machine of FIG. 8.*

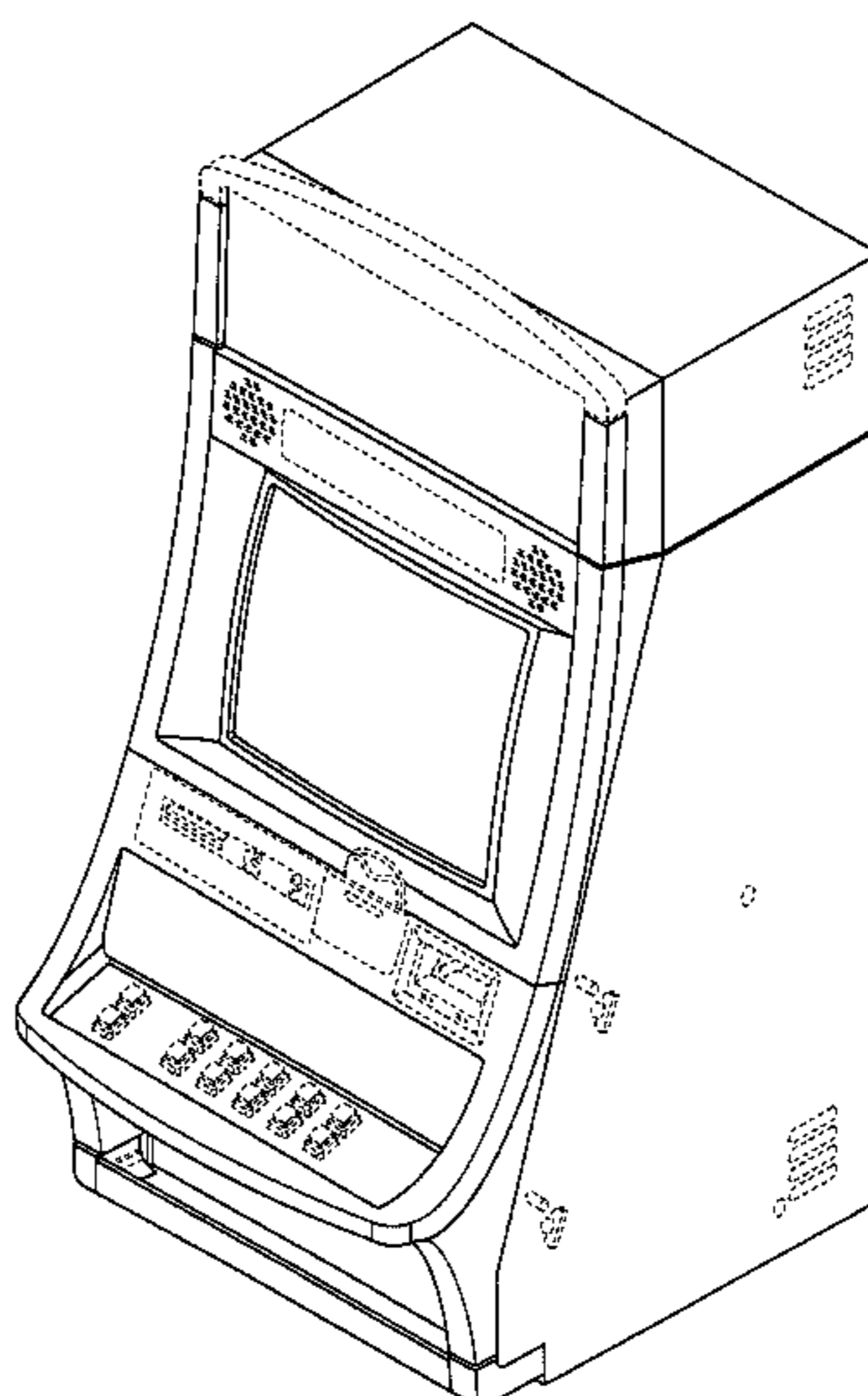
*FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the gaming machine of FIG. 8;

