(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for a transparent aquatic board, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a transparent aquatic board showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof,

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the transparent aquatic board showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a partial top view of an alternate embodiment of the design of my invention in which an end of the board carries an opaque design, the remaining features being identical to those shown in FIGS. 1 to 6.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a further emdodiment of a transparent aquatic board showing my new design;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the board of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the board of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a side elevational view of the transparent aquatic board of FIG. 8 showing my new design;

FIG. 12 is a front view of the board of FIG. 8;


FIG. 13 is a rear view of the board of FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 14 is a partial top view of an alternate embodiment of the design of my invention in which an end of the board carries a design, the remaining features being identical to those shown in FIGS. 8 to 13.
