The ornamental design for a water pipe, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a water pipe, showing my design, the broken lines are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the invention;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof, the broken lines are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the invention;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the broken lines are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the invention; and,







