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(57) **ABSTRACT**

A new *Chrysanthemum* plant named 'CIDZ0090' particu-
larly distinguished by the large white, daisy-type inflores-
cences, strong and vigorous plant habit, and a flowering
response time of 7 weeks.

BACKGROUND OF THE NEW PLANT

The present invention comprises a new *Chrysanthemum*,
botanically known as *Chrysanthemum x morifolium*, and
hereinafter referred to by the variety name 'CIDZ0090'.

'CIDZ0090' is a product of a planned breeding program.
The new cultivar has large white, daisy-type inflorescences,
strong and vigorous plant habit, and a flowering response
time of 7 weeks.

'CIDZ0090' originated from a hybridization made in
September, 2011 in a greenhouse in Gilroy, Calif. The
female parent was the unpatented, proprietary plant desig-
nated as 'D0089', having purple and white bicolored daisy
inflorescences, larger flower size and fuller, wider plant
habit when compared to 'CIDZ0090'.

The male parent of 'CIDZ0090' was the unpatented,
proprietary plant designated as 'B7685', with white colored
daisy-type inflorescences and slower flowering response
than 'CIDZ0090'.

The seed was sown in May, 2012 and the resulting plants
were grown in pots in a greenhouse in Gilroy, Calif.
'CIDZ0090' was selected as one flowering plant within the
progeny of the stated cross in October 2012.

The first act of asexual reproduction of 'CIDZ0090' was
accomplished when vegetative cuttings were propagated
from the initial selection in February, 2013, in Gilroy Calif.

BRIEF SUMMARY OF INVENTION

Horticultural examination of plants grown from cuttings
of the plant initiated in May, 2013 and continuing thereafter,
has demonstrated that the combination of characteristics as
herein disclosed for 'CIDZ0090' are firmly fixed and are
retained through successive generations of asexual repro-
duction.

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'CIDZ0090' has not been observed under all possible
environmental conditions. The phenotype may vary signifi-
cantly with variations in environment such as temperature,
light intensity and day length.

A Plant Breeder's Right for this cultivar has not been
applied for. 'CIDZ0090' has not been made publicly avail-
able prior to the effective filing date of this application,
notwithstanding any disclosure that may have been made
less than one year prior to the effective filing date of this
application by the inventor or another who obtained
'CIDZ0090' directly from the inventor.

The following traits have been repeatedly observed and
are determined to be basic characteristics of the new variety.
The combination of these characteristics distinguishes this
Chrysanthemum as a new and distinct variety.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS

The accompanying photographic drawing shows typical
flower and foliage characteristics of 'CIDZ0090' with colors
being as true as possible with an illustration of this type. The
photographic drawing shows in FIG. 1 a close-up view plant
of an inflorescence, and in FIG. 2 a flowering plant of the
new variety.

DETAILED BOTANICAL DESCRIPTION

The plant descriptions and measurements were taken
indoors in Gilroy, Calif. in January, 2017 on about 11 week
old plants. Unrooted cuttings had been planted, 4 plants per
pot, in 6 inch pots on Oct. 26, 2016. The plants were pinched
and moved to short days on Nov. 14, 2016 to induce
flowering.

The aforementioned photographs: FIGS. 1 and 2 was
taken in Gilroy, Calif. in January, 2017, and showing a plant
from a trial, in which flowering had been induced by
applying black cloth.

These plants were about 11 weeks of age. Unrooted cuttings had been planted, 4 plants per pot, in 6 inch pots. The plants were pinched and moved to short days to induce flowering.

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What is claimed is:

1. A new and distinct variety of *Chrysanthemum* plant named 'CIDZ0090' substantially as illustrated and described herein.


