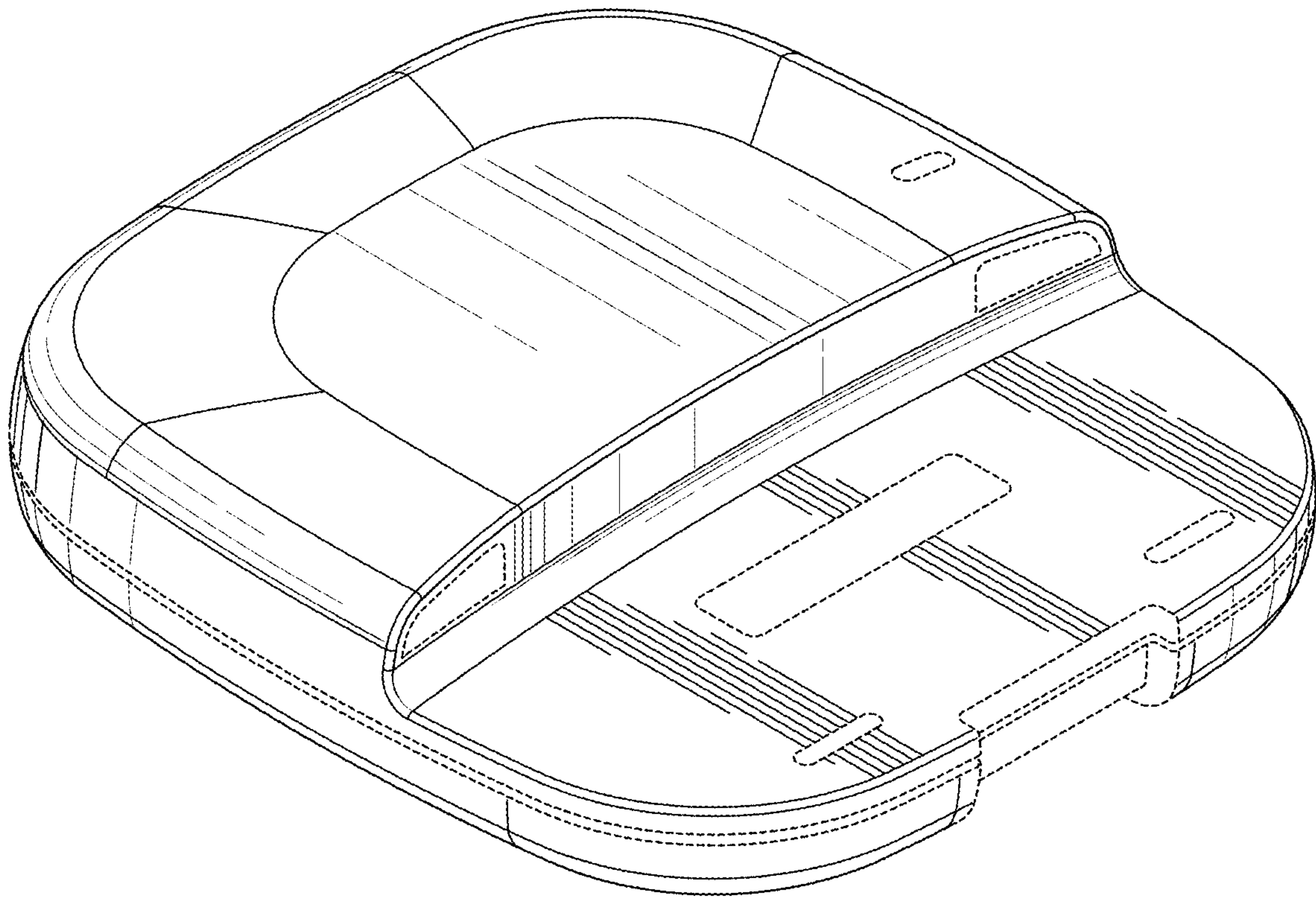