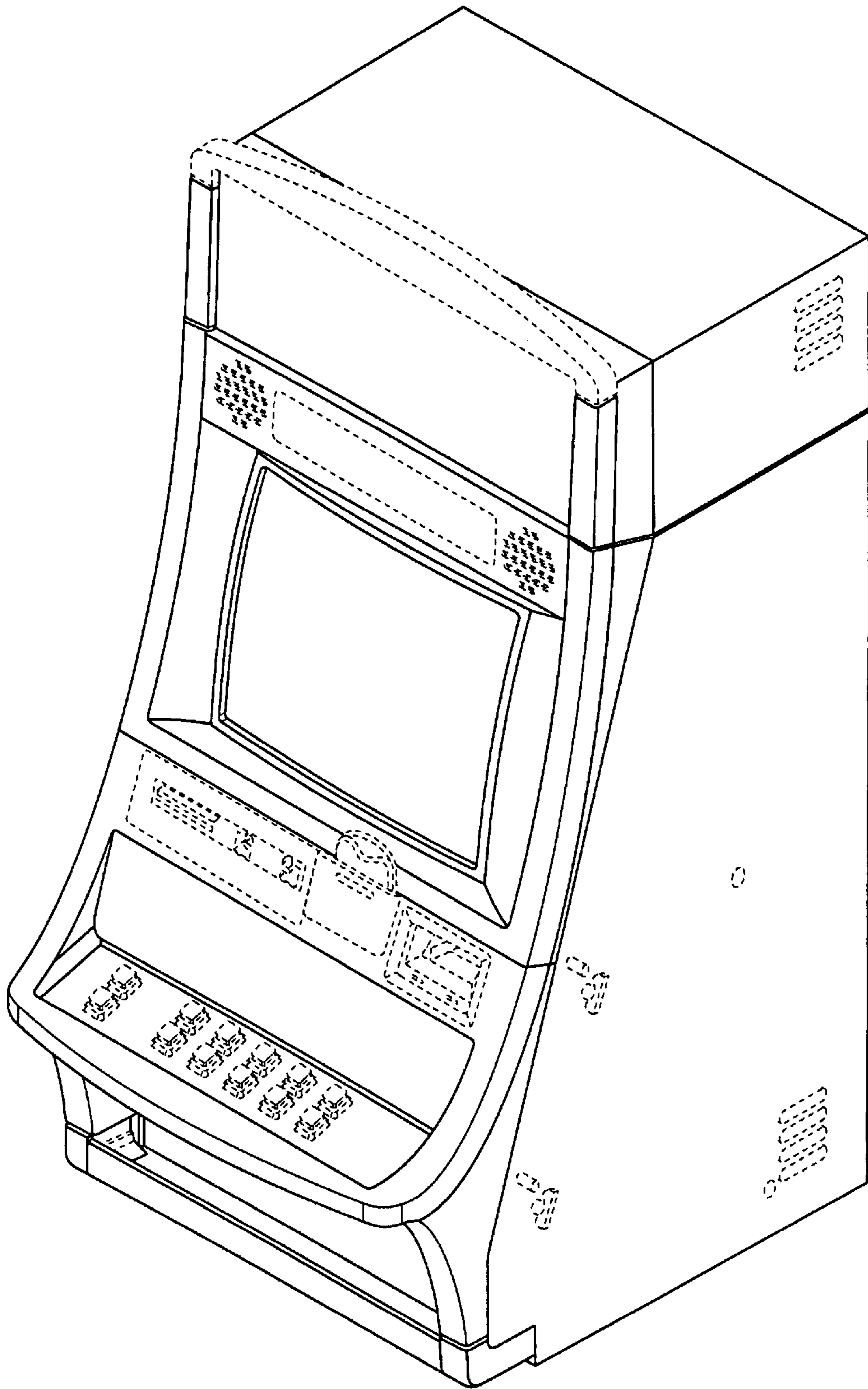

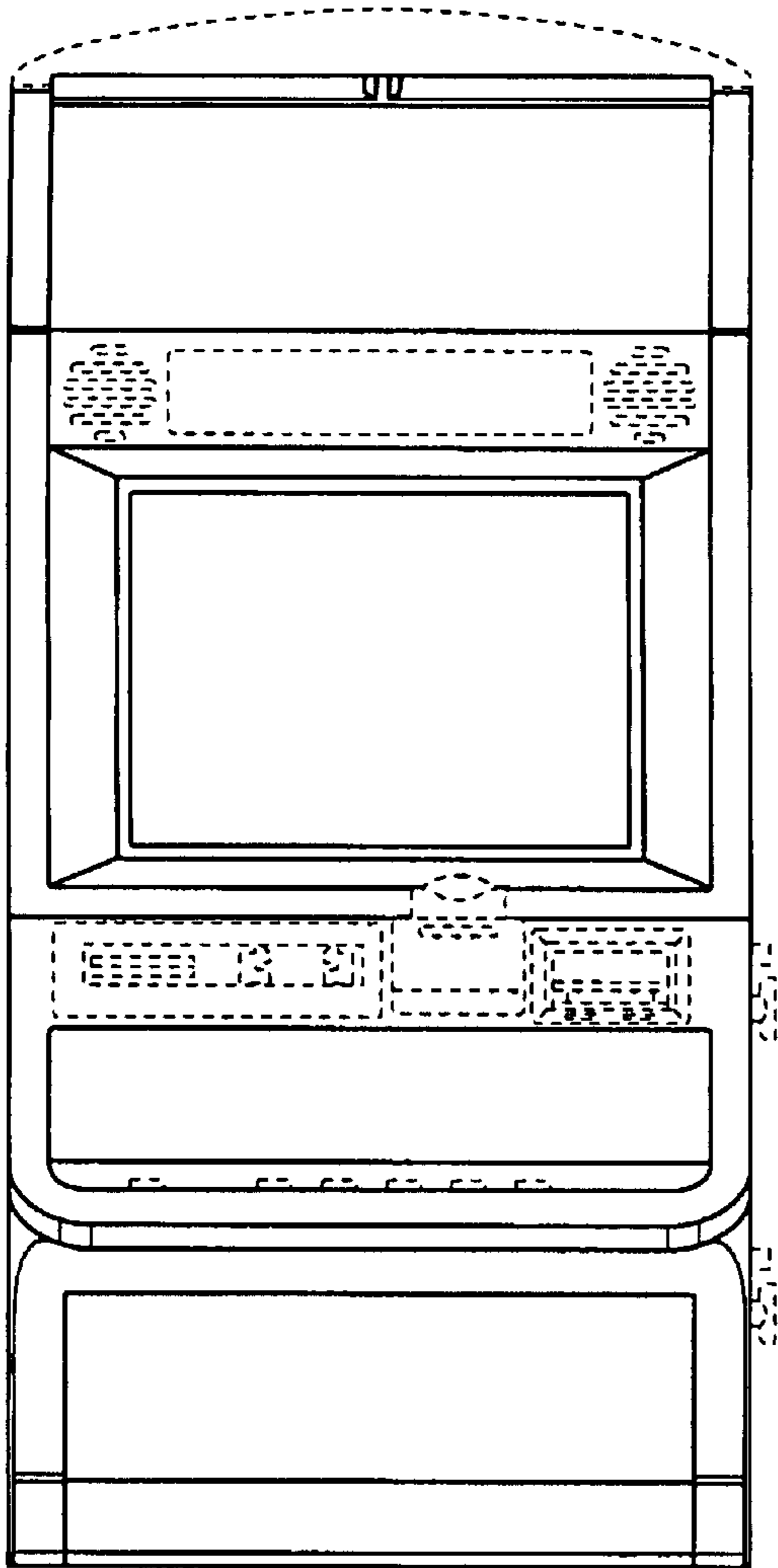

