The undisclosed rear view is planar and unornamented except for the round pin that is identical to the front center pin.

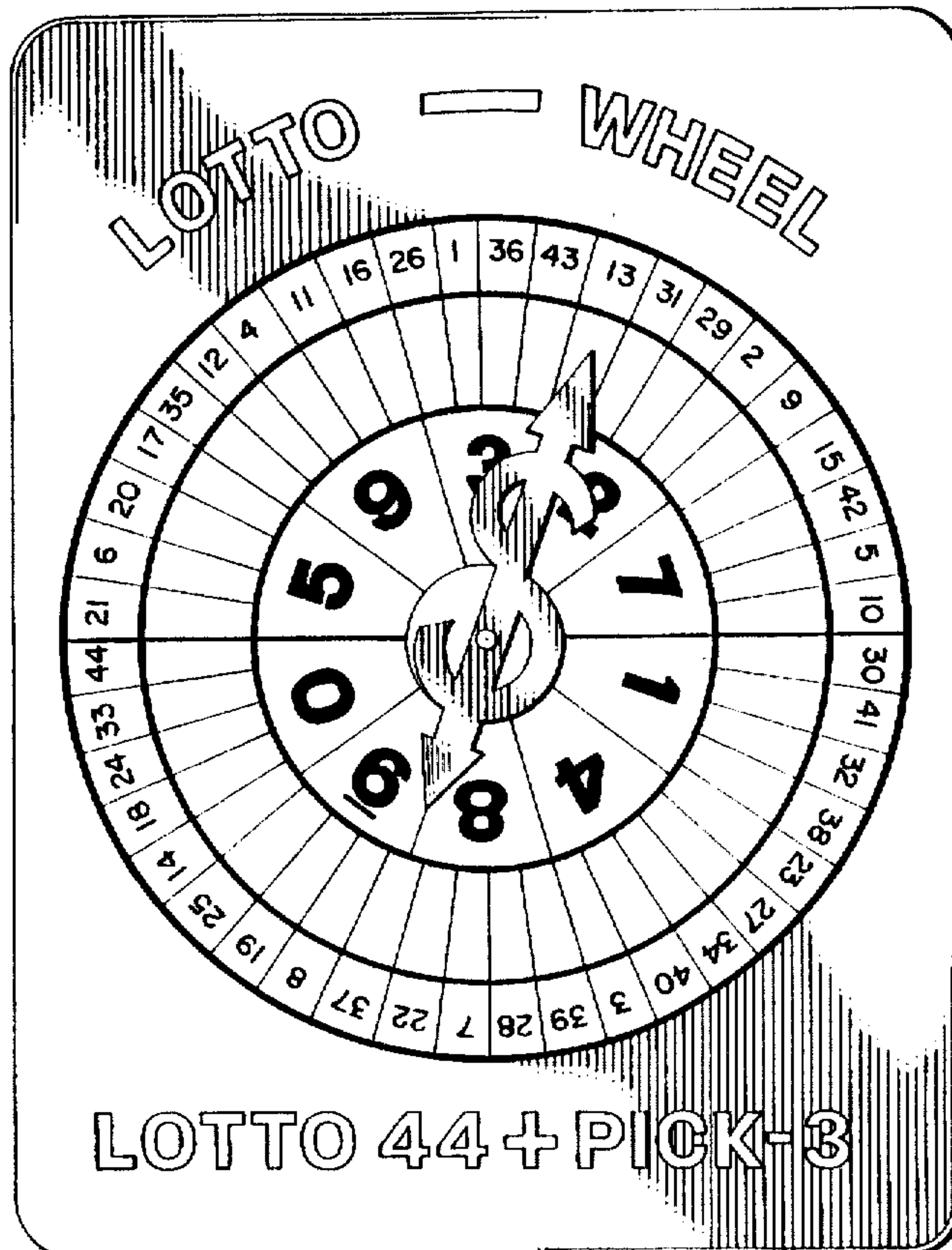

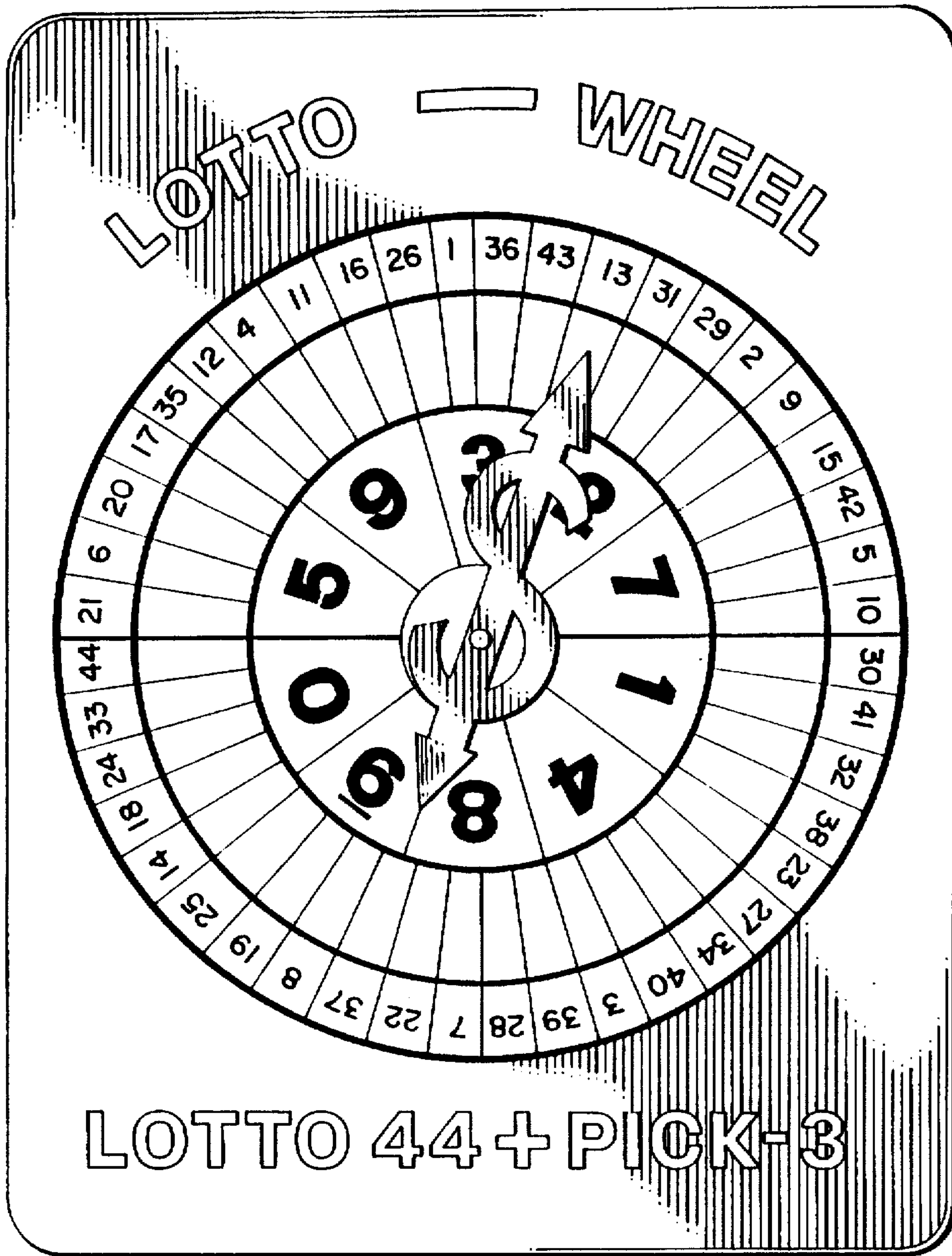