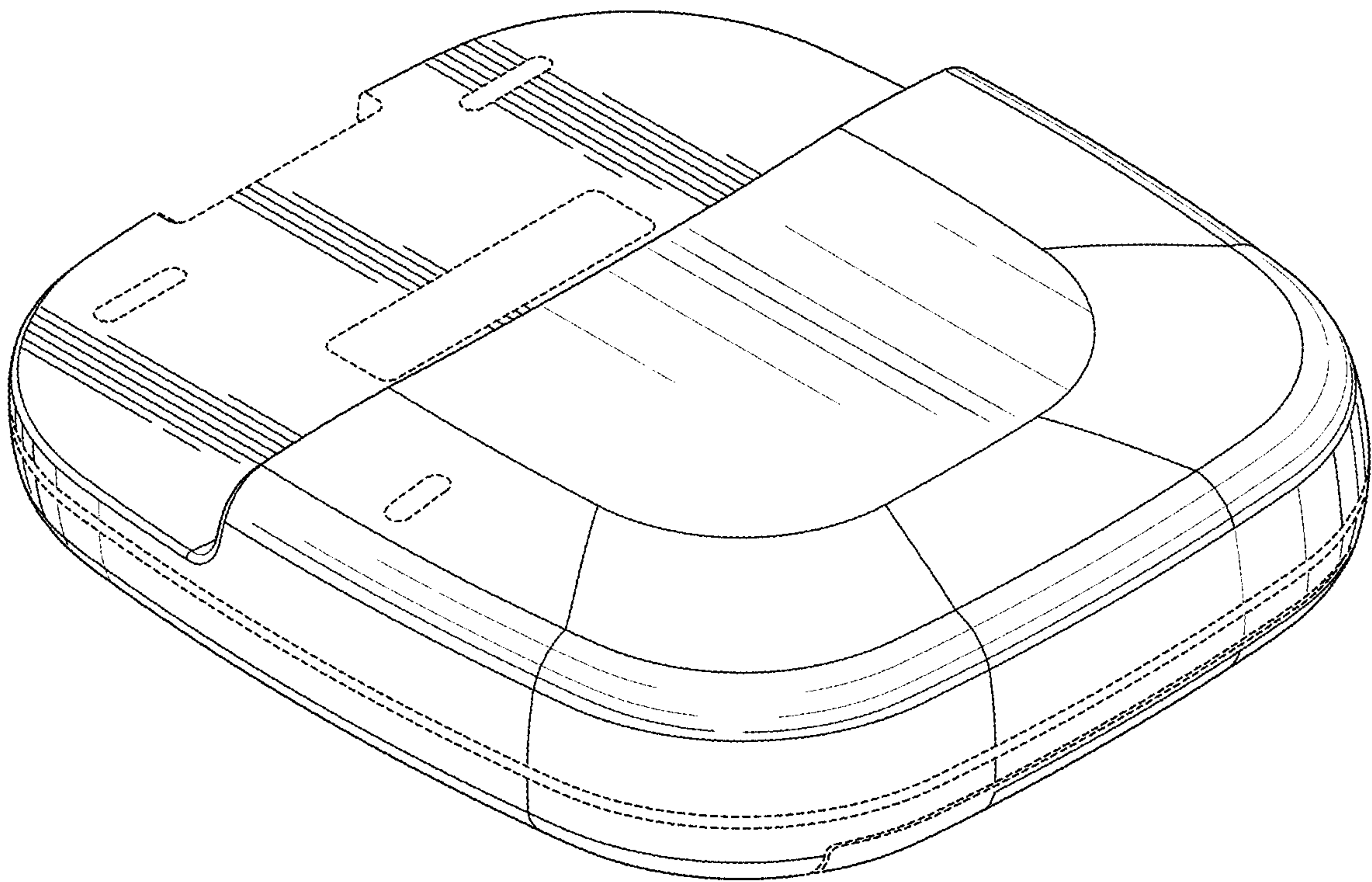

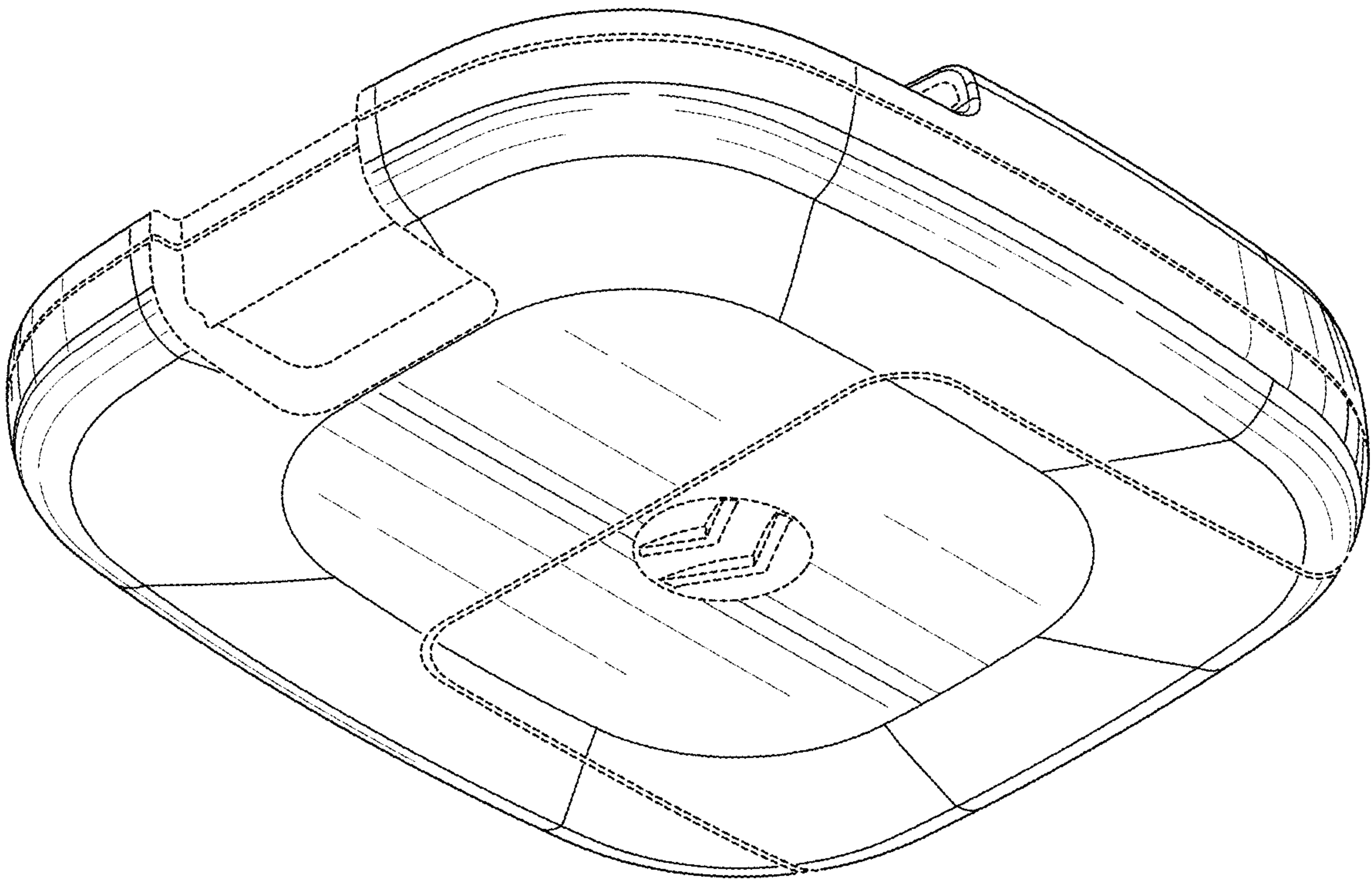