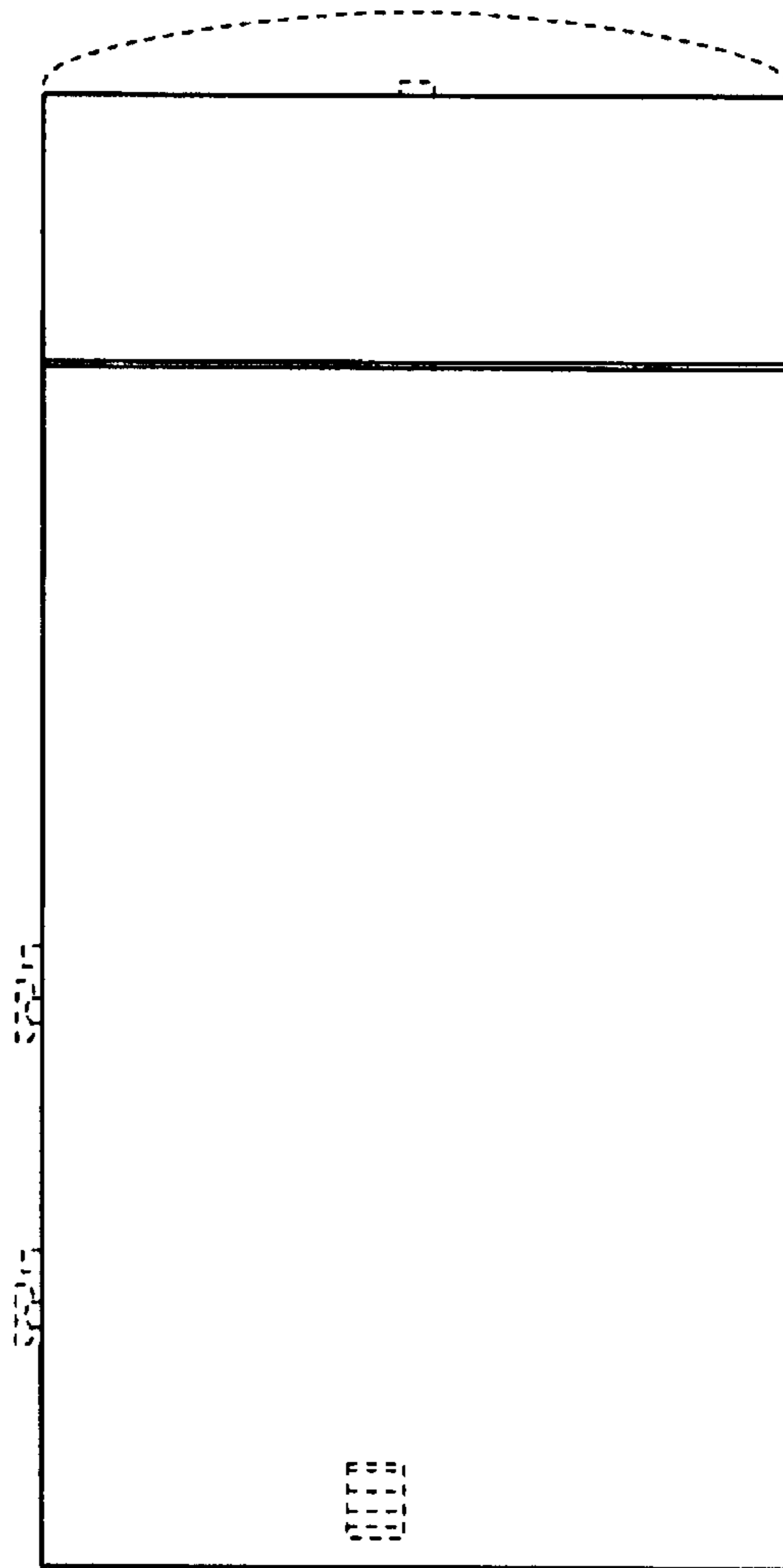

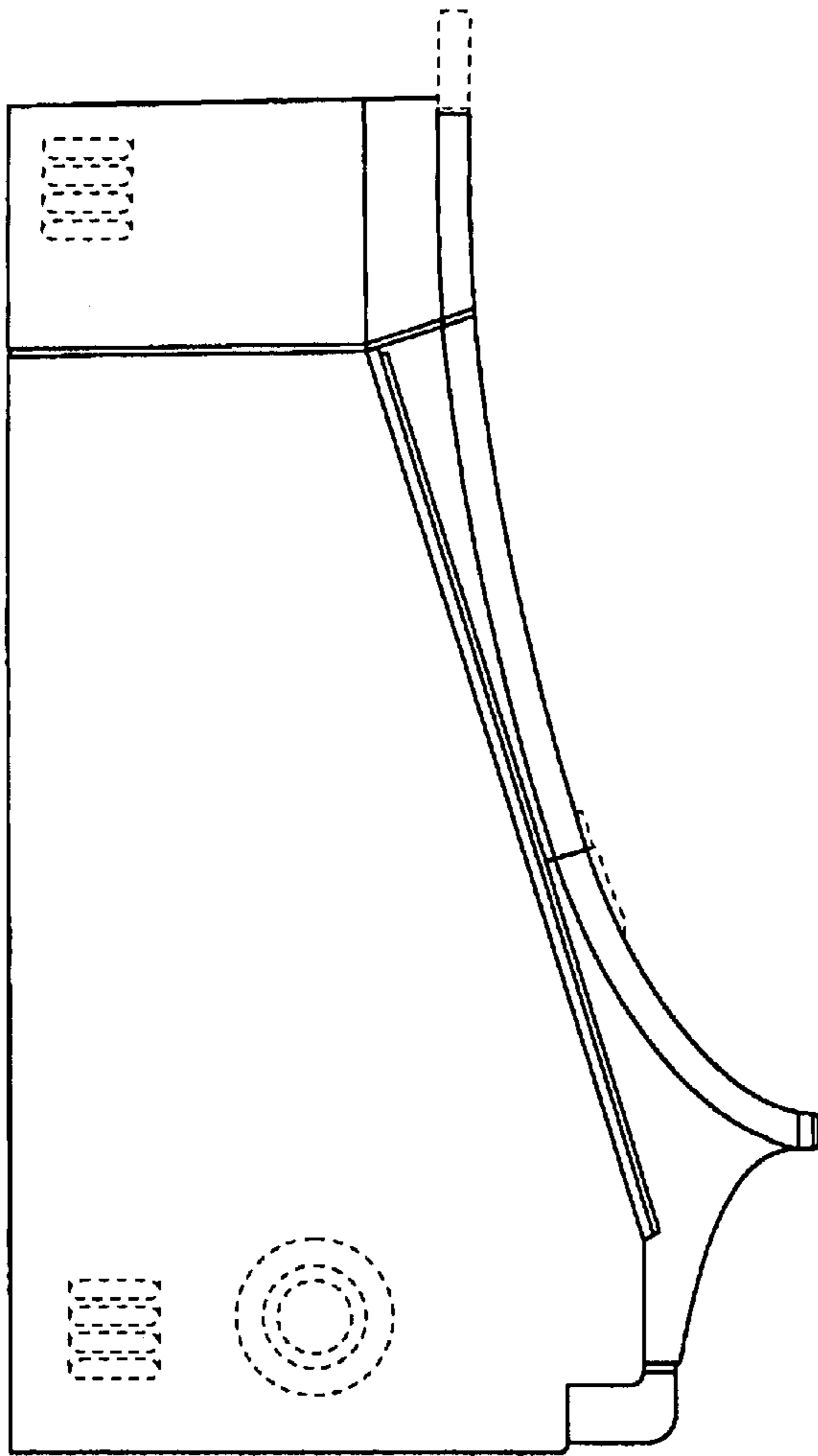