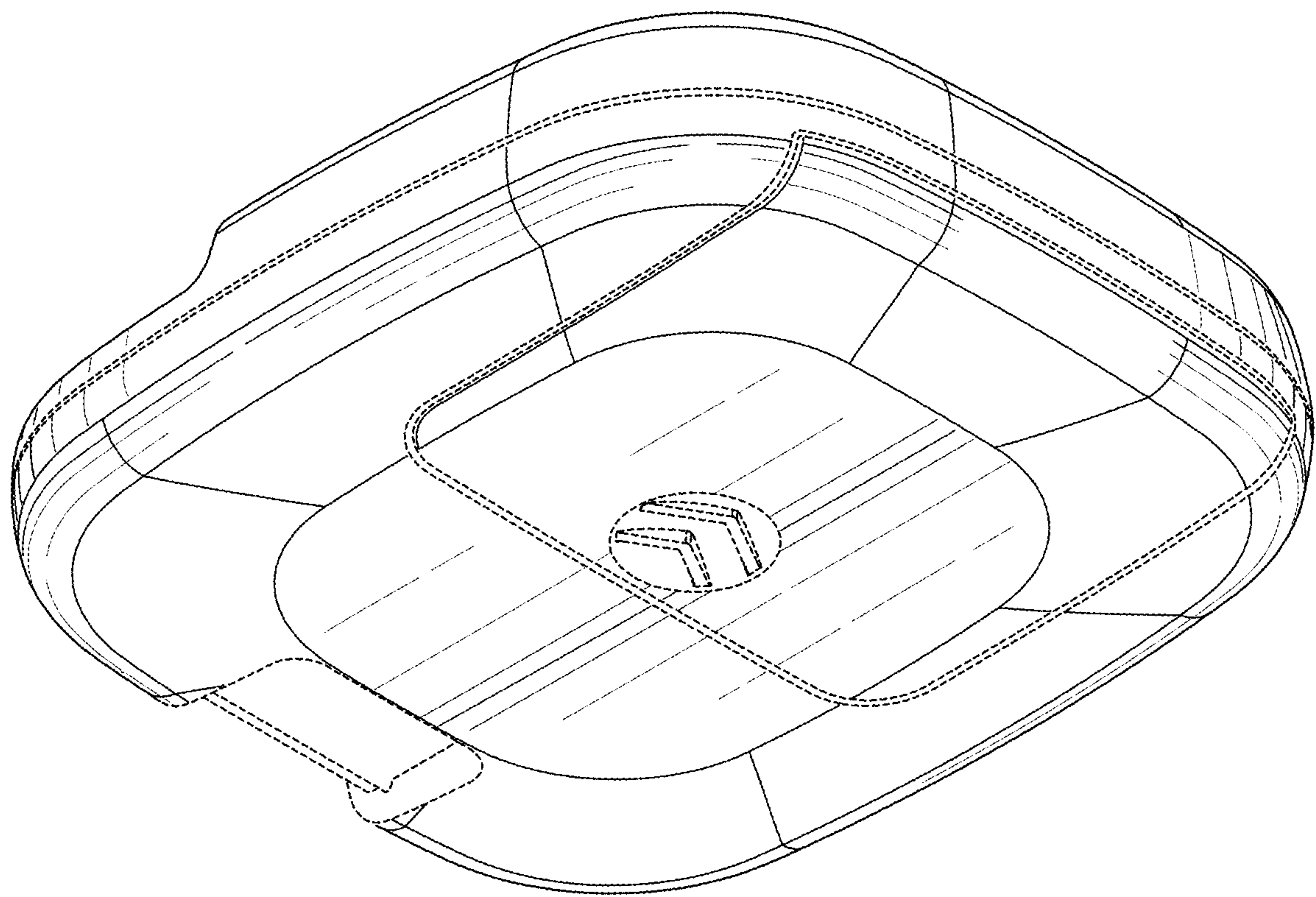