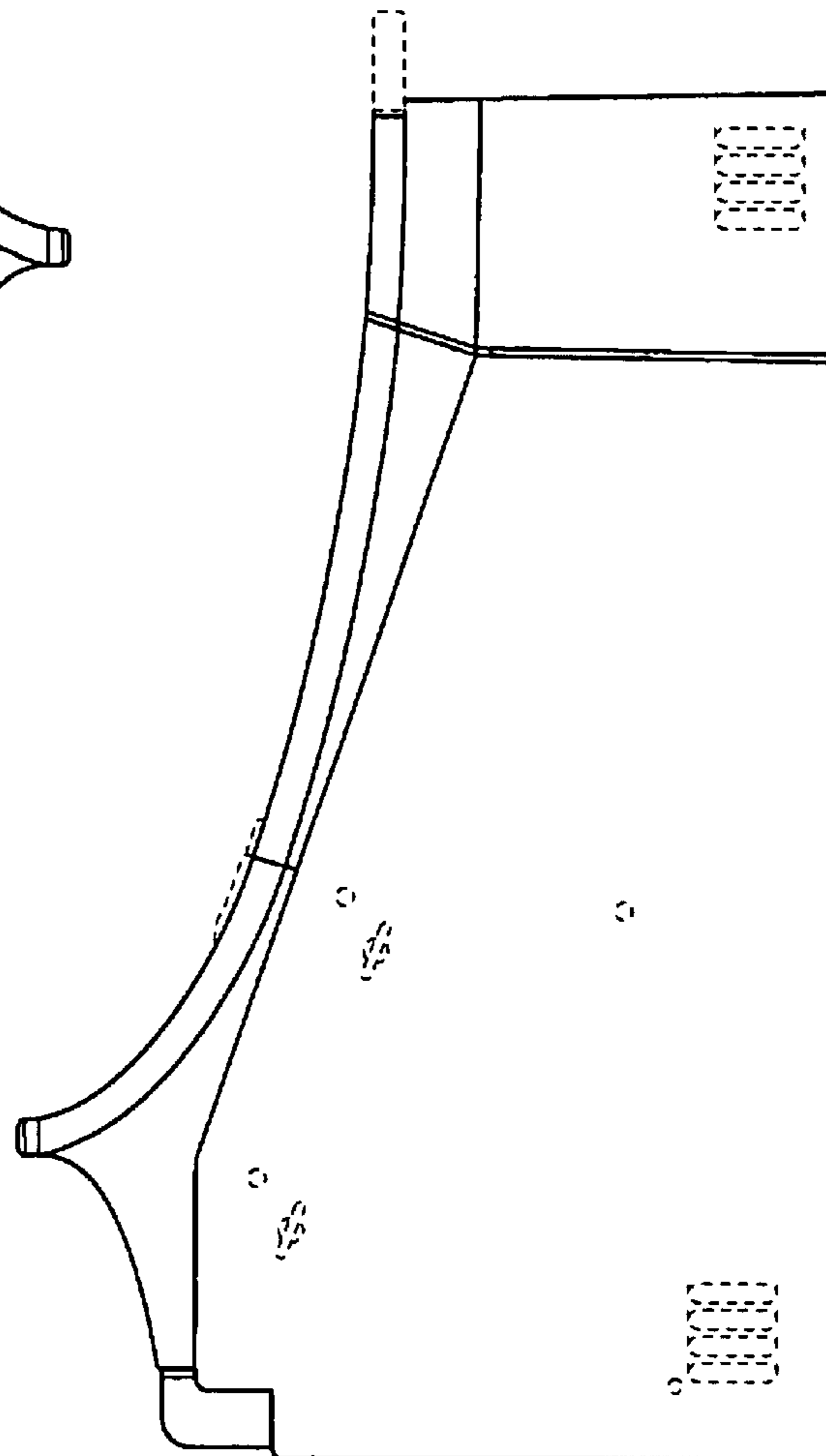

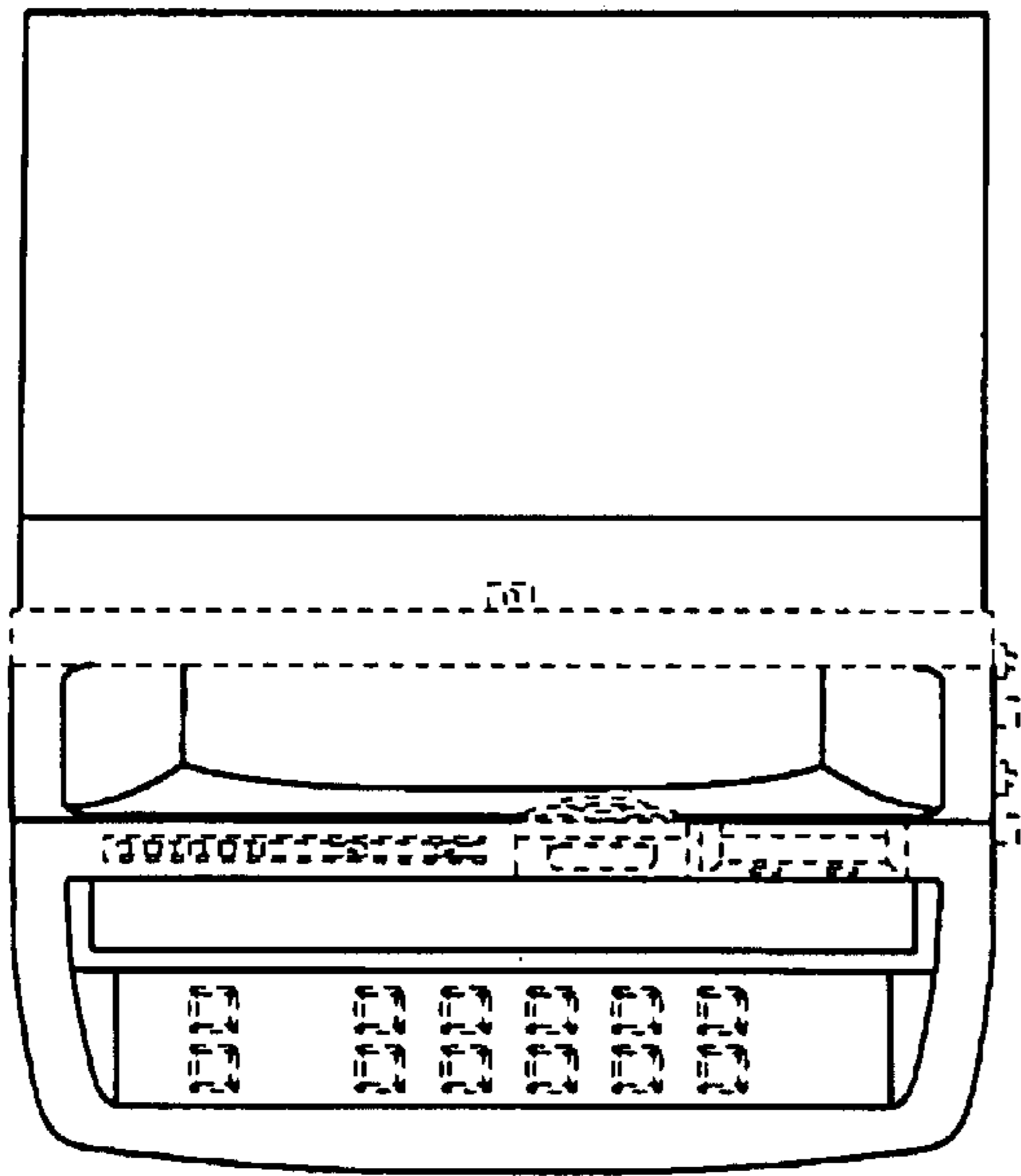

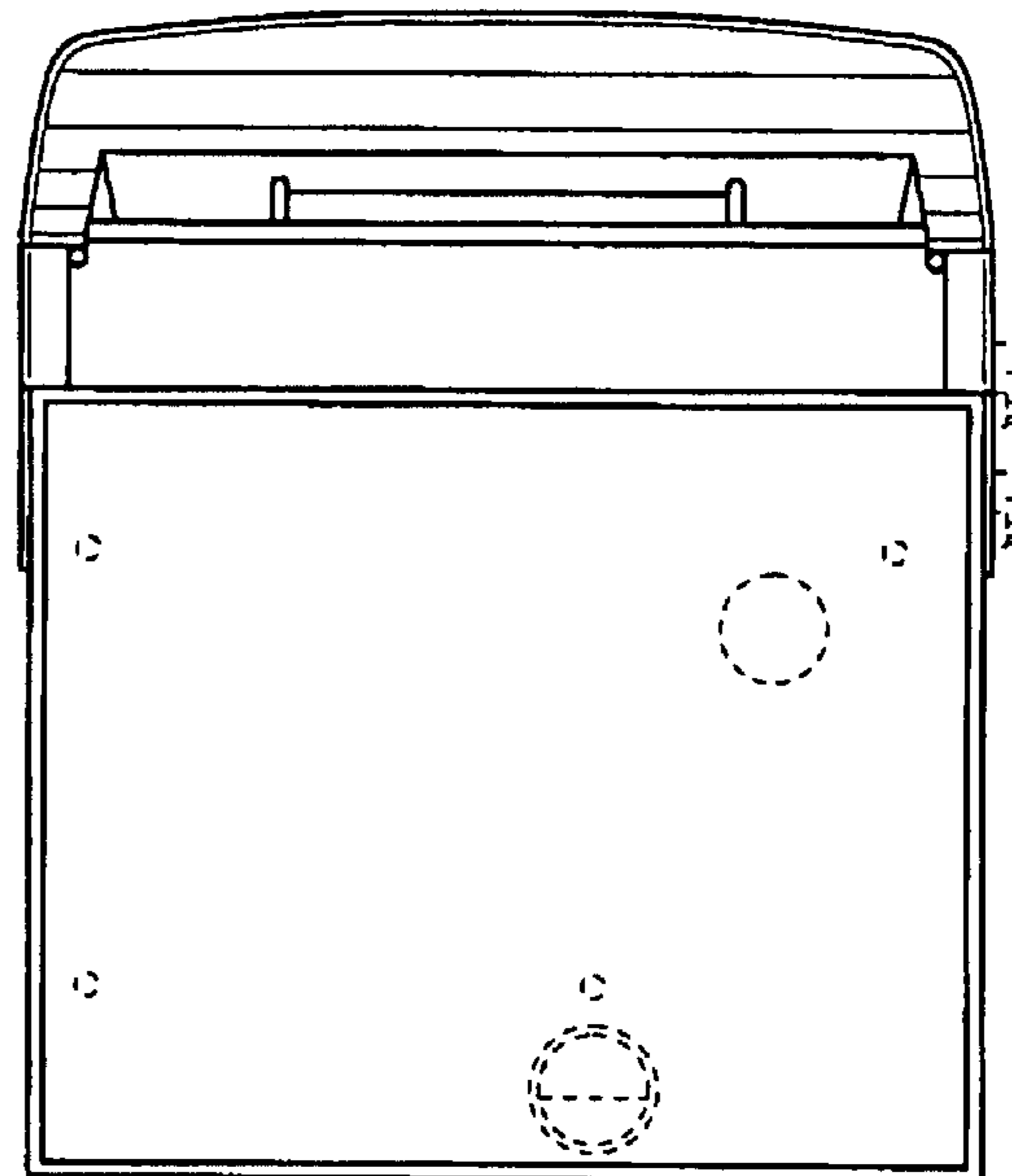

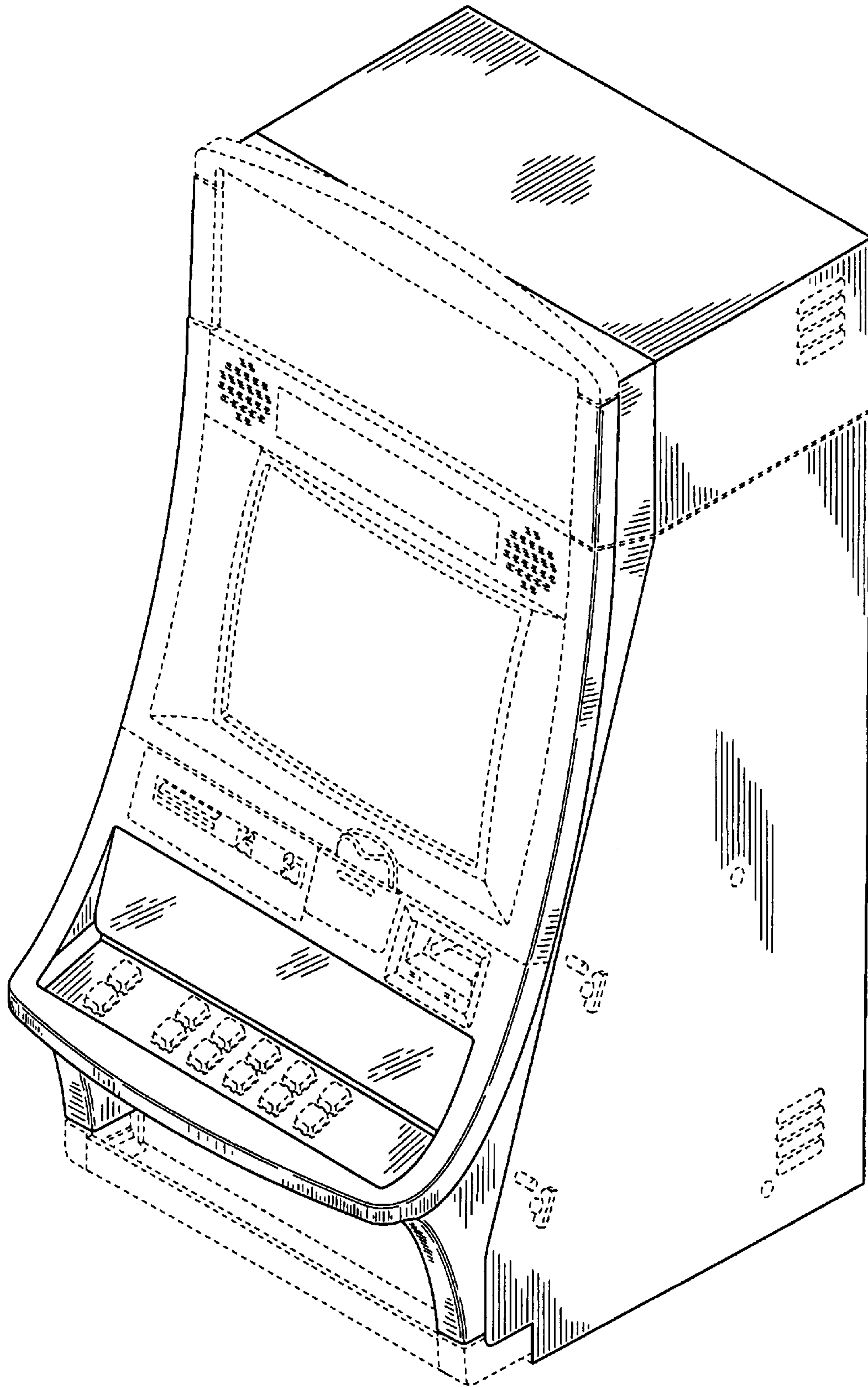