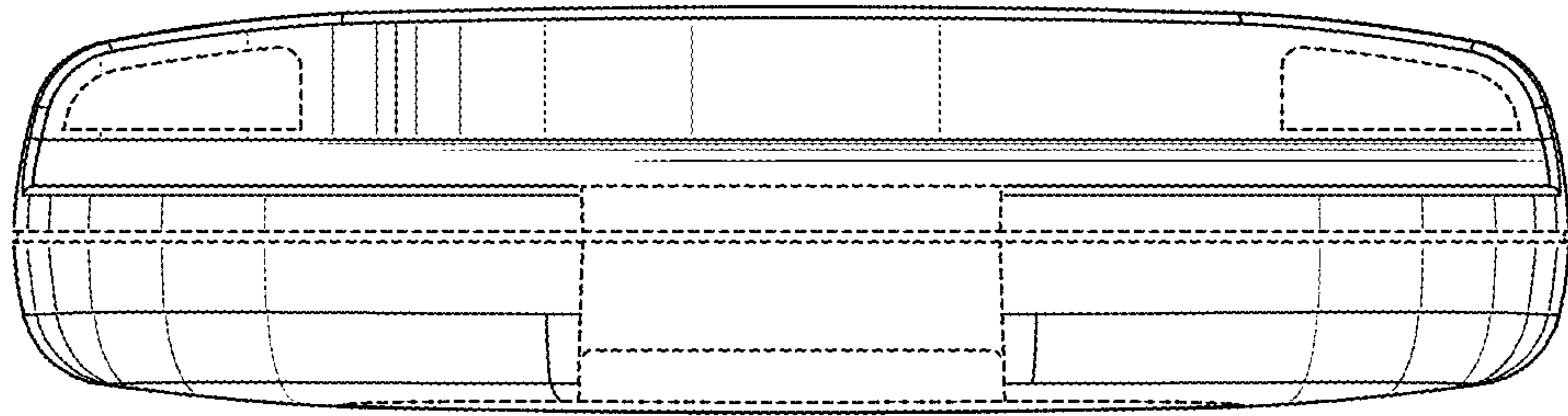

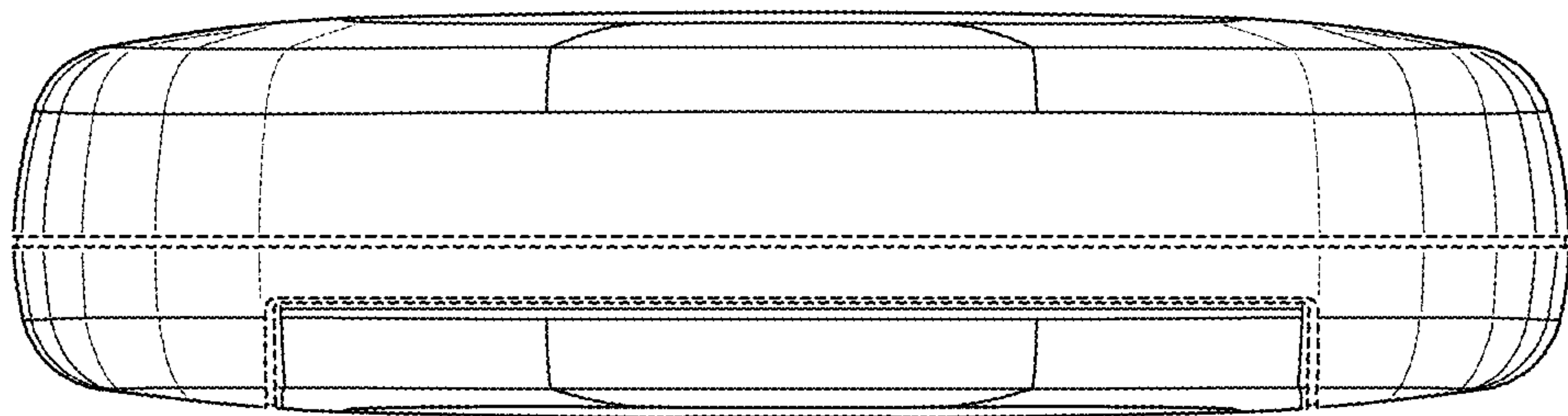