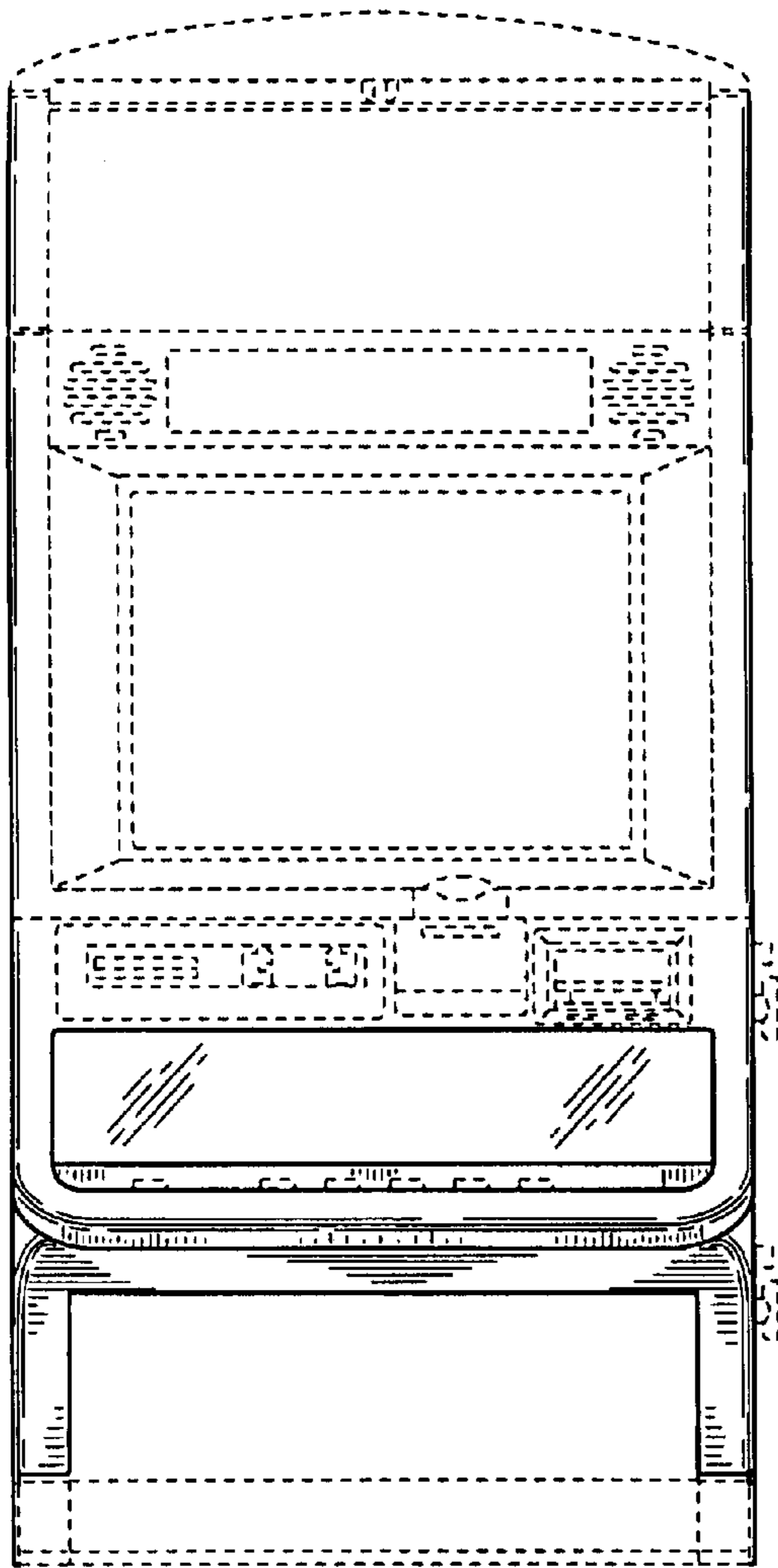

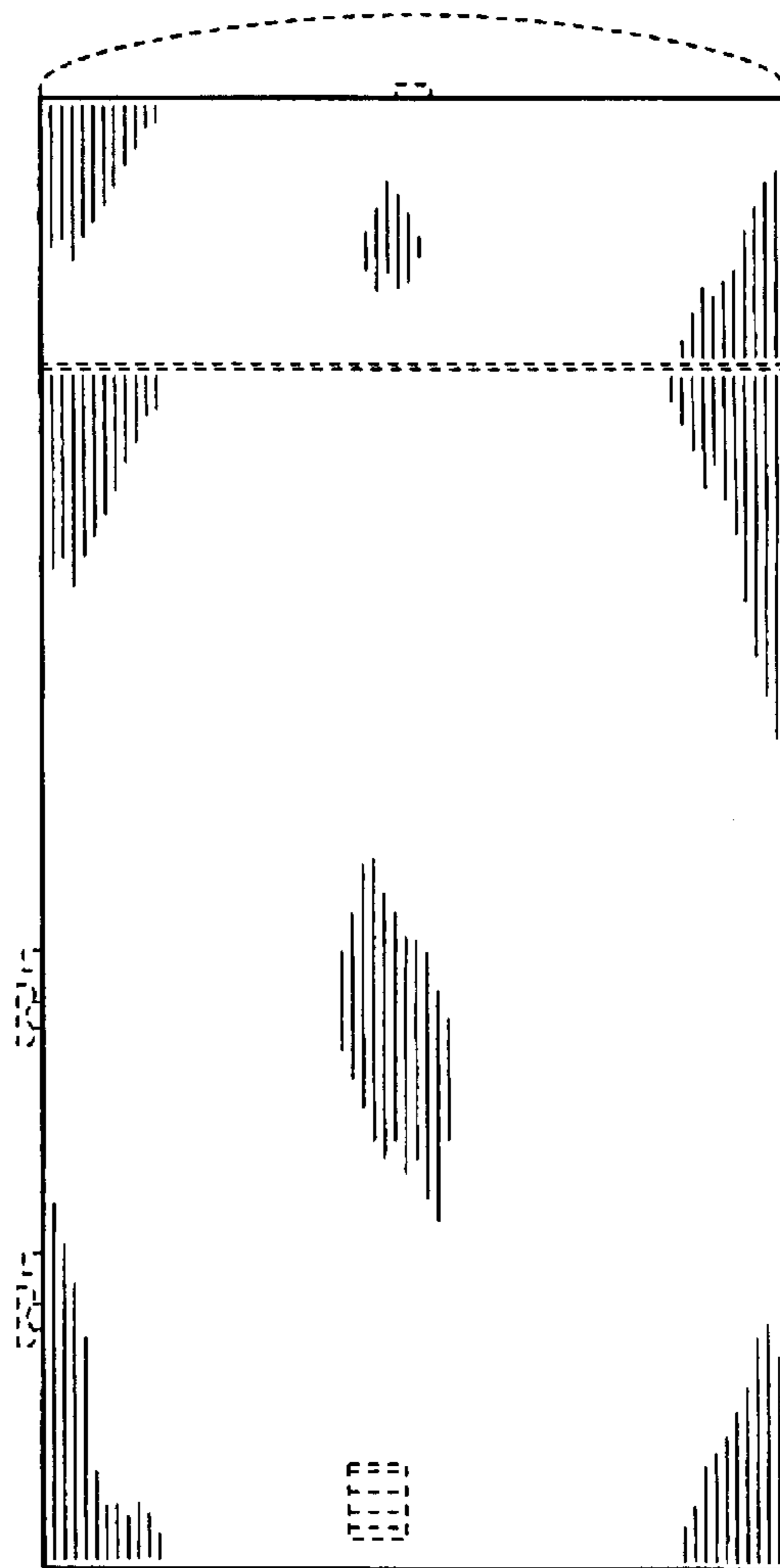

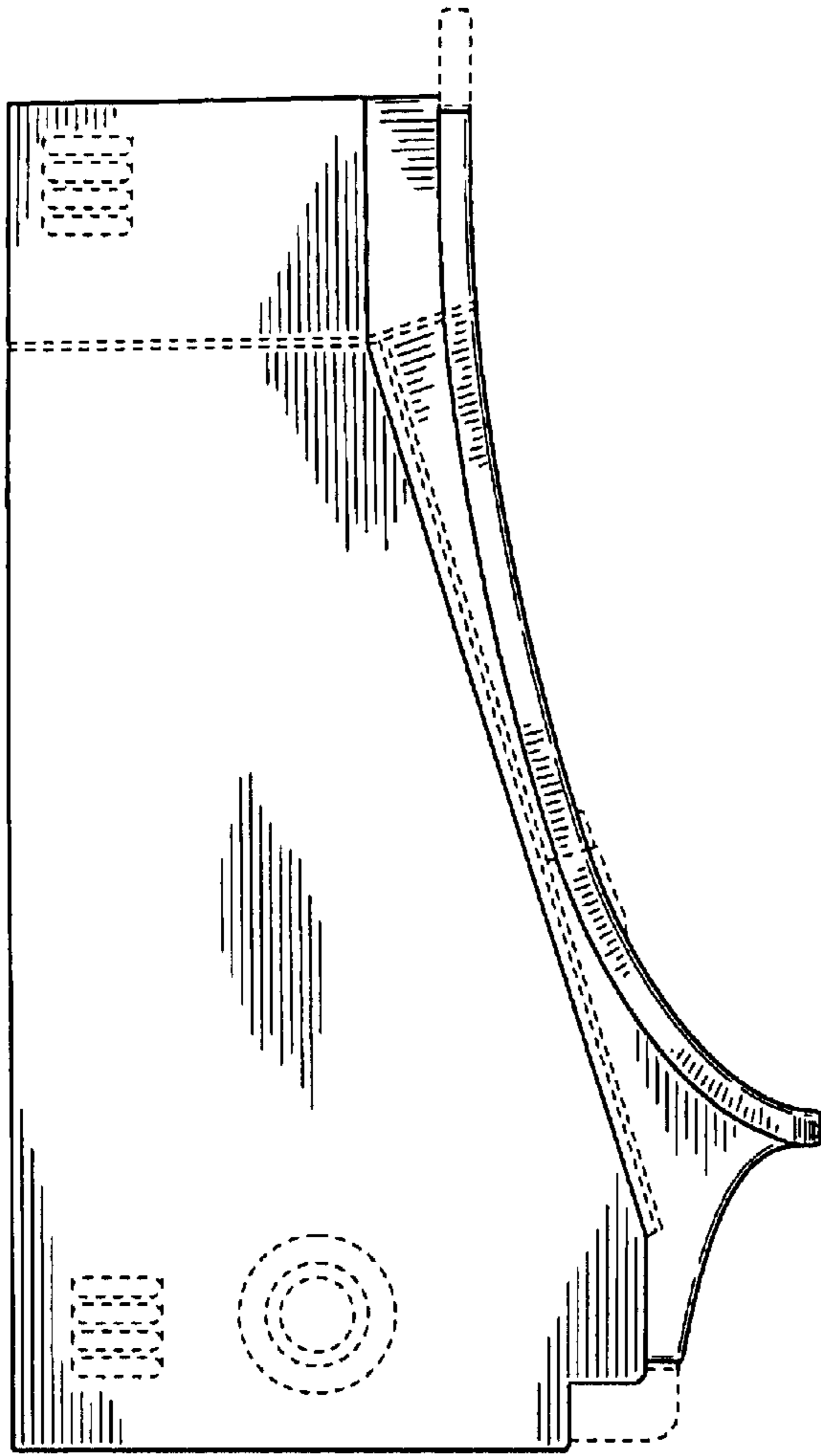

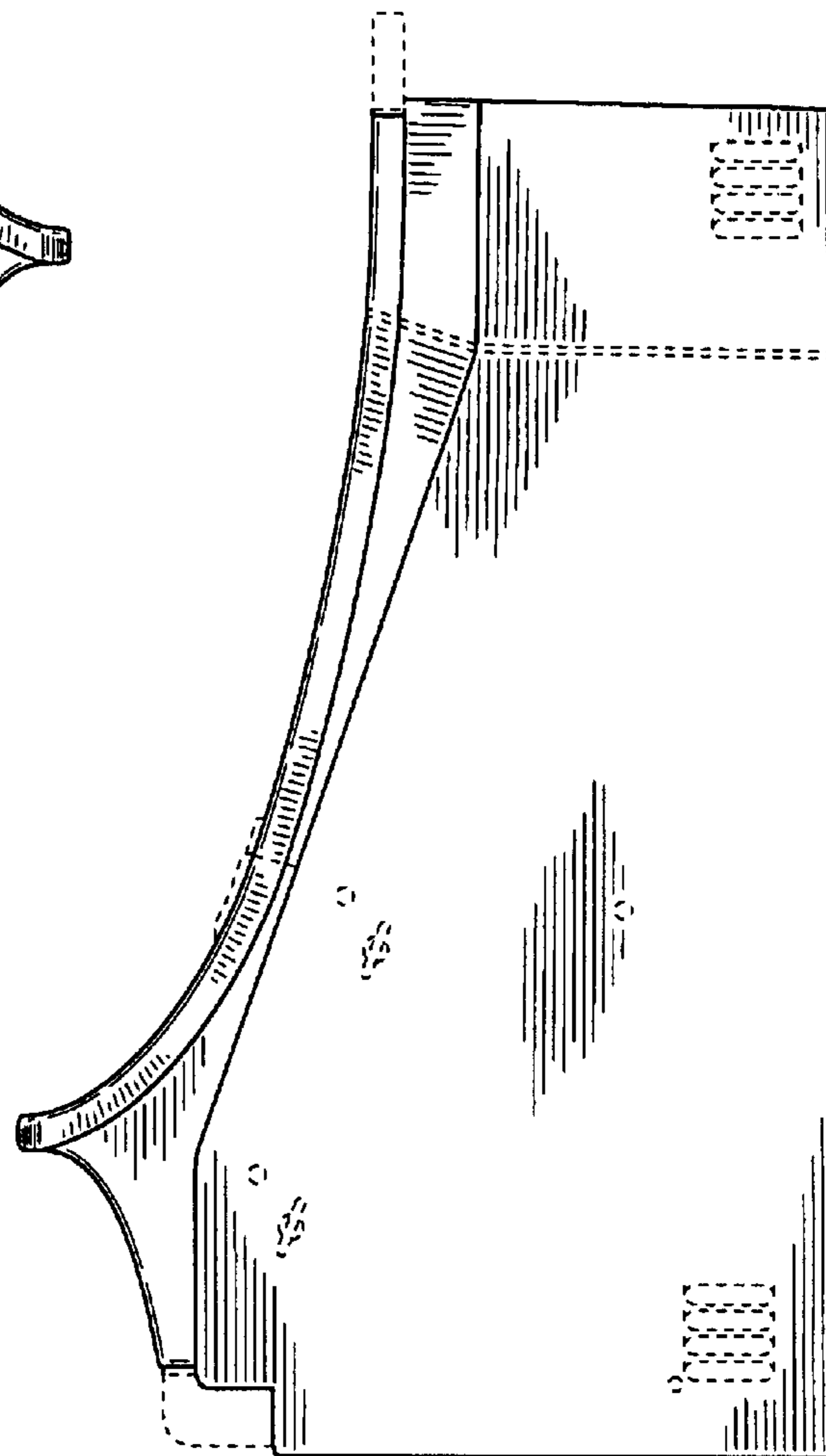