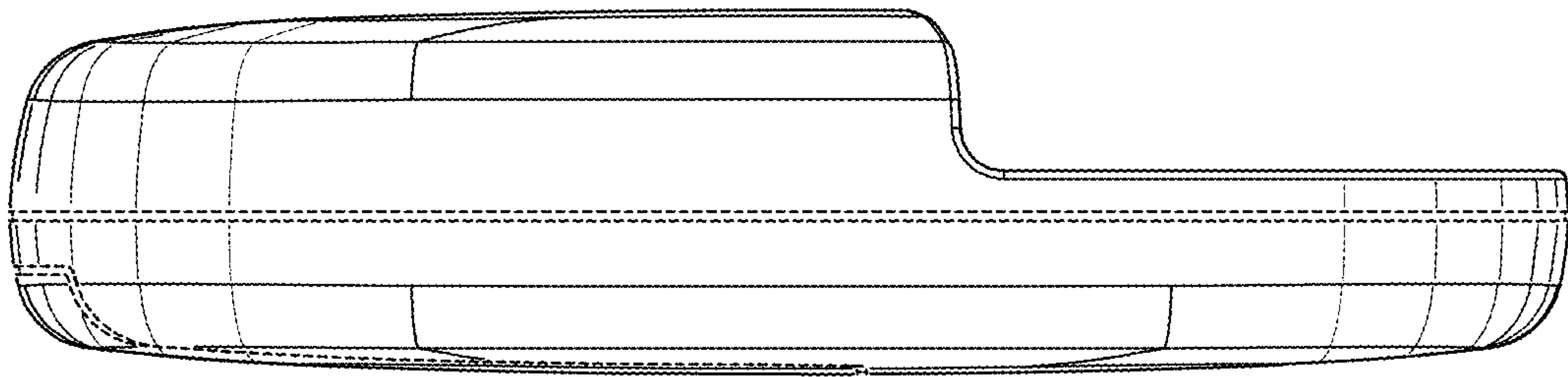

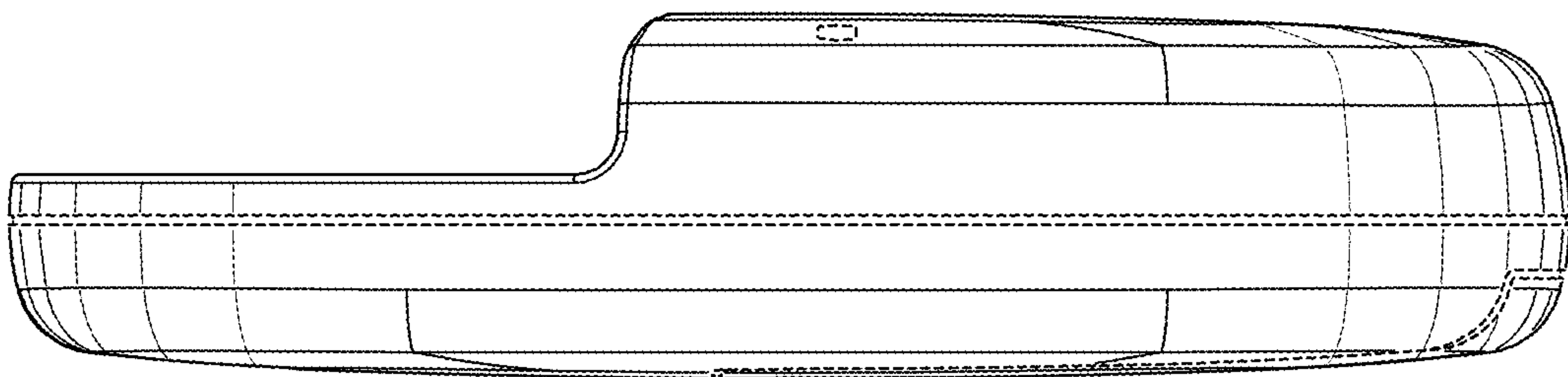

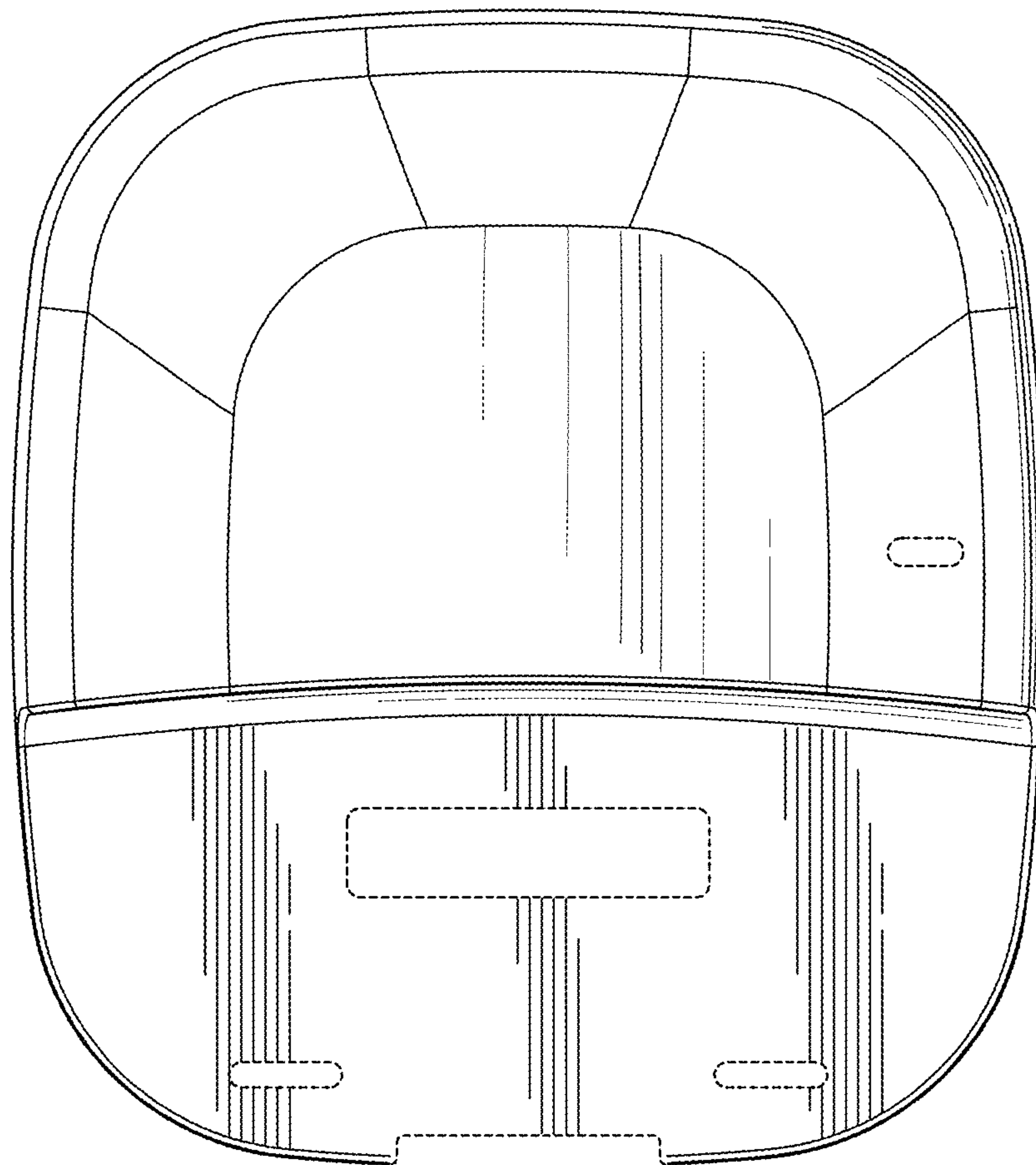