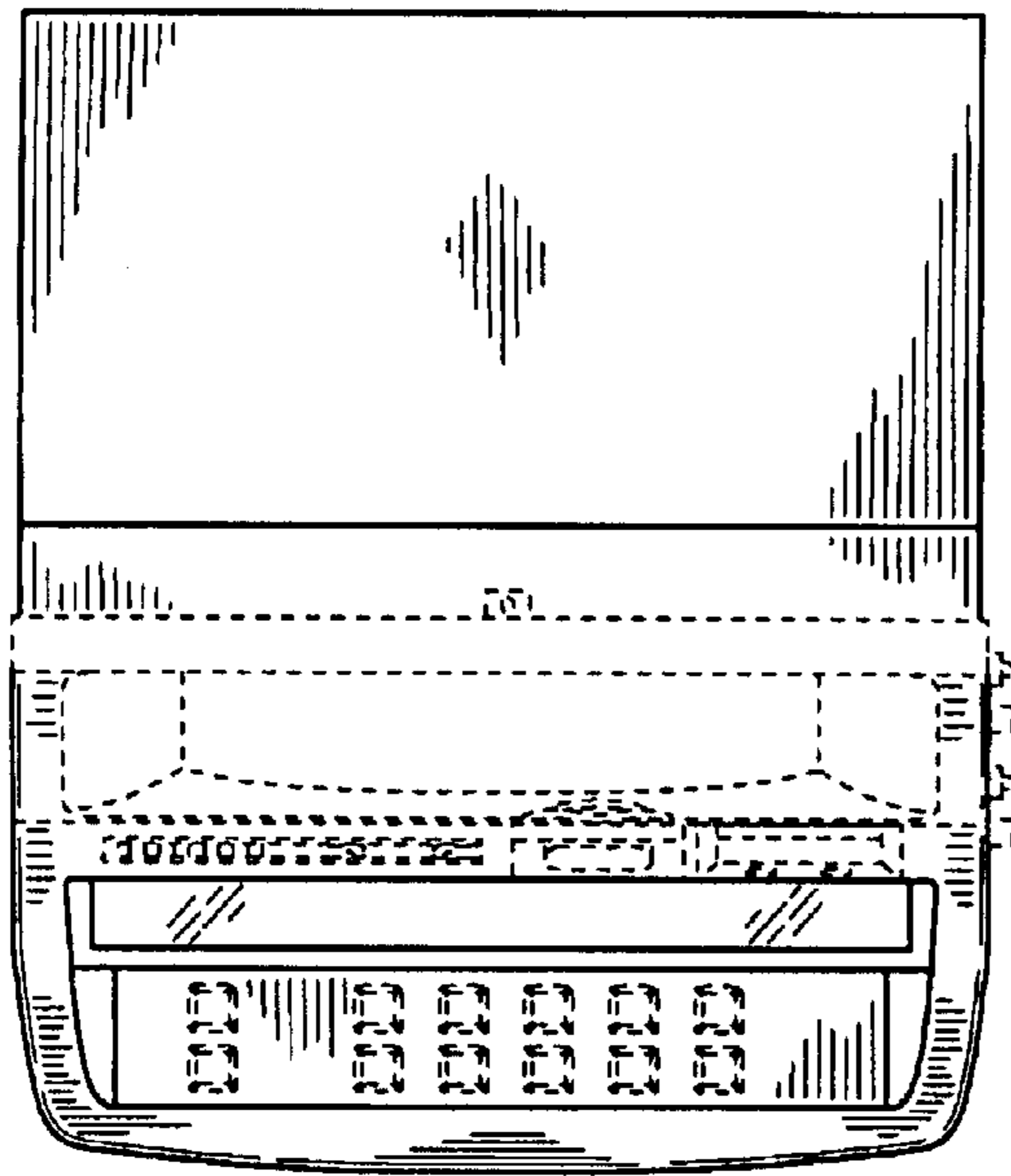

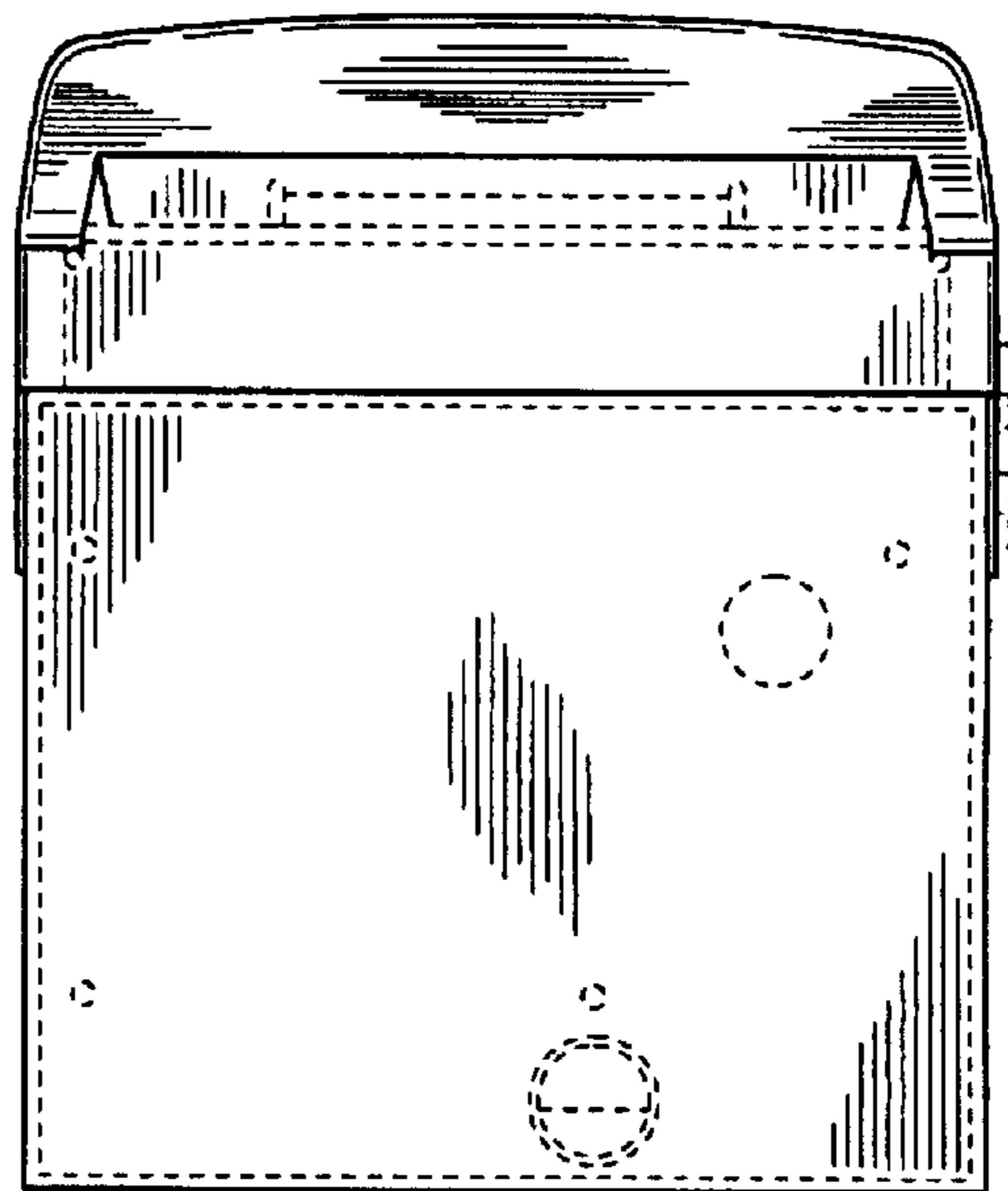