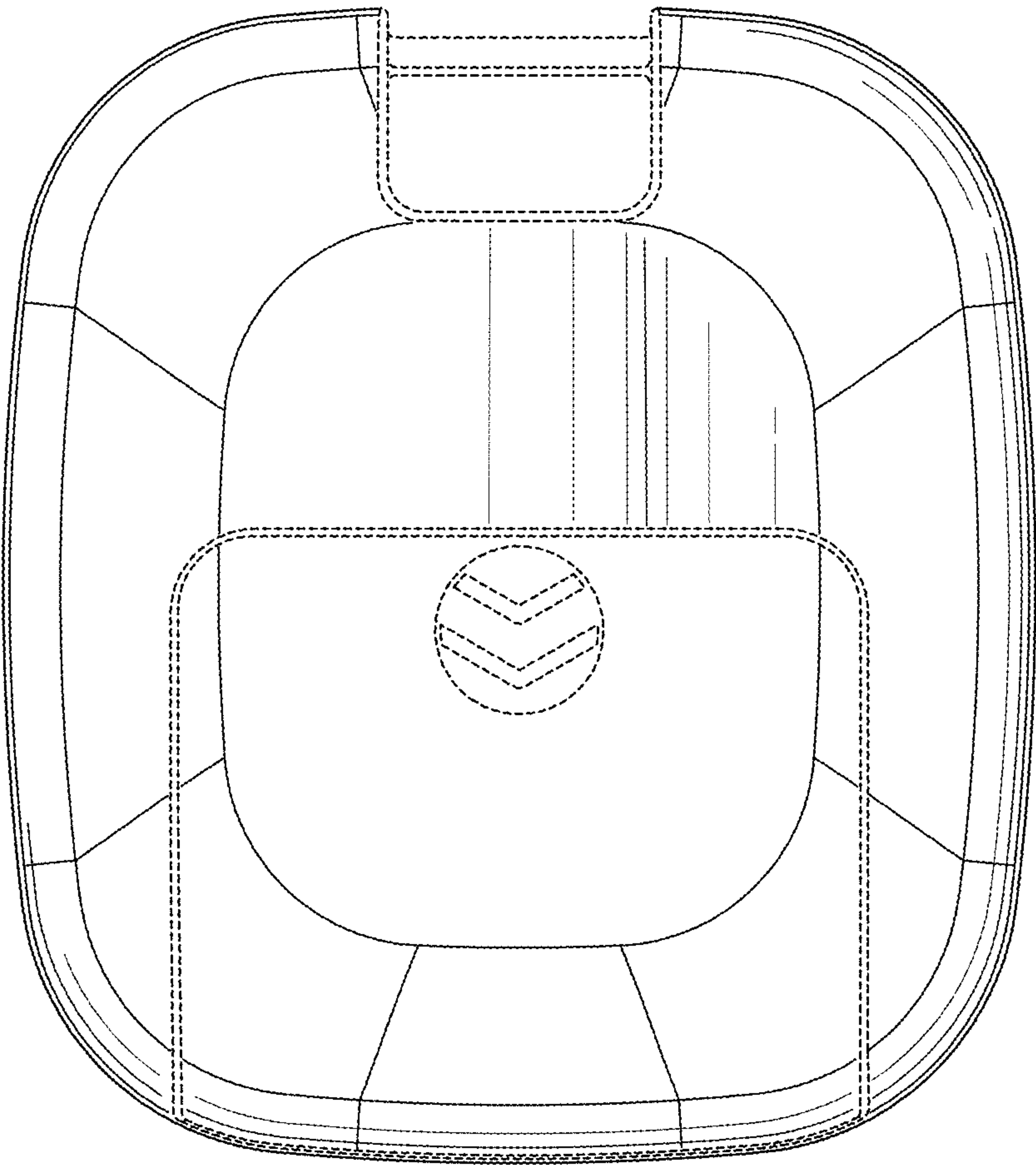
